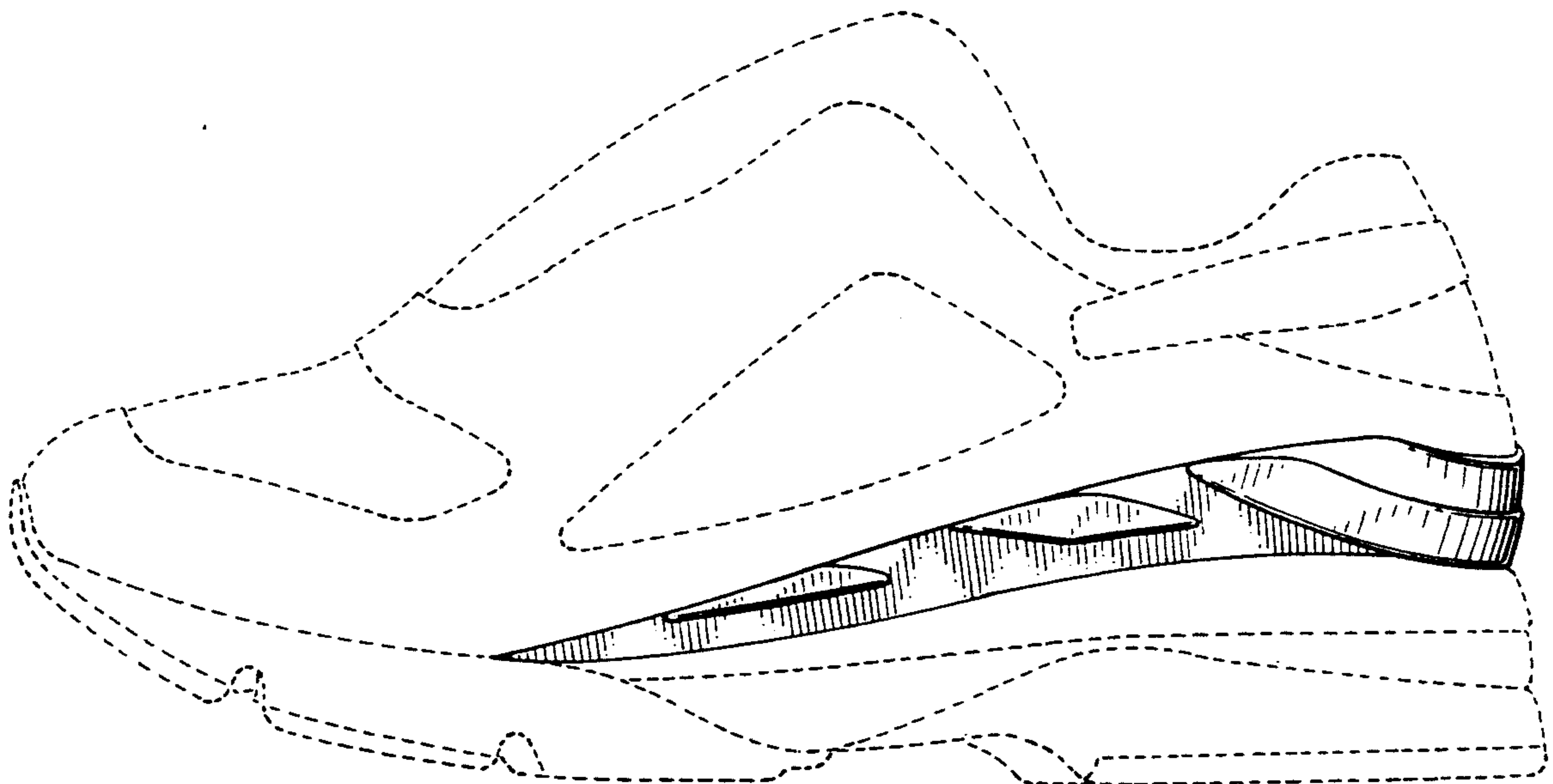
FIG. 1 is a left side view in elevation of an element of a shoe showing our new design;

The dotted lines are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.



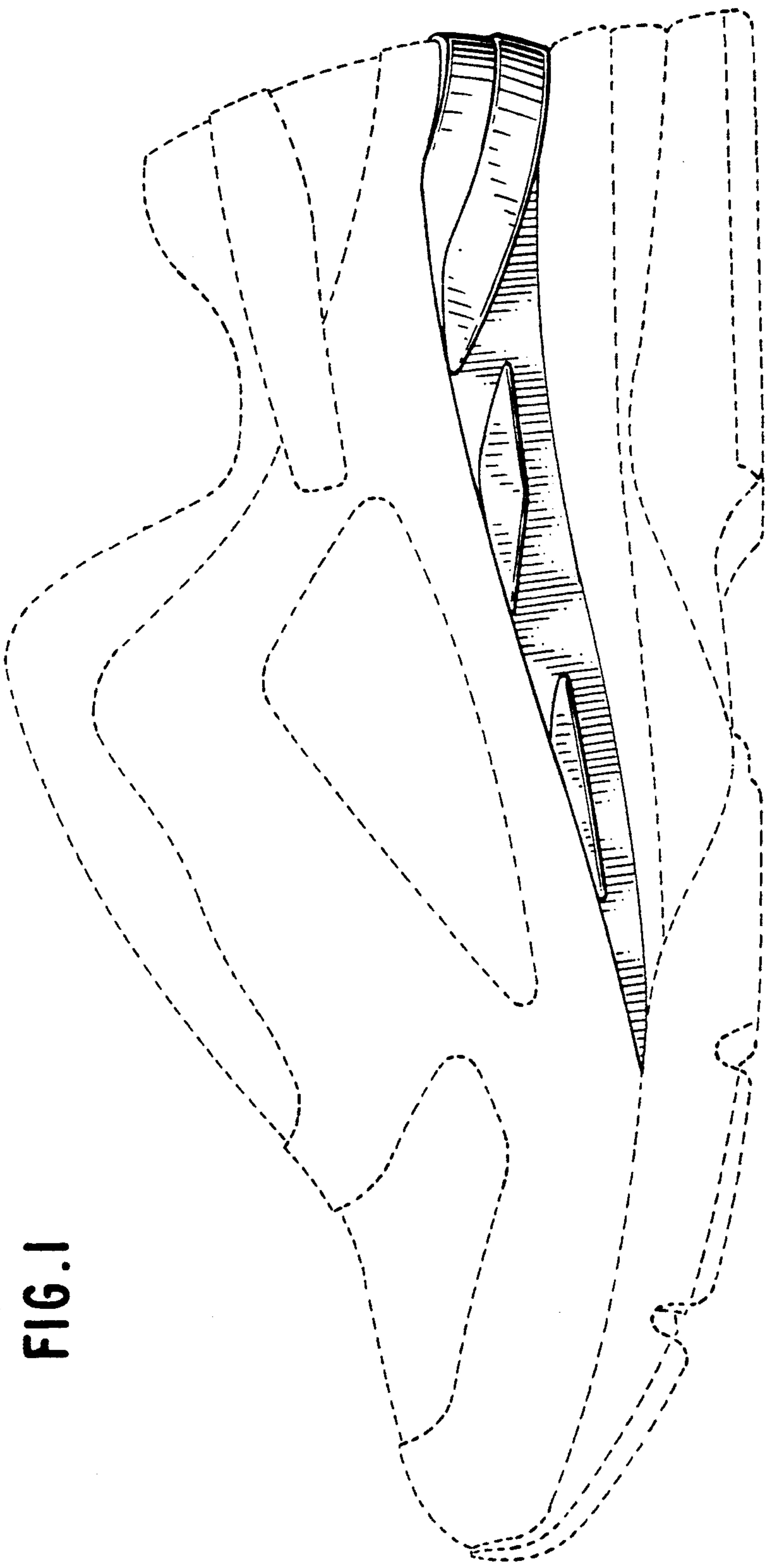
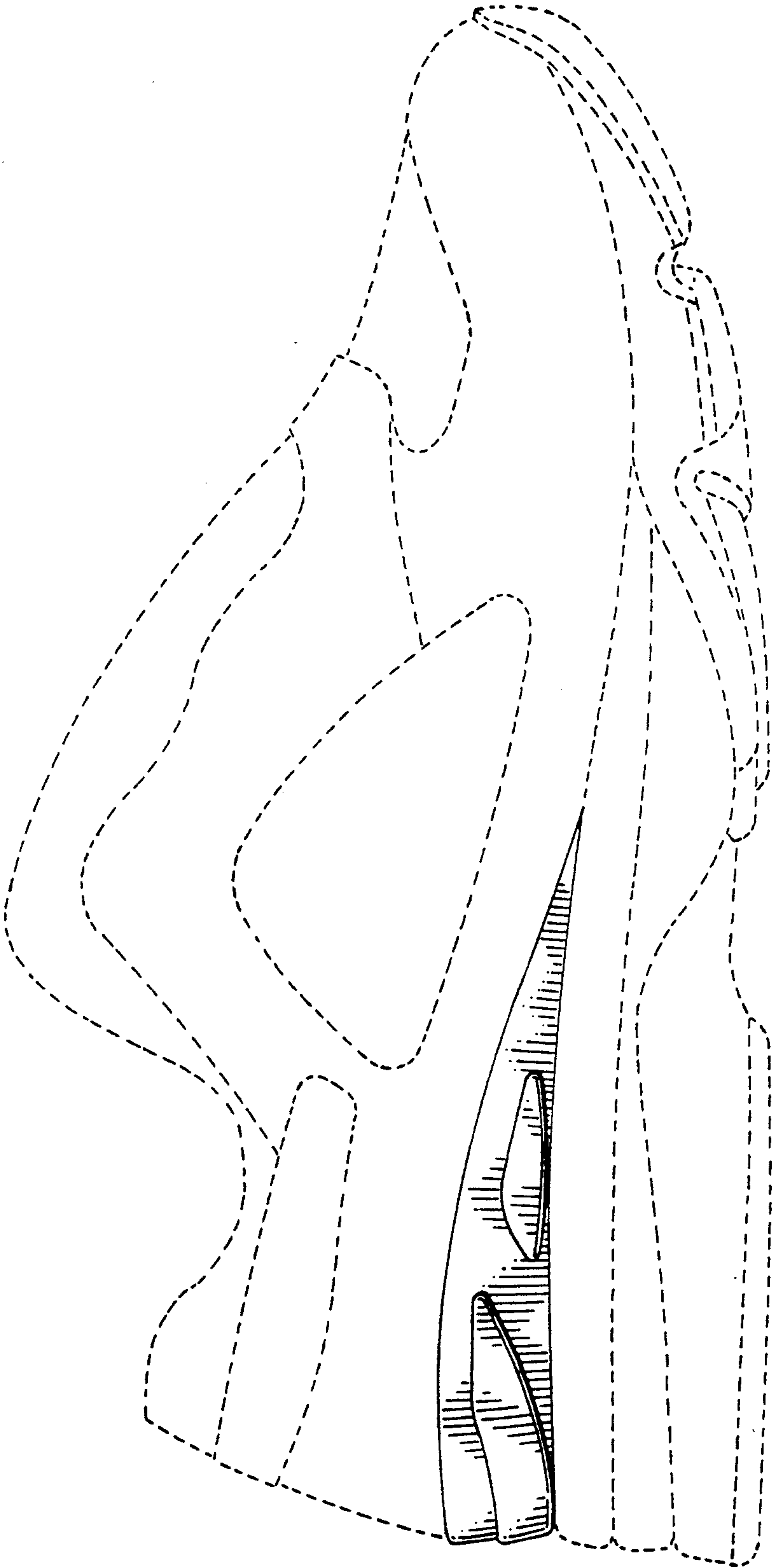

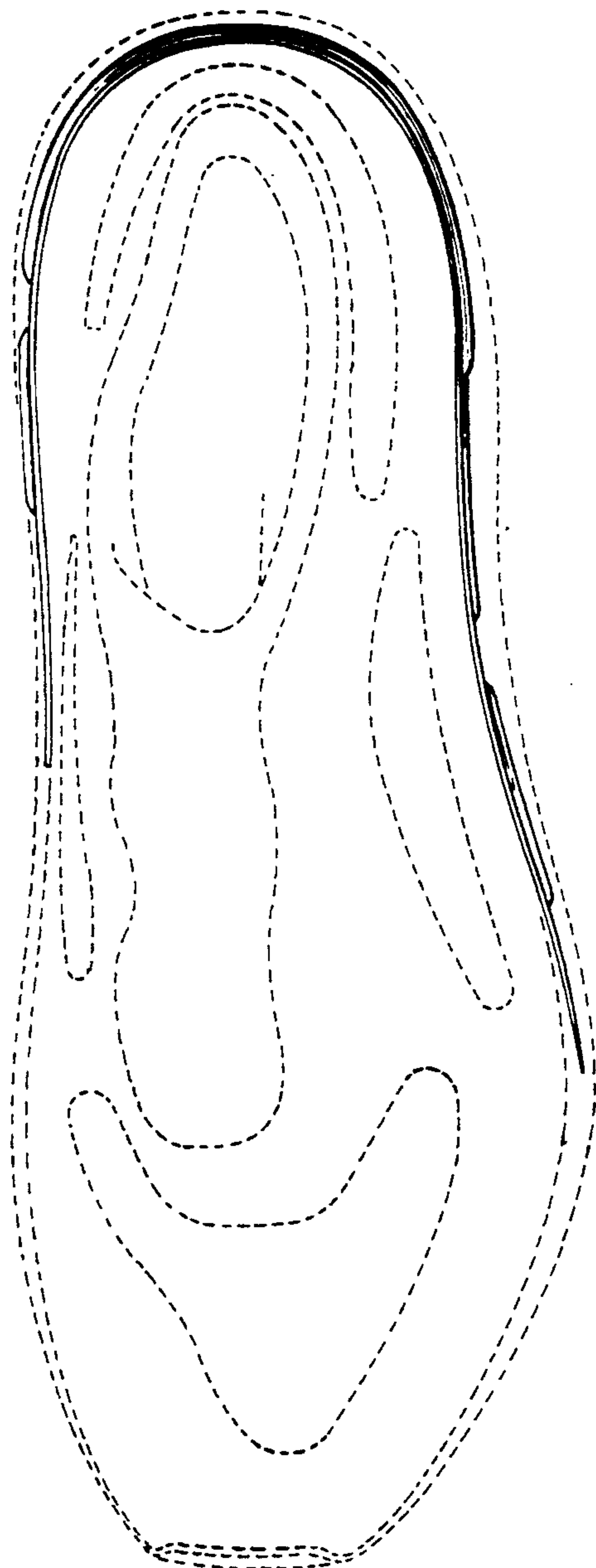

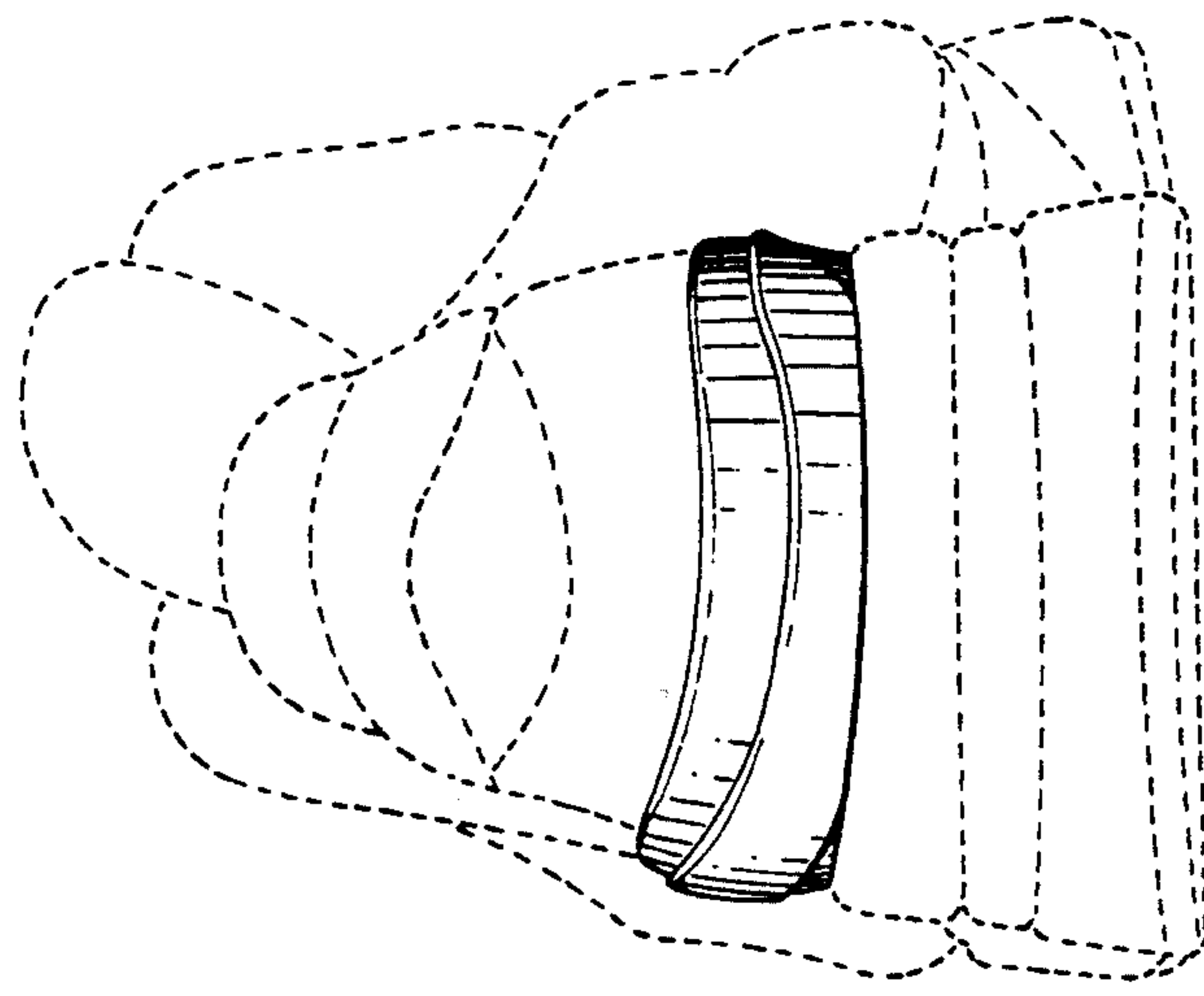
