FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof;

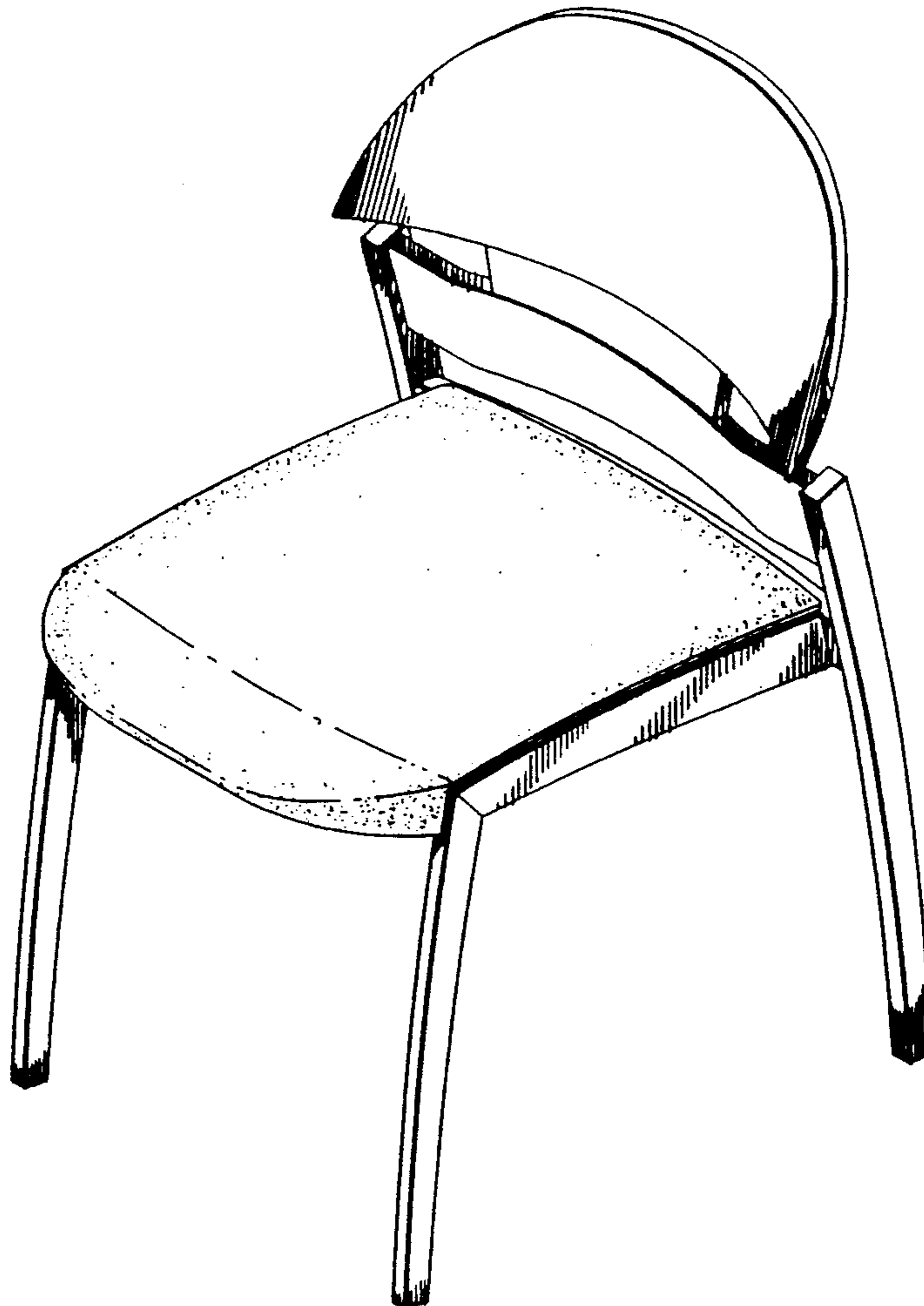
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of the chair showing our new design with the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 10 is a top perspective view thereof.



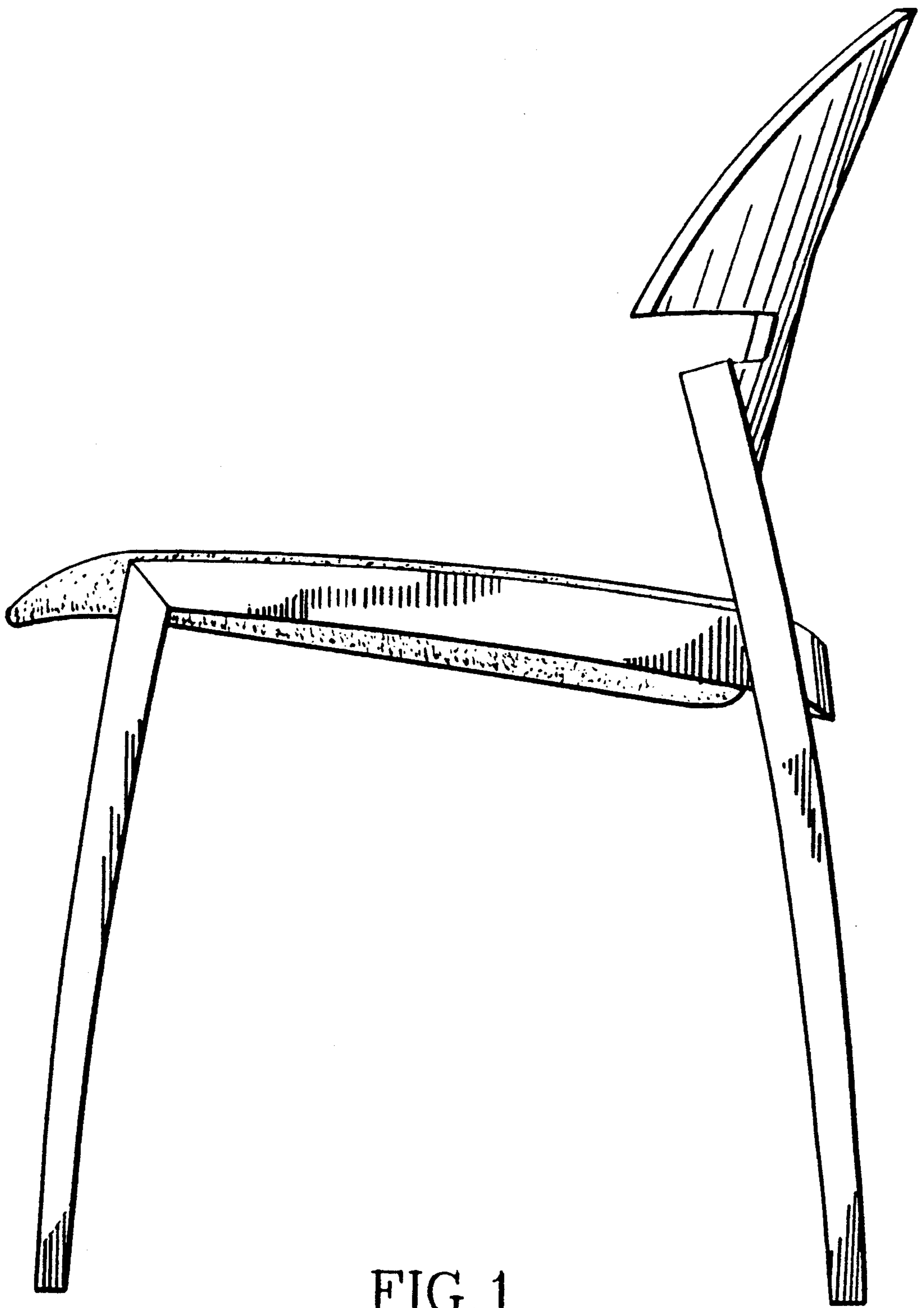

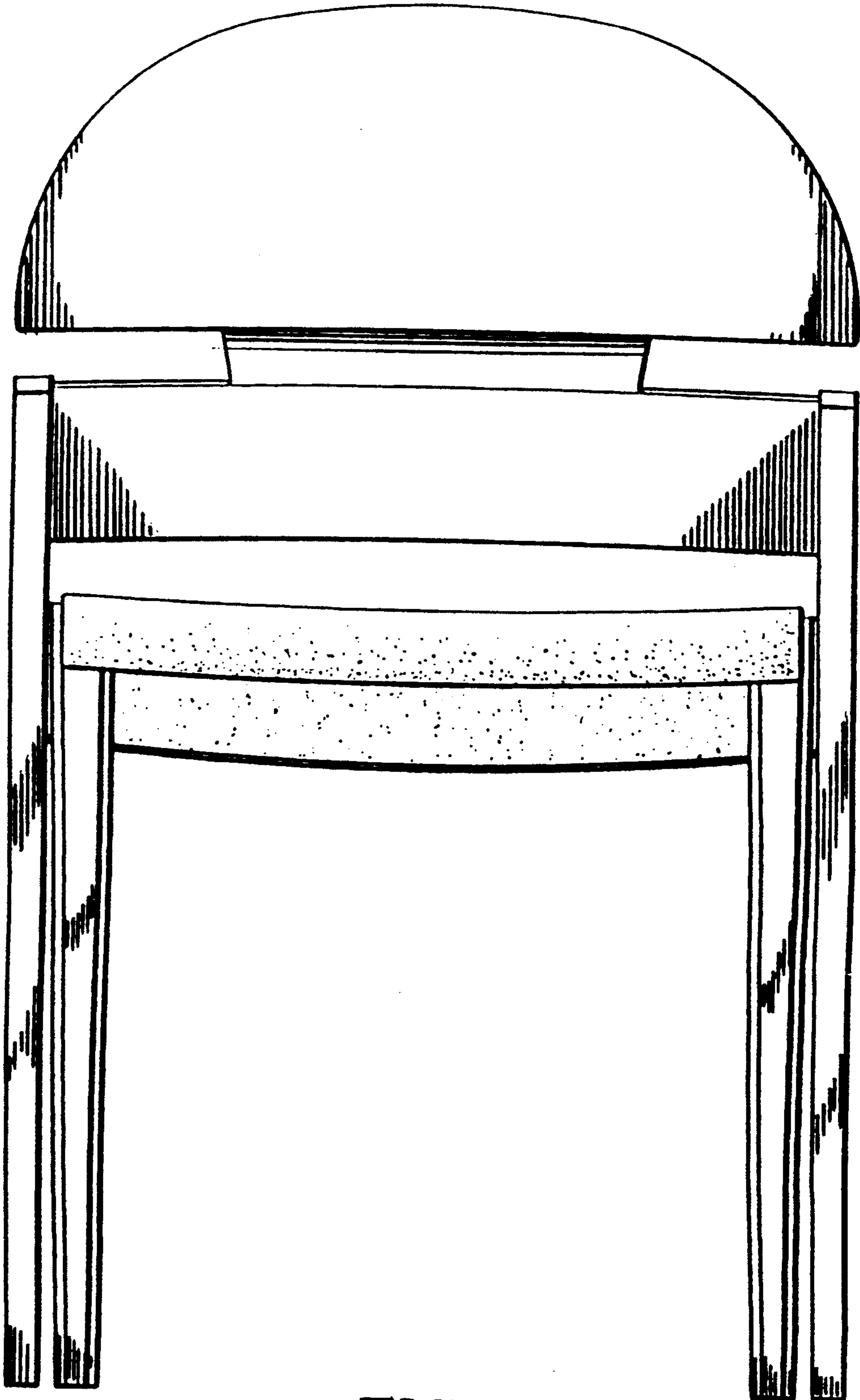

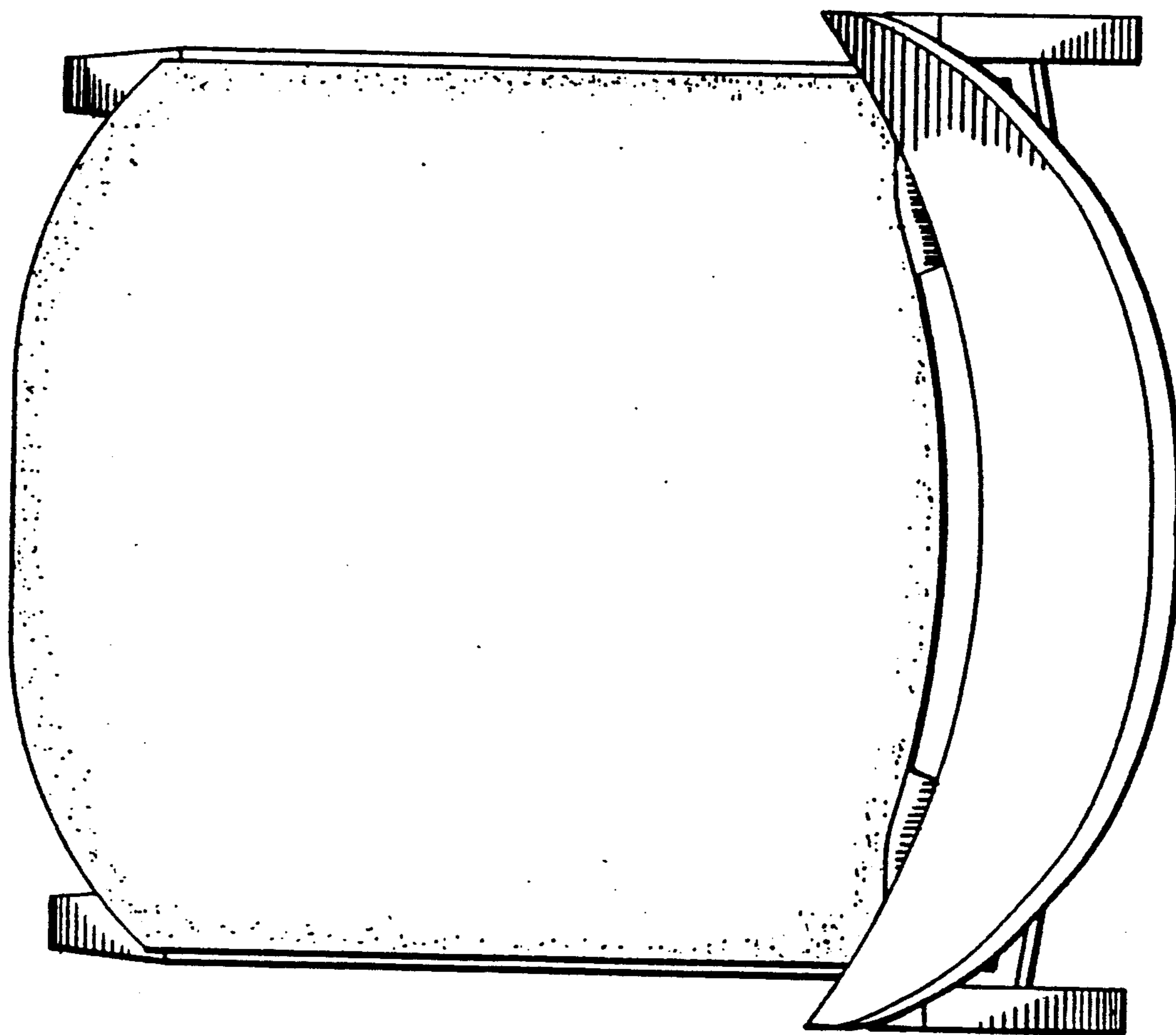

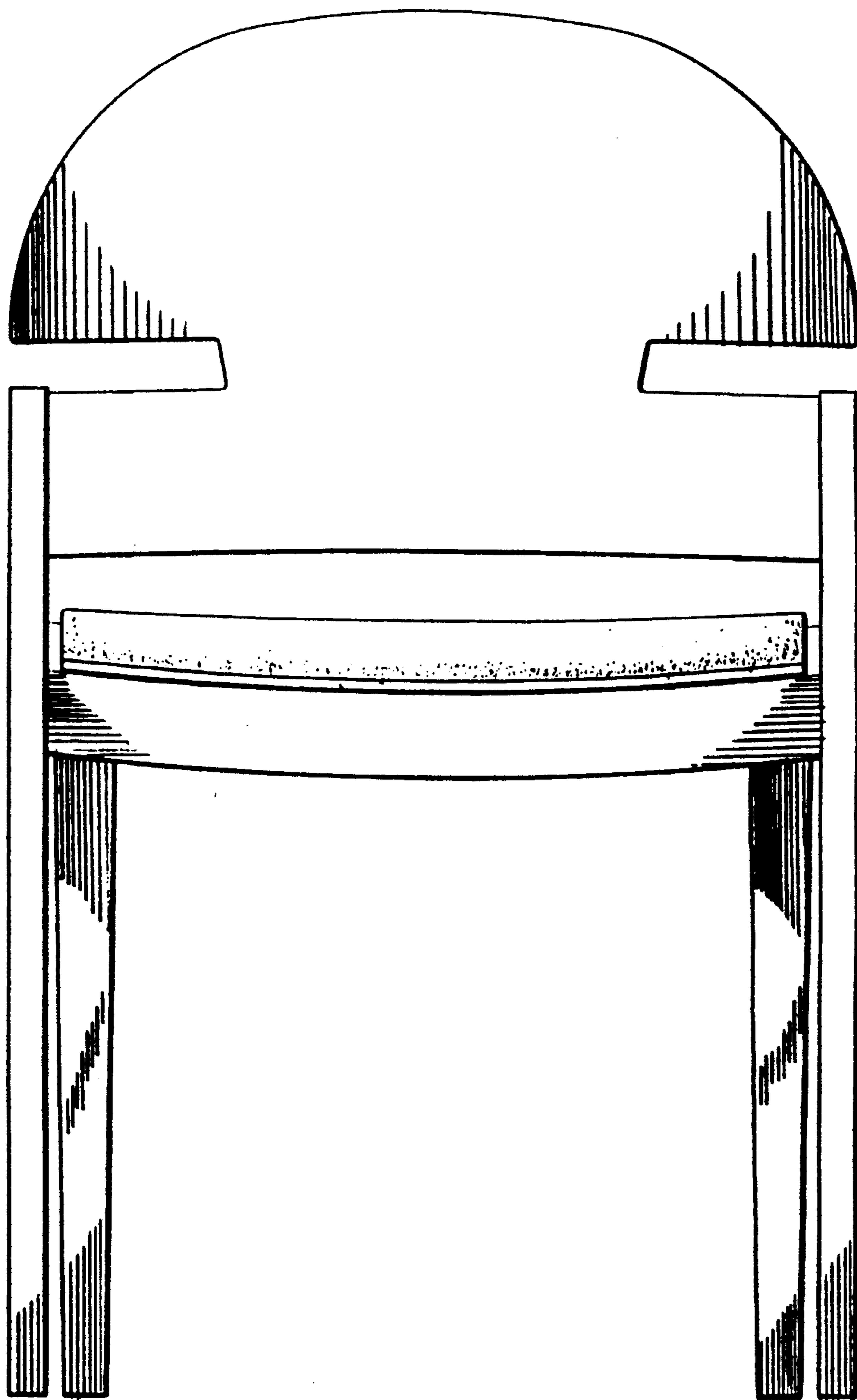

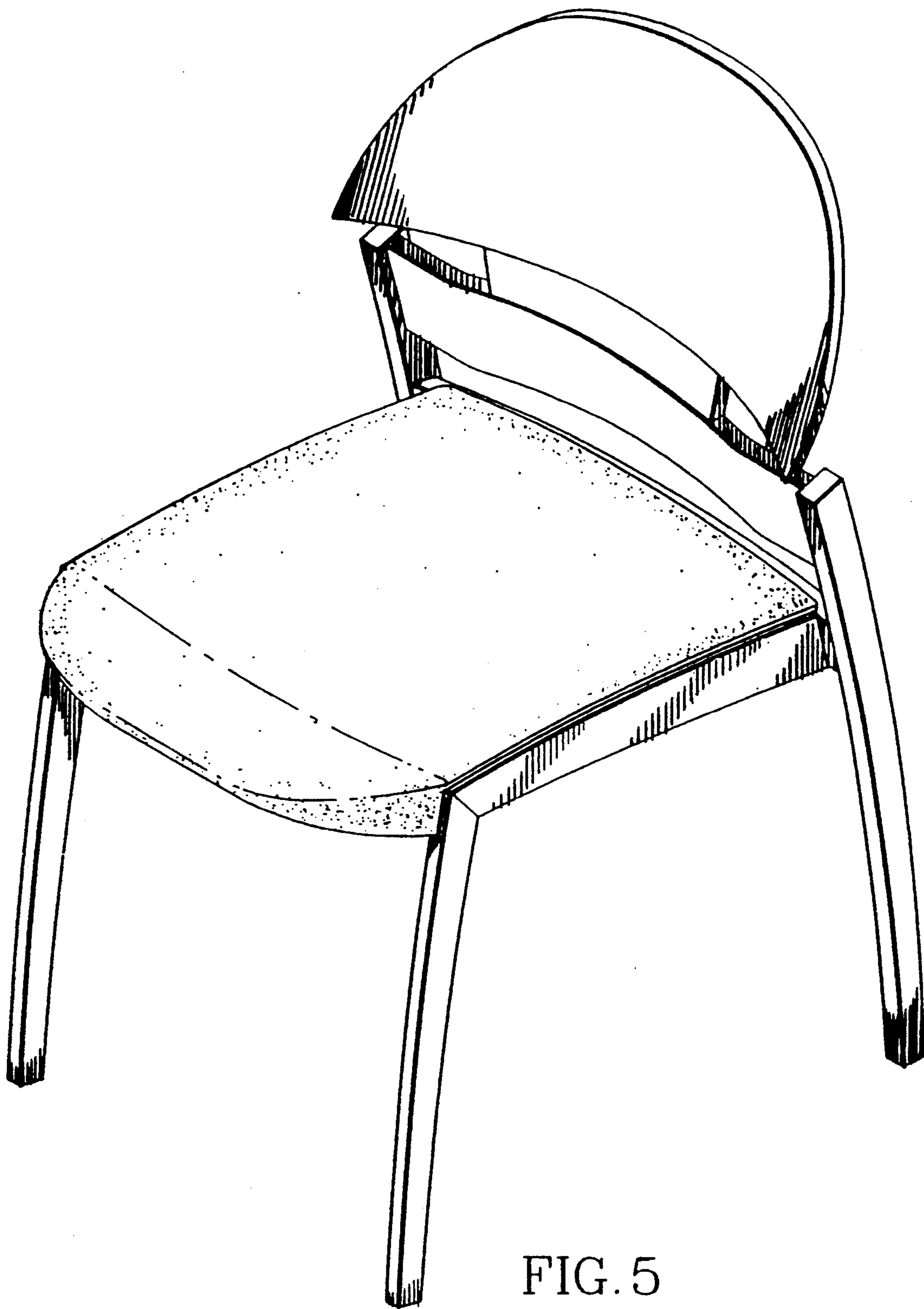

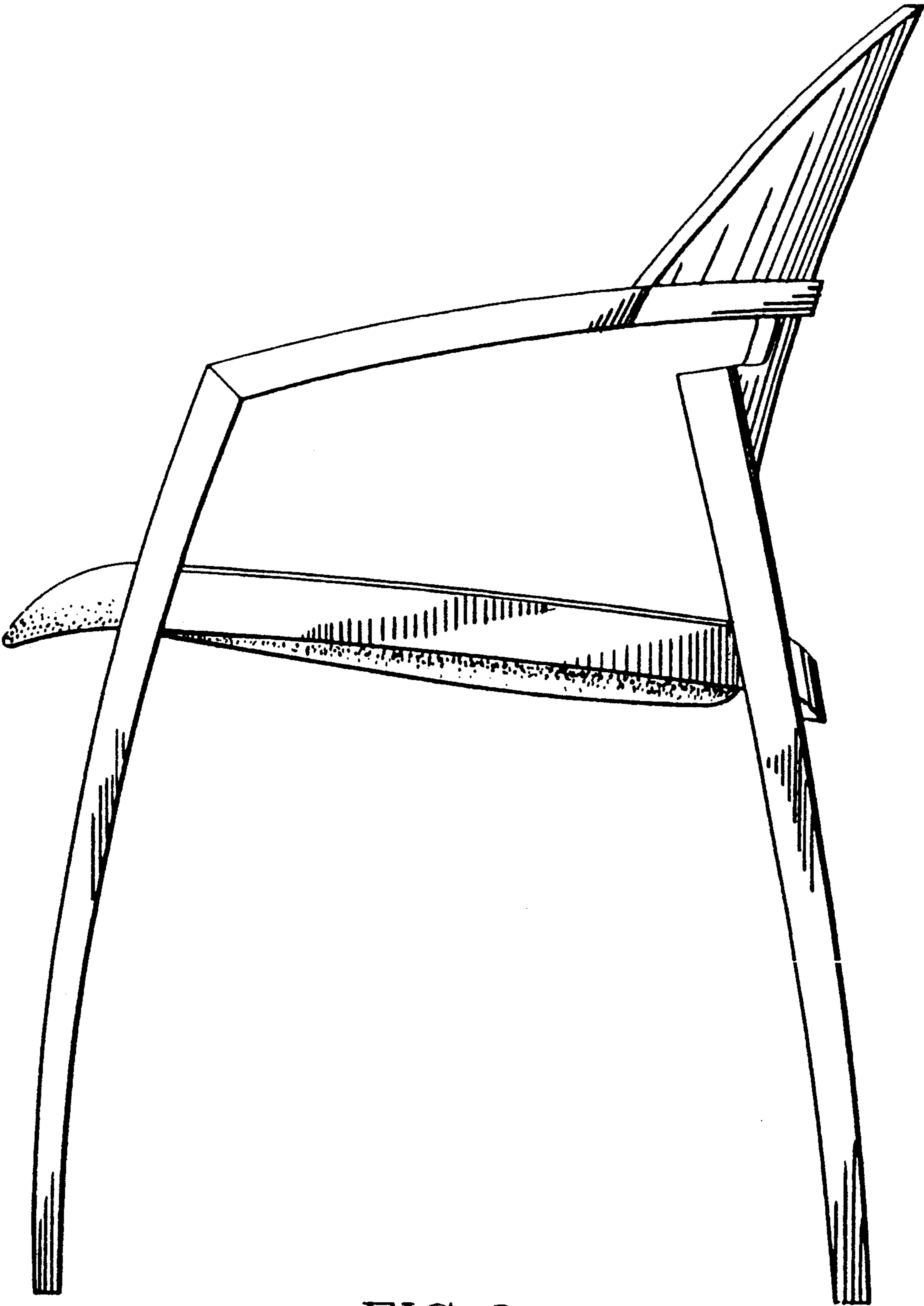

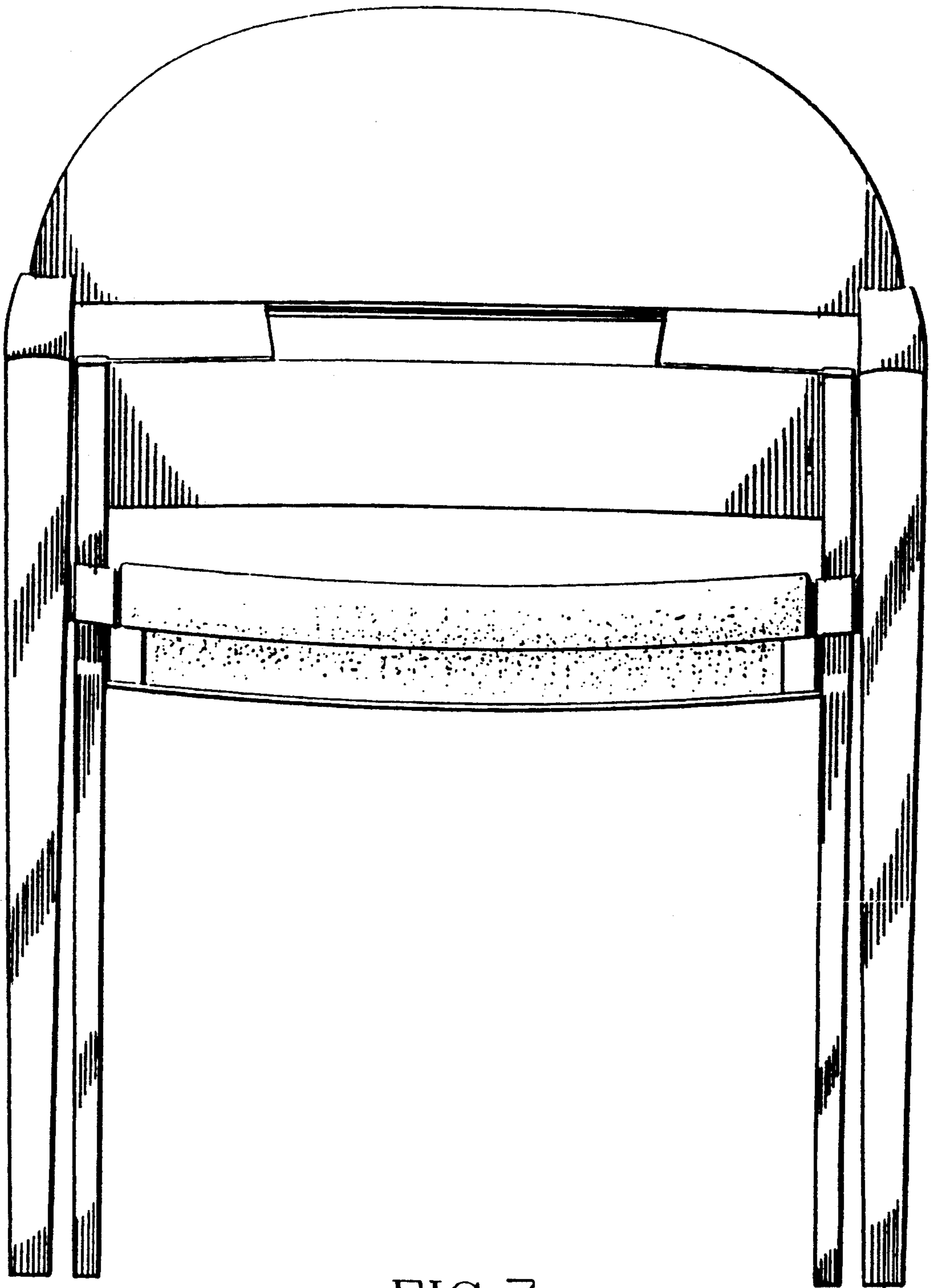

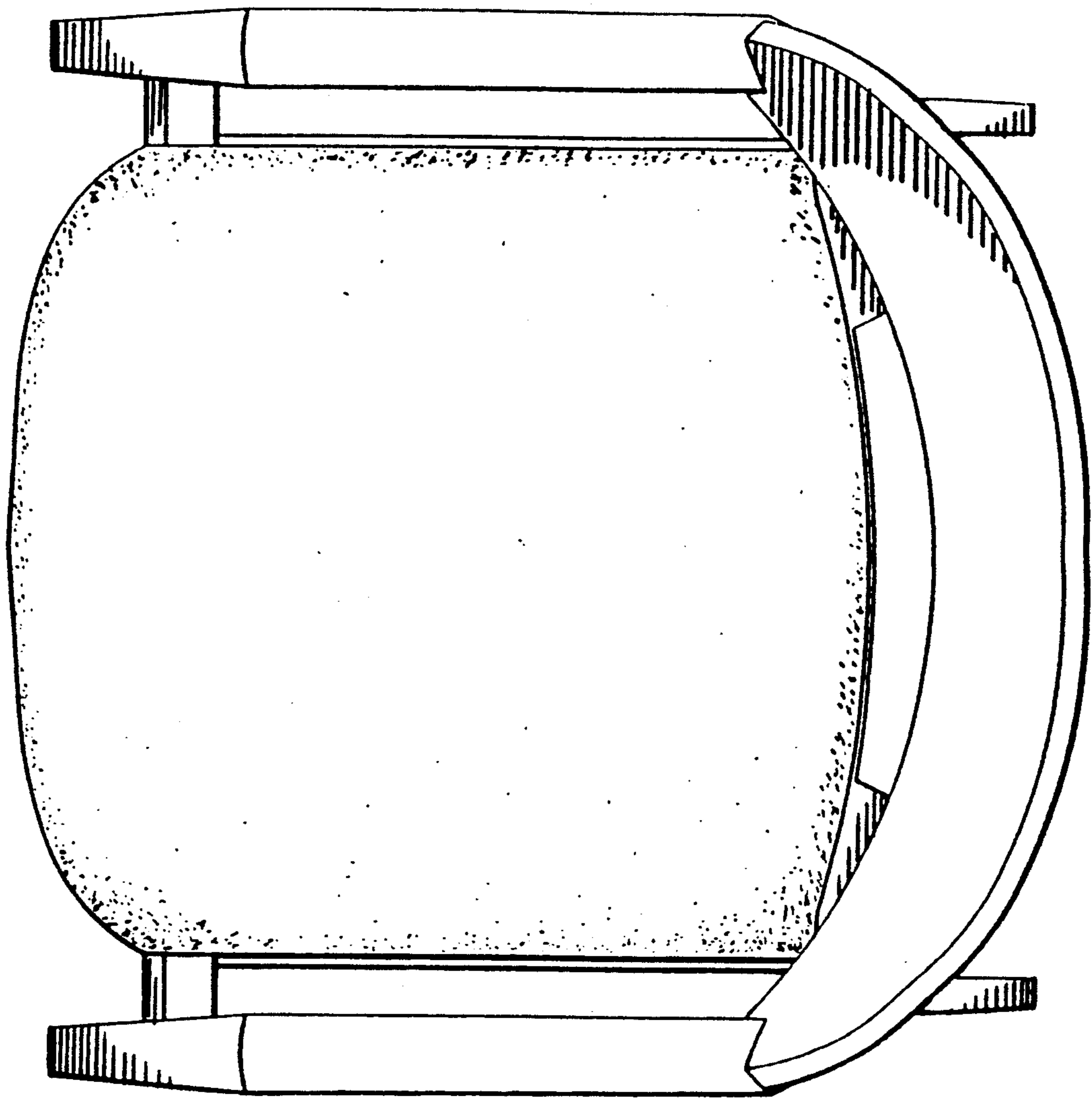

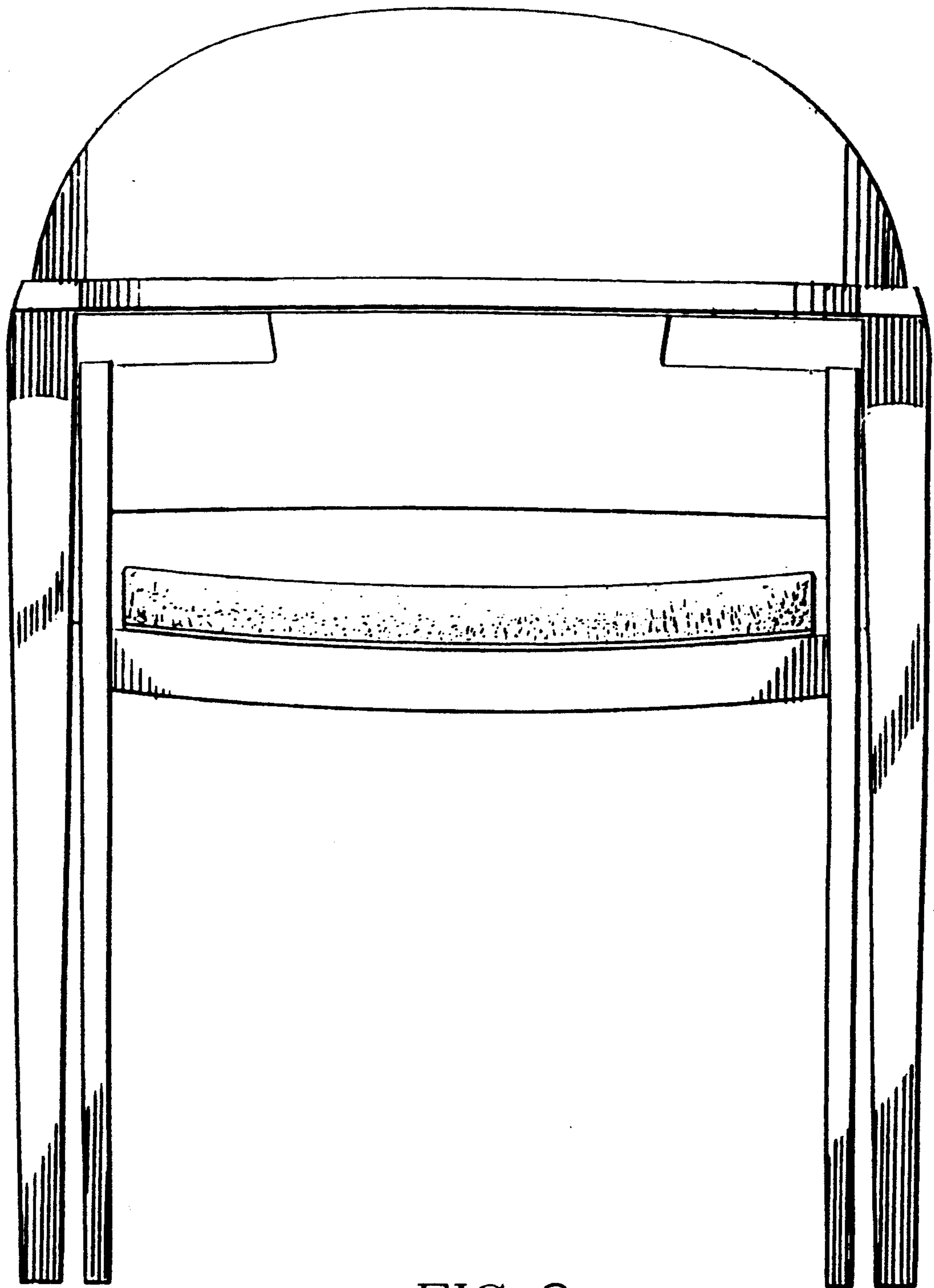

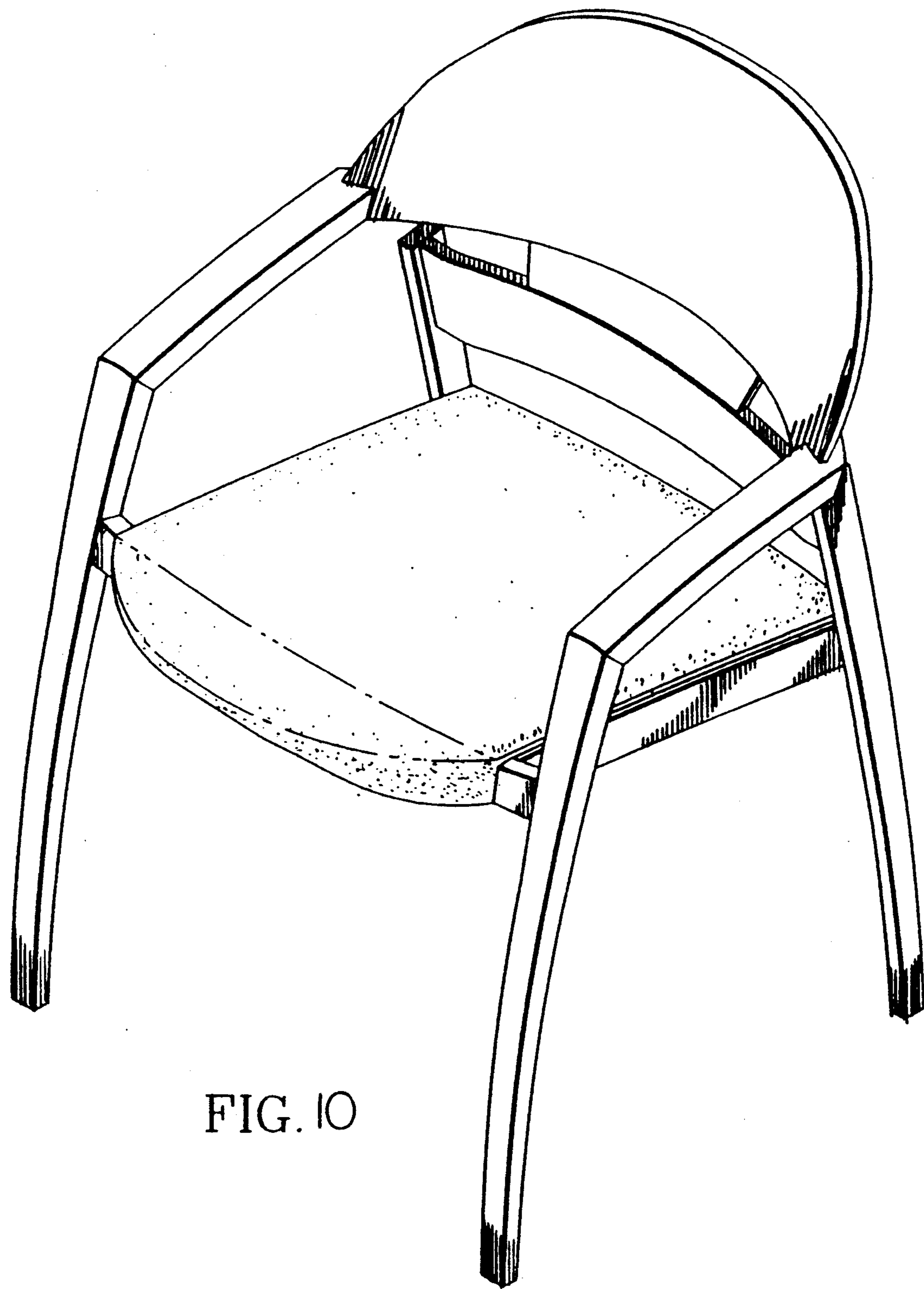
