The ornamental design for a necktie, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a necktie showing my new design the broken away portion is for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of my necktie; FIG. 3 is a right side elevated view of my necktie; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of my necktie;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of my necktie;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of my necktie; FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of a necktie showing my new design the broken

away portion is for clarity of illustration, the difference being the pointed front end and the pattern applied to the necktie;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of my necktie;


FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view of a second embodiment of my necktie;


FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of a second embodiment of my necktie;
