[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cover for a telephone handset, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a cover for a telephone handset, showing my new design in open condition;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof in closed condition;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2;

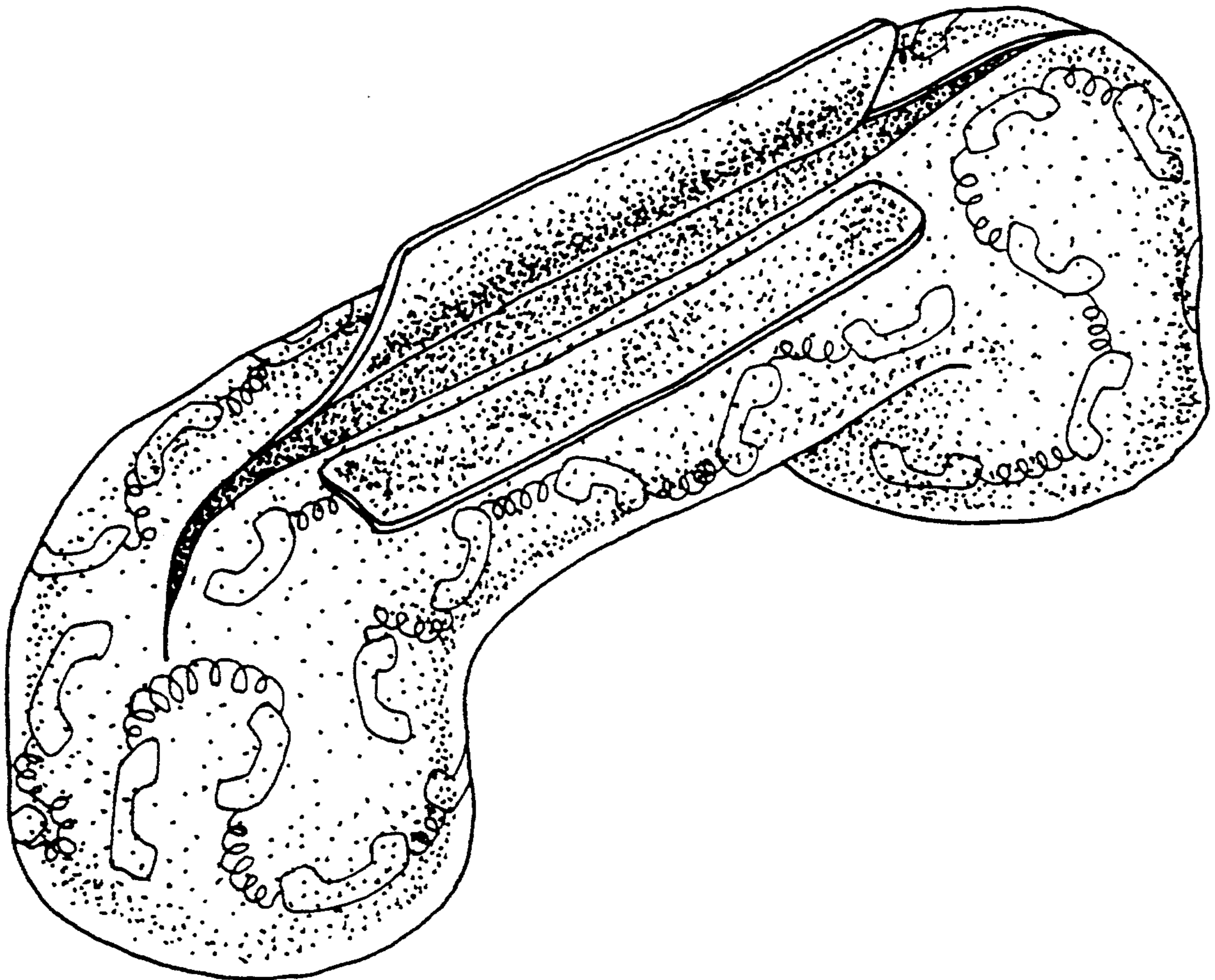
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2.

The mesh pattern is partially shown in FIG. 7 for ease of illustration, and is understood to extend throughout each of the two circular areas.



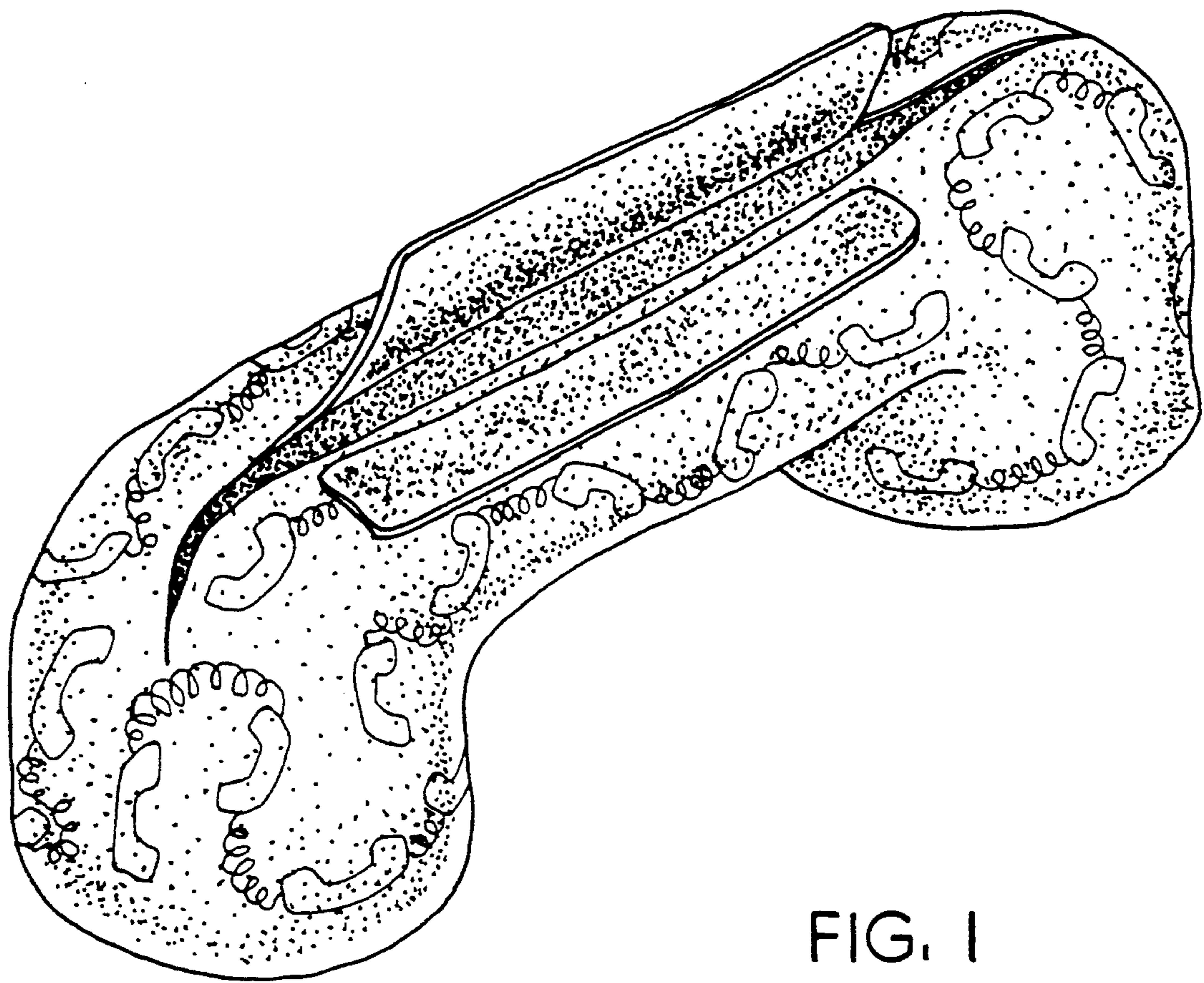

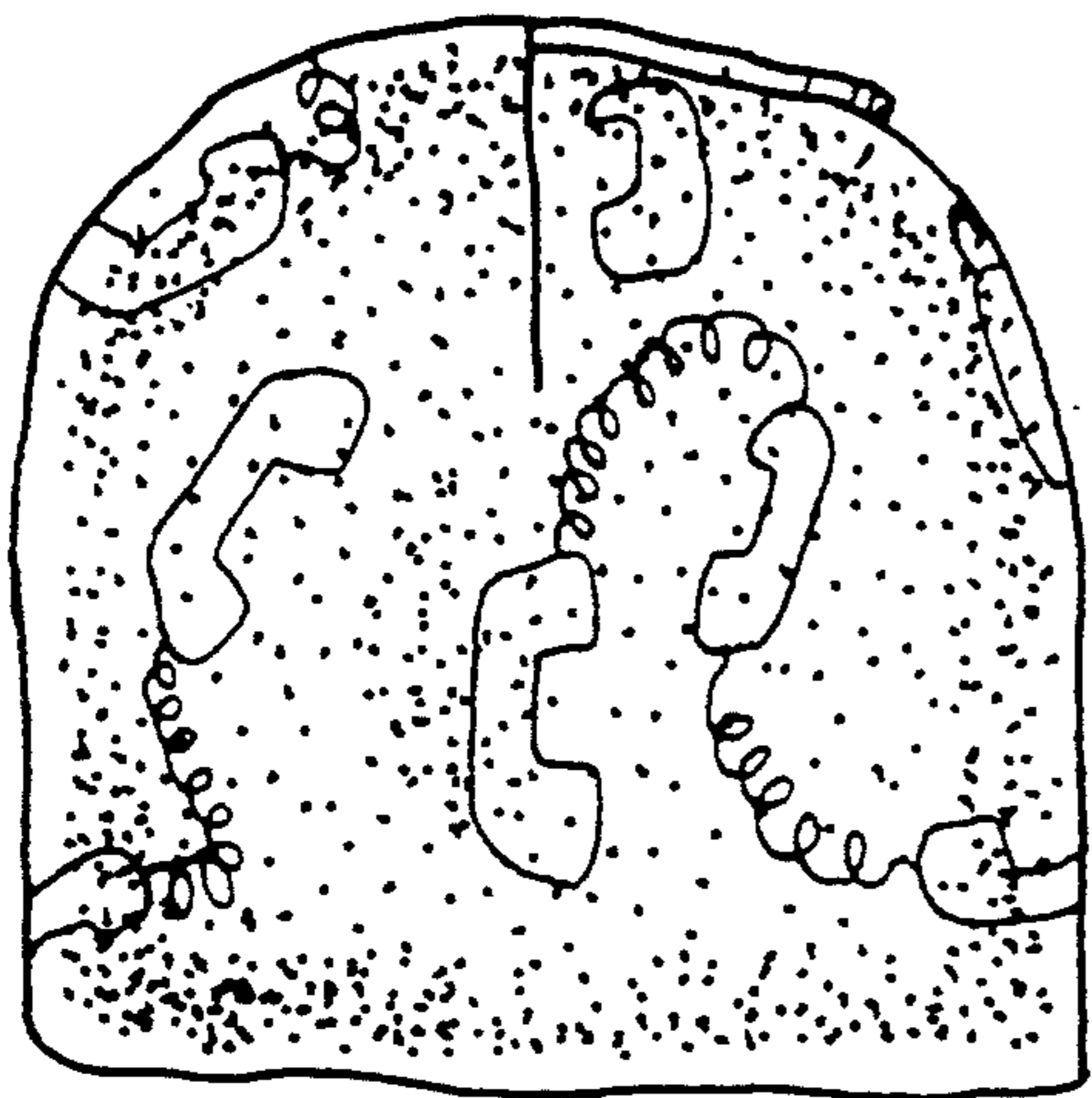

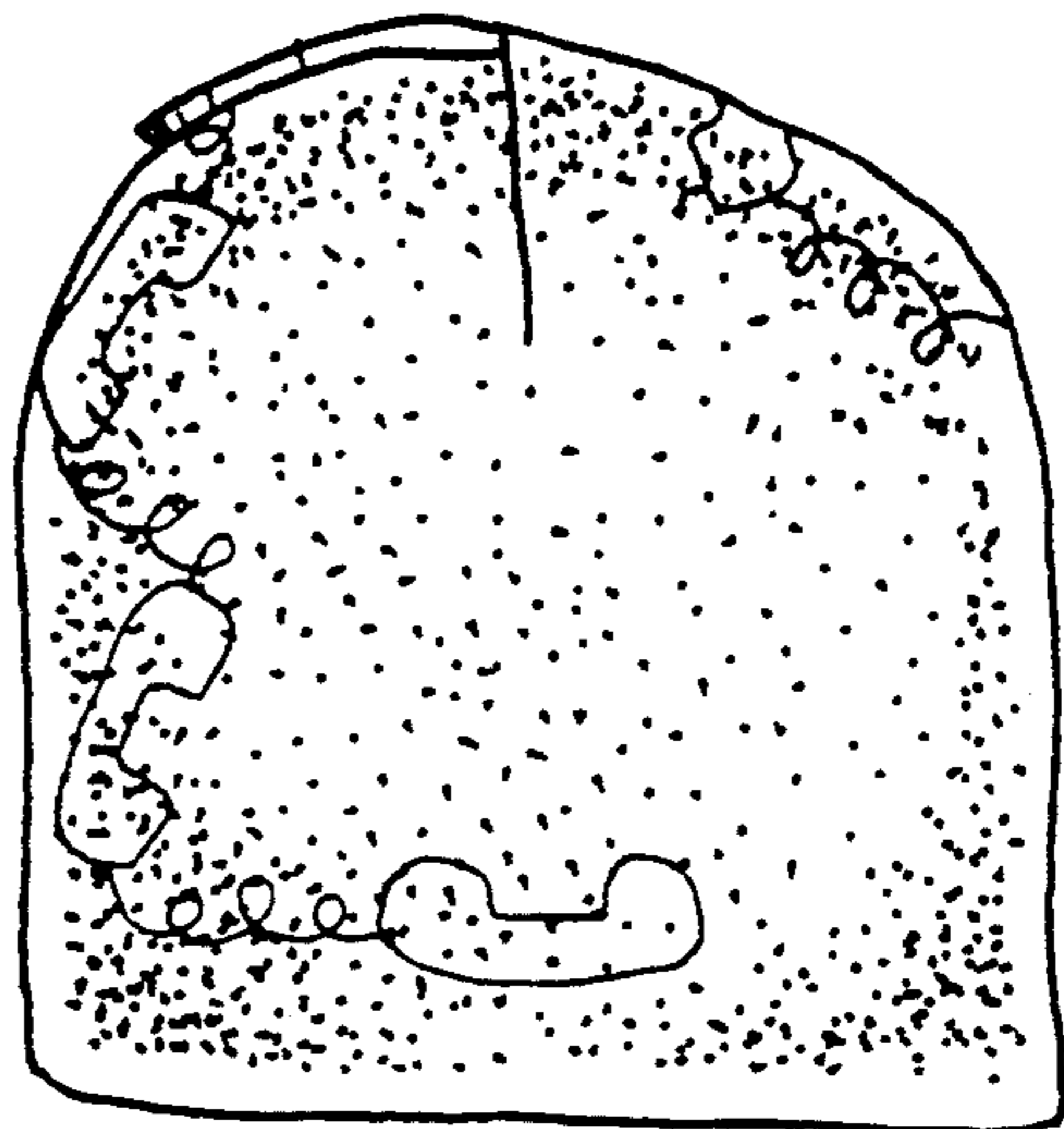

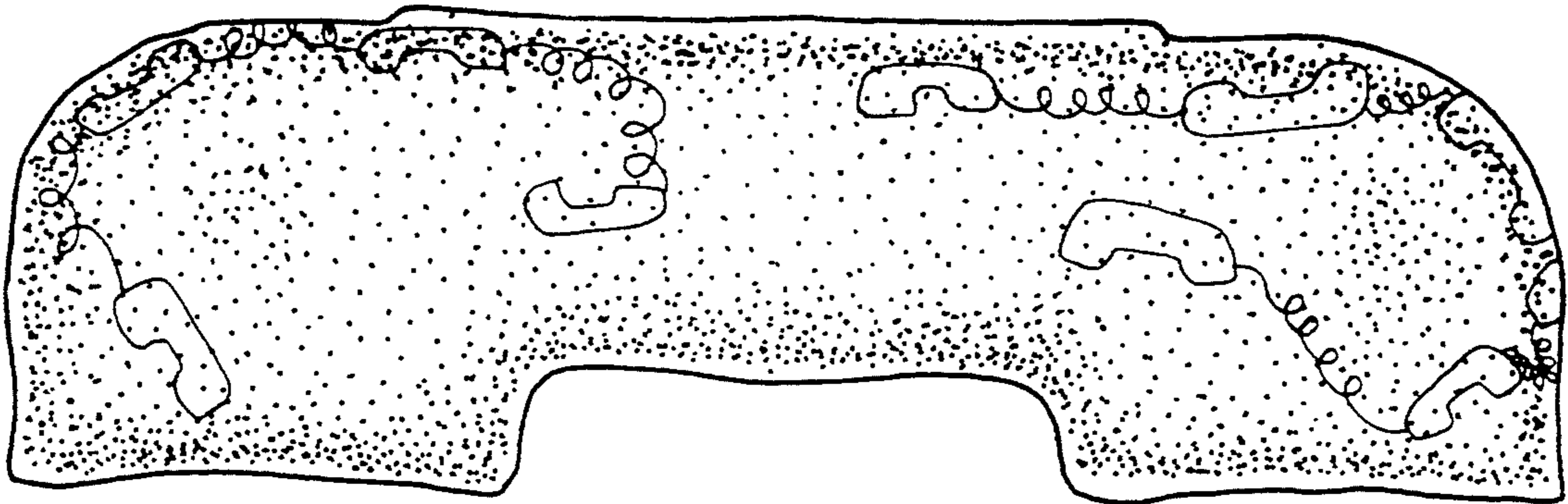

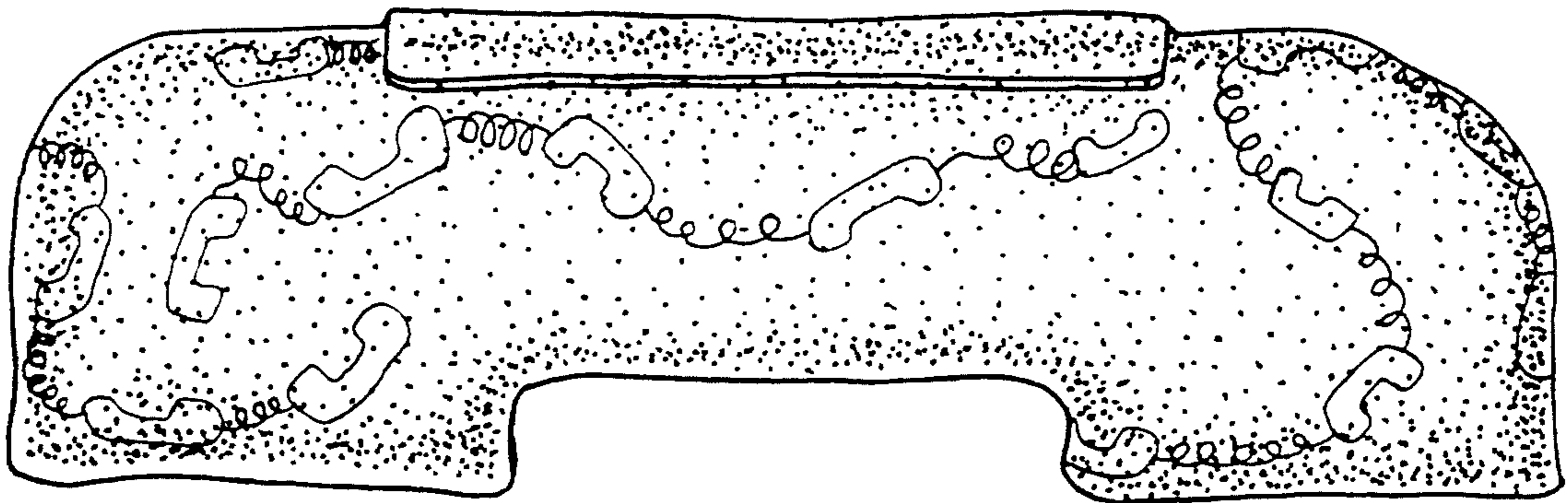

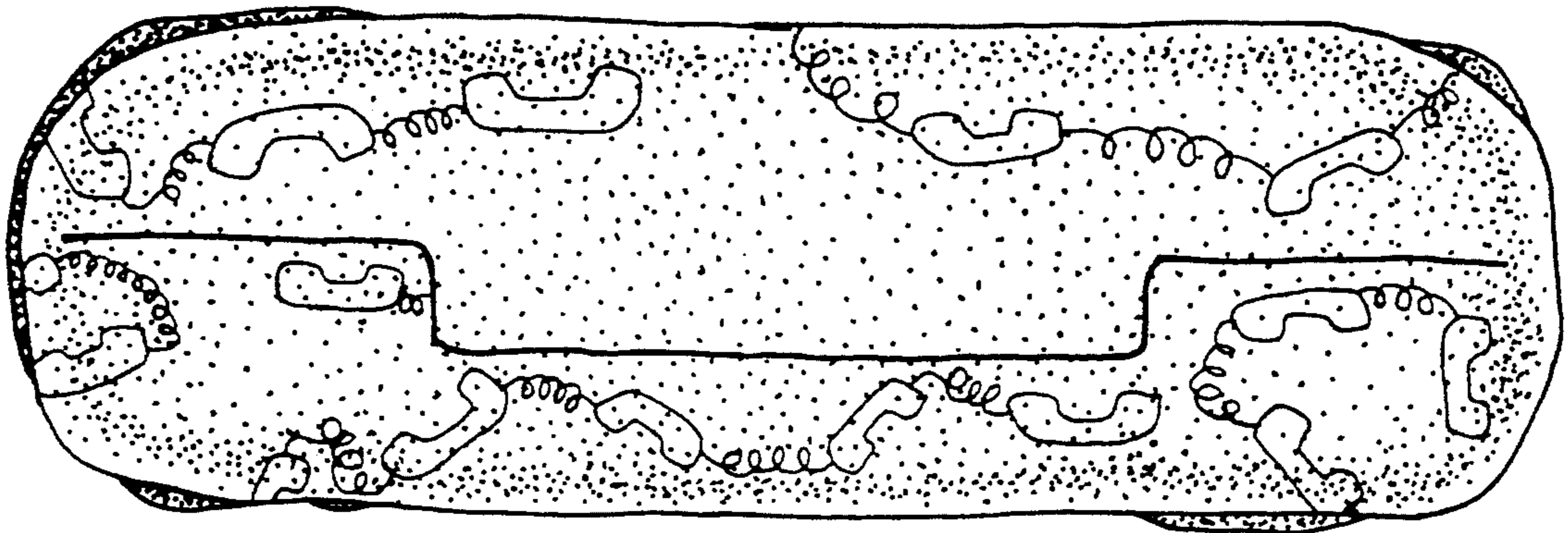

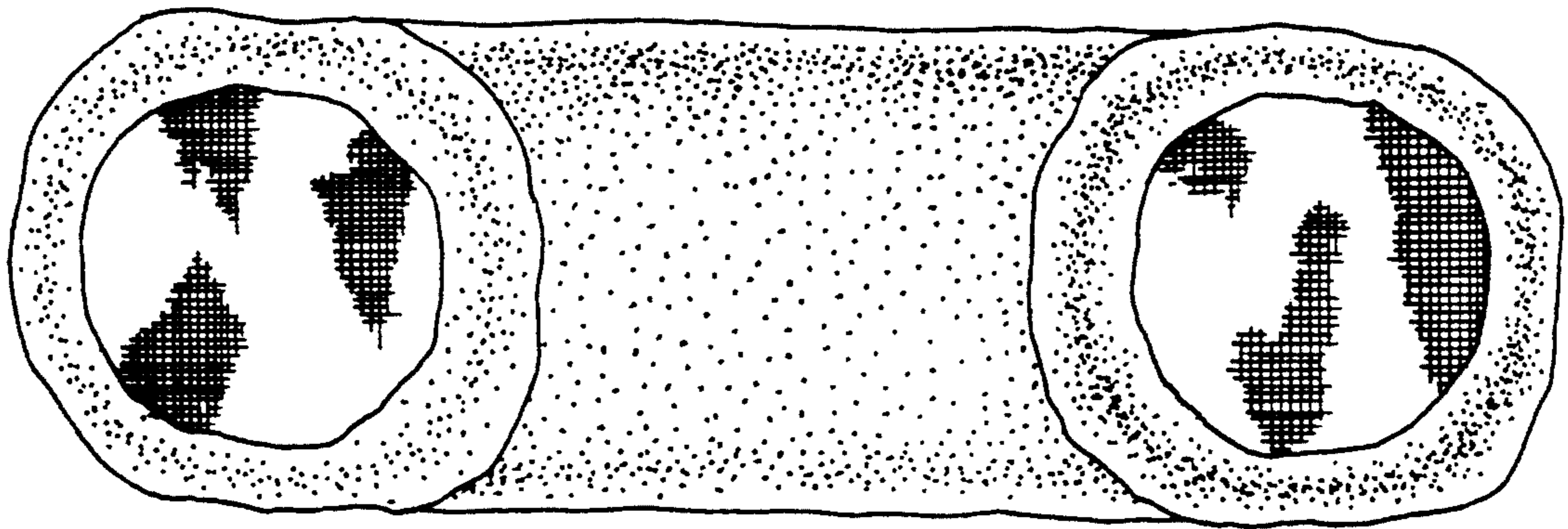
