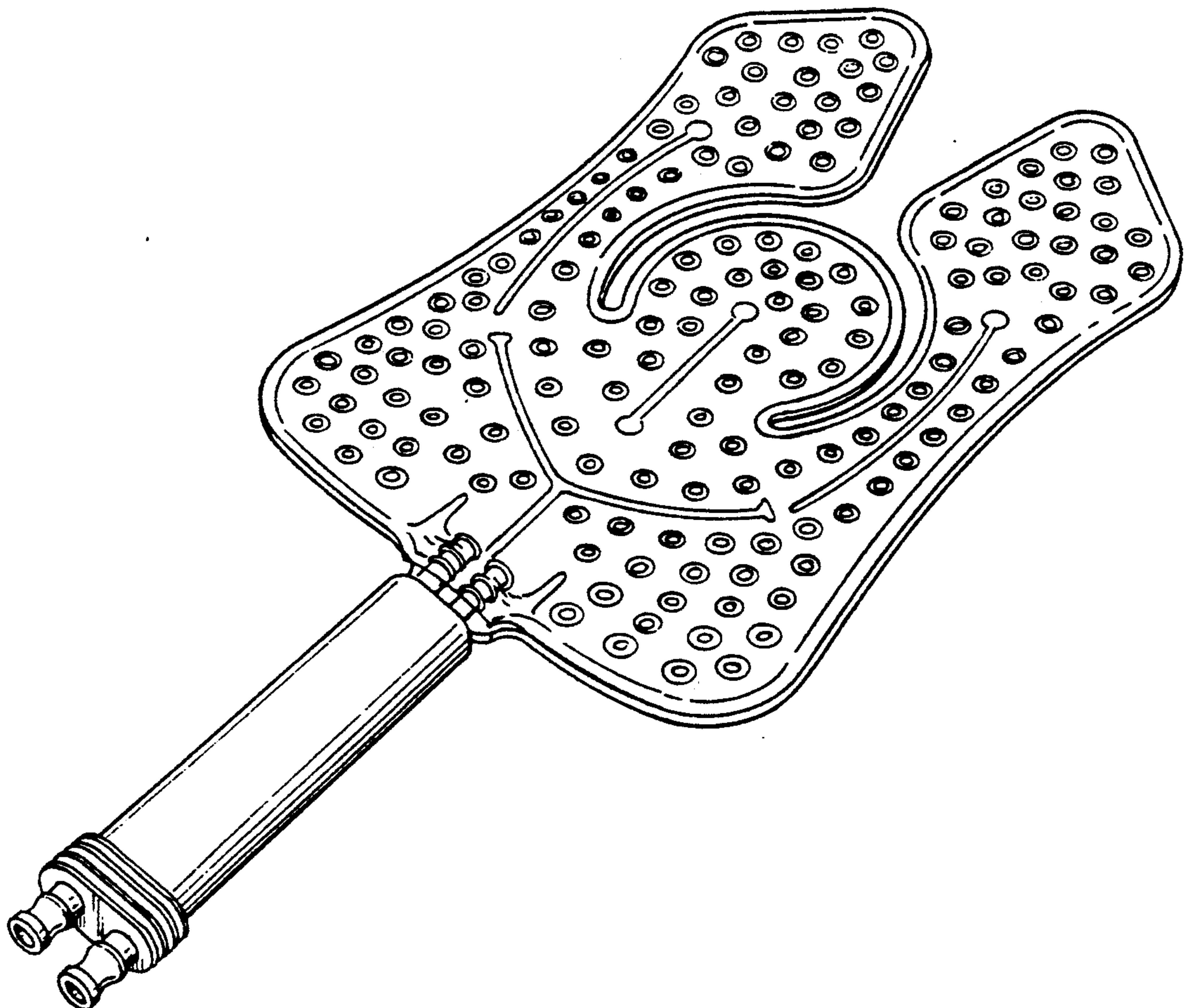

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a therapeutic fluid circulation pad showing our design;
FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



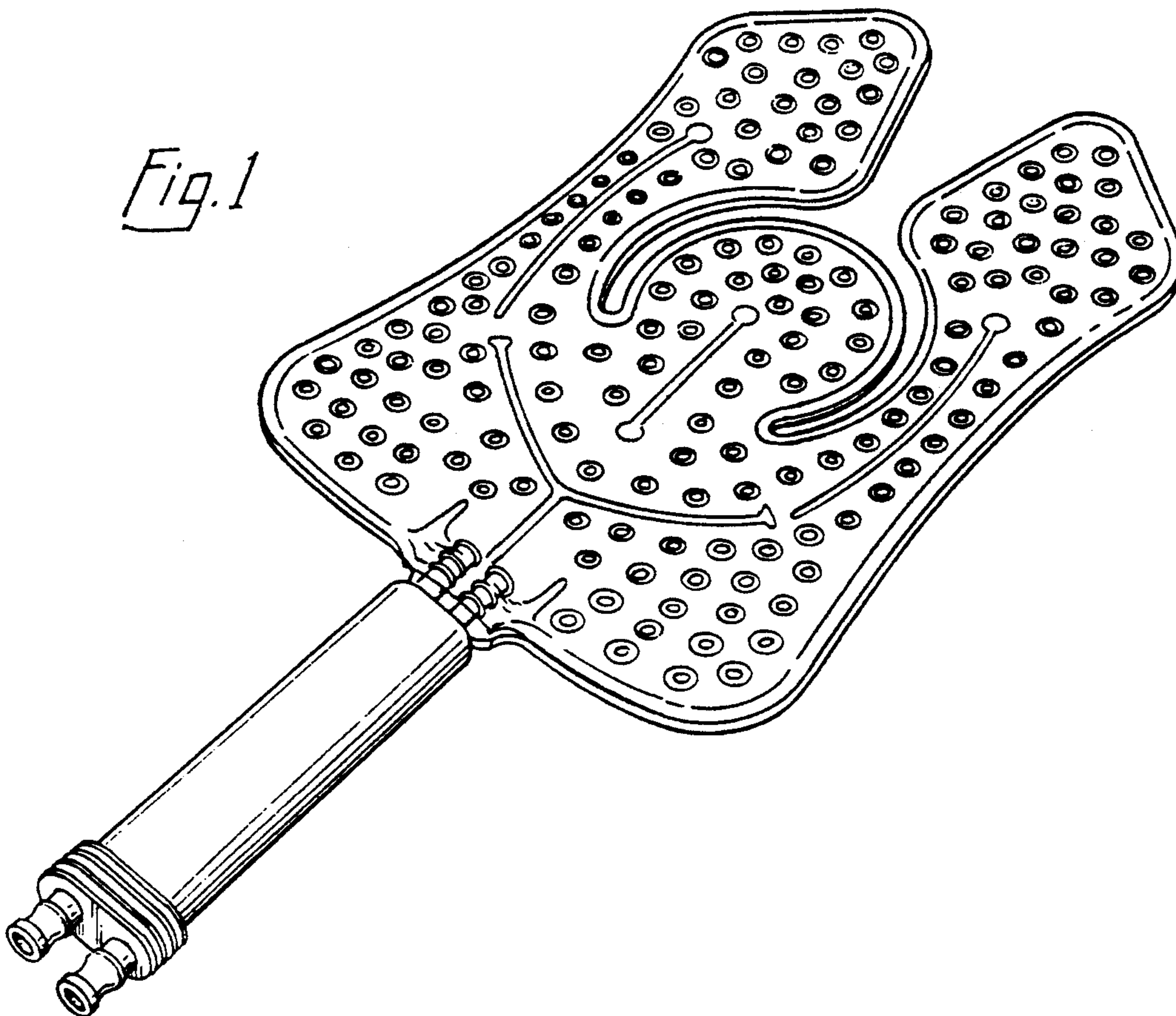

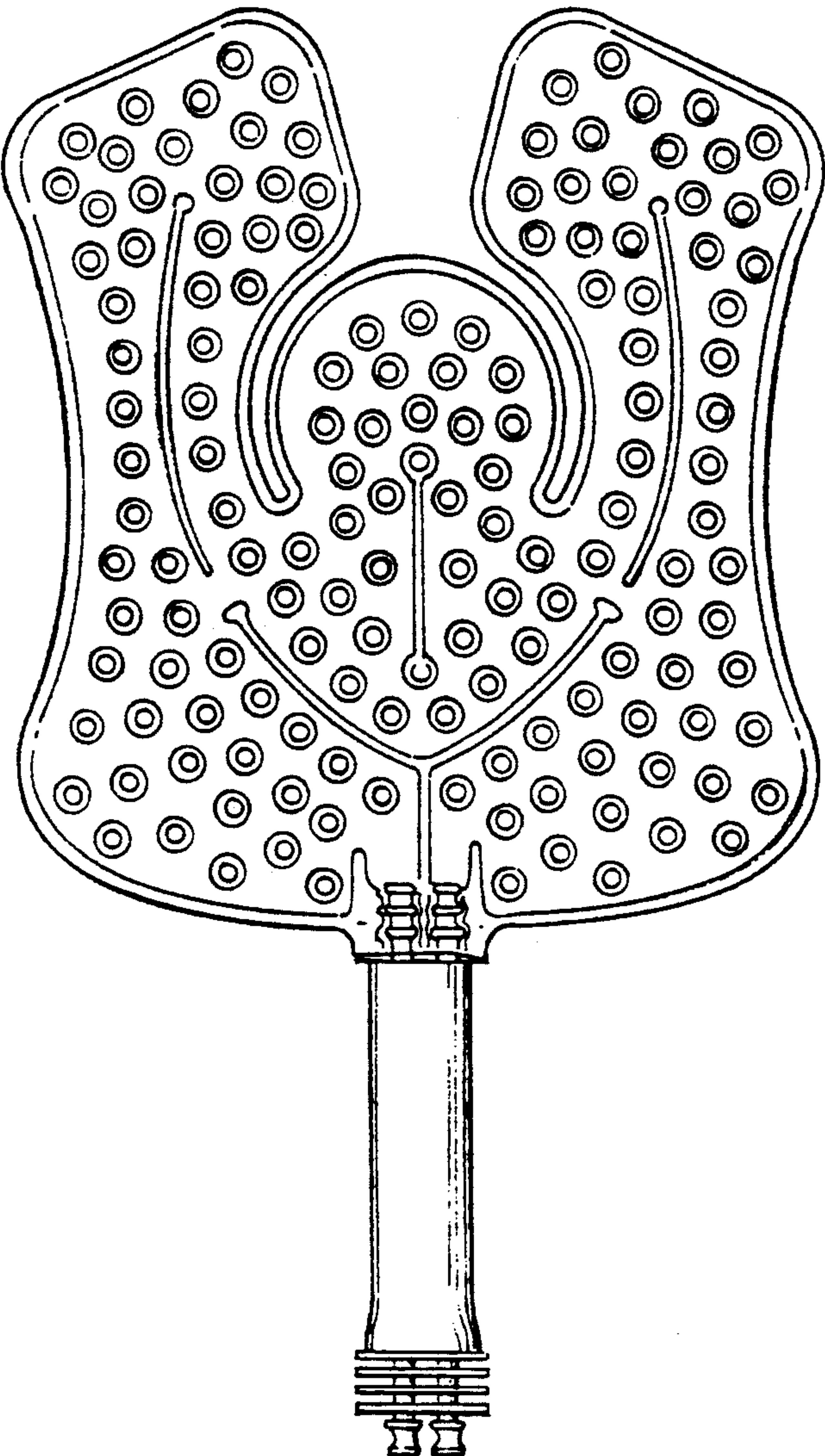

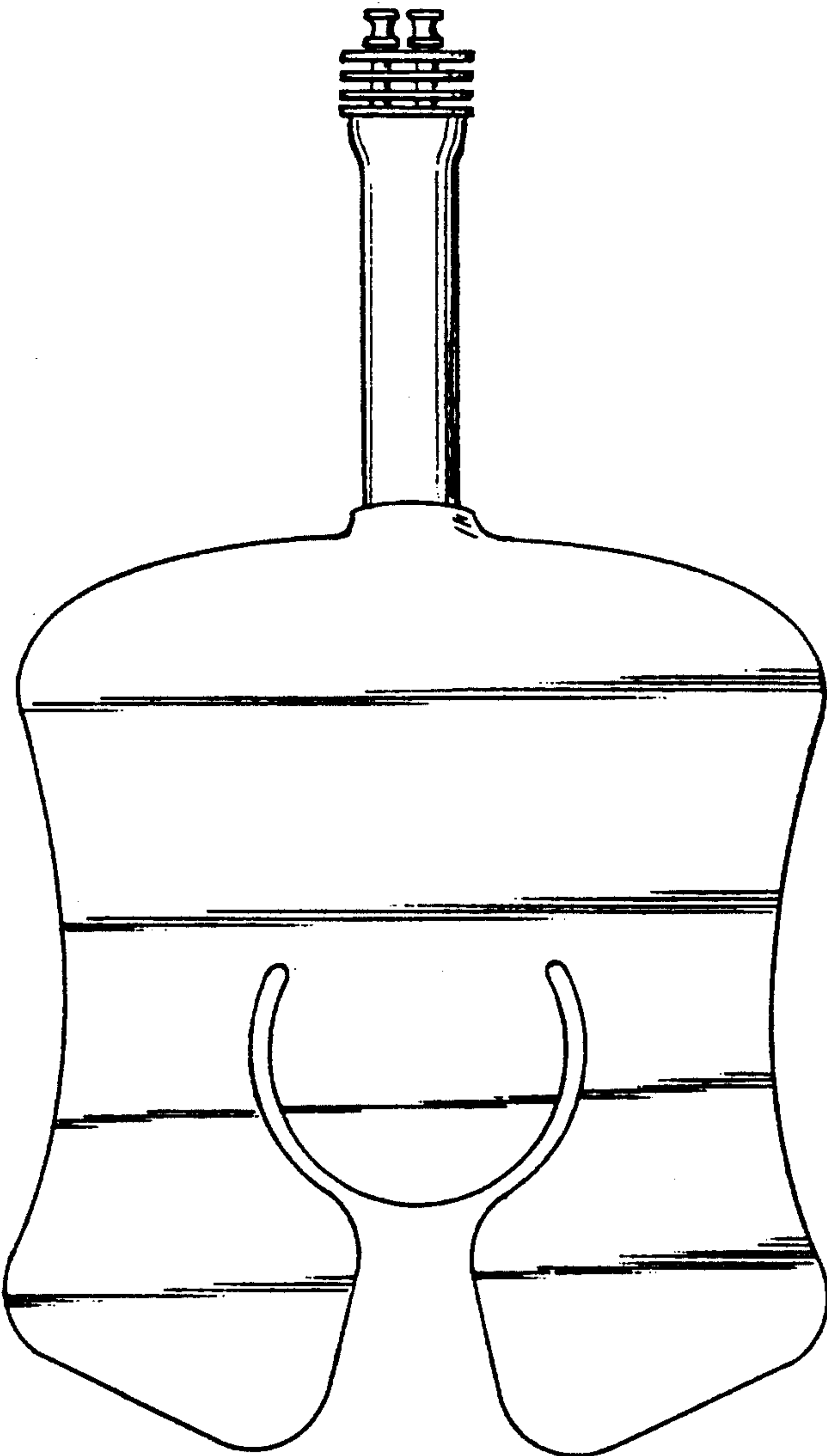
