[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for safety spectacles without temples, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the safety spectacles with temples showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

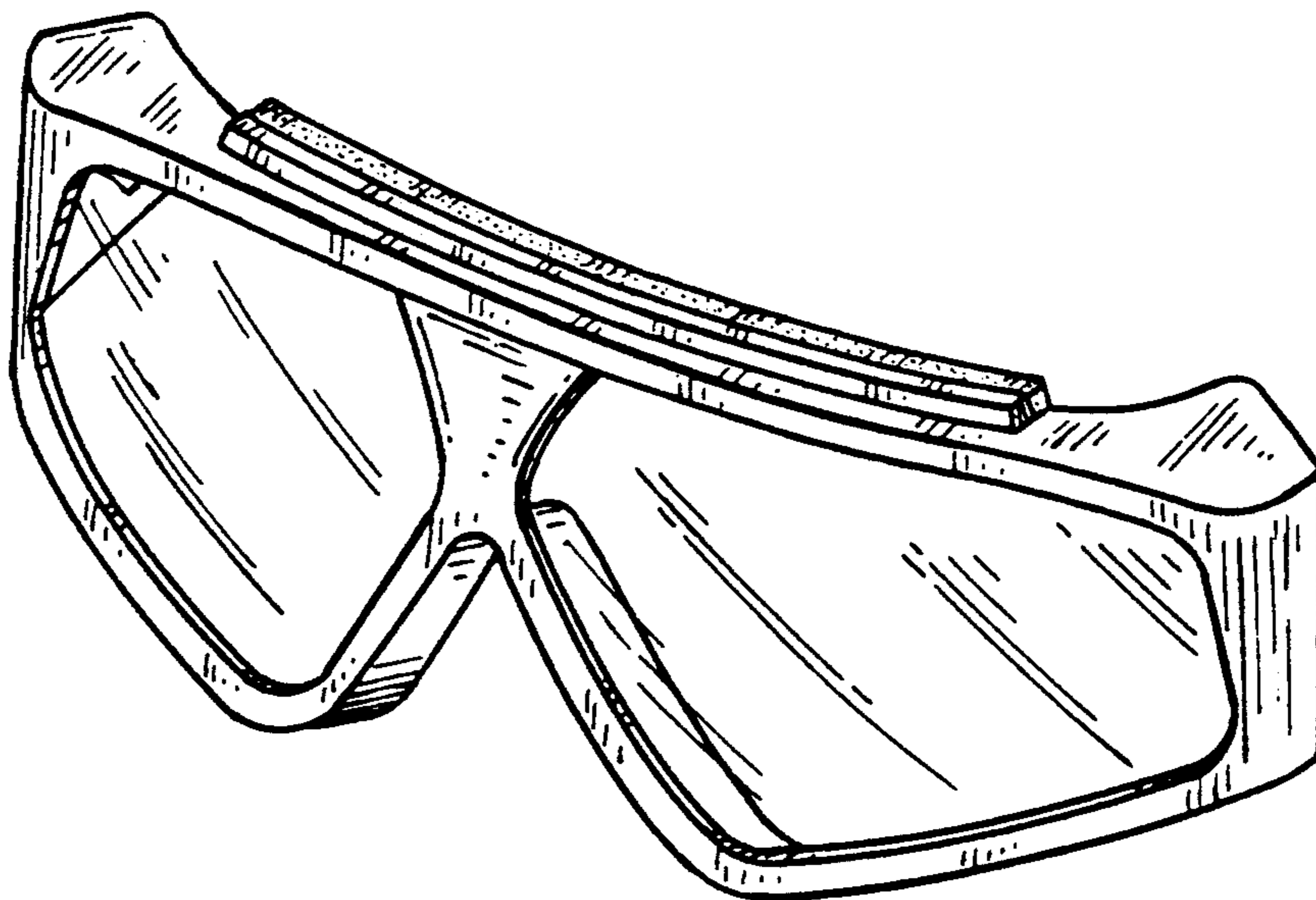

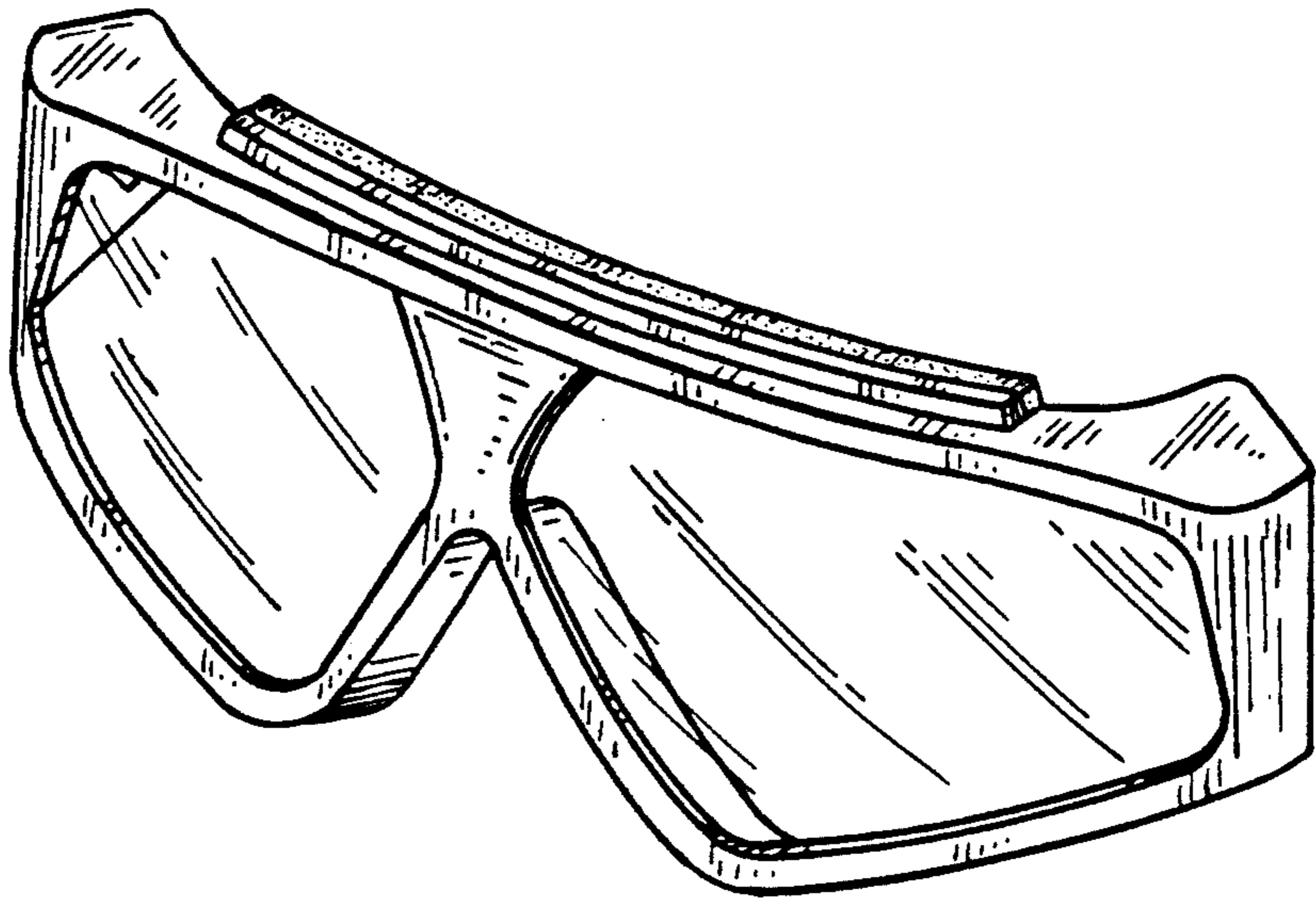

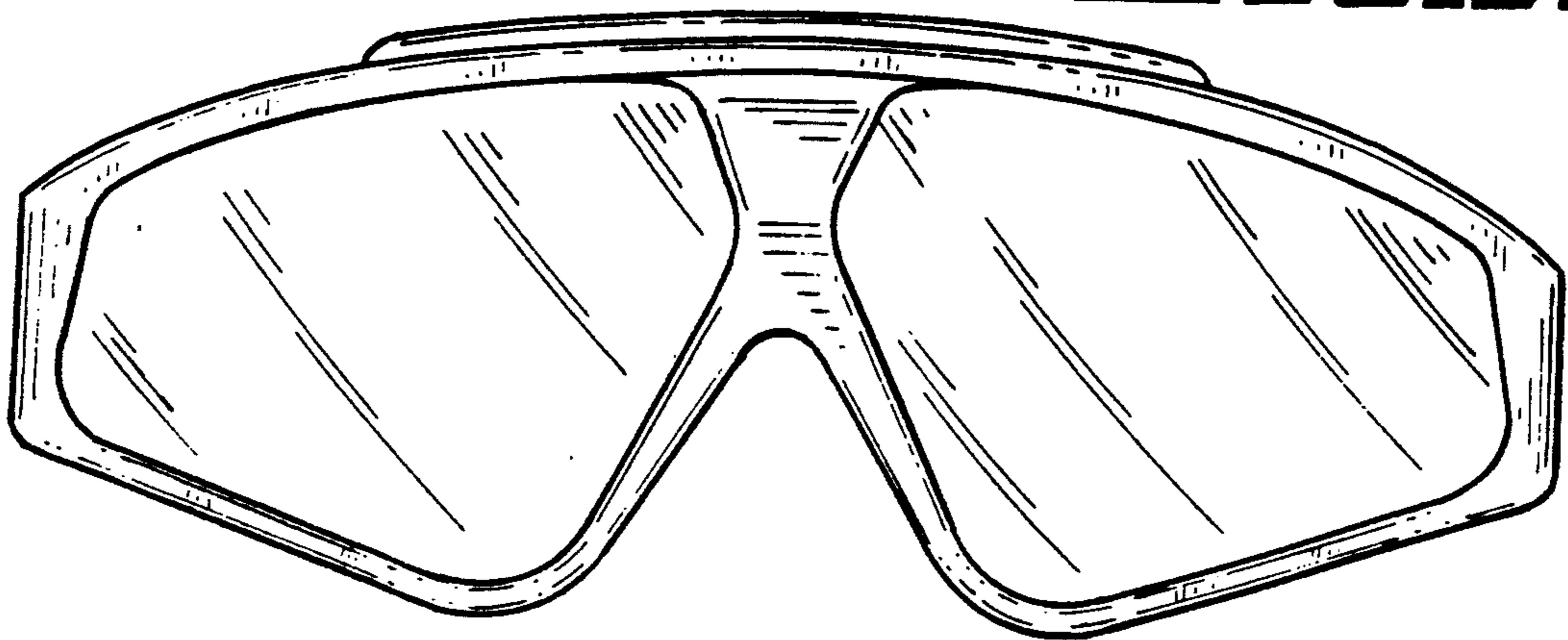

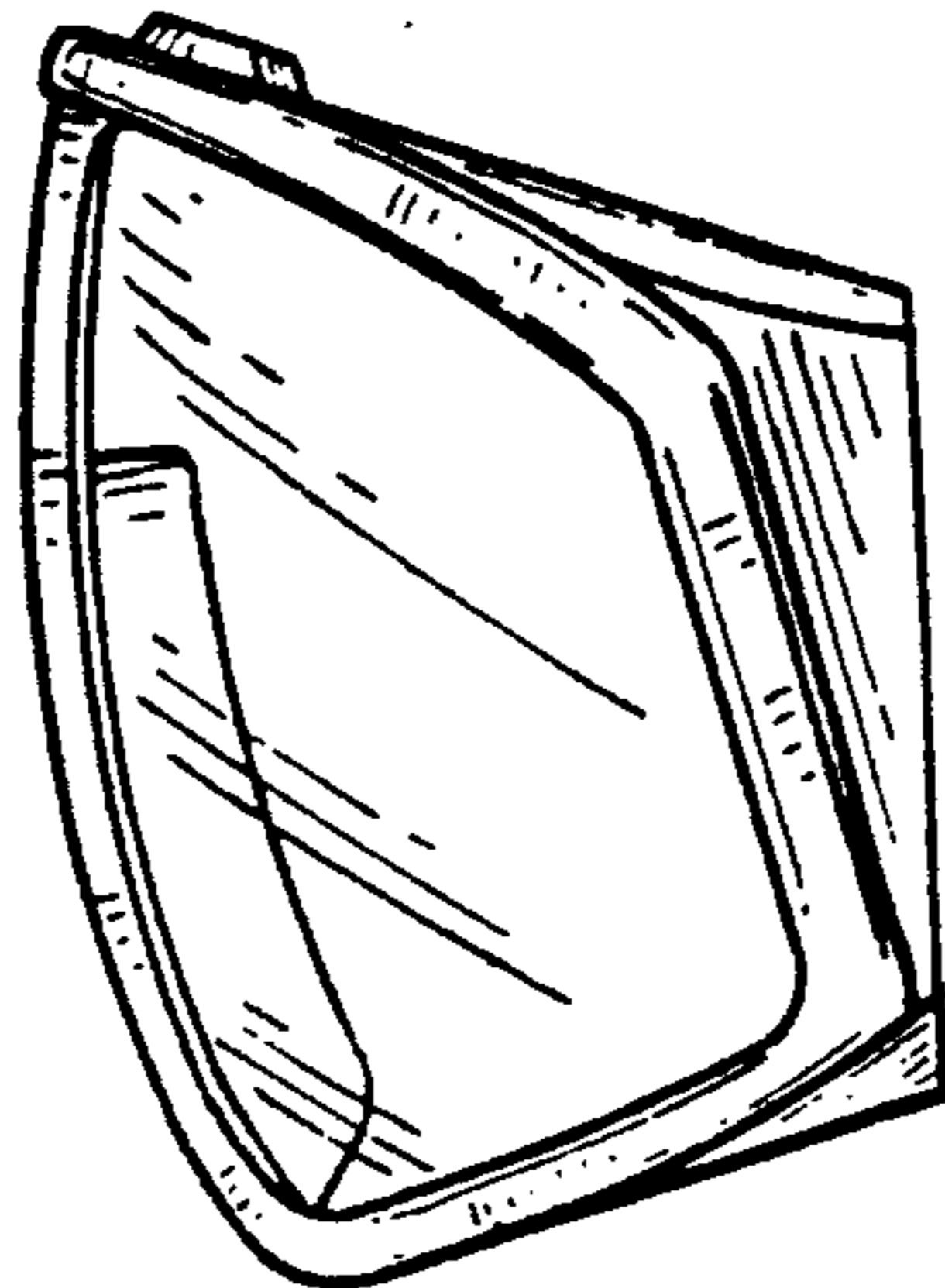

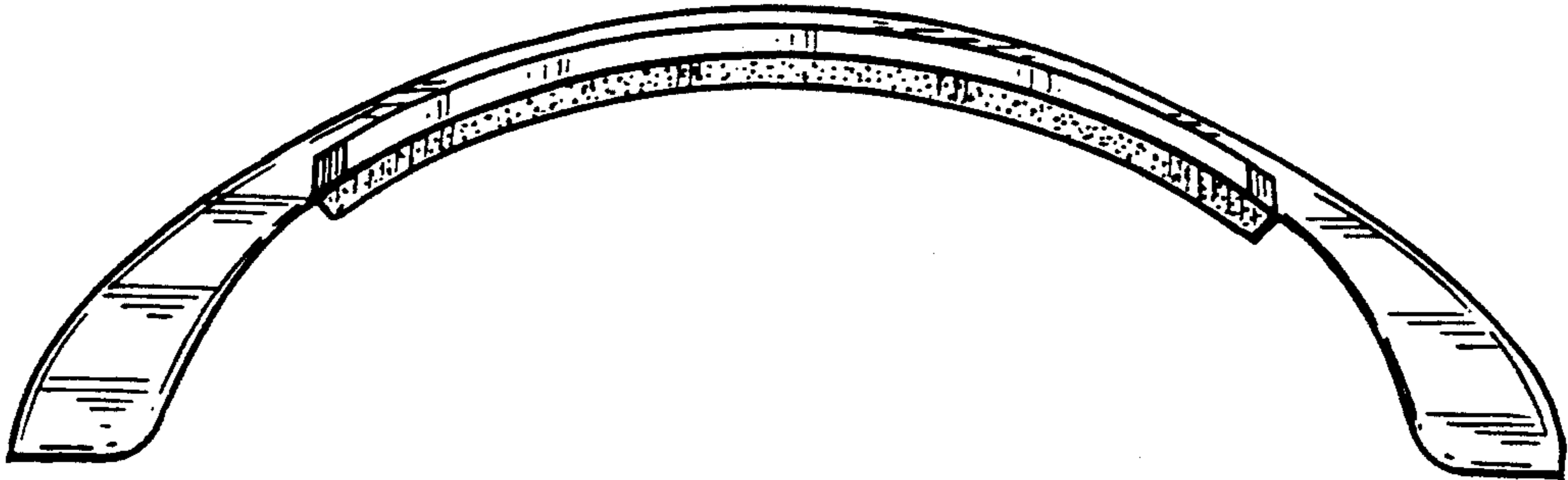

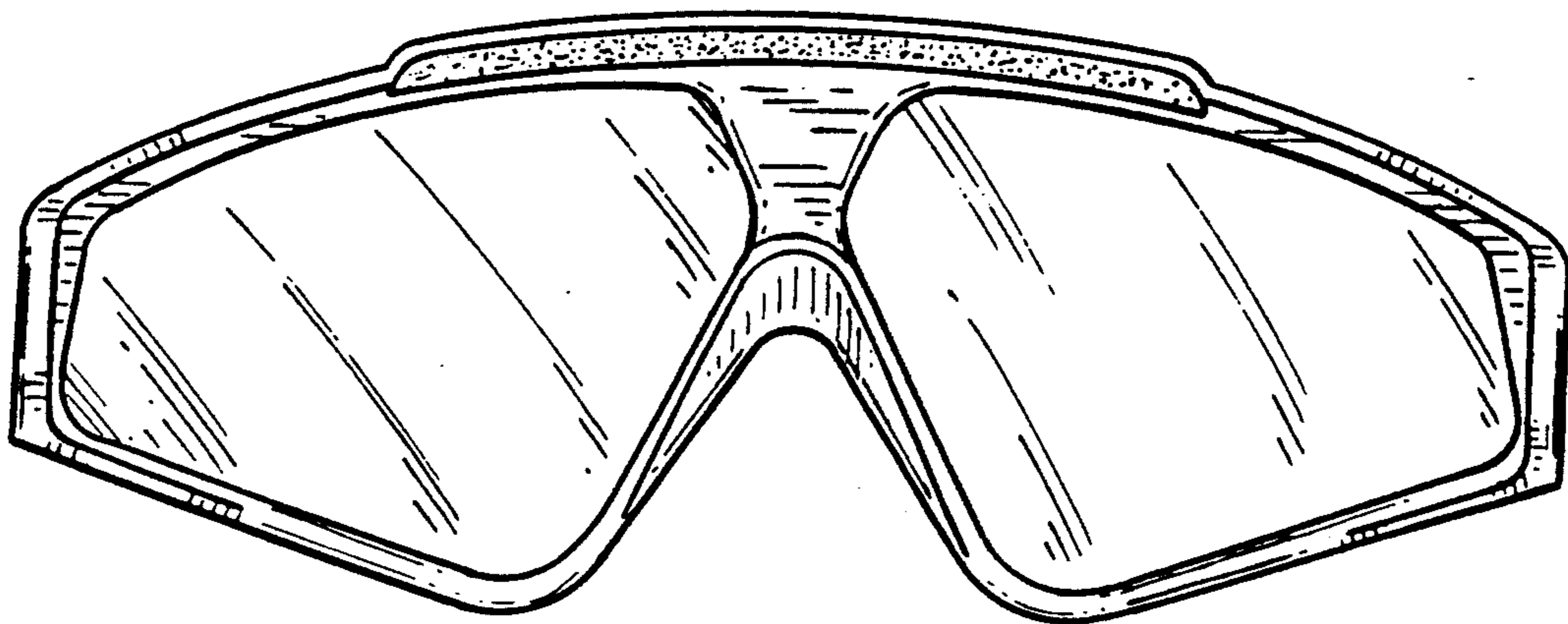
