DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the tape measure;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view;

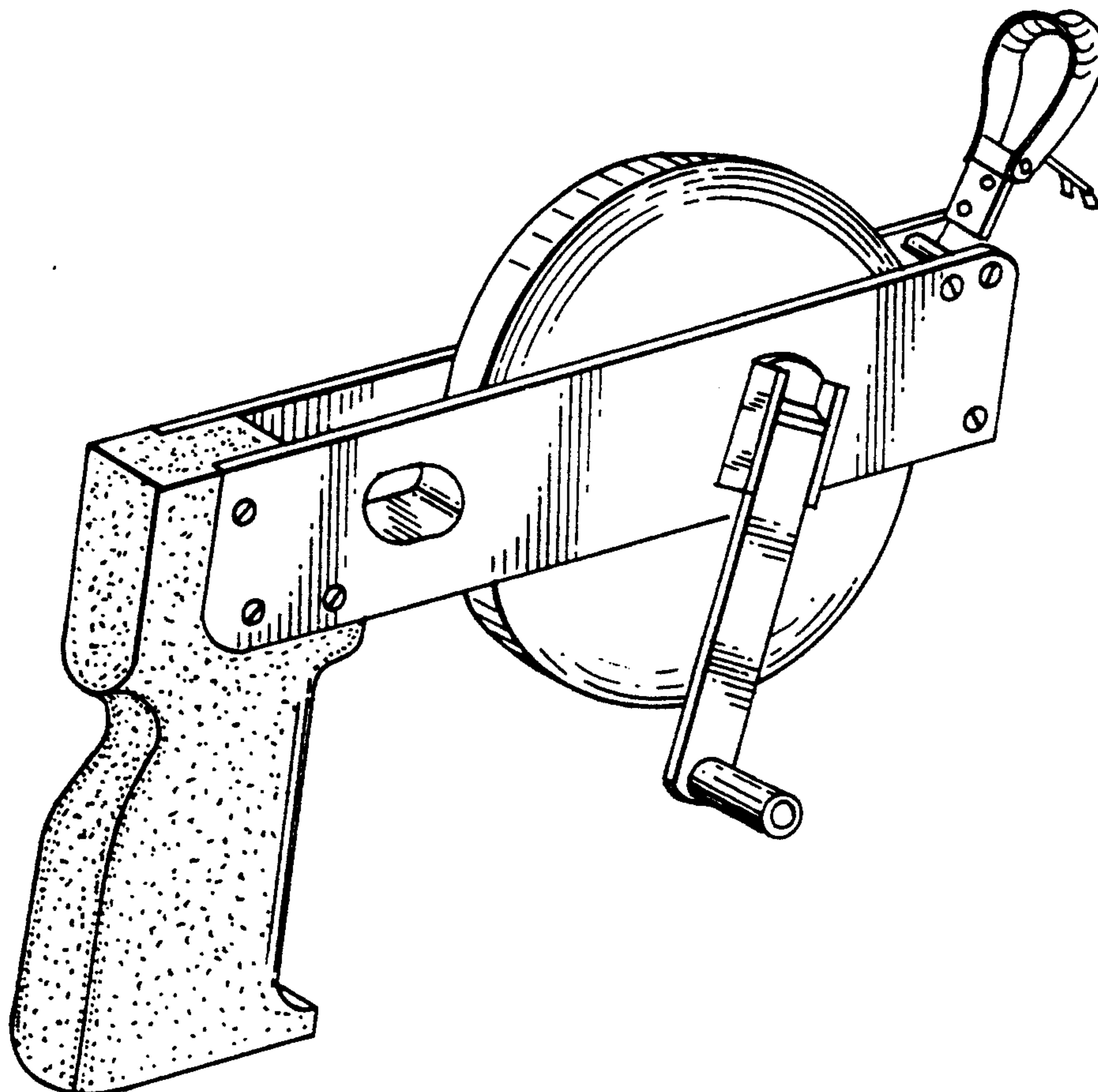
FIG. 4 is a plan view from above in the sense of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is an end elevation view from the left in the sense of FIG. 2; and,

The tape measure of FIG. 1 is shown in a condition of use.



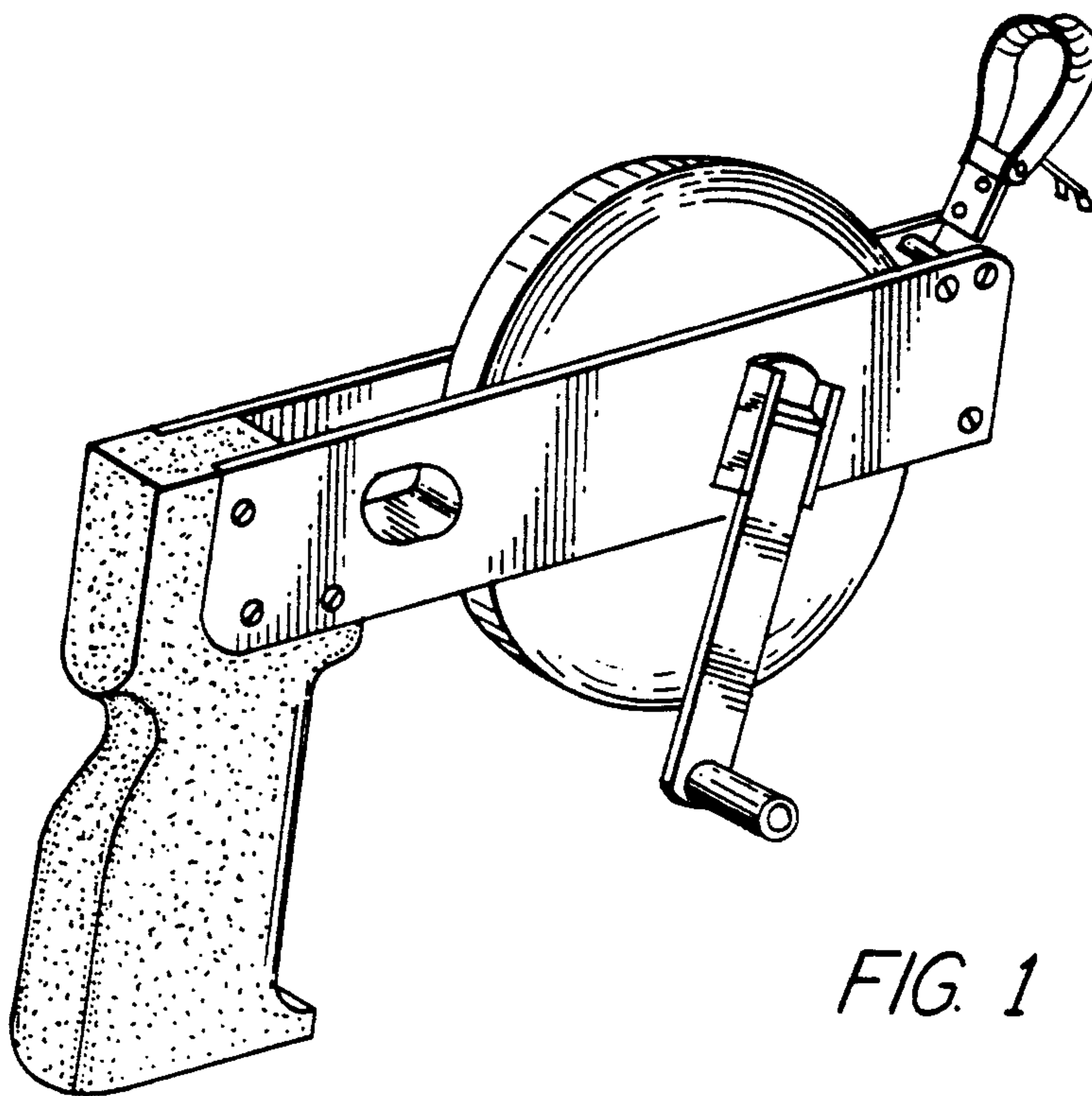

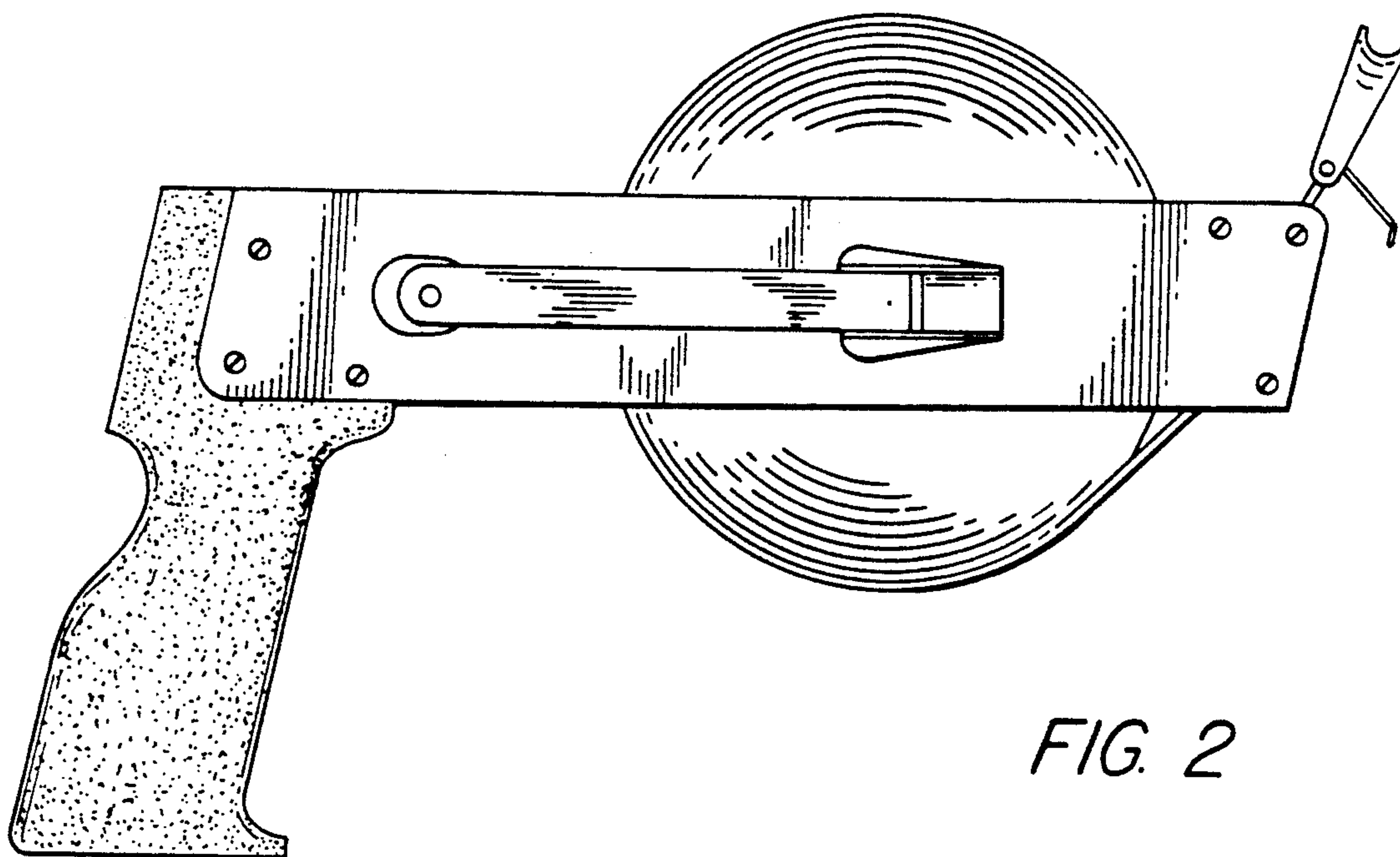

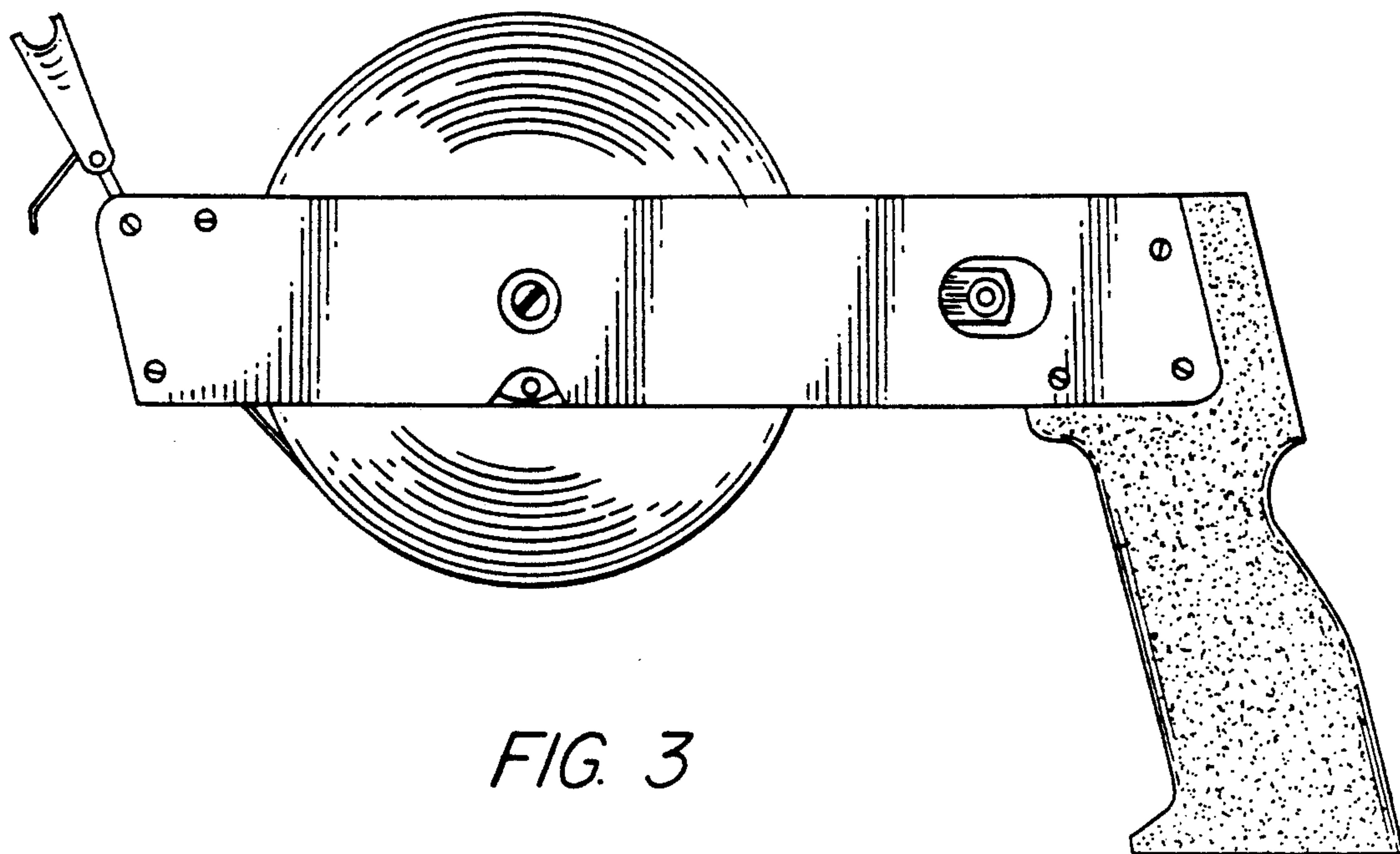

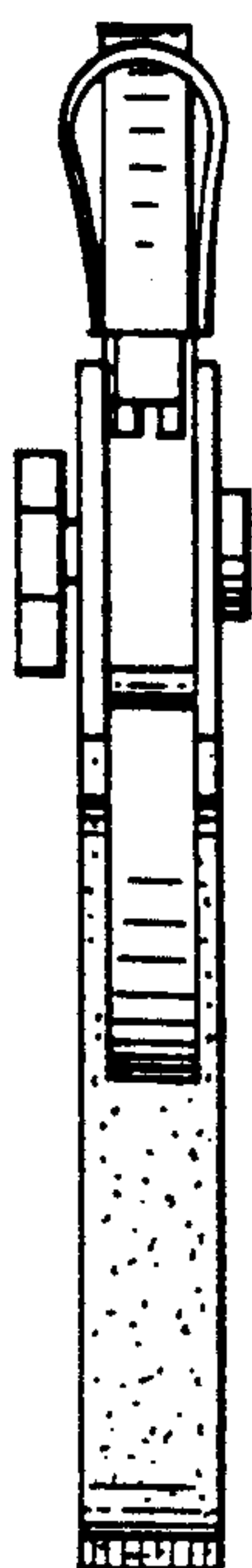

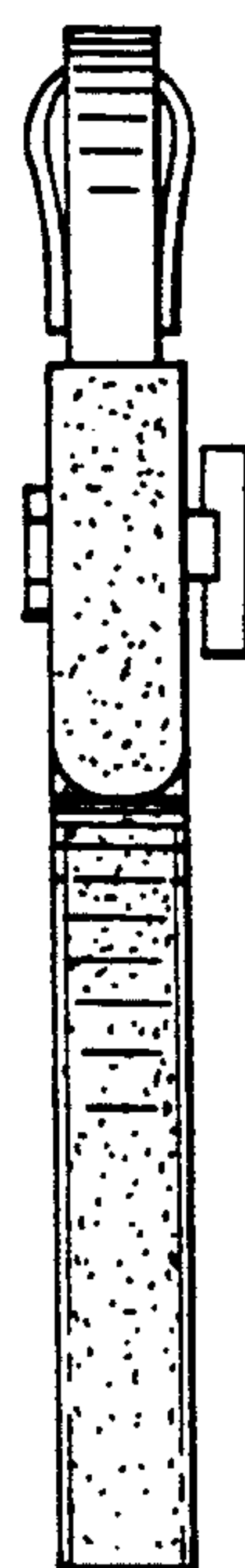
