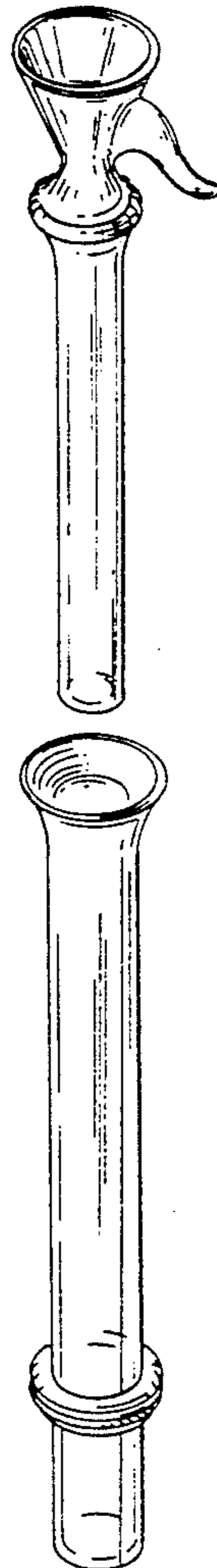

The undisclosed bottom portion of FIG. 4 is identical in appearance to the disclosed bottom of FIG. 2.



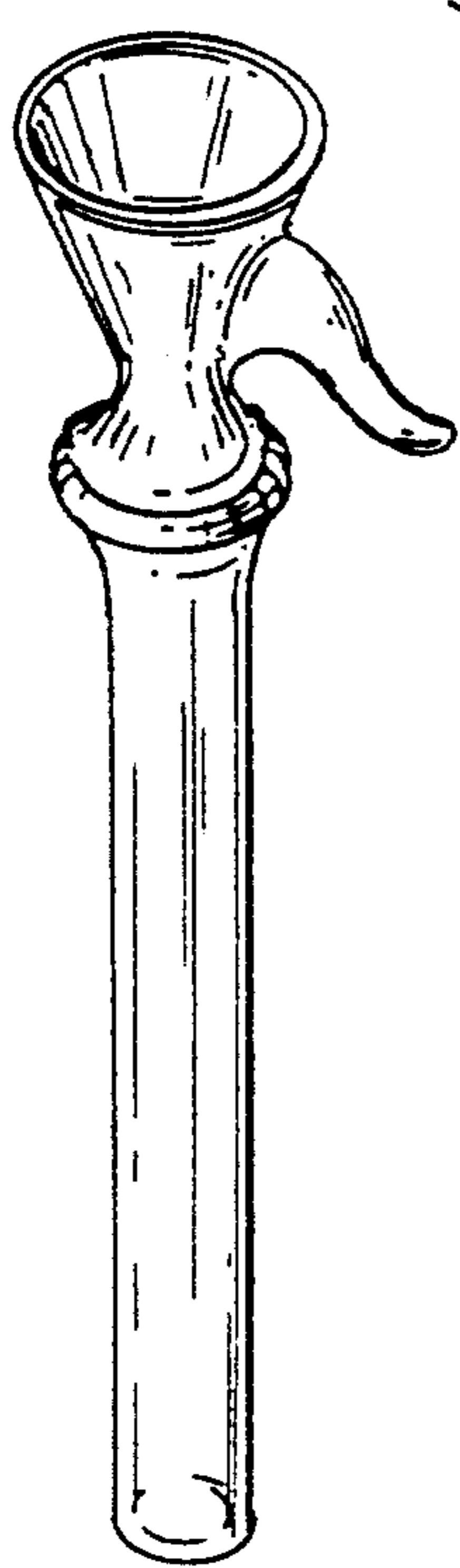

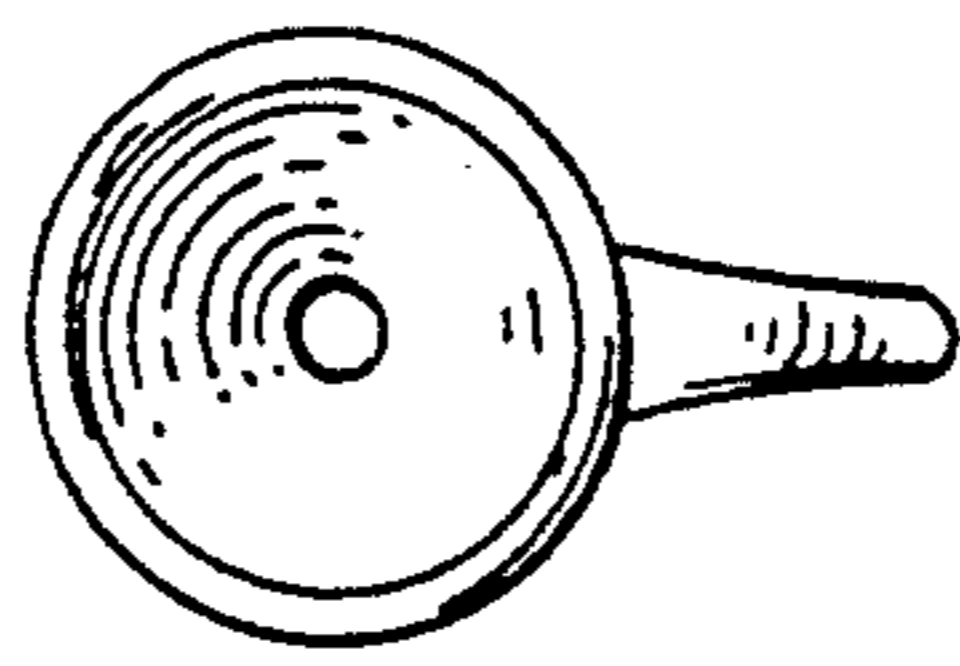
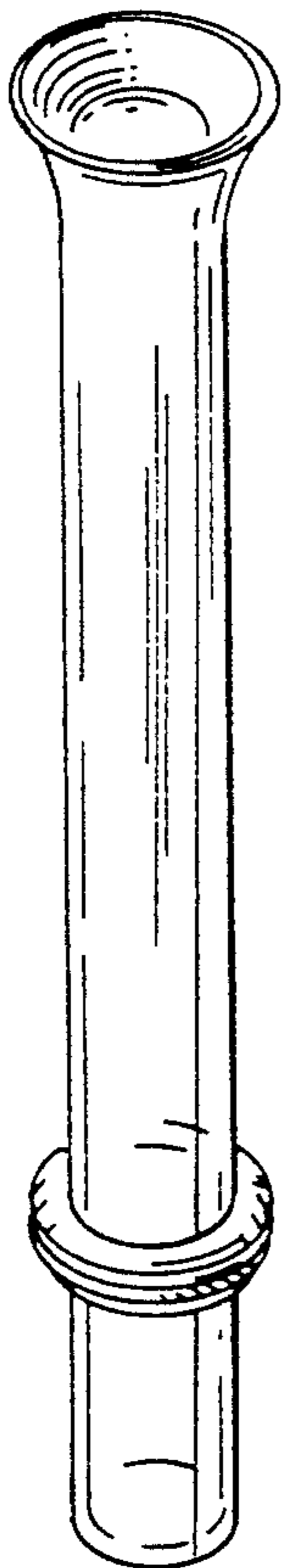

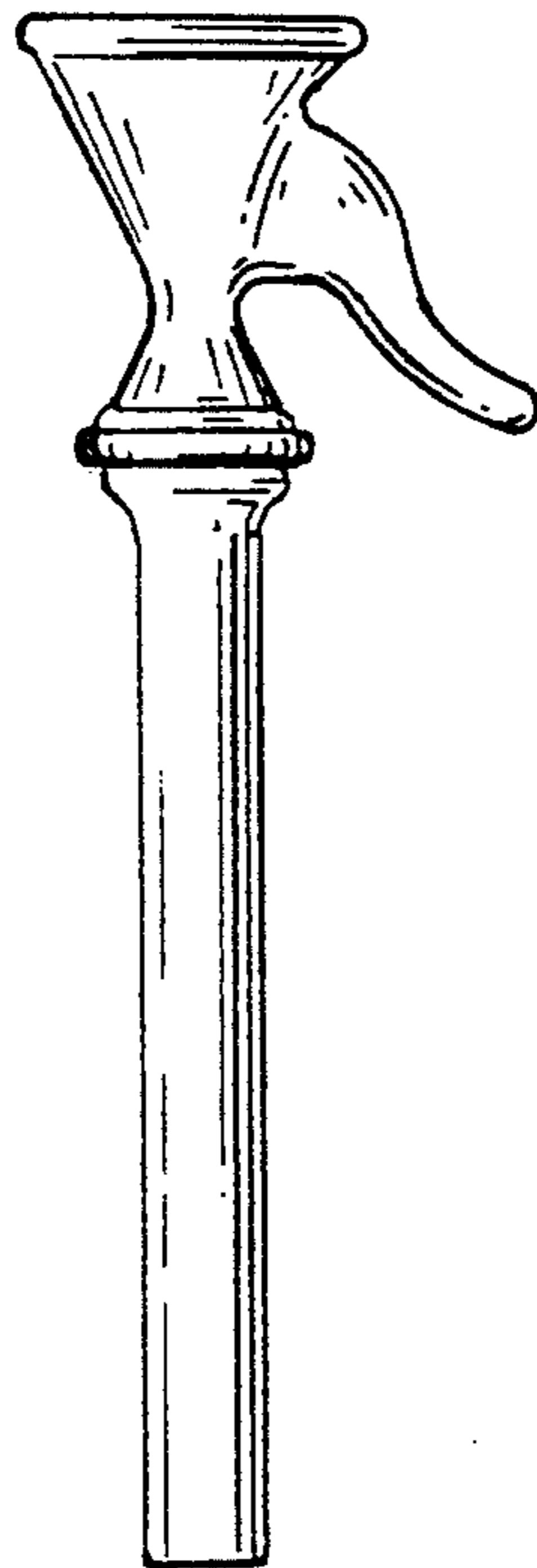

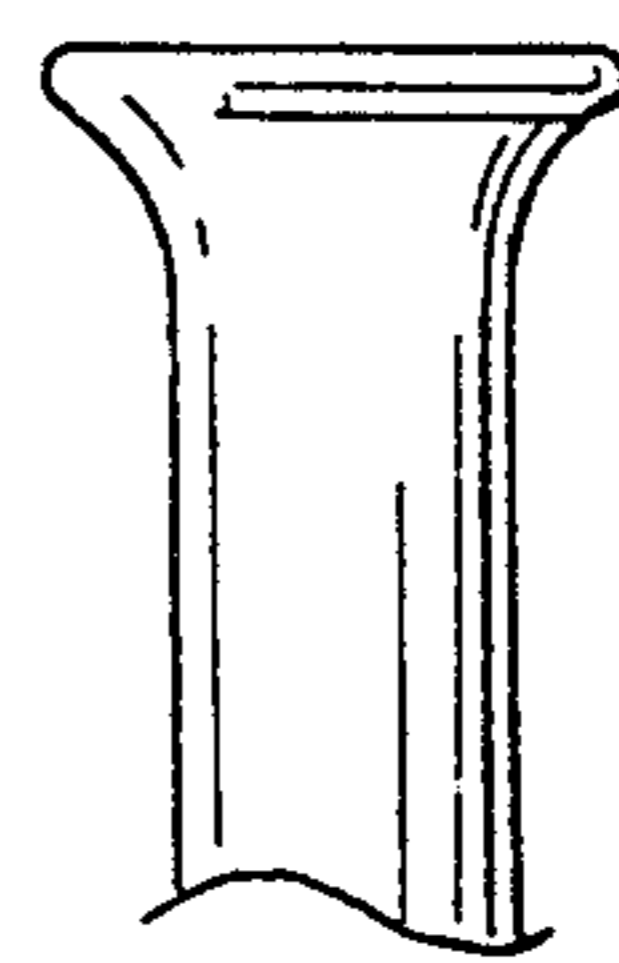
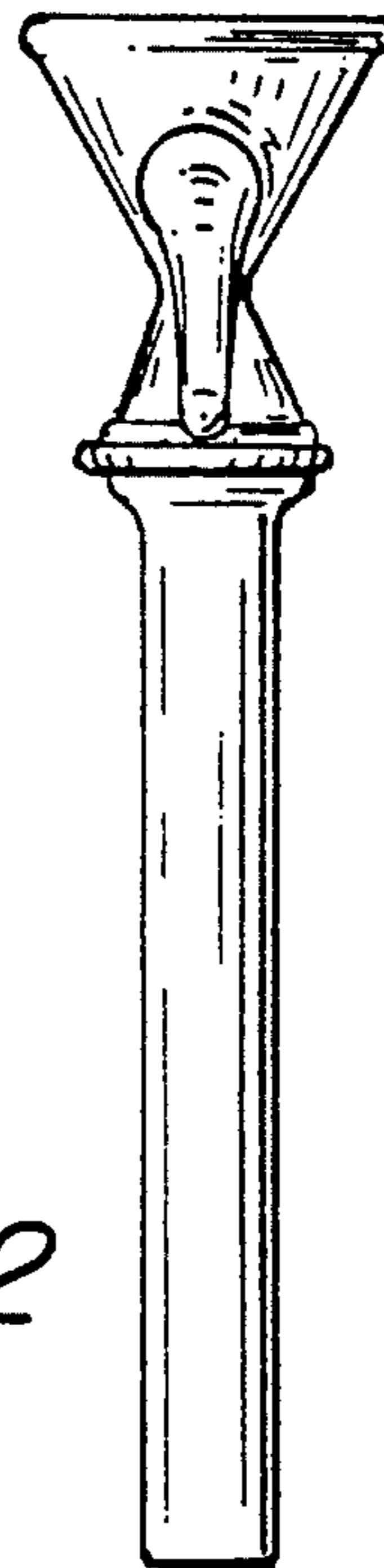
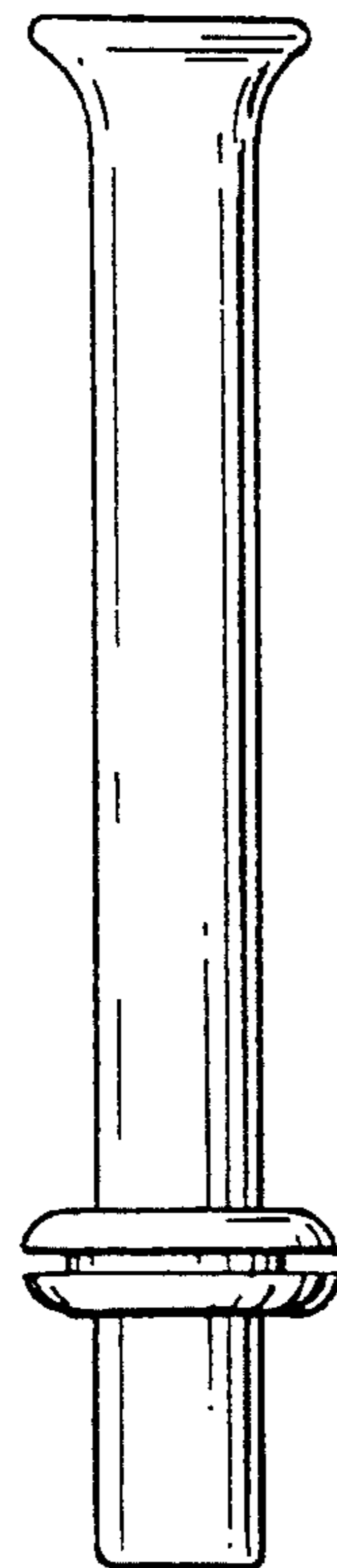

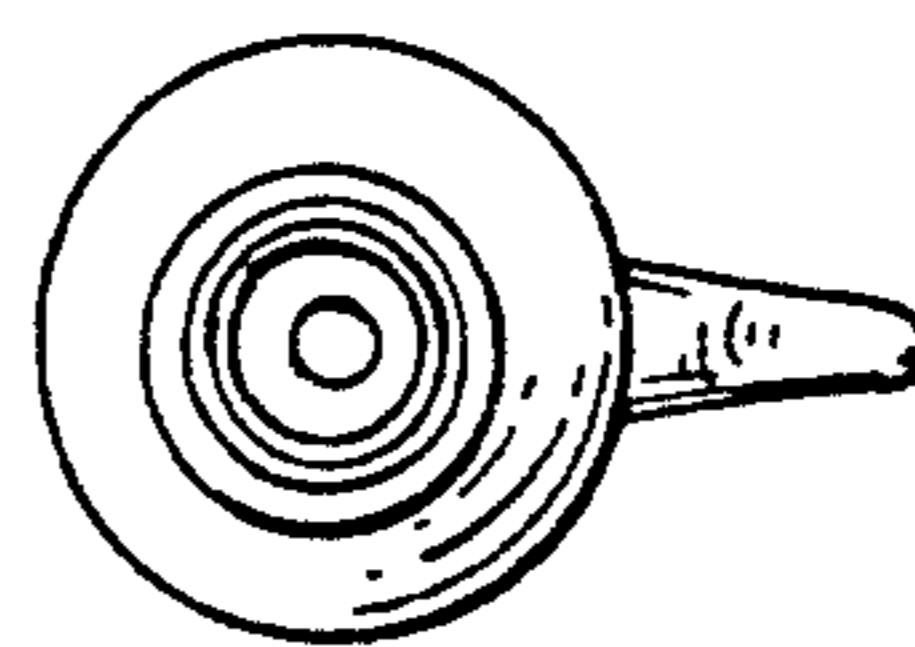
