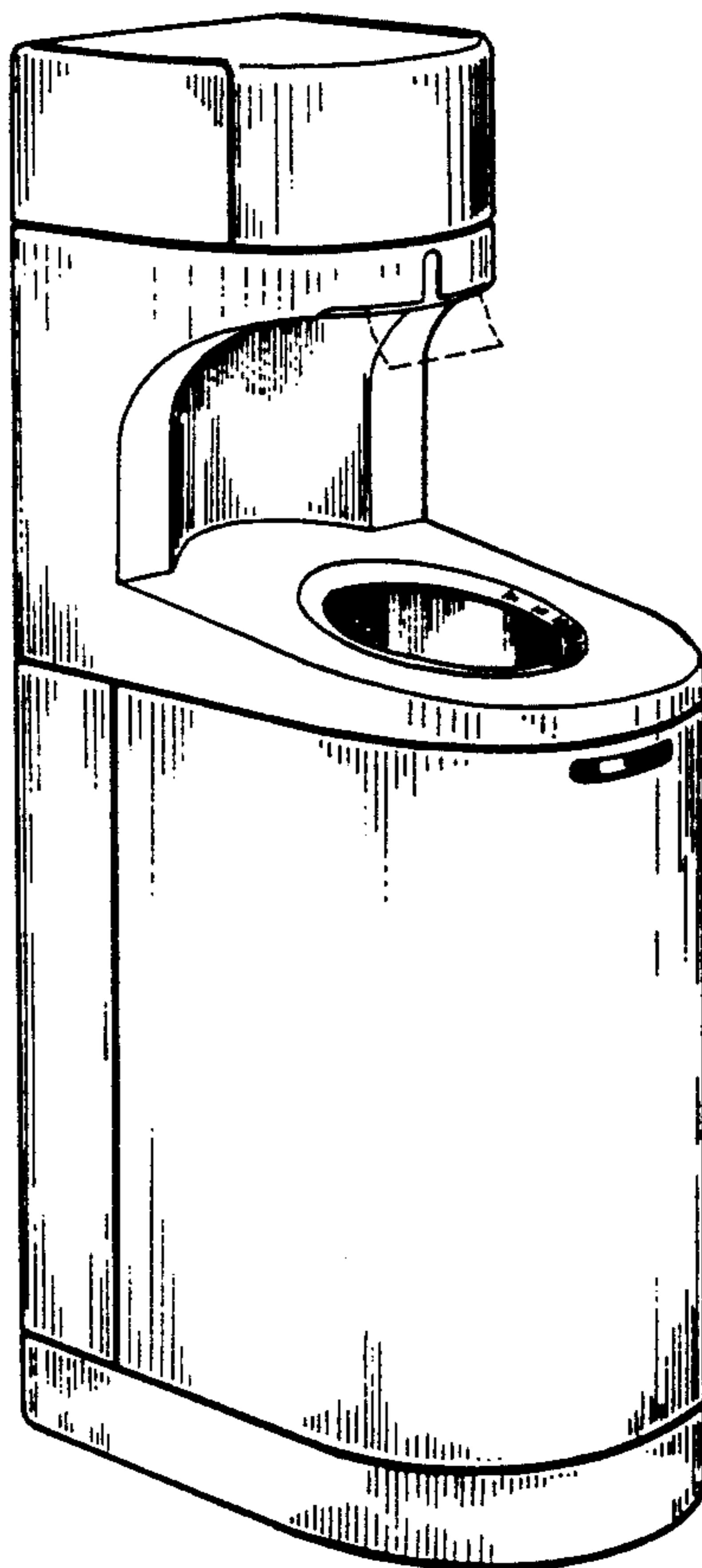
FIG. 6 is left side plan view of our new design as shown in FIG. 1, with the opposite, or right side view being the mirror image thereof; and,

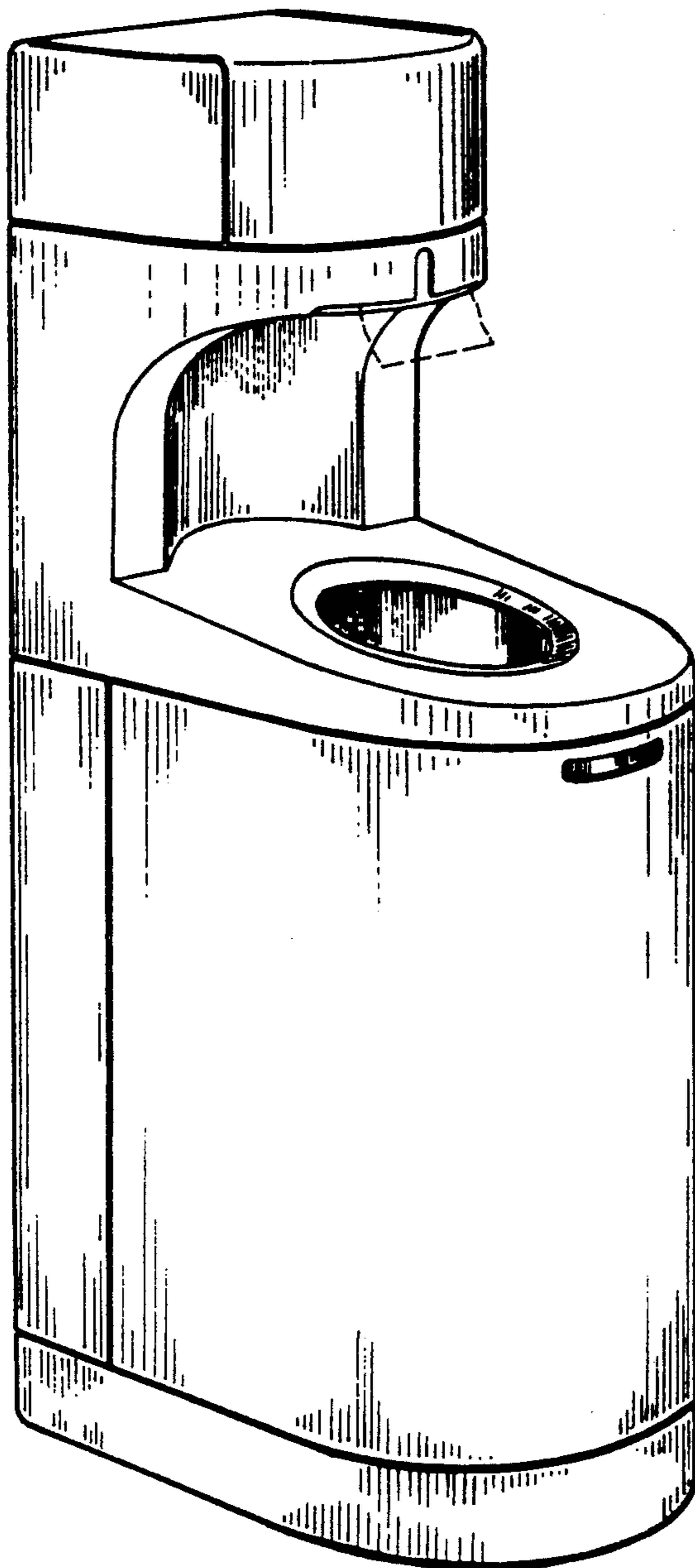

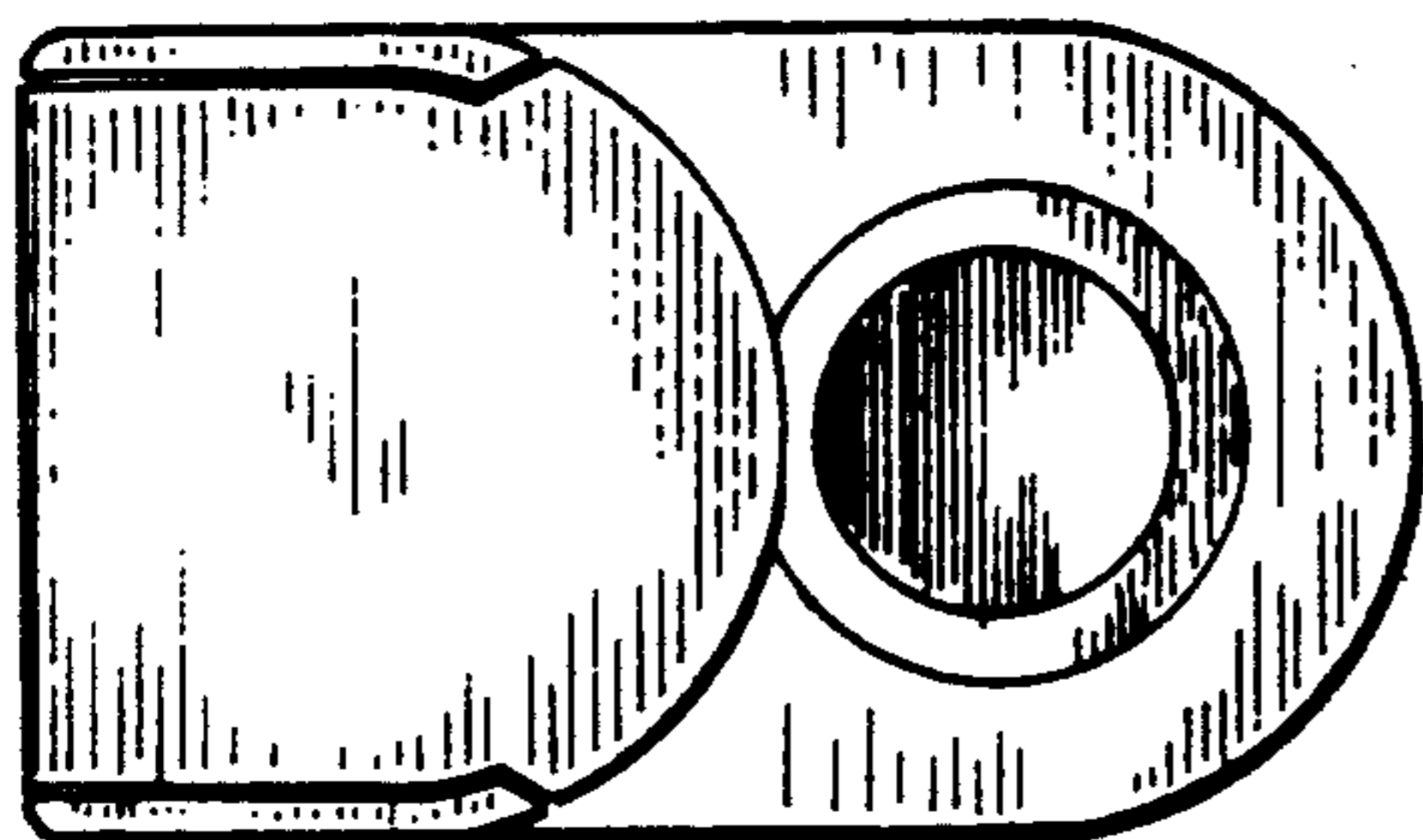

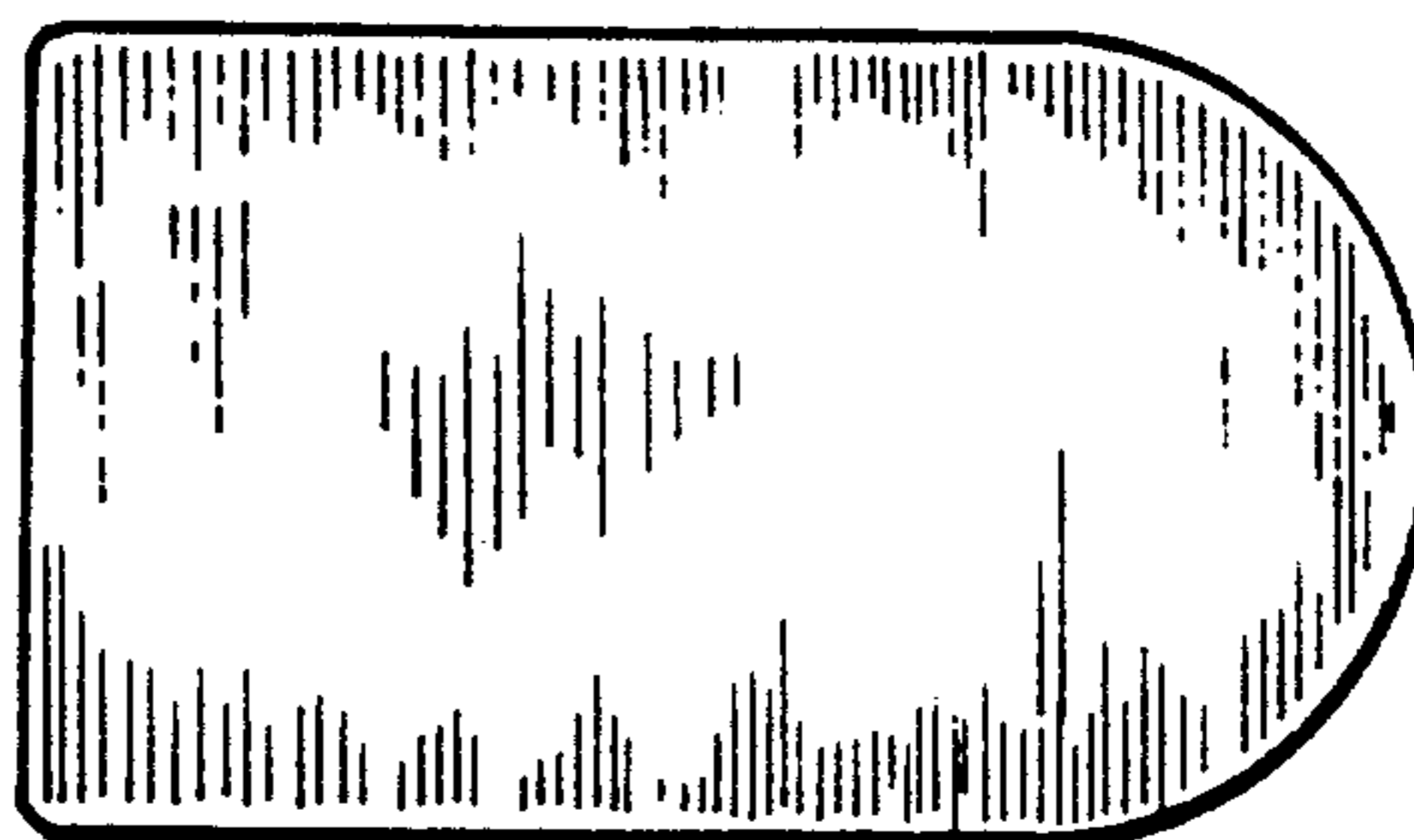

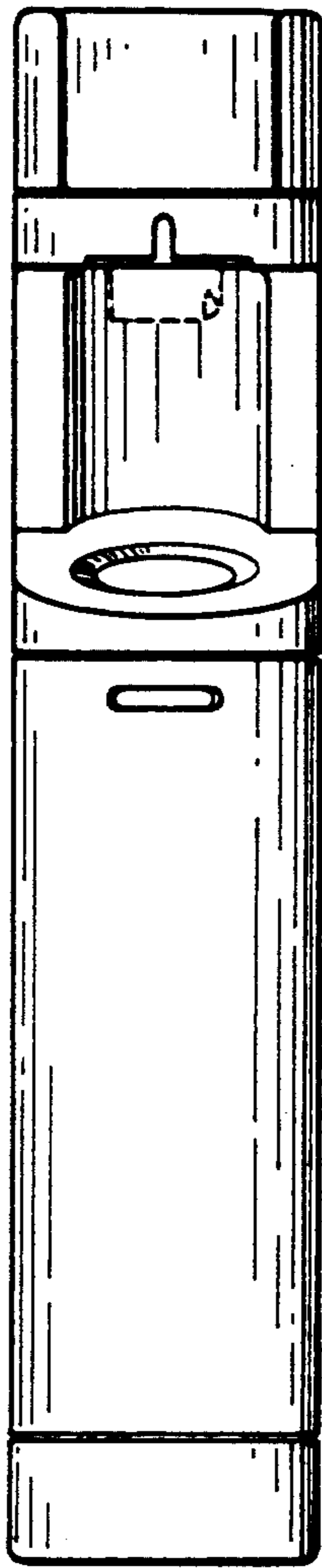

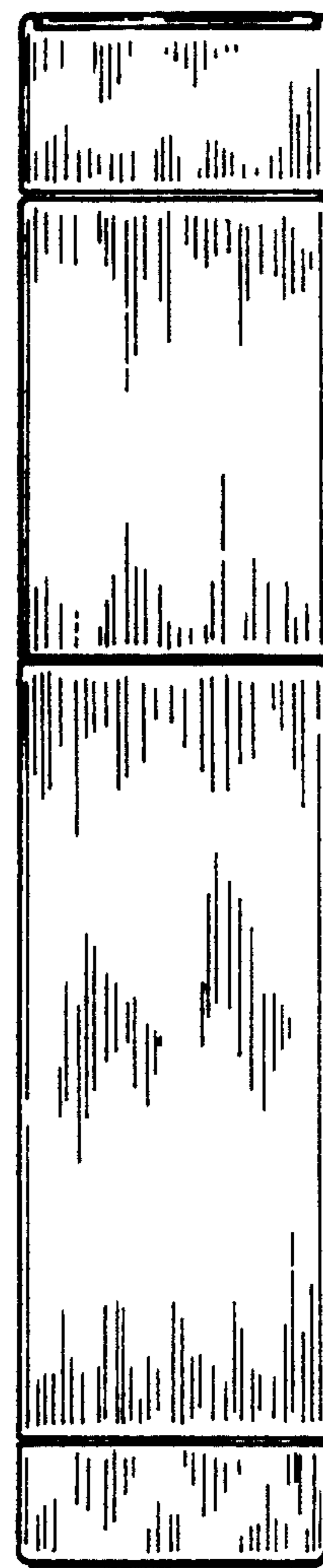

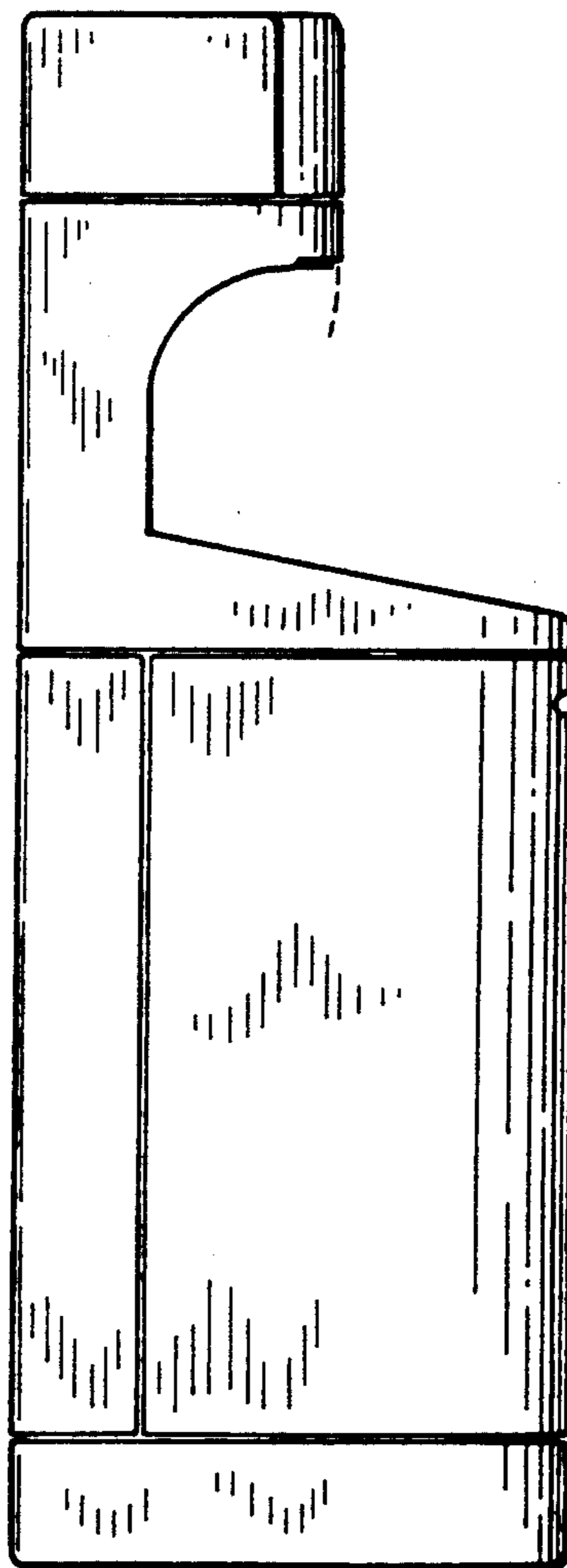

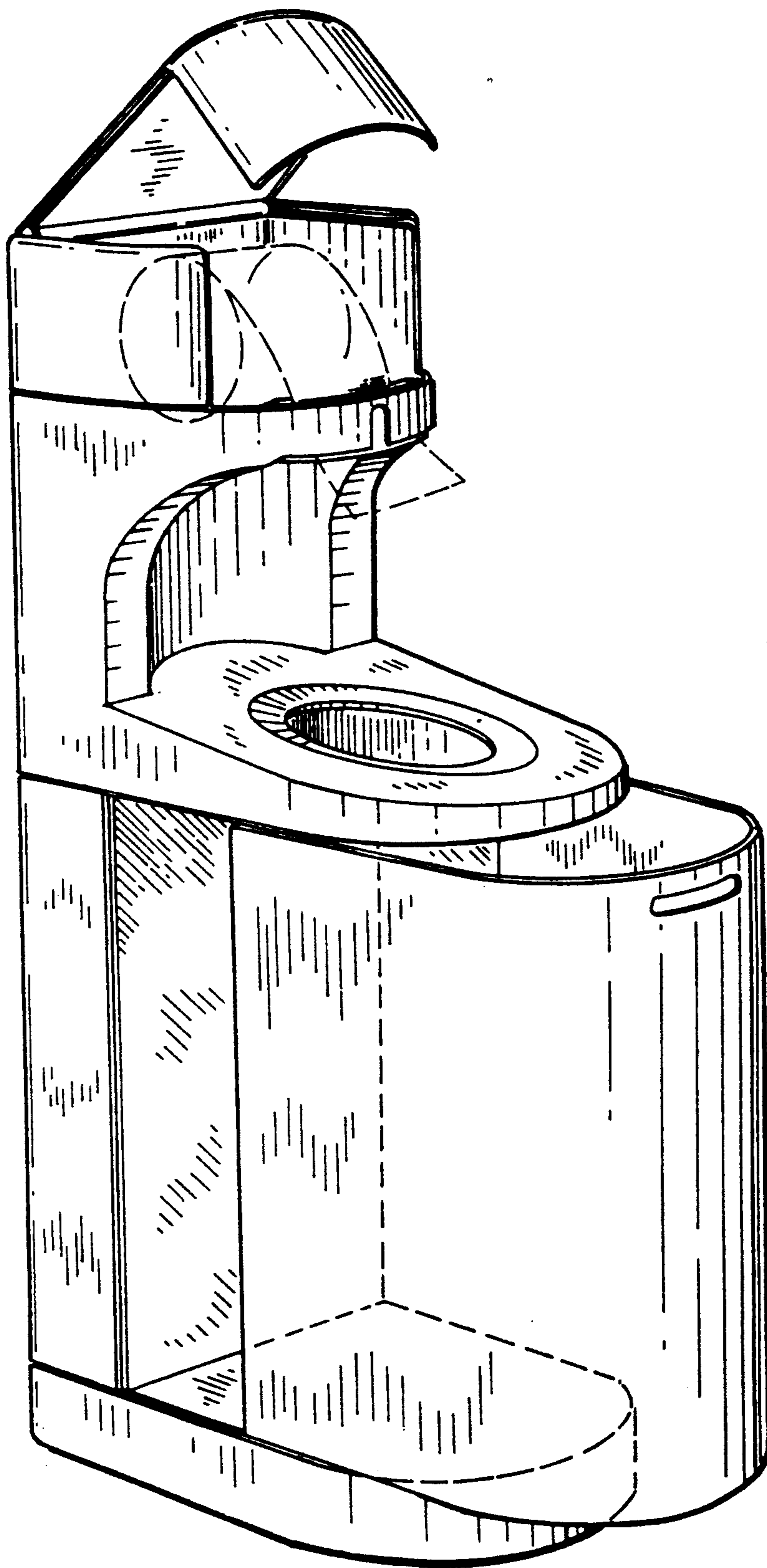
