FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

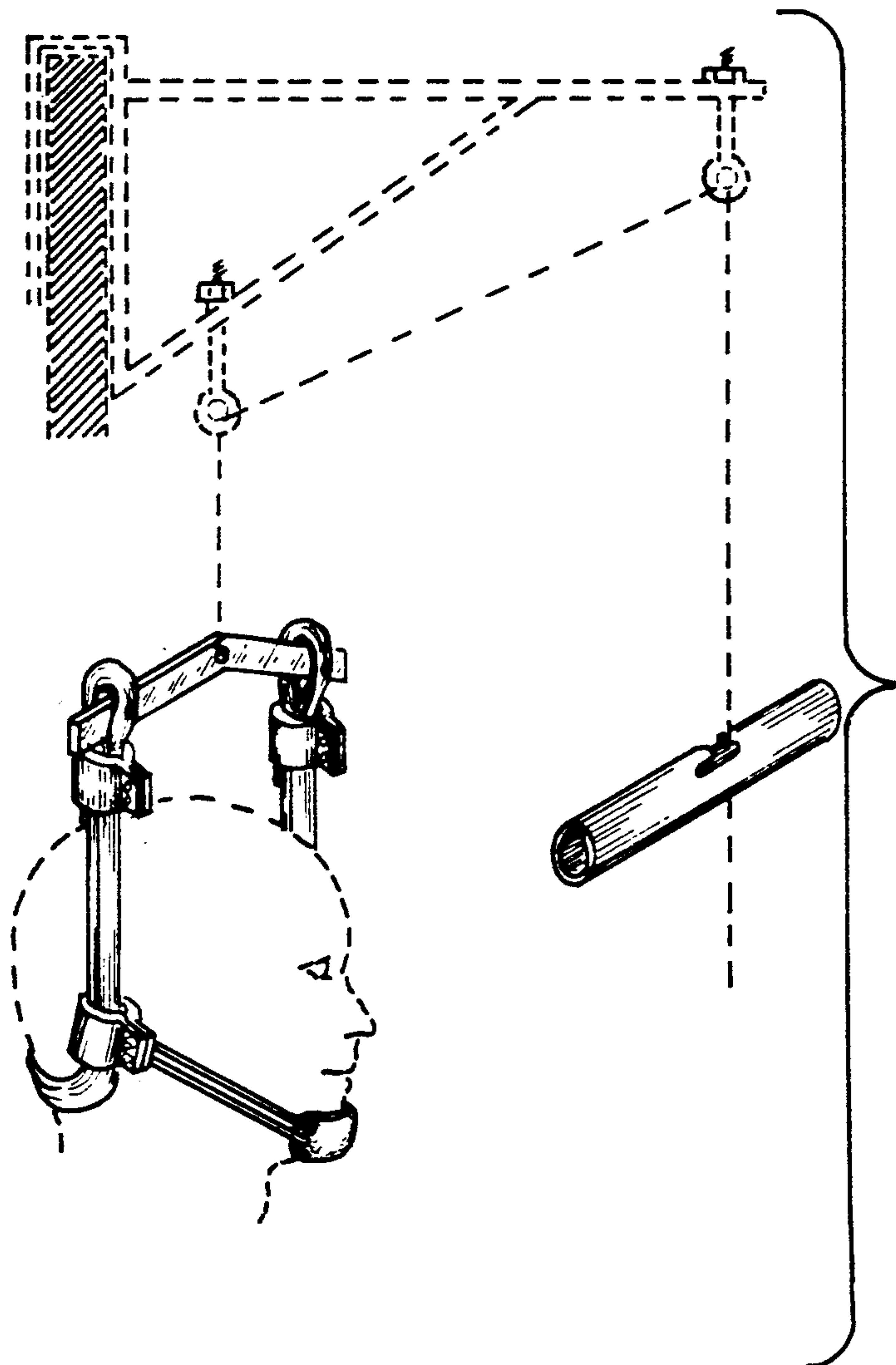
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the hand grasping bar; and,

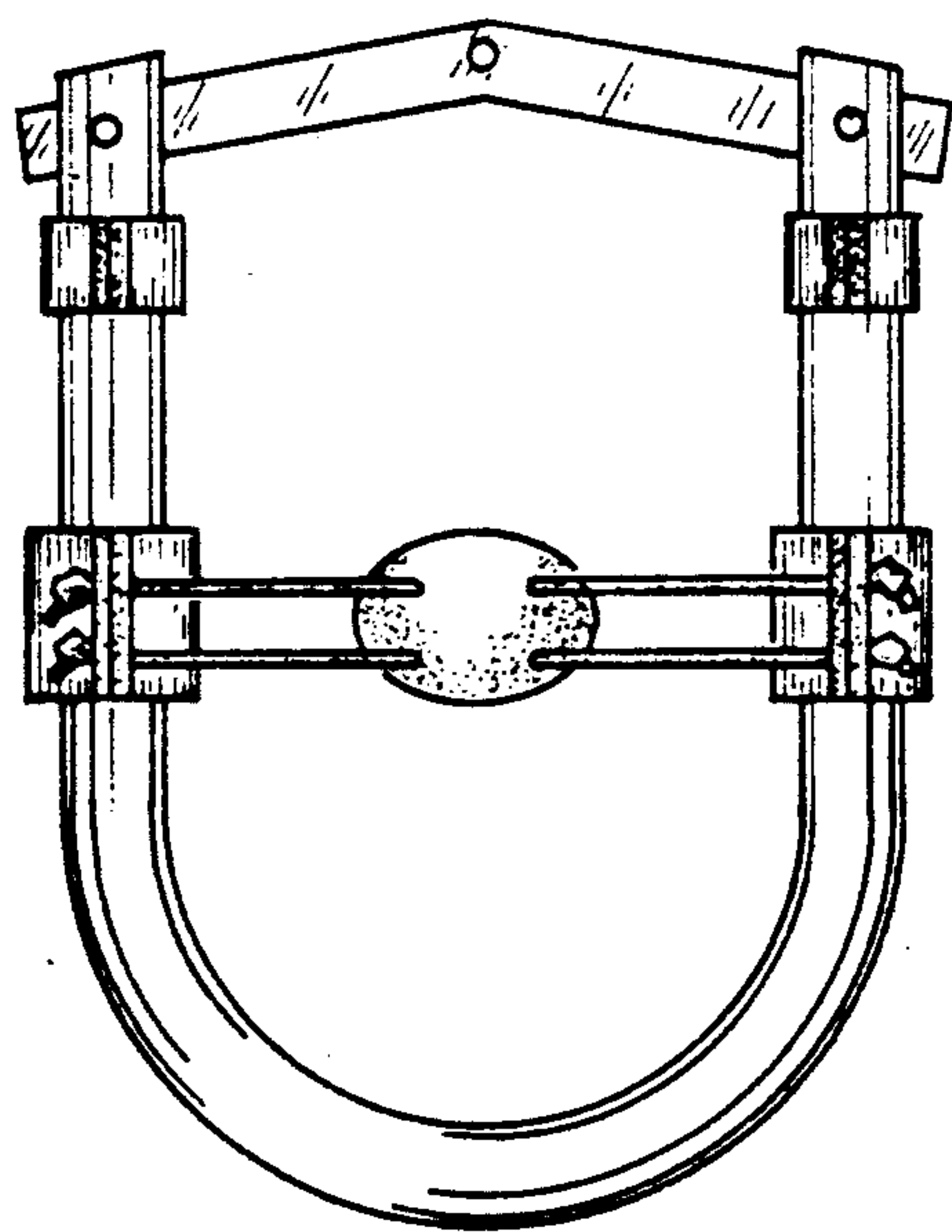

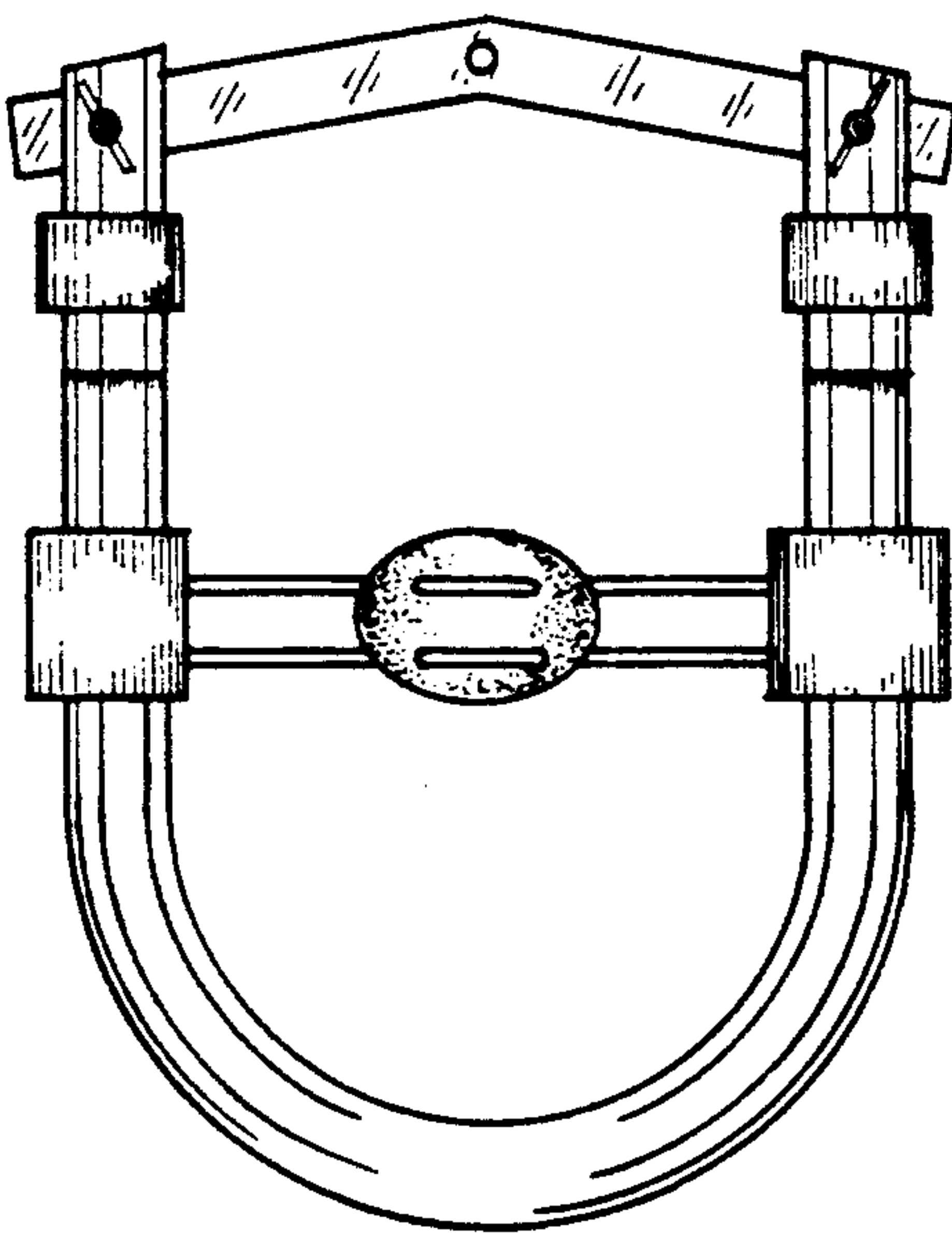

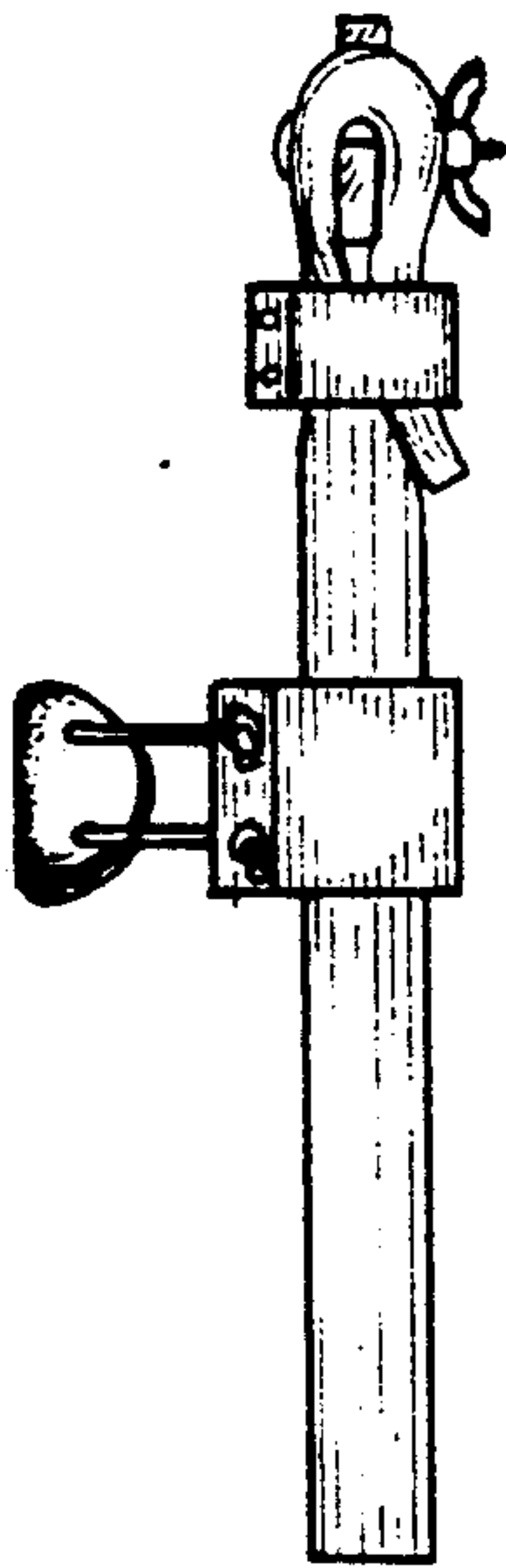

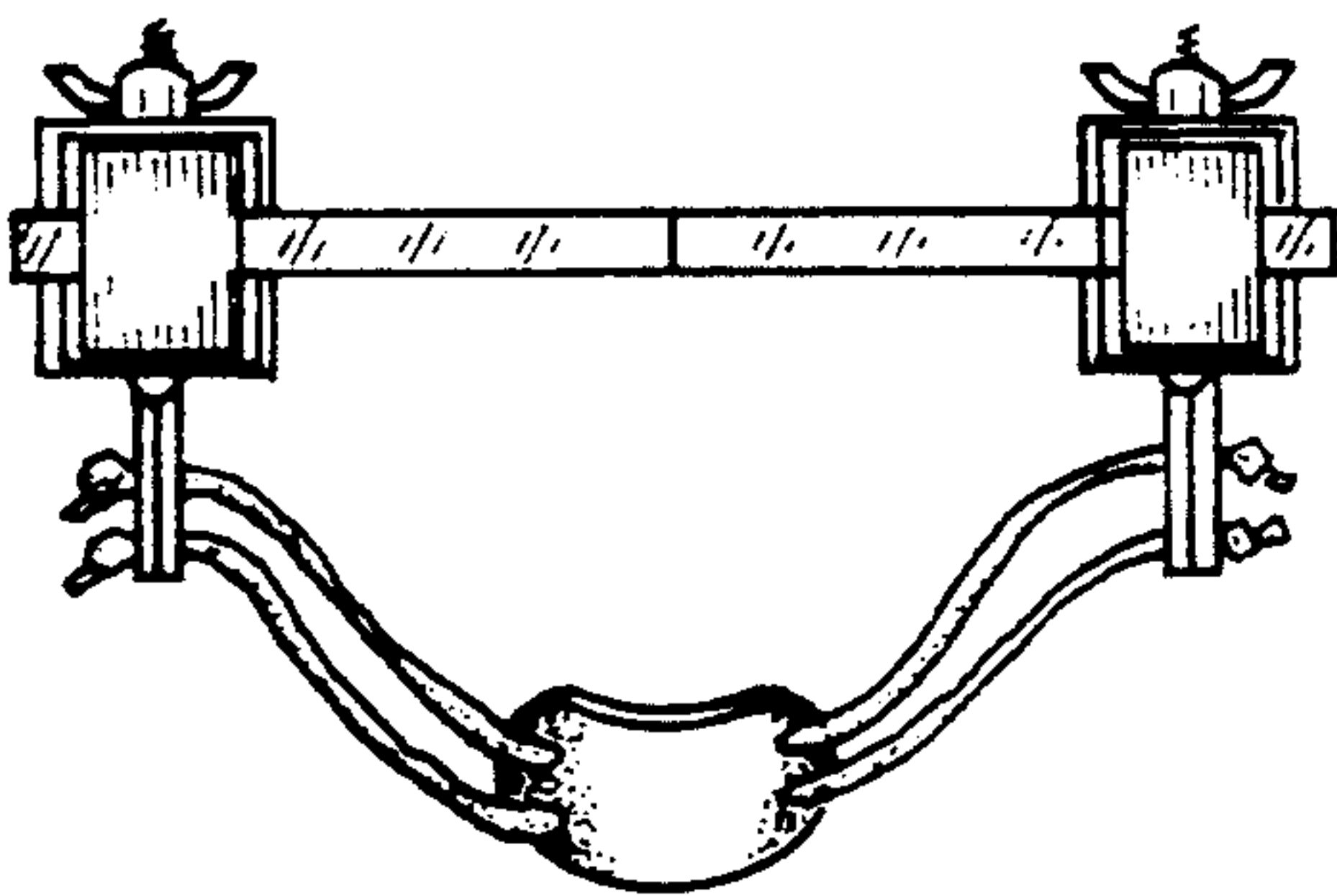

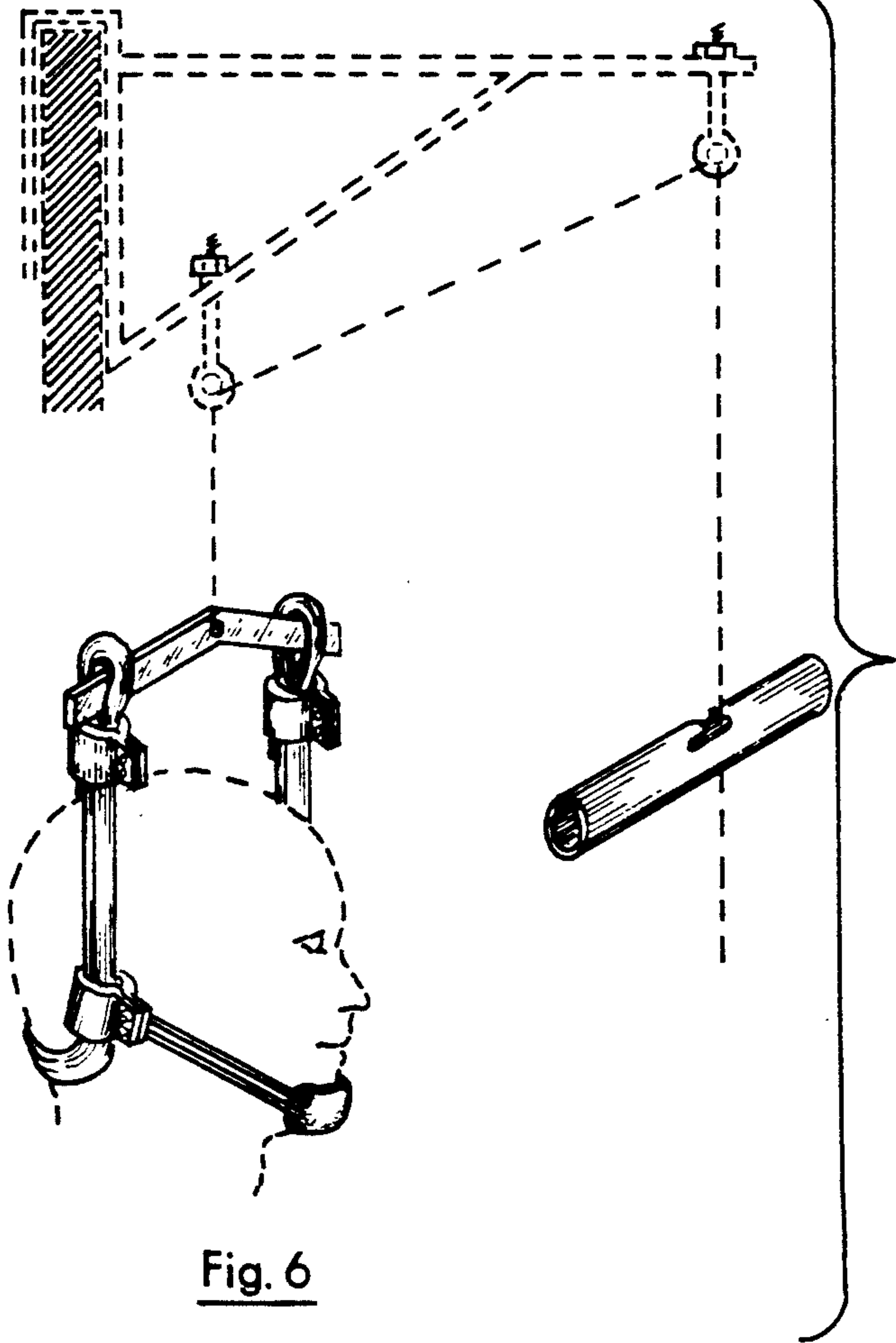
