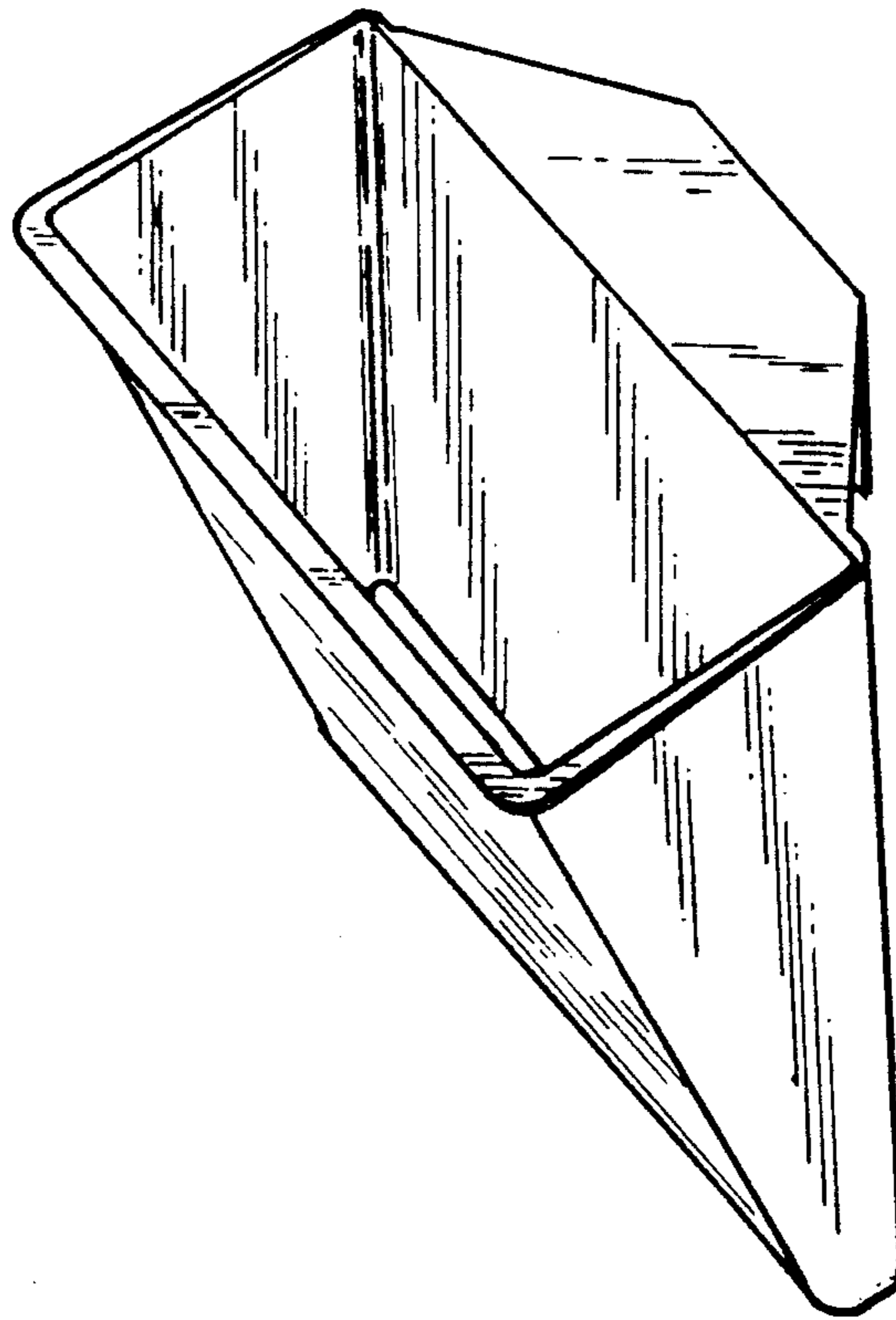

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a paint can supported brush holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a paint can supported brush holder showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along lines 3-3 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof.



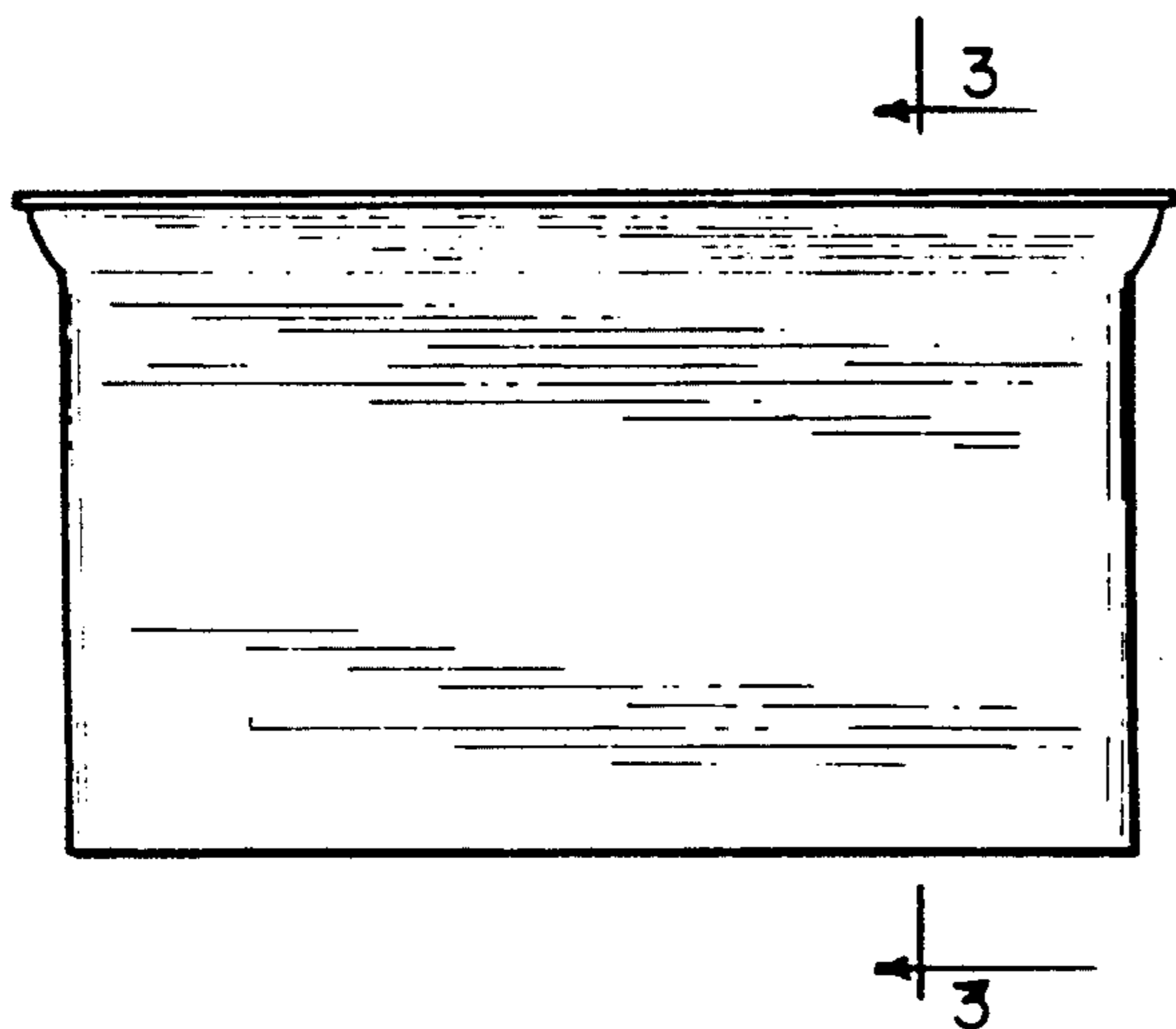

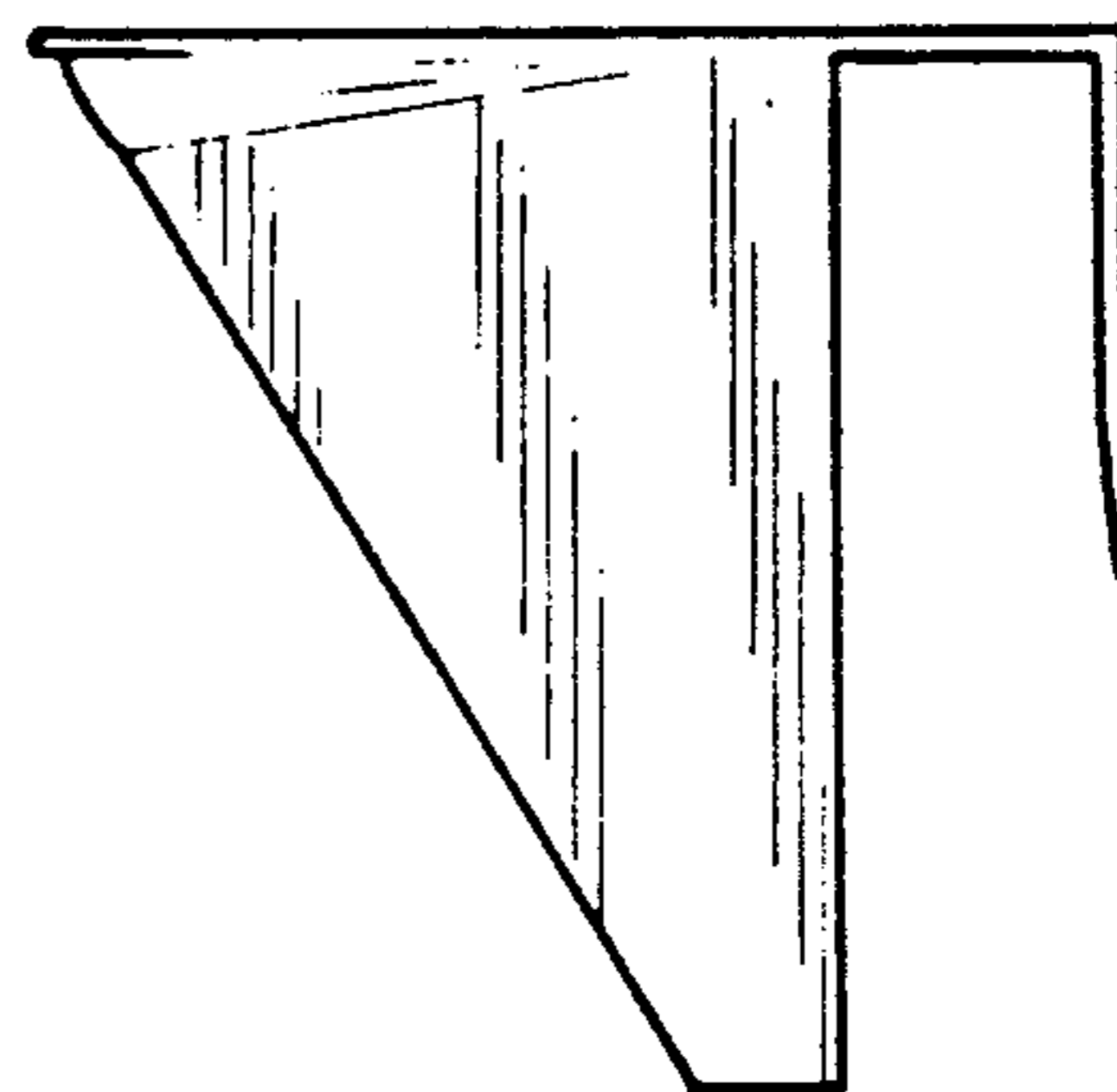

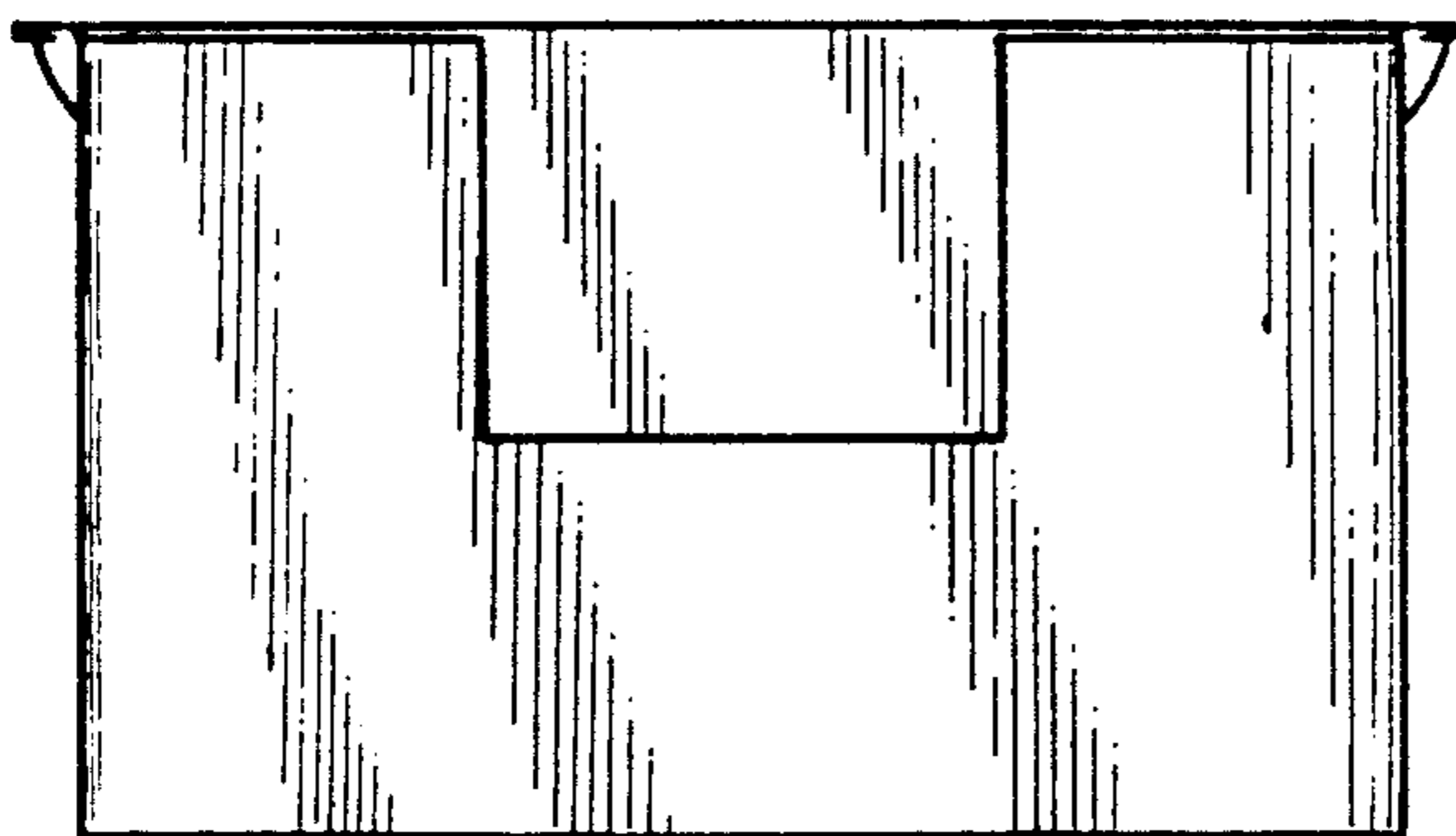

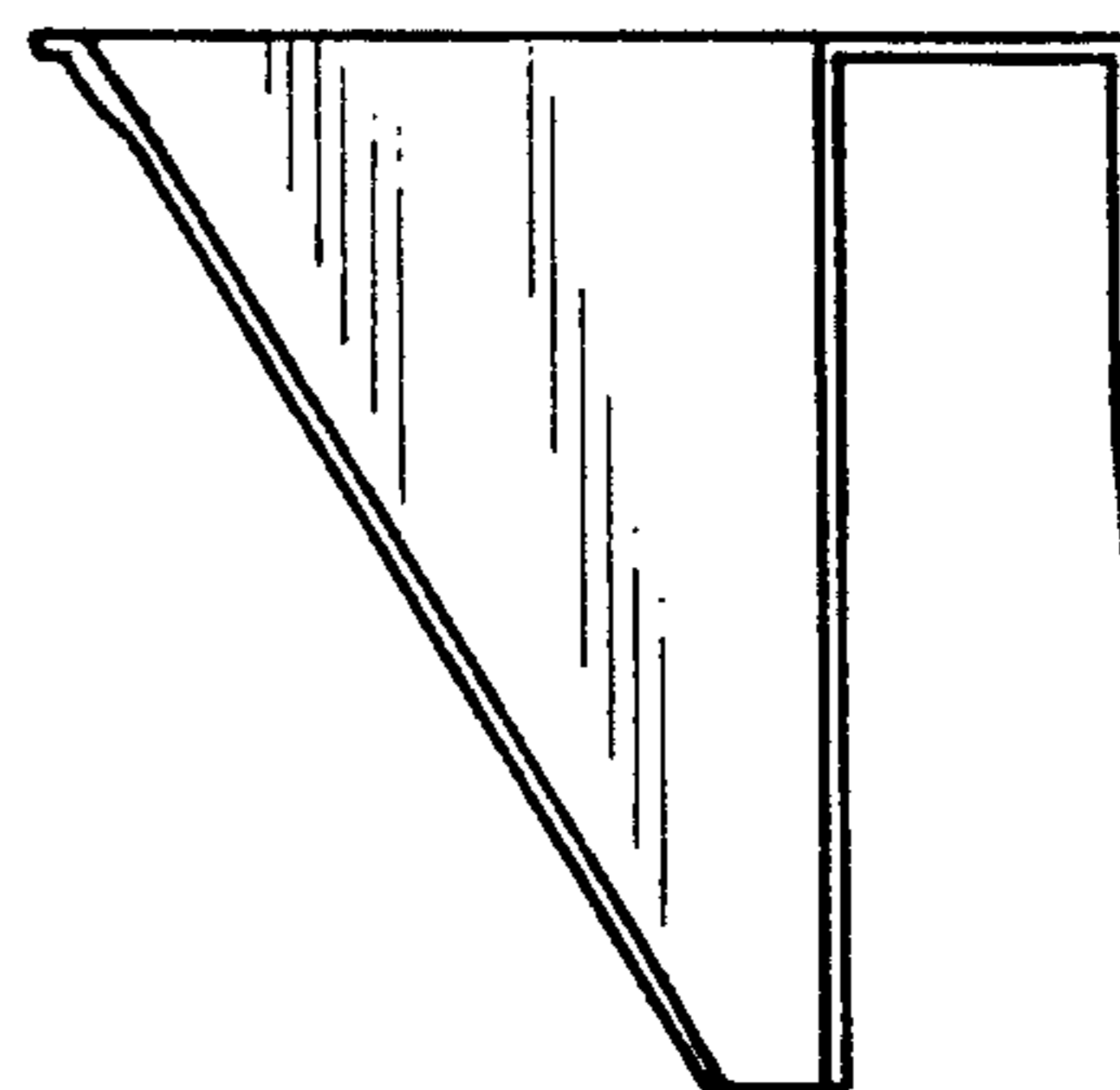

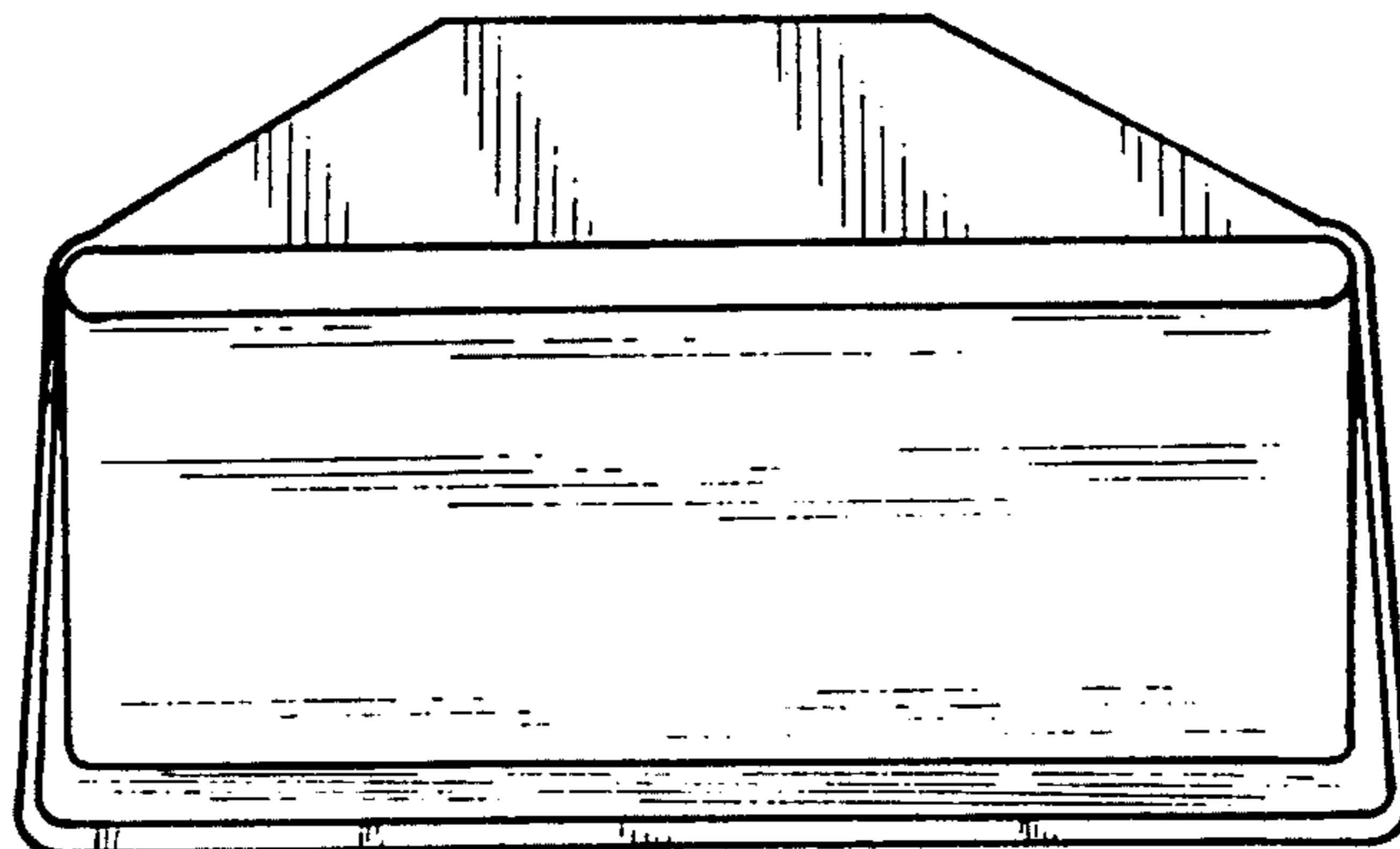

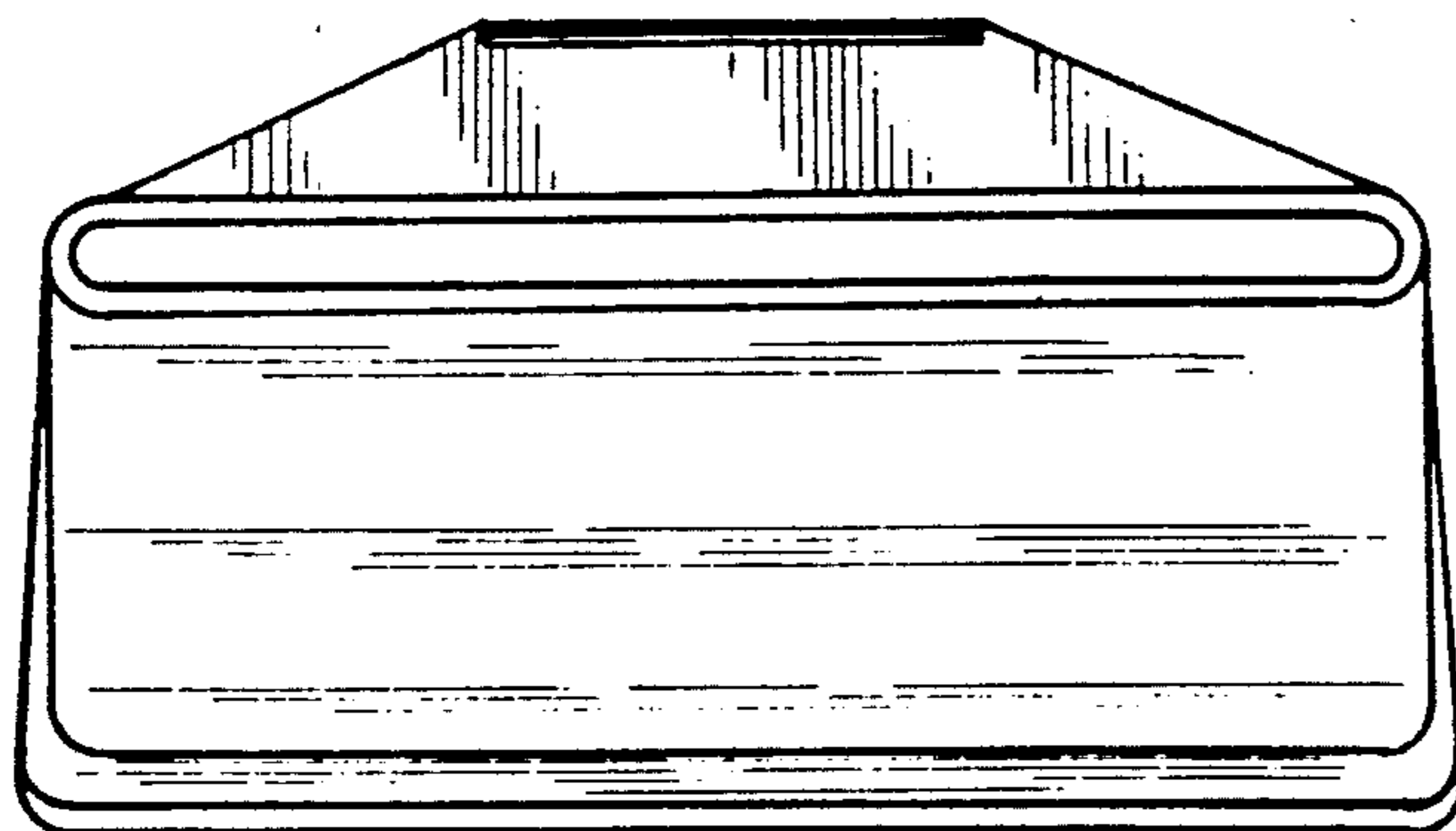

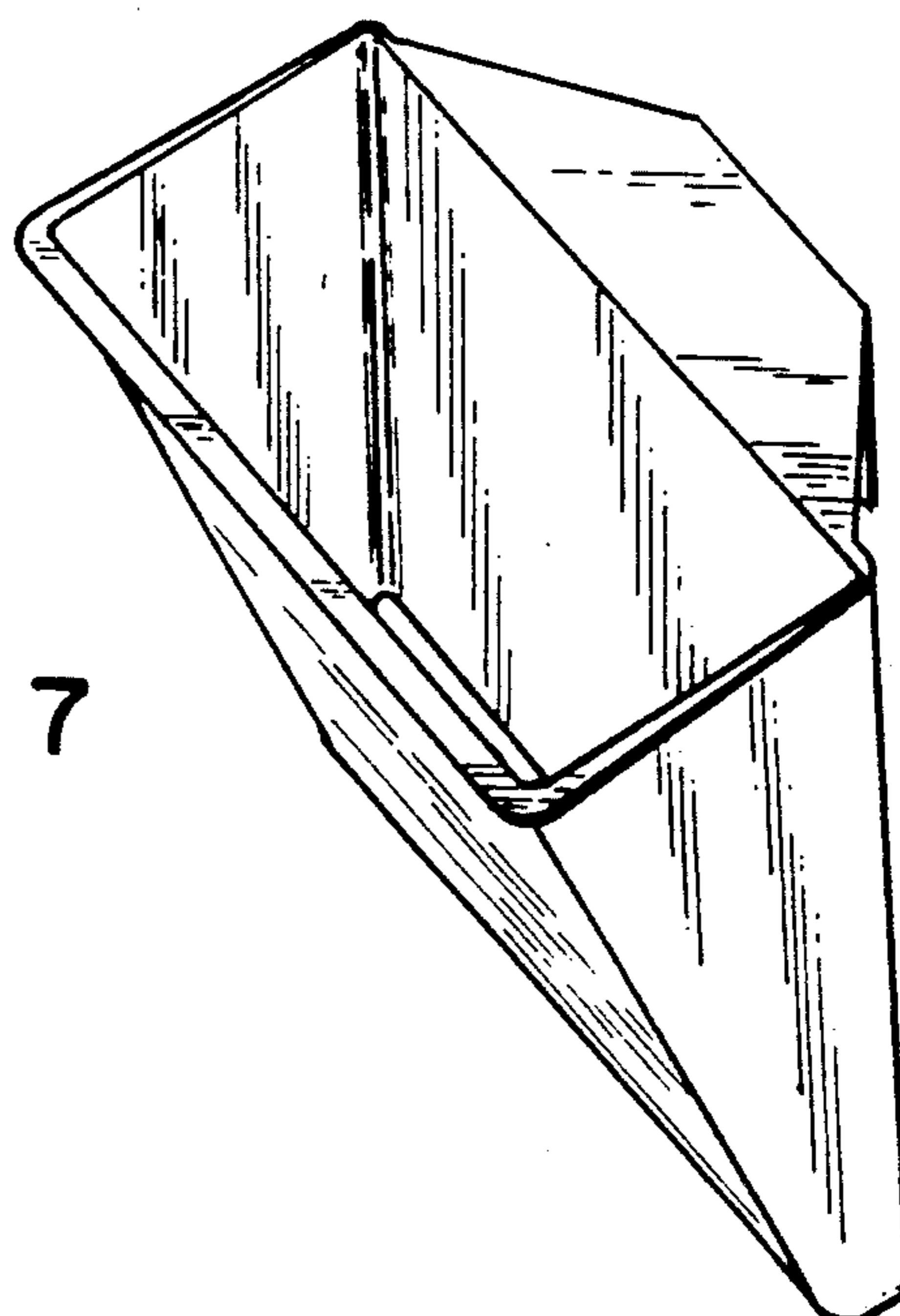
