FIG. 1 is a front, top and side perspective view of the combined compass, thermometer, time zone and clock showing my new design;

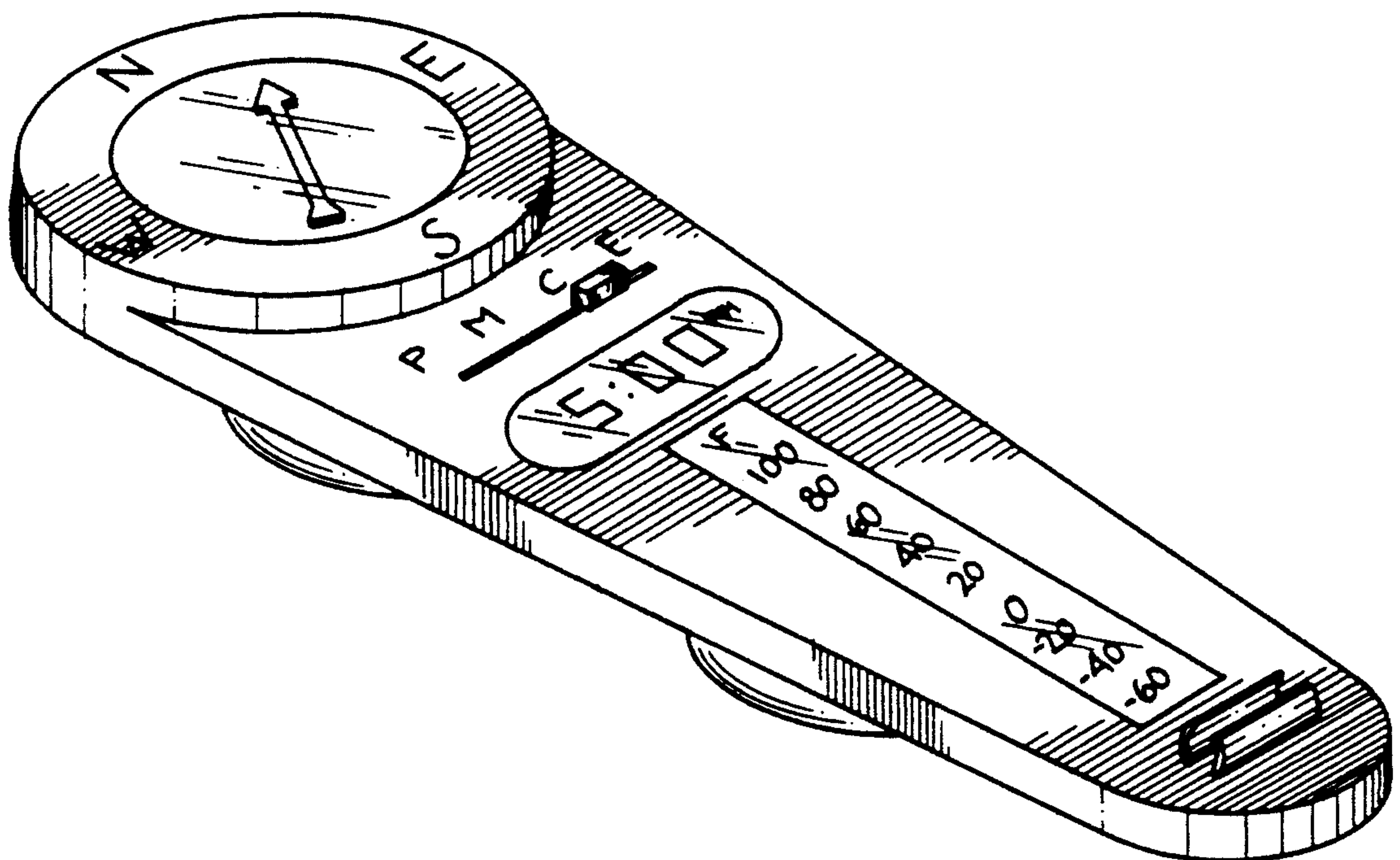
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



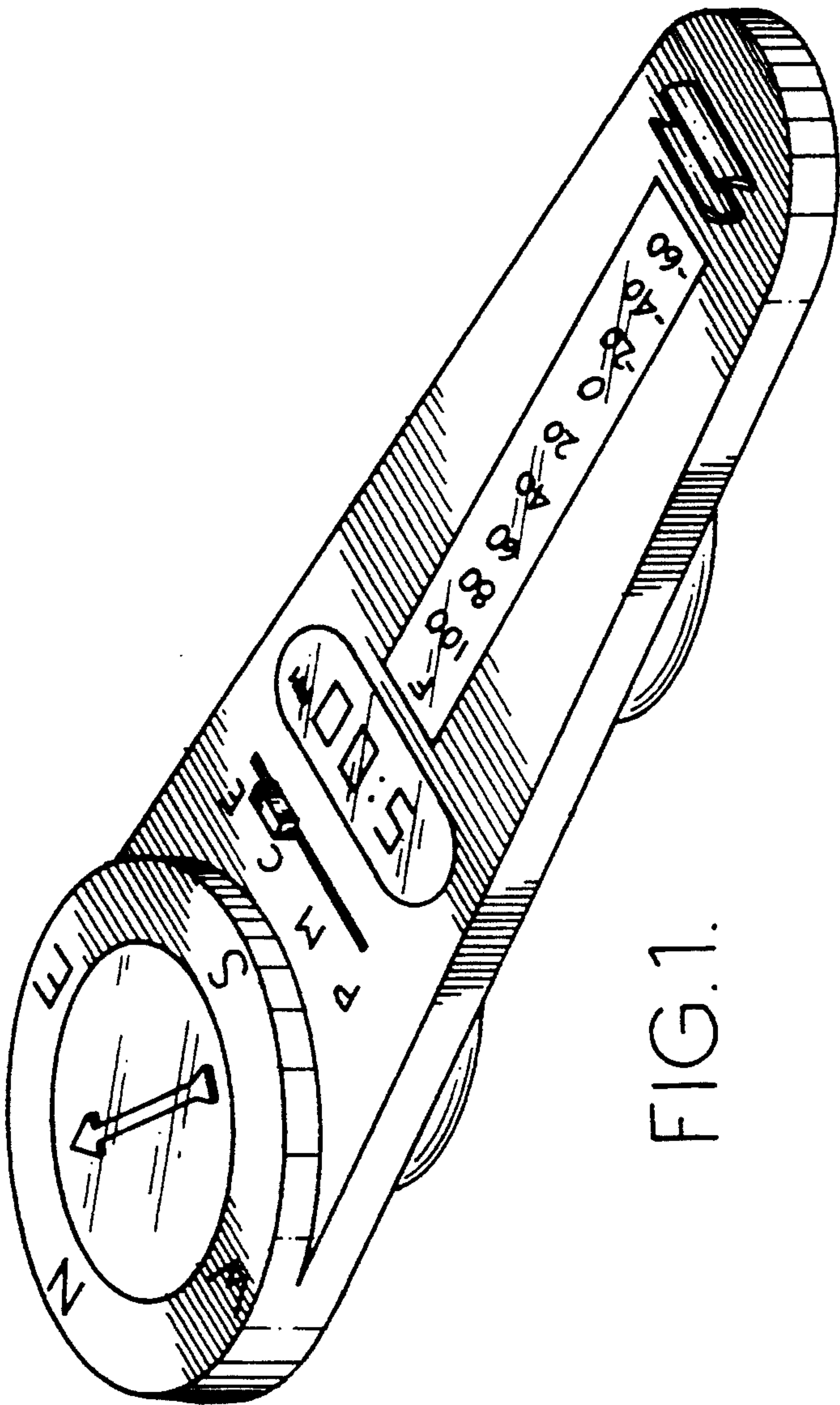

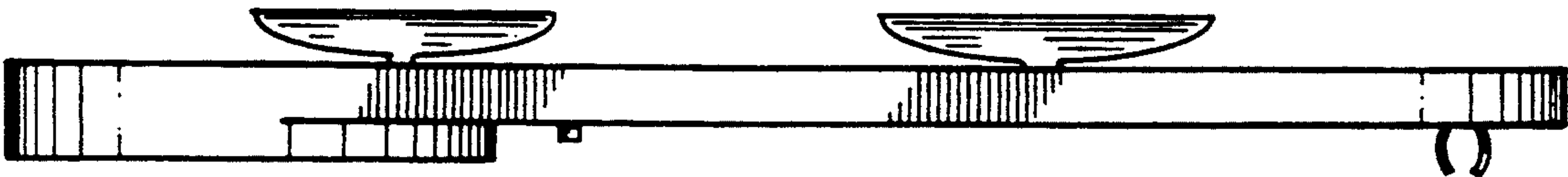

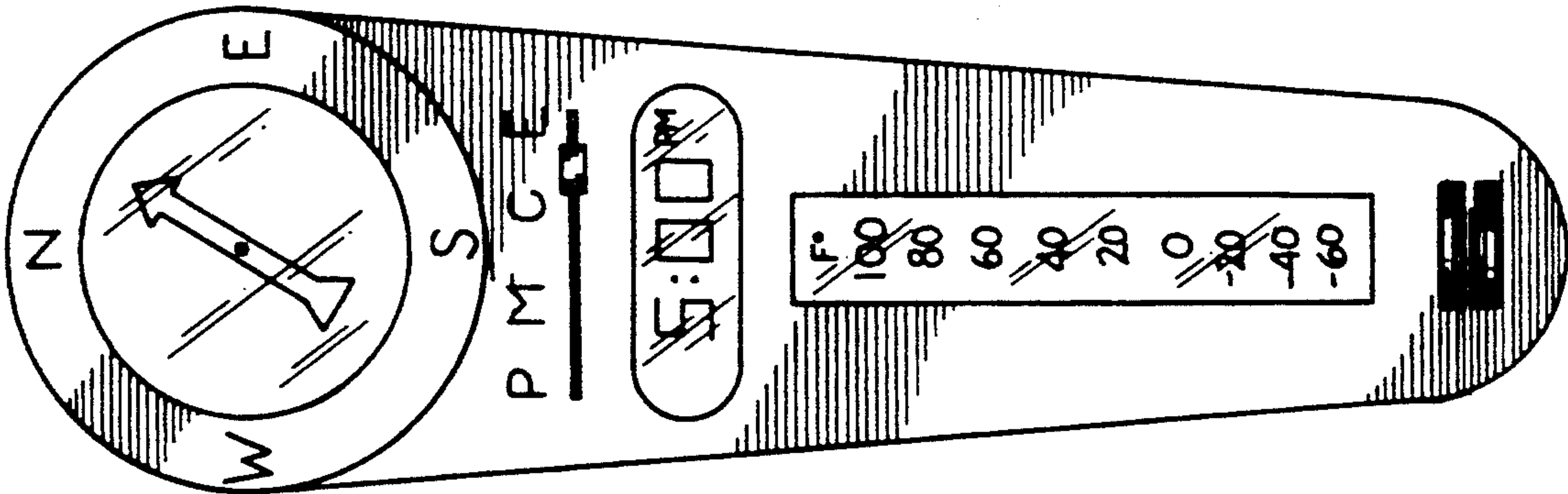

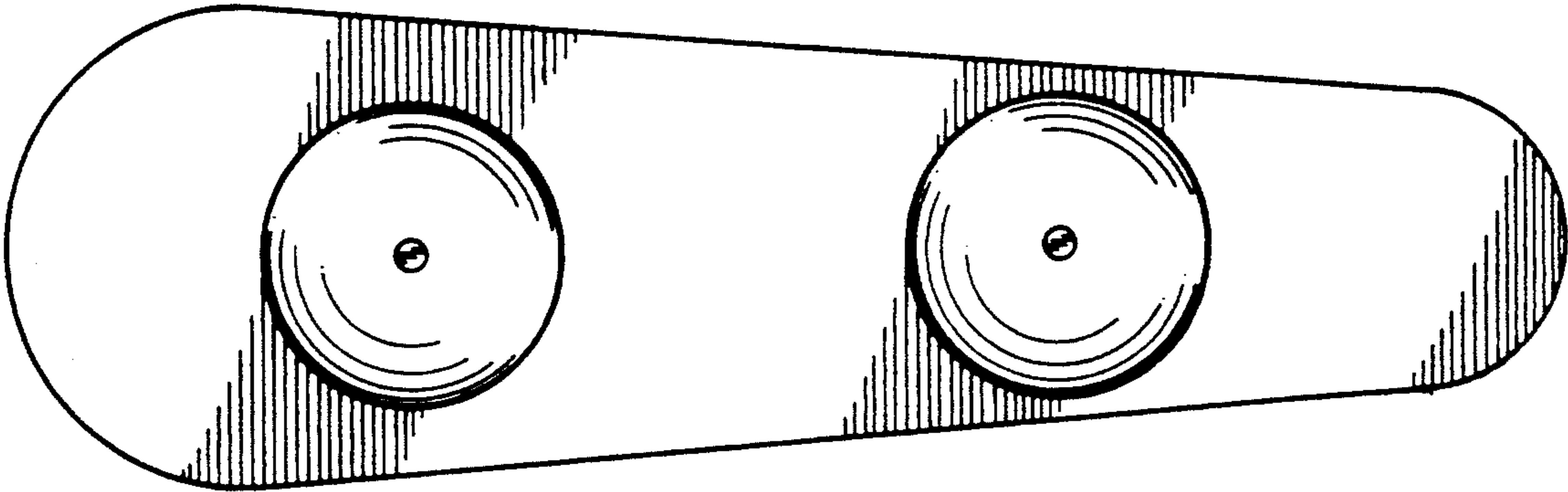

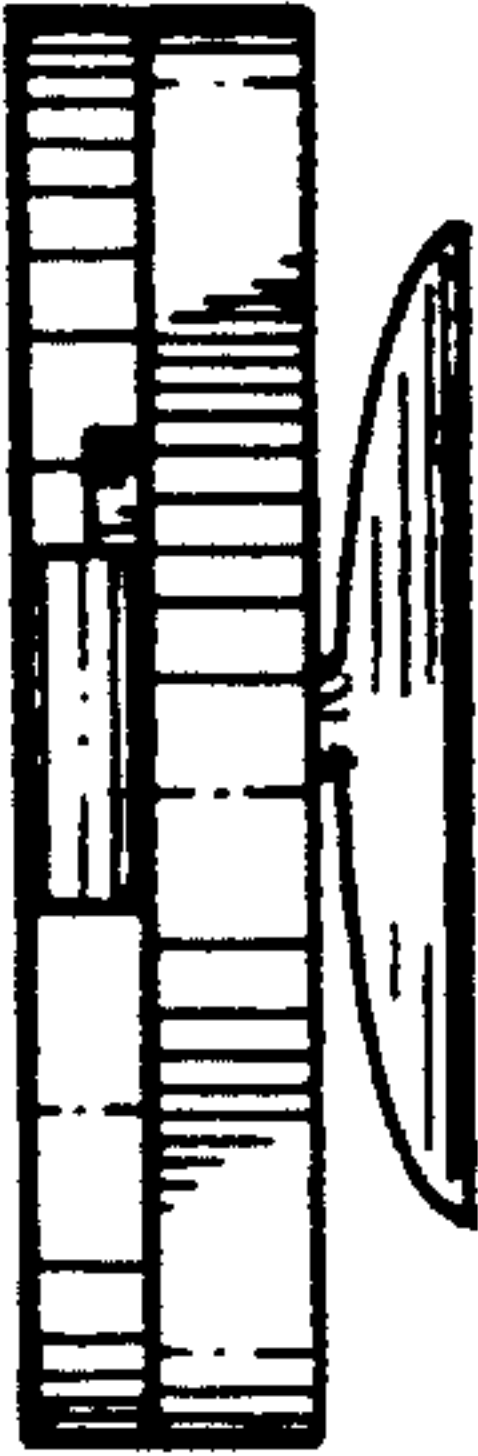
