[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for combined ceiling fan motor and switch housing and blade iron unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of combined ceiling fan motor and switch housing and blade irons unit of my new design;


FIG. 2 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof and with other side views being substantially identical;


FIG. 3 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;
