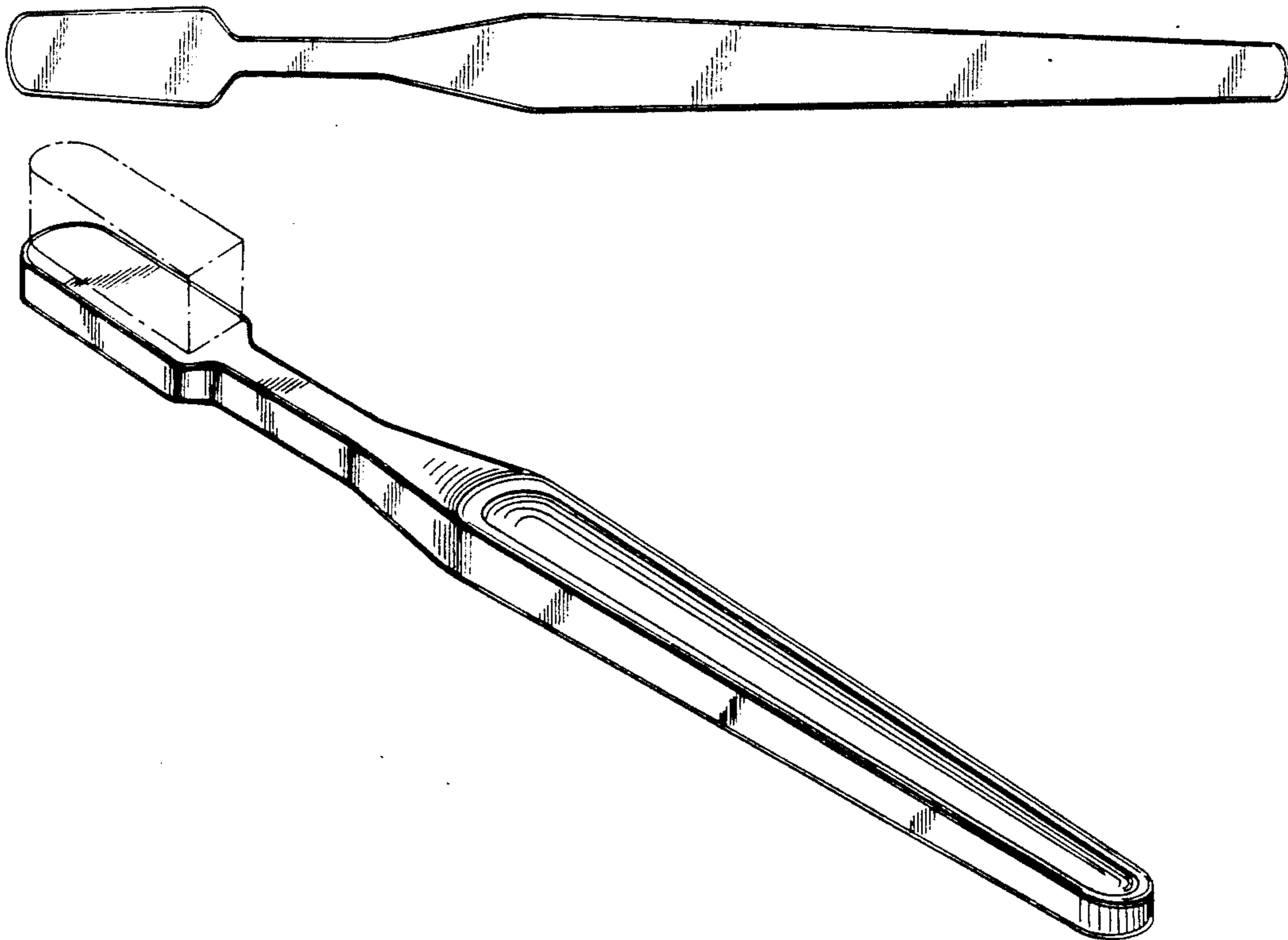

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toothbrush handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toothbrush handle showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof.
 The structure shown in phantom or broken lines in the Figures forms no part of the claimed design and is present only to illustrate the environment.
 The undisclosed end is unornamented.



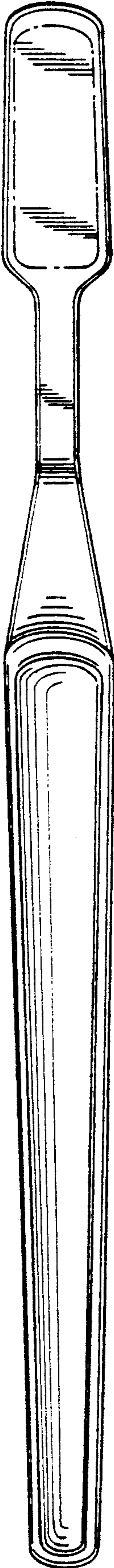

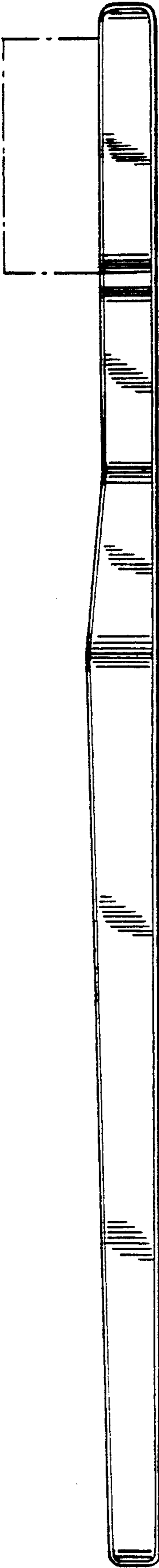

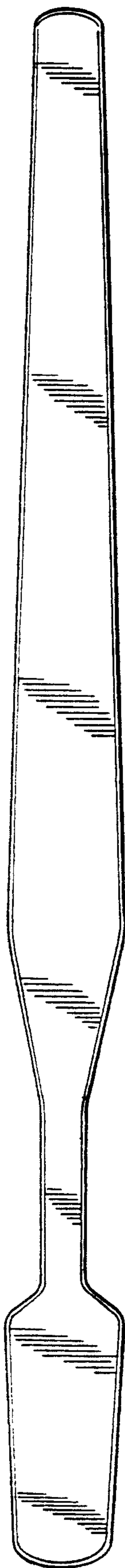

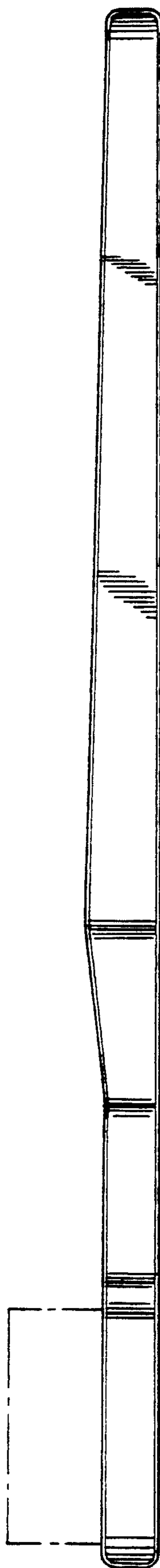
