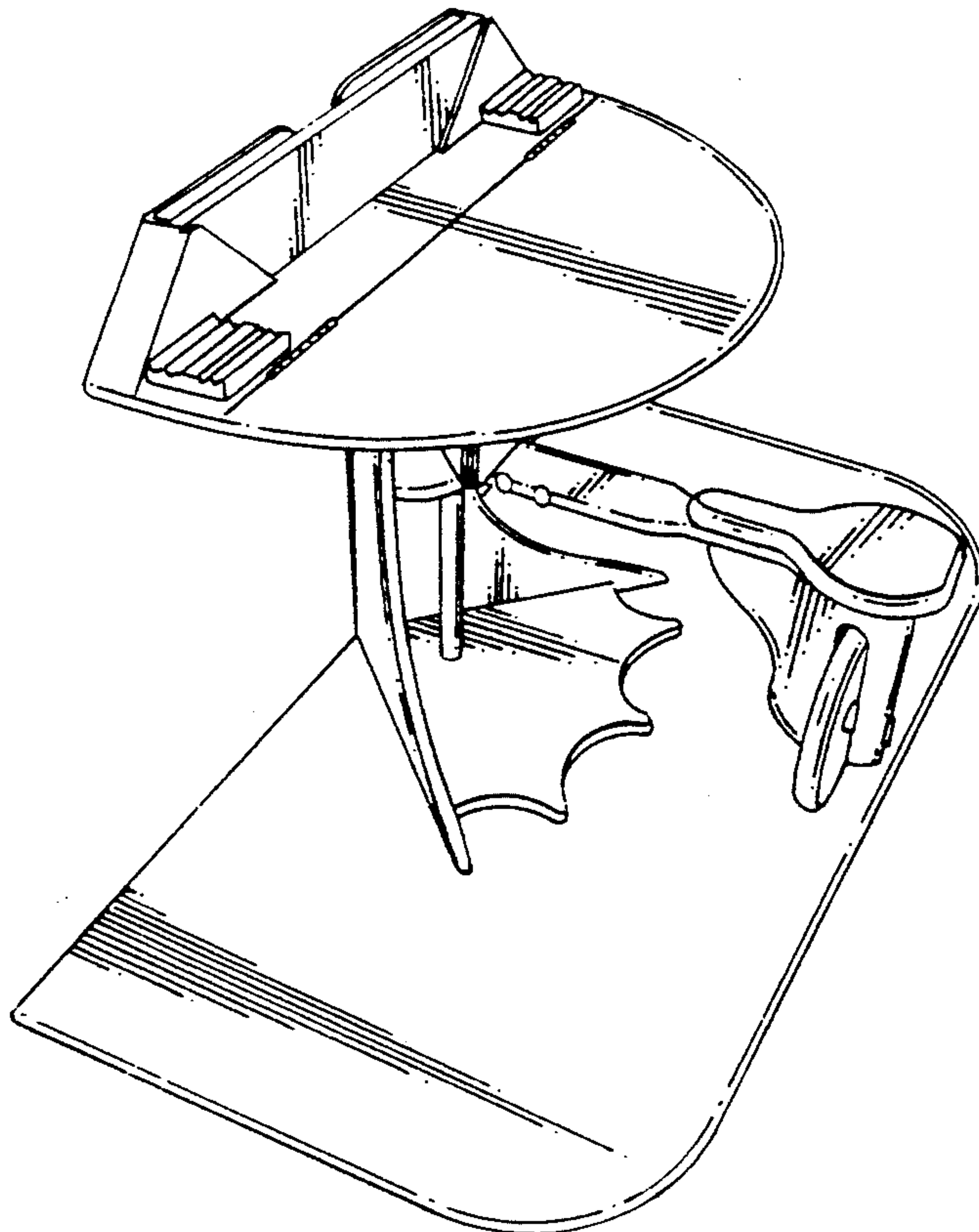
DESCRIPTION

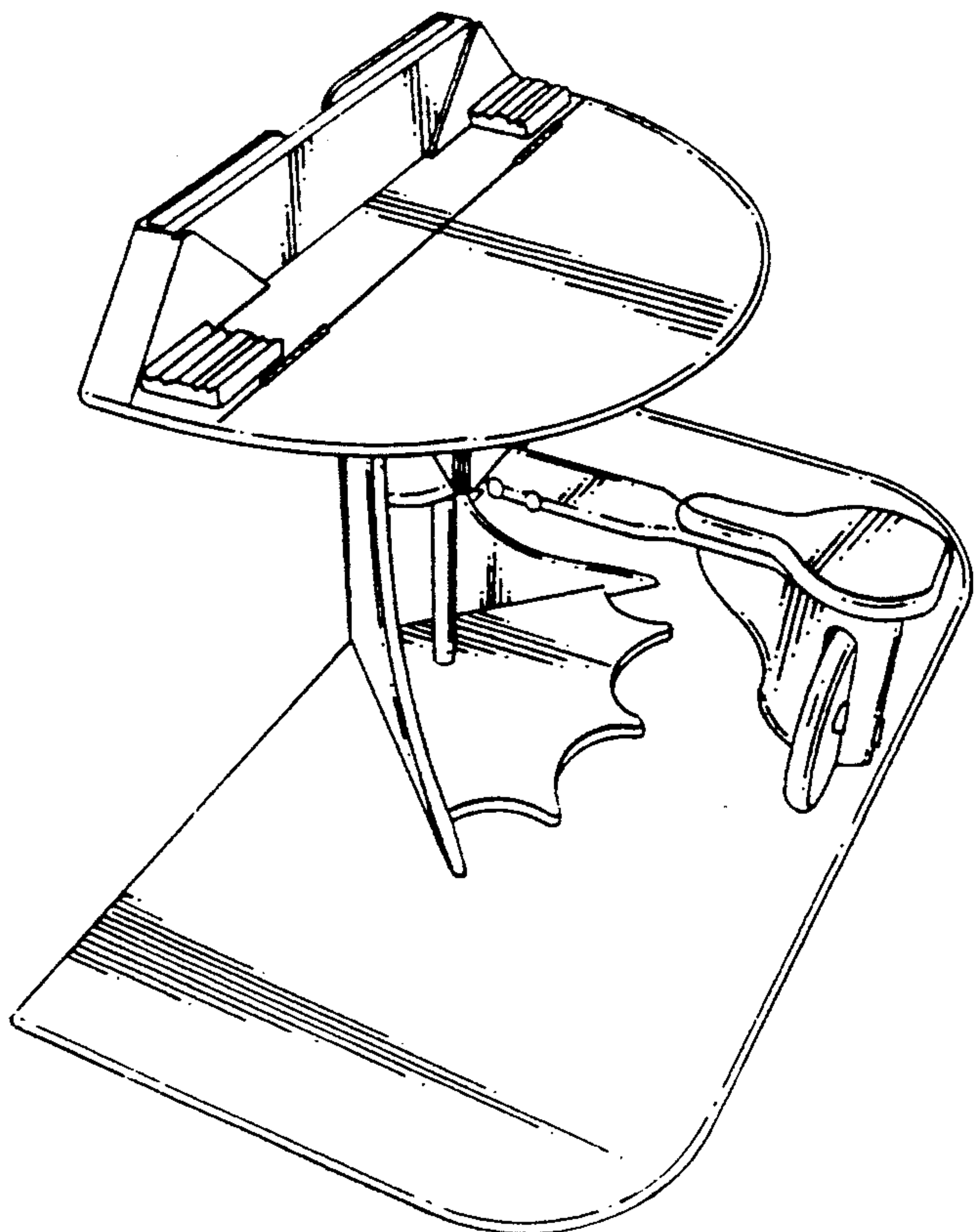

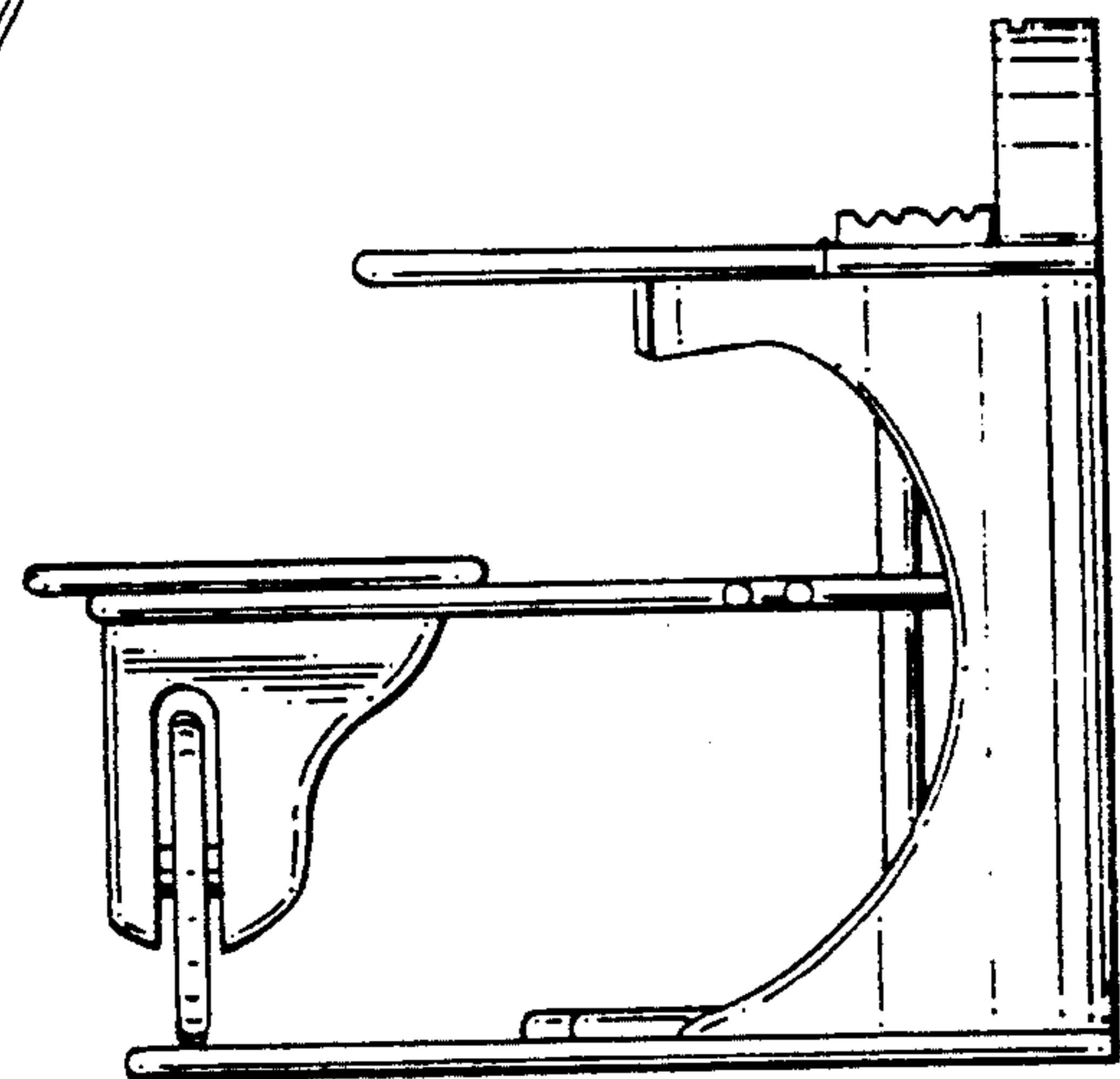

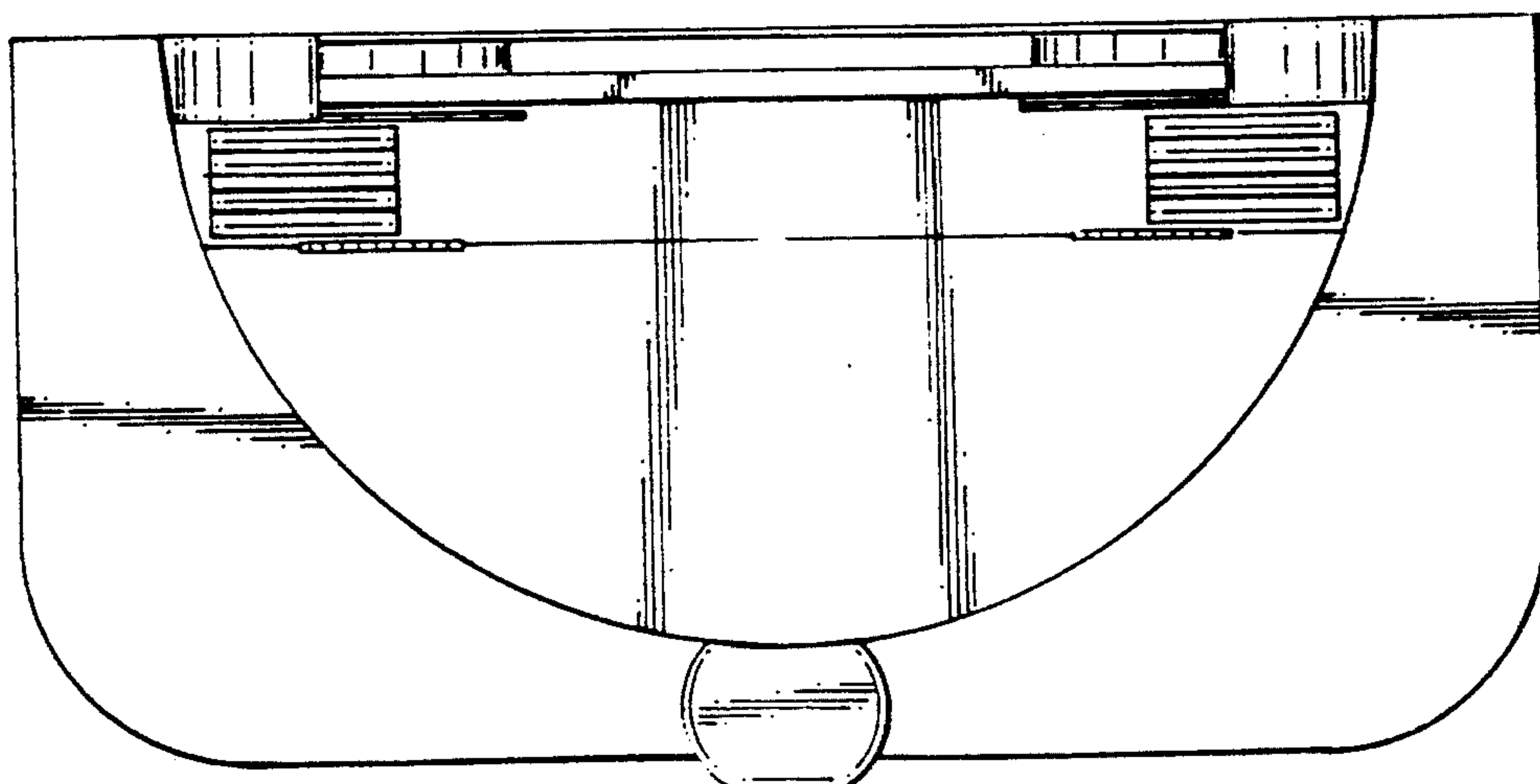

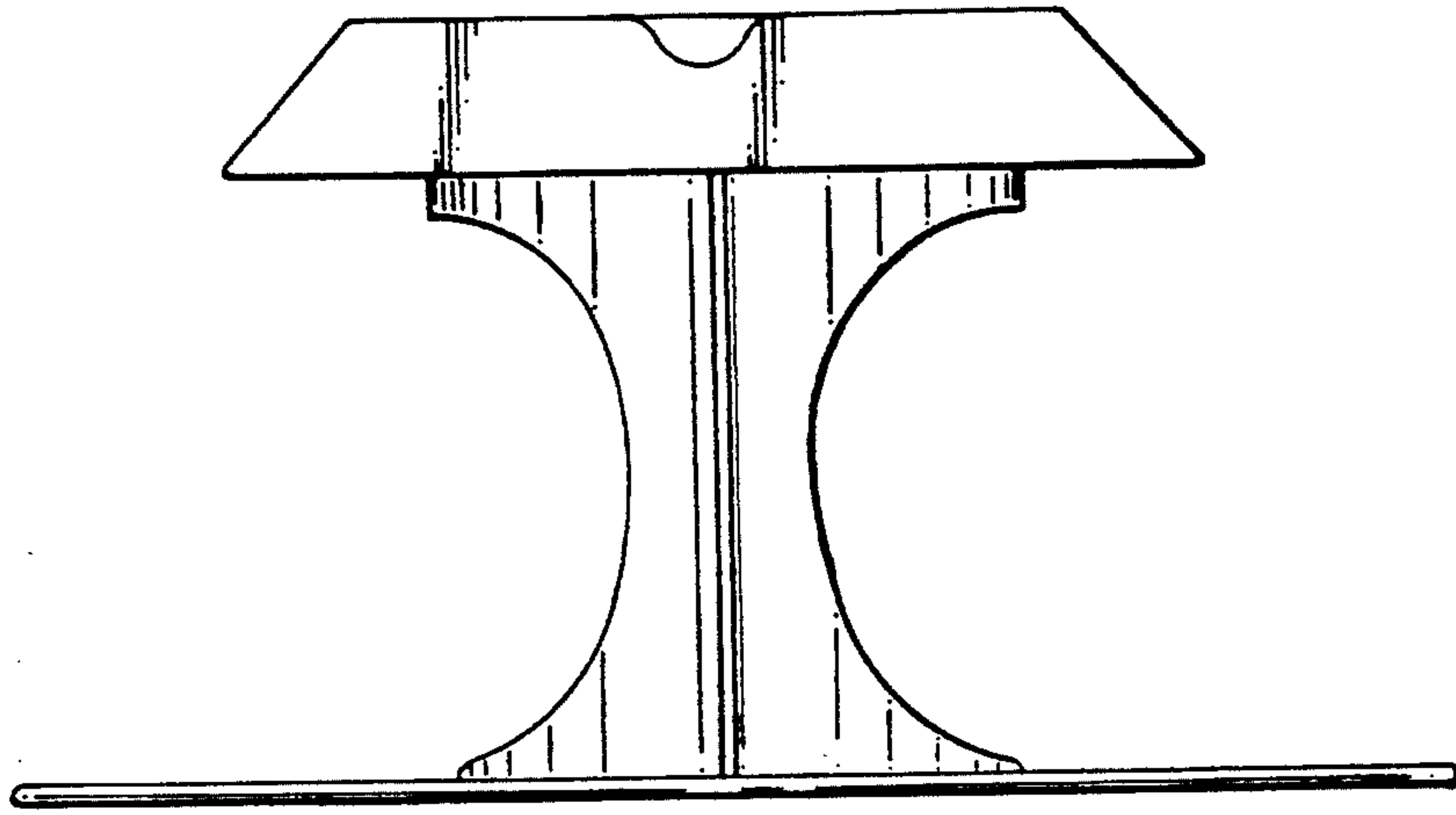

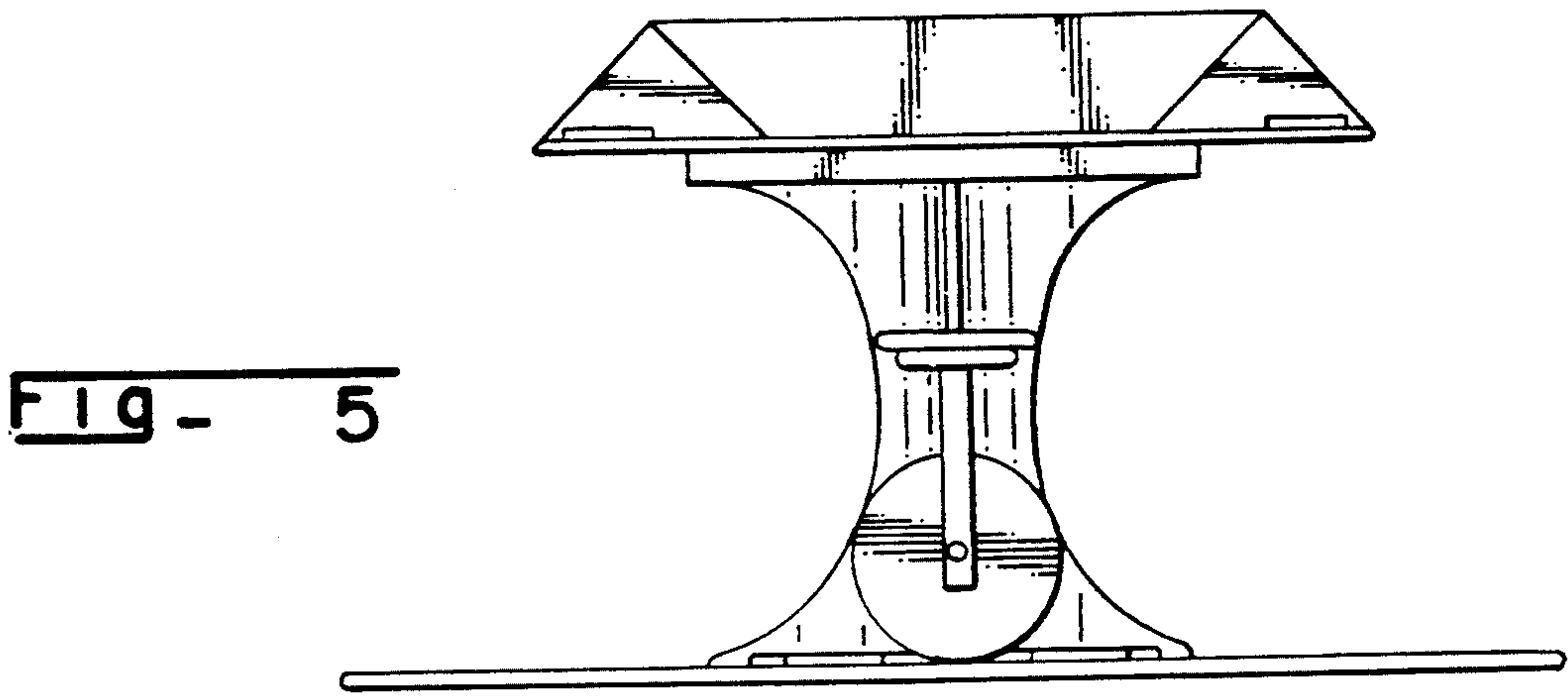

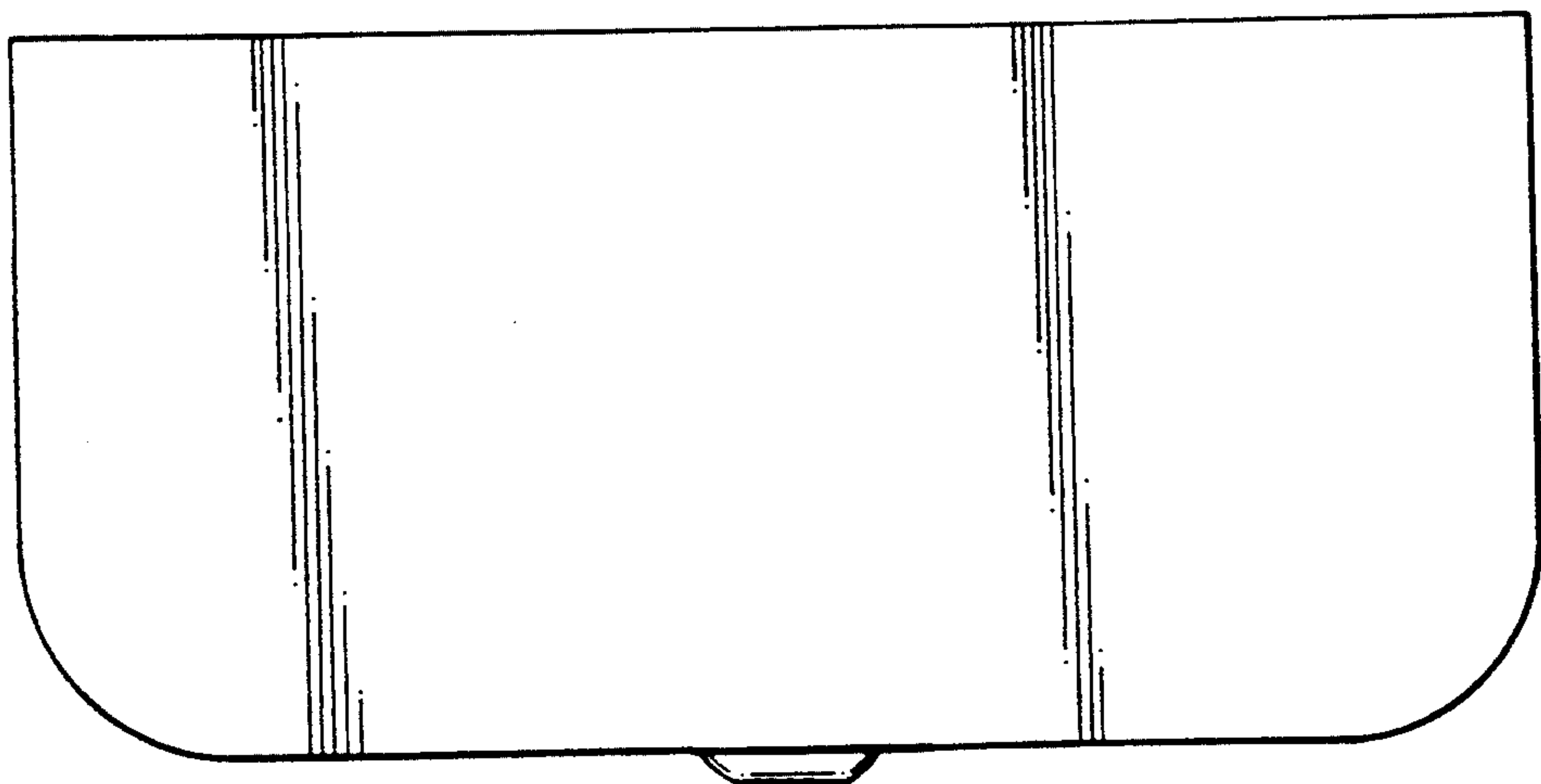

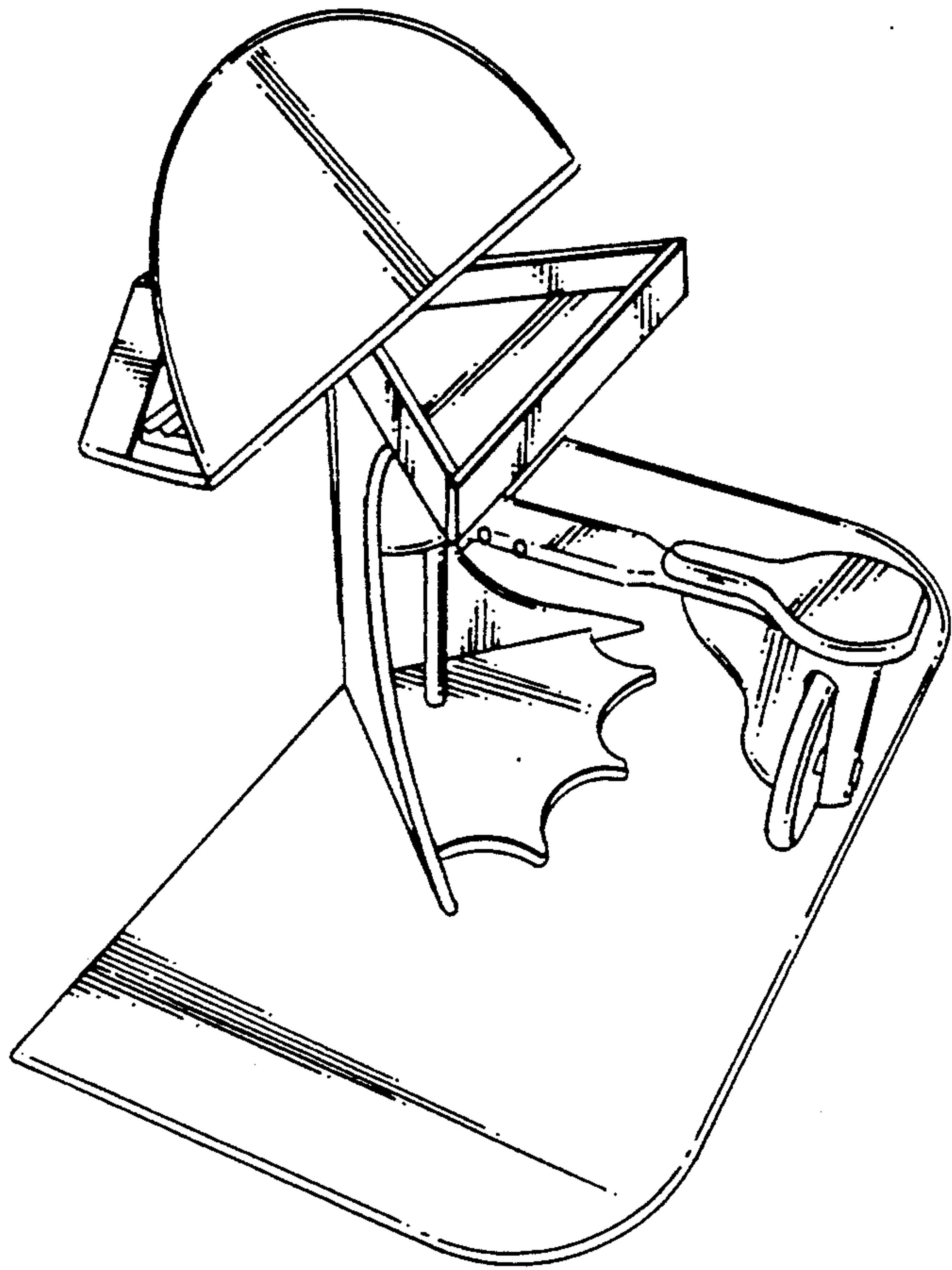
