## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the chair according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the chair of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the chair of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a back view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a right hand side view of the chair in FIG. 3, the left hand side view being its mirror image; and,

FIG. 6 is a top view of FIG. 3.

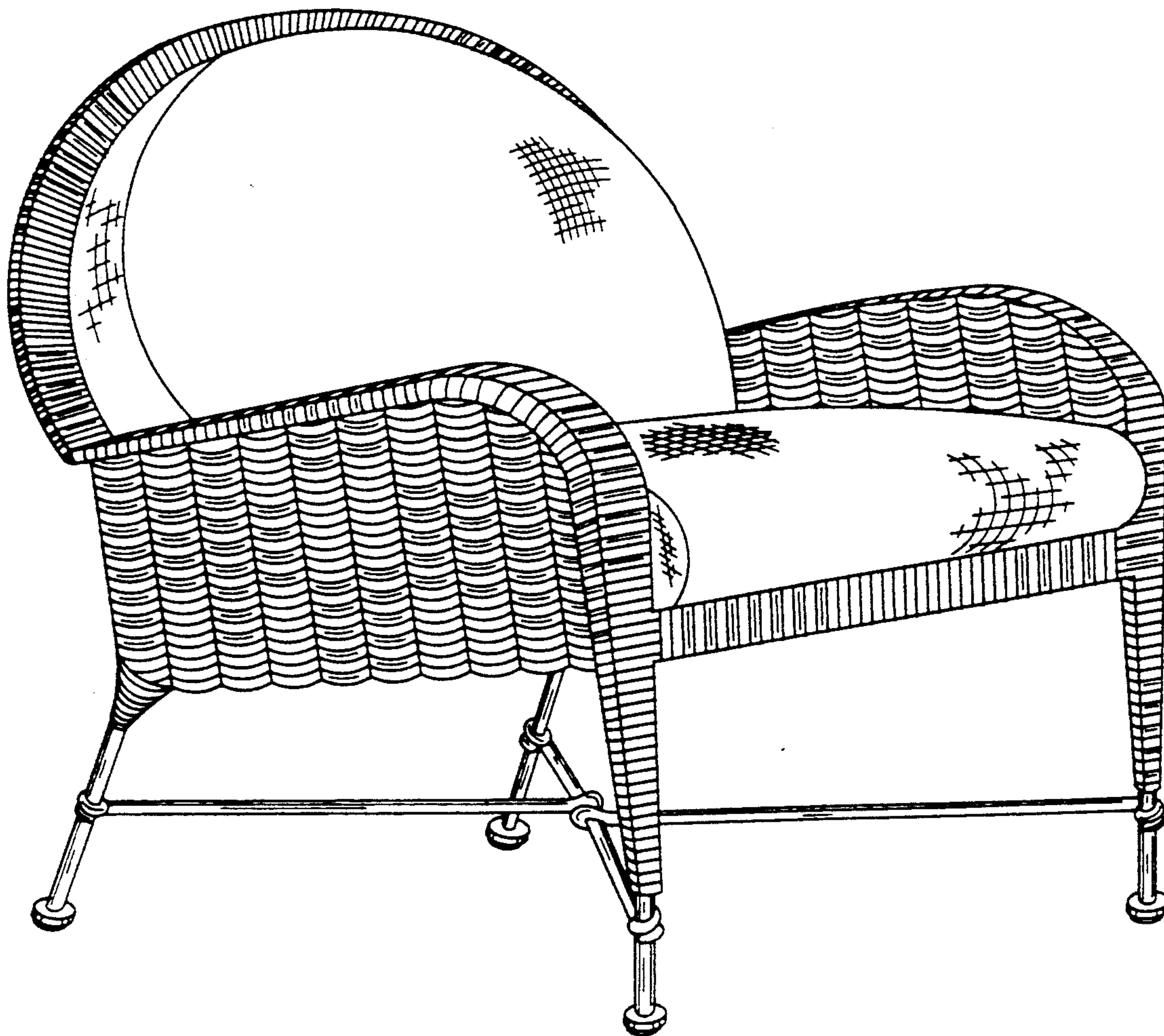

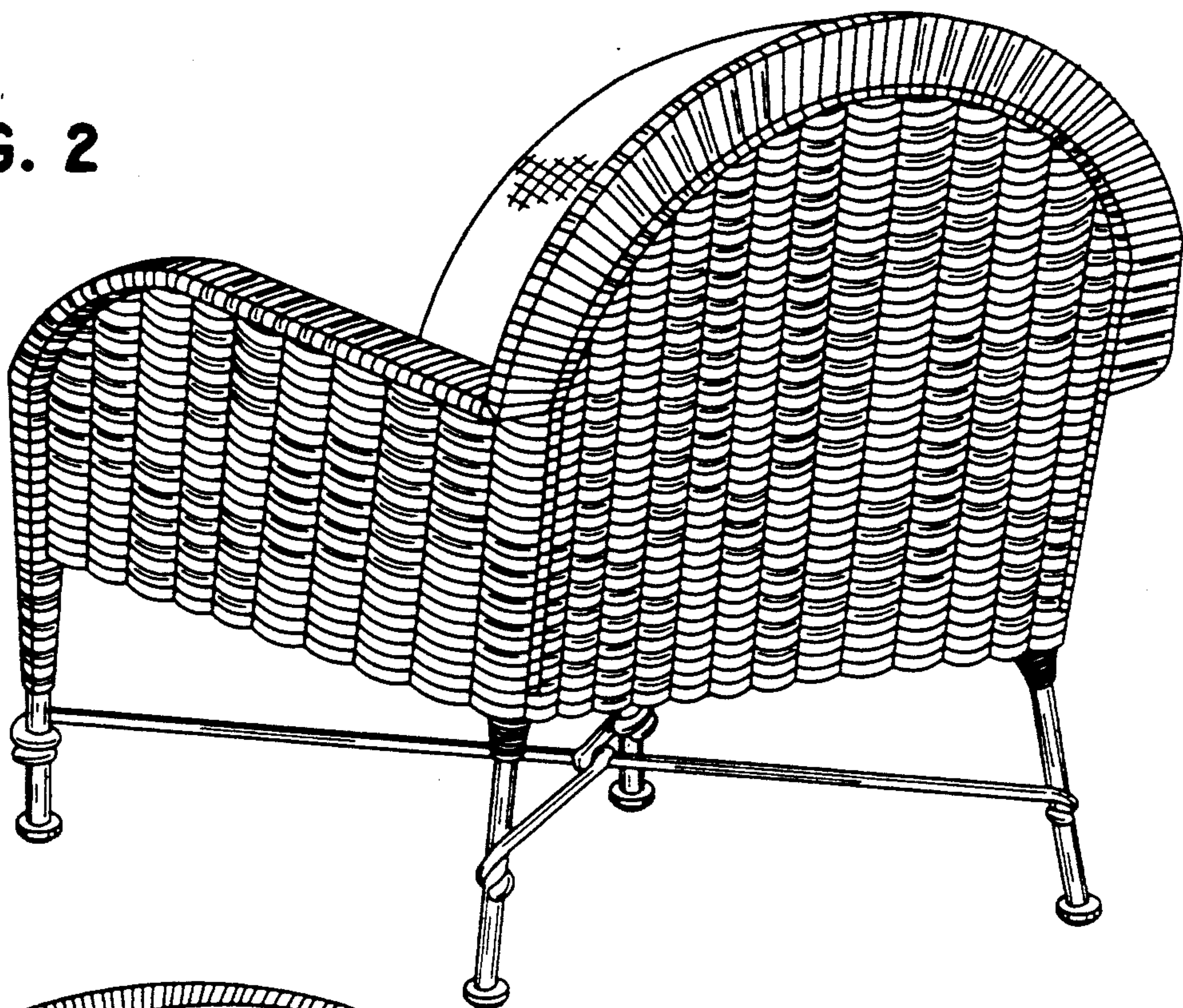
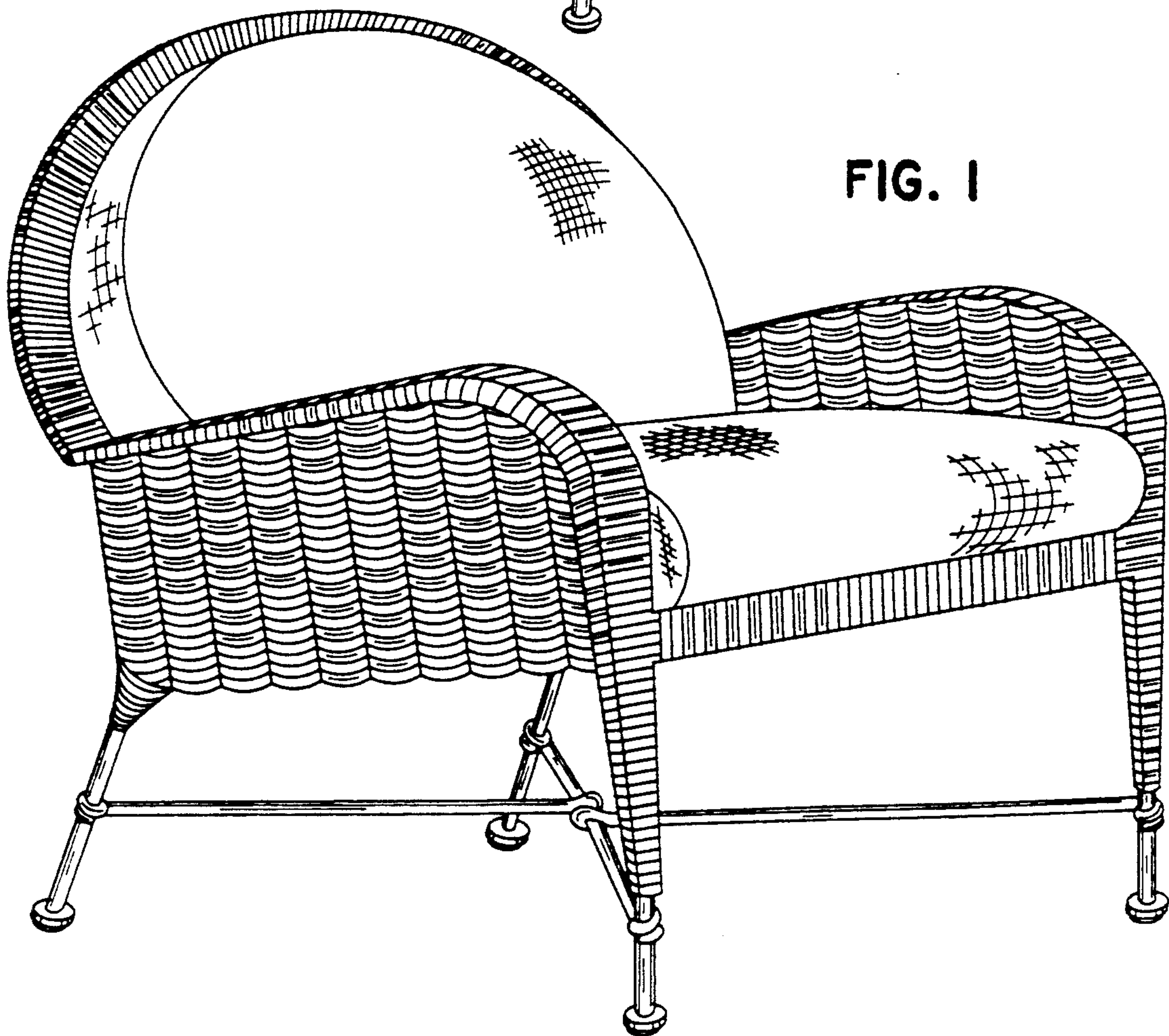

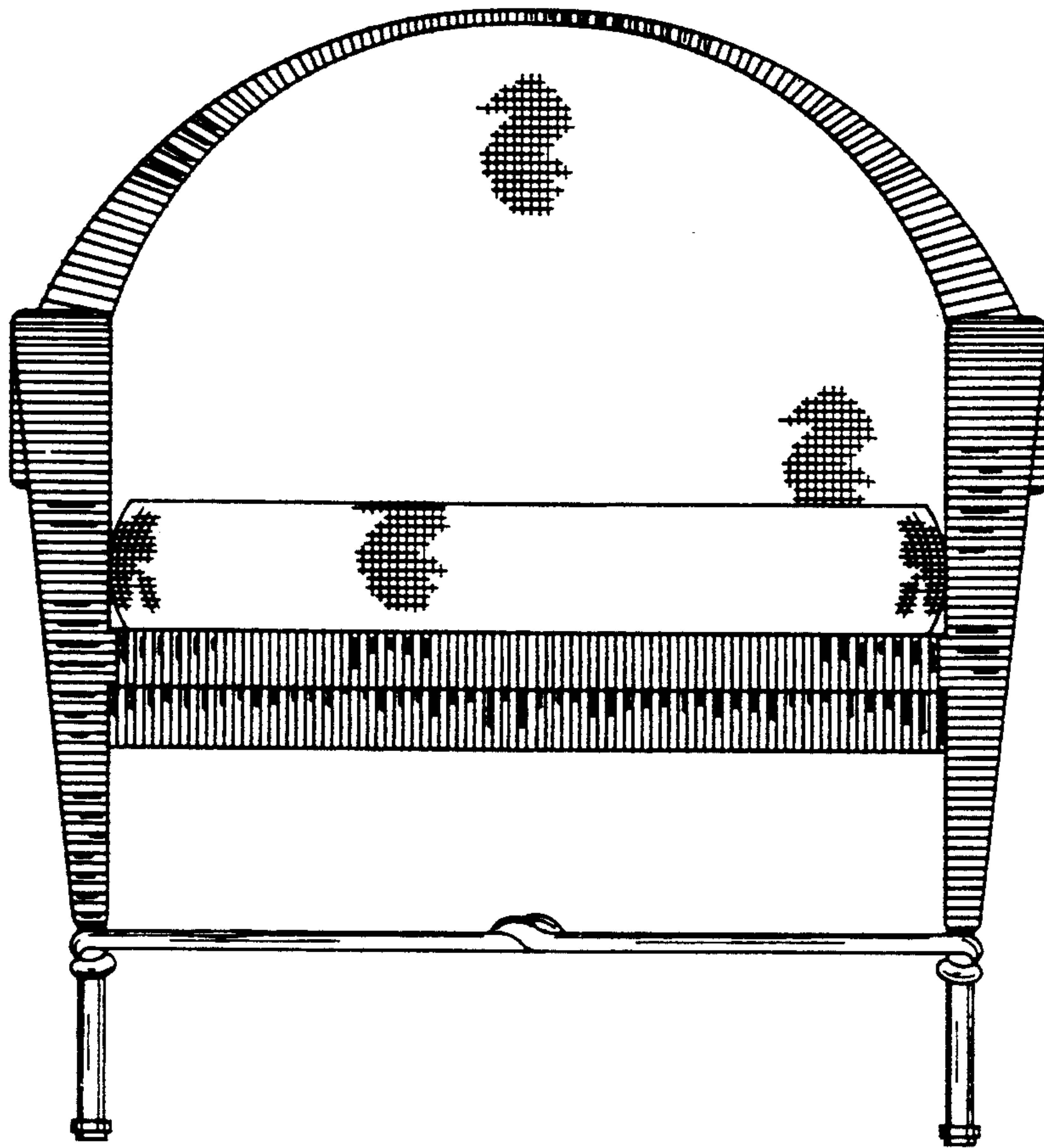

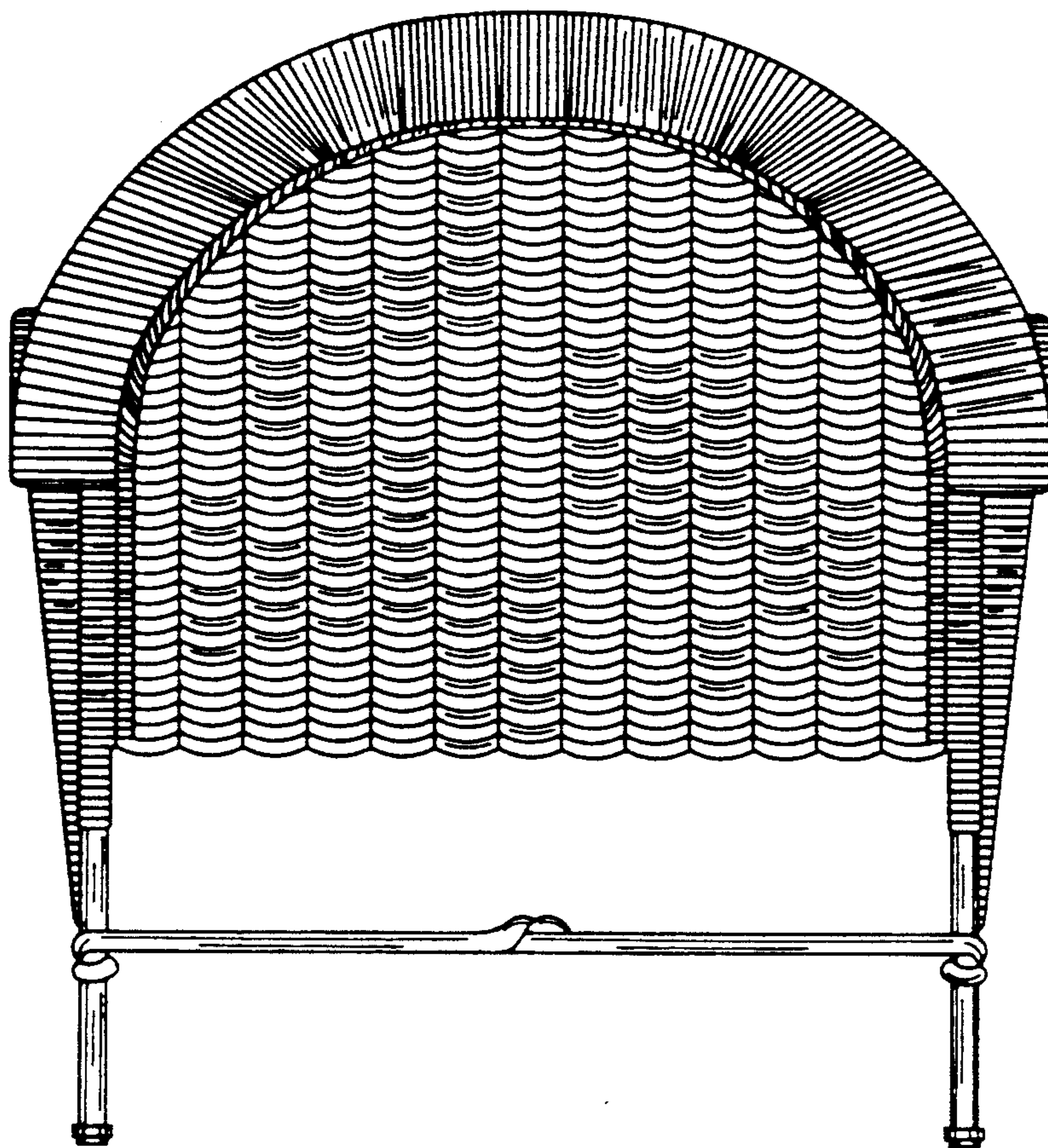

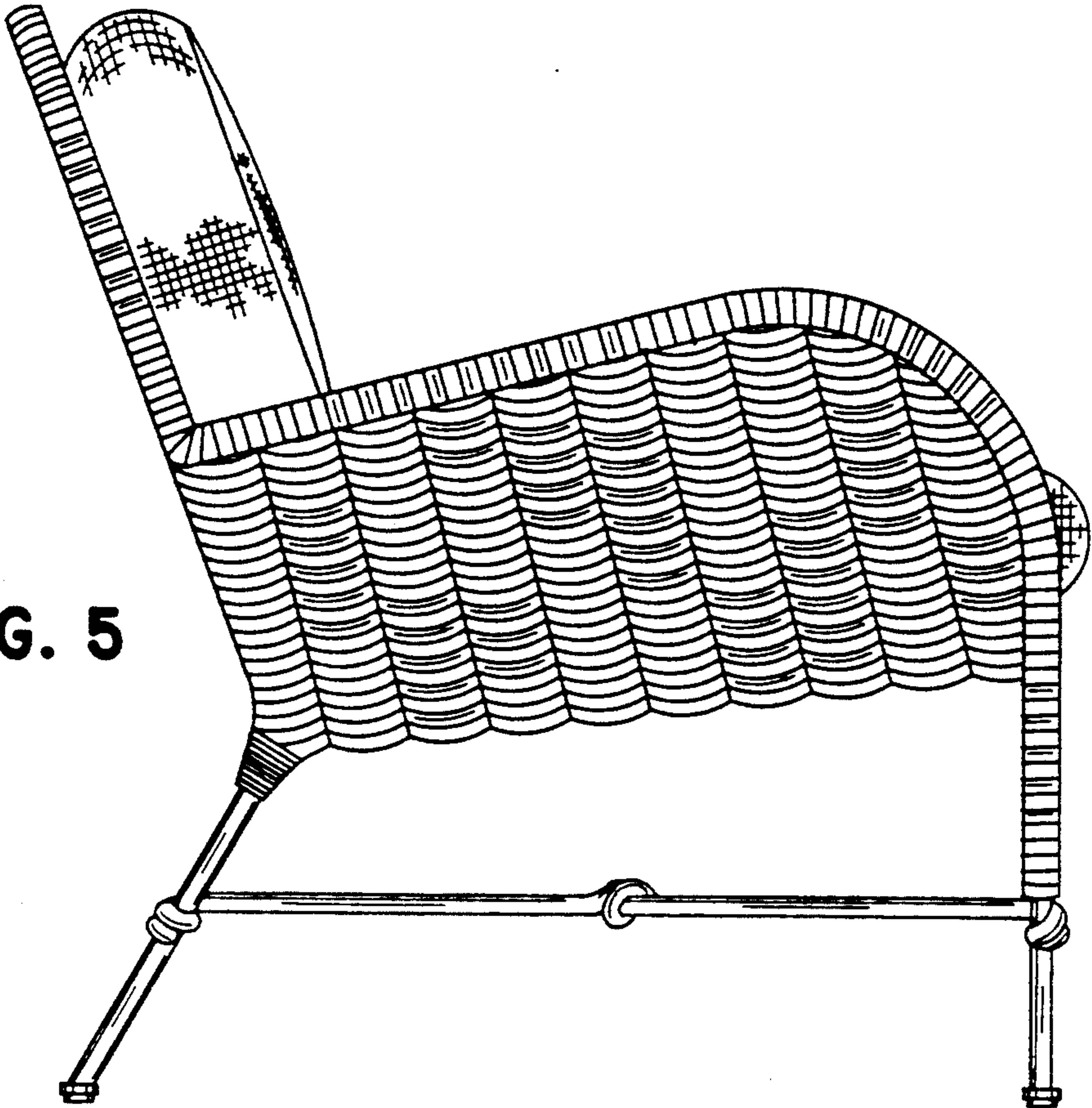
