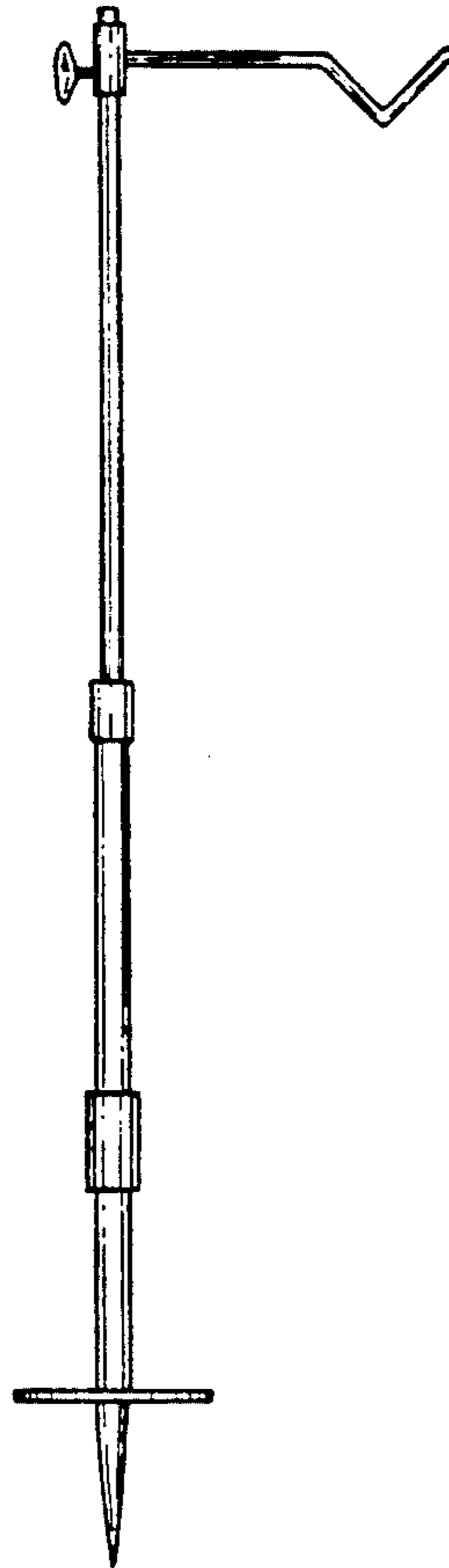
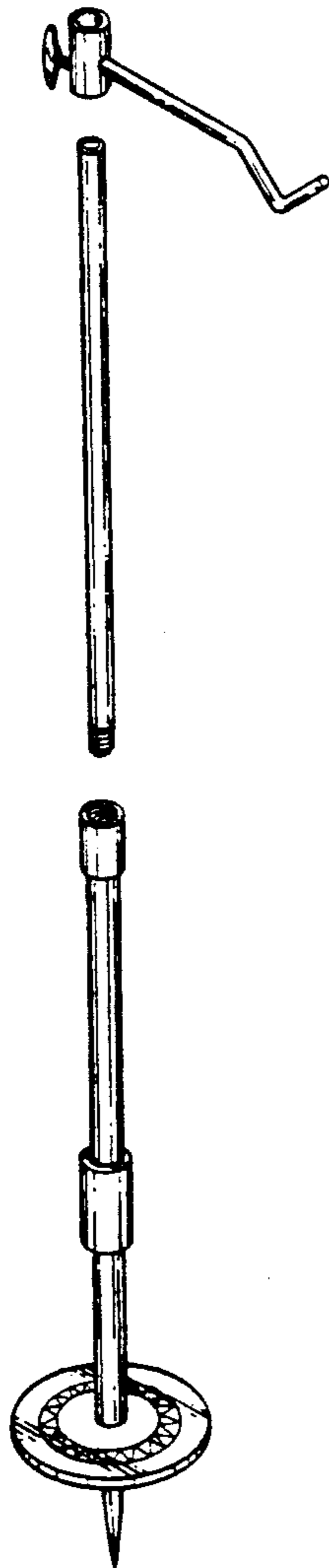

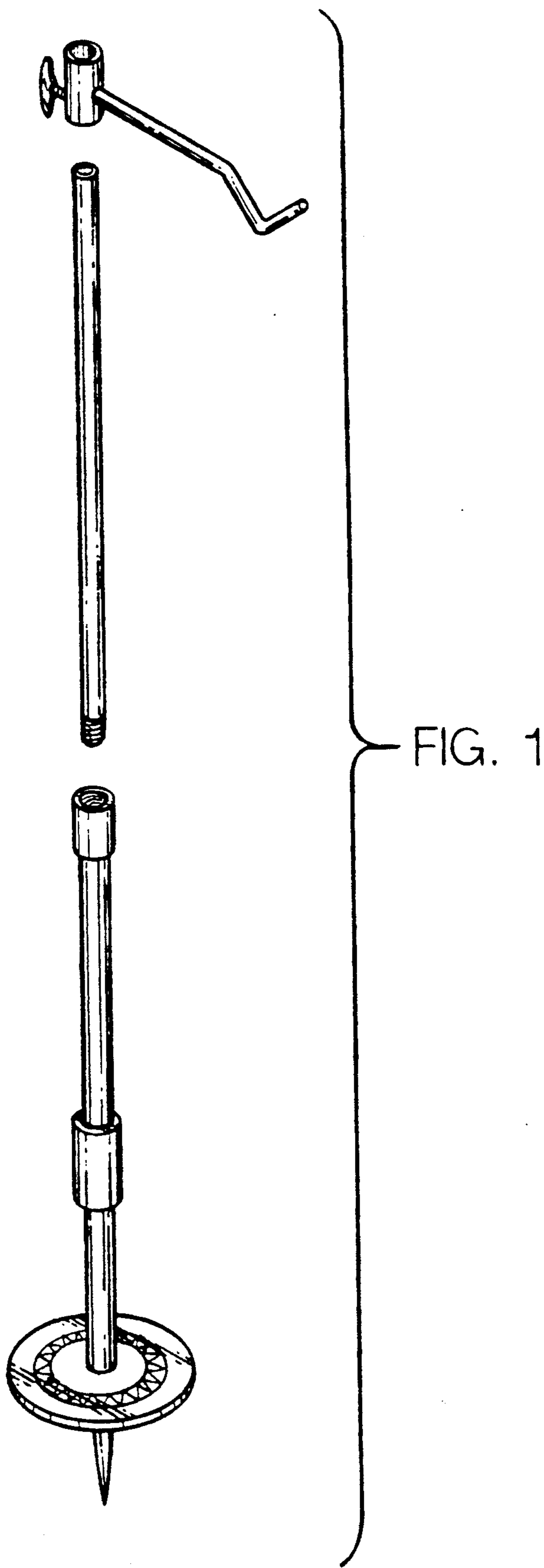
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an insect lamp stand, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of the insect lamp stand embodying the design of the present invention;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof in the assembled condition, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.





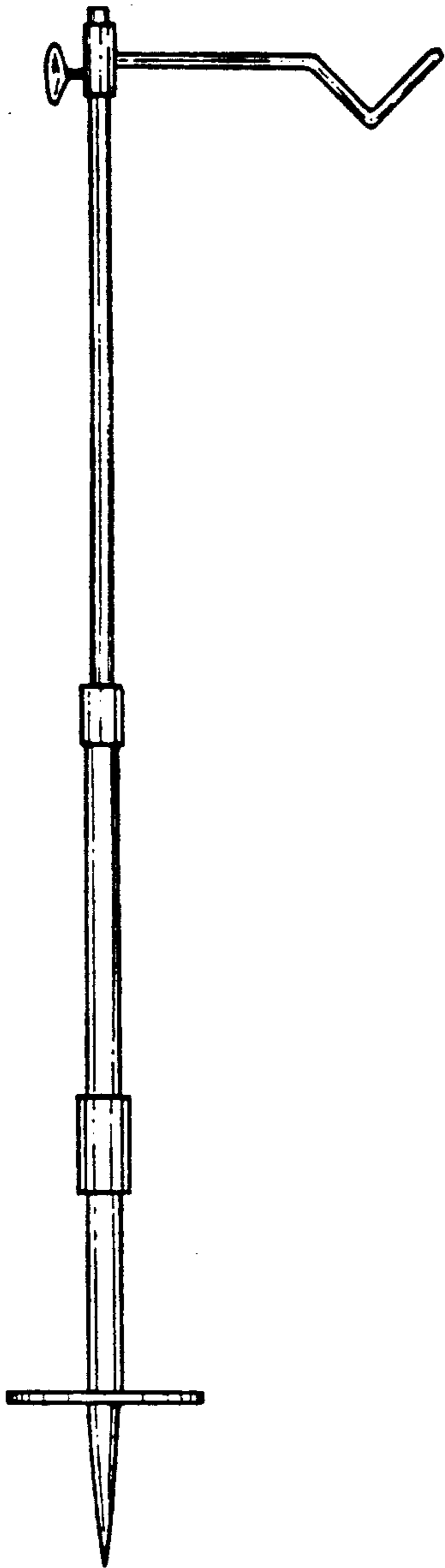

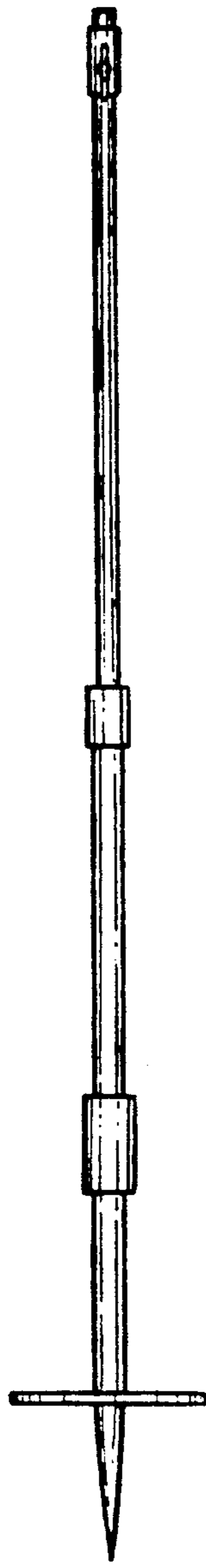

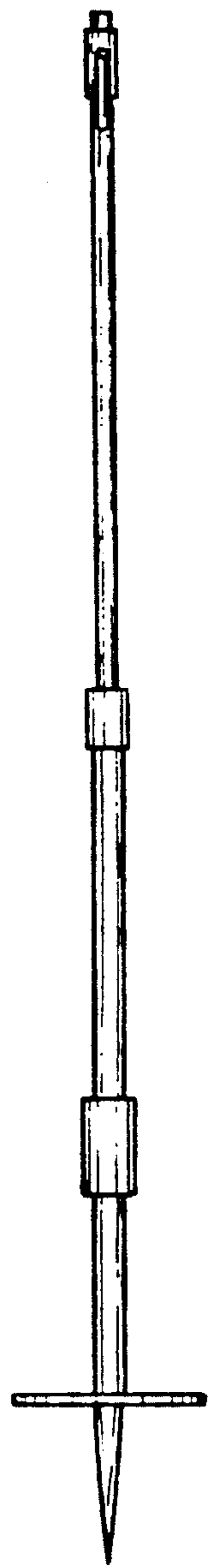

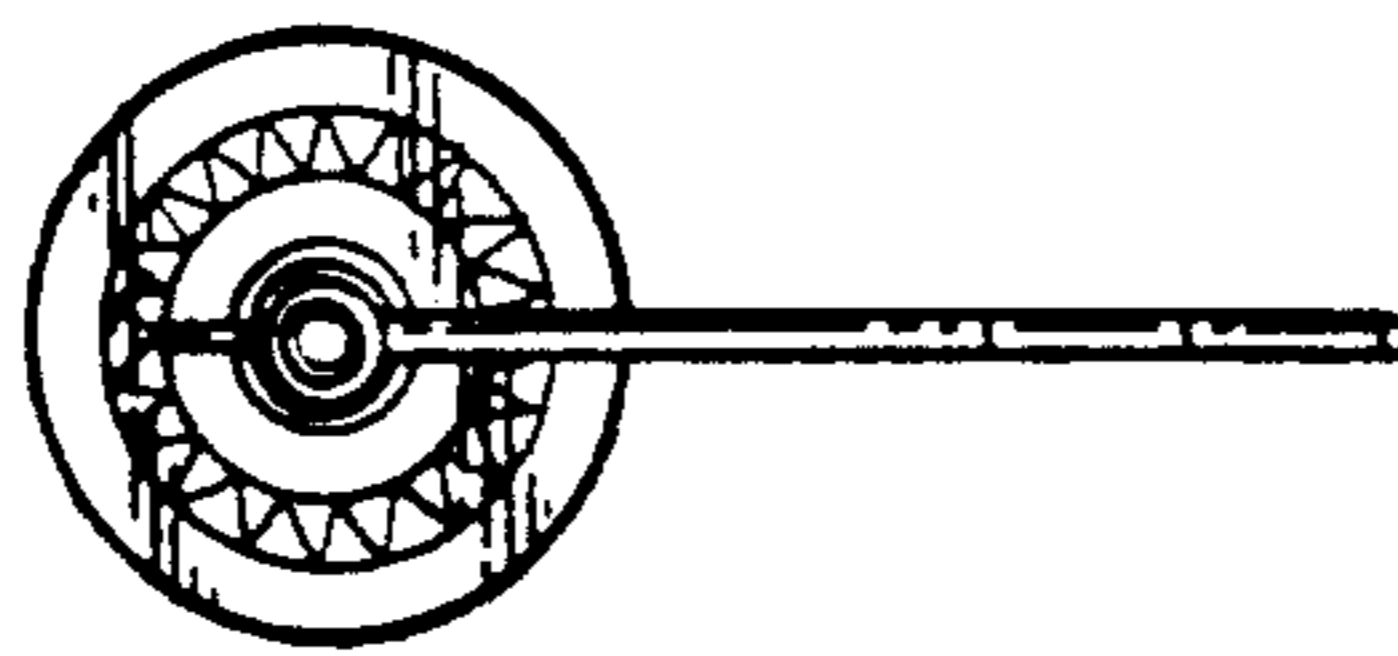

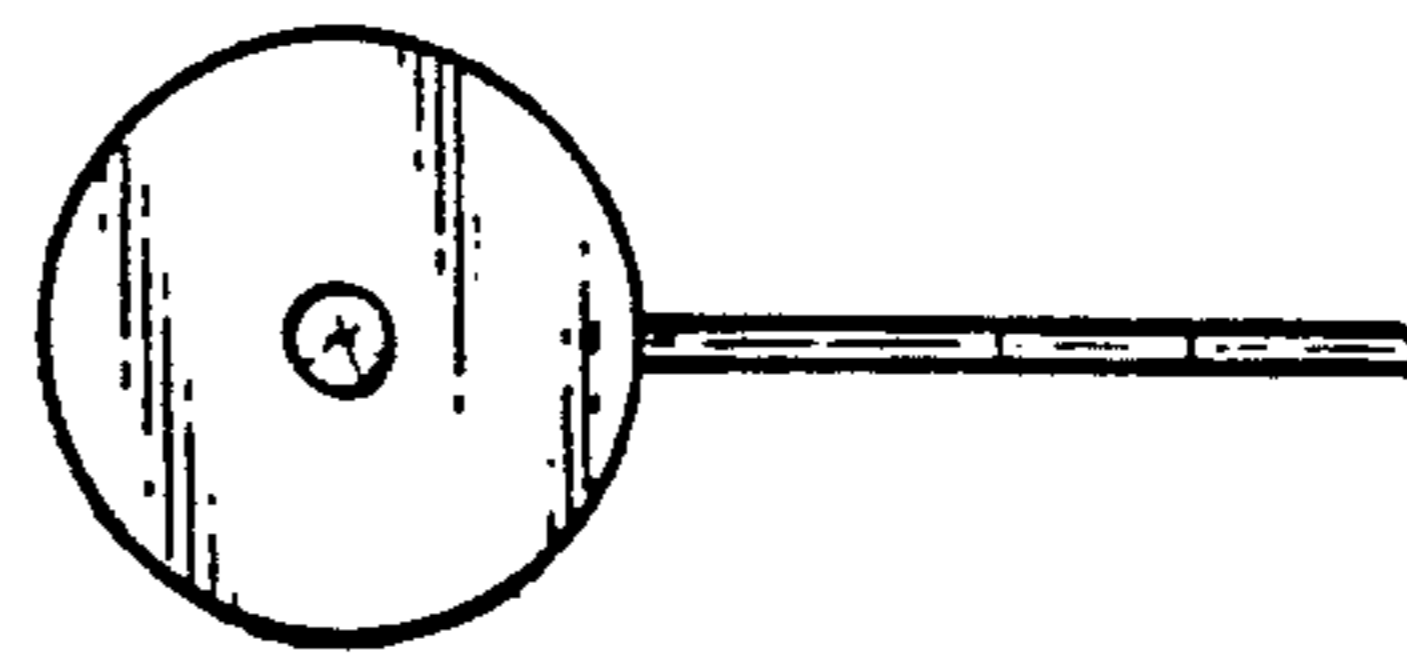
