[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a strap system for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a strap system for a shoe upper showing a first embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the strap system showing in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the strap system shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the strap system shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the strap system shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of one side of a strap system for a shoe upper showing a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the other side of the strap system shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the strap system shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the strap system shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the strap system shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 11 is a side elevational view of one side of a strap system for a shoe upper showing a third embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view of the other side of the strap system shown in FIG. 11;


FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of the strap system shown in FIG. 11:

FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view of the strap system shown in FIG. 11;

FIG. 15 is a top plan view of the strap system shown in FIG. 11 with the strap done; and,

FIG. 16 is a top plan view of the strap system shown in FIG. 11 with the straps undone.

The broken line showing of a shoe upper and sole periphery in the figures are for illustrative purposes and form no part of the claimed design.







































