FIG. 1 is a left-front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

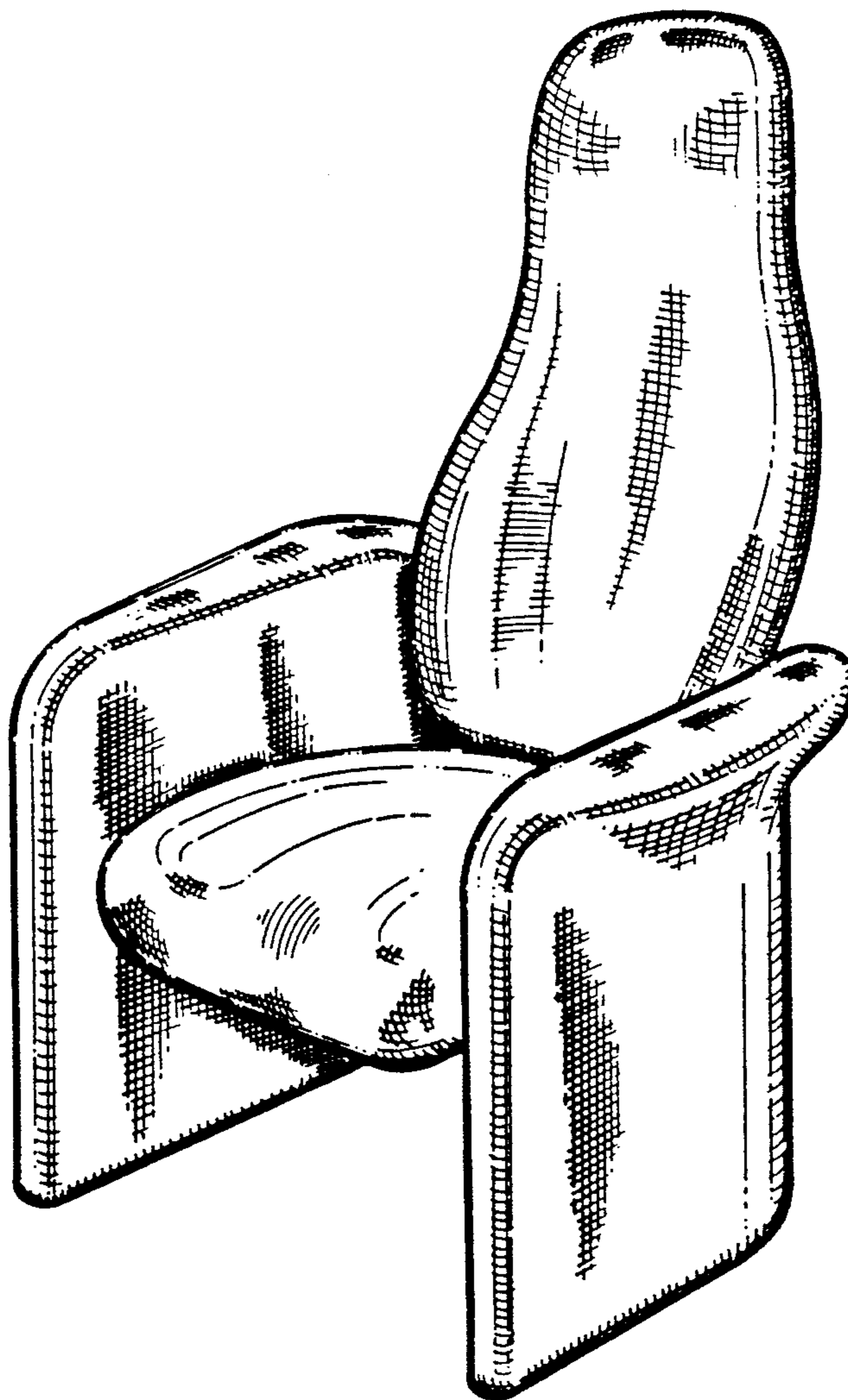
FIG. 2 is an front elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a left-front perspective view of a chair showing a second embodiment of my new design.



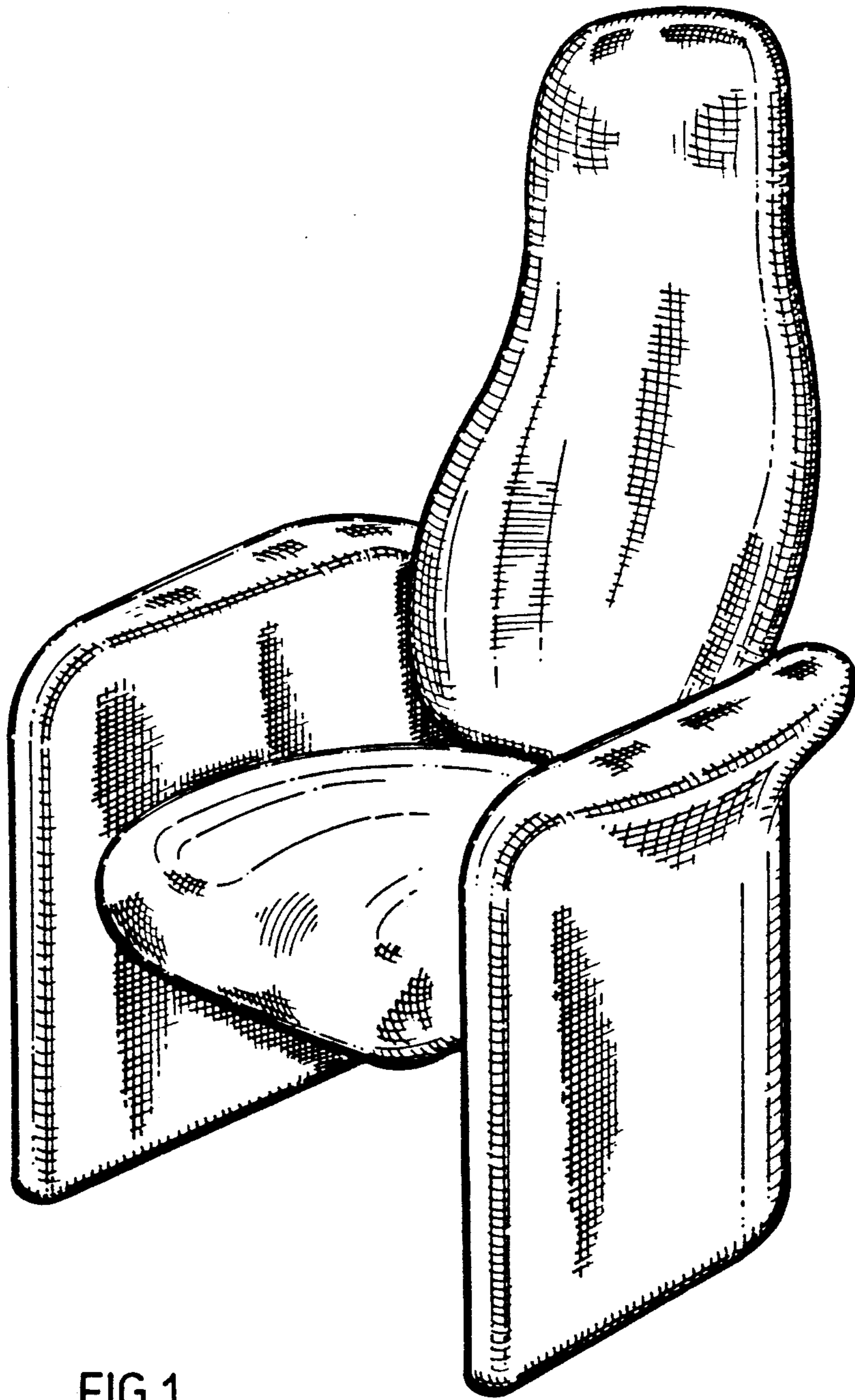

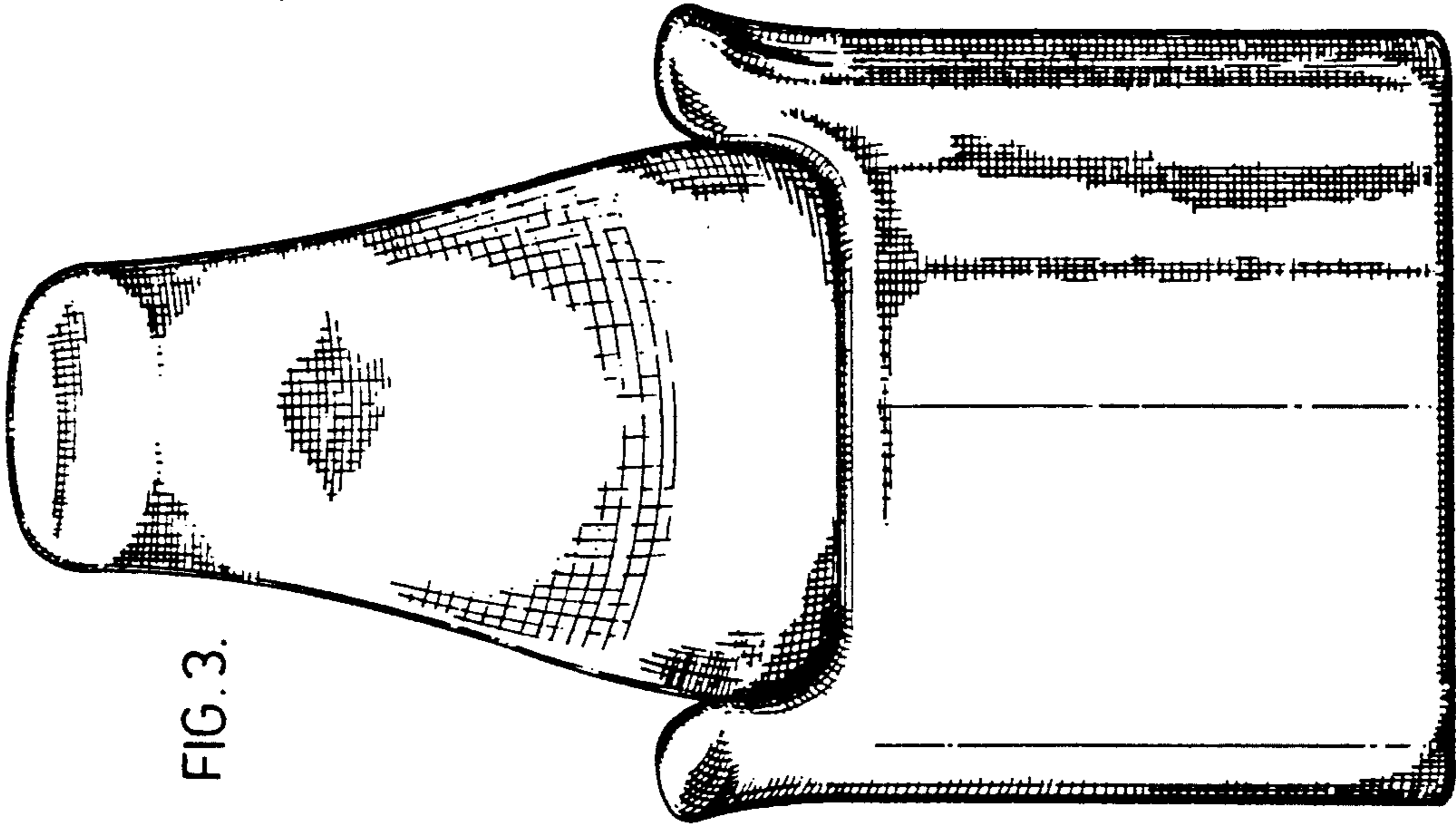

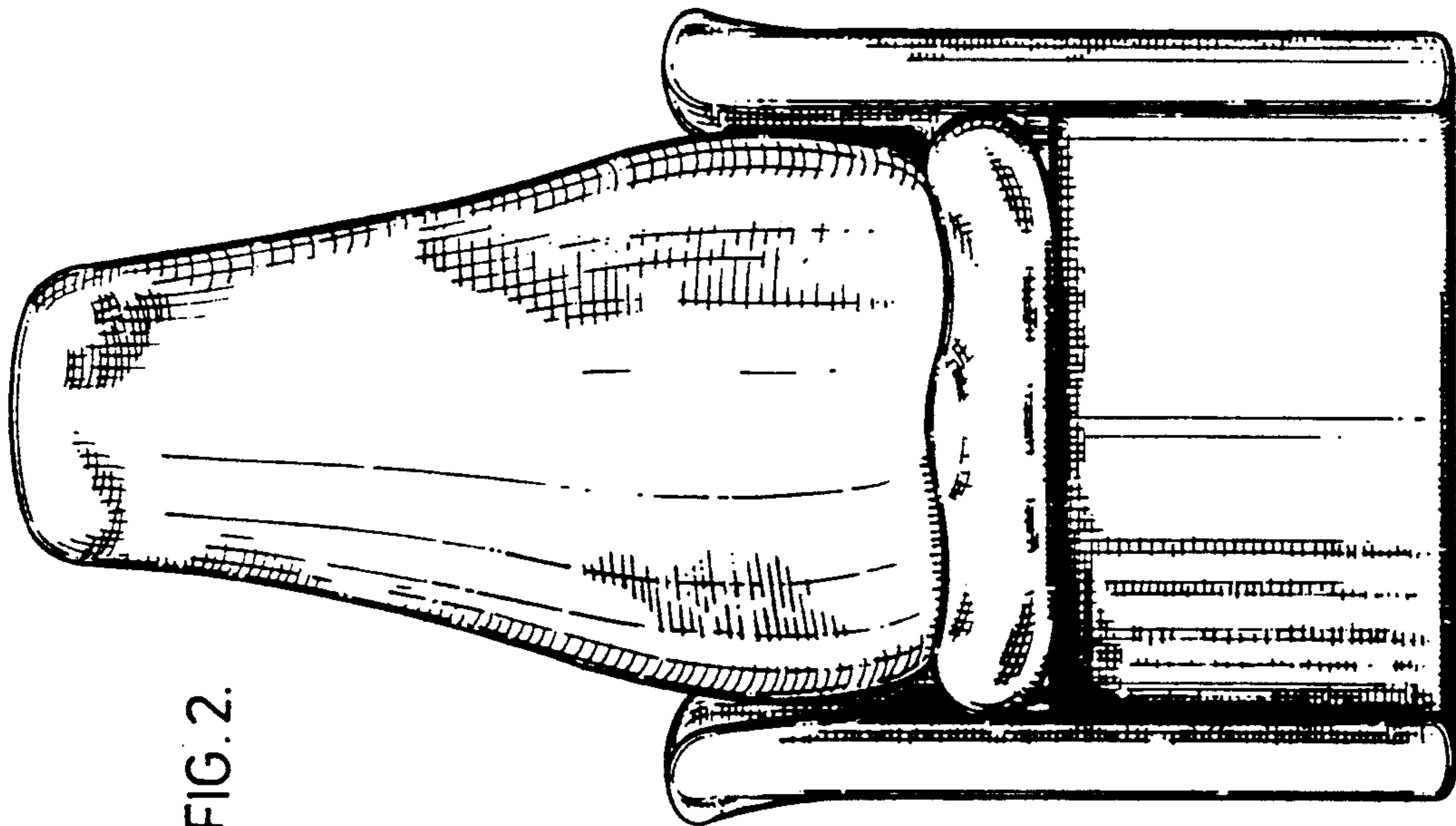

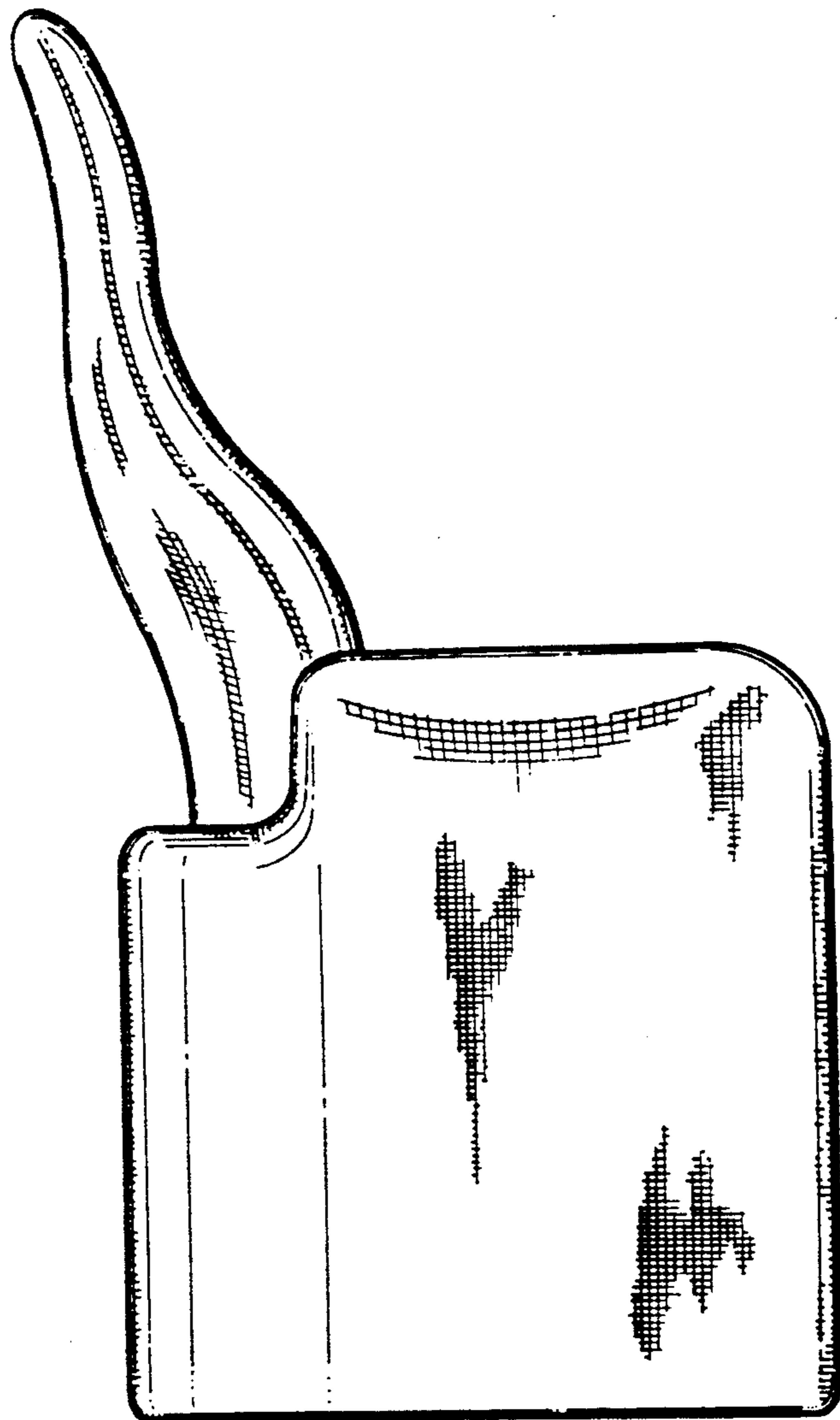

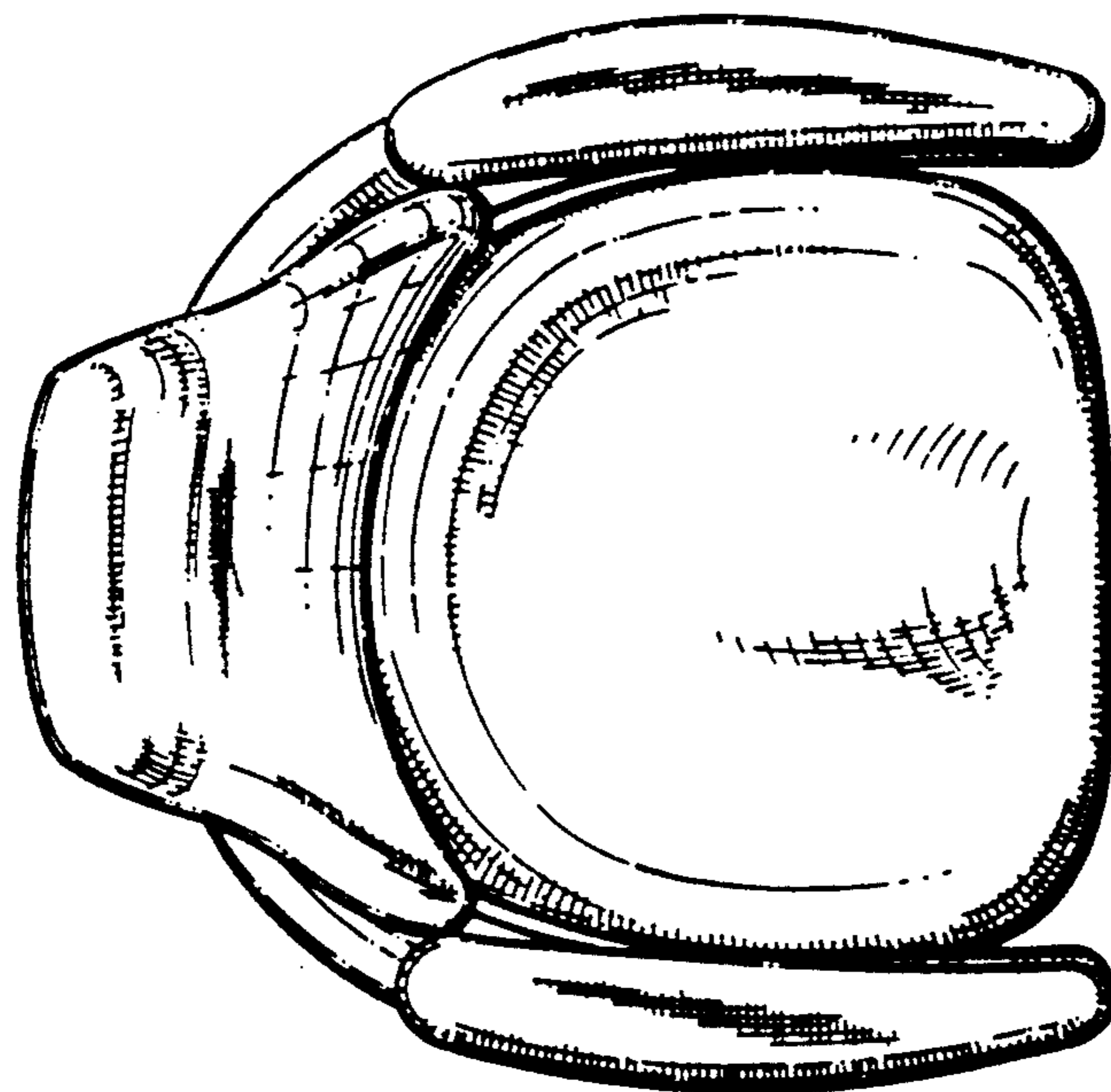

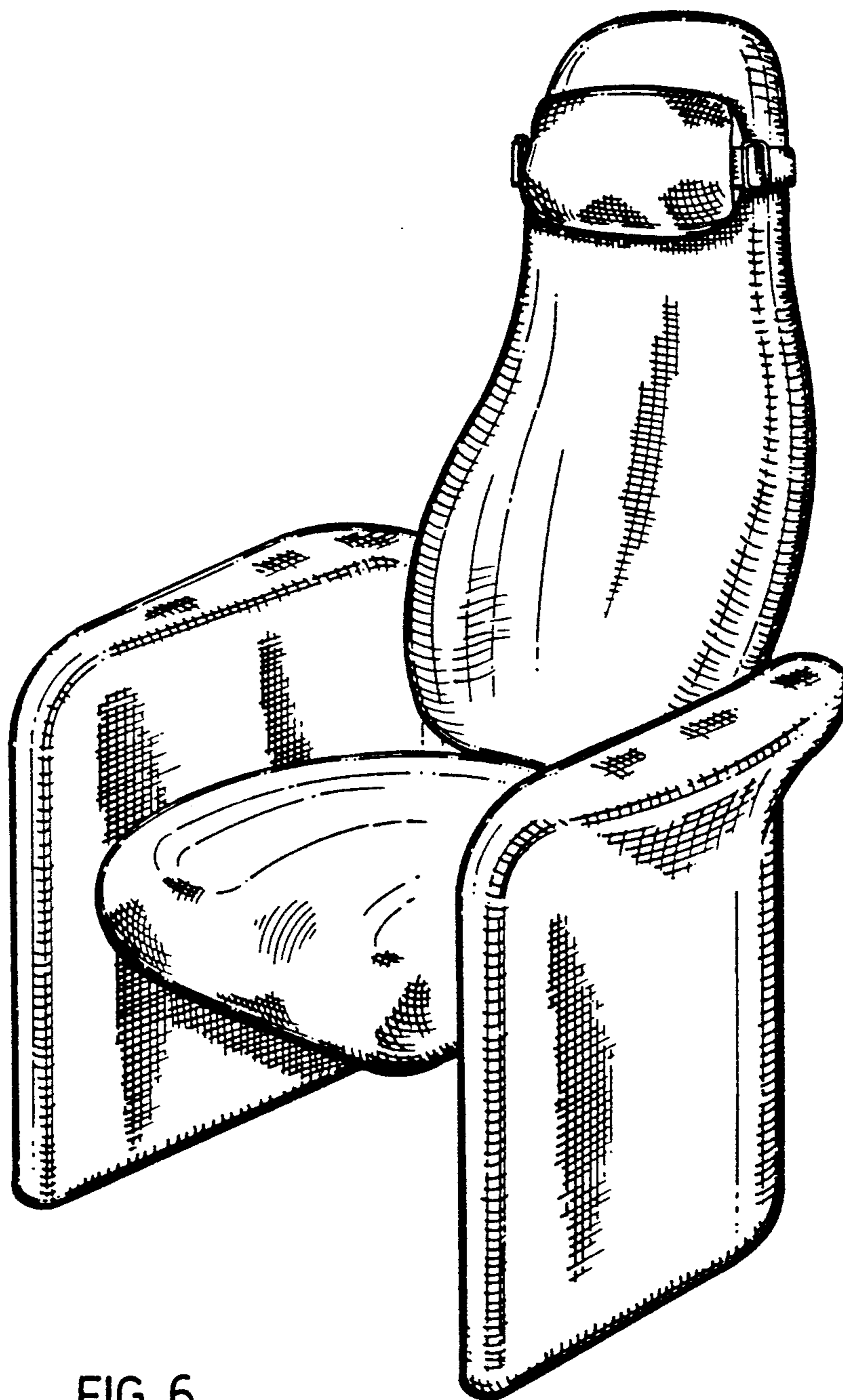
