[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fluted container, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the fluted container
incorporating the new design;

FIG. 2 is a side view thereof, the other sides being the
same as the side shown;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a vertical cross-section of the fluted container
shown in FIG. 2.

The broken line showing a pull tab in FIGS. 1 and 3 is
for illustrative purposes only and does not form part of
the claimed design.

The characteristic feature of our design resides in the
specific configuration of the fluting pattern in combina-
tion with the container as shown.

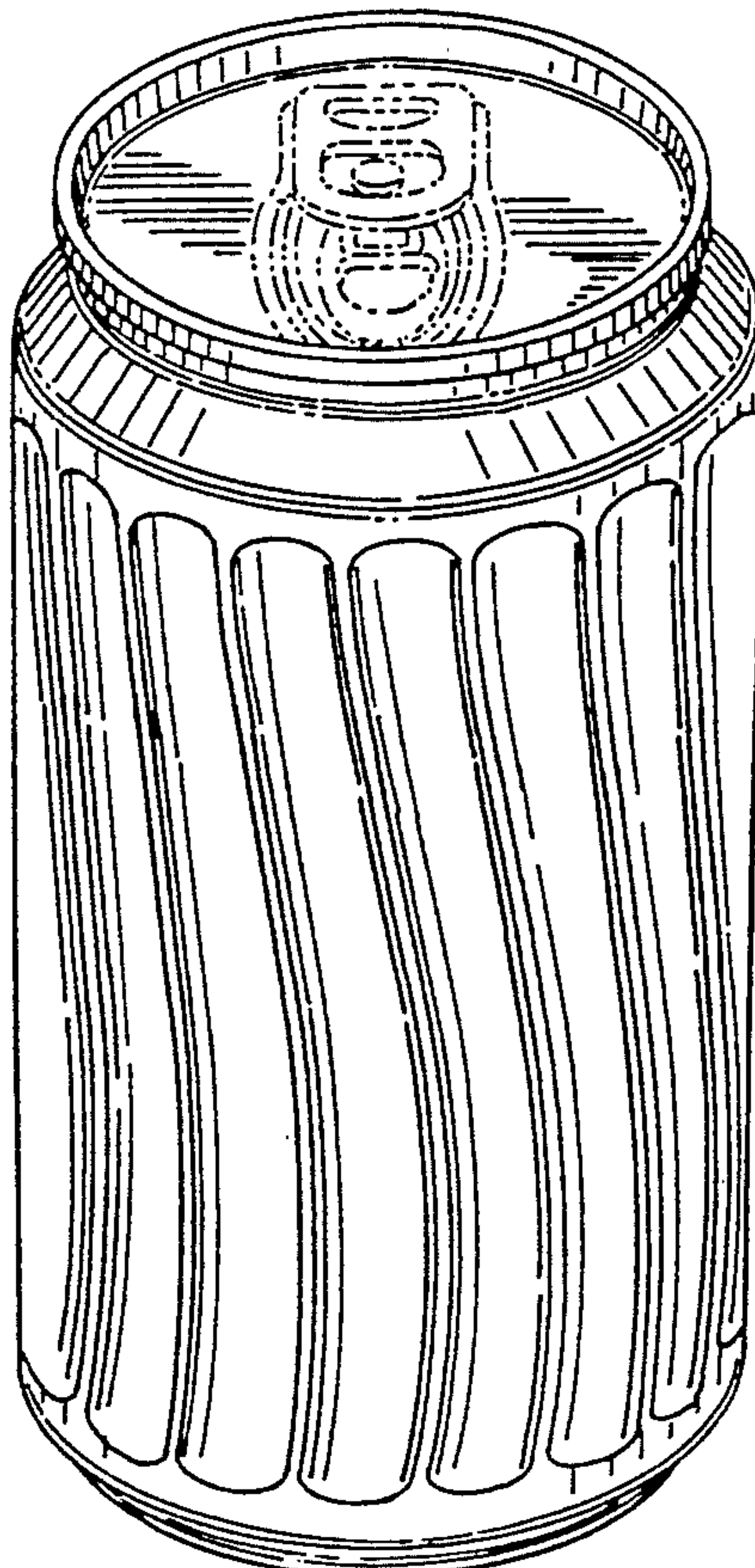

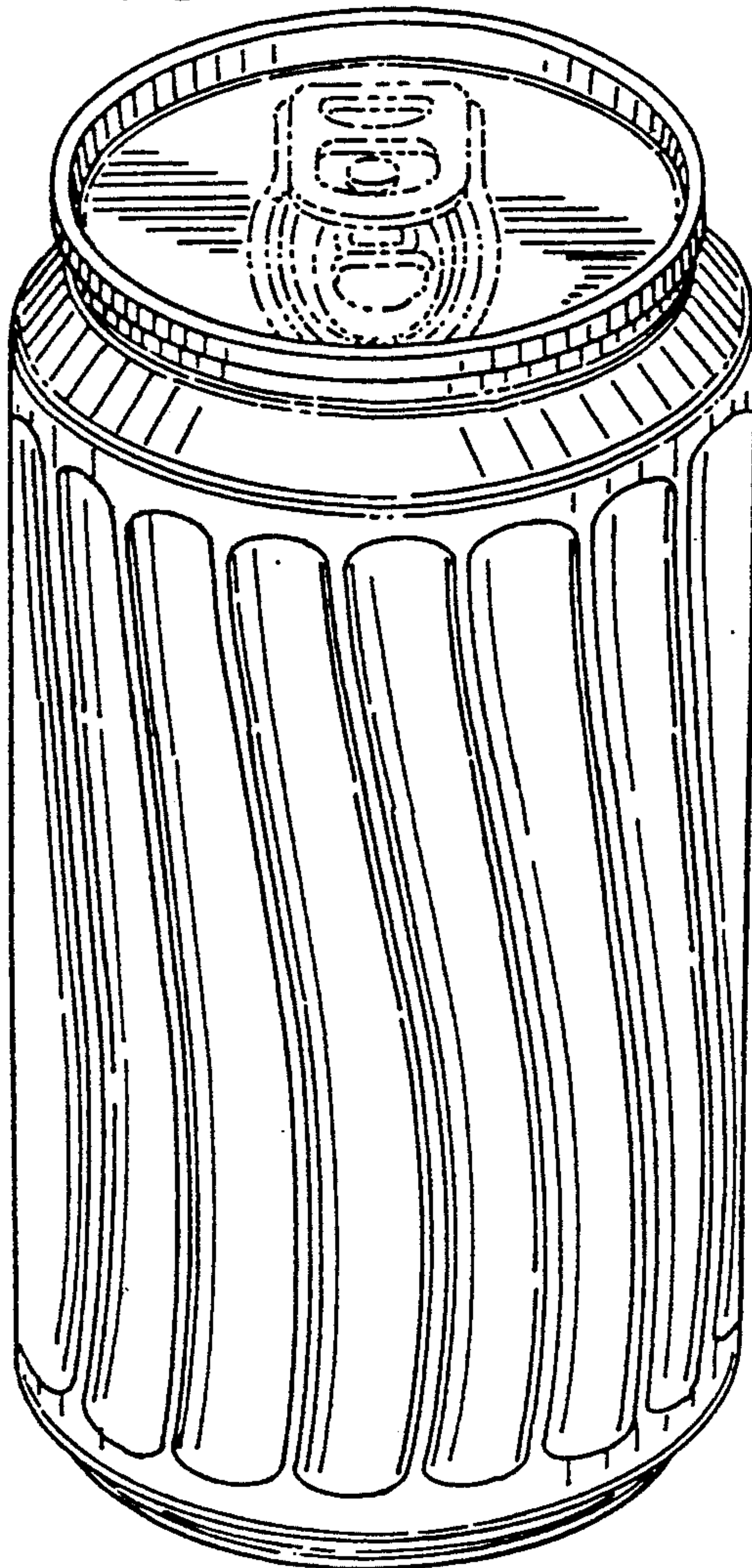

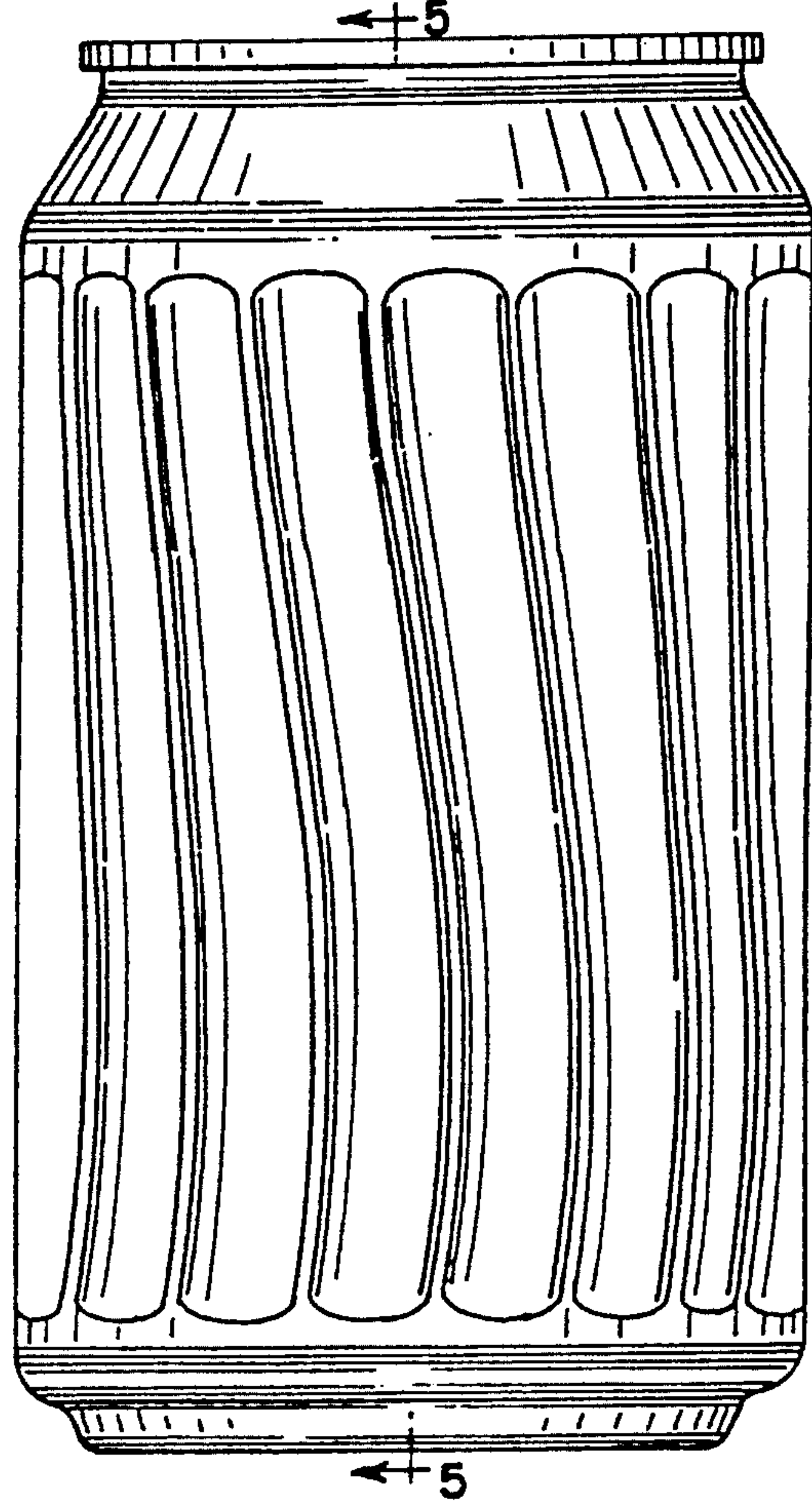

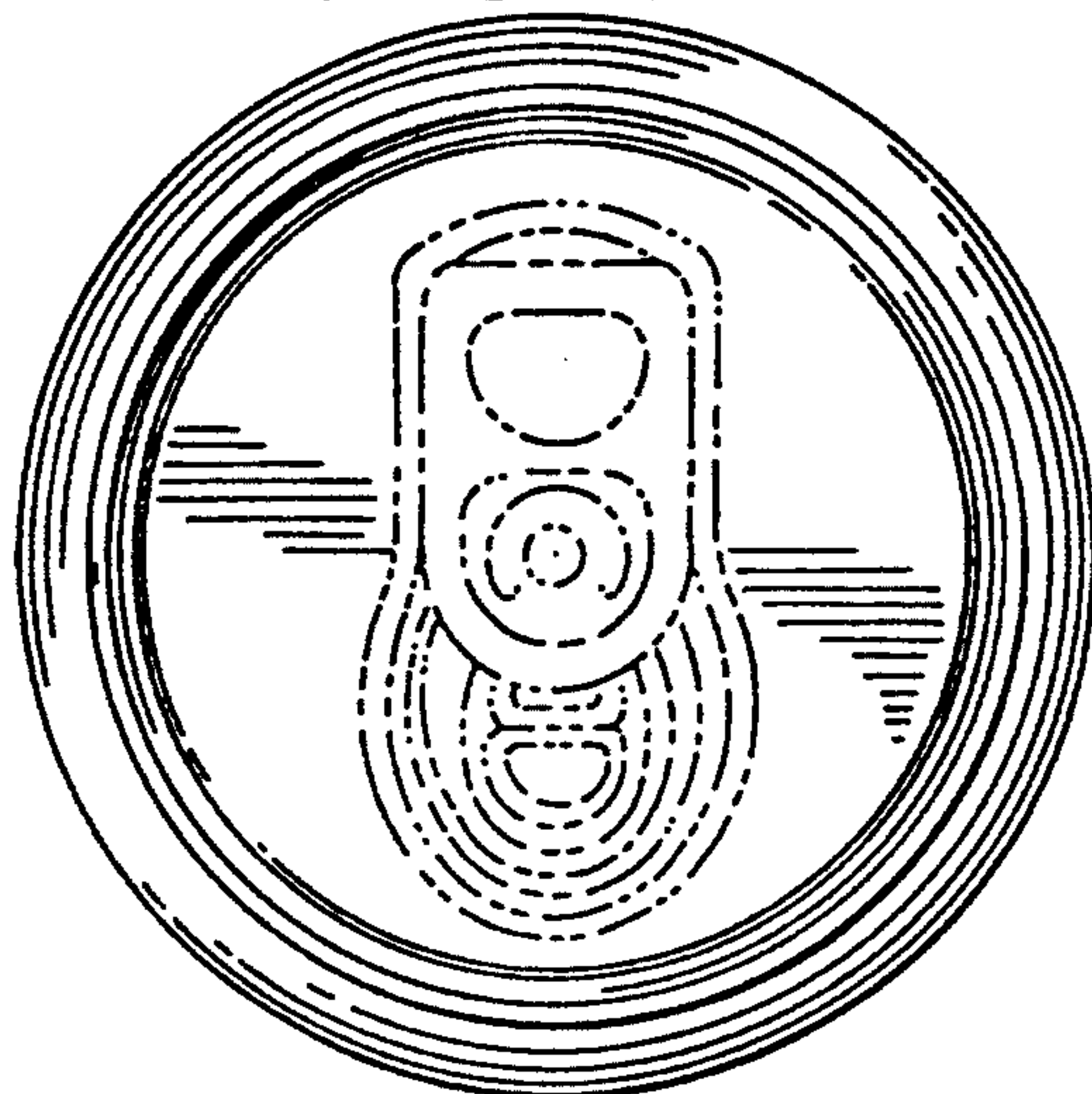

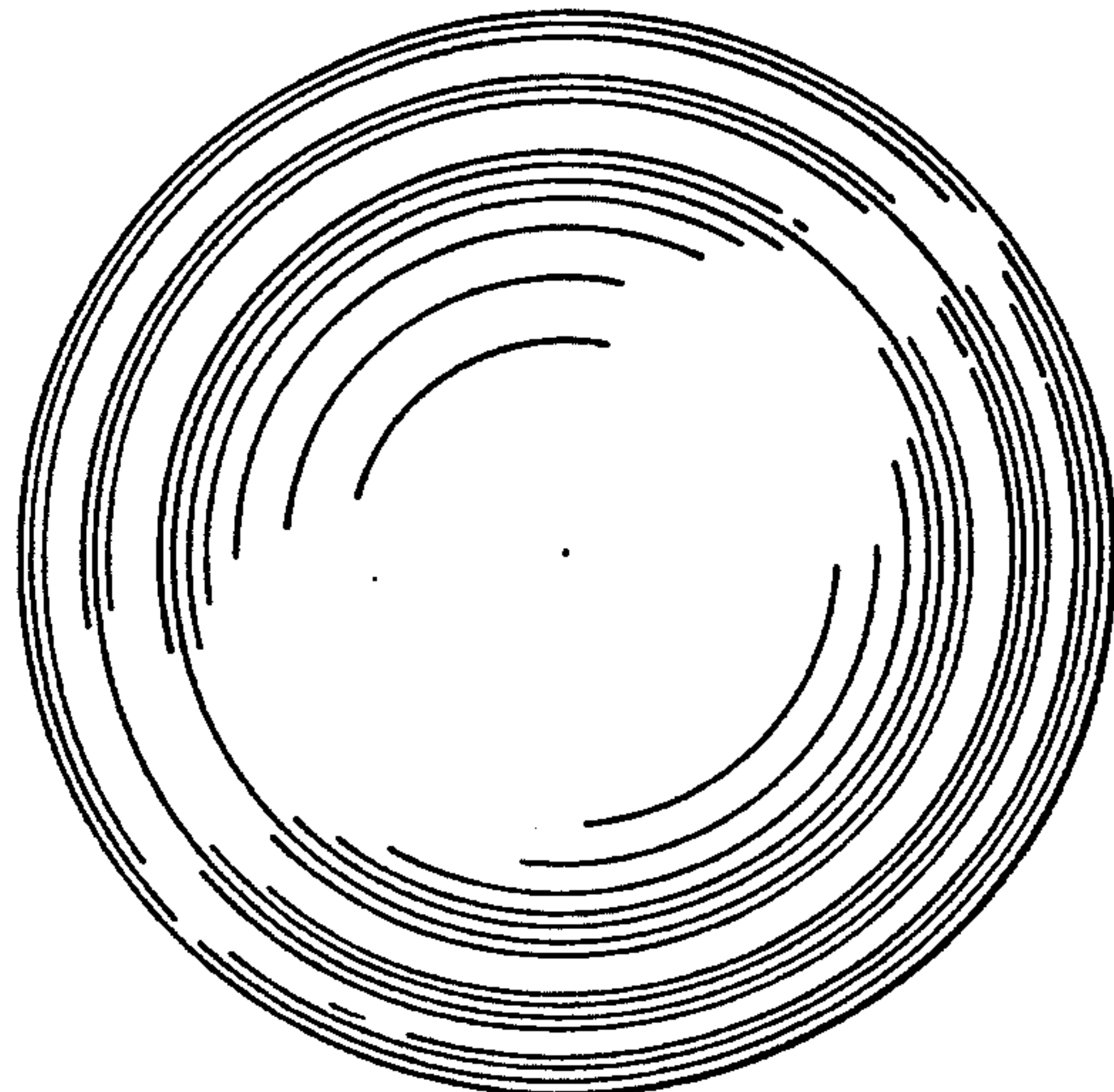
