[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an interior suspension lamp,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the interior suspension lamp from below;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the interior suspension lamp;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the interior suspension lamp;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the interior suspension lamp;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 1 showing a second embodiment of the interior suspension lamp;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view similar to FIG. 2 showing a second embodiment of the interior suspension lamp;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view similar to FIG. 3 showing a second embodiment of the interior suspension lamp; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom view similar to FIG. 4 showing a second embodiment of the interior suspension lamp.

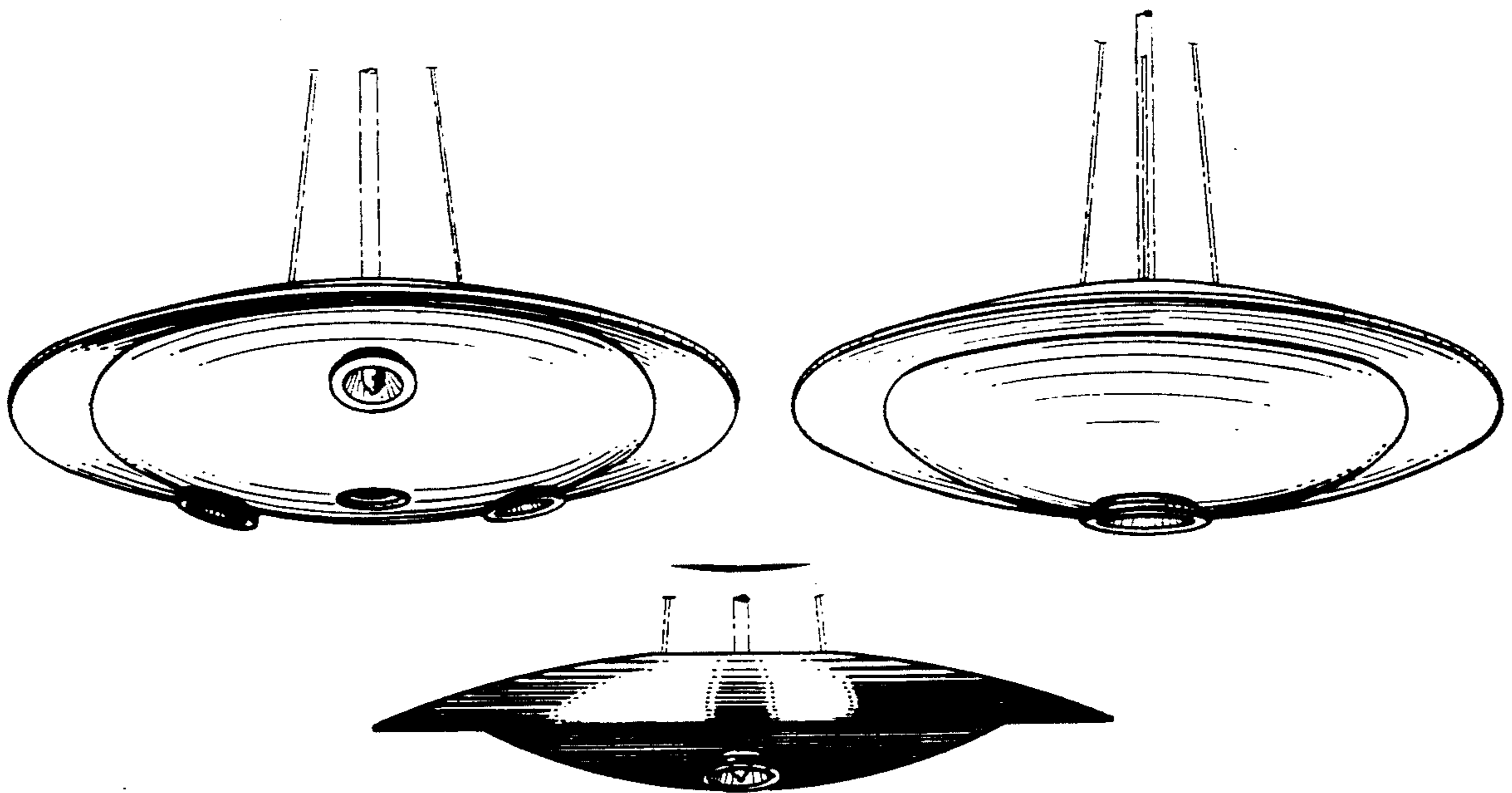

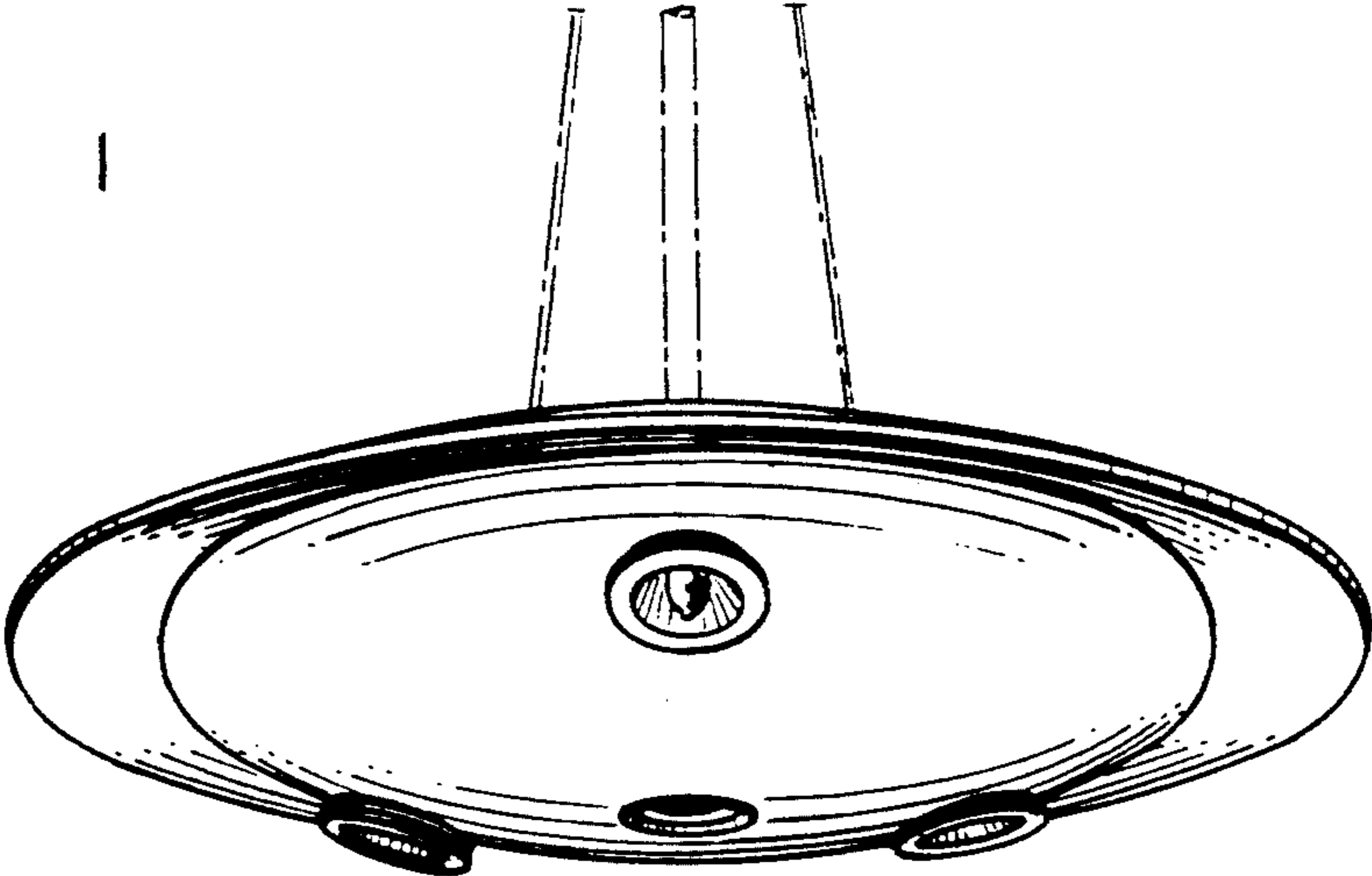

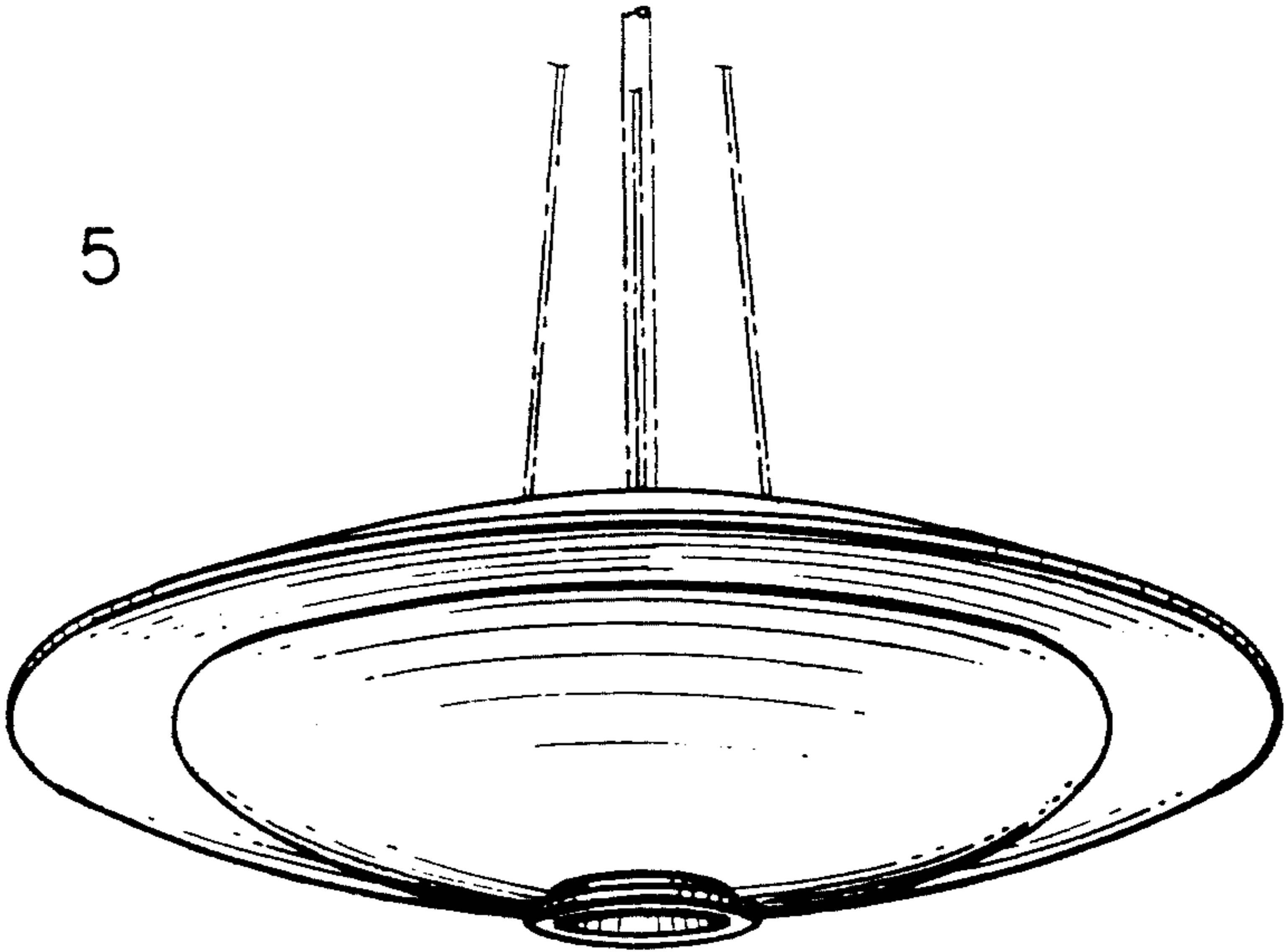

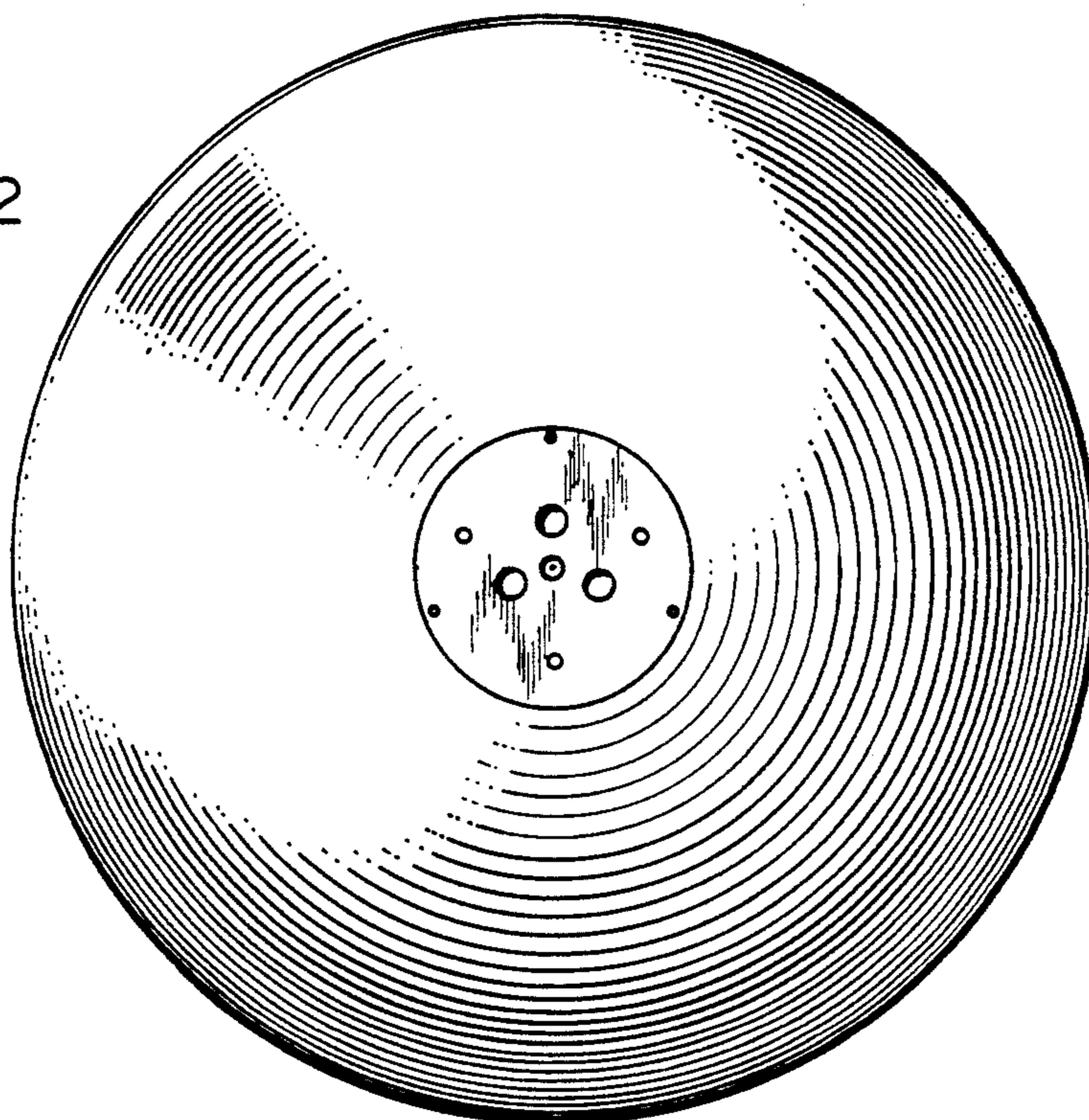

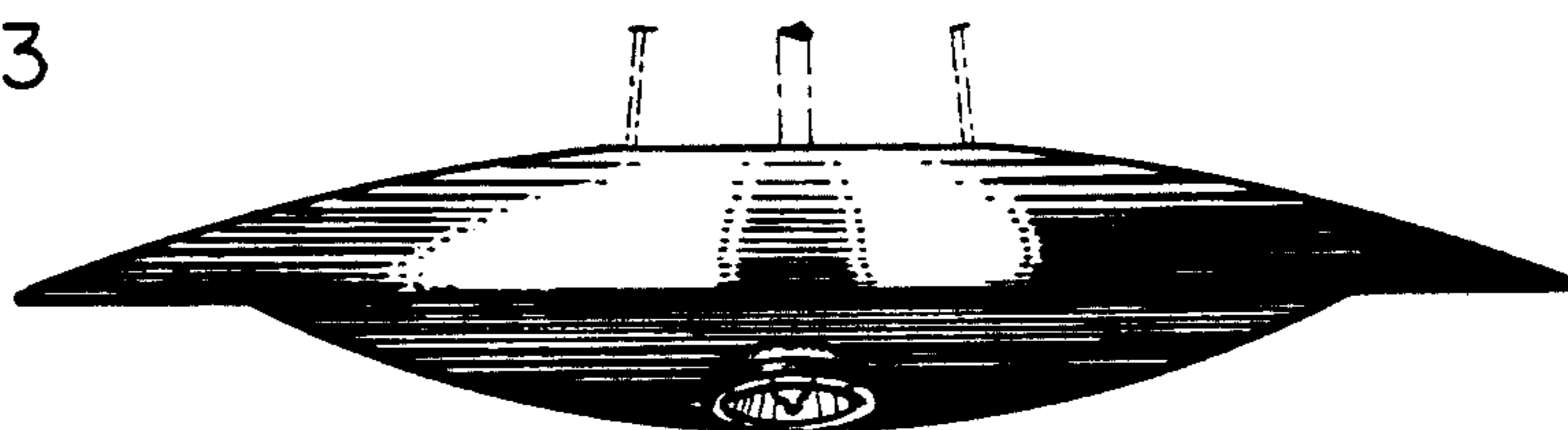

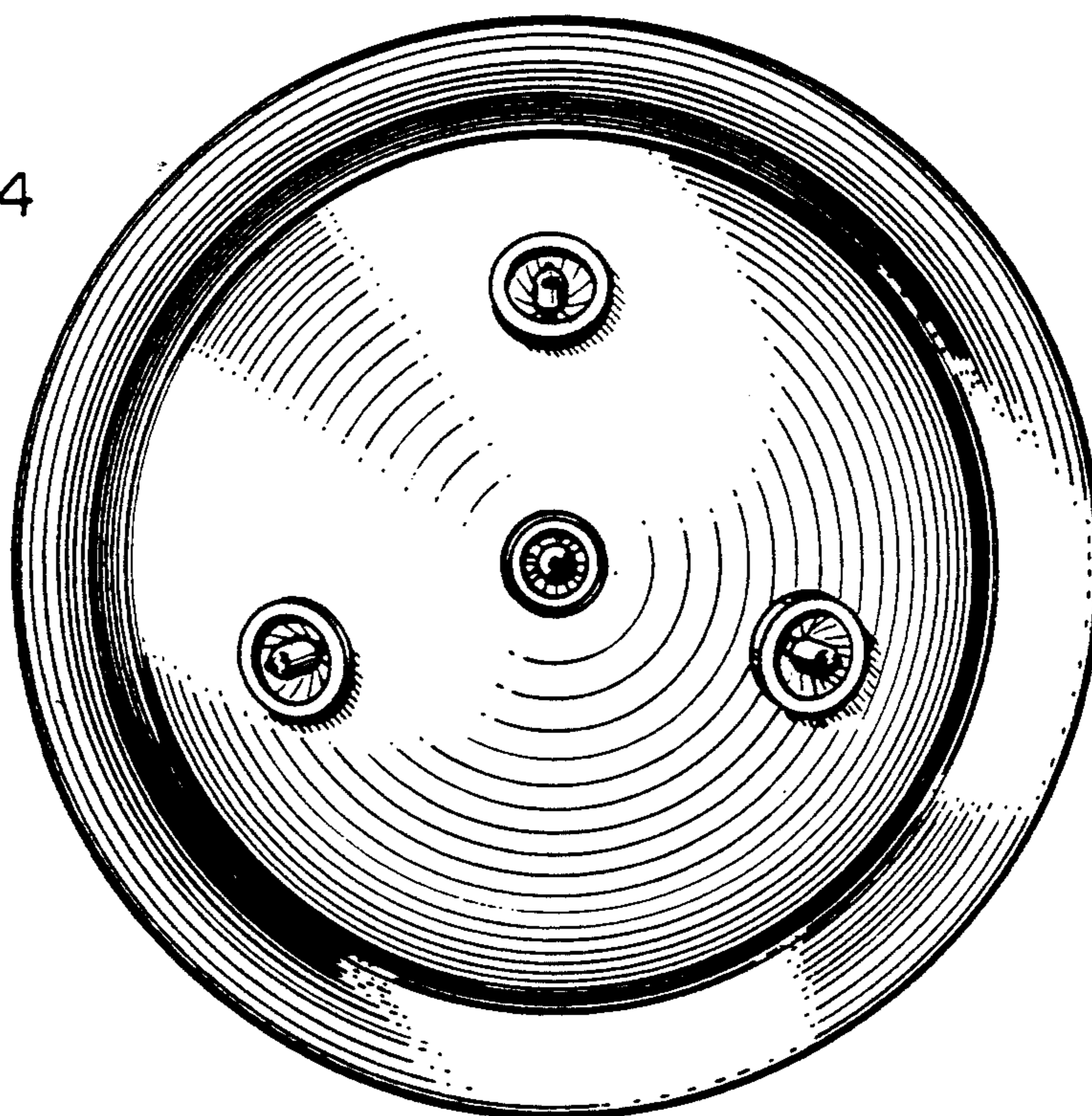

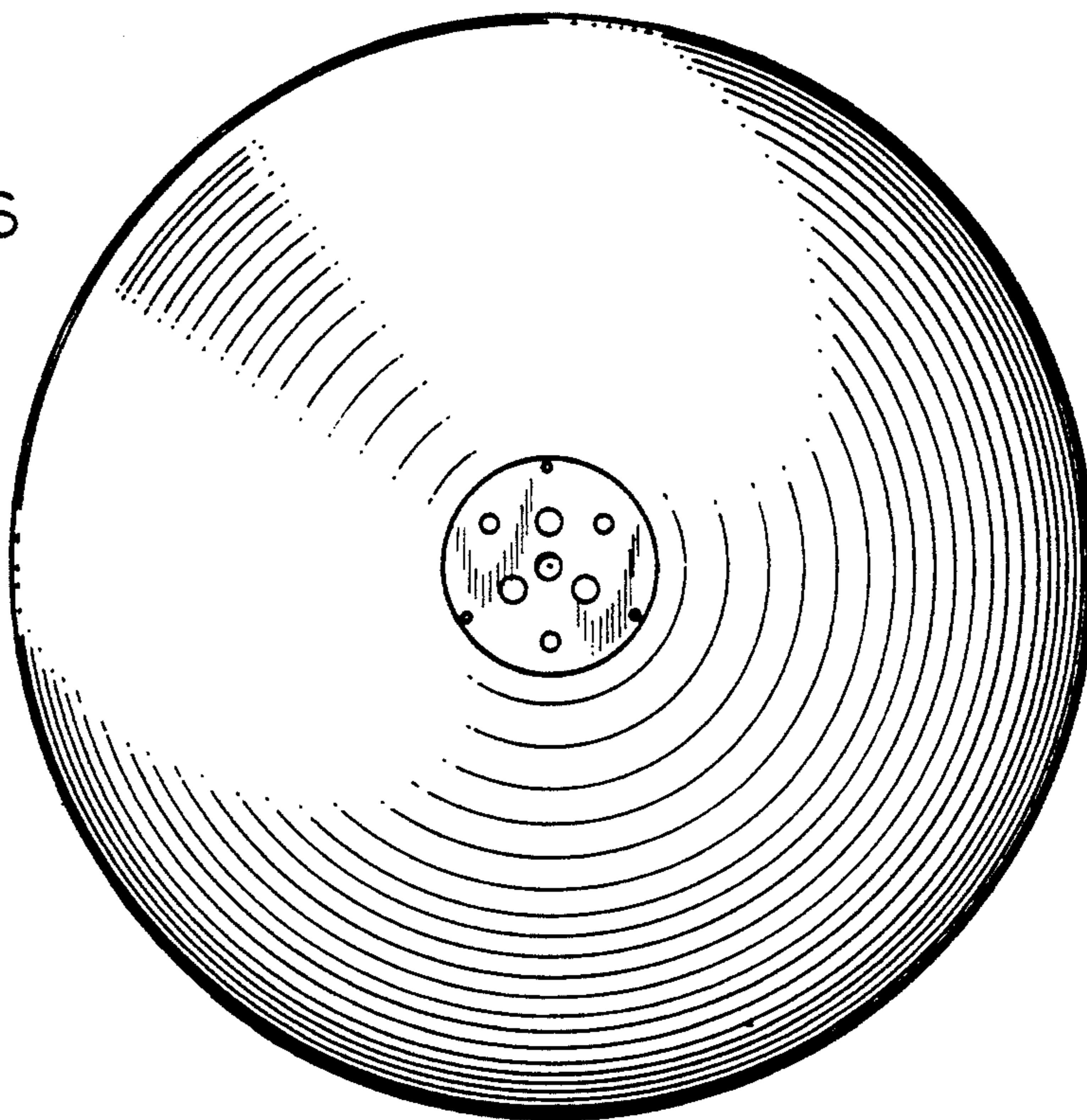

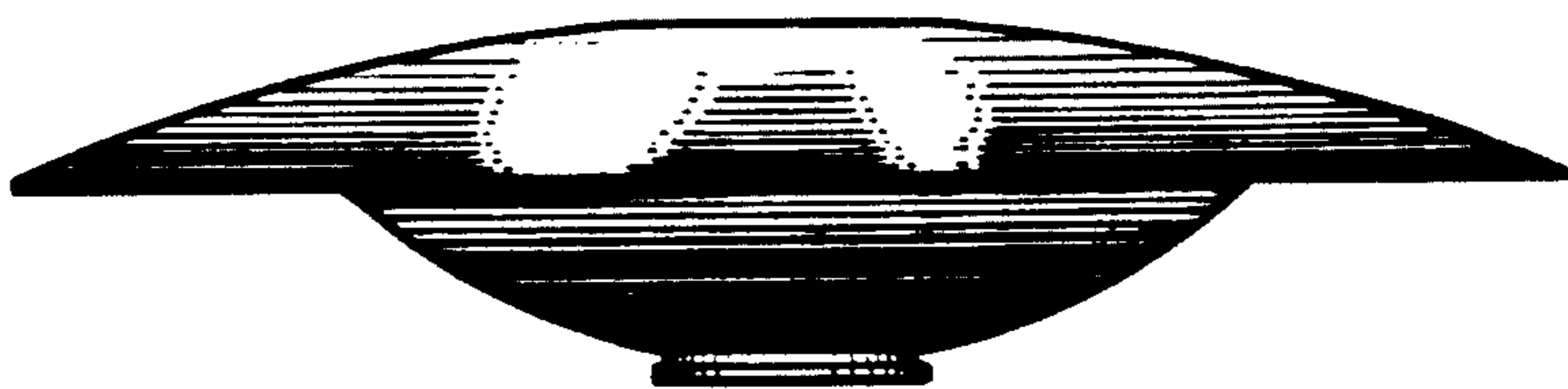
