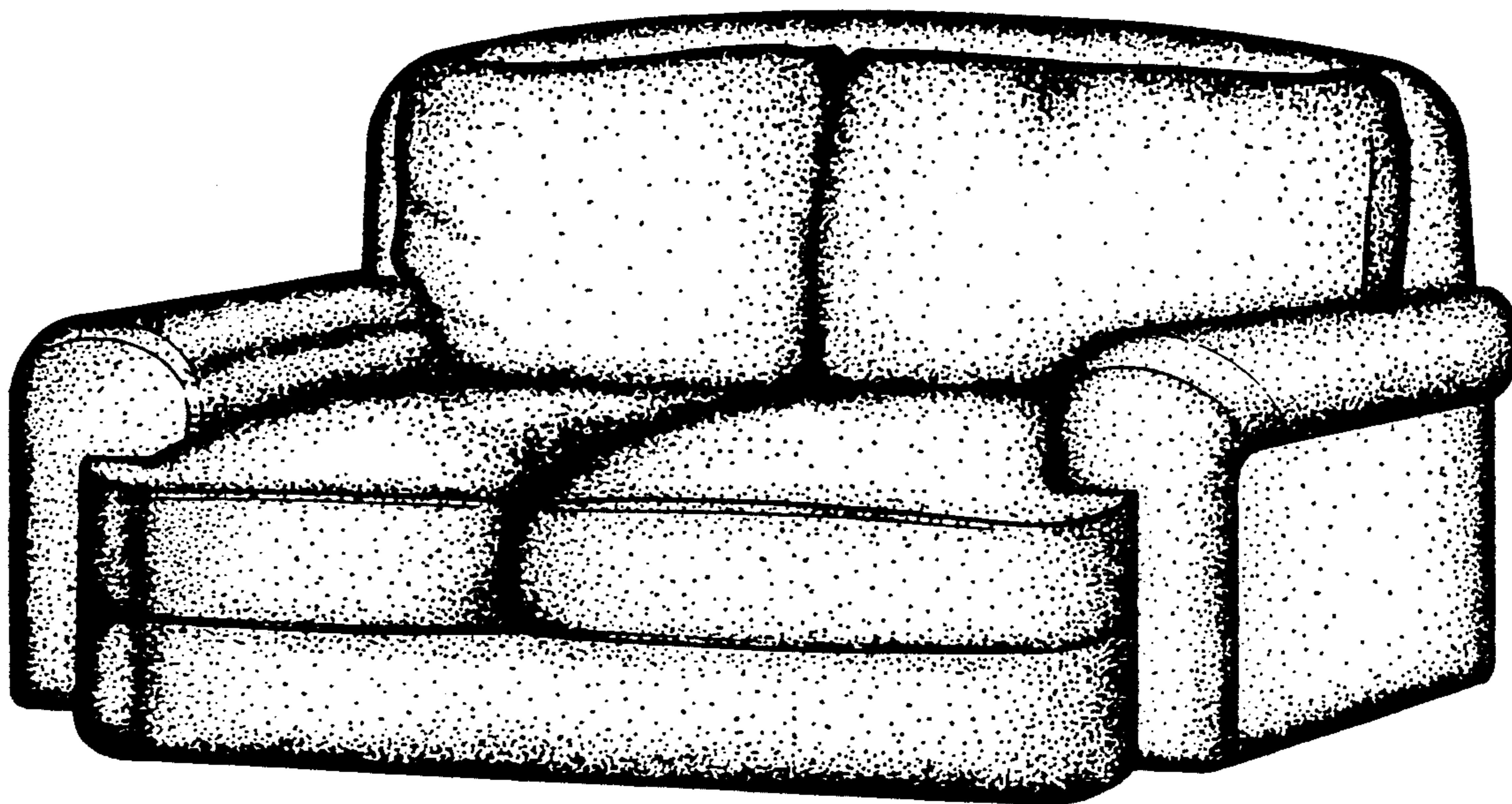

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a seat showing my design;  
FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a side plan view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; and,  
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a seat showing my new design.  
The bottom and rear views not shown are plain and unornamented.



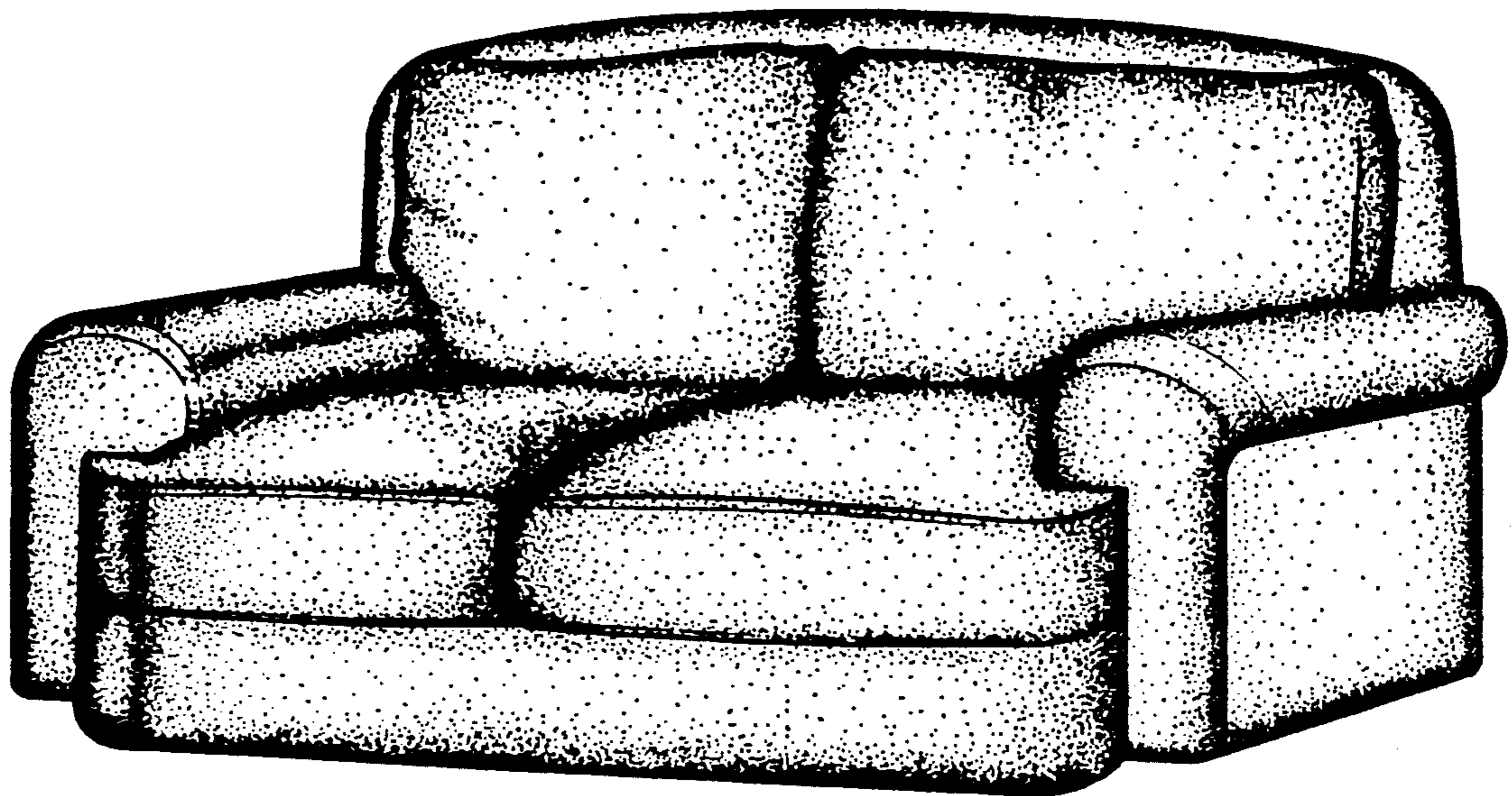

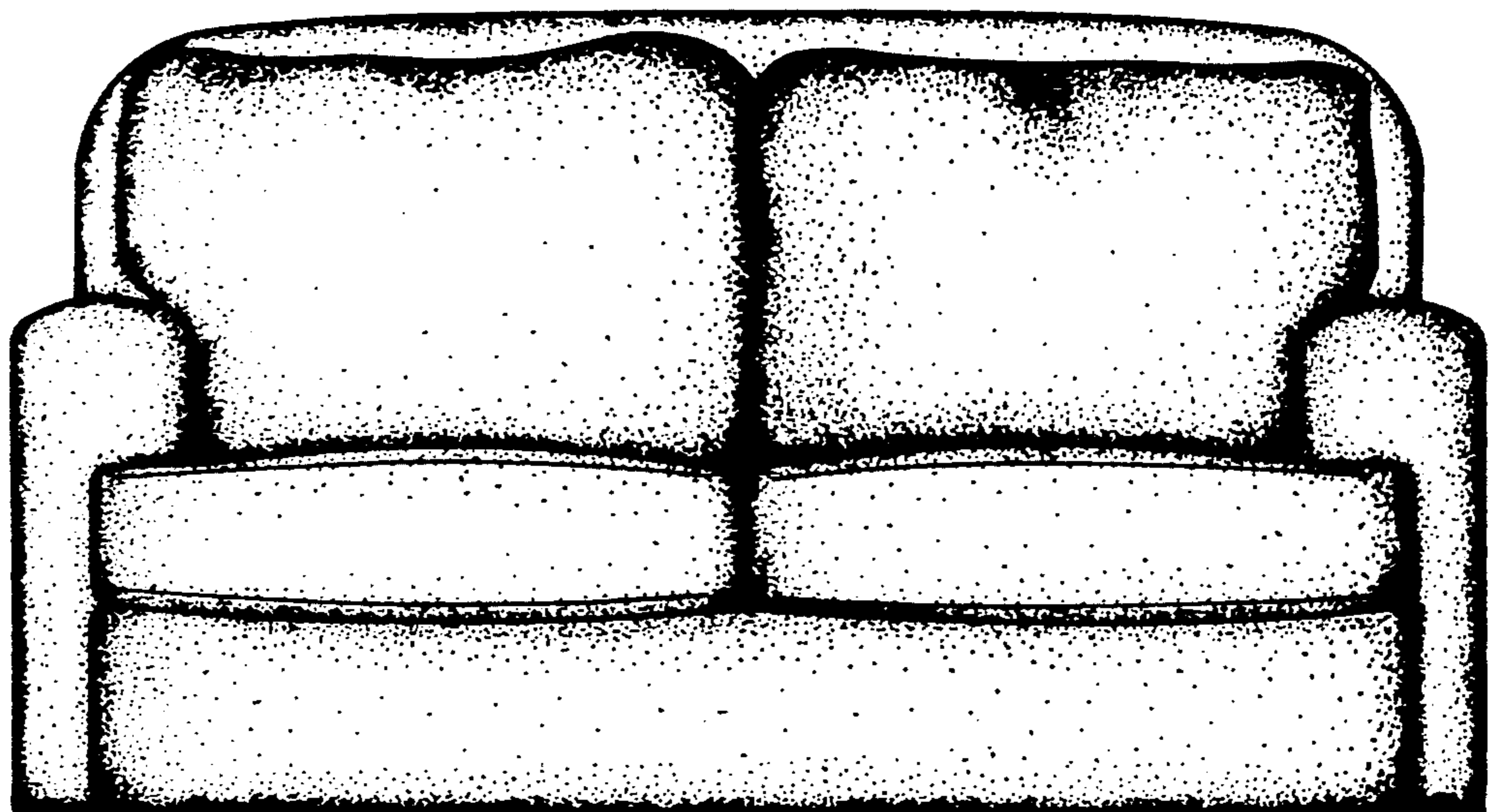

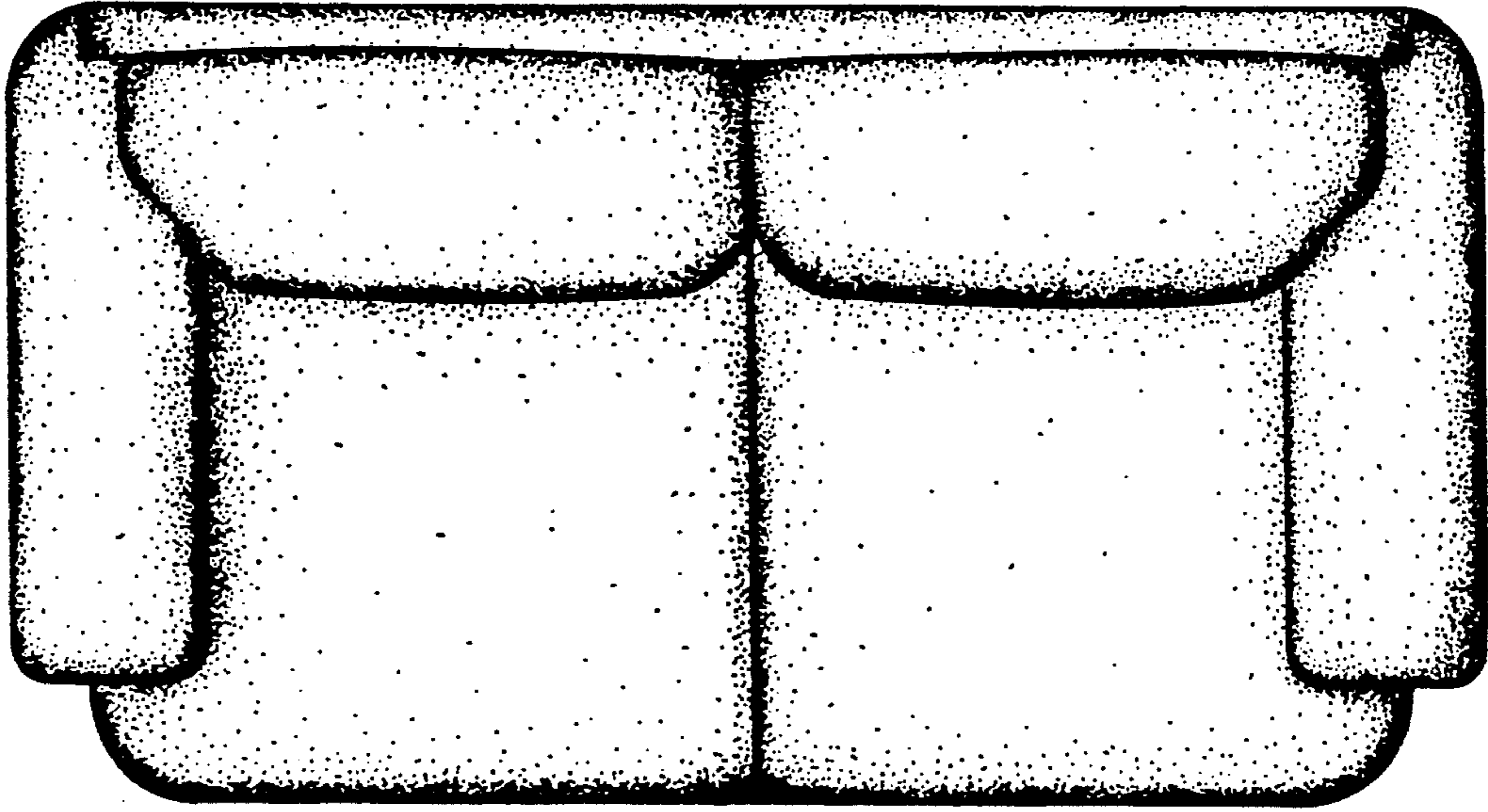

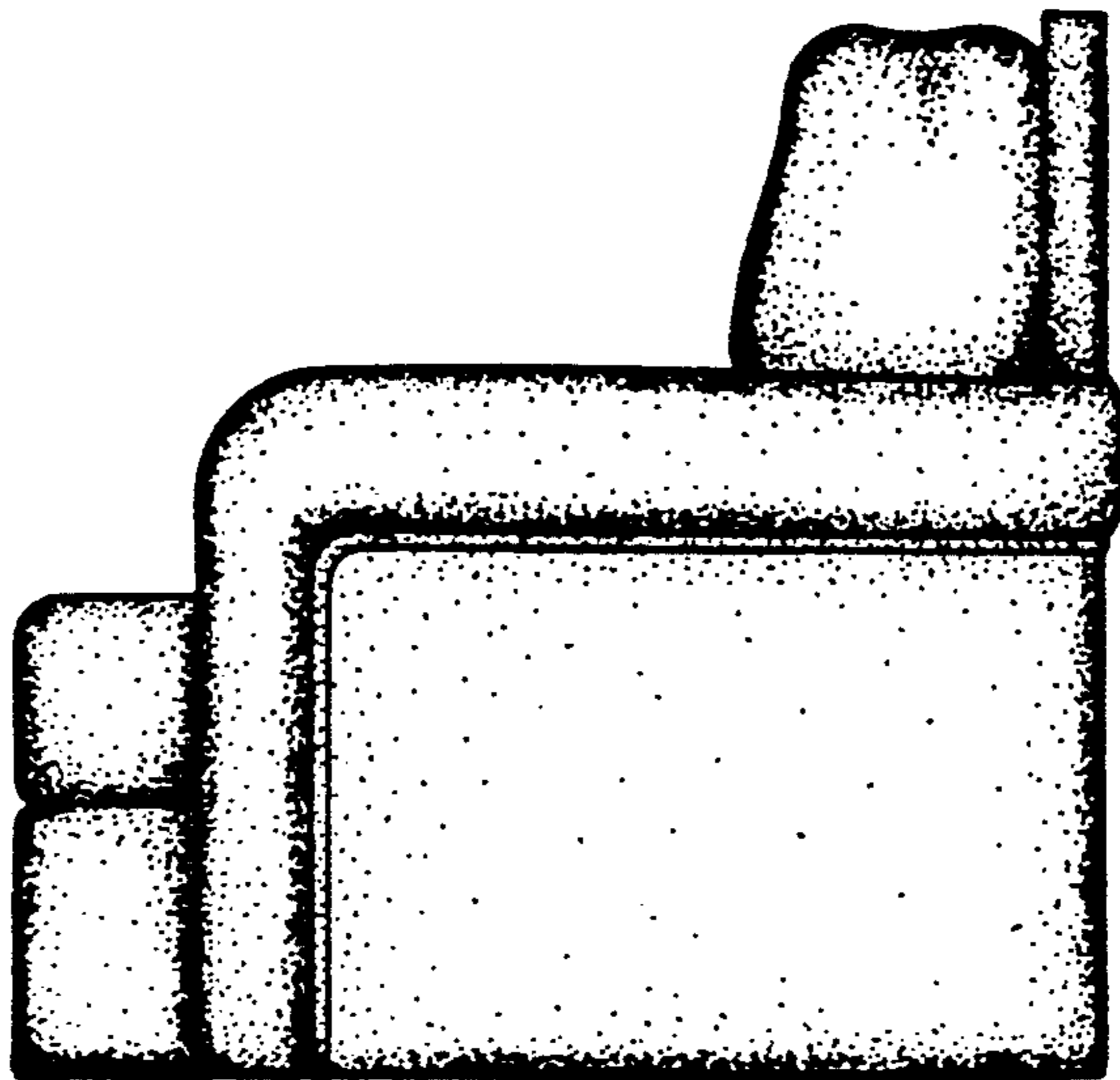

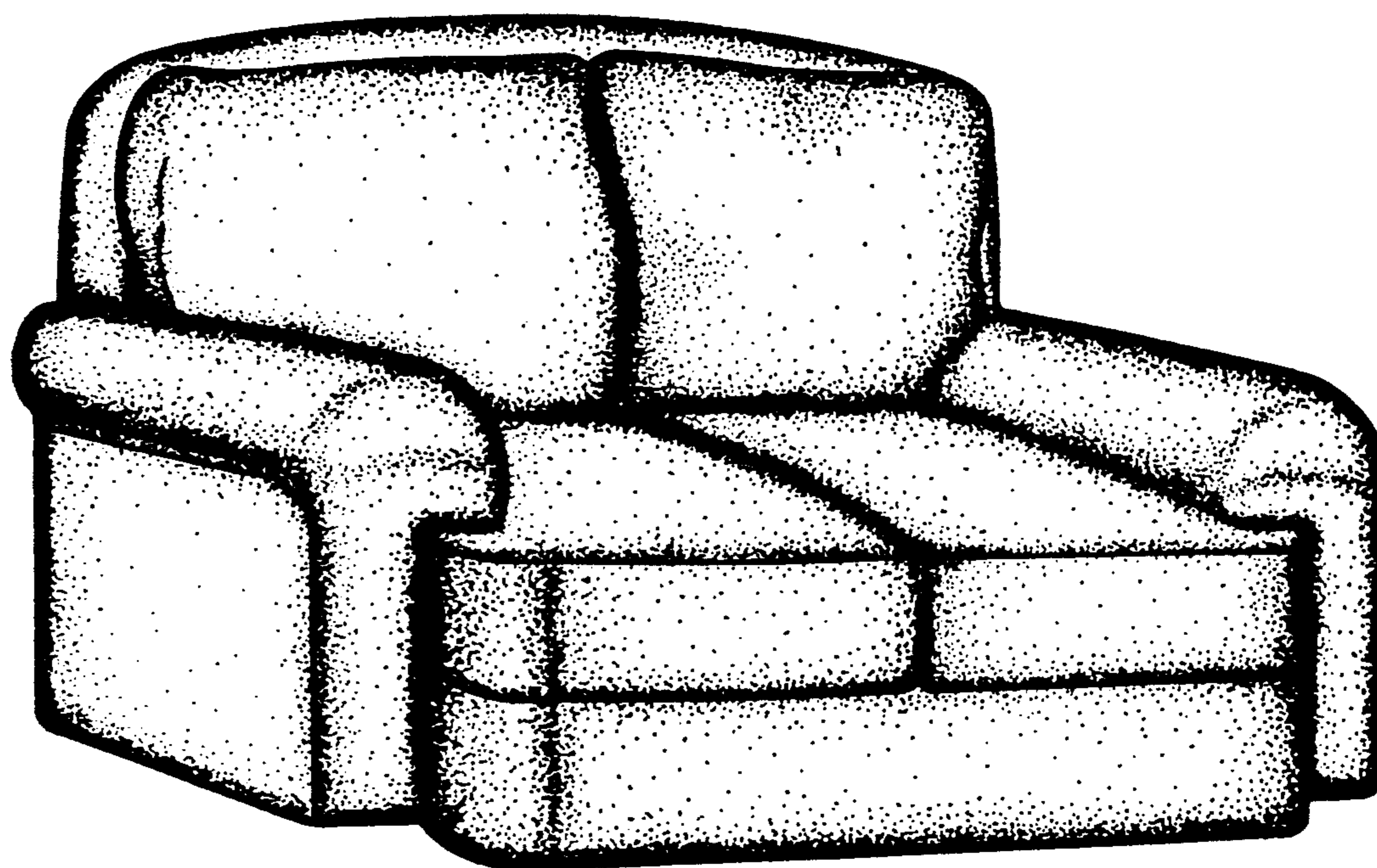
