[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tape player combined with a radio receiver and a clock, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right-side perspective view of a tape player combined with a radio receiver and a clock, showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

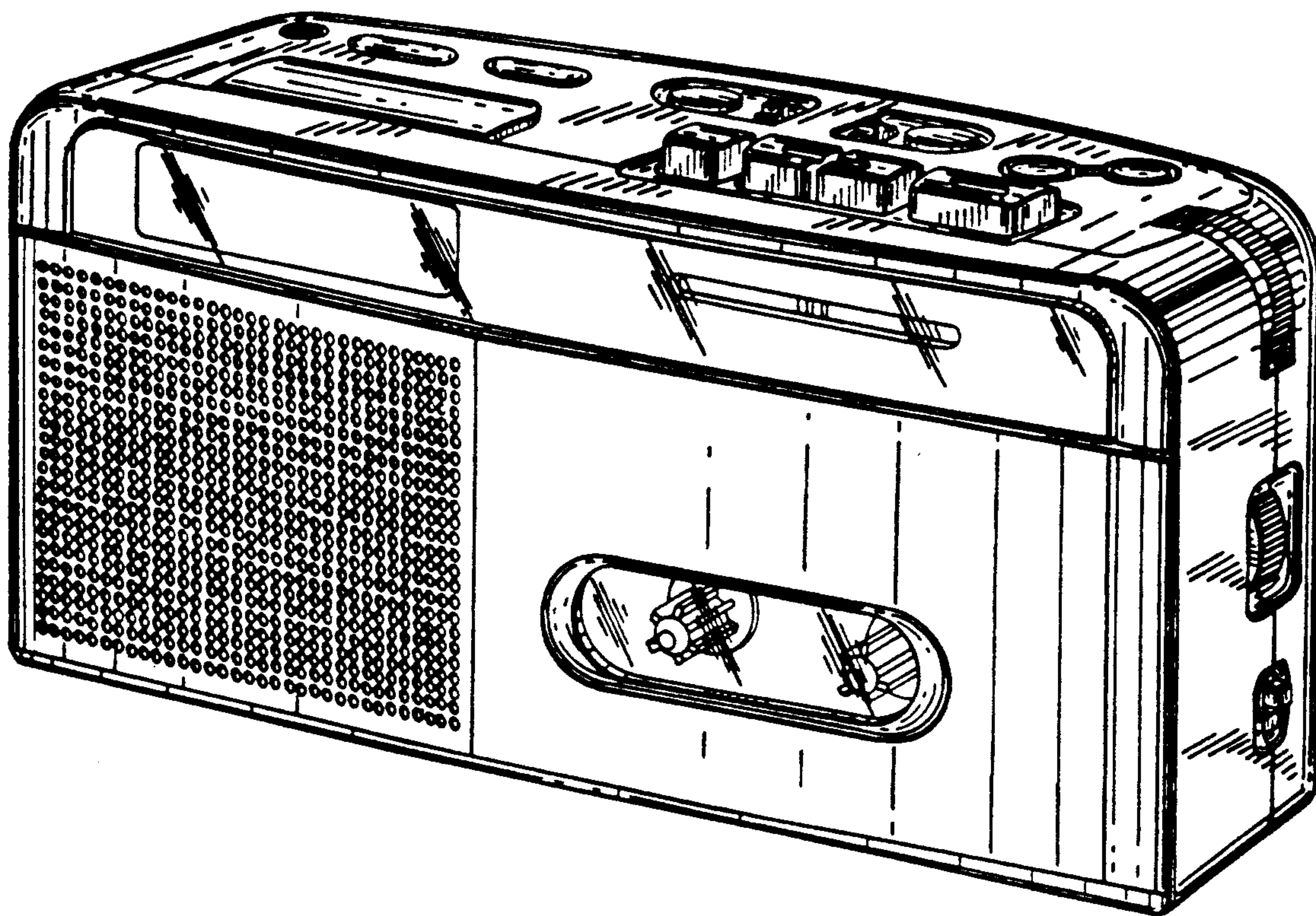

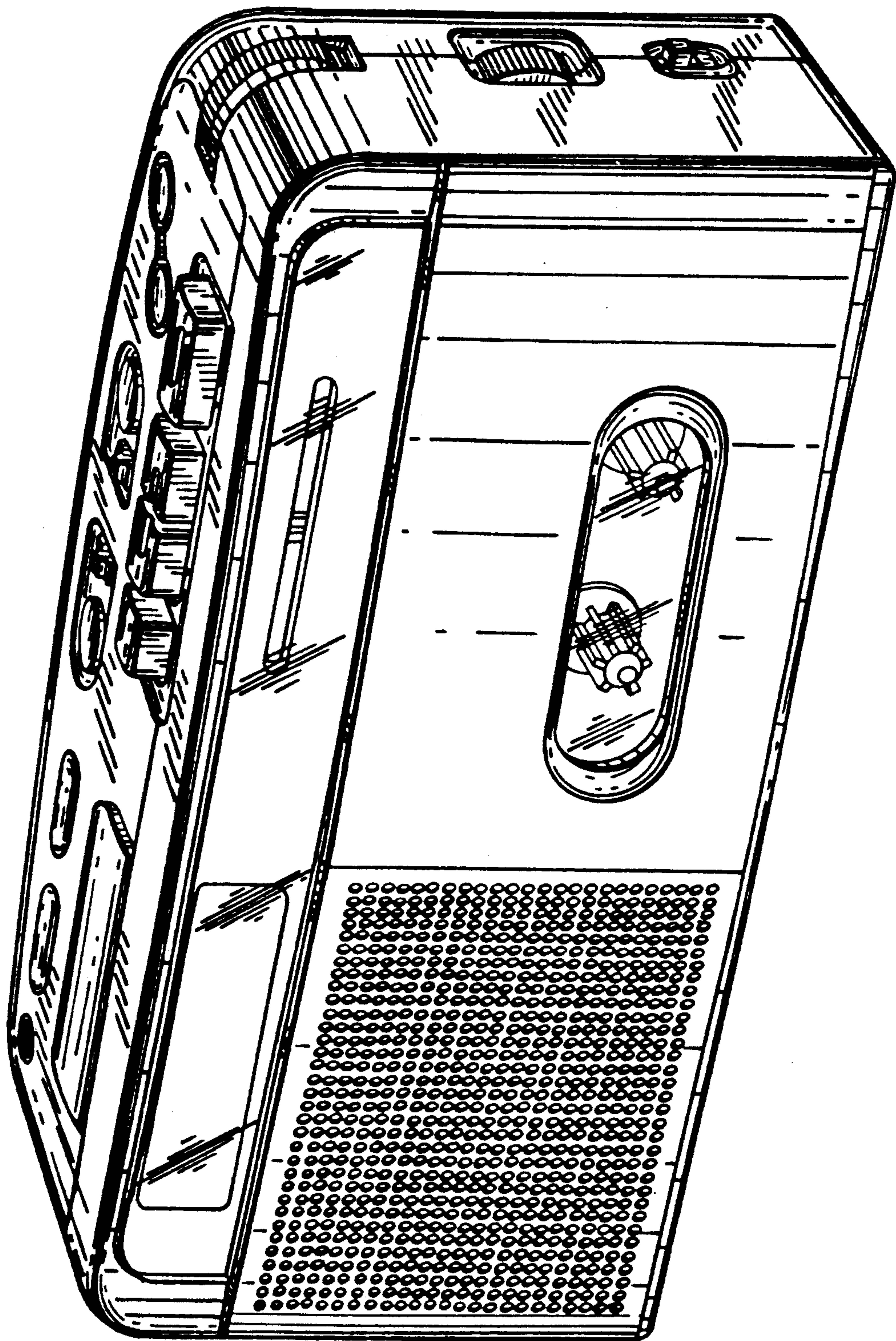

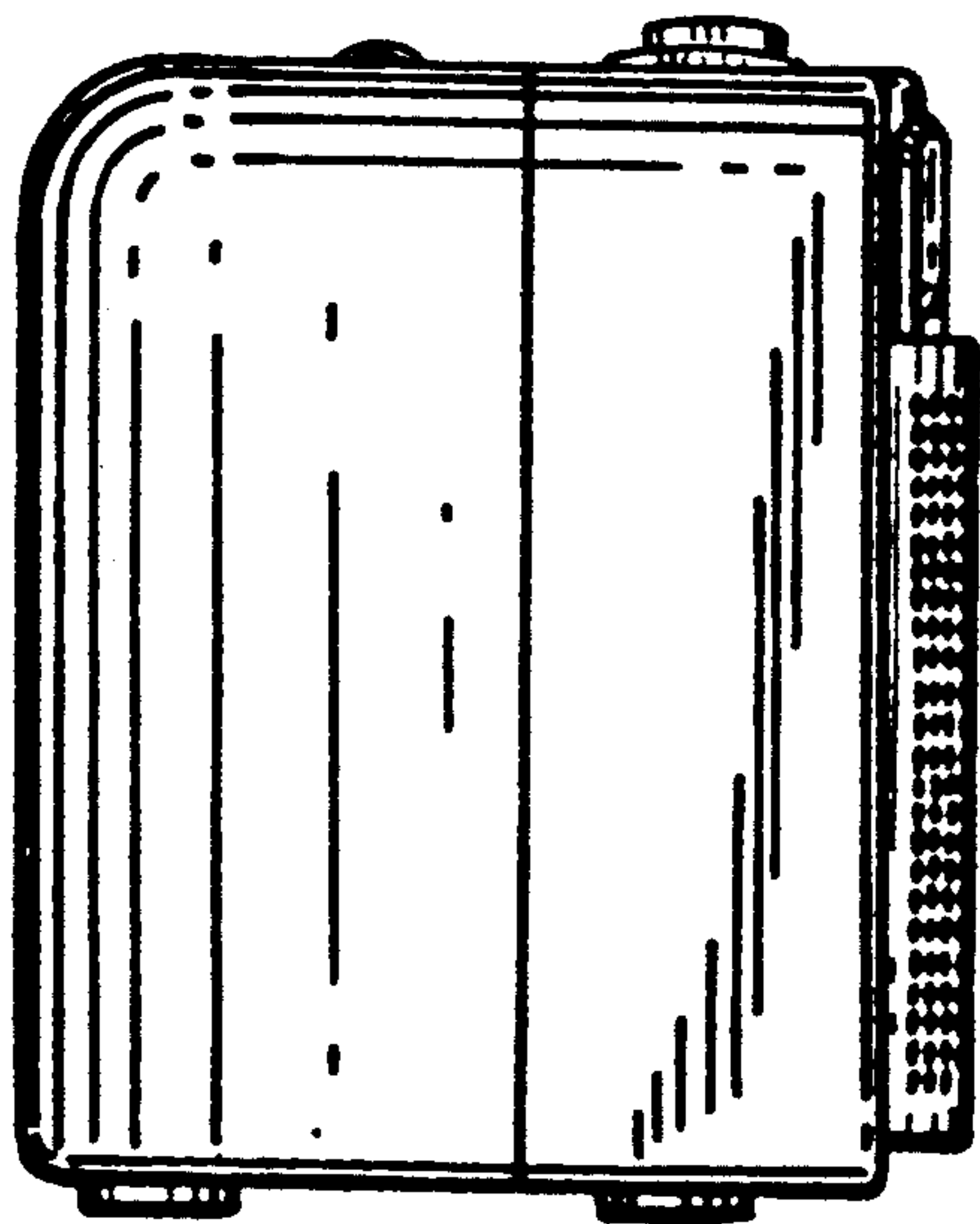
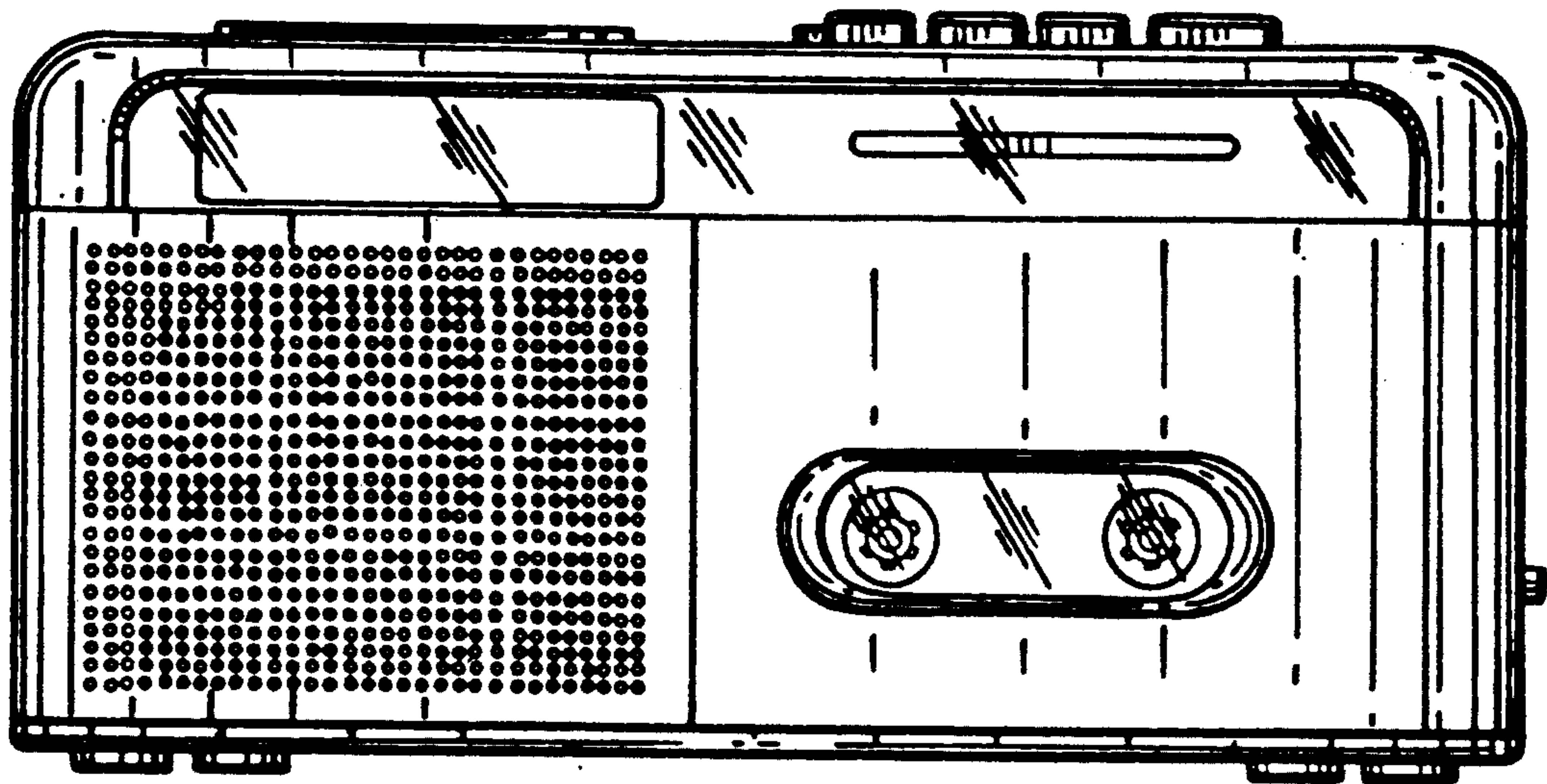

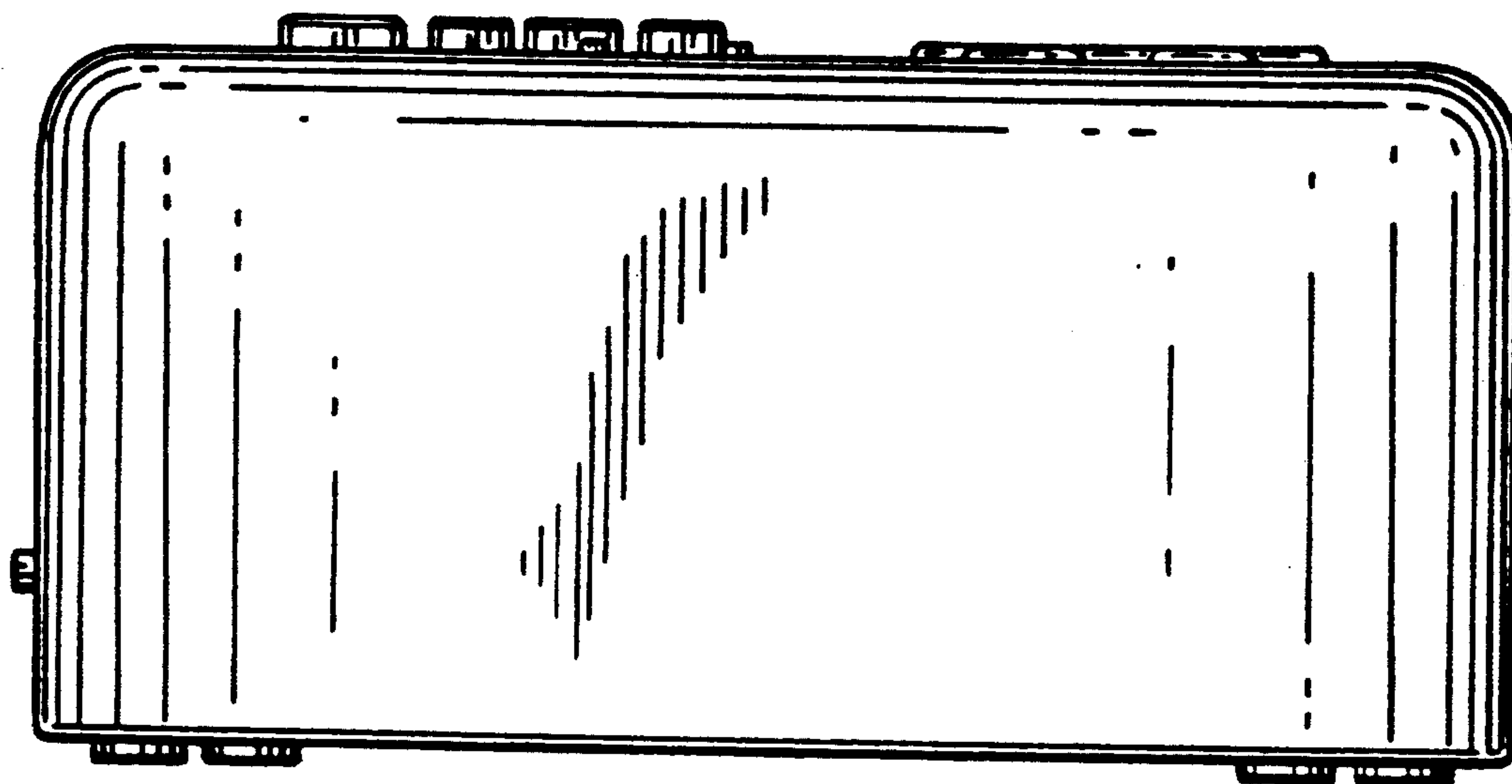

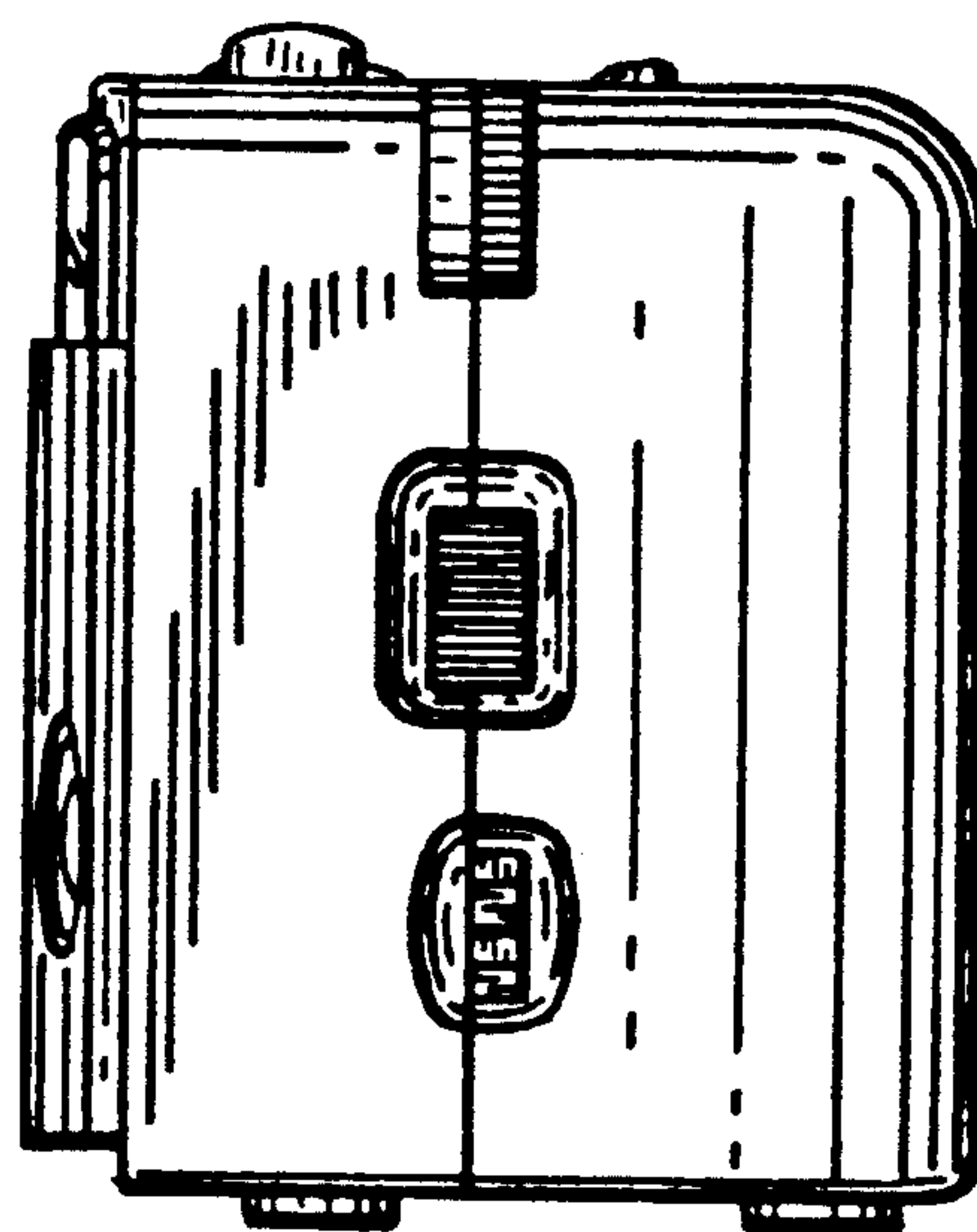

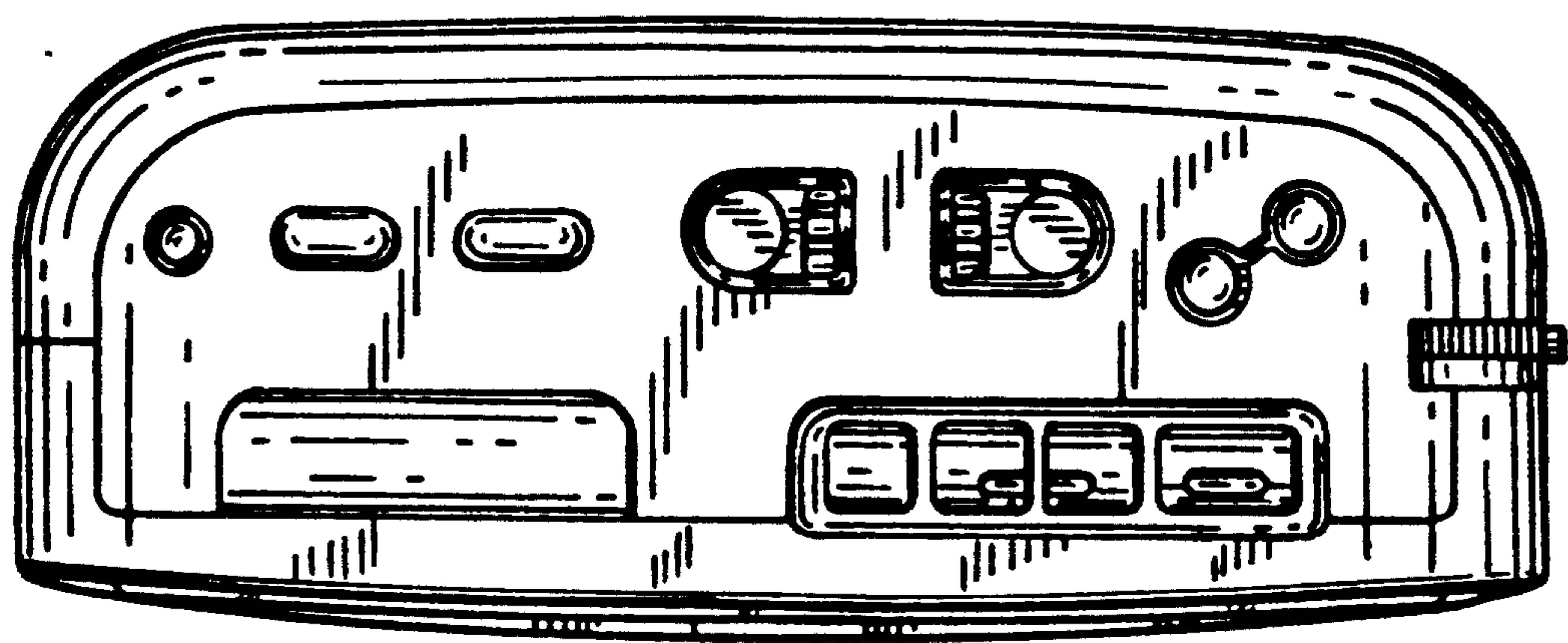
