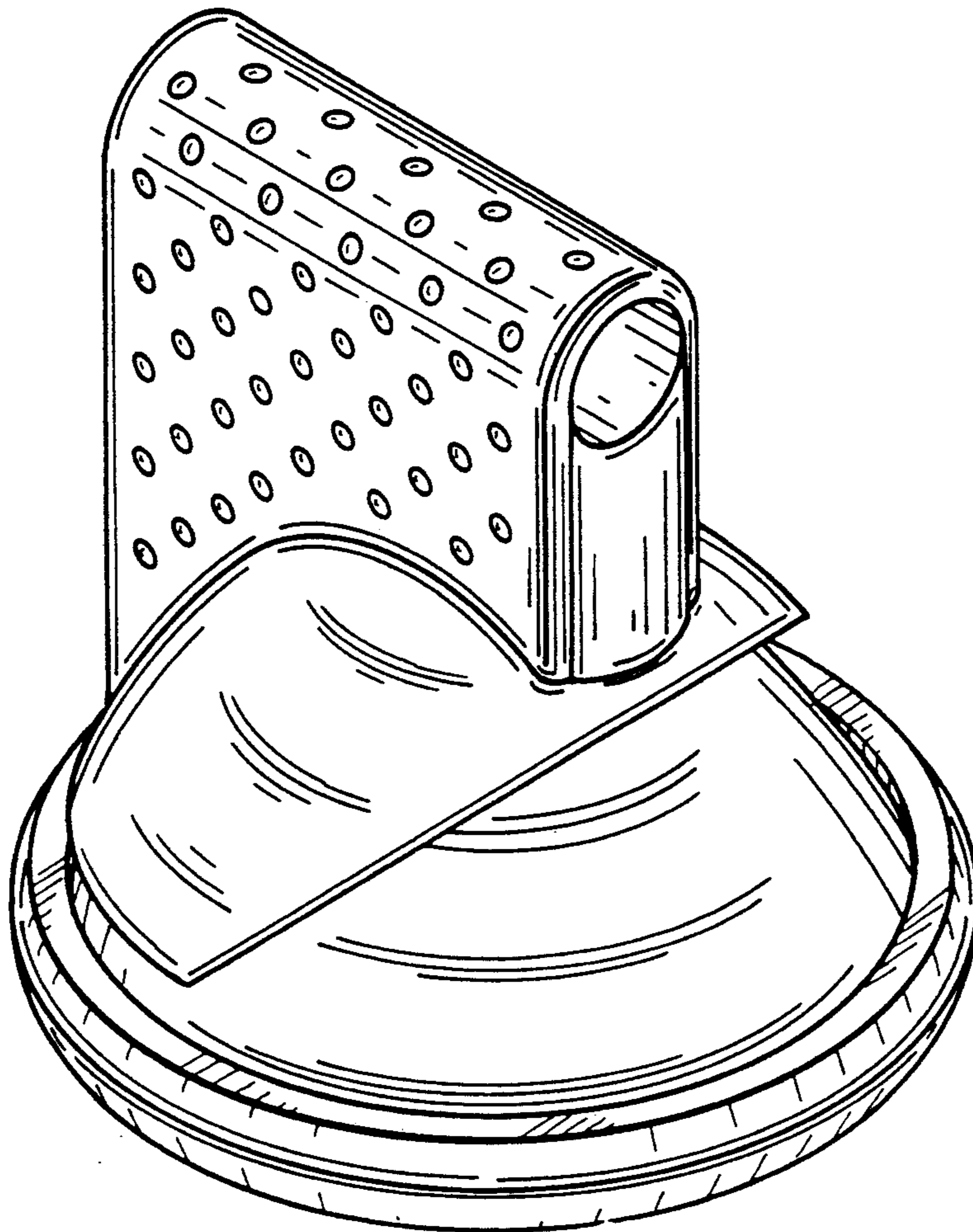

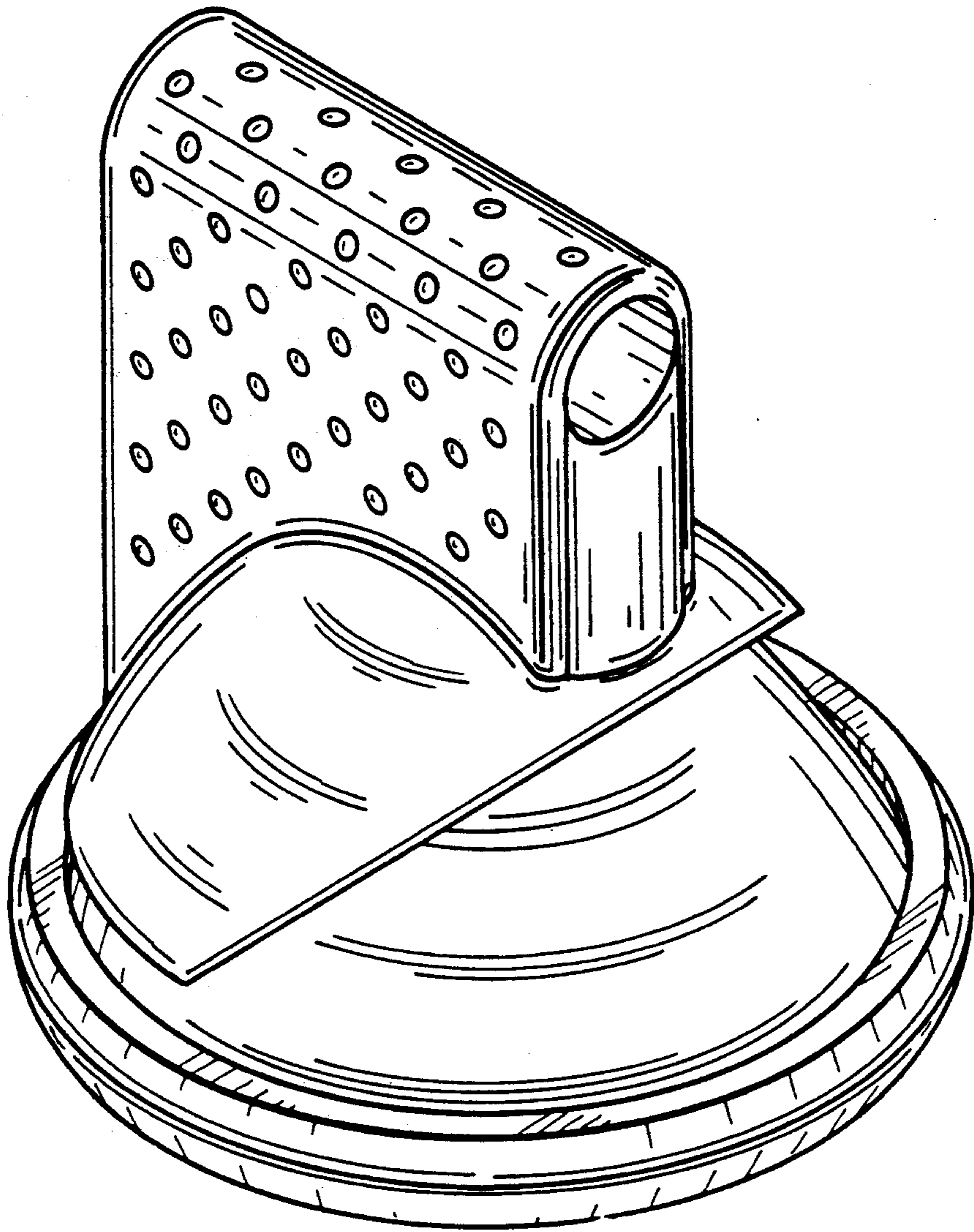

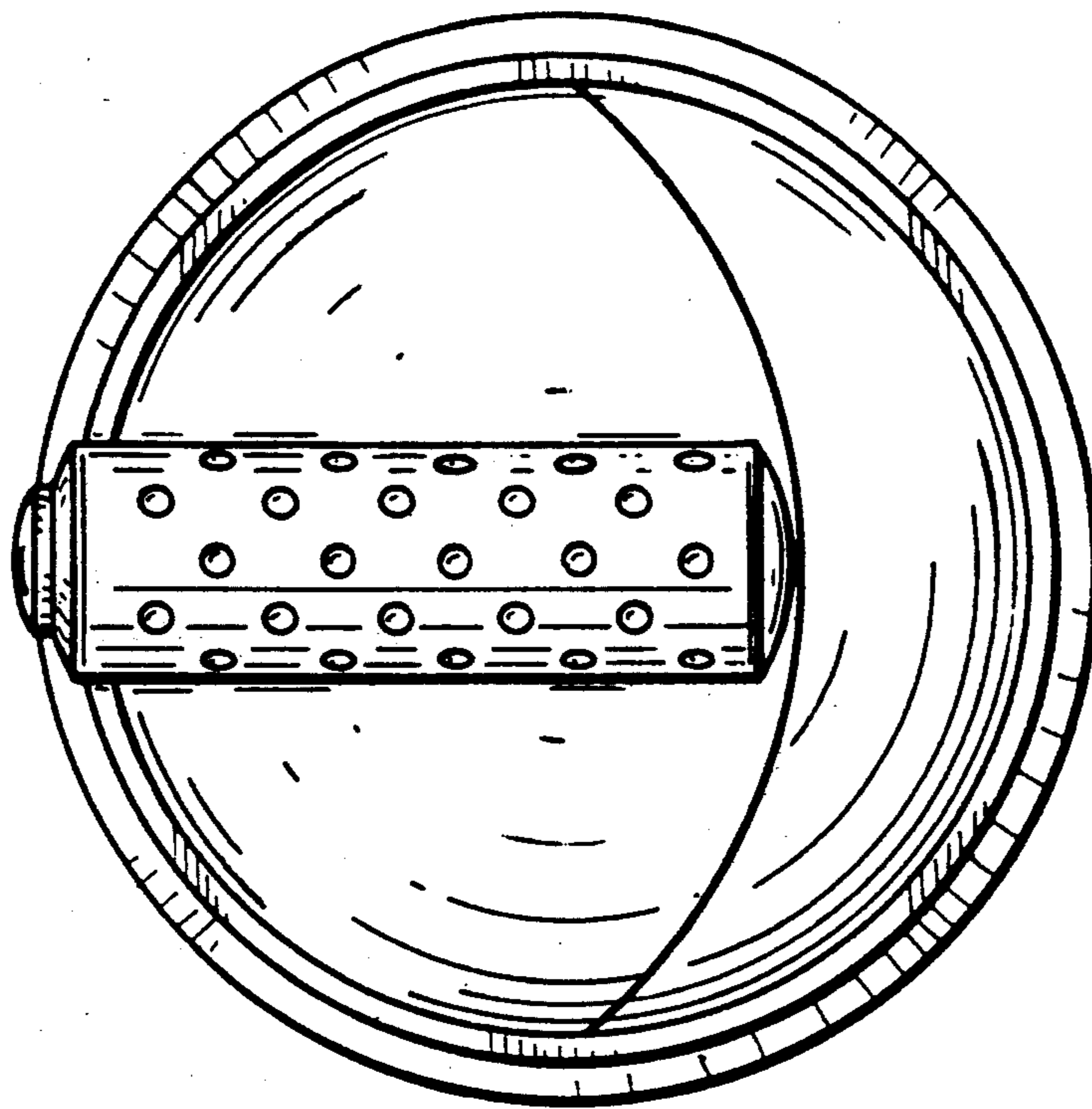
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of another embodiment of

ment only in that the mounting bracket is plain.

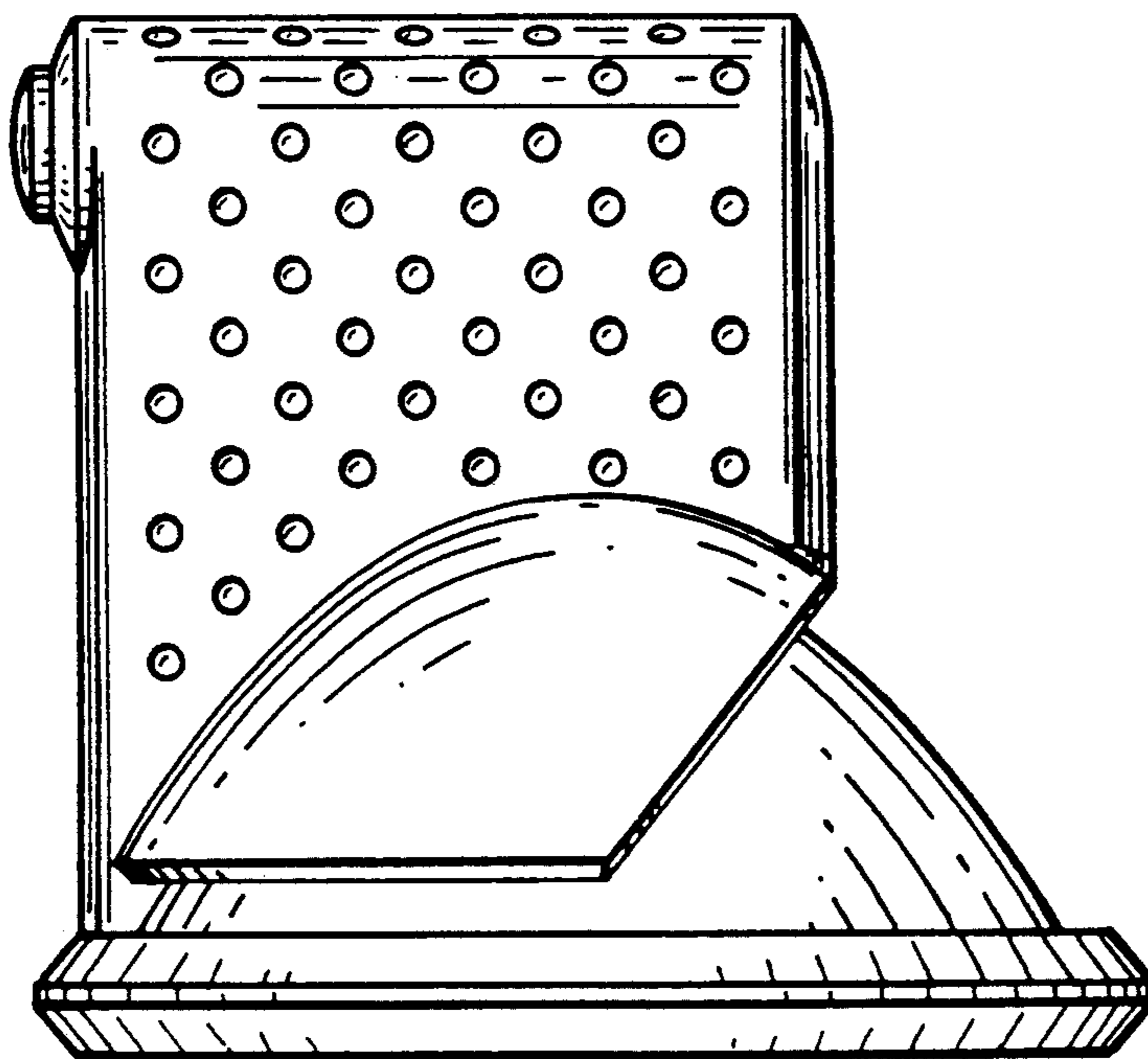




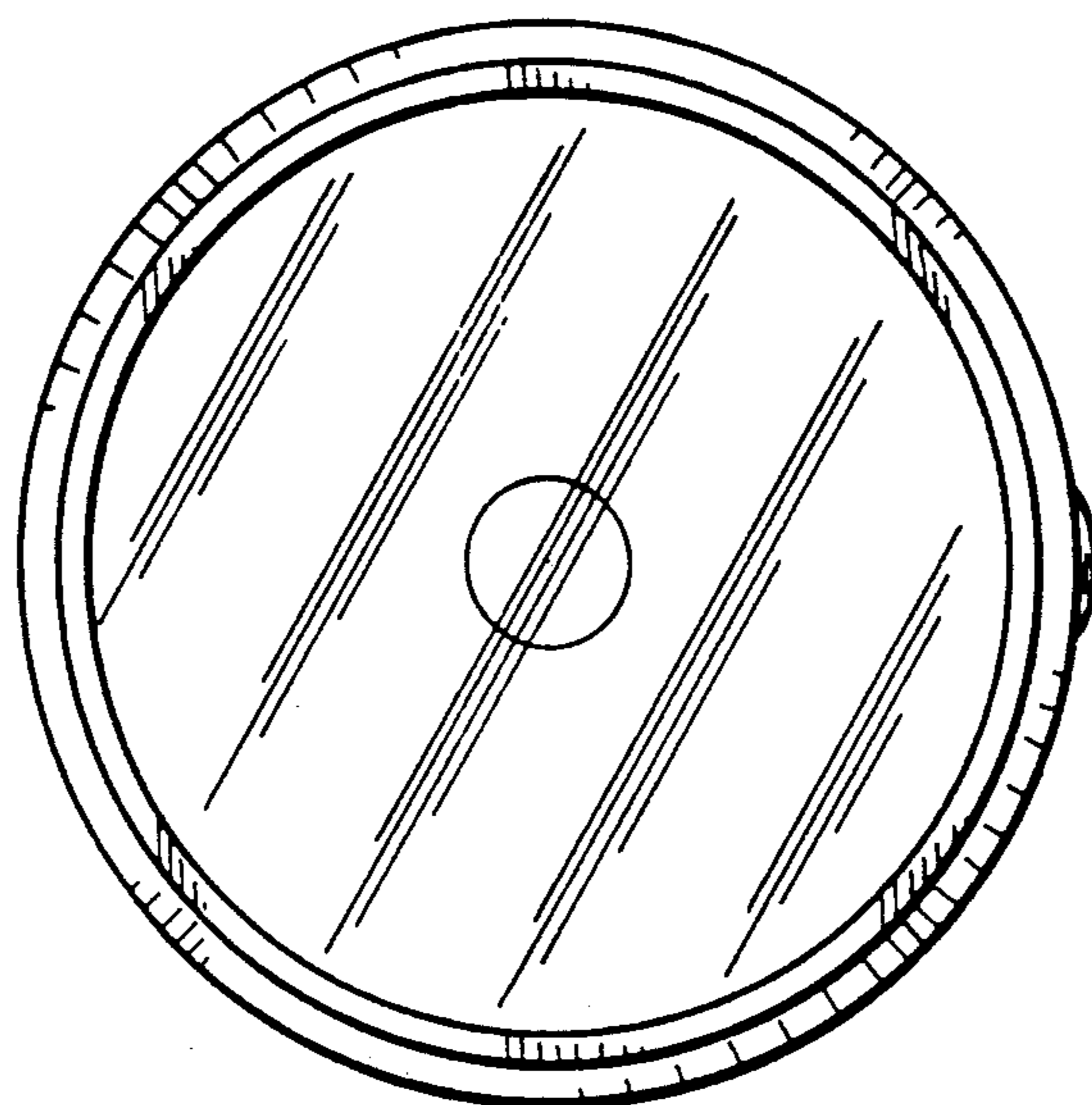

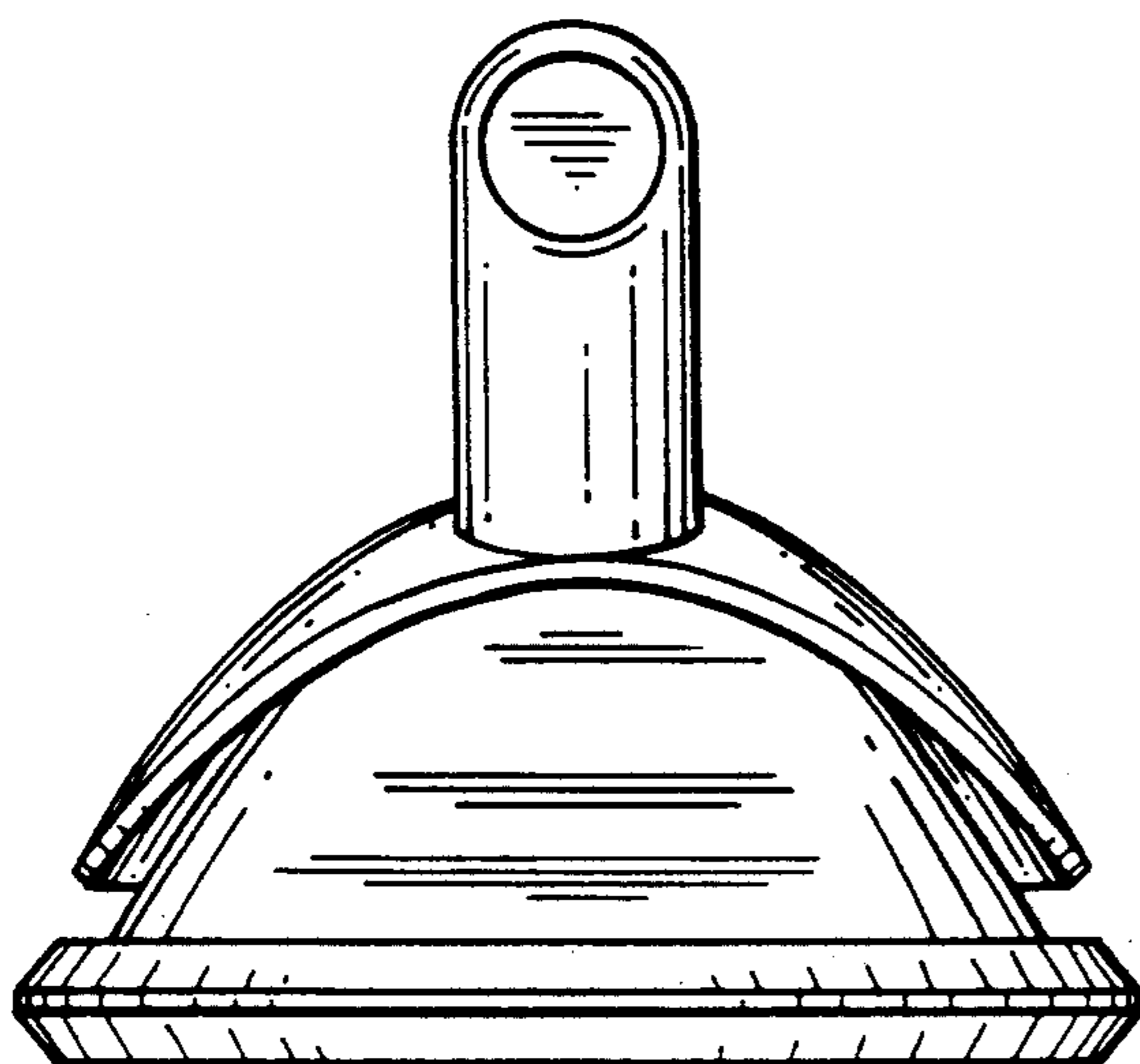

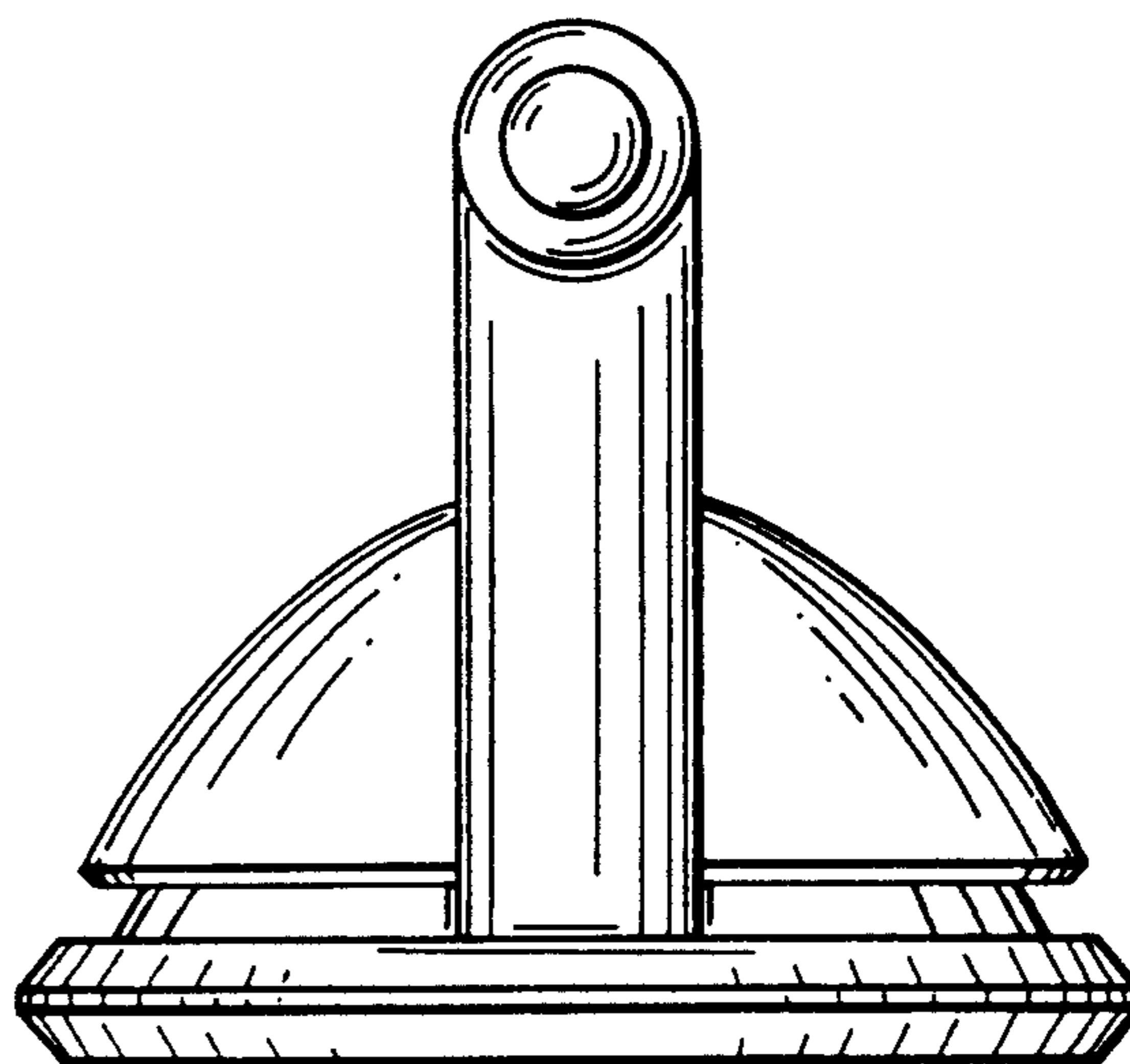

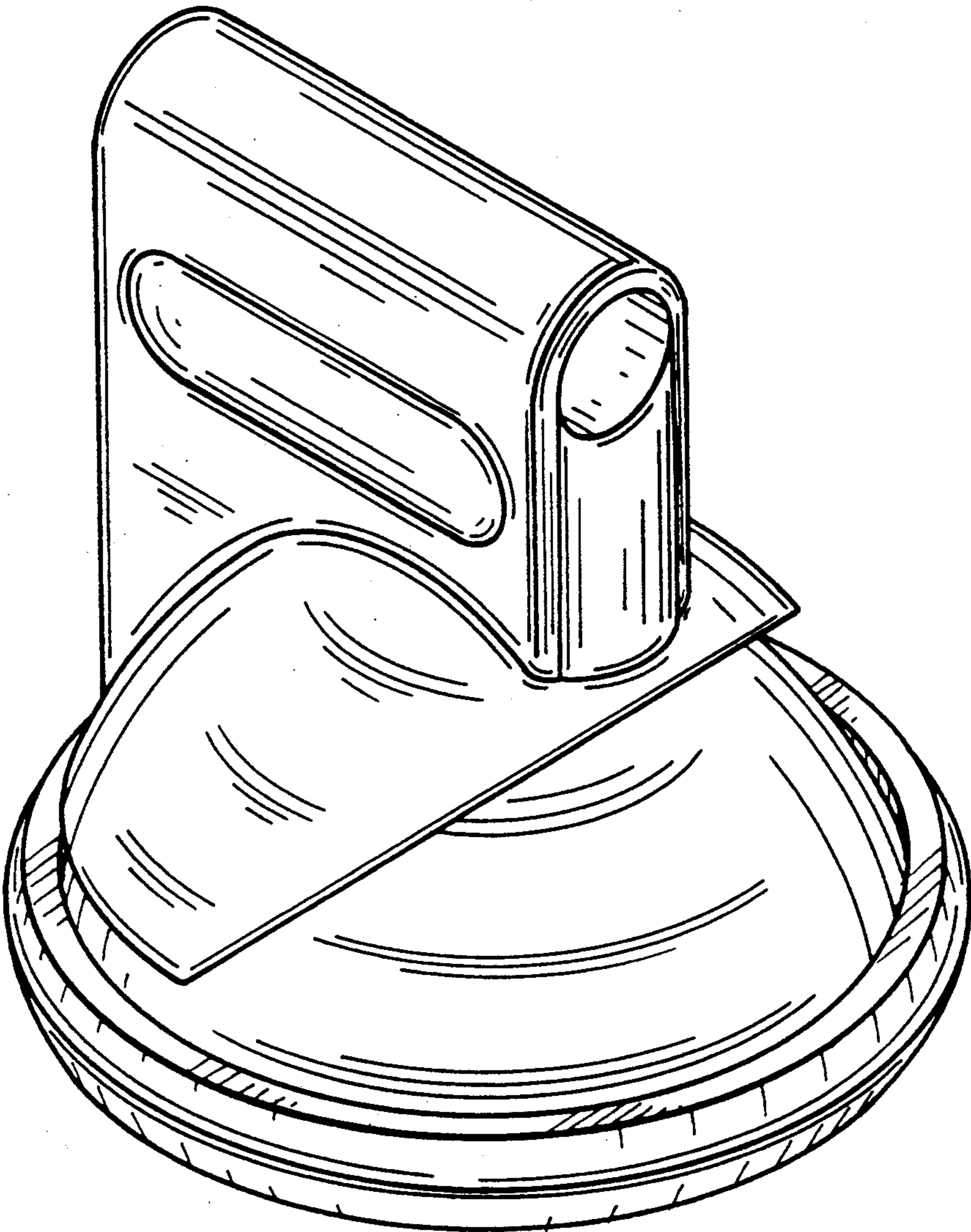

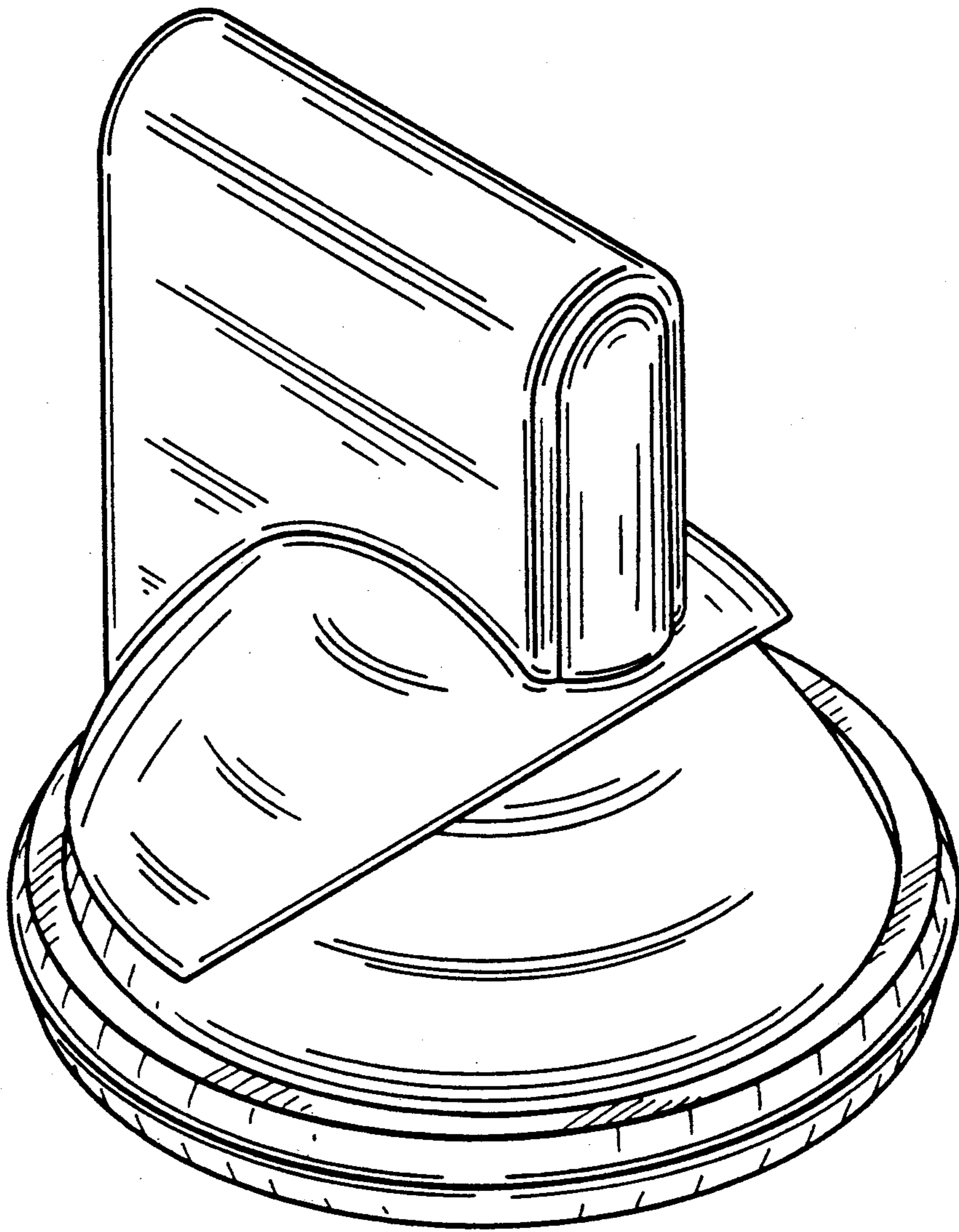
