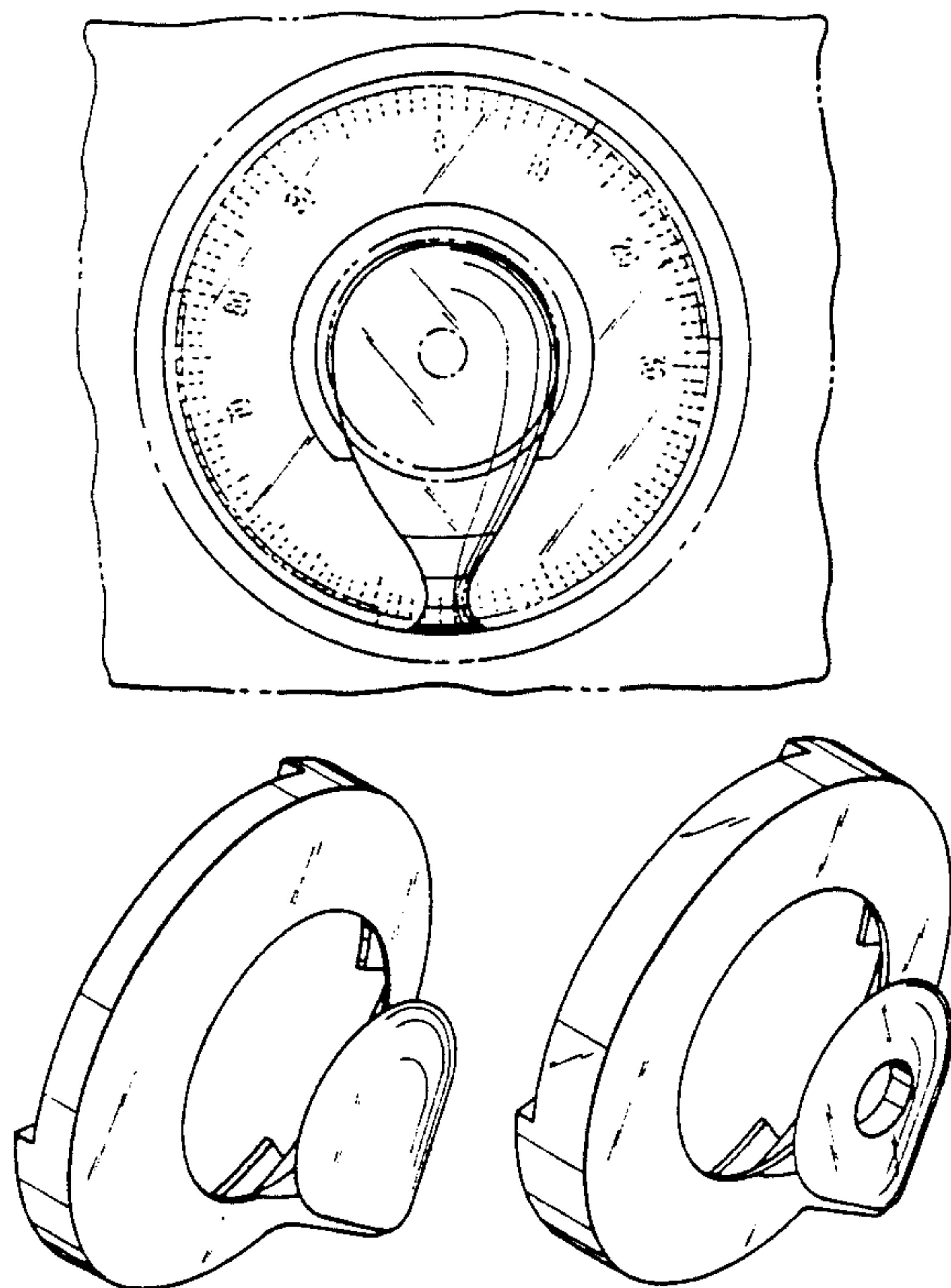

[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a protective cover for a combination lock dial, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a protective cover for a combination lock dial showing my new design, the

broken-line disclosure of a combination lock dial and fragment of surrounding surface being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a top, front, and left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a second embodiment of a protective cover for a combination lock dial showing my nw design;
FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view thereof.



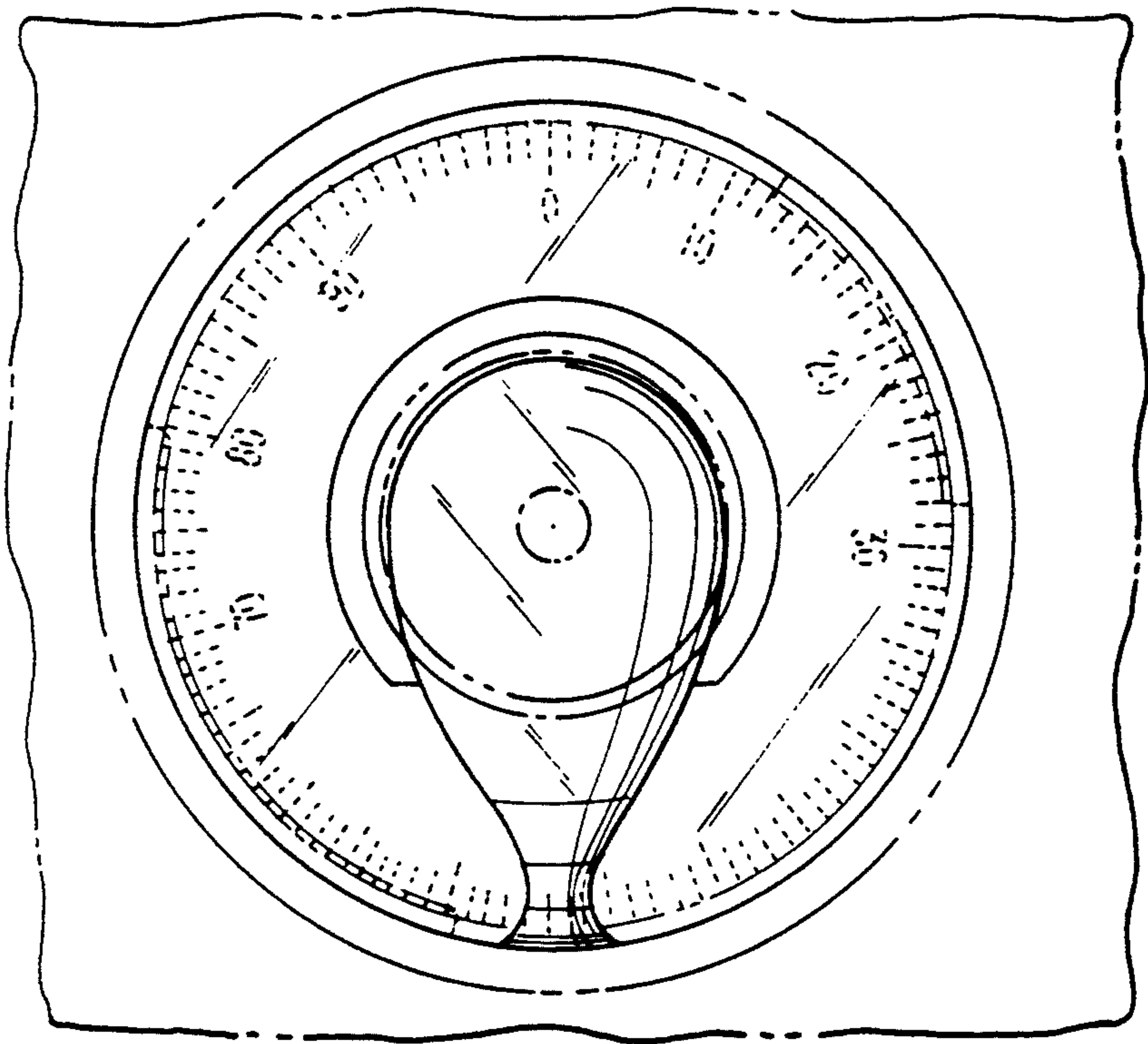

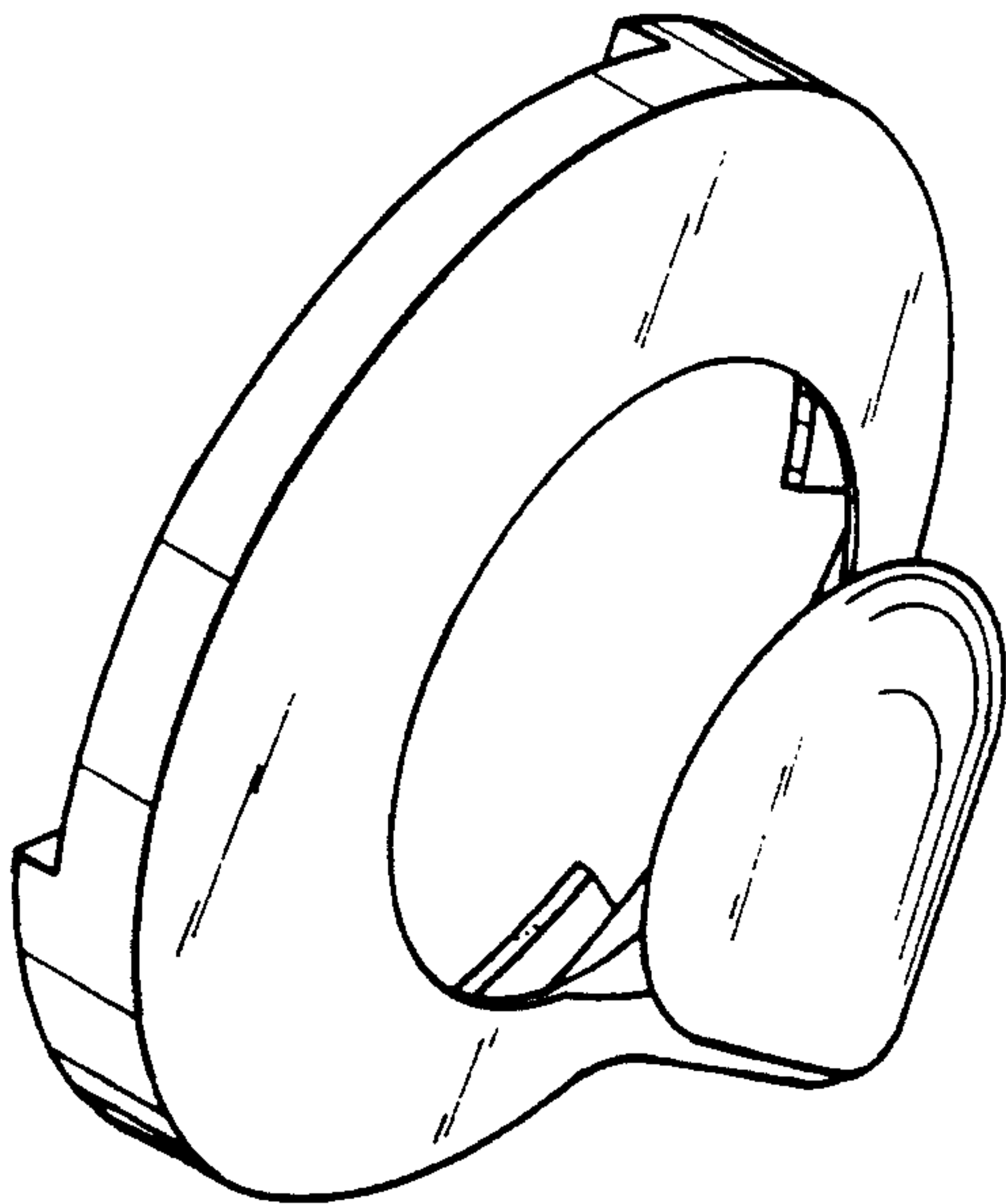

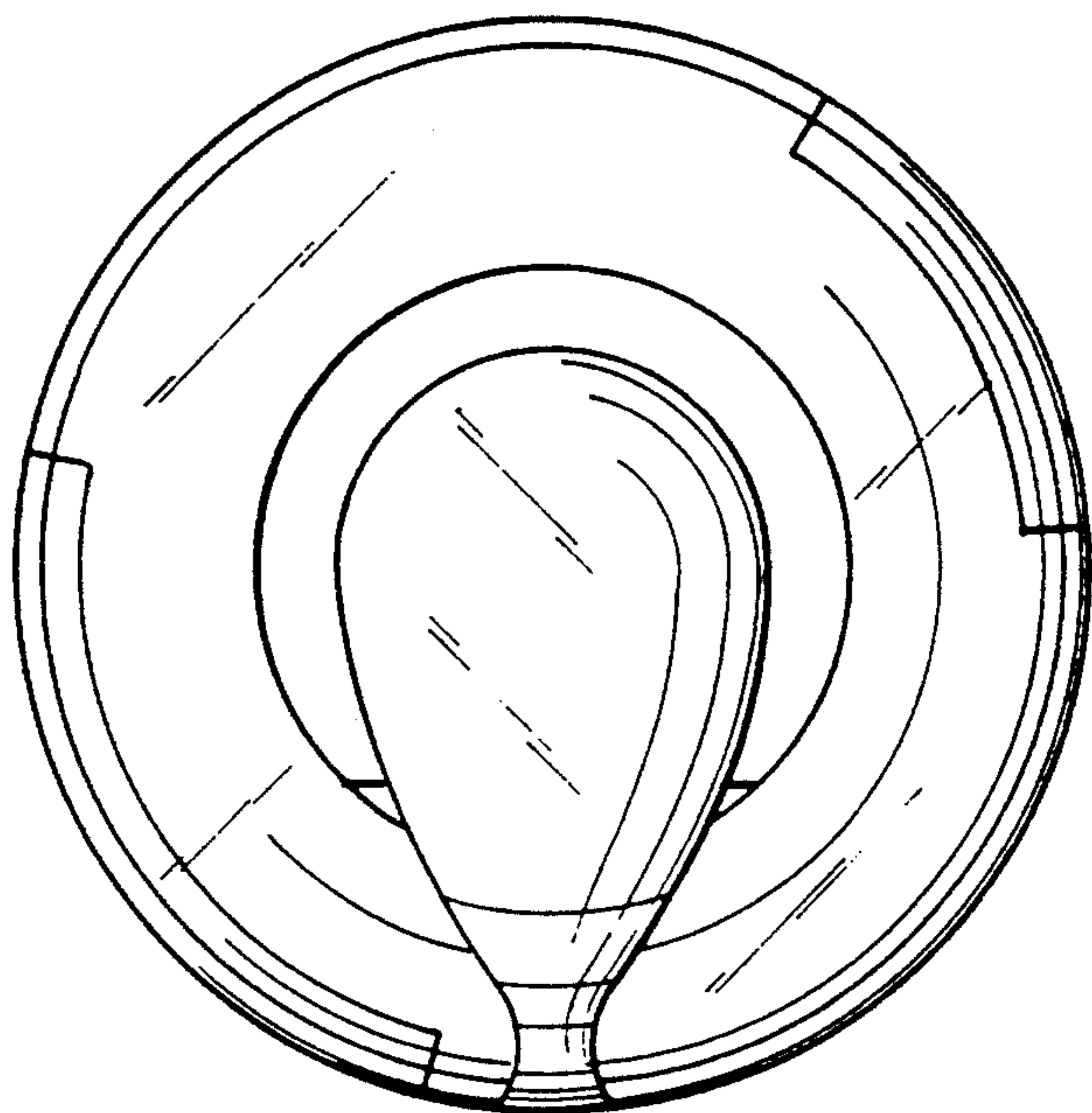

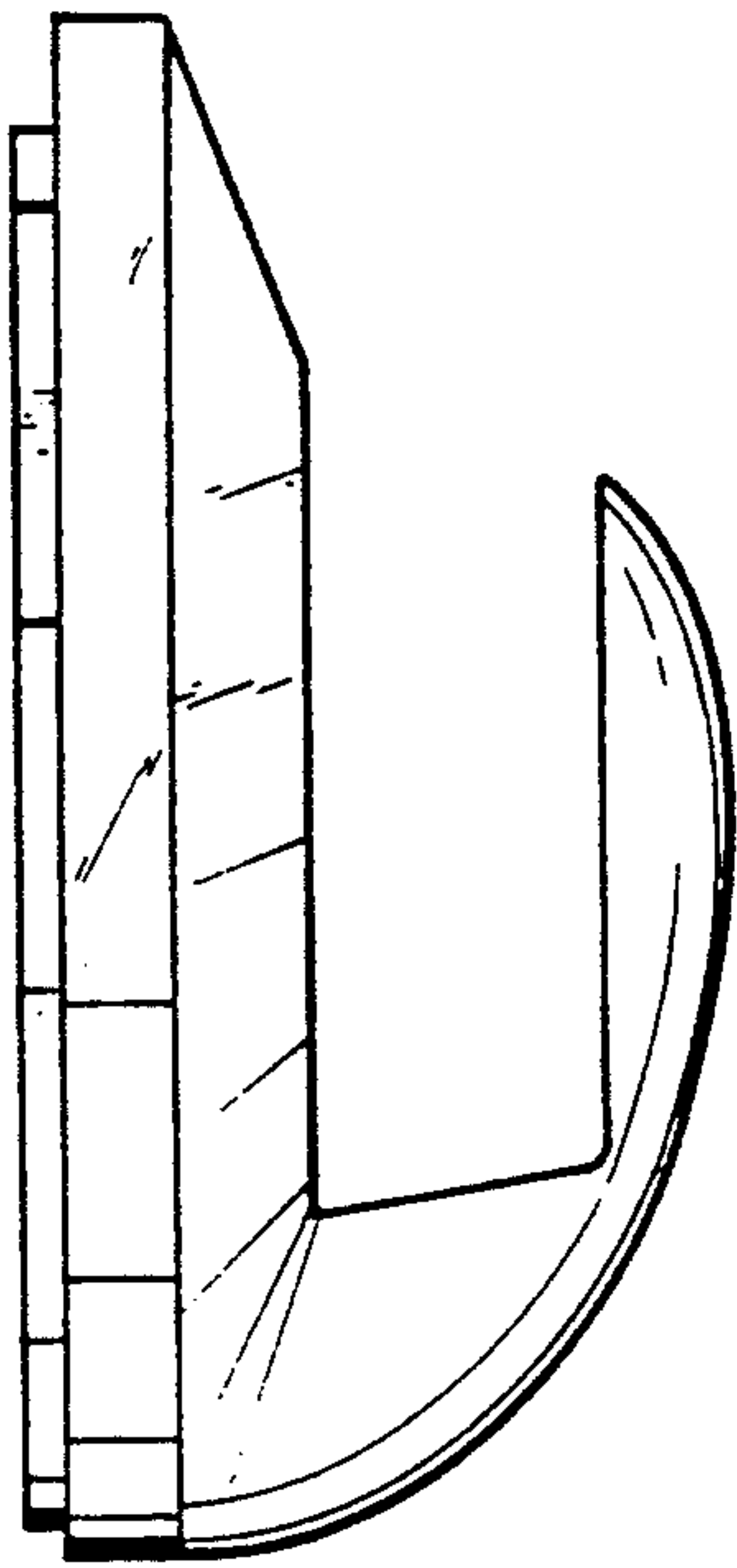

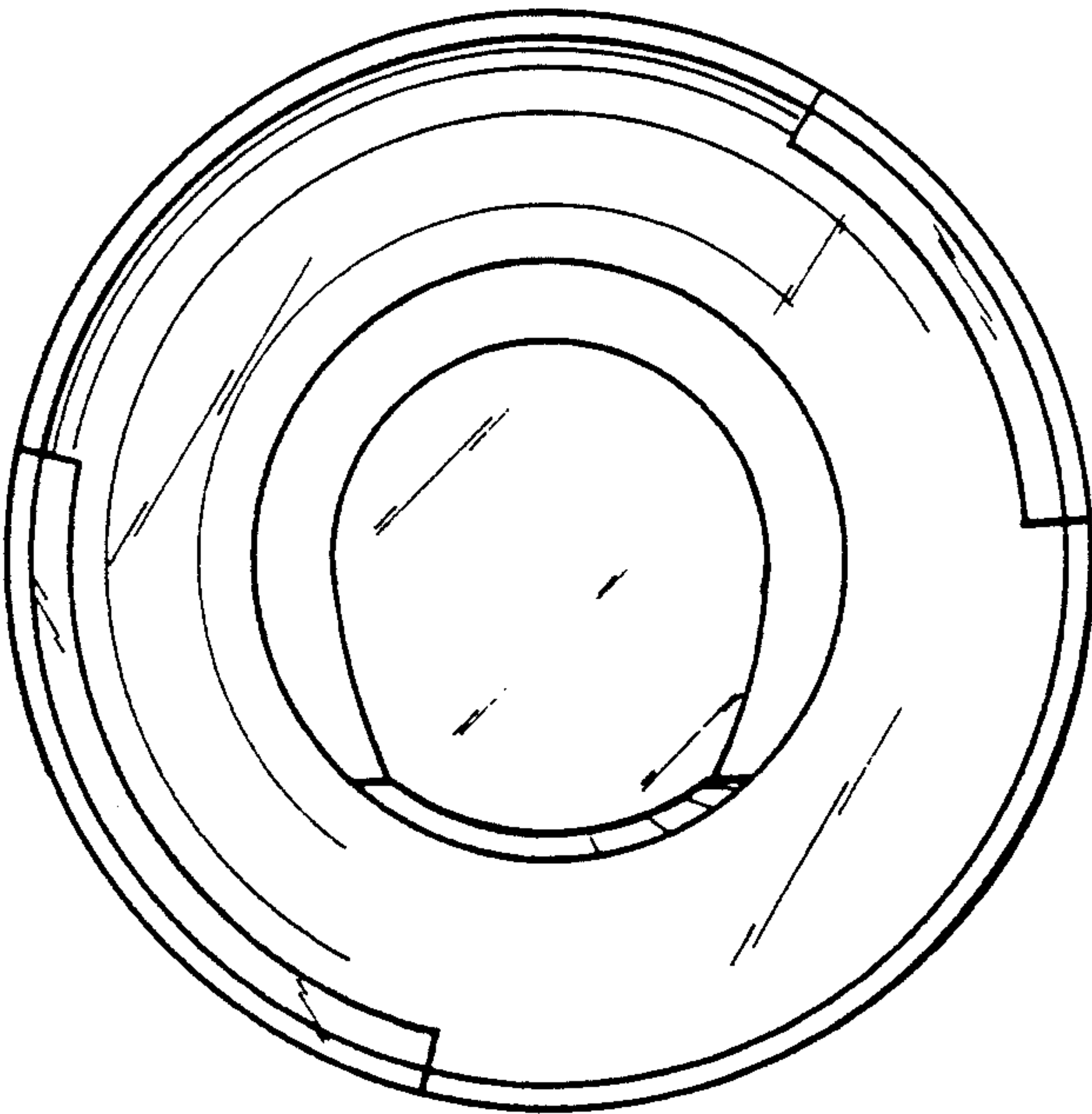

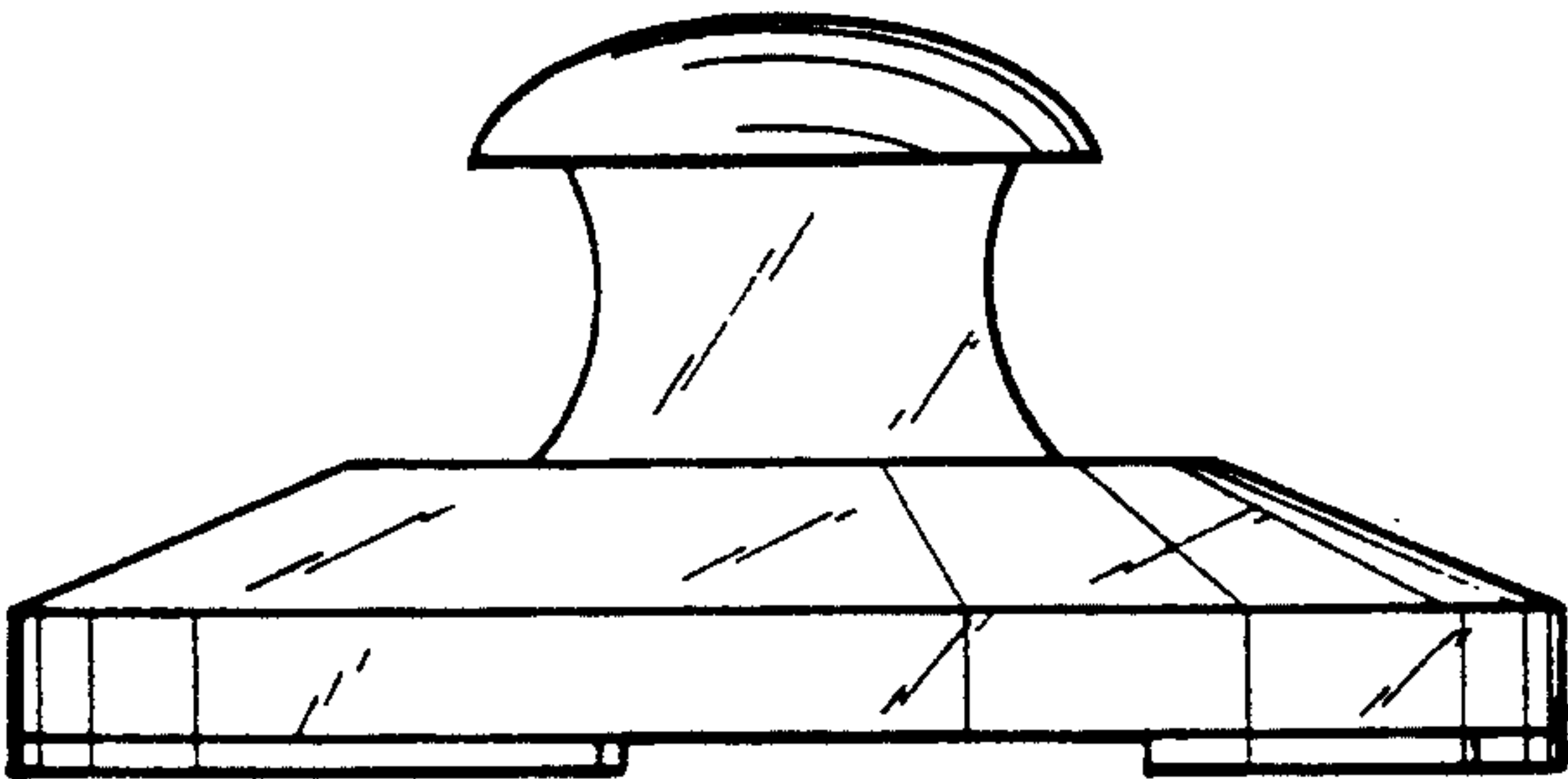

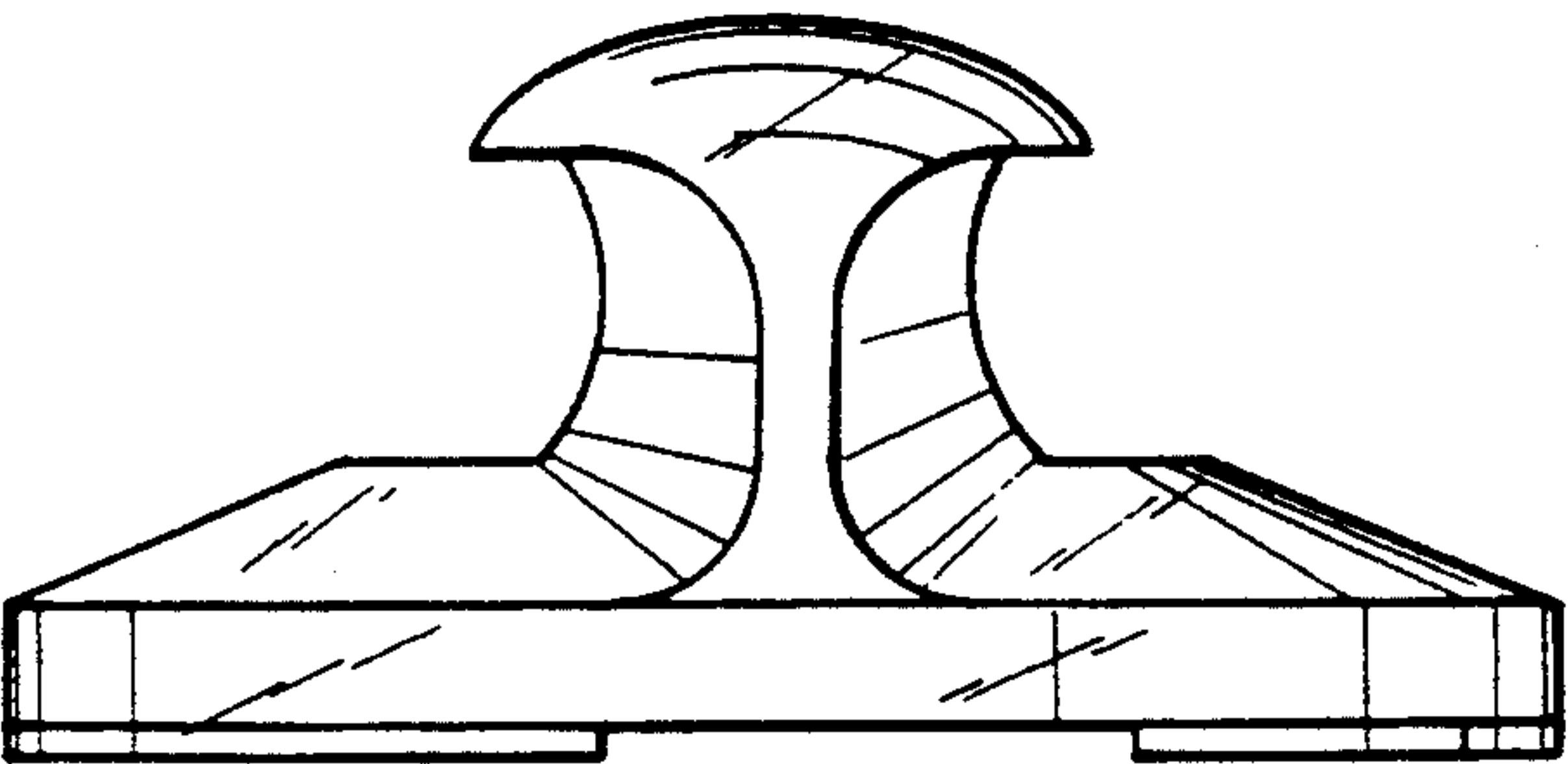

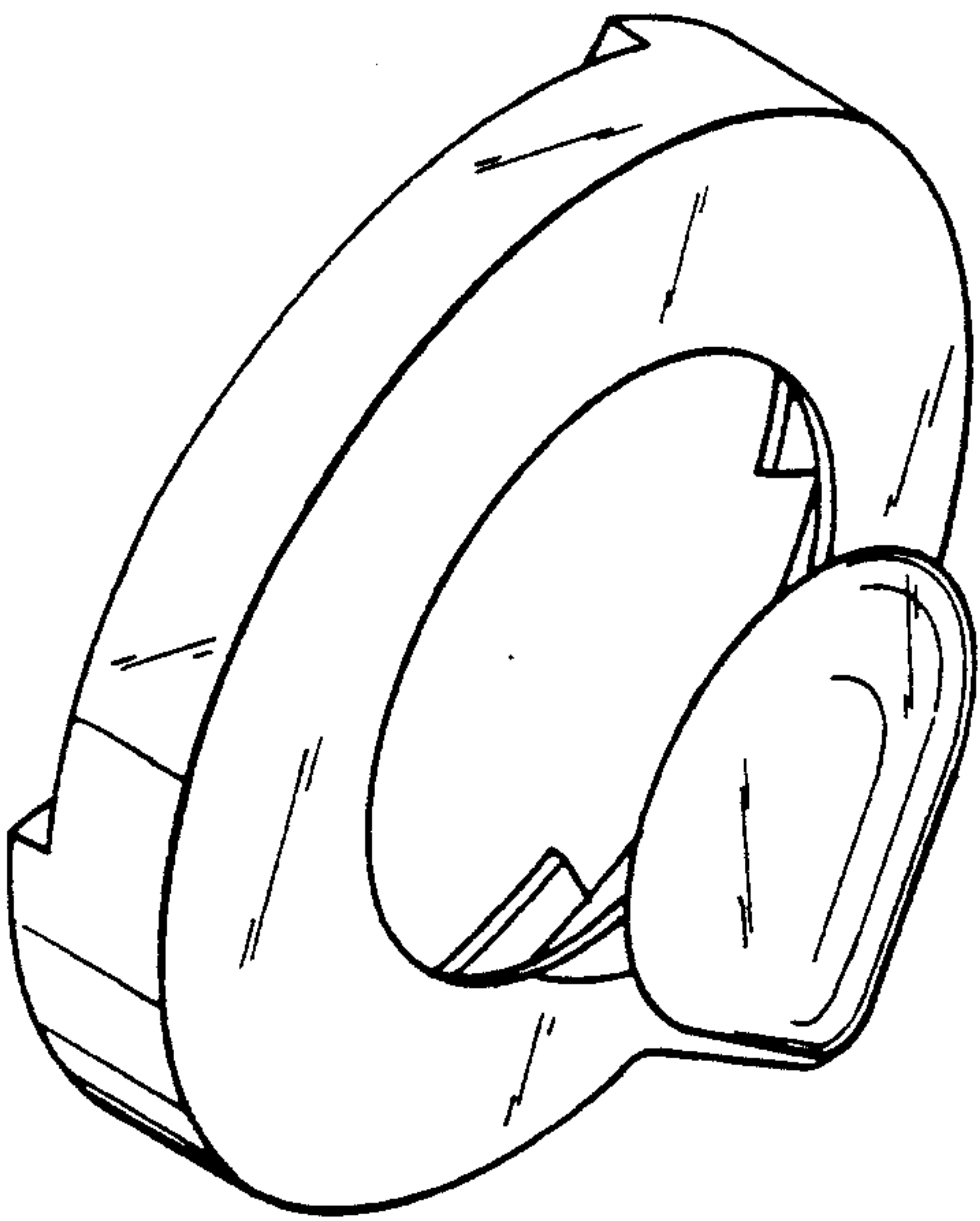

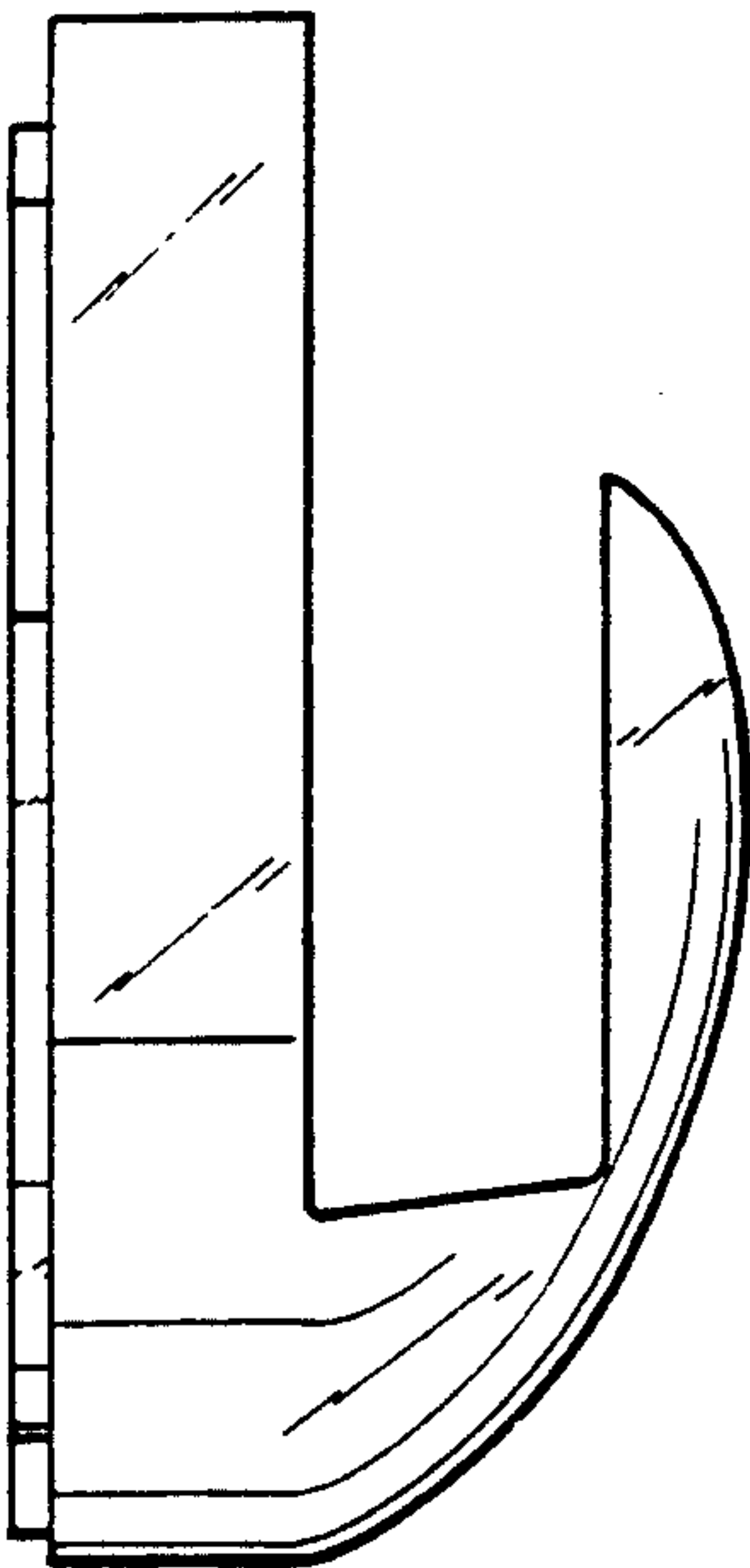

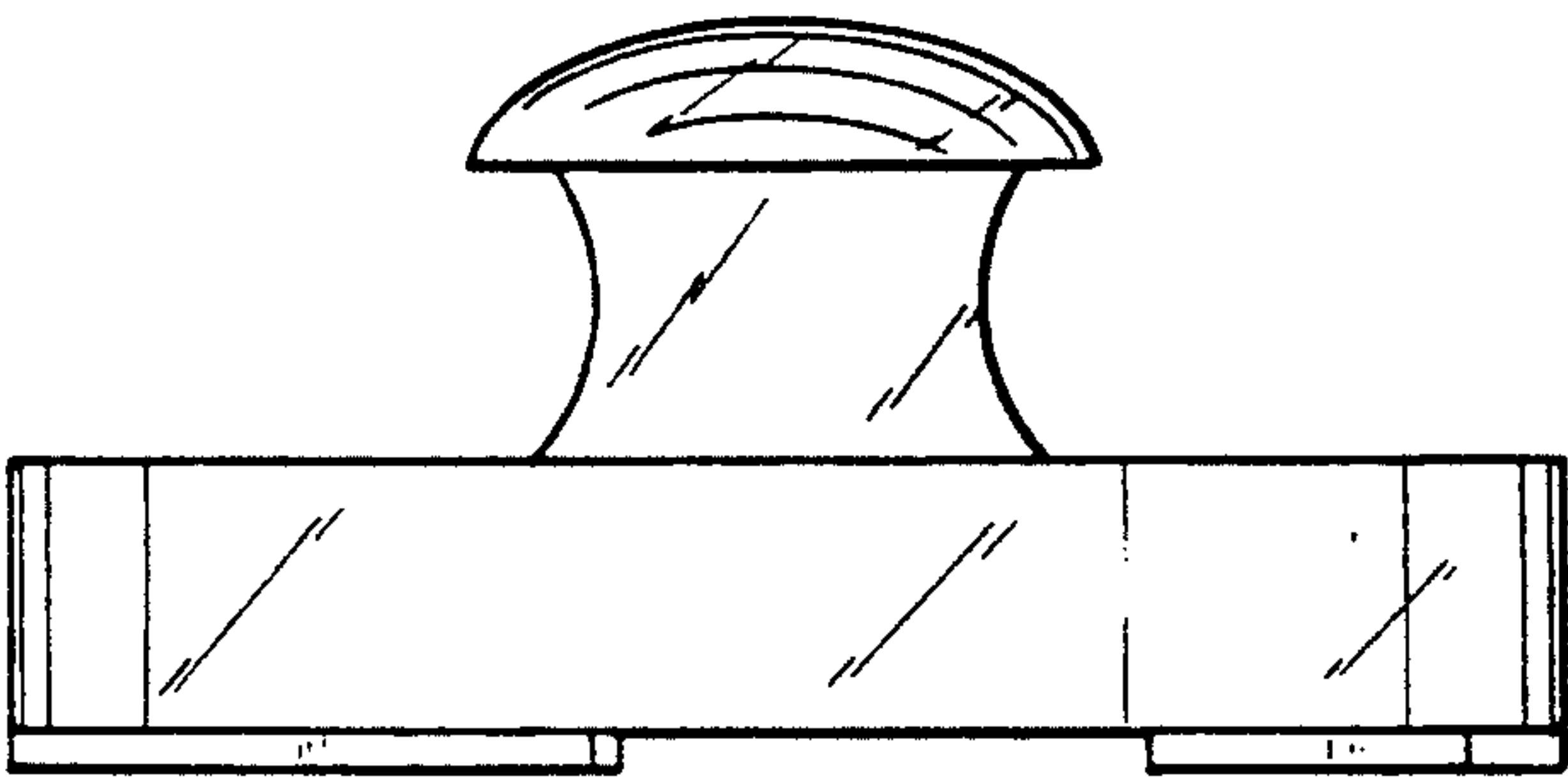

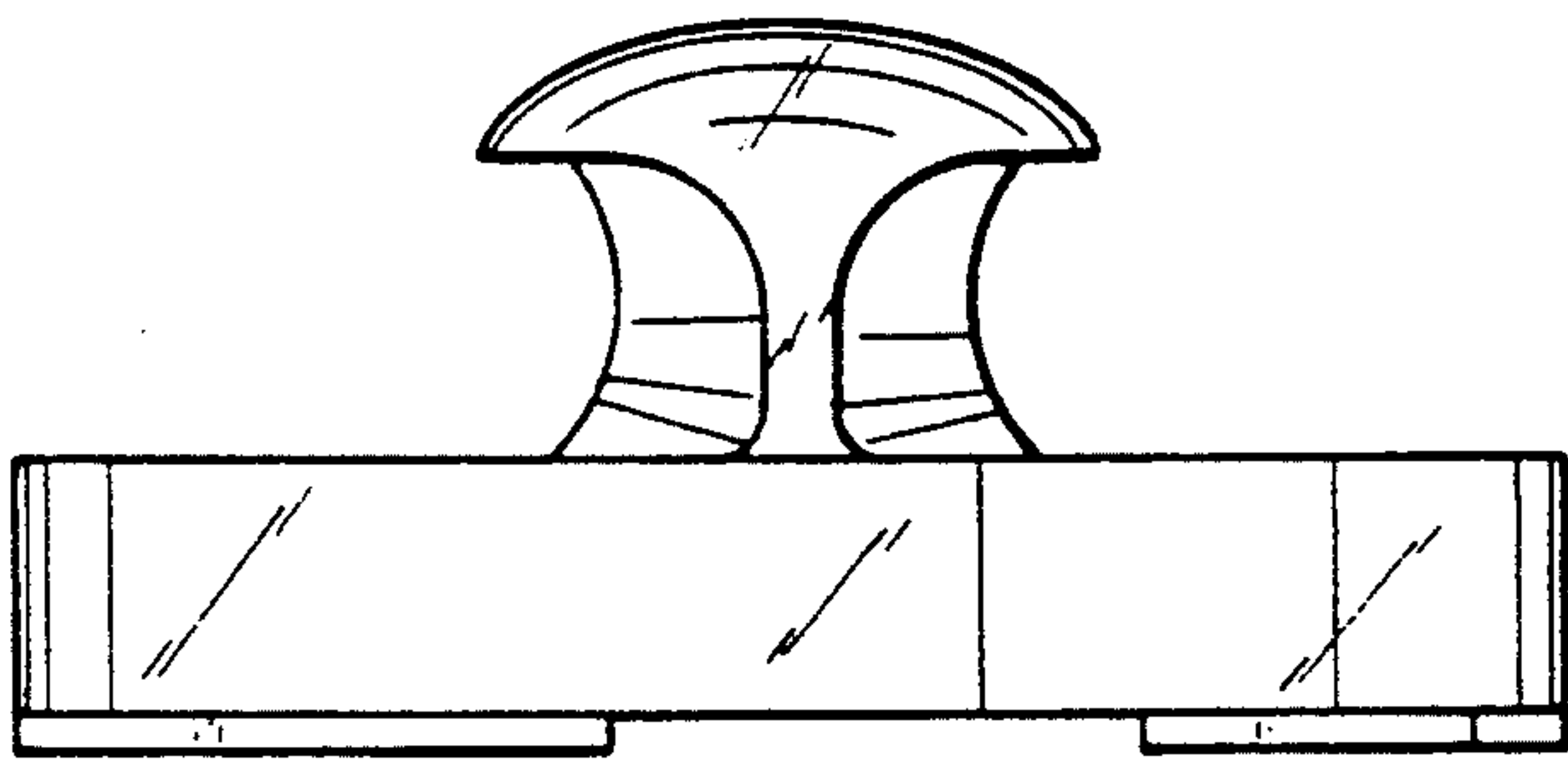

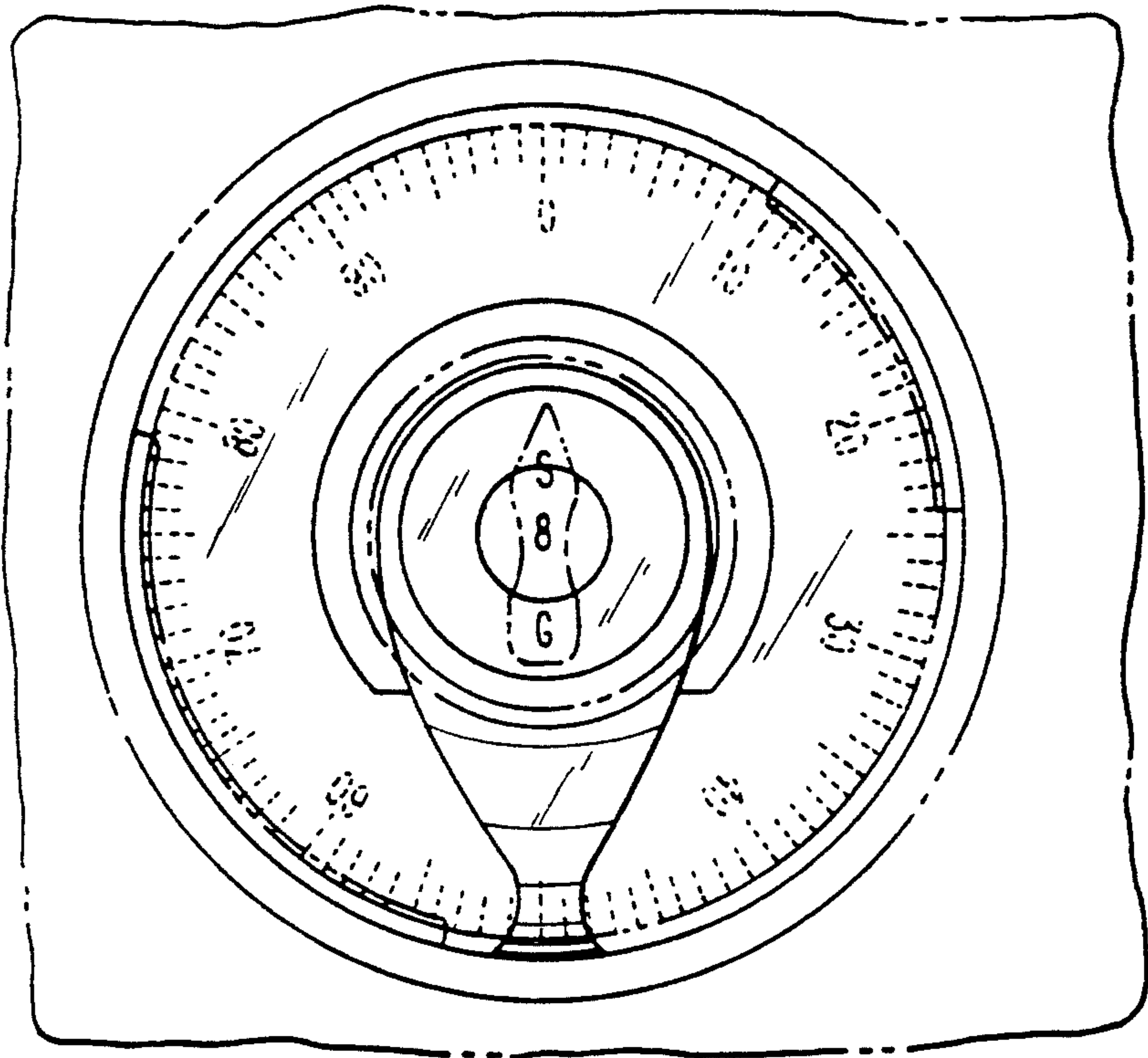

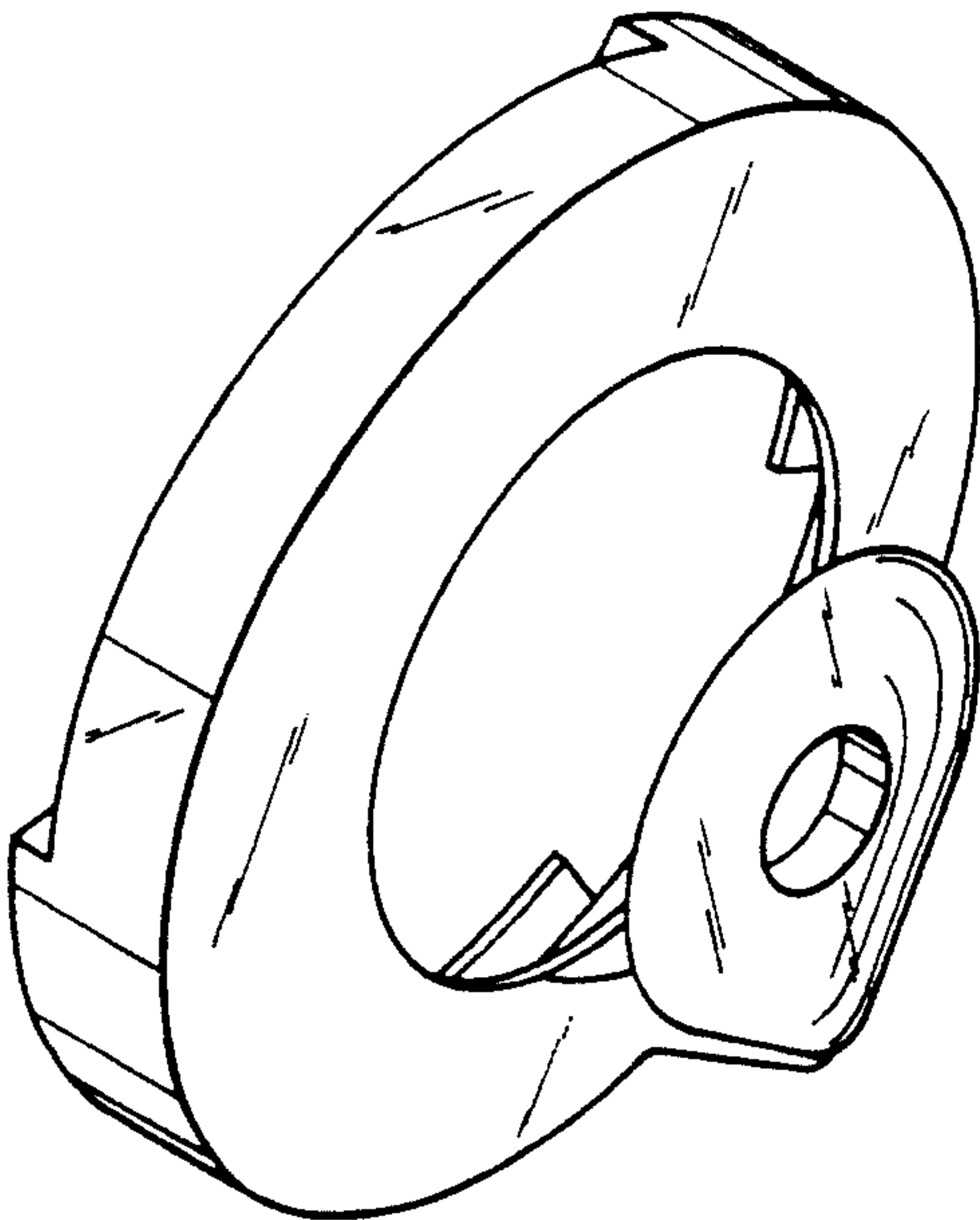

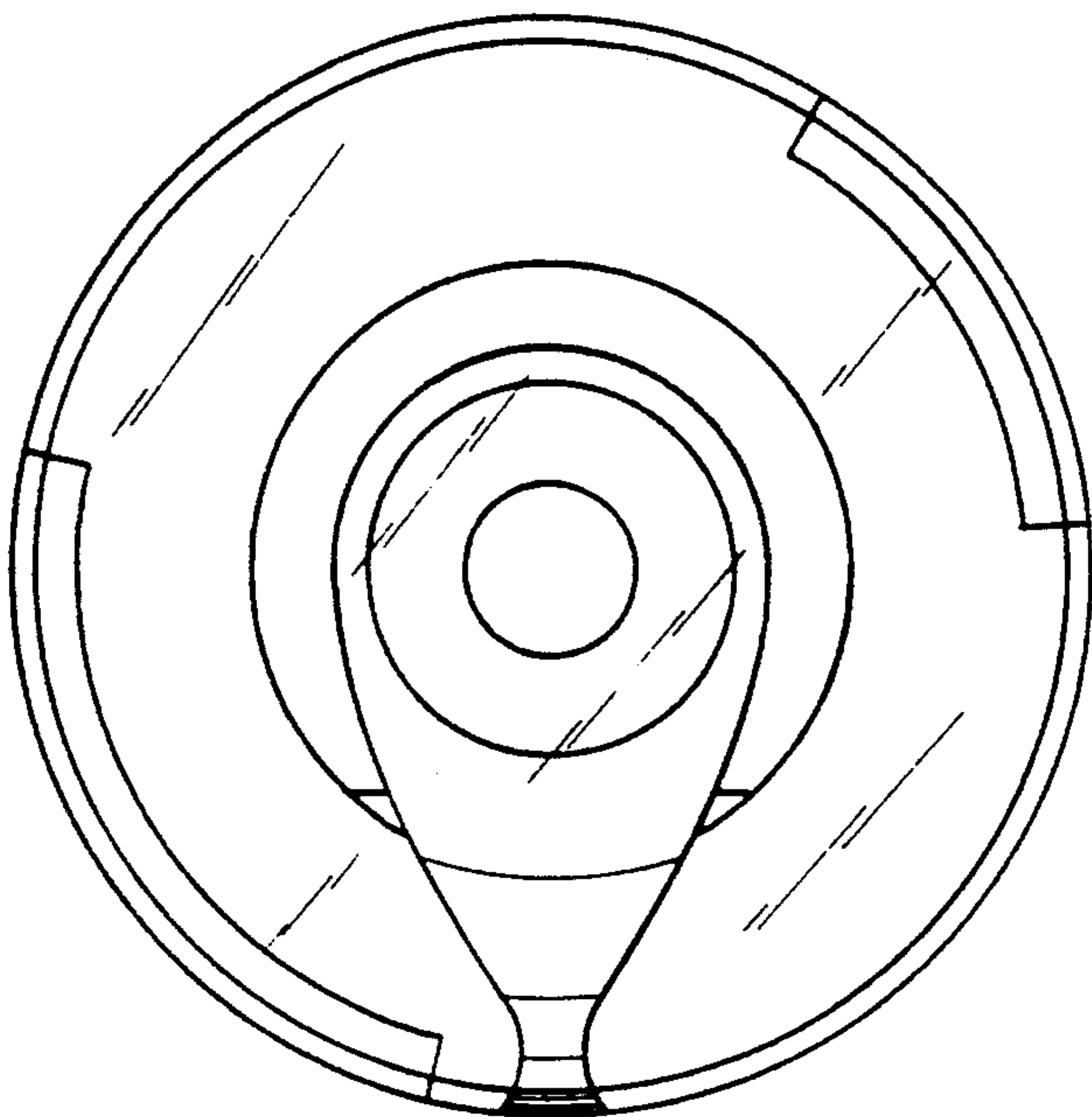

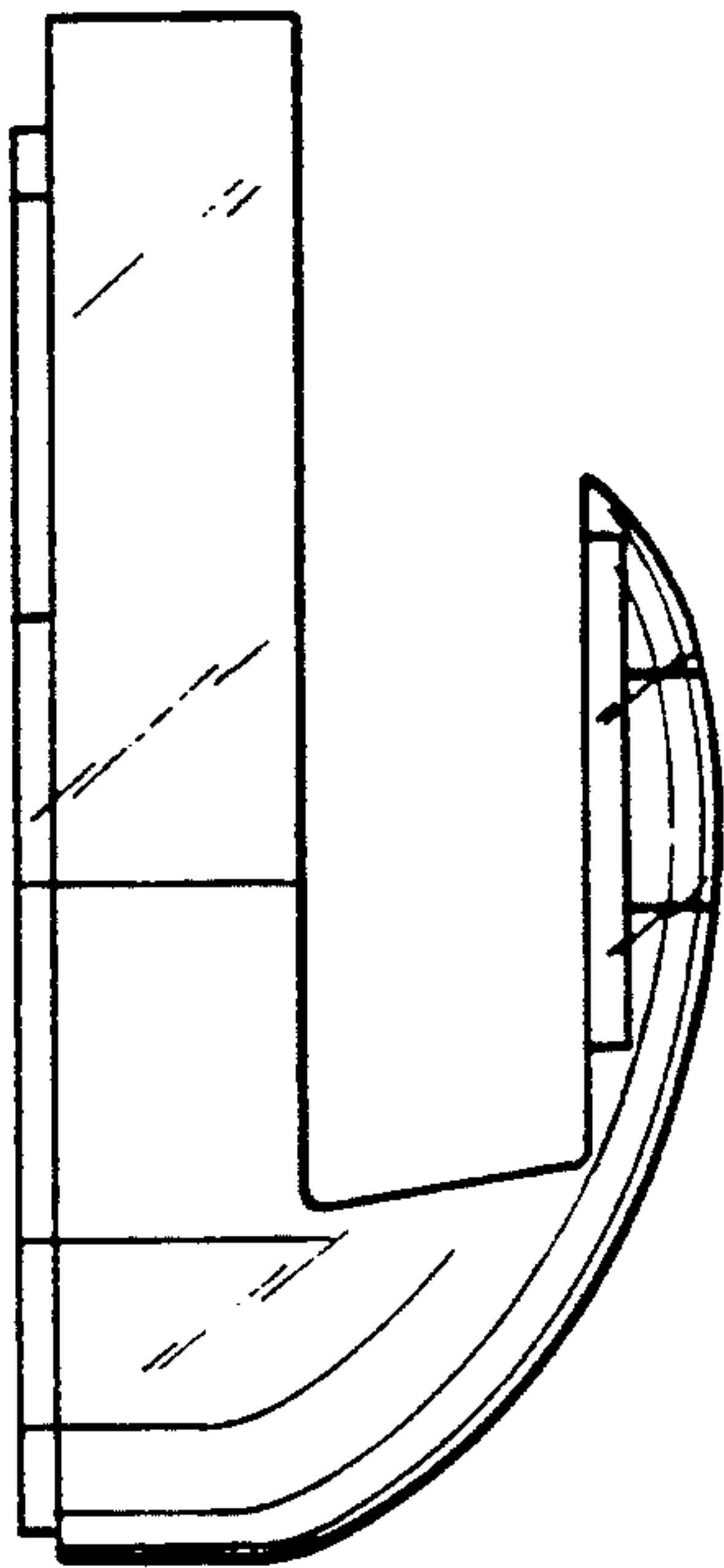

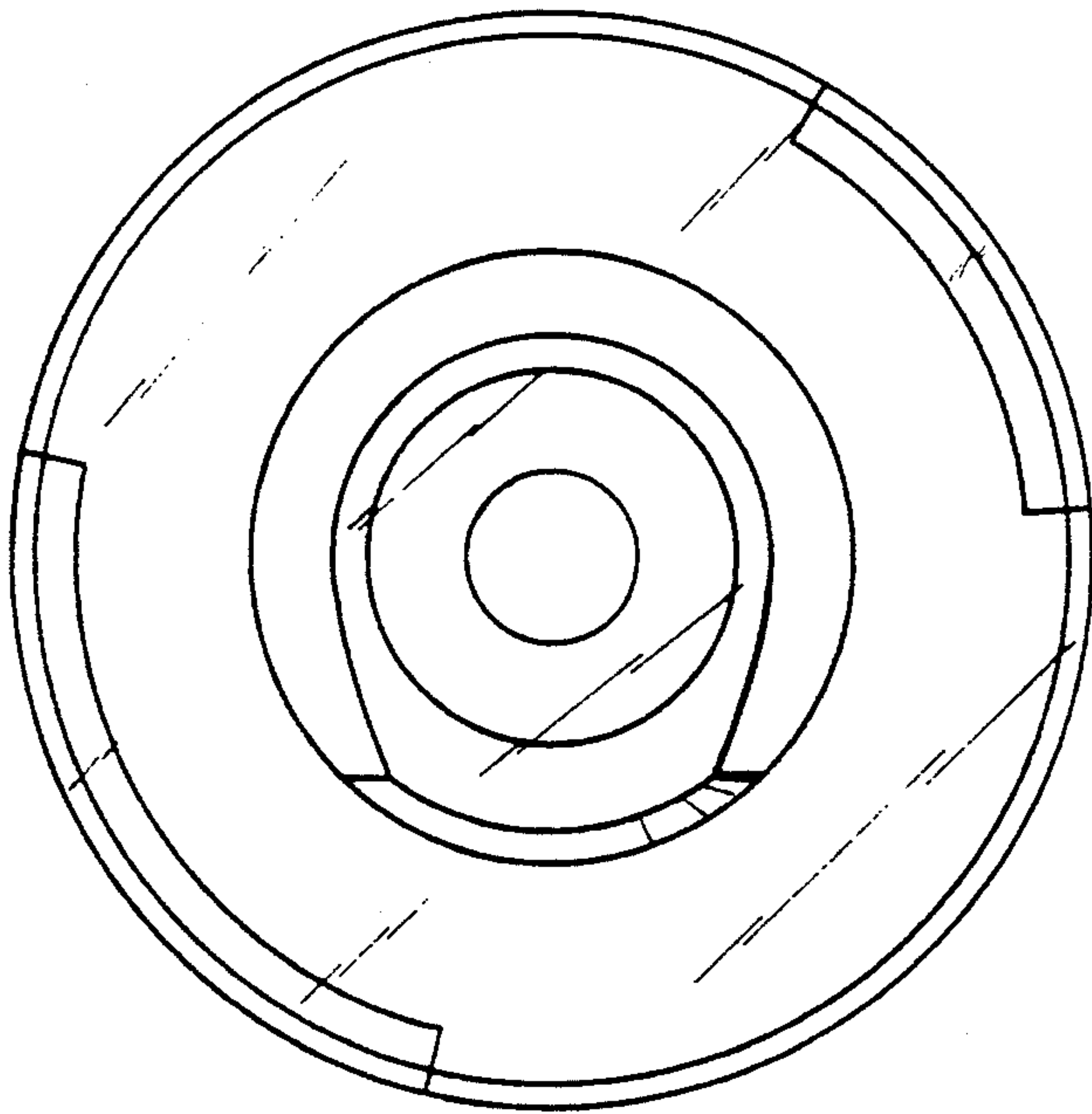

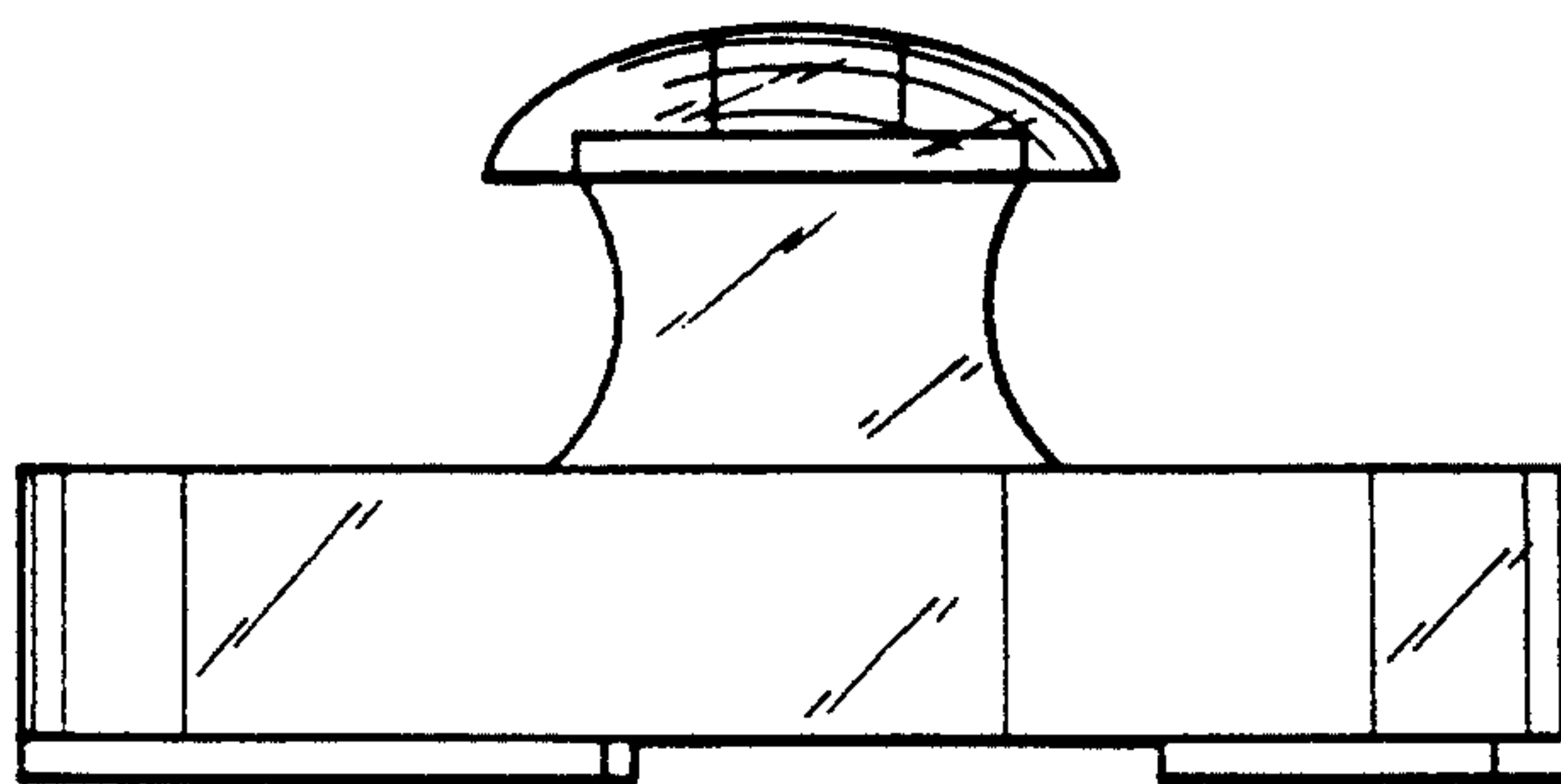

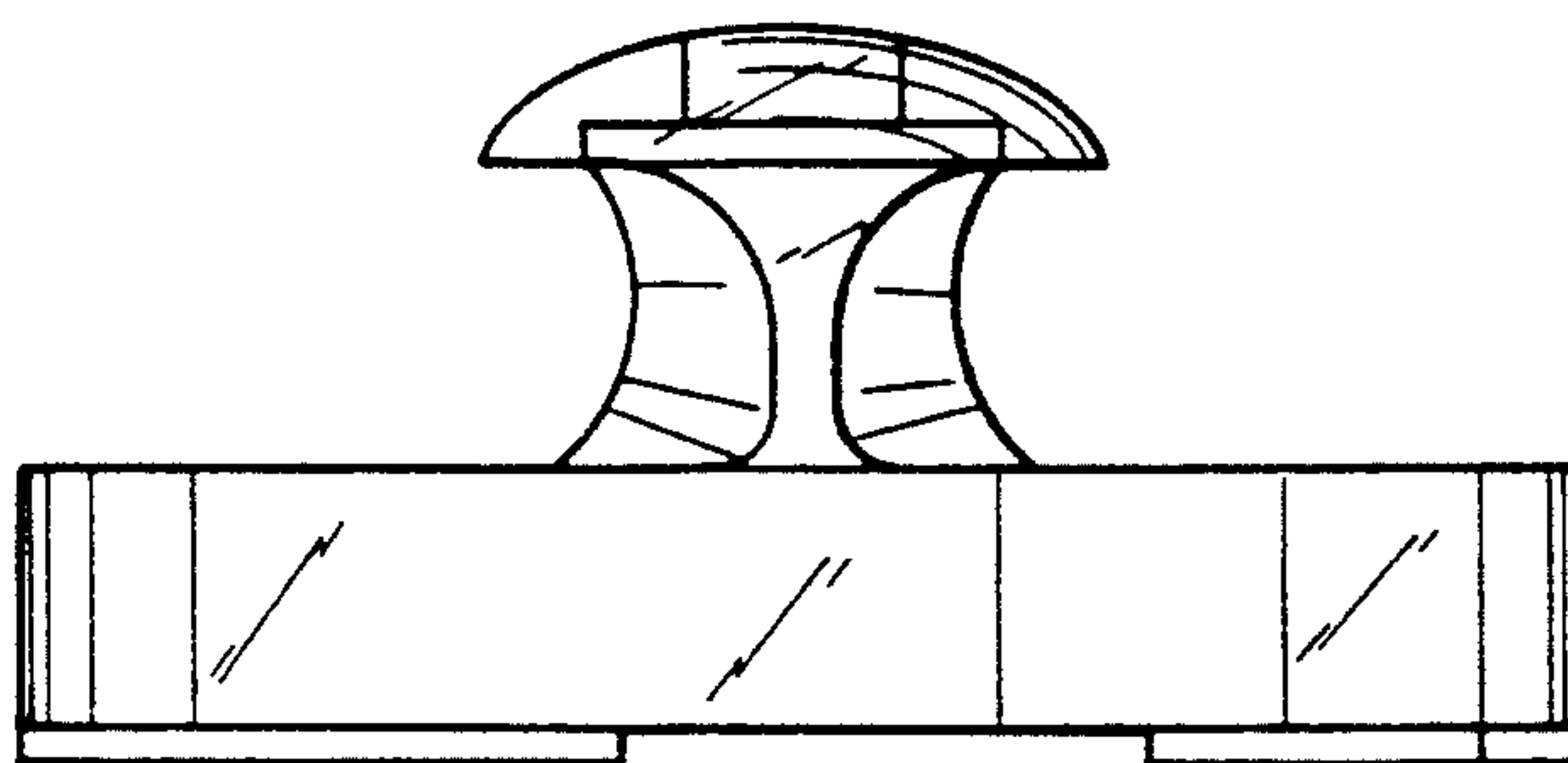
