The ornamental design for a dresser, as shown and described.

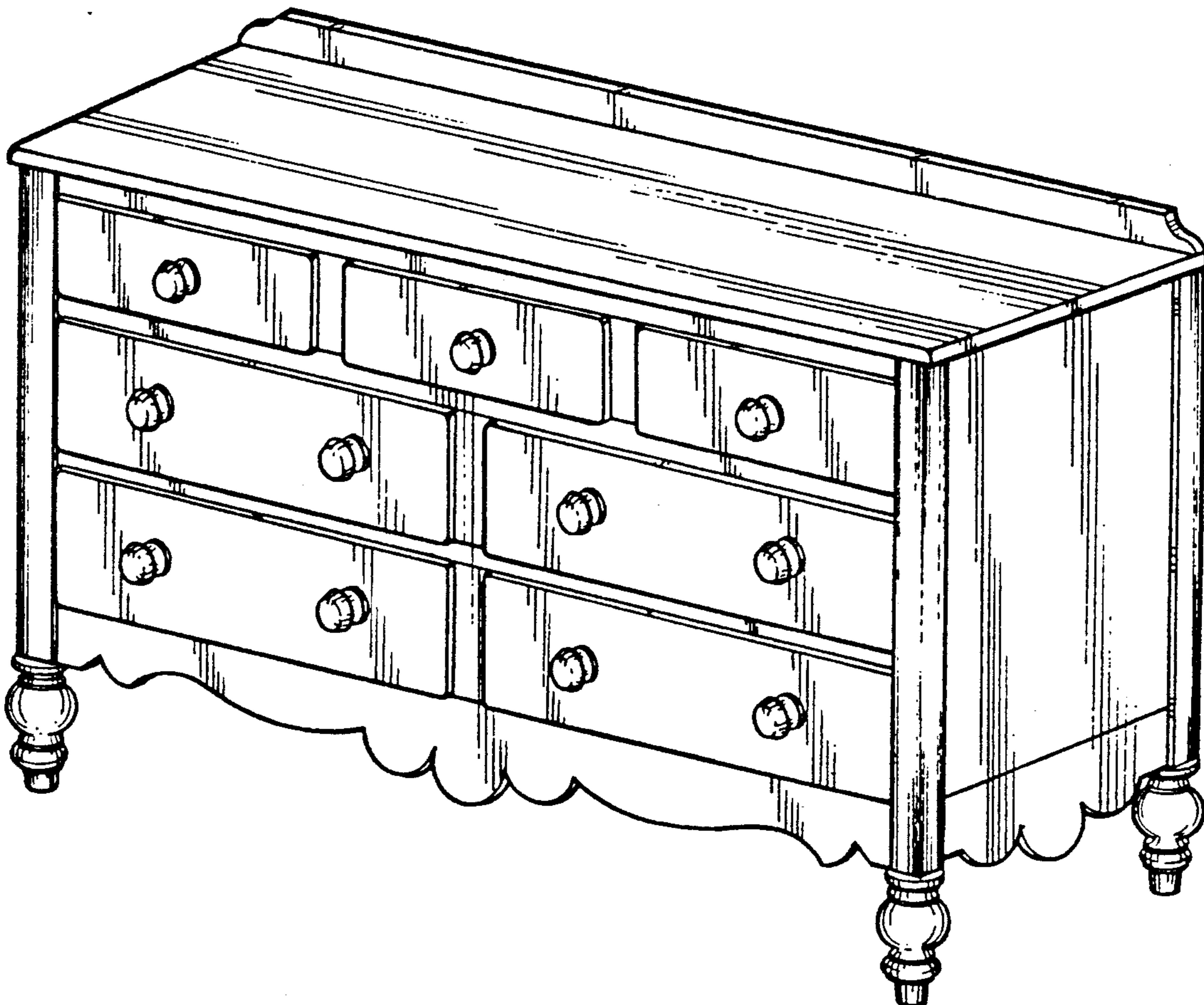
DESCRIPTION

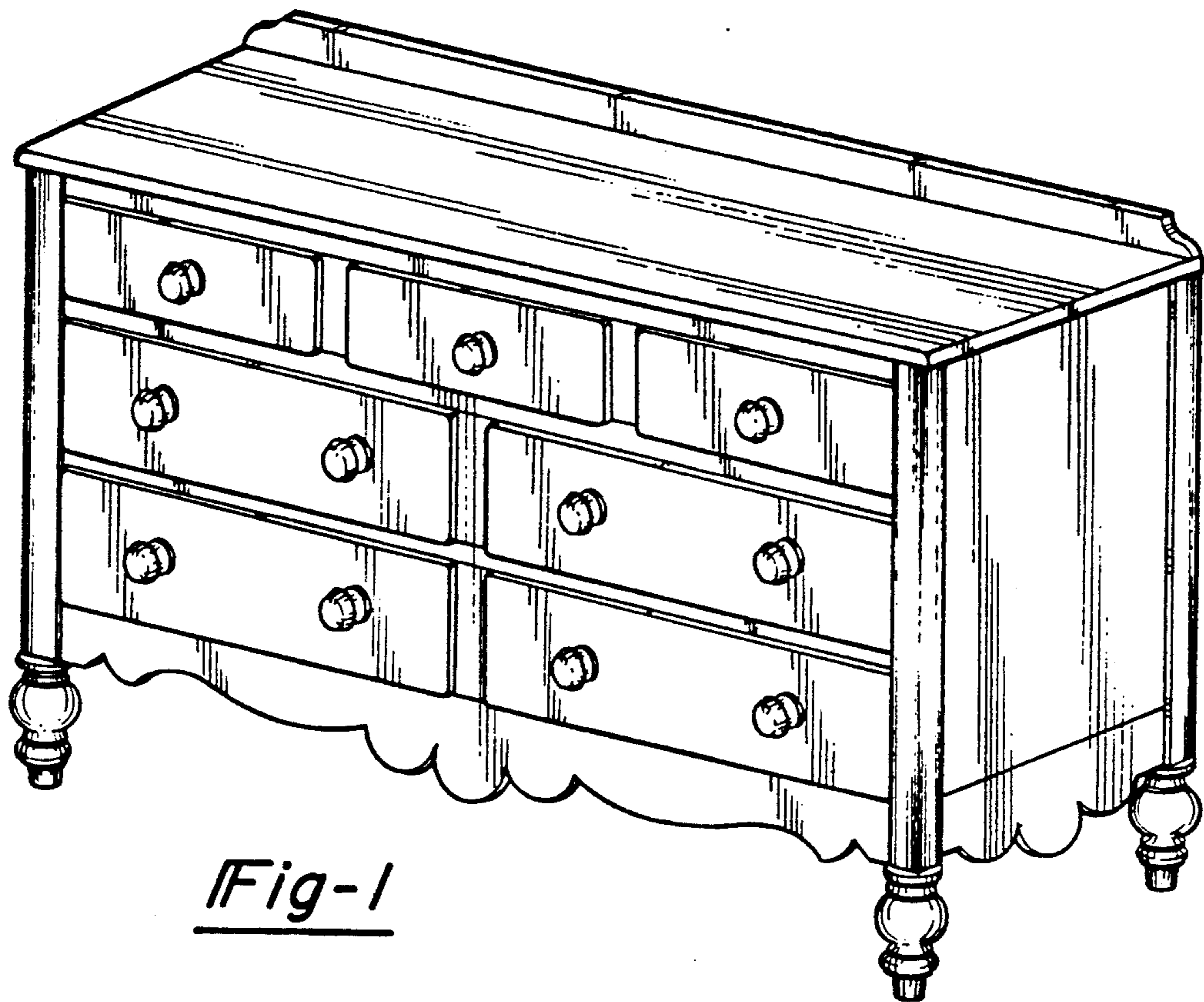

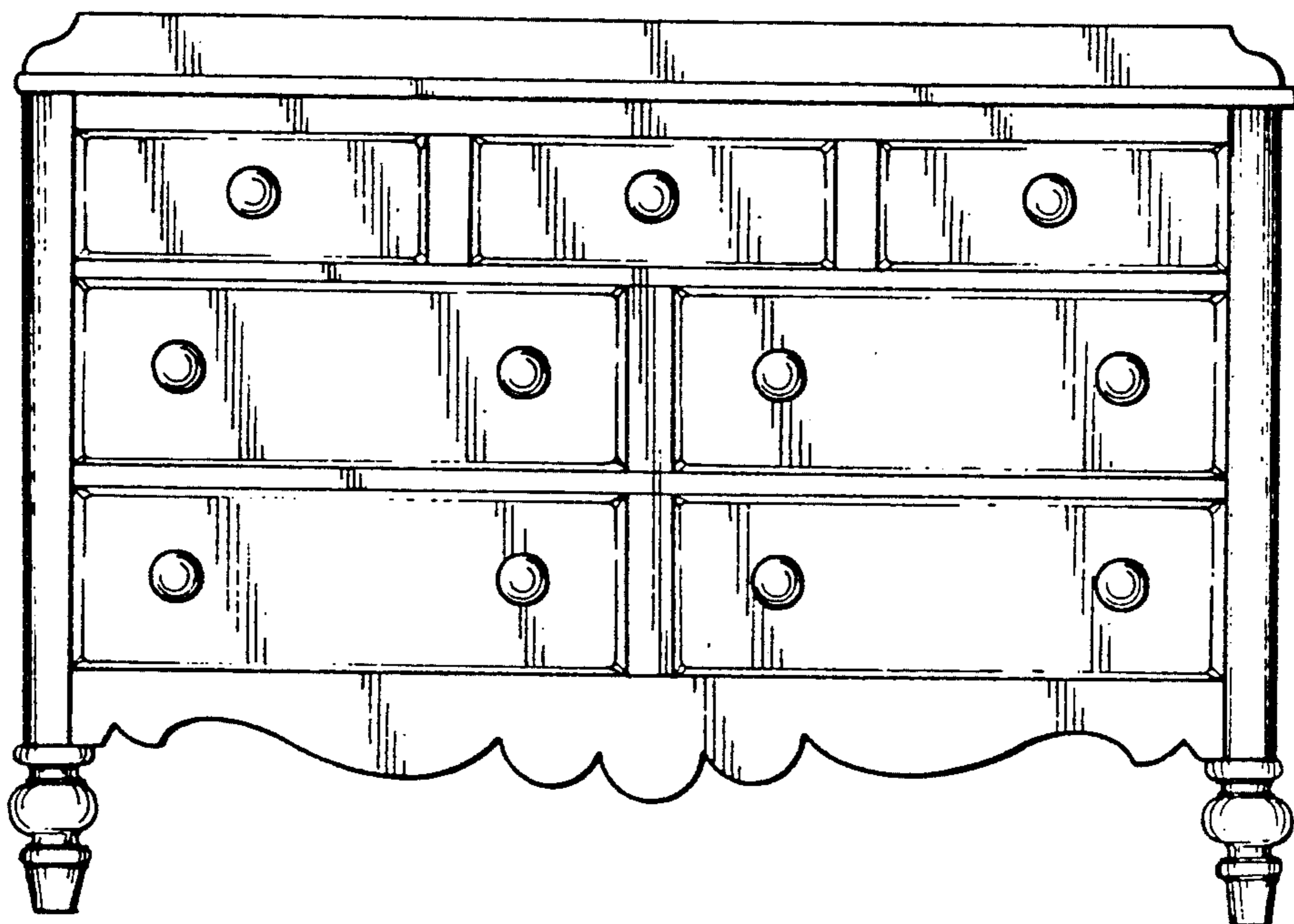

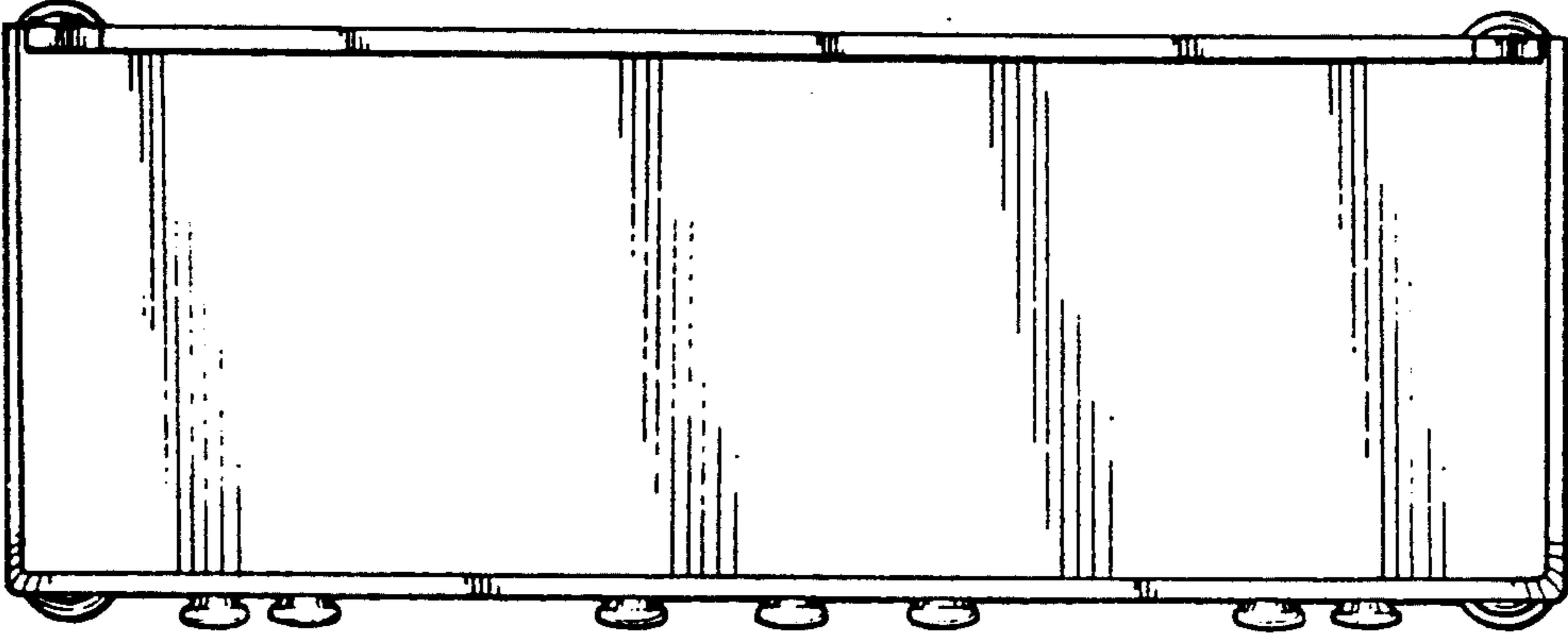

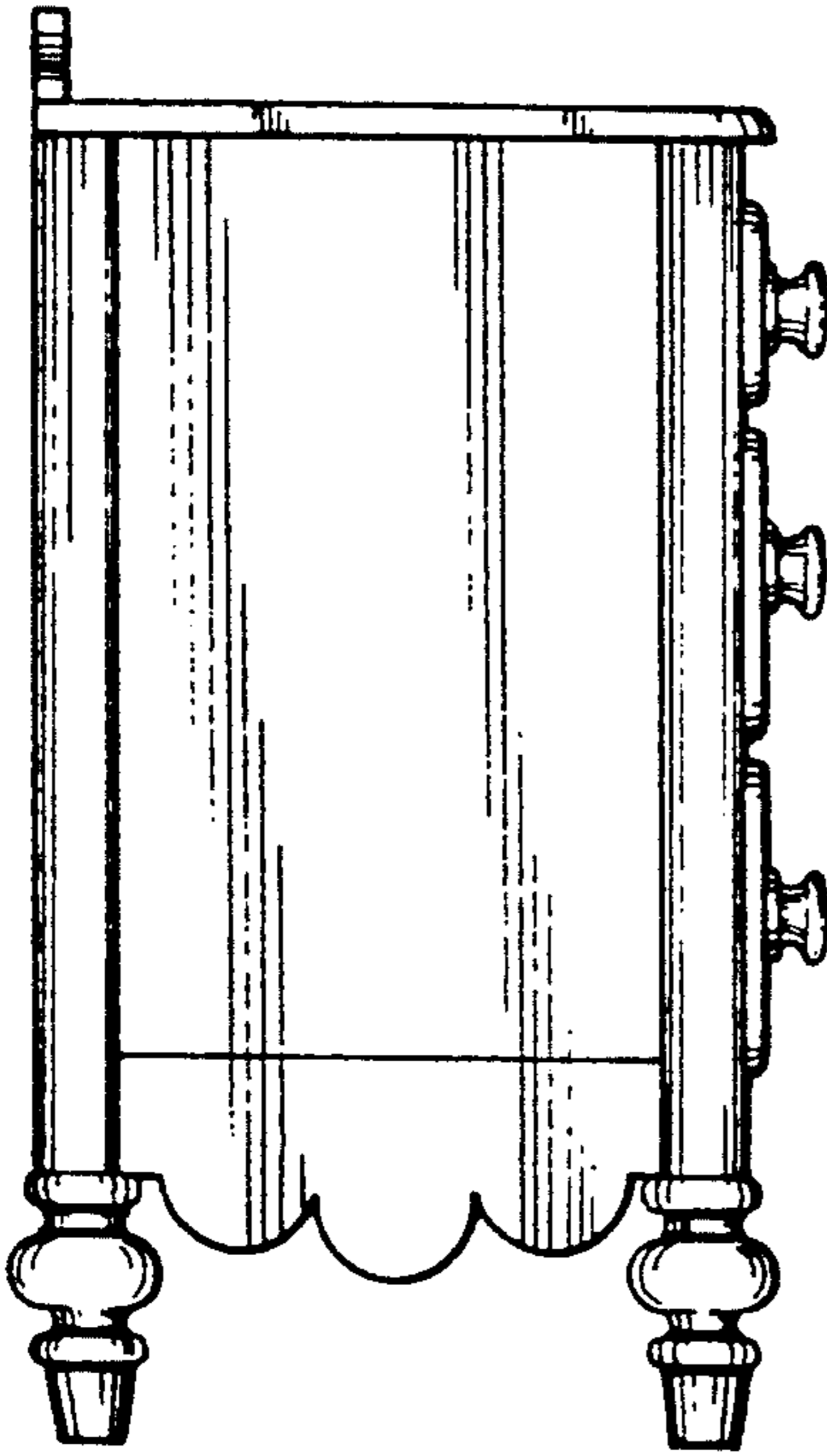

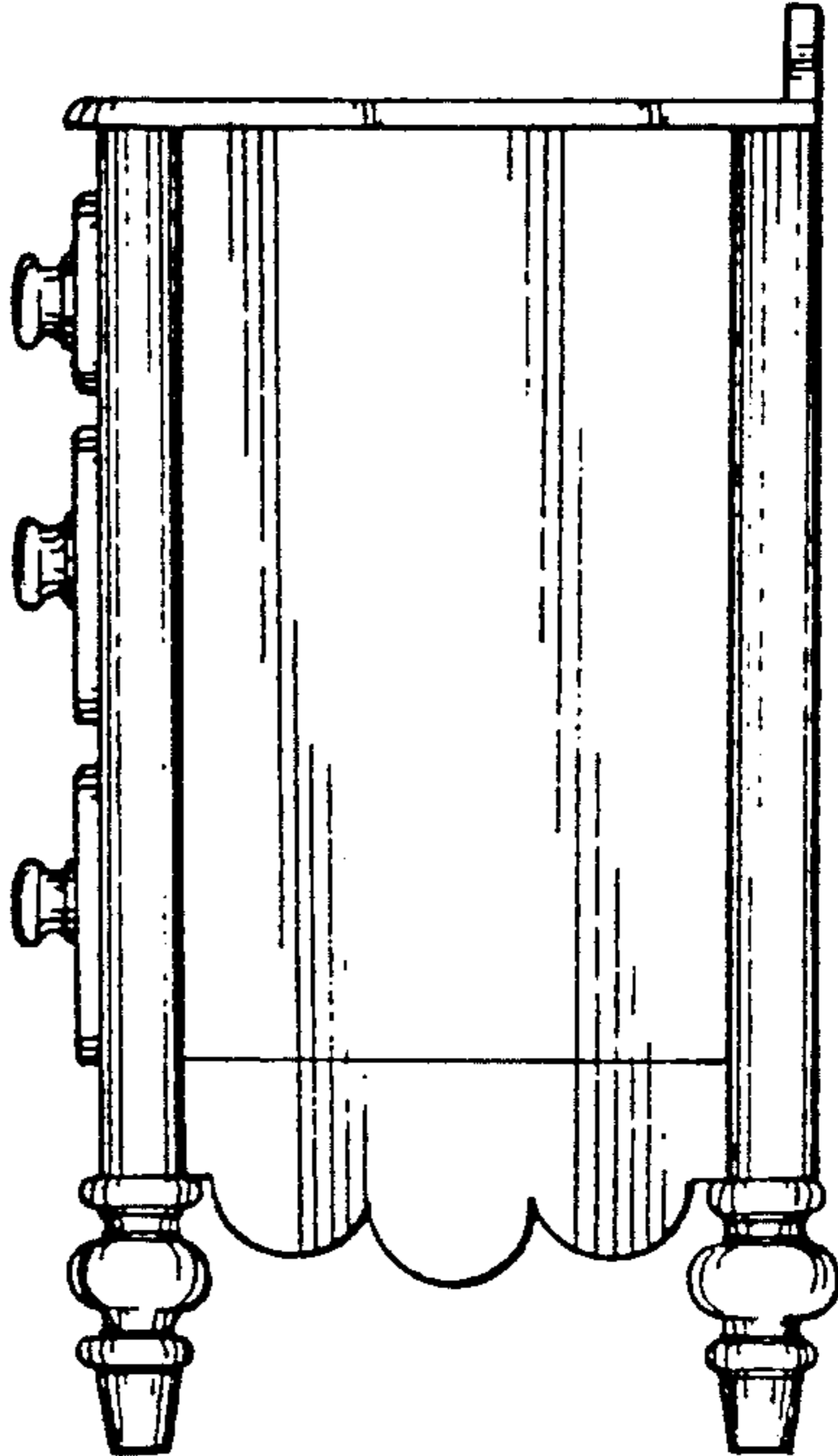
