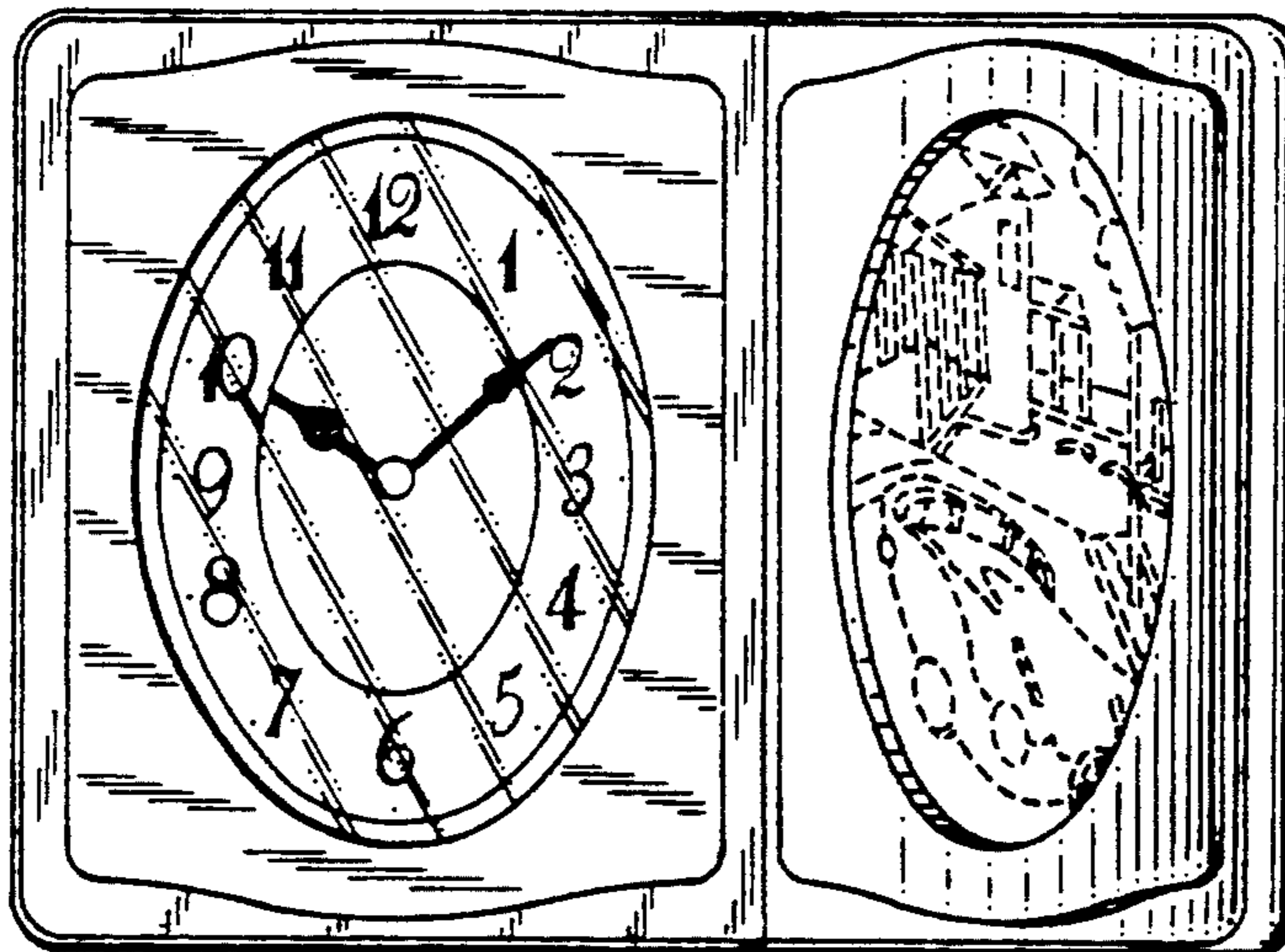

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clock with picture frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock with picture frame showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being the same in appearance as the top;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view with a broken line showing of a representative photograph which is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



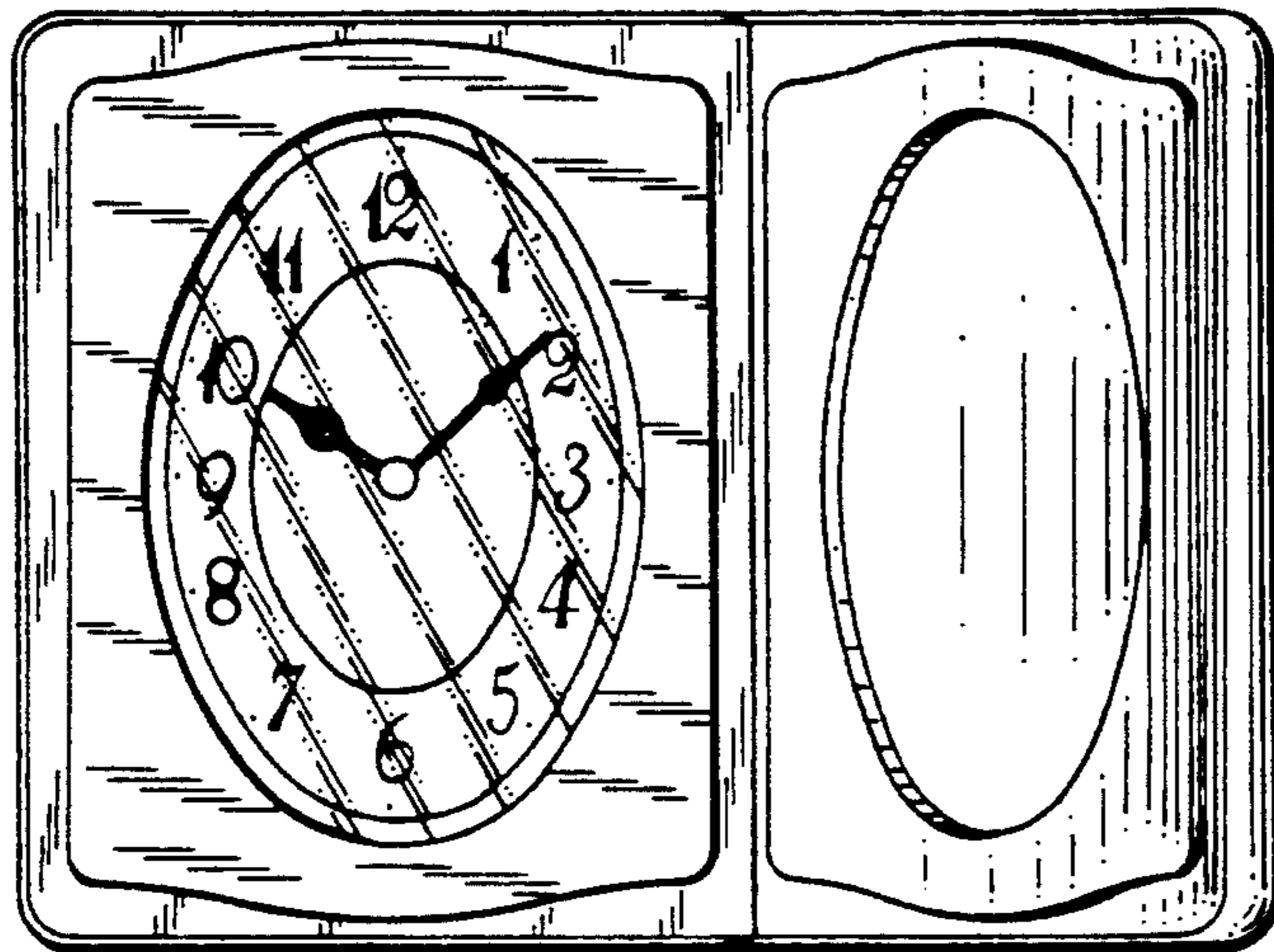

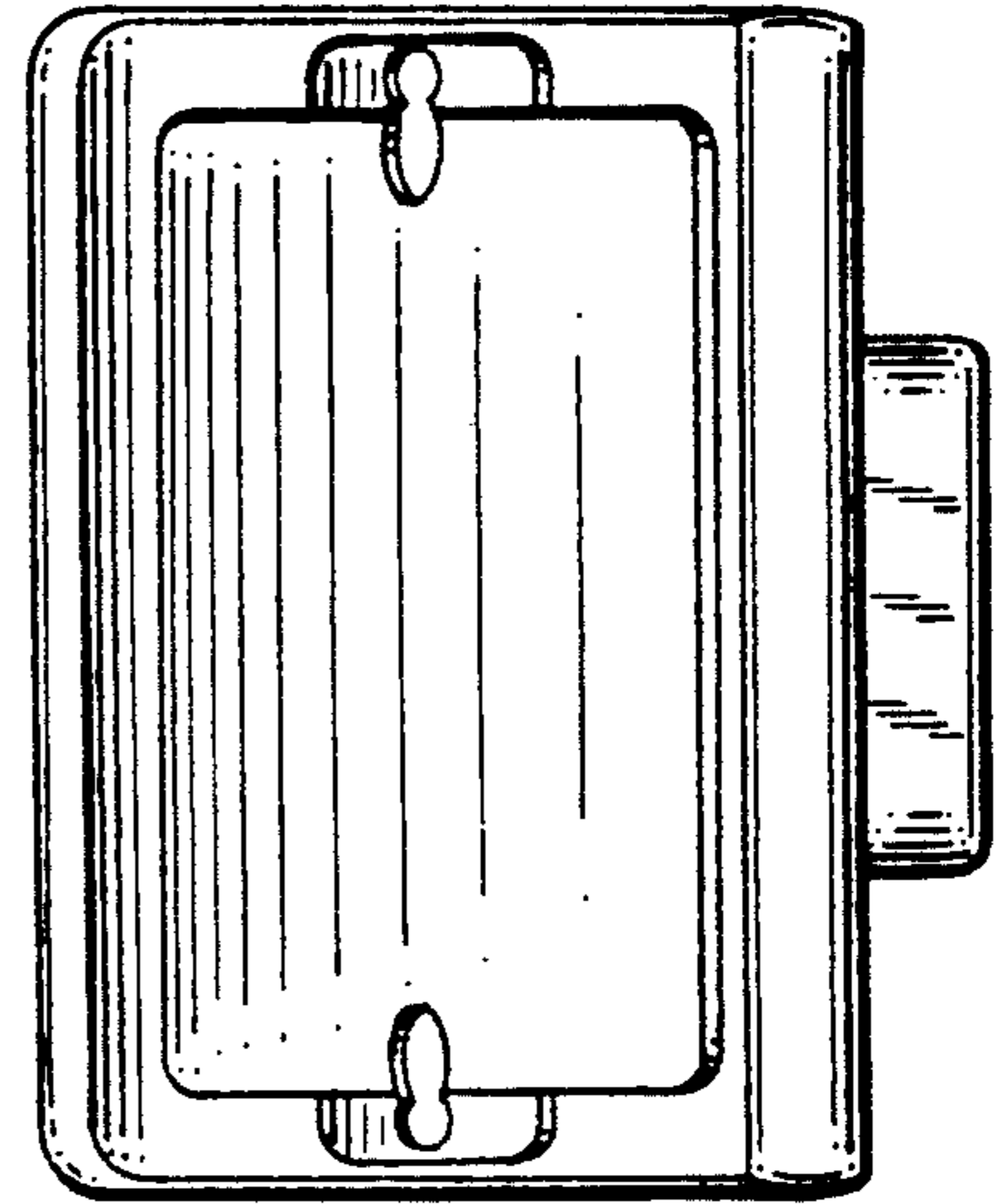

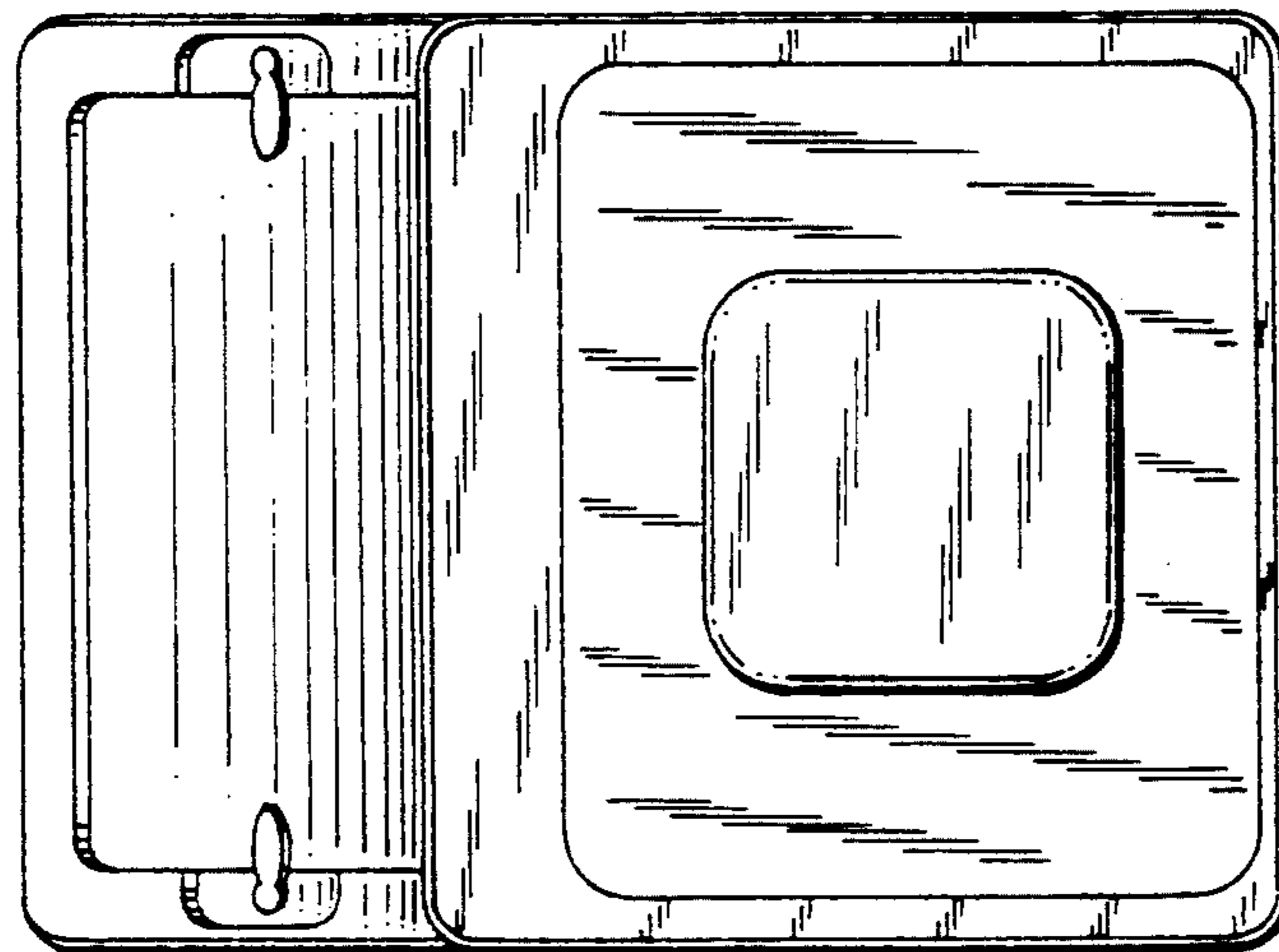

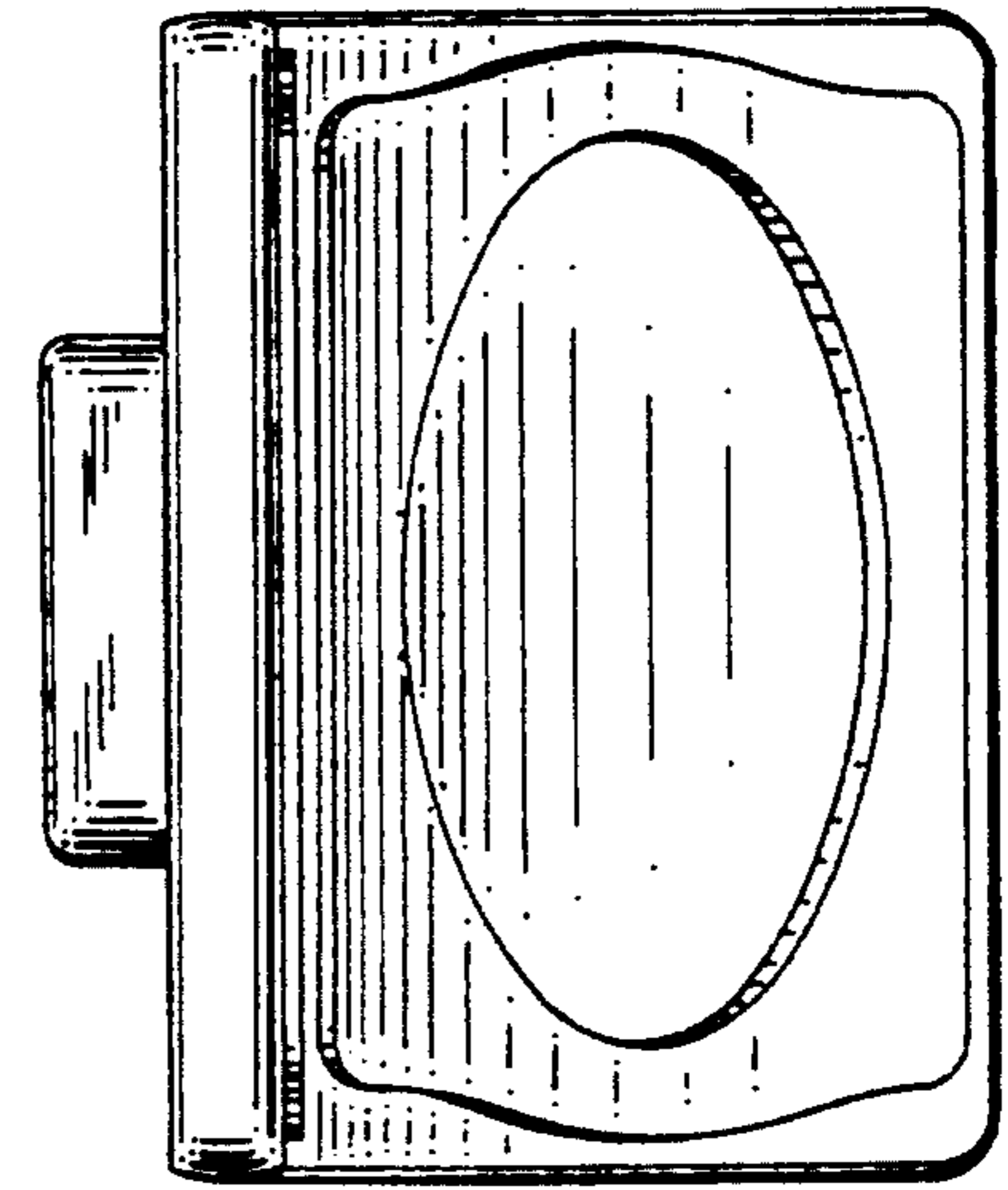

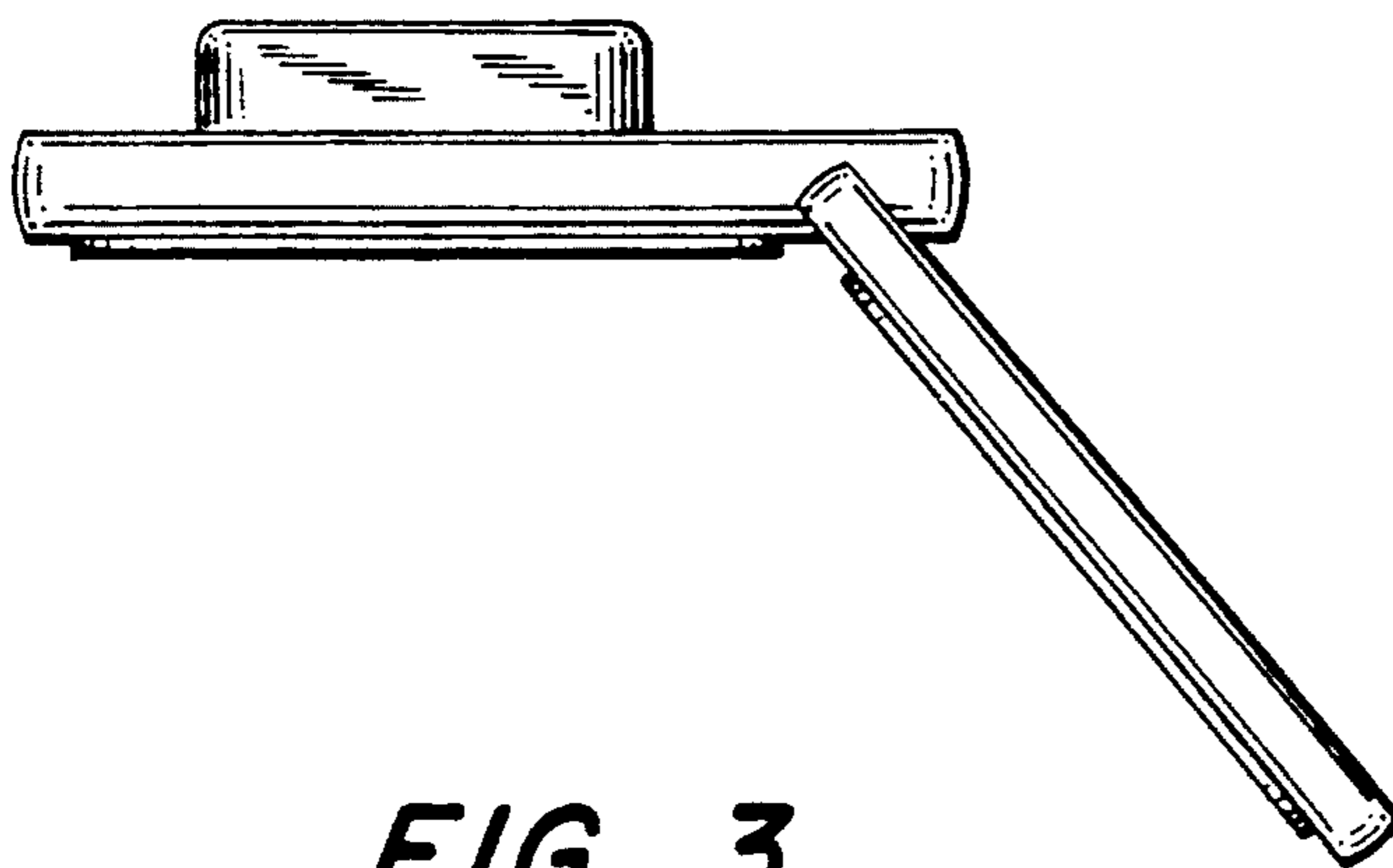

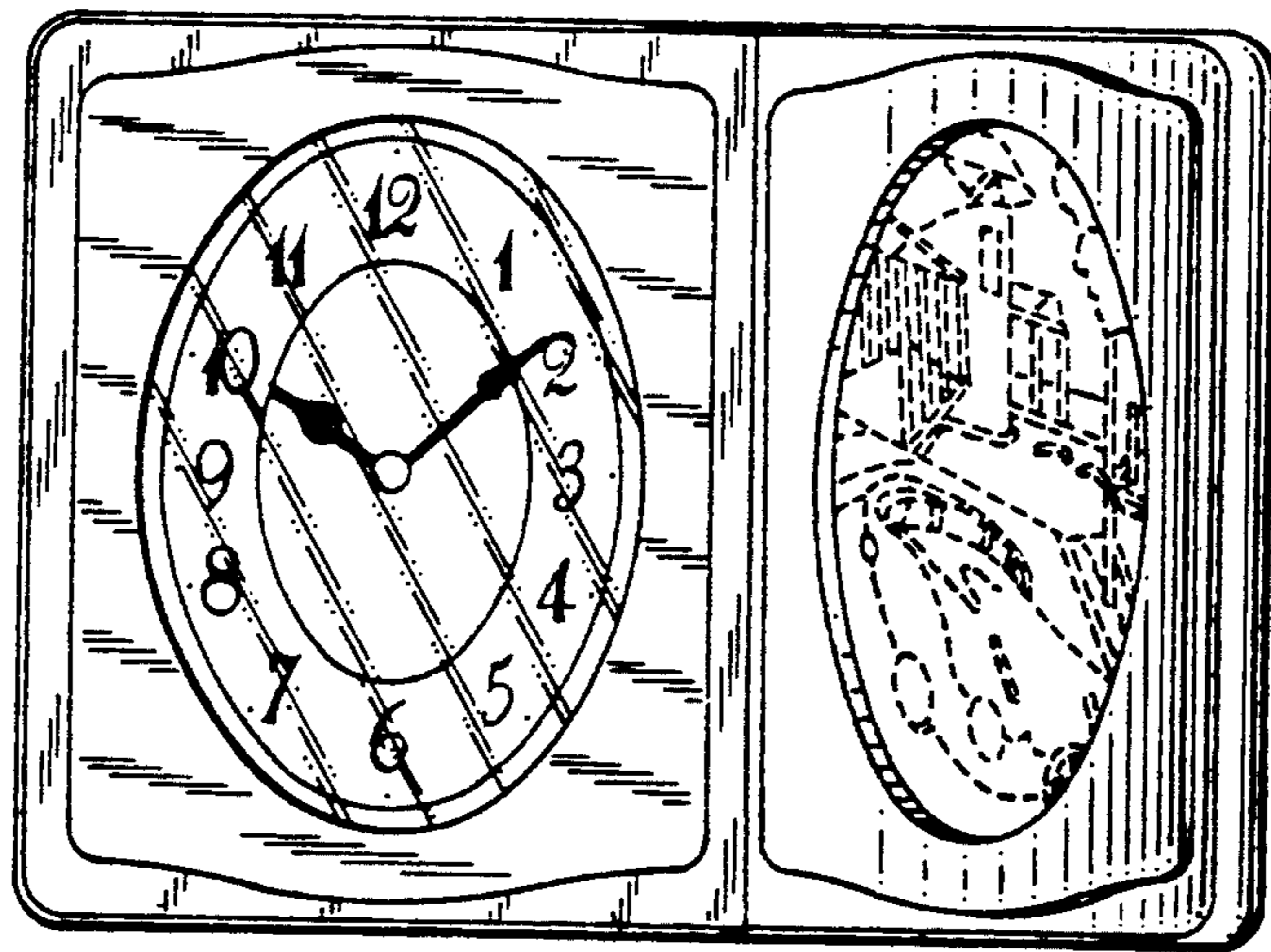
