FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevation view thereof;

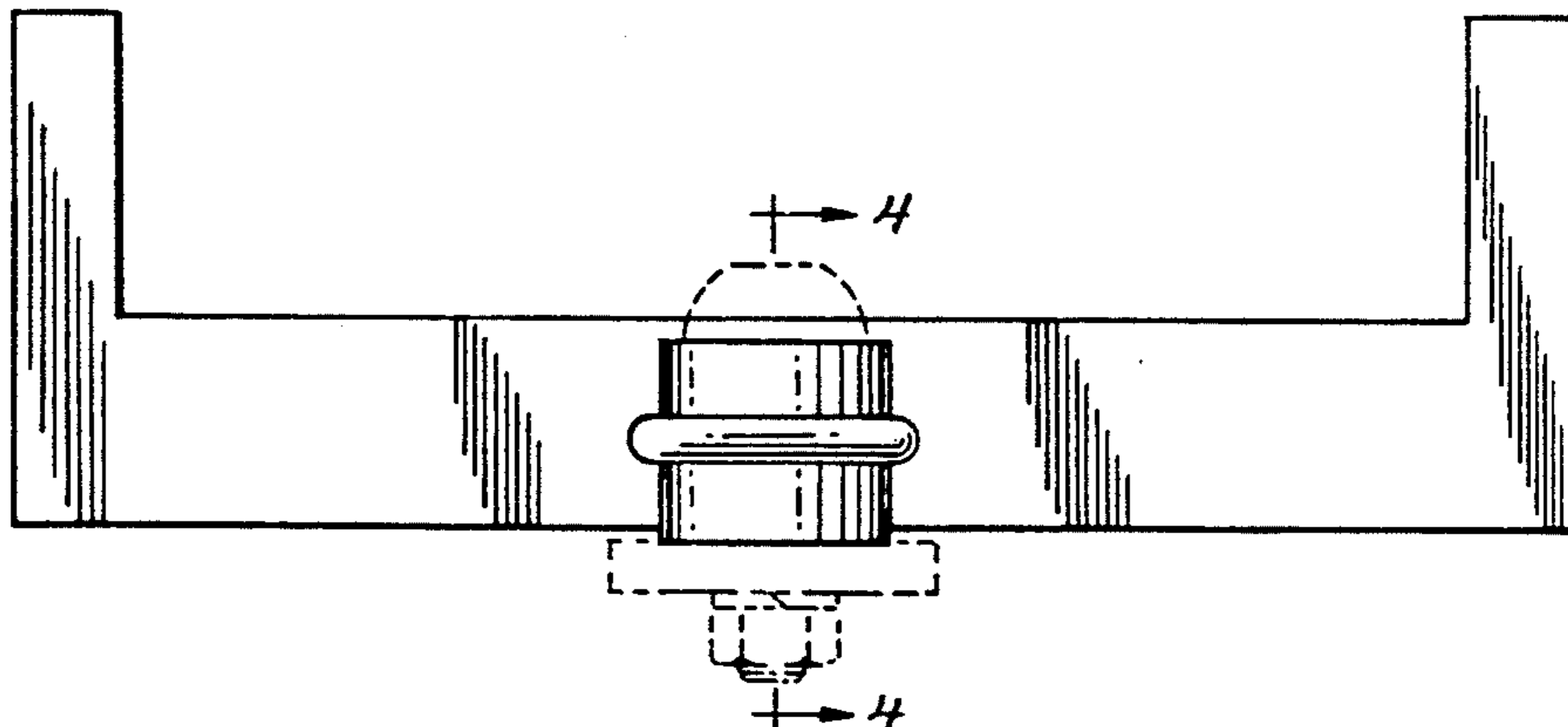
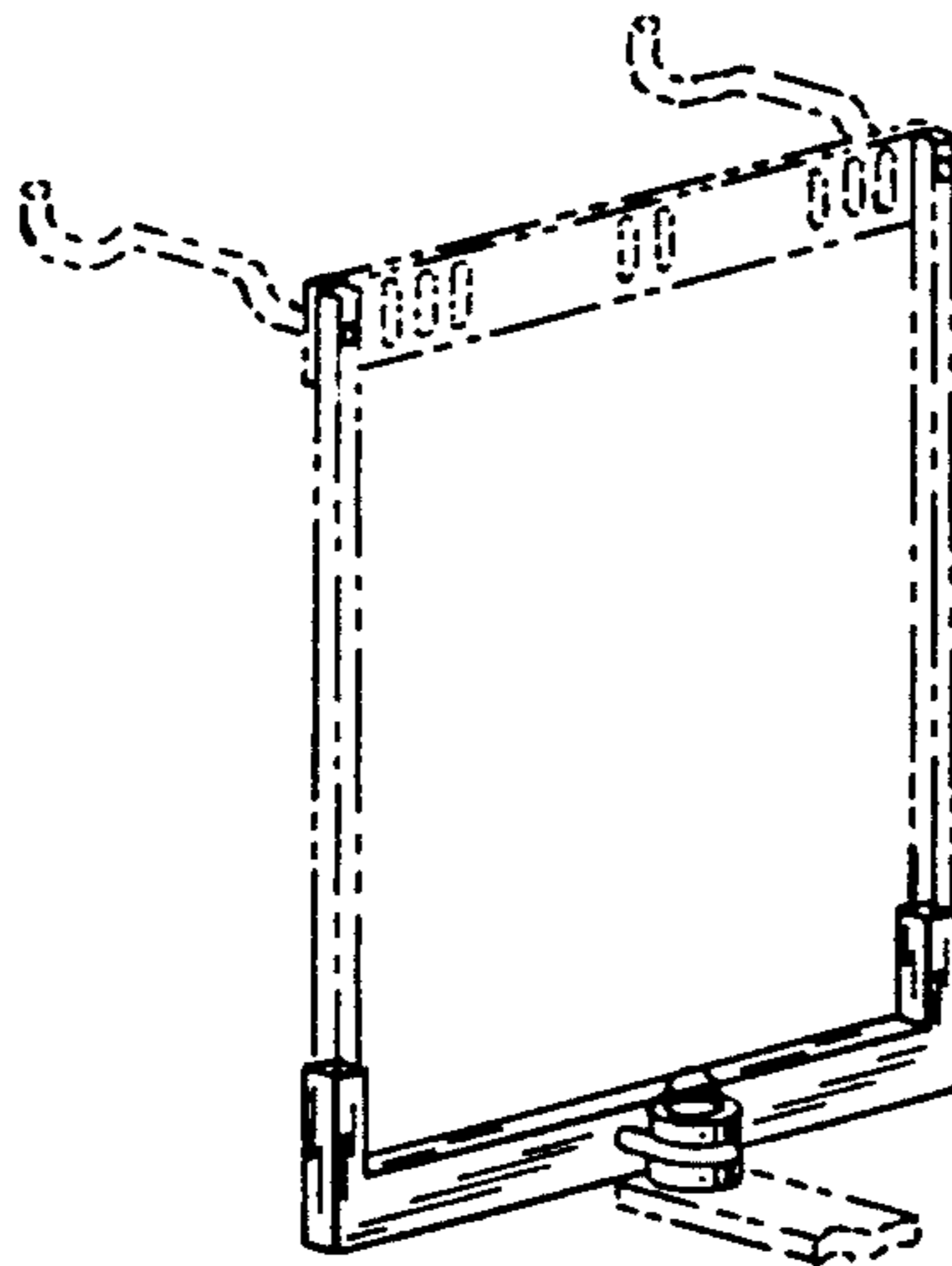
FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged rear elevation view thereof.



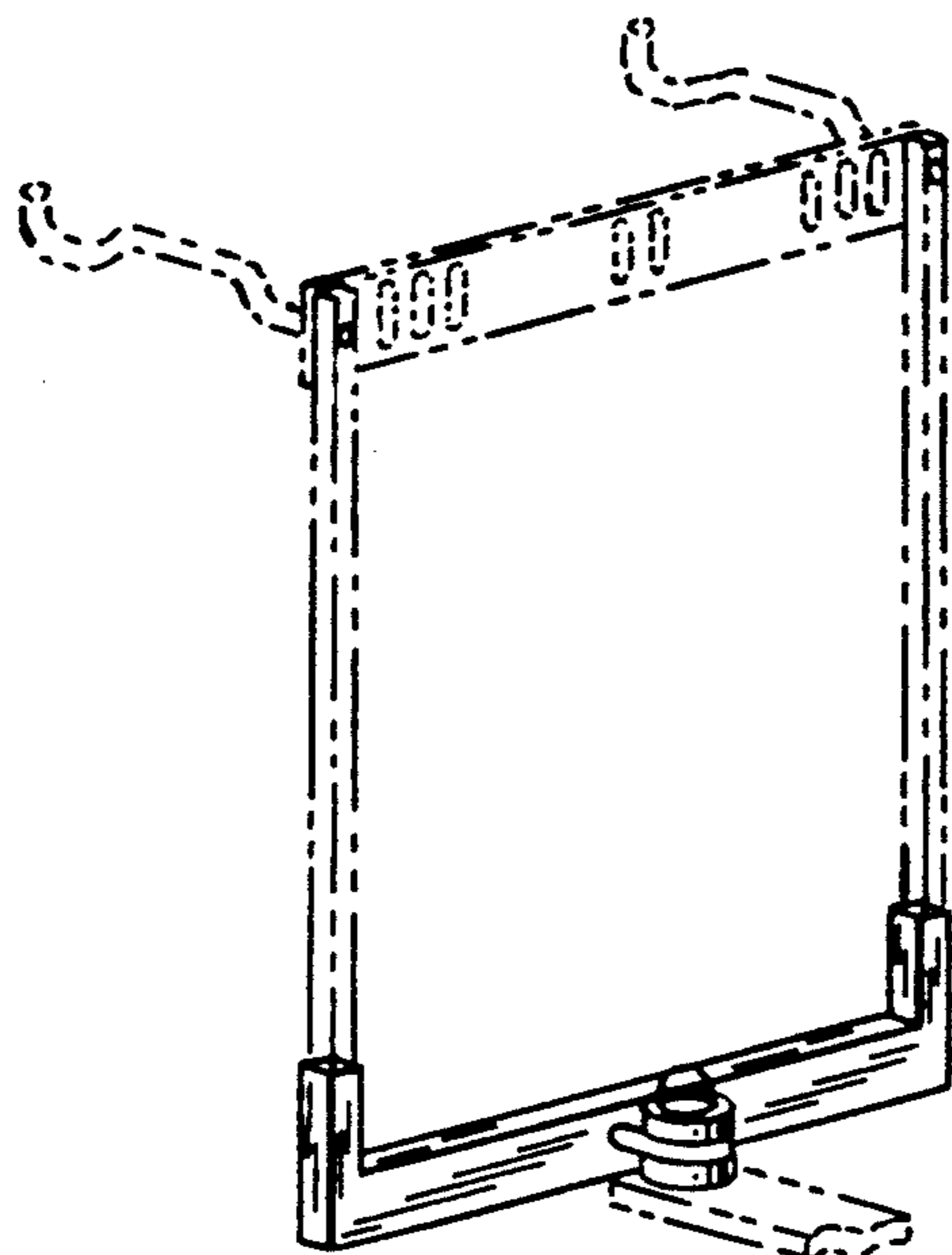

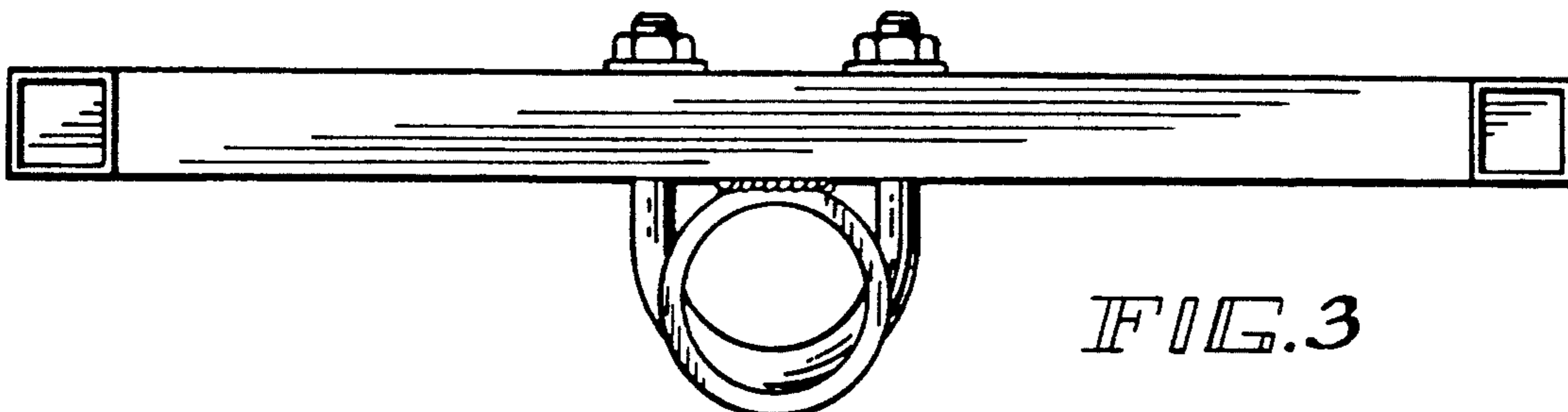
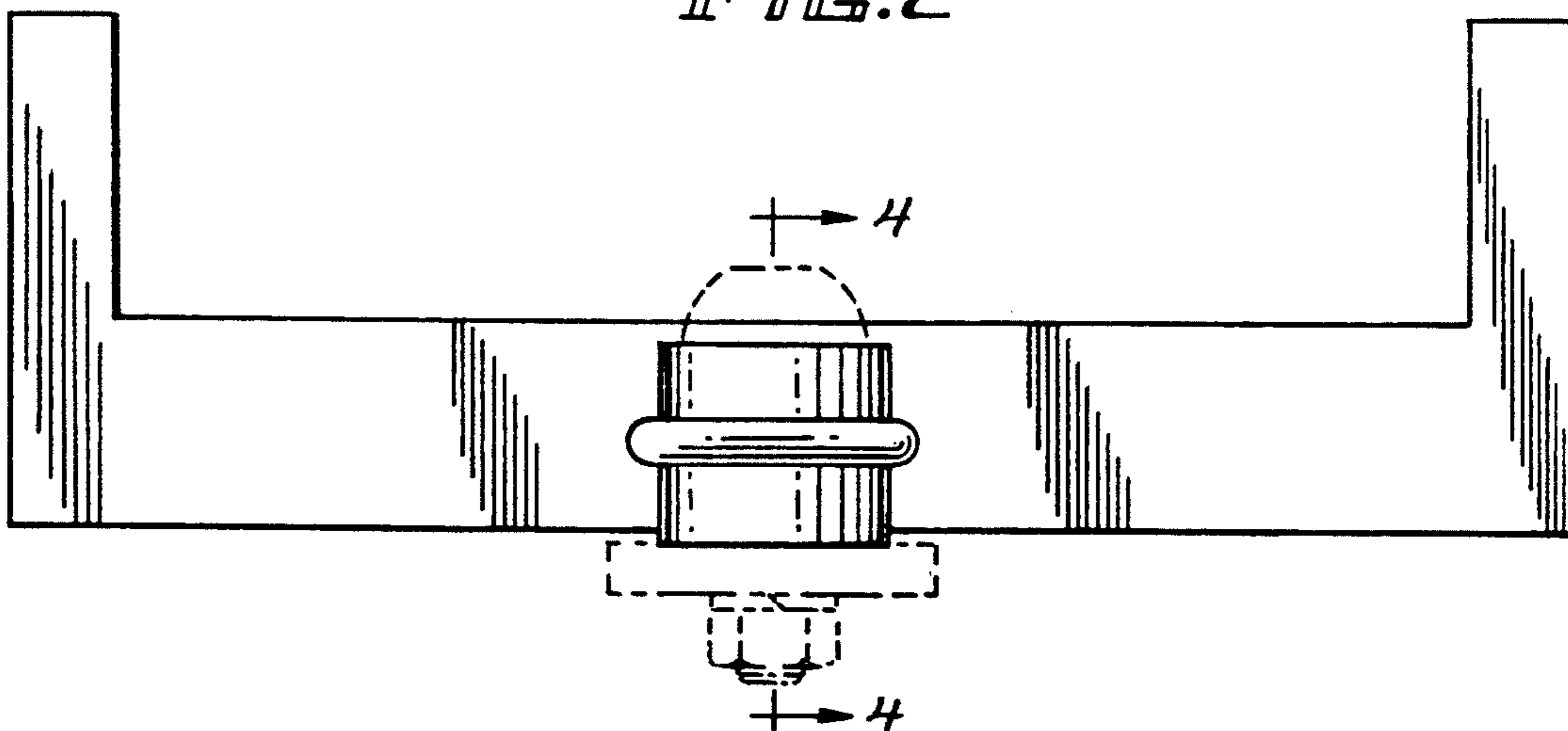

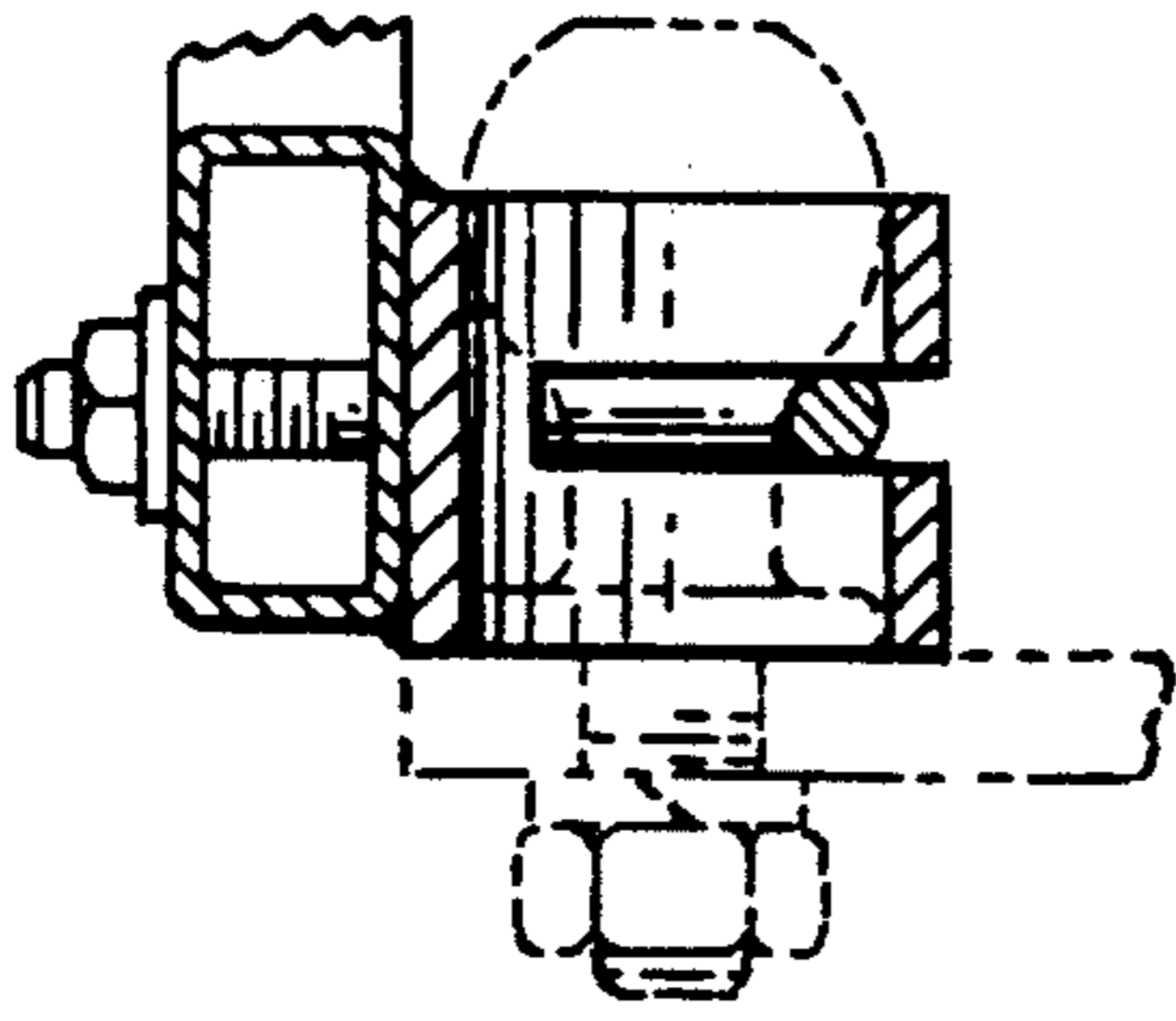

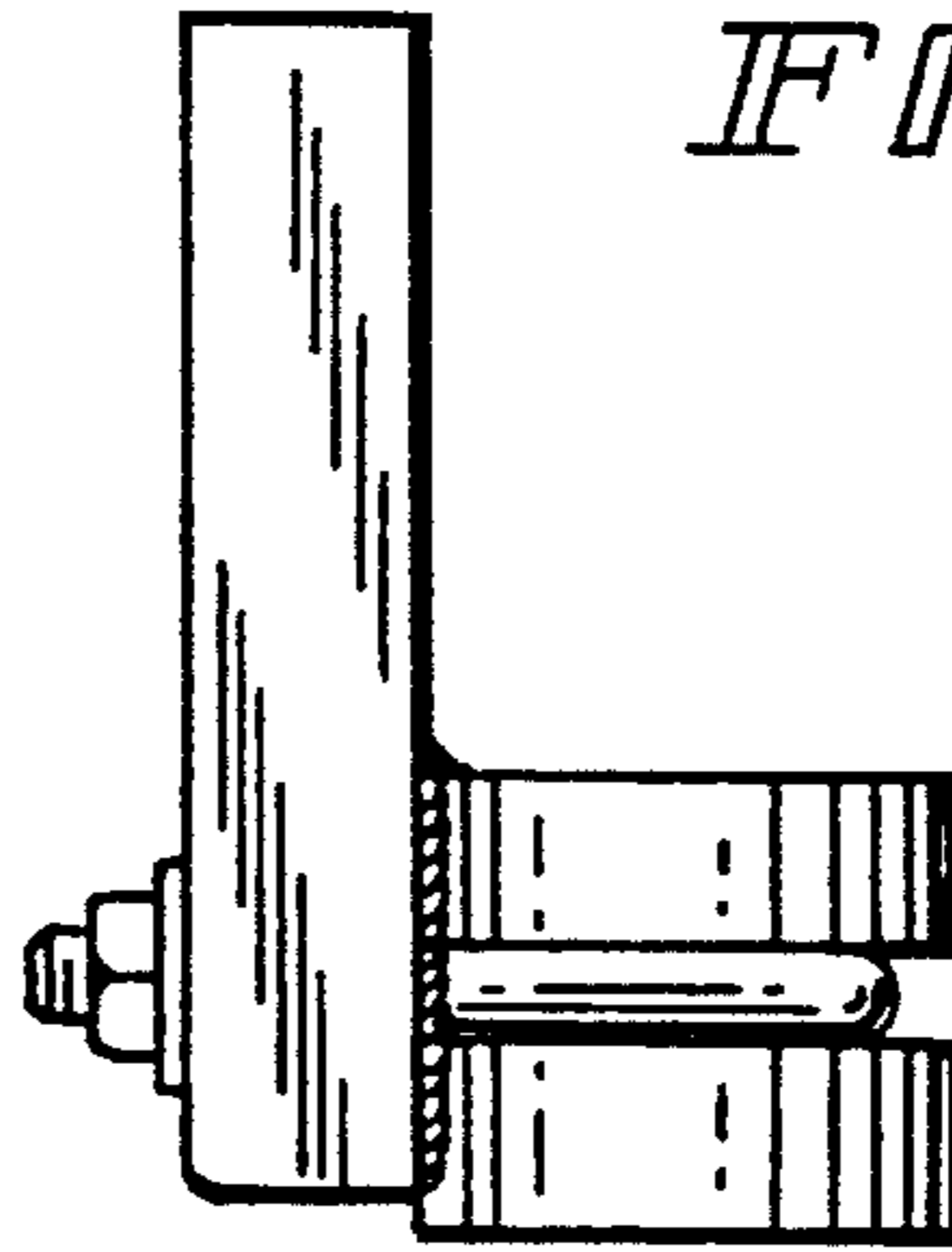

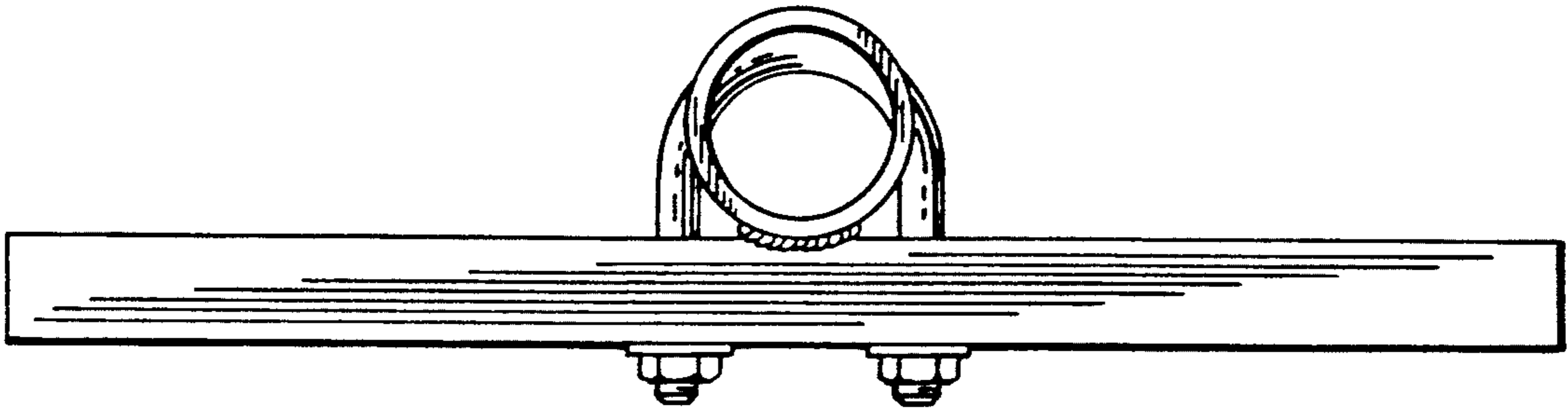
