CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lapel pin, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lapel pin showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a lapel pin showing a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7.

The broken line showing of a pin in FIGS. 1-2, 4-8 and 10-12 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The opposite side view to FIGS. 3 and 9 is plain and unornamented.
