The ornamental design for a neck of a musical instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom isometric view of a neck of a musical instrument showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side cross-sectional view of the neck of FIG. 2 taken through the line 3—3 thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the neck of a musical insturment;


FIG. 5 is an end elevational view taken from the bottom thereof;


FIG. 6 is an end elevational view taken from the top thereof; and,
