[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a medieval sword in stone game, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a medieval sword in stone game showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
