FIG. 9 is an end elevational view thereof, corresponding to the end elevational view of FIG. 4 but with the toothbrush in its position of use.

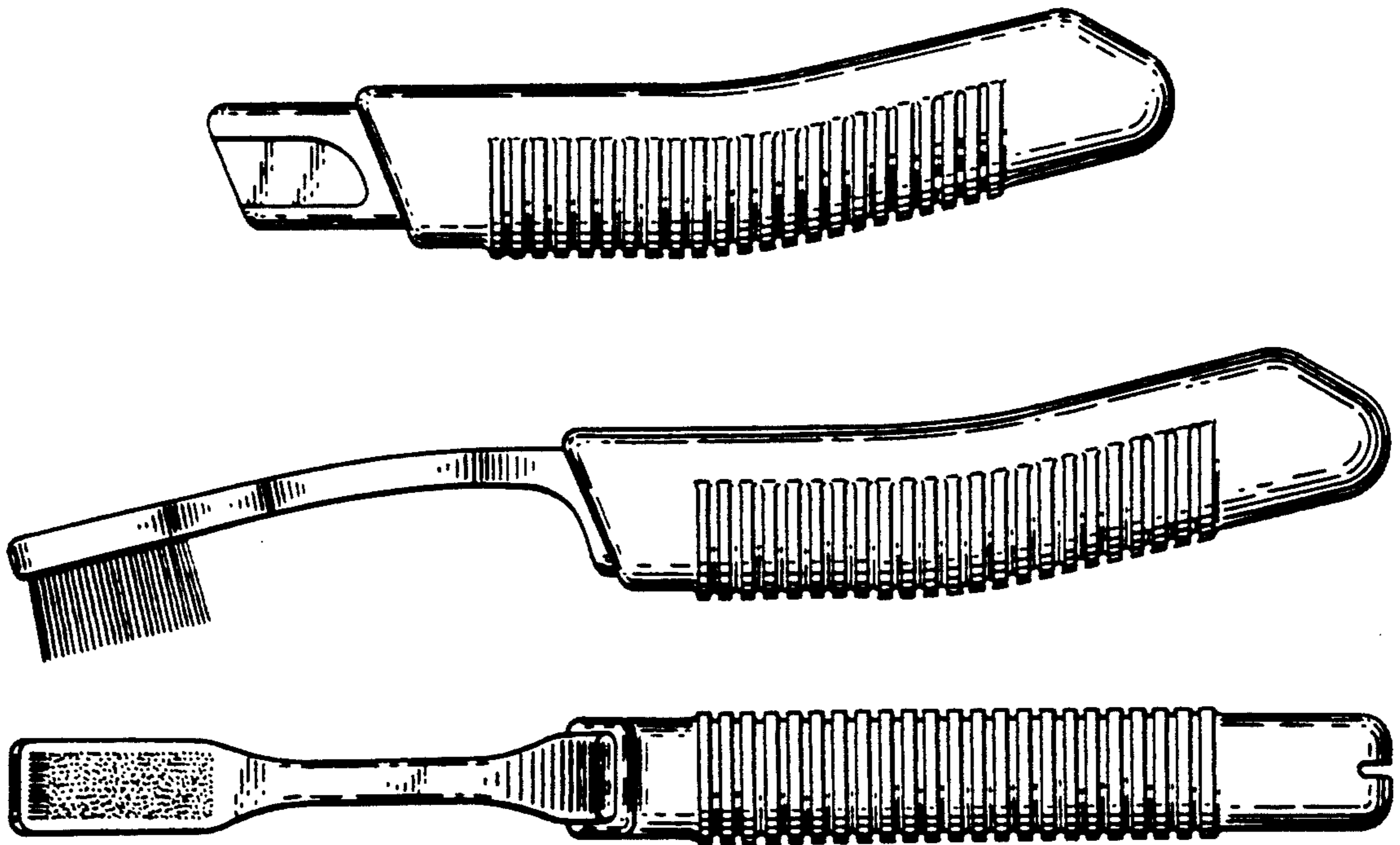

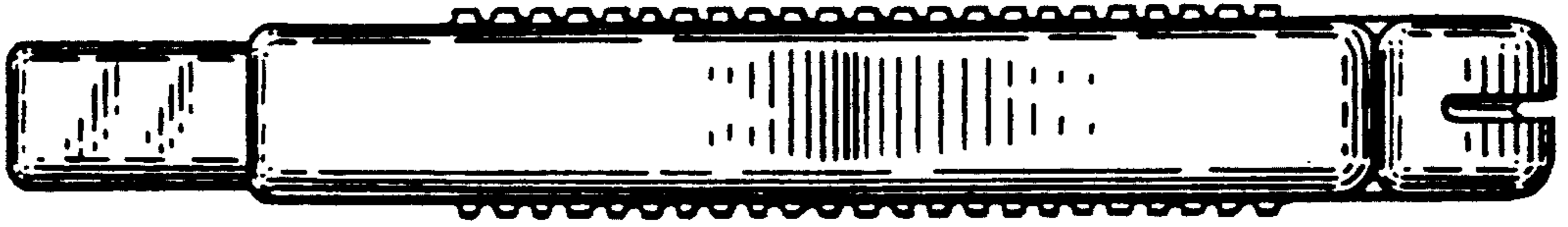

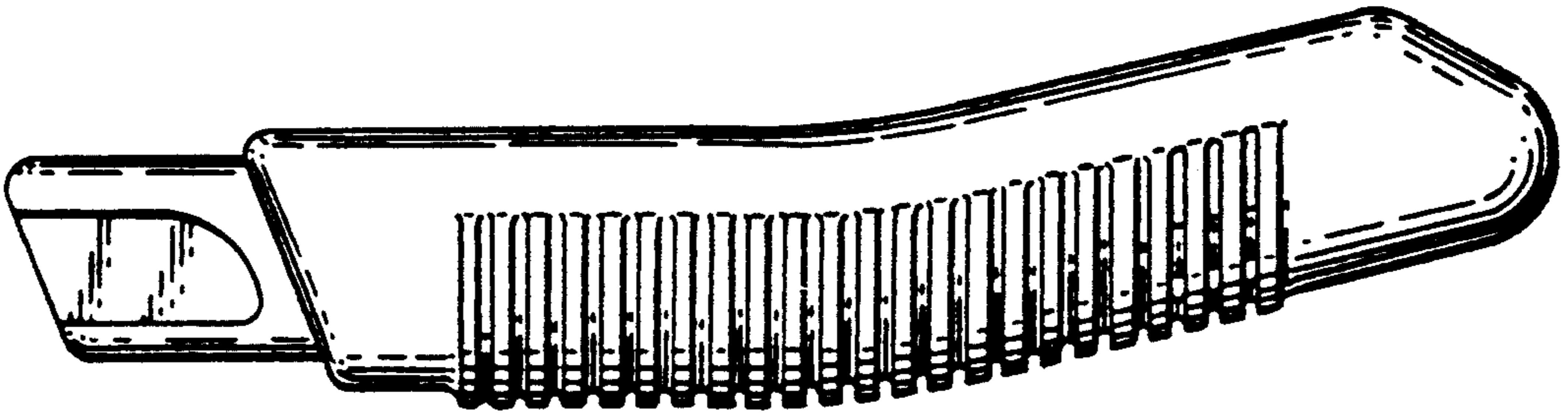

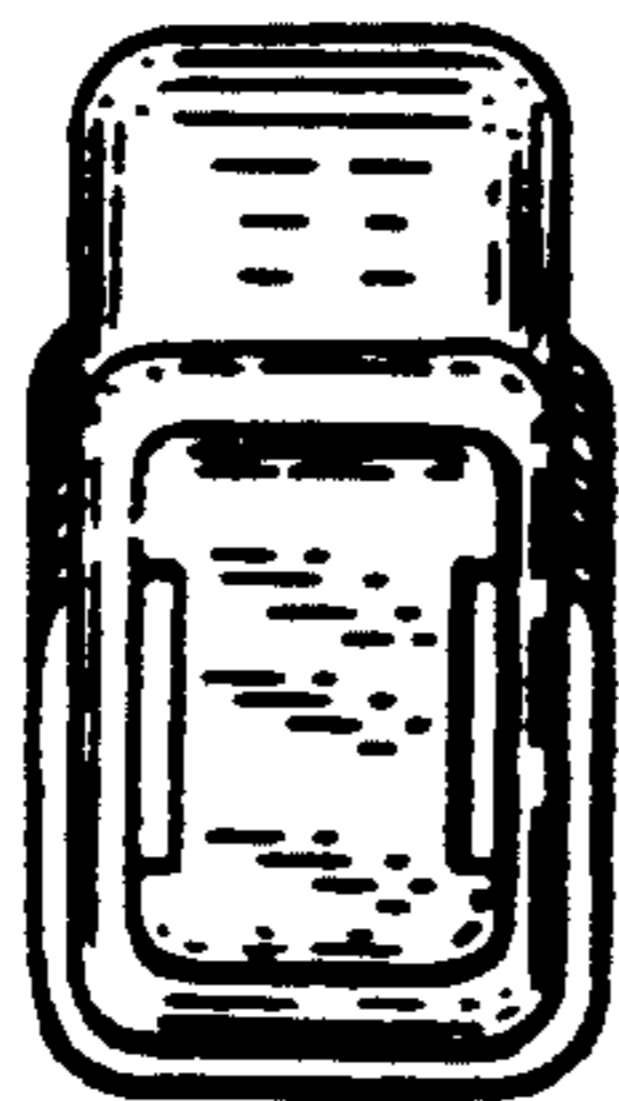
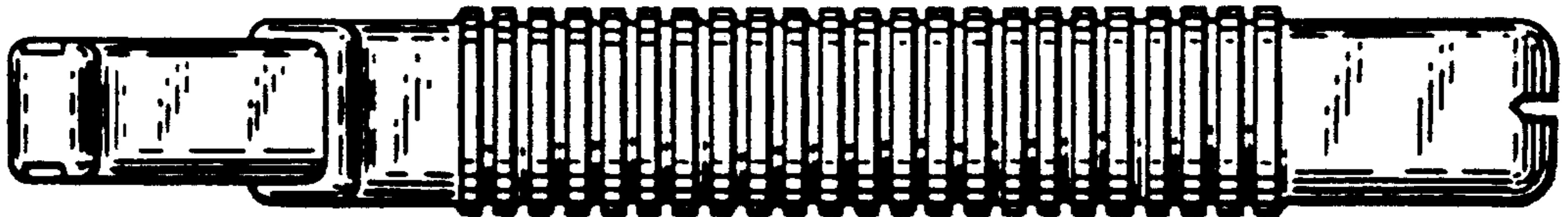

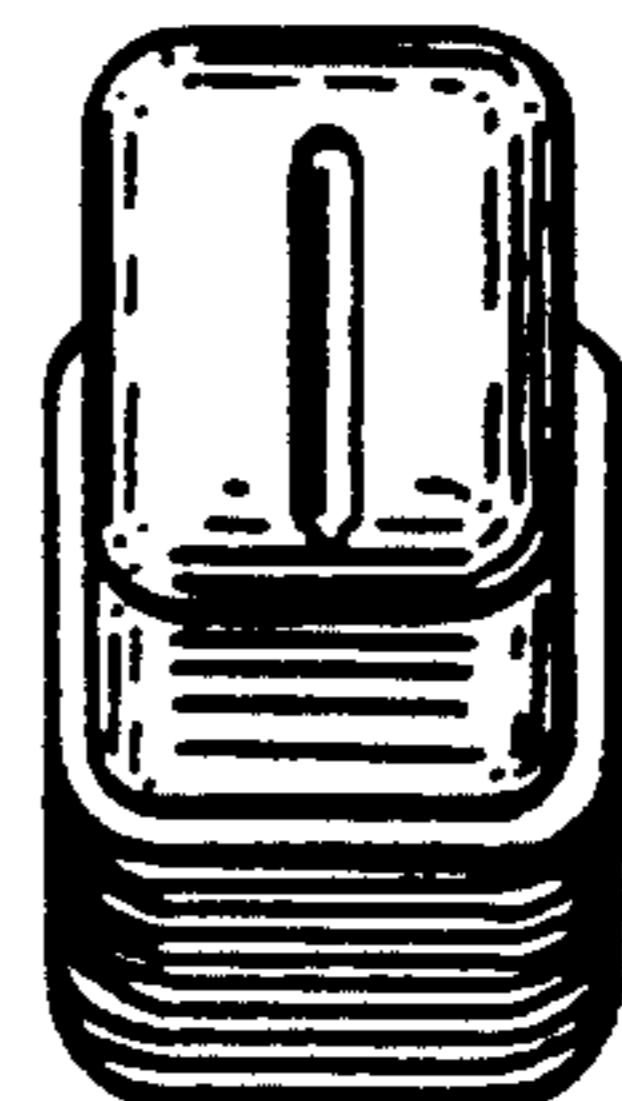

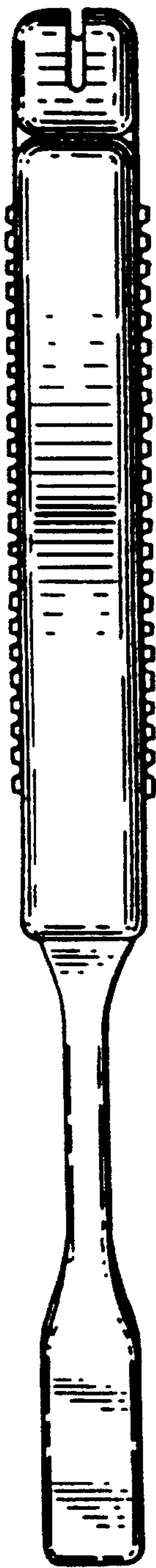

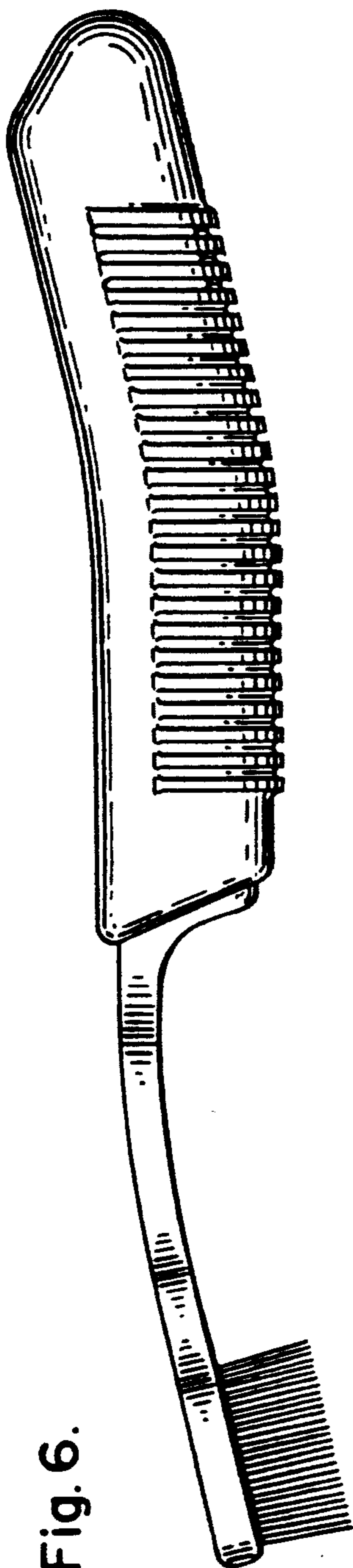

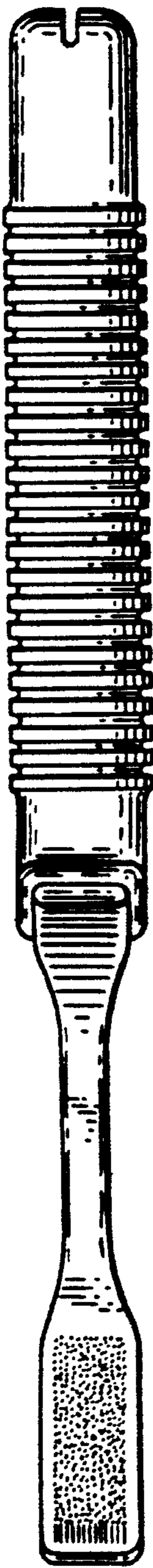
