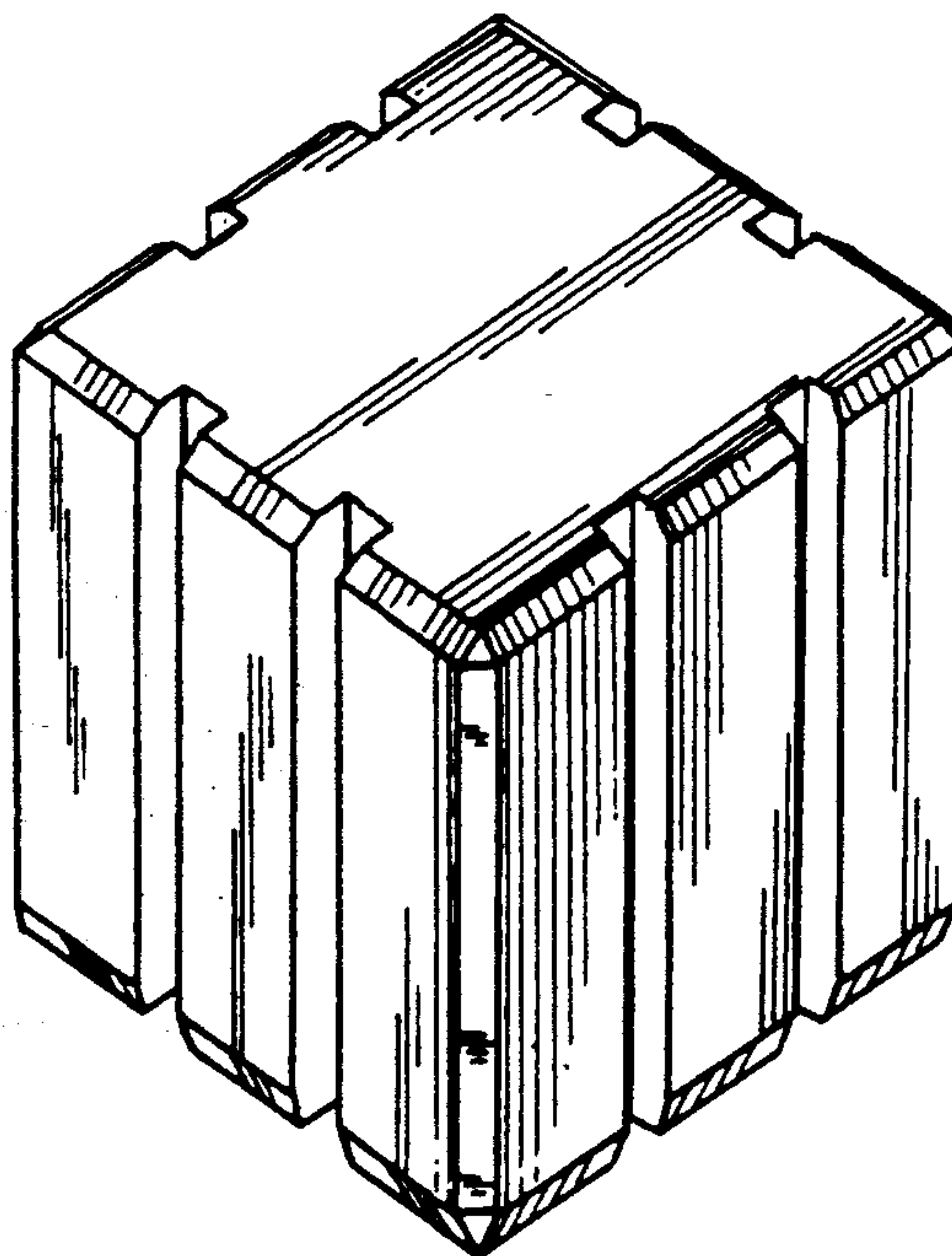
The ornamental design for a moth deterrent cube, as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a front view in elevation, the rear, left and right sides being mirror images thereof.



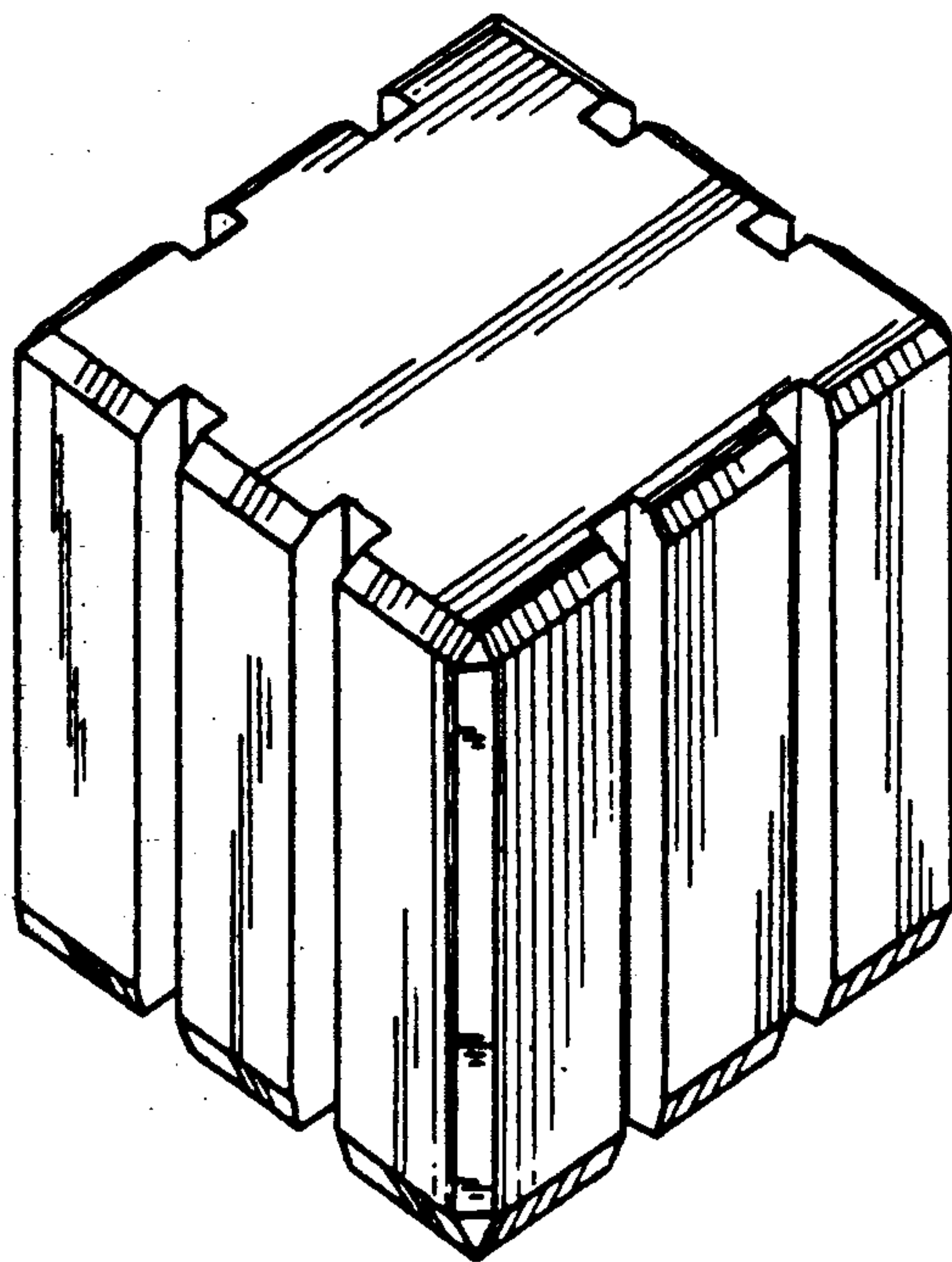

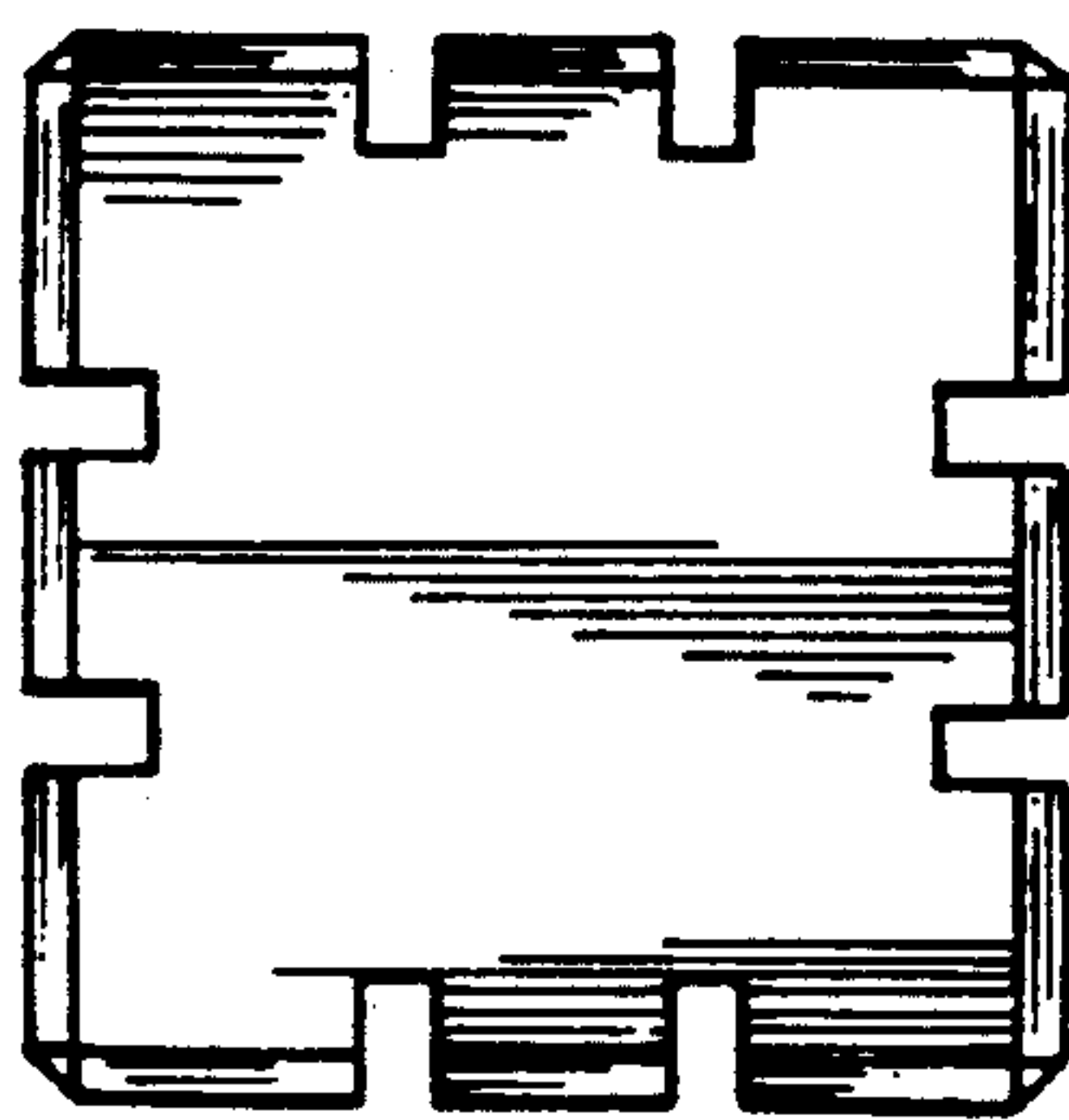

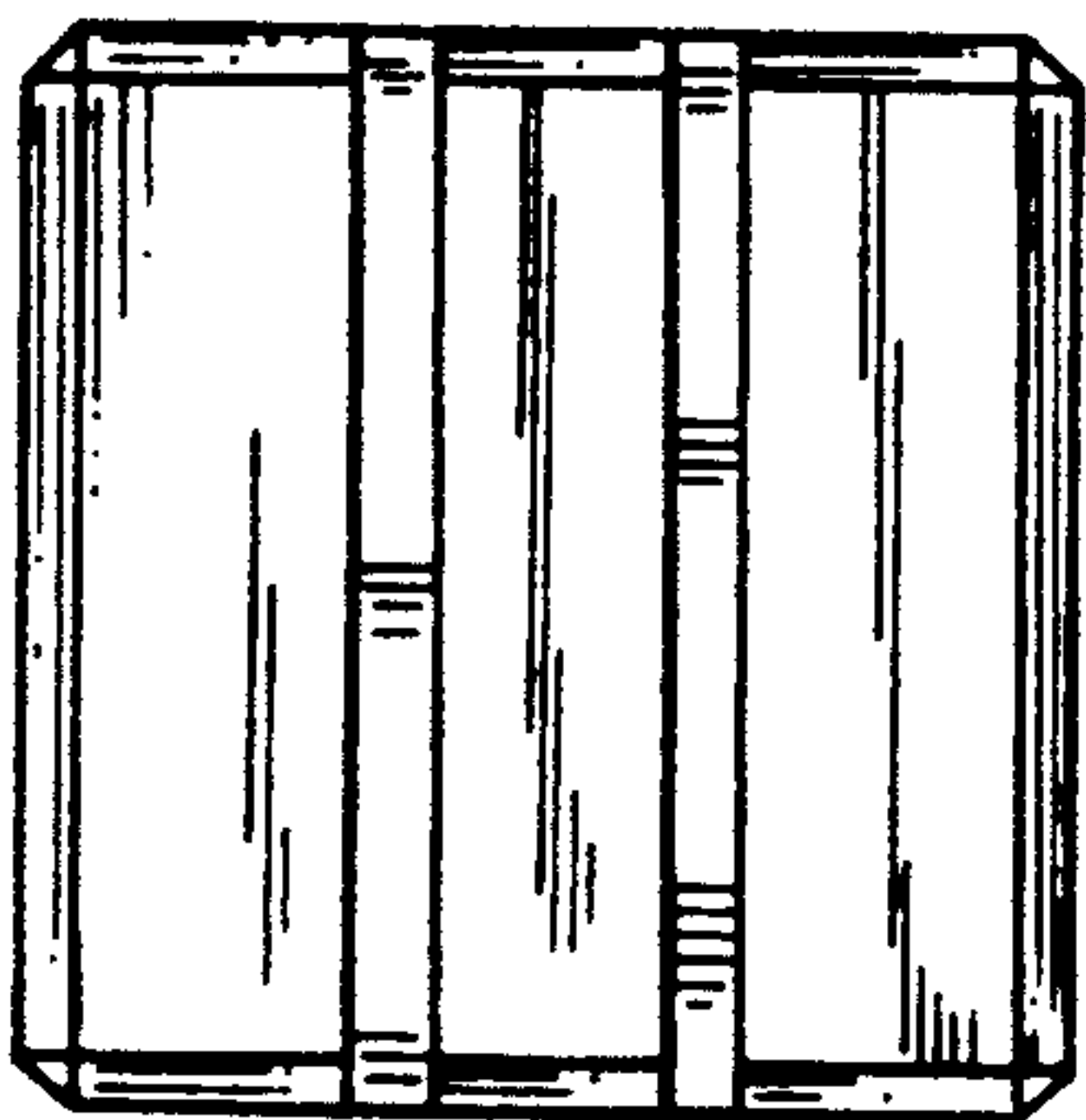
