FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a utility truck body showing our new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

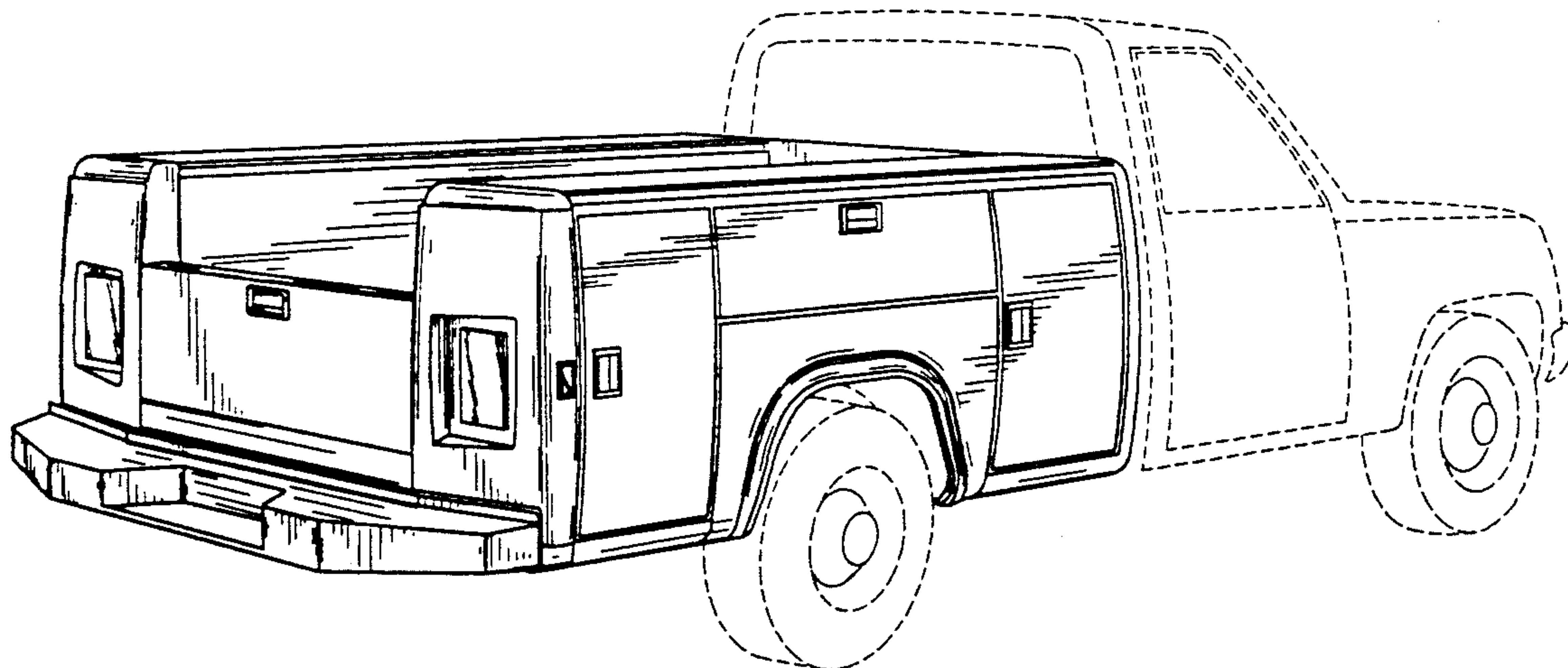
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



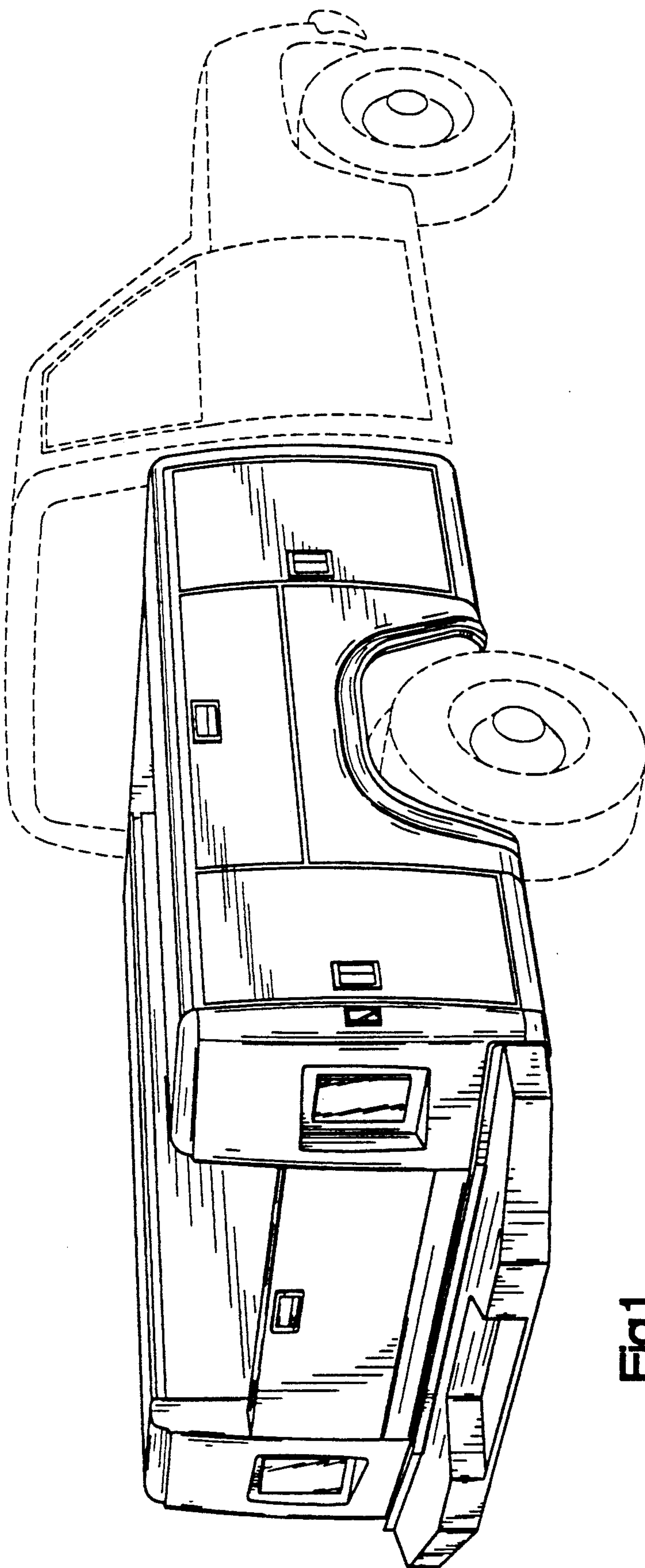

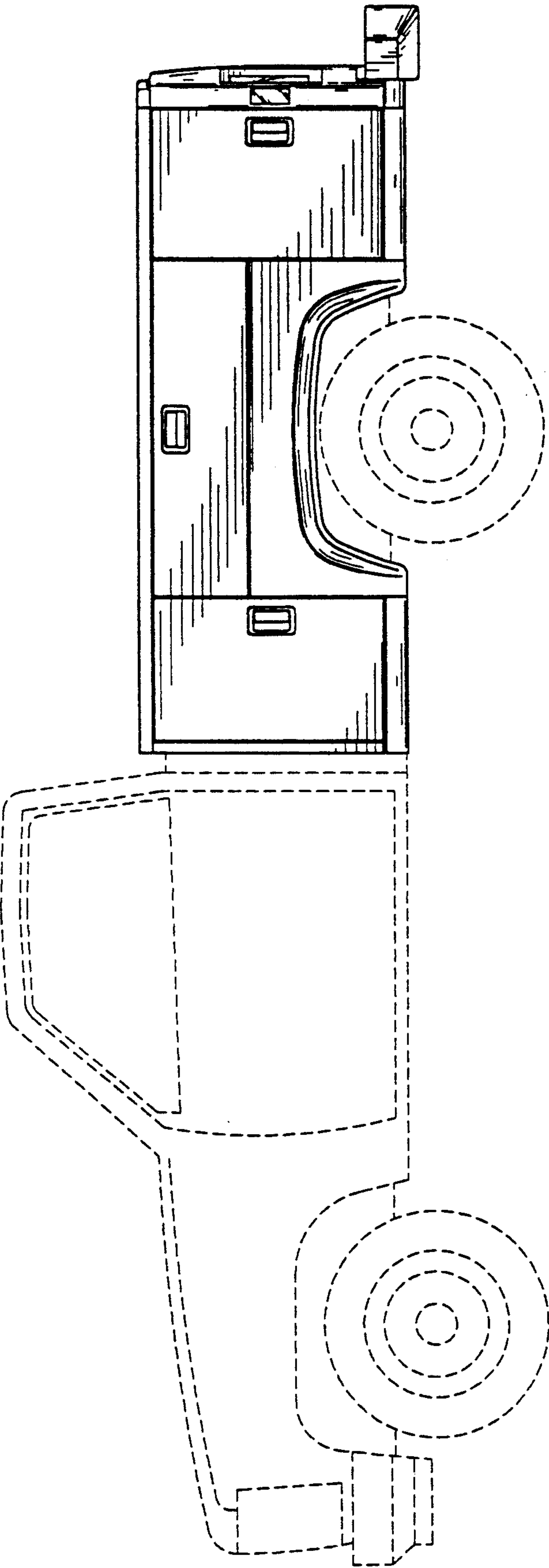

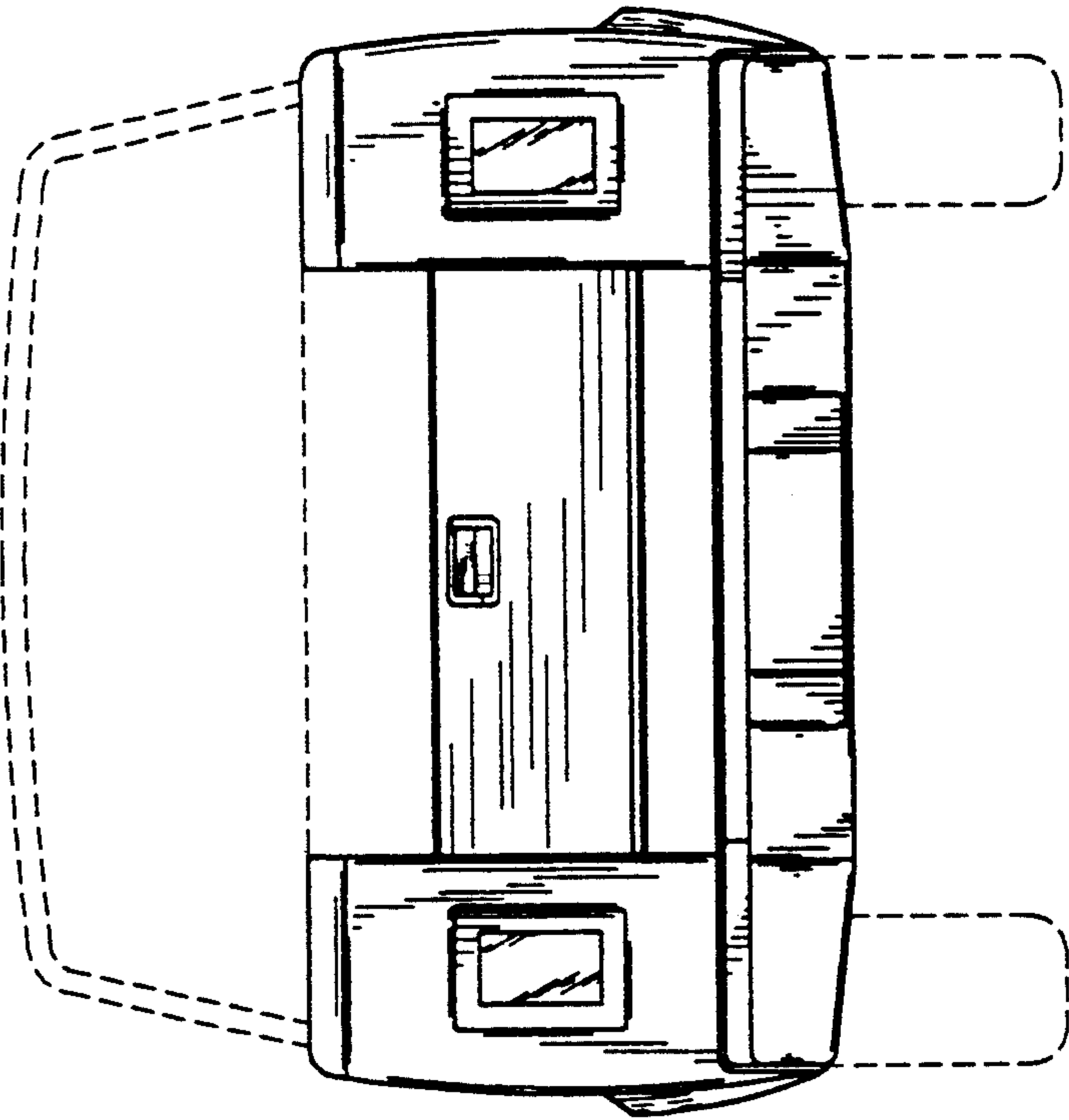

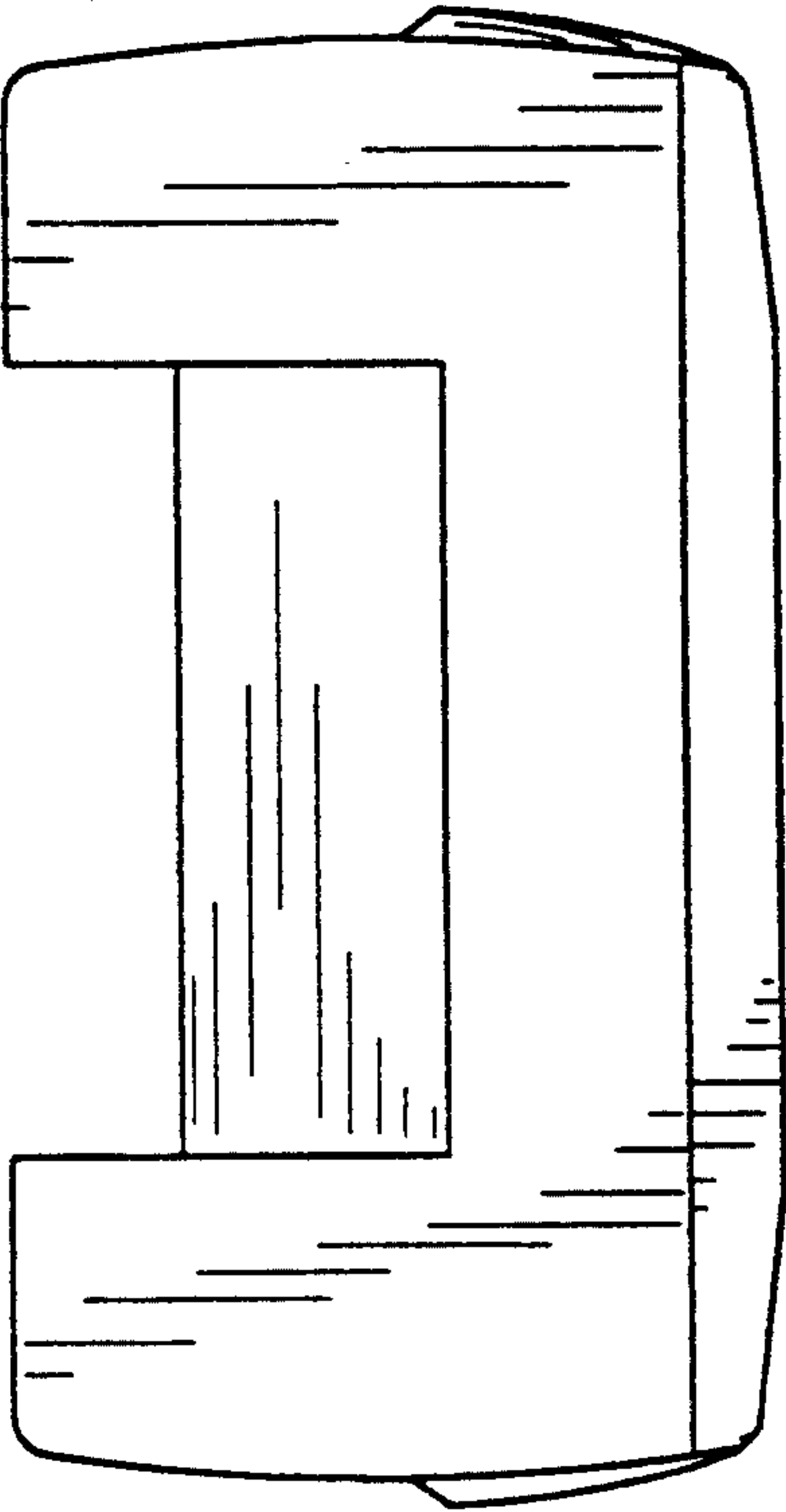

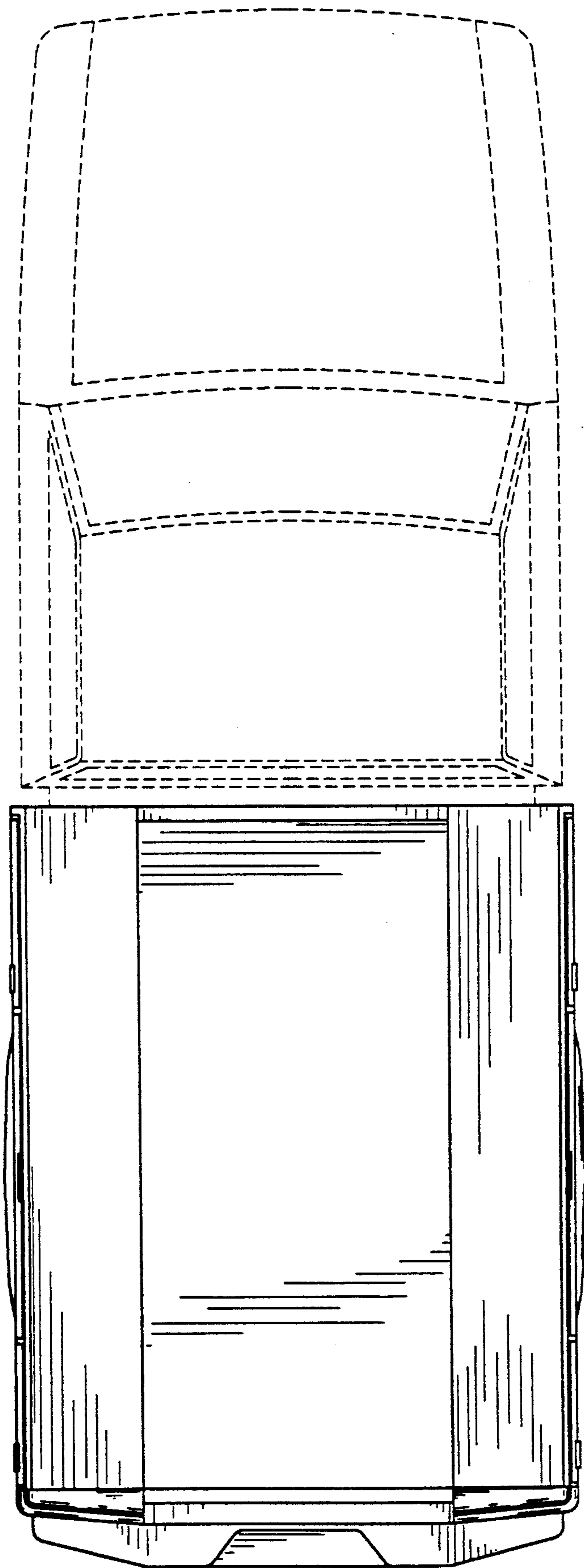

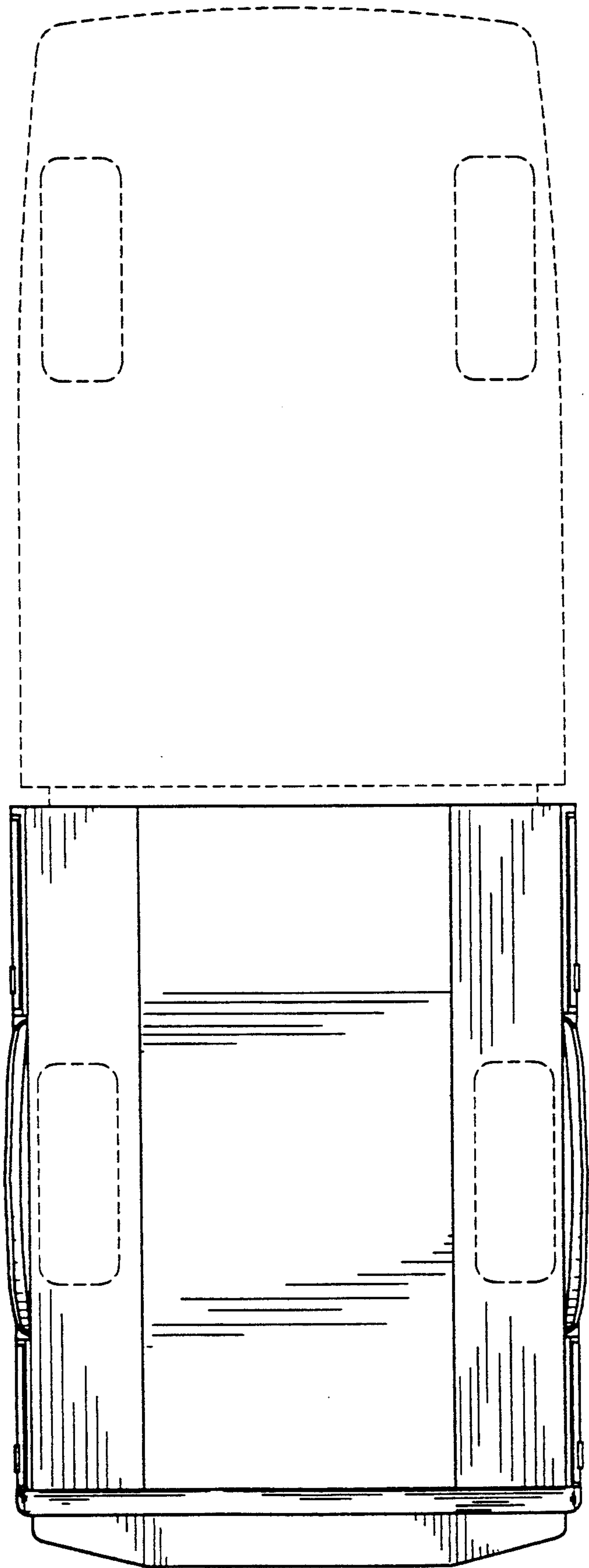
