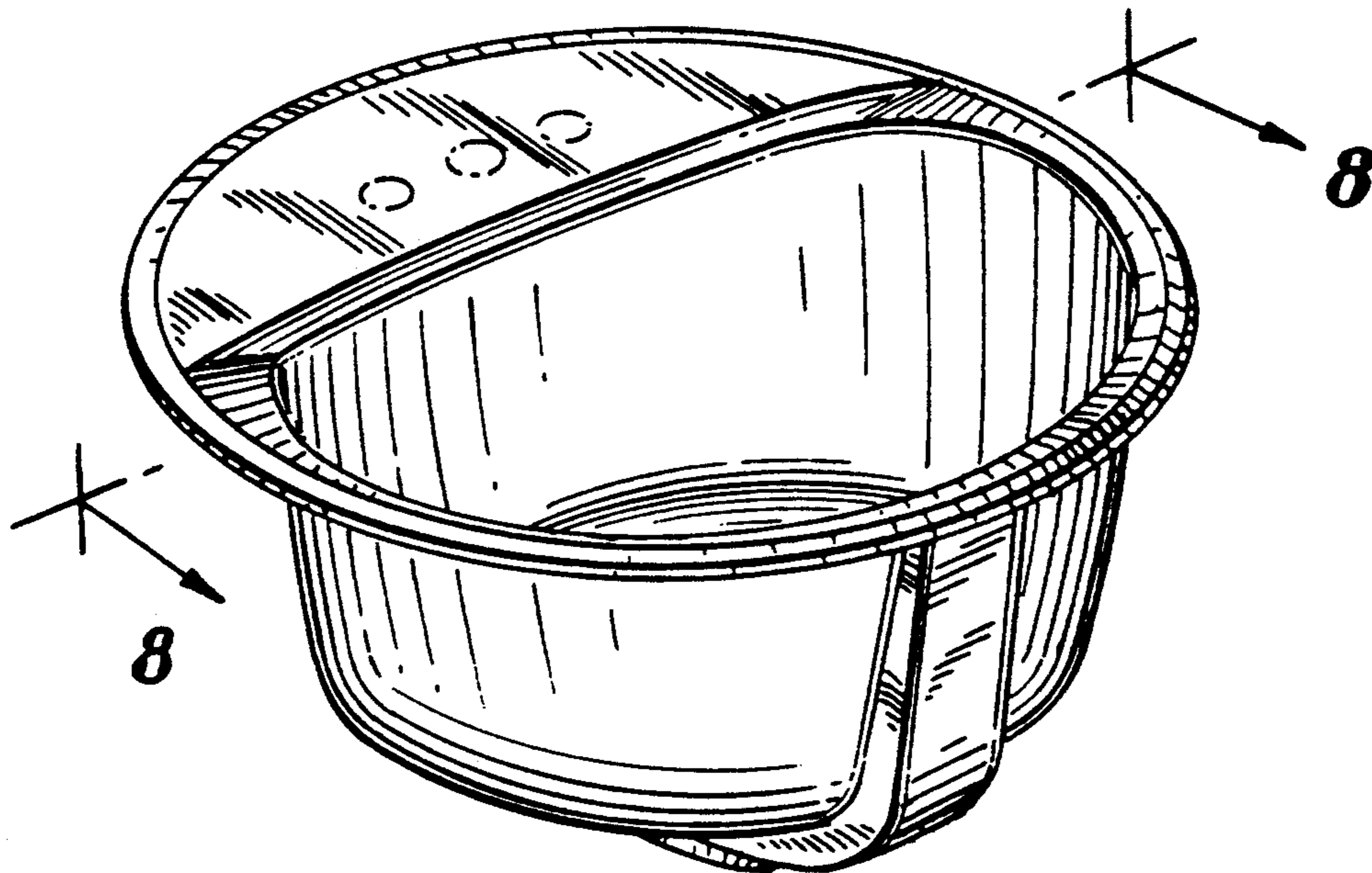
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lavatory, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a lavatory showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIGS. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 1.

The broken line representation of openings for fittings in FIGS. 1, 2 and 7 are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.



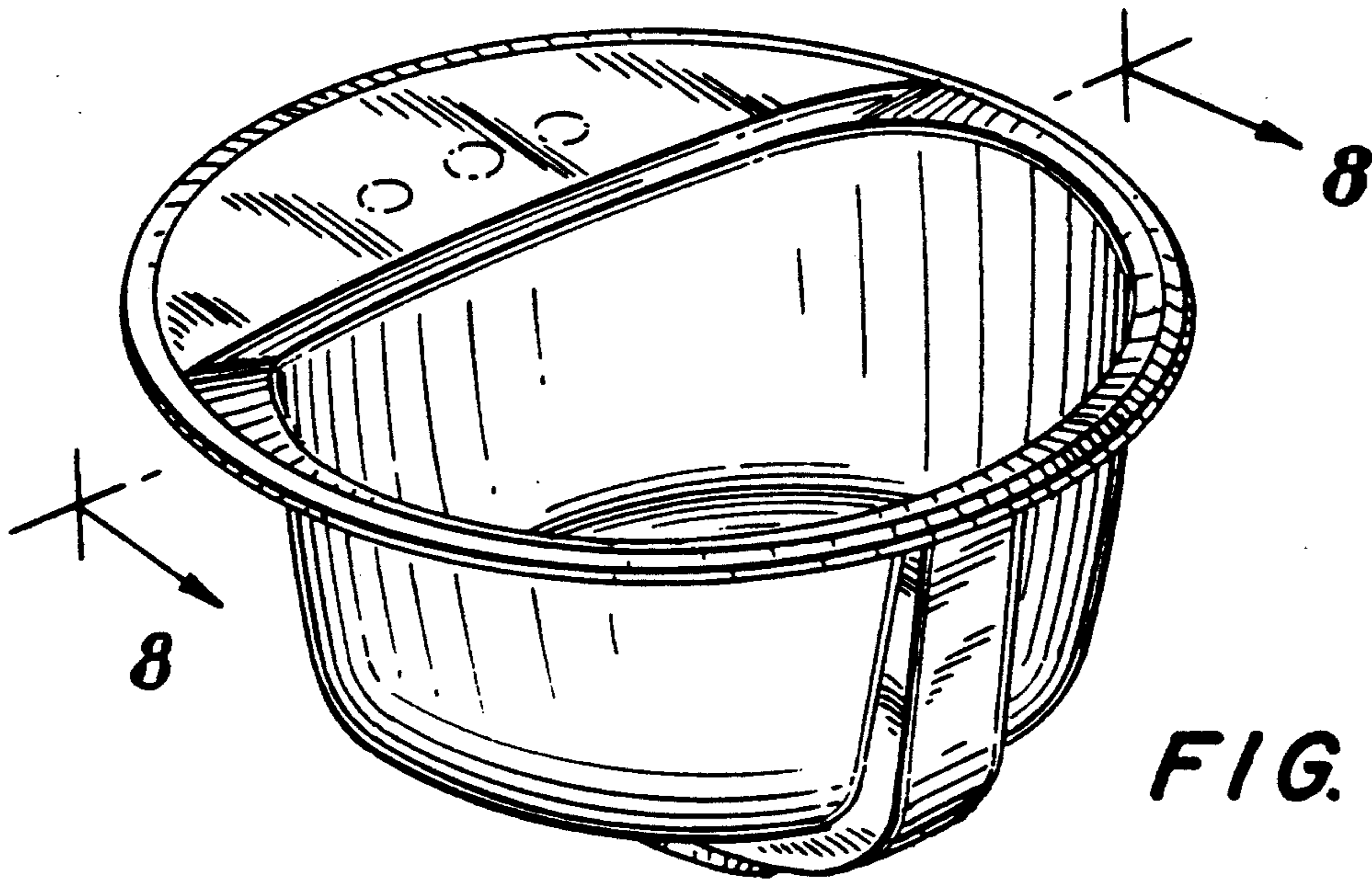

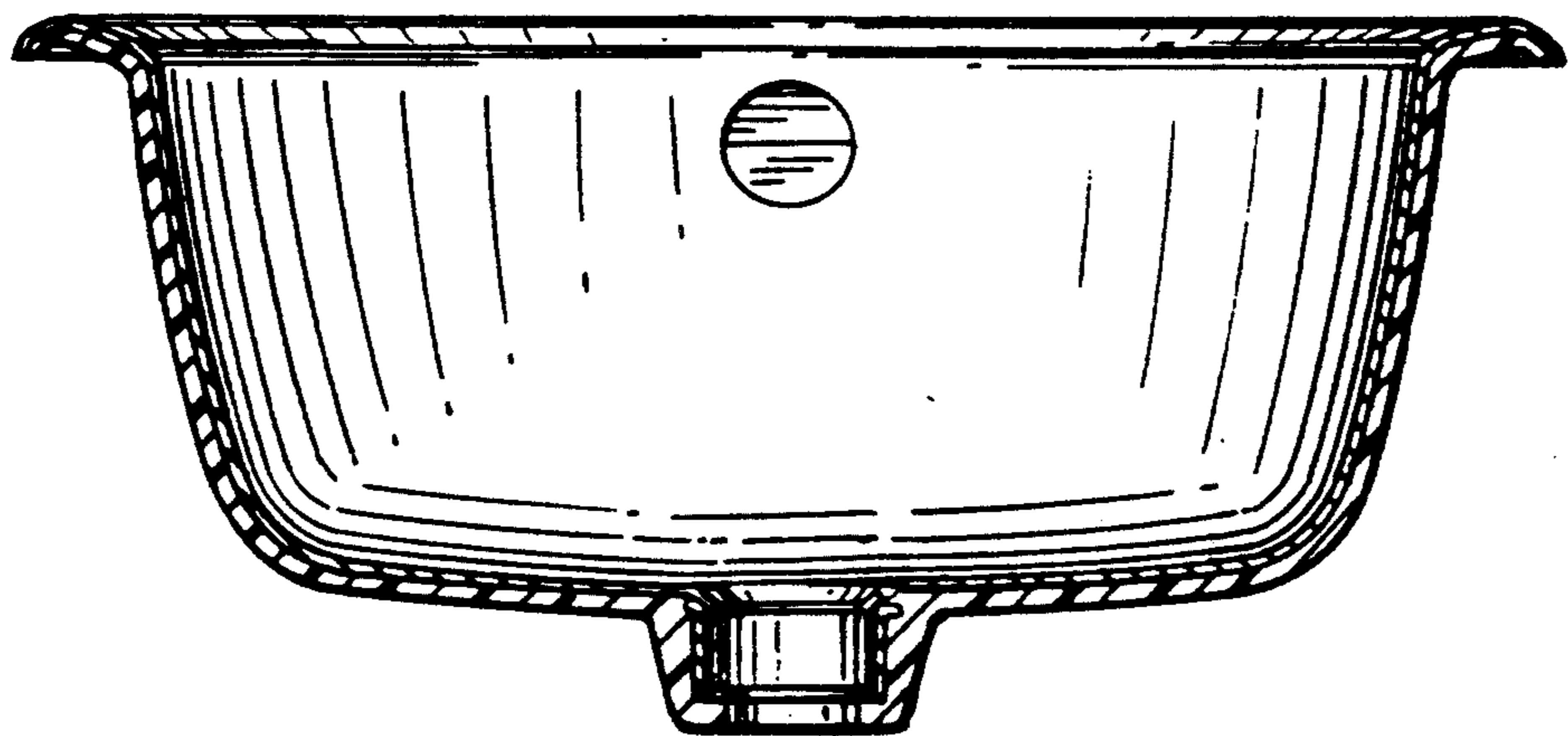

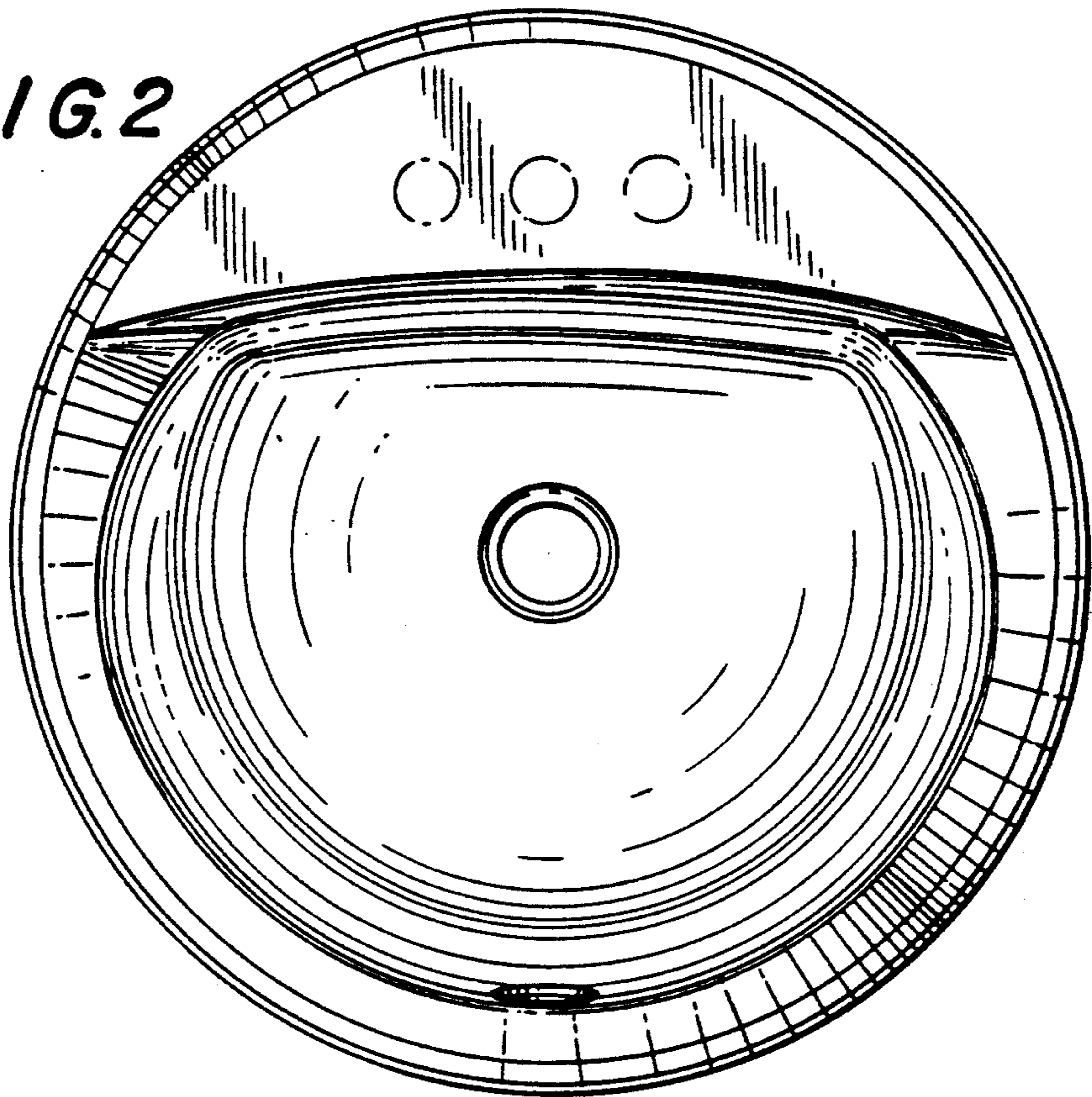

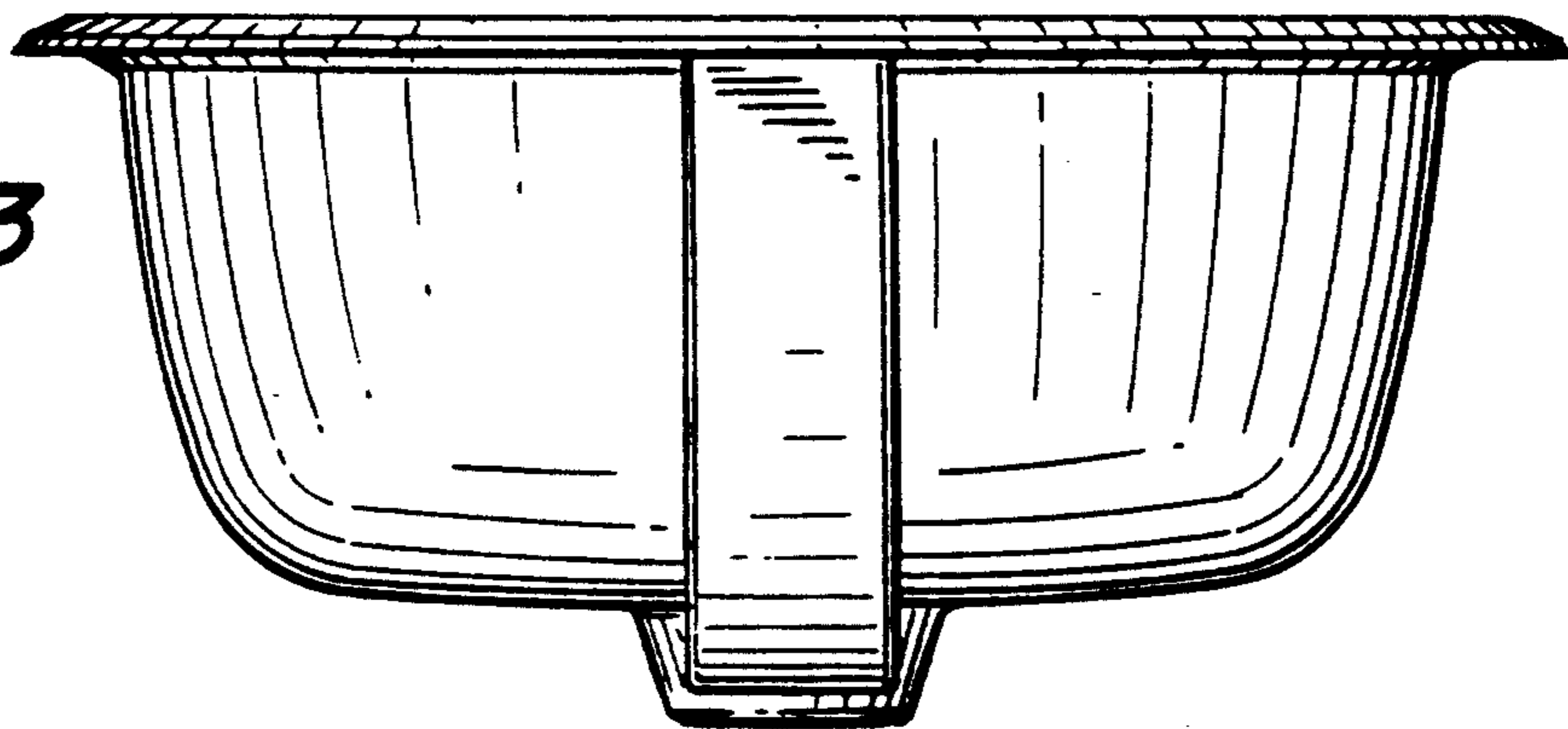
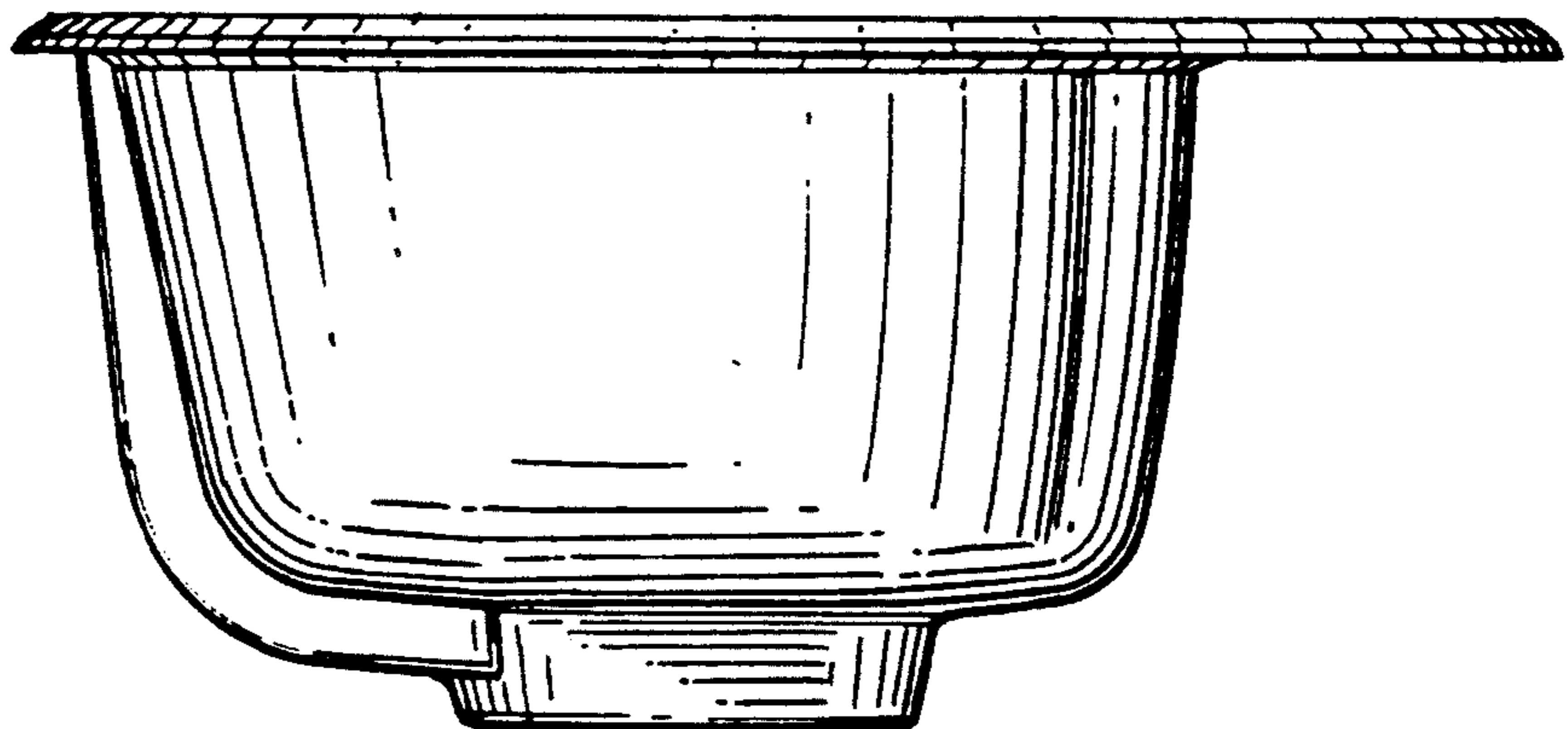

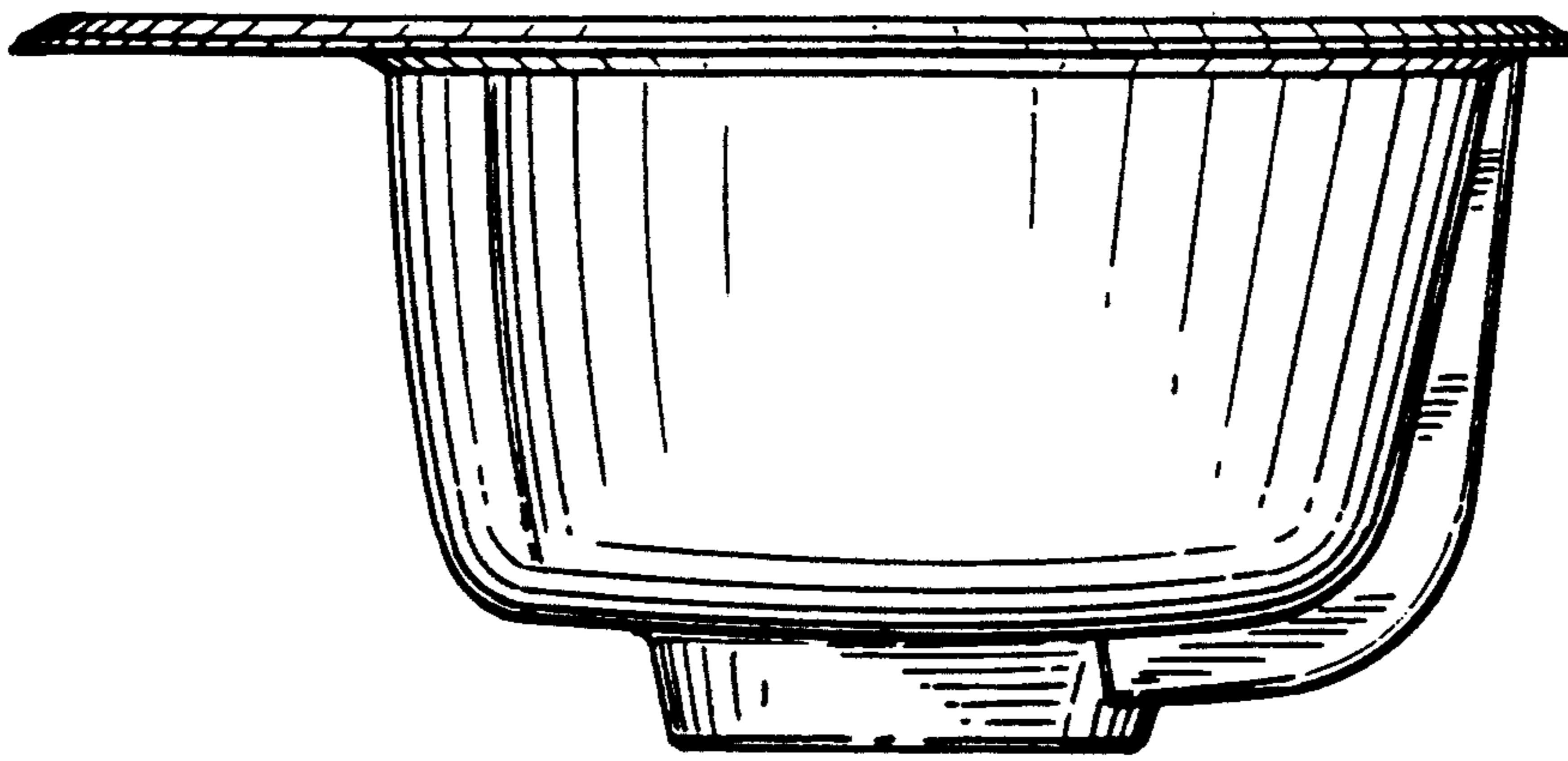

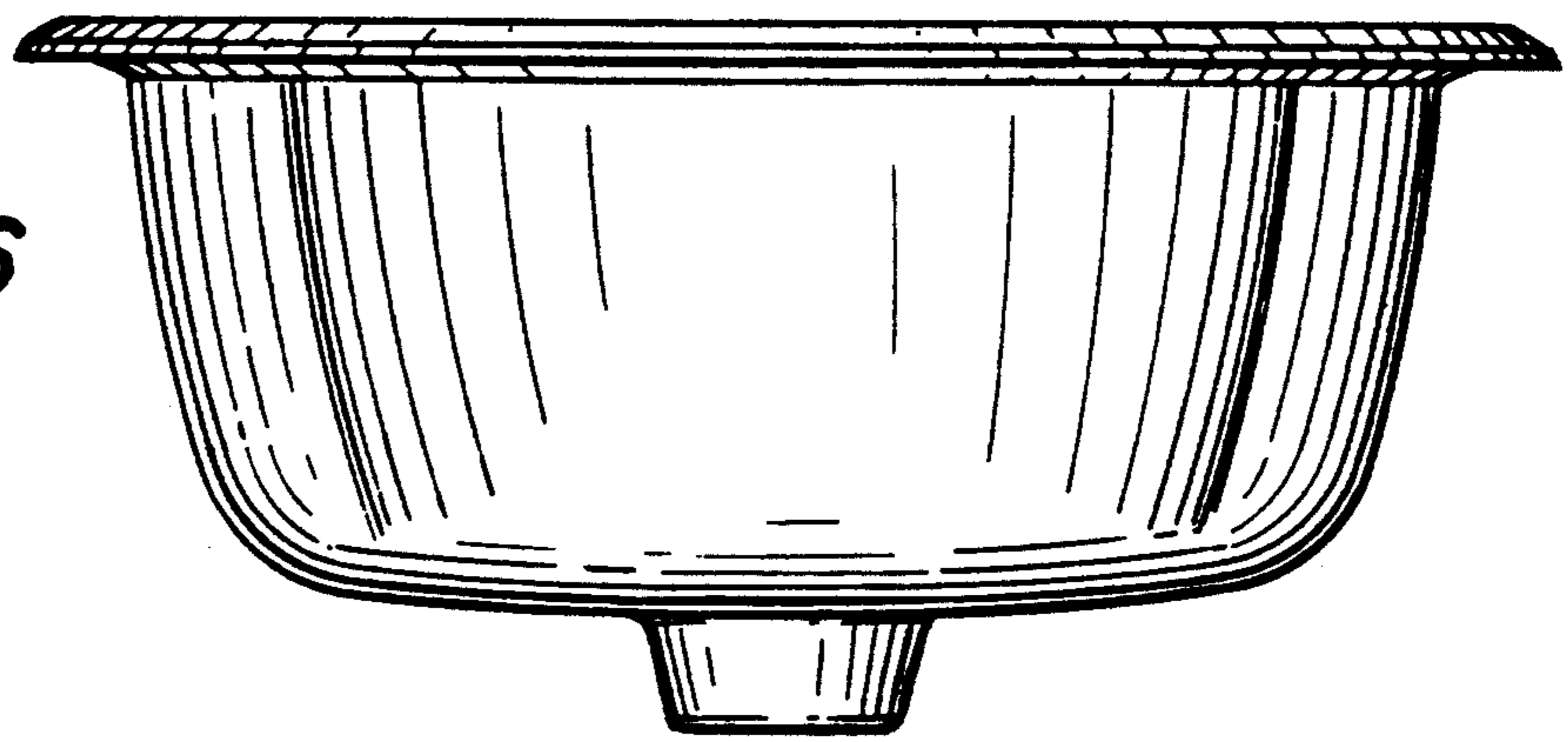

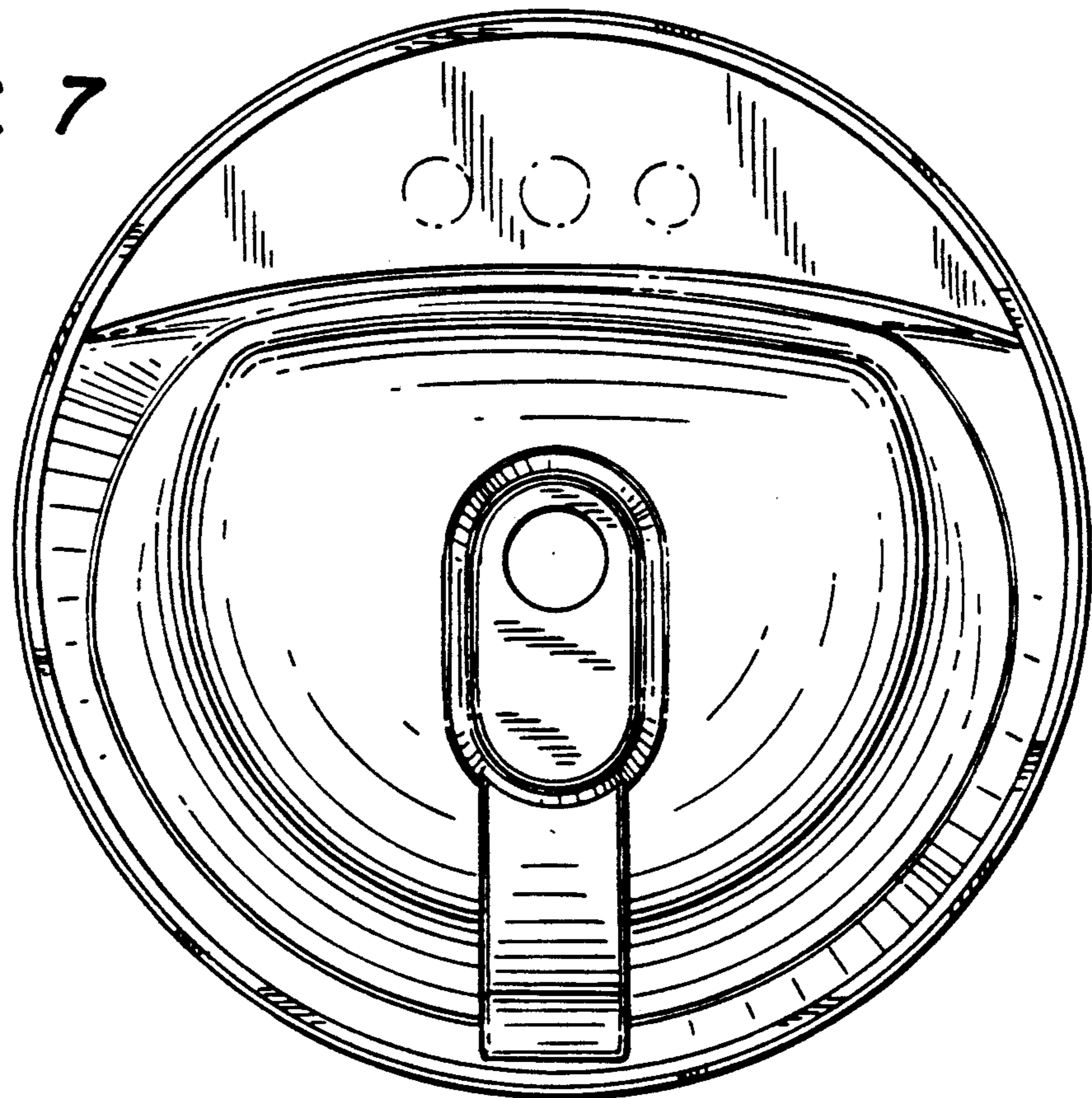
