[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined plush animal and handbag set, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective of a combined plush animal and handbag set showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof. The strap is shown broken away in FIGS. 2-4 for convenience of illustration.

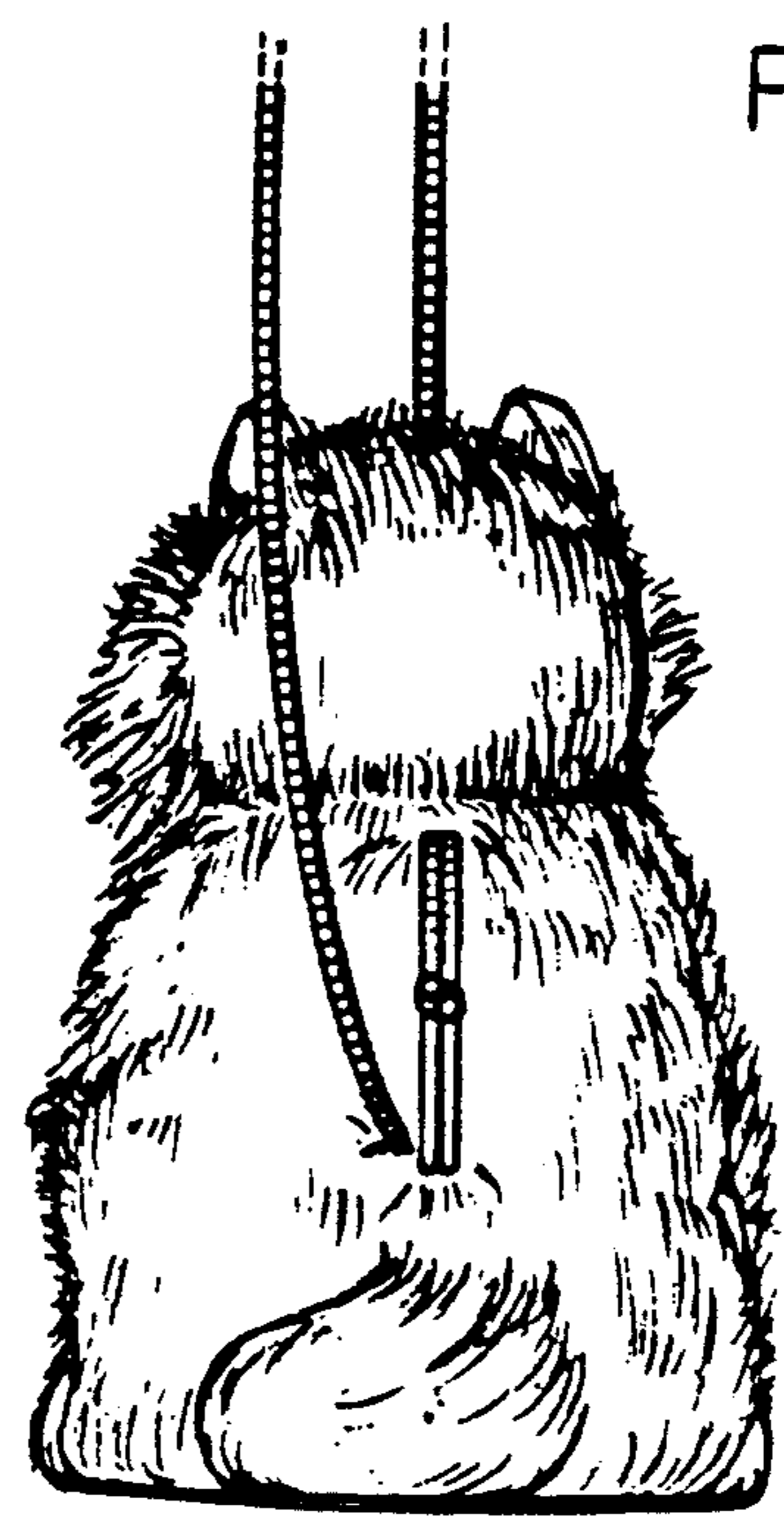

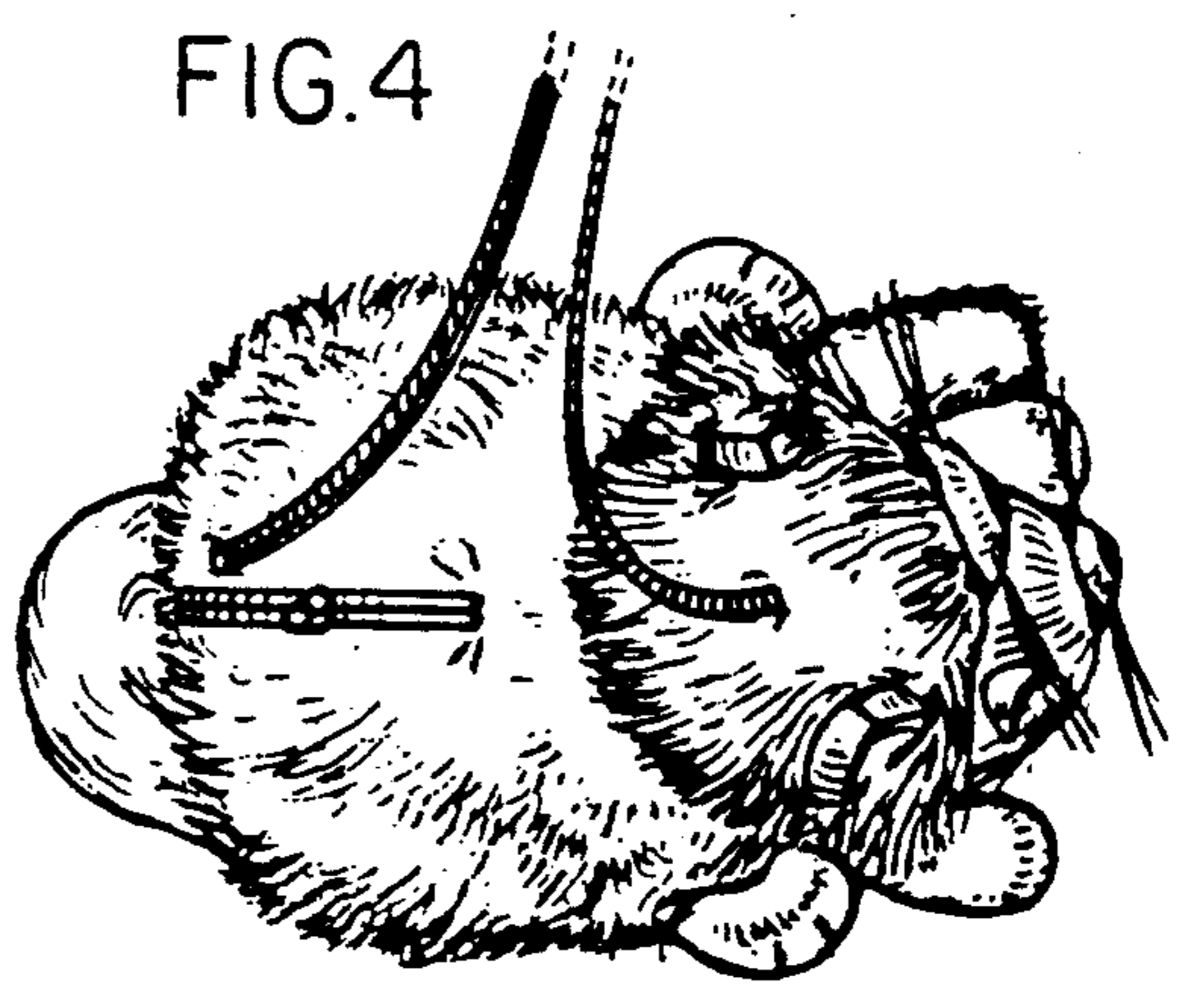

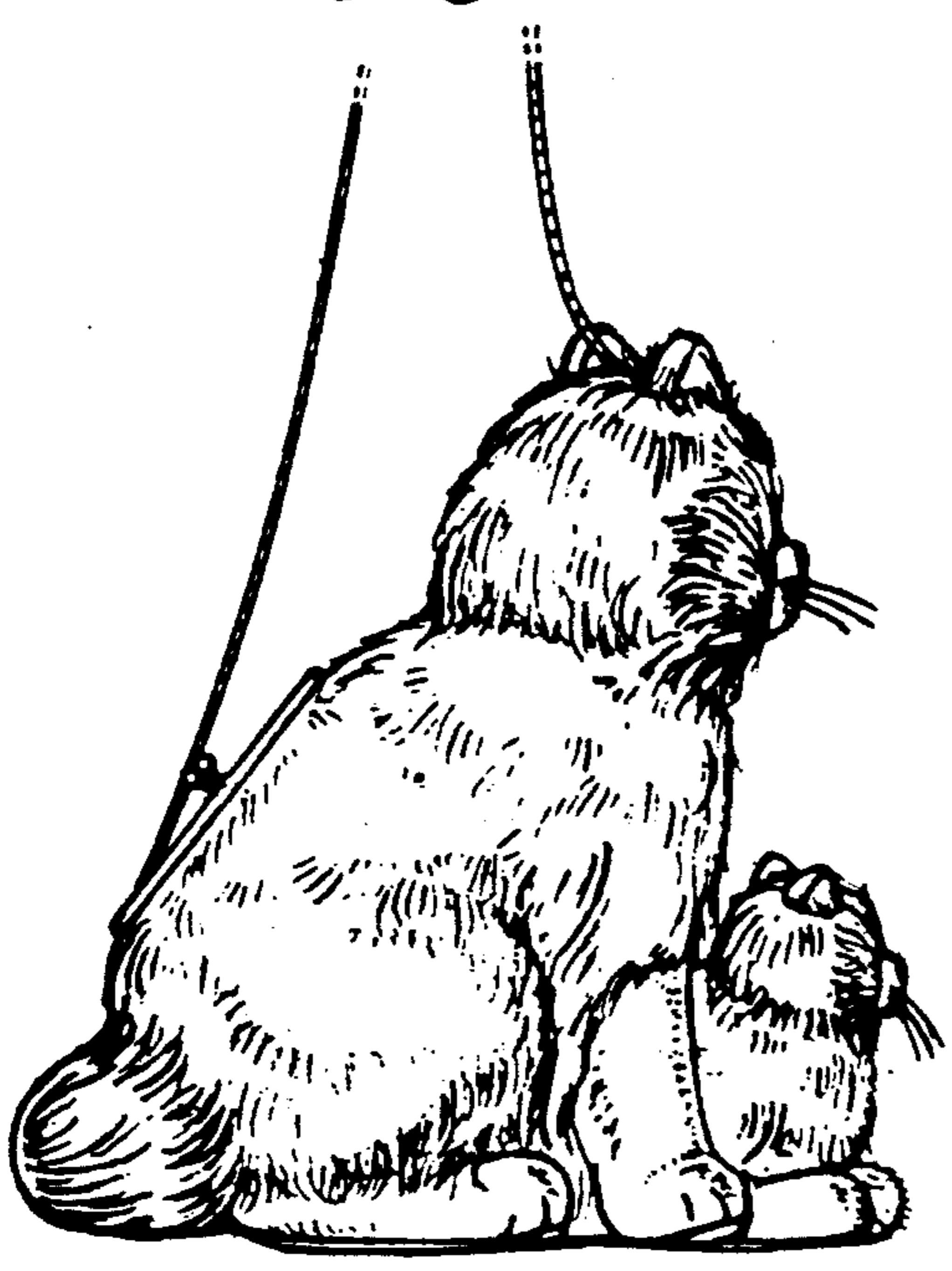
