DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and lower right perspective view of a flashlight battery recharger system showing our new design, in which the broken line showing of the flashlight is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forms no part of the claimed design;

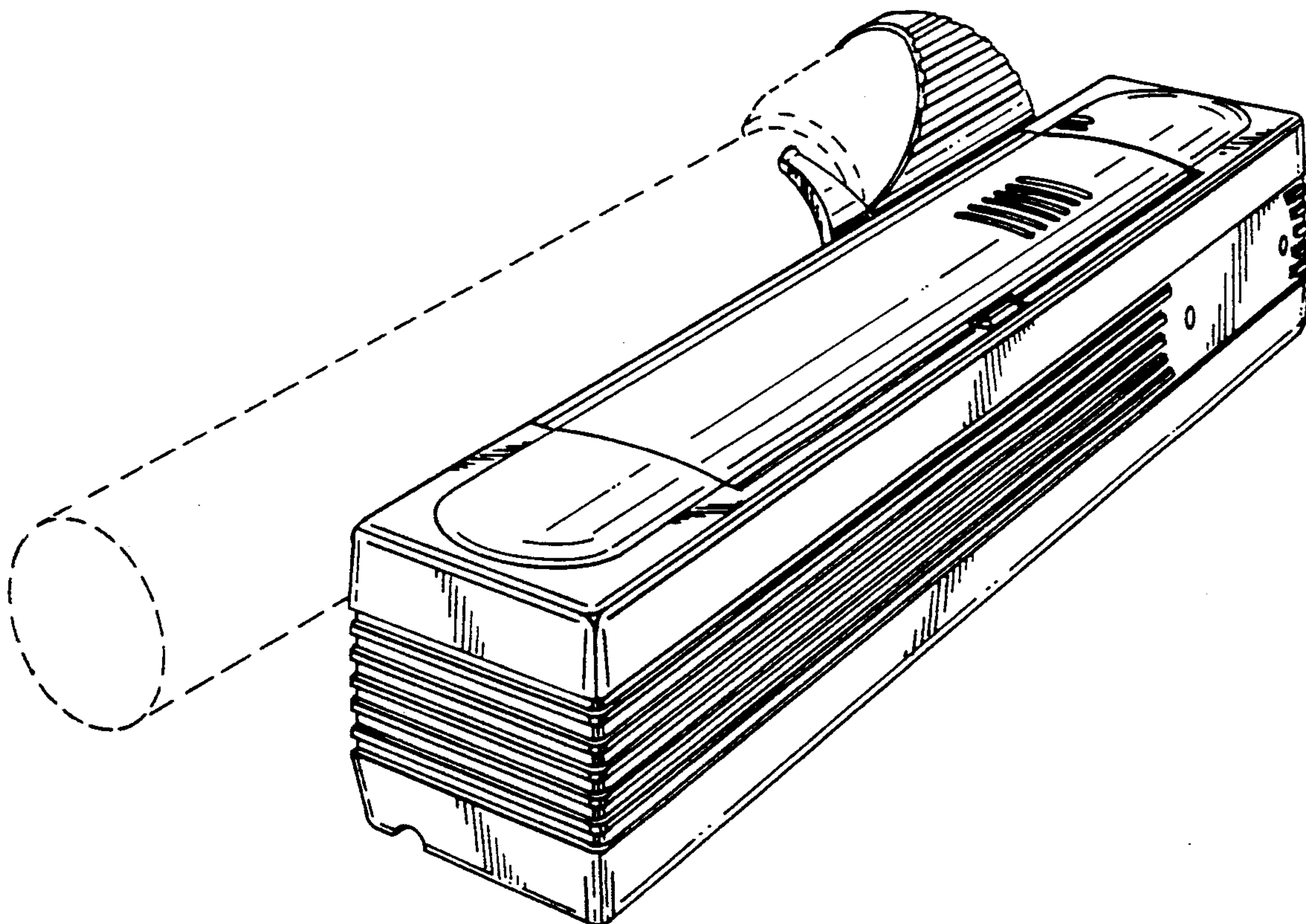

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



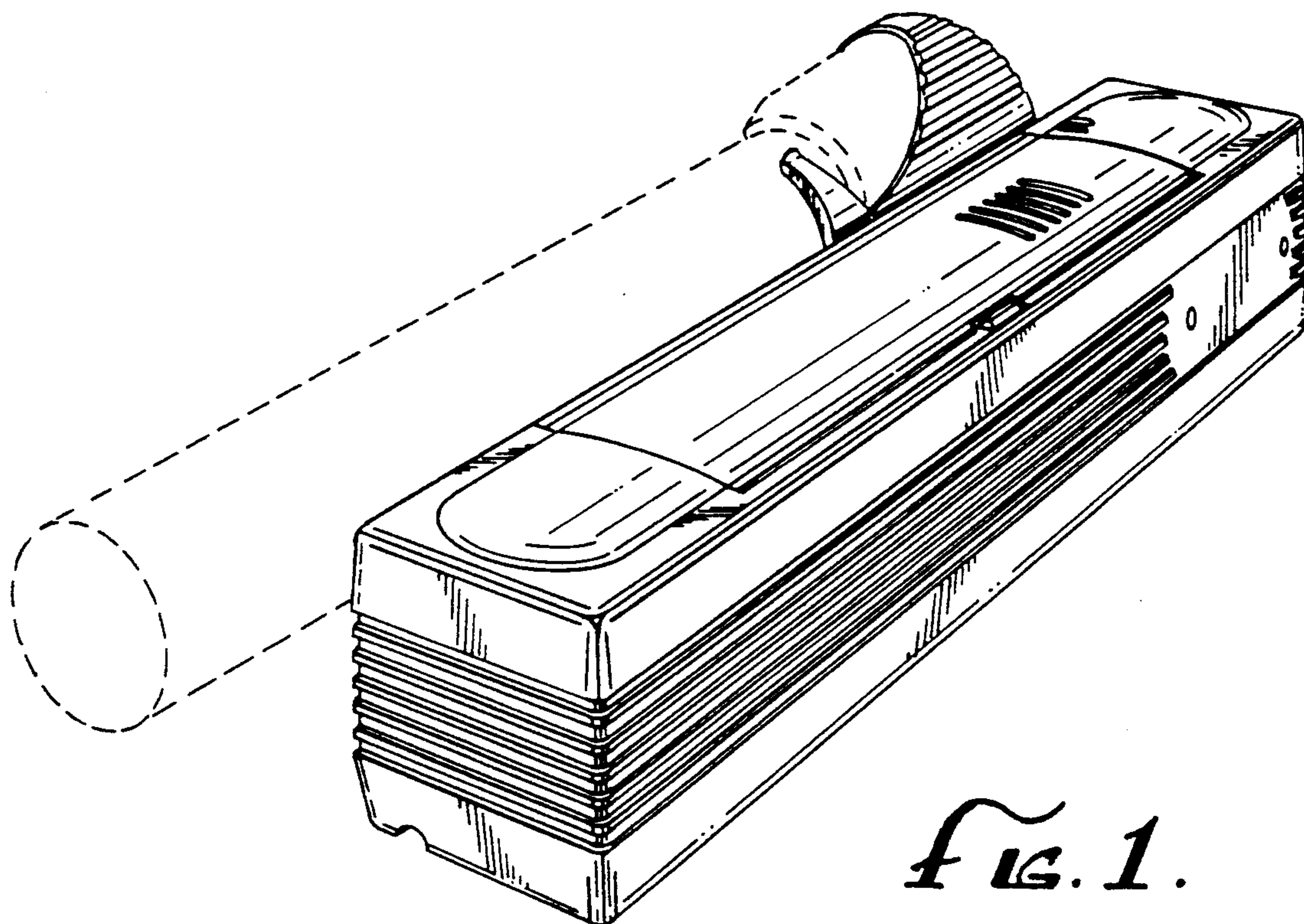

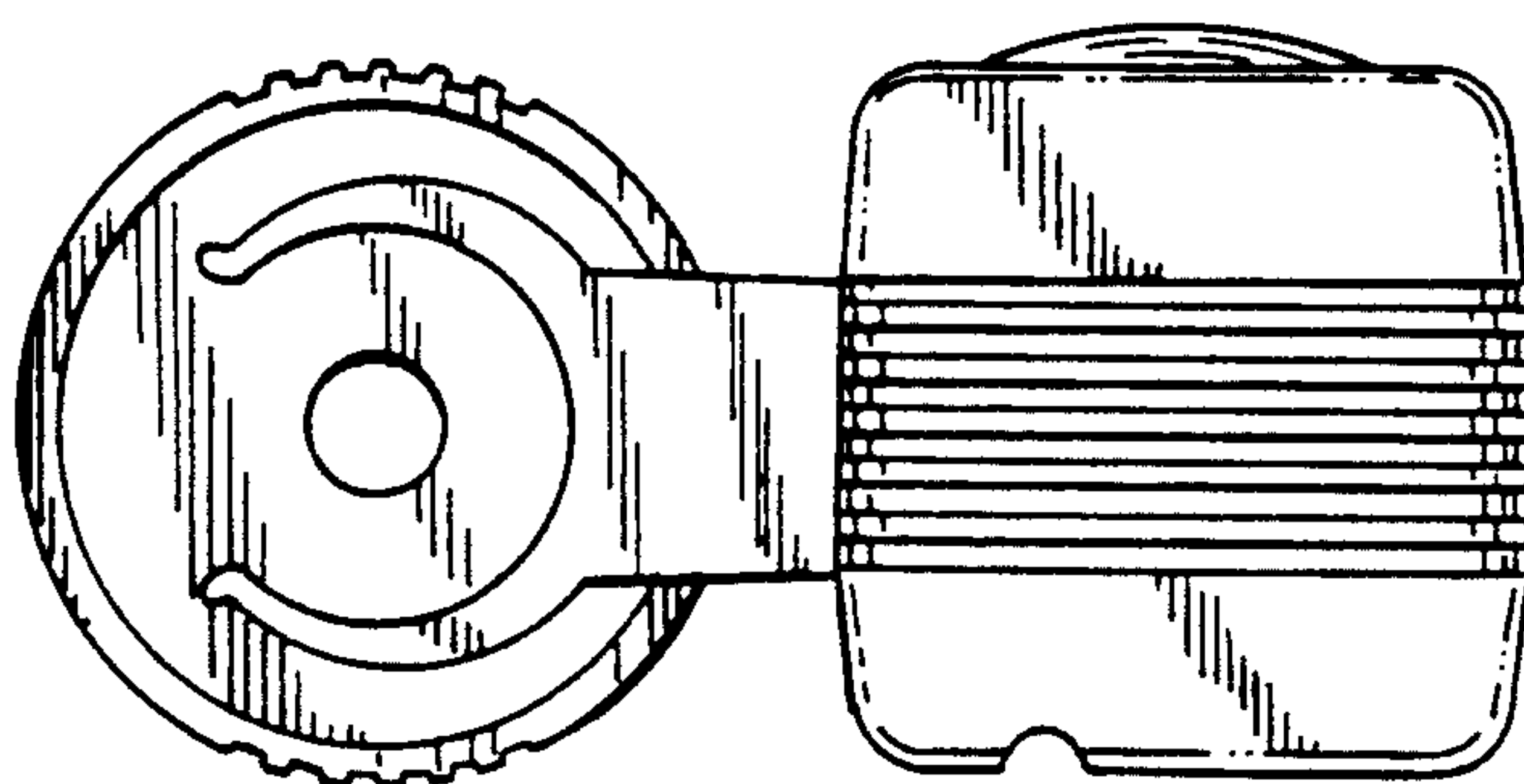

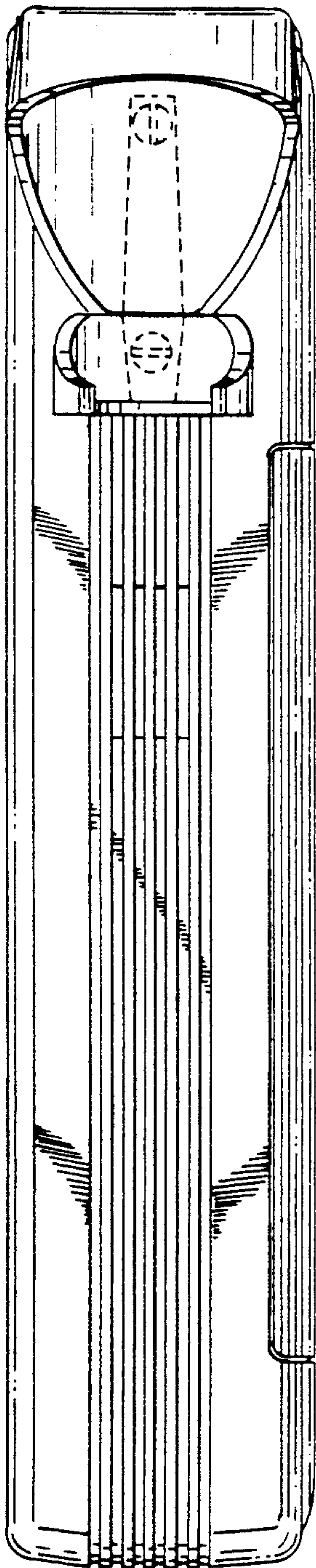
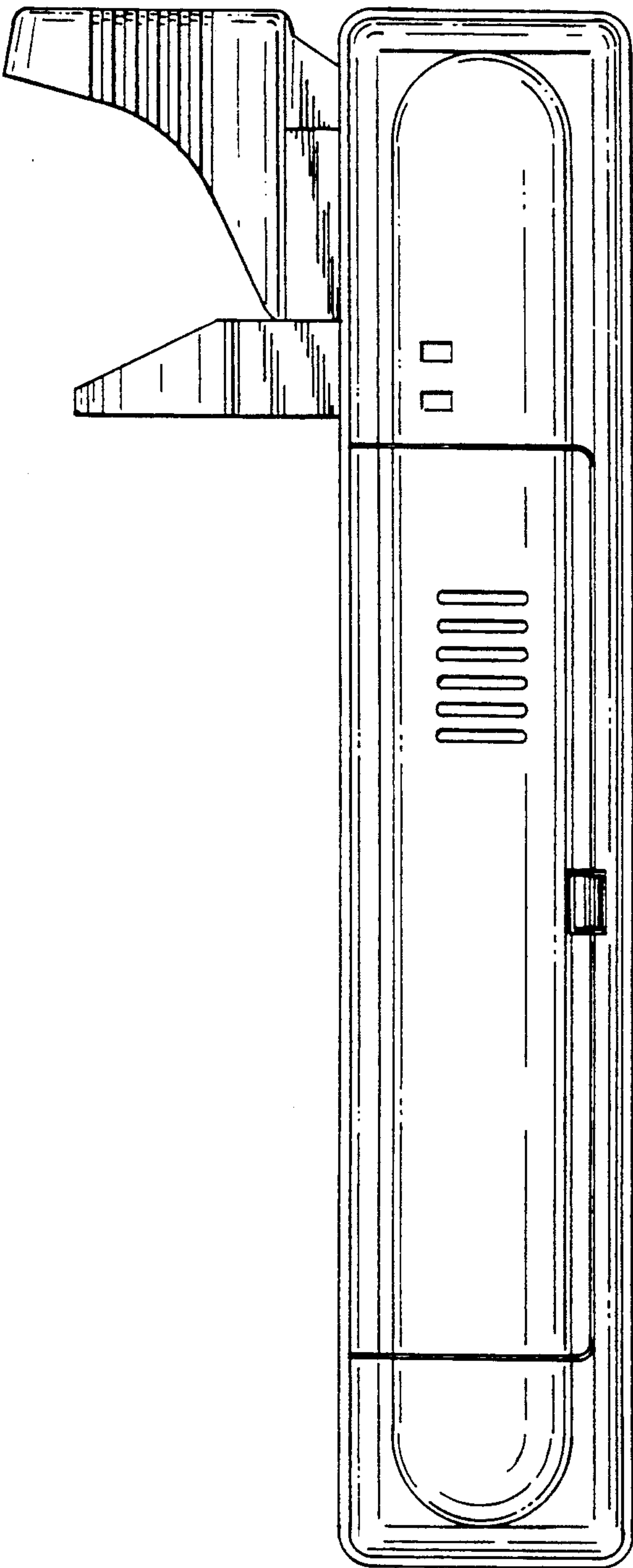

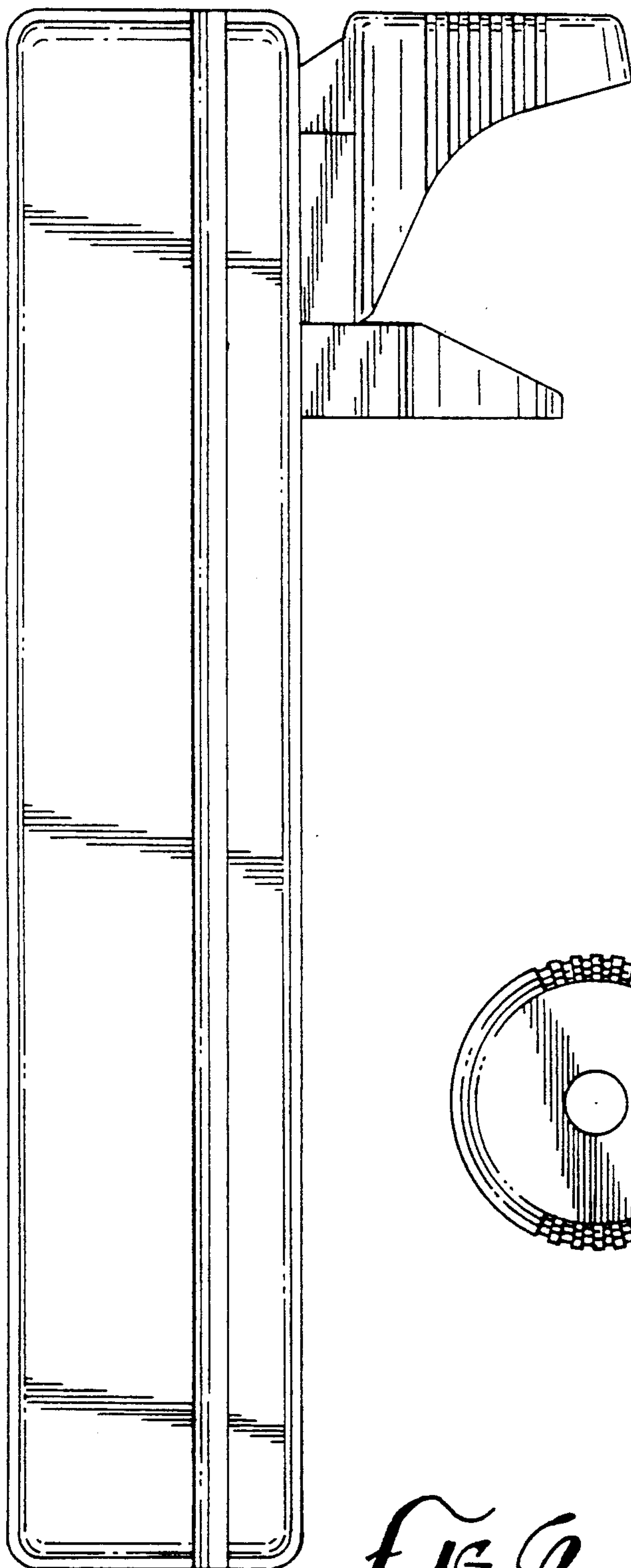

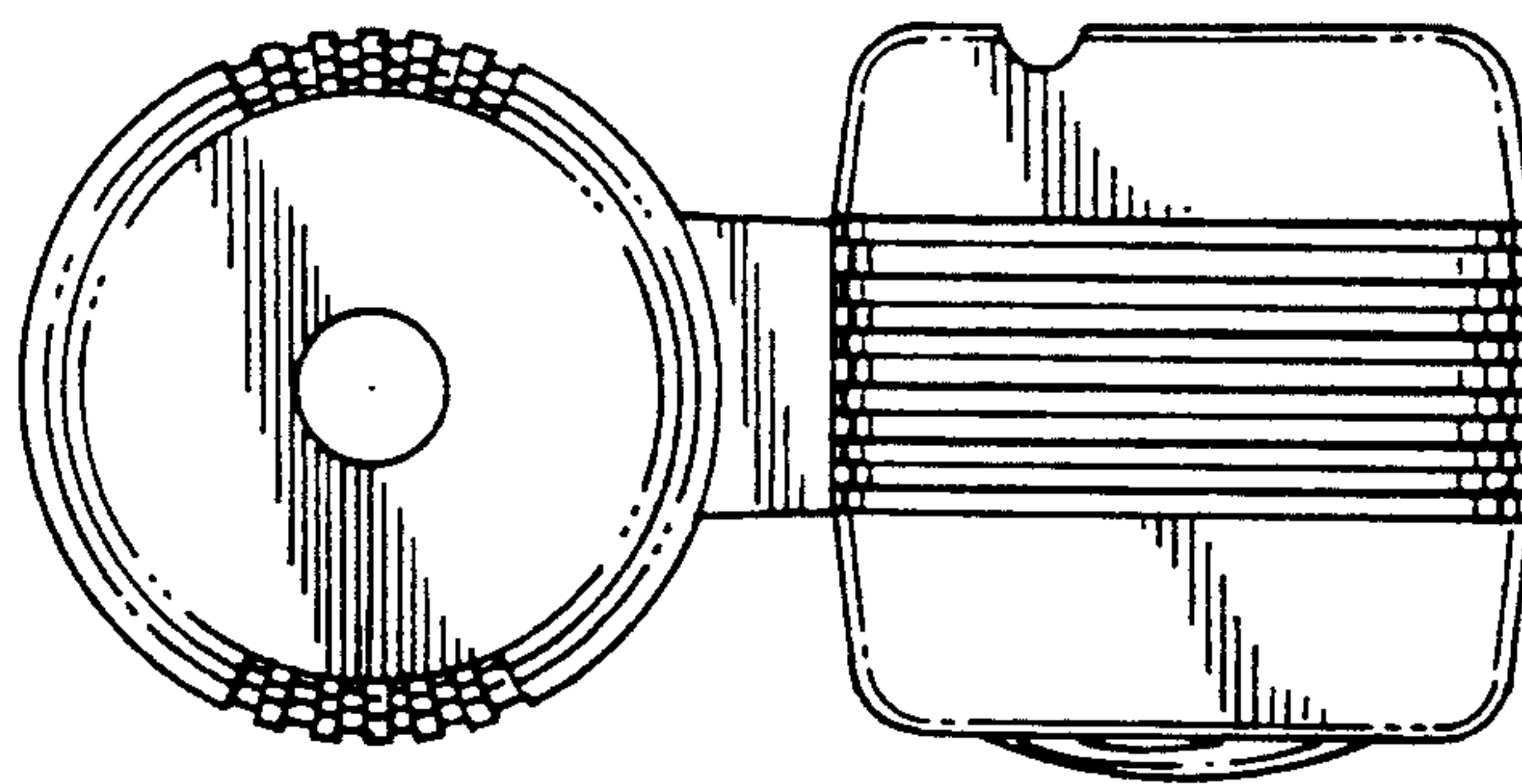
