FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

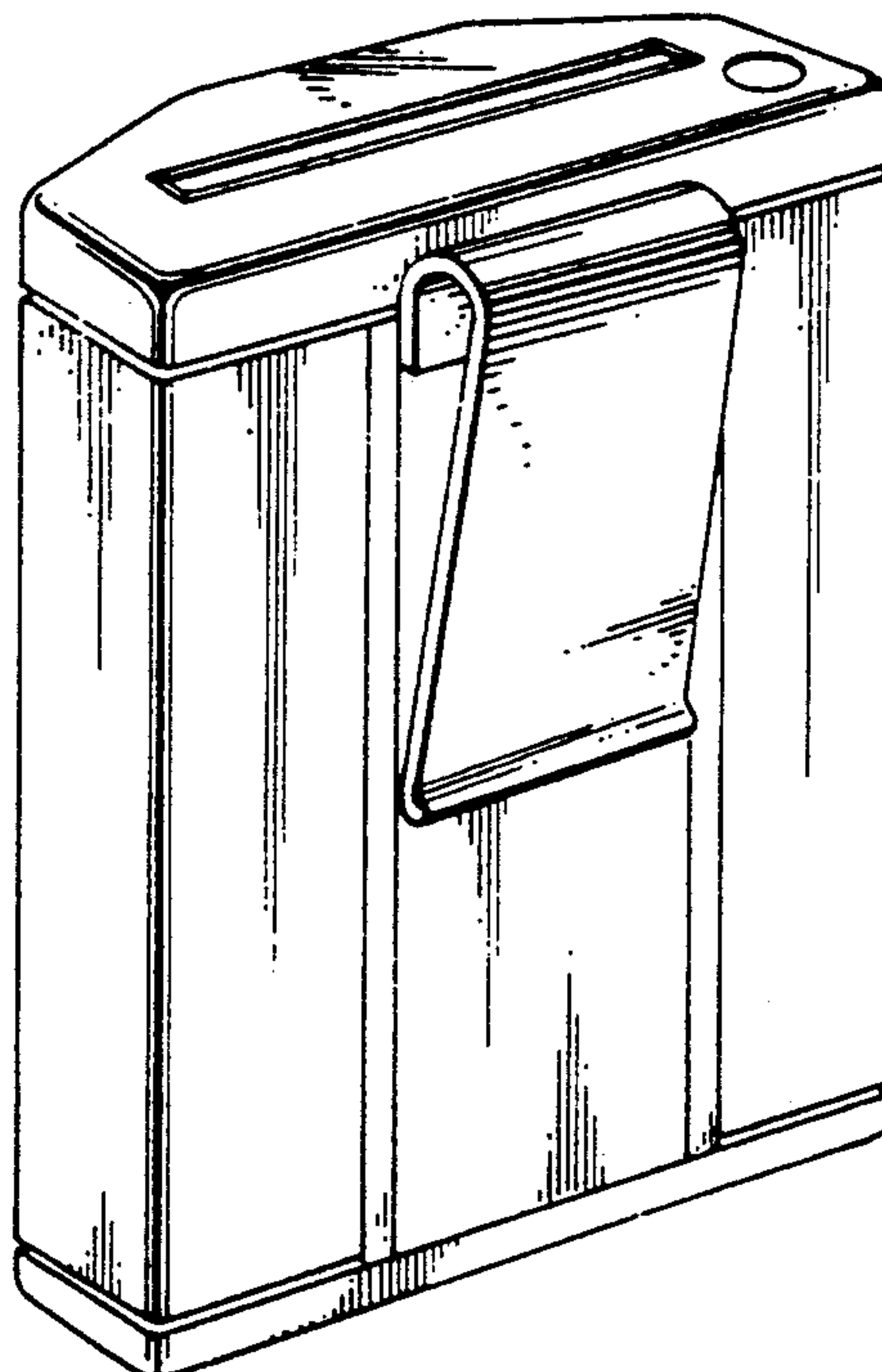
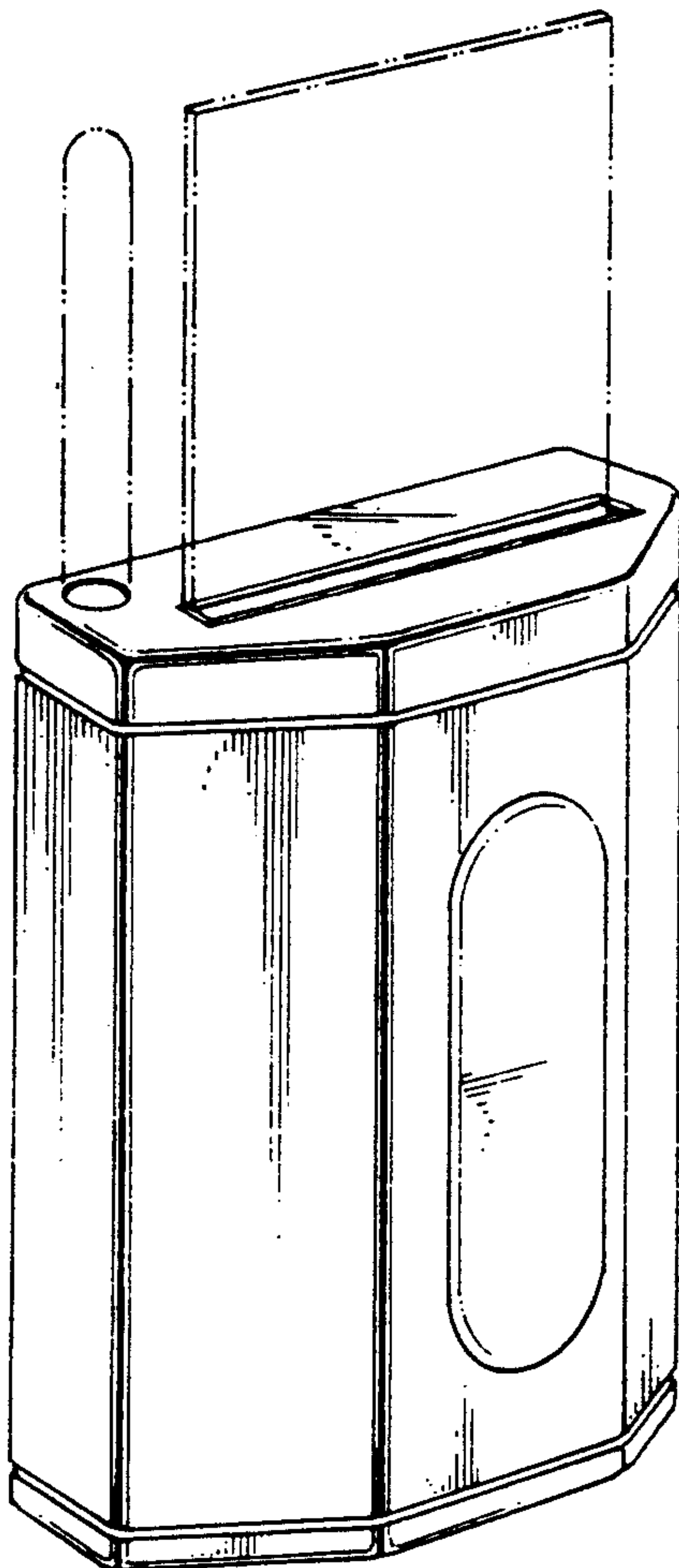
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;

only and form no part of the claimed design.



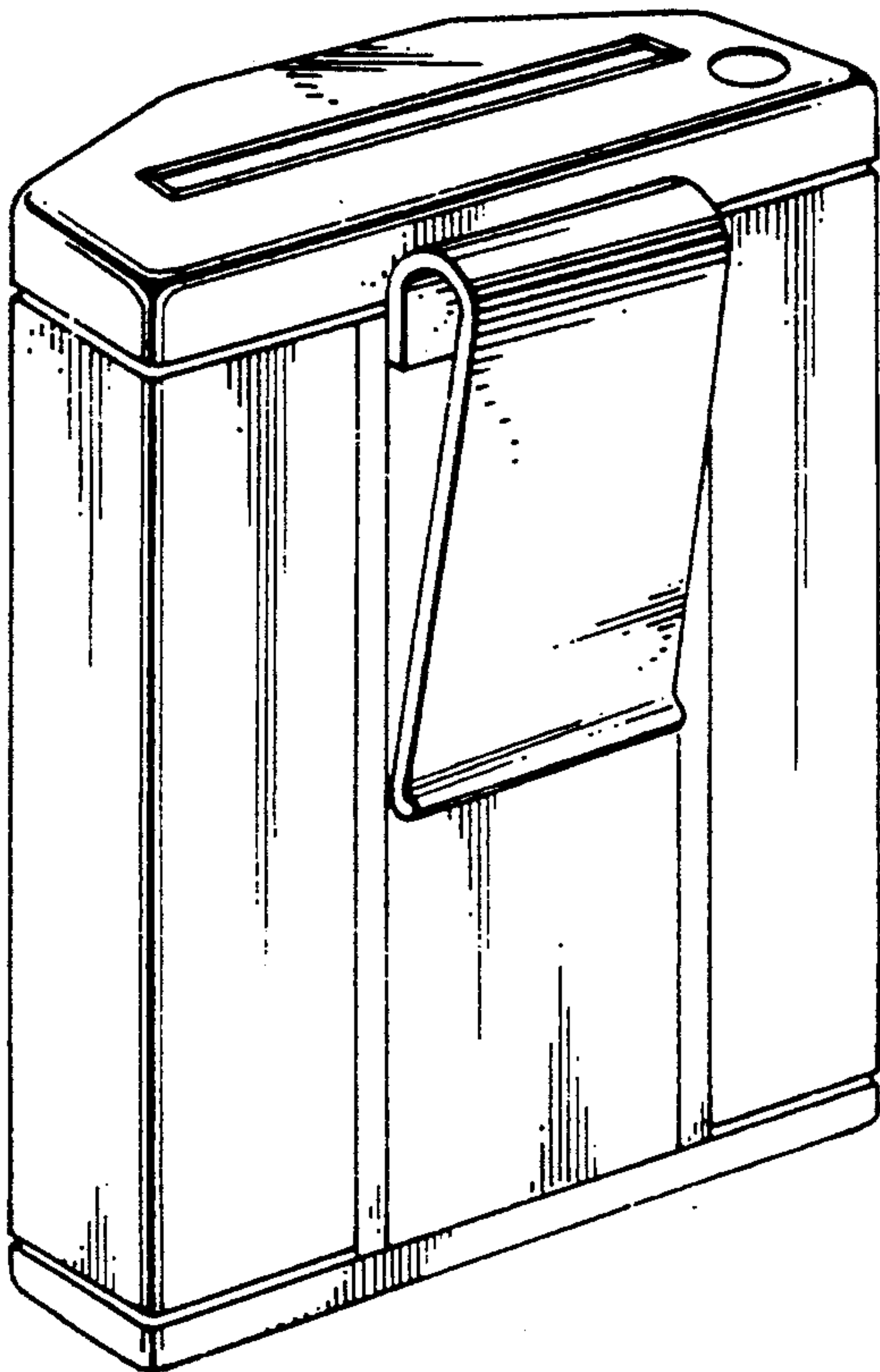

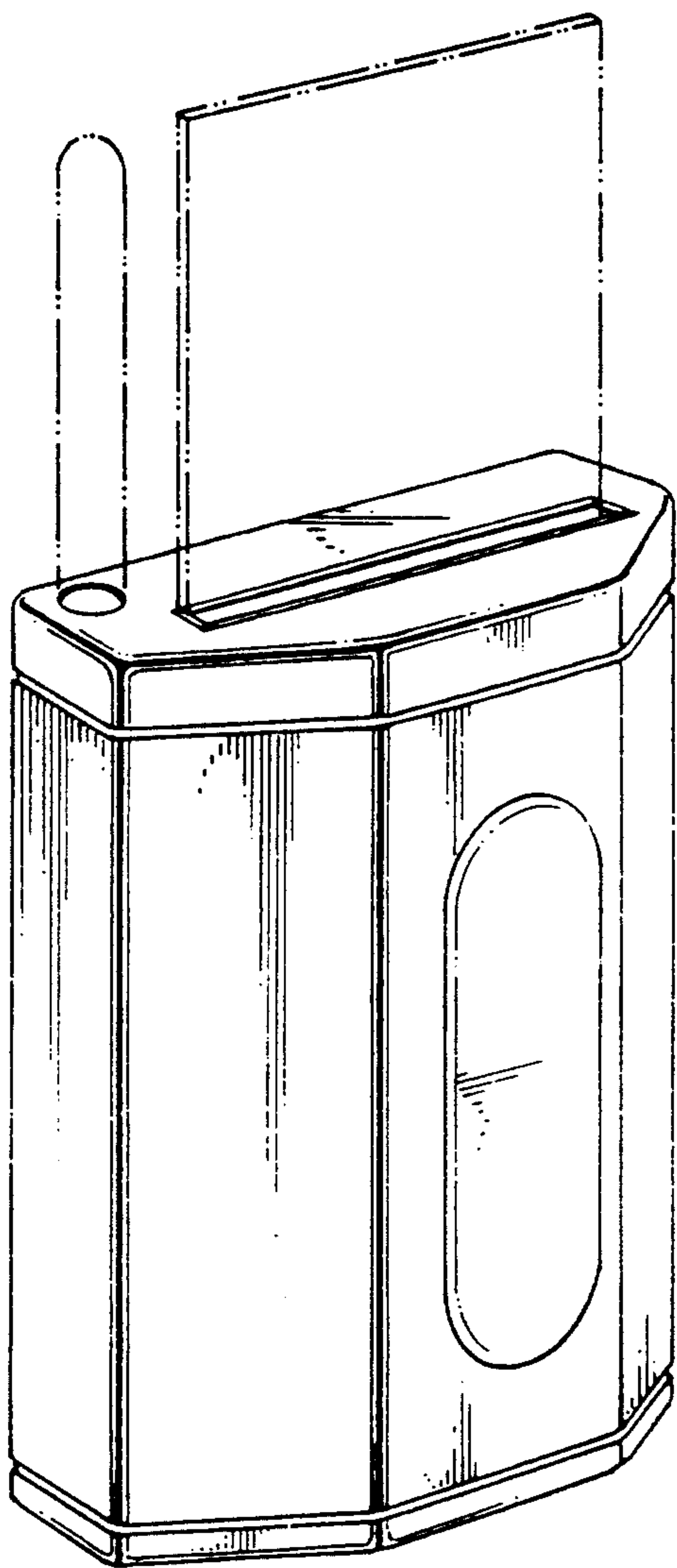

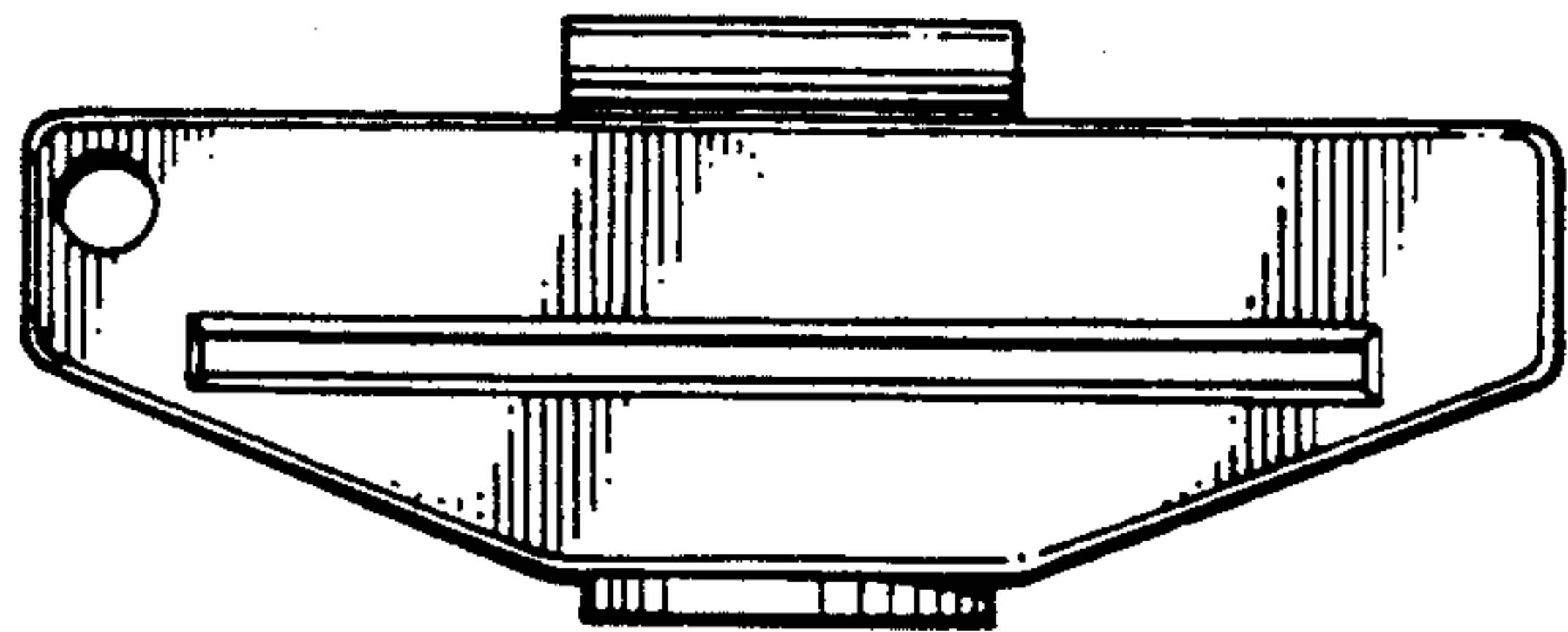

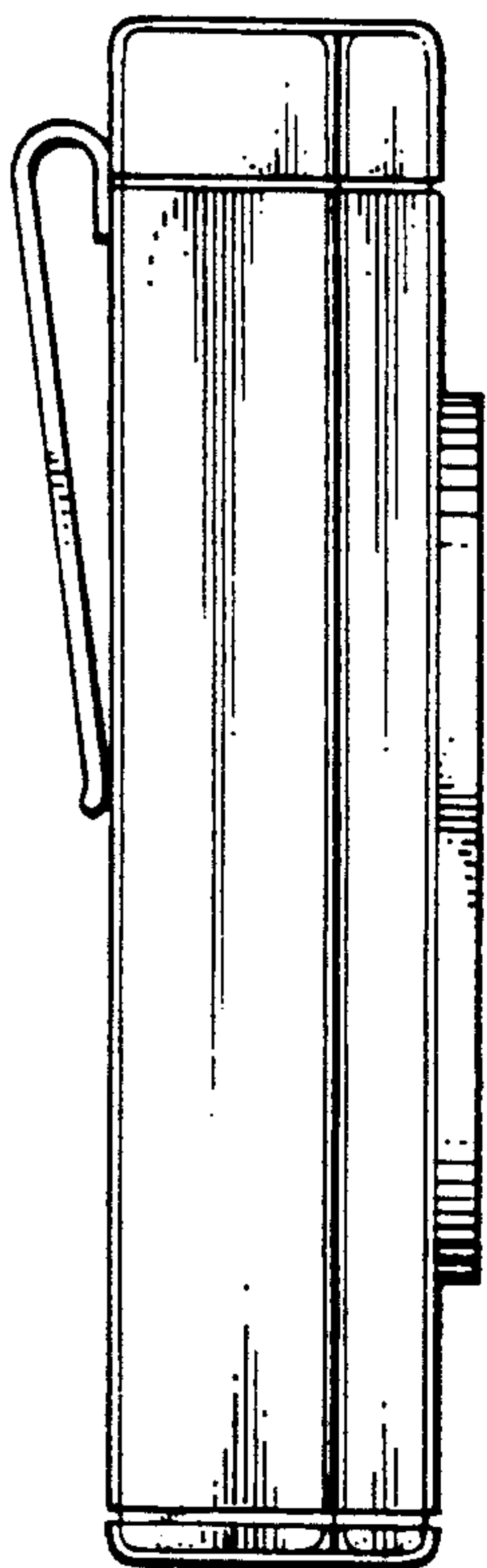

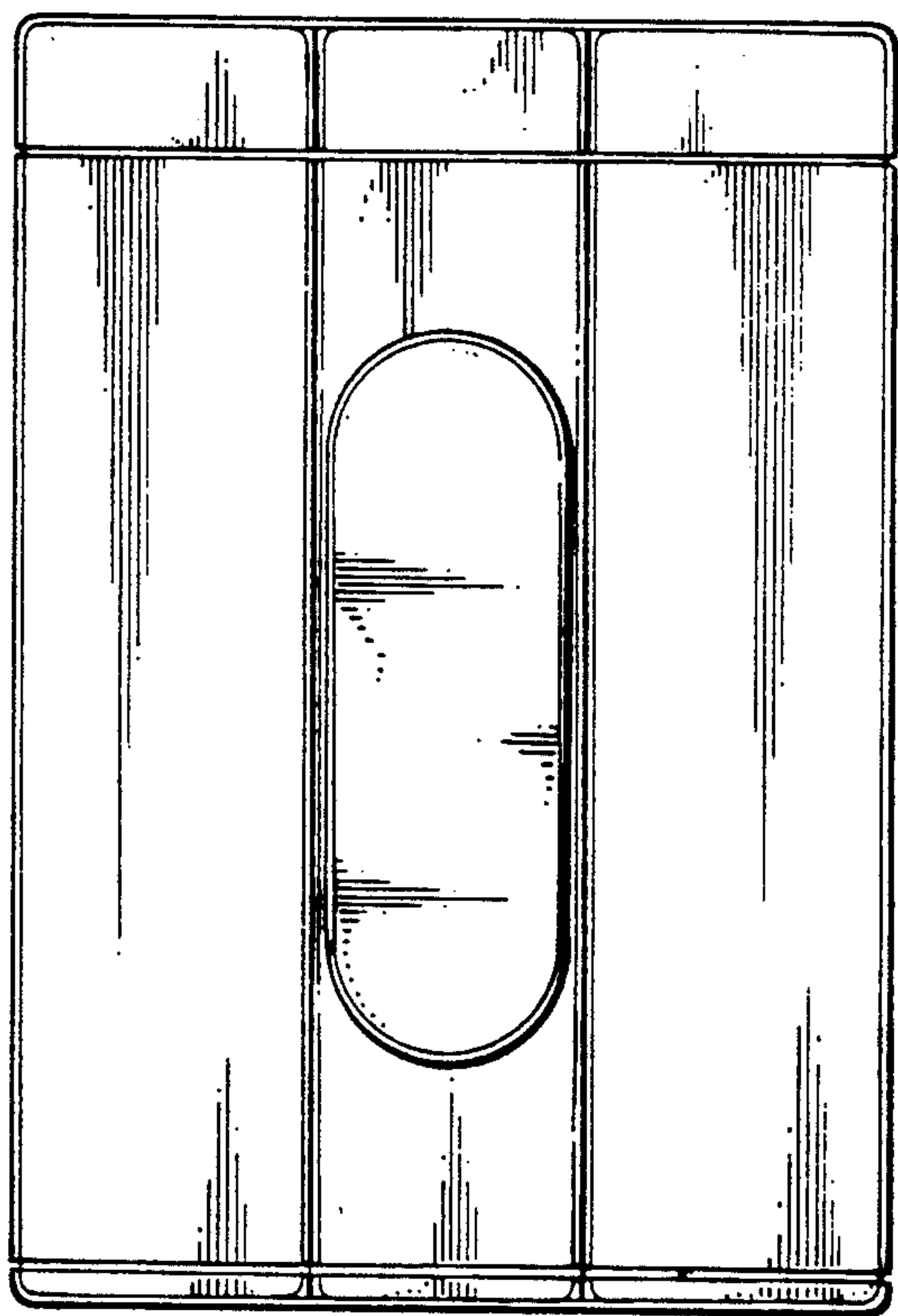

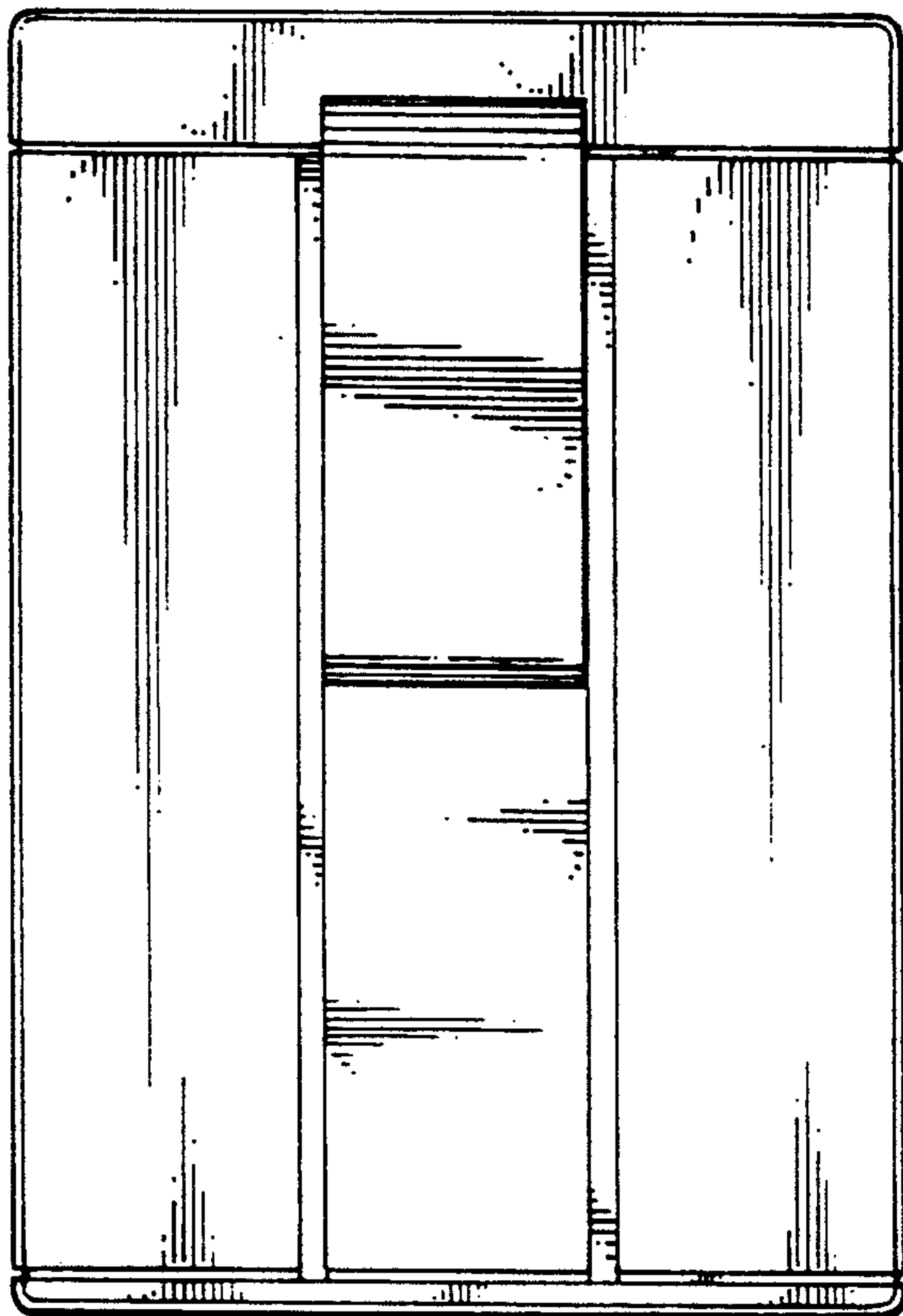

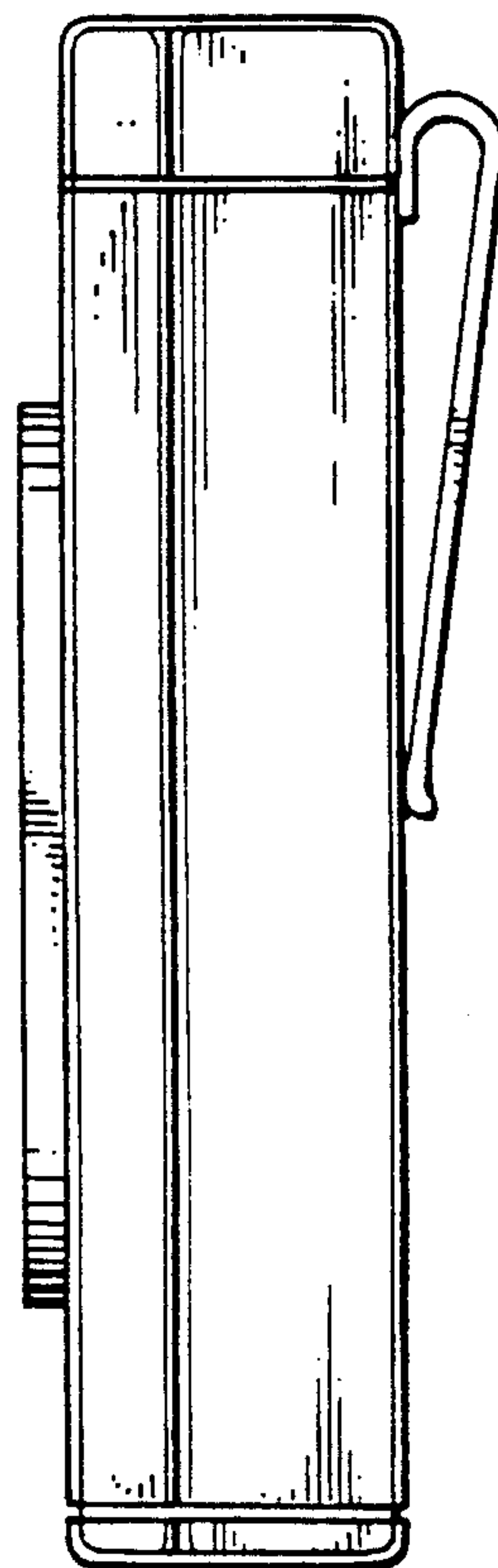

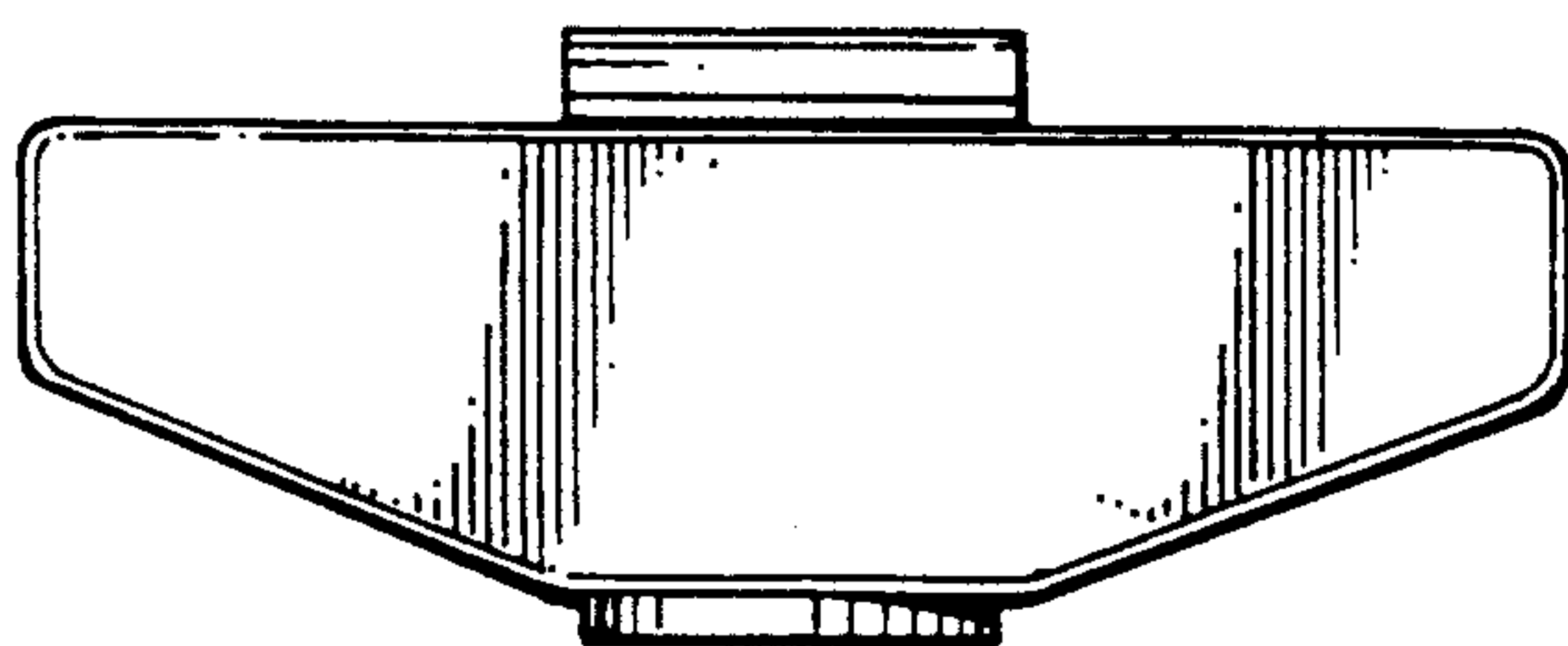
