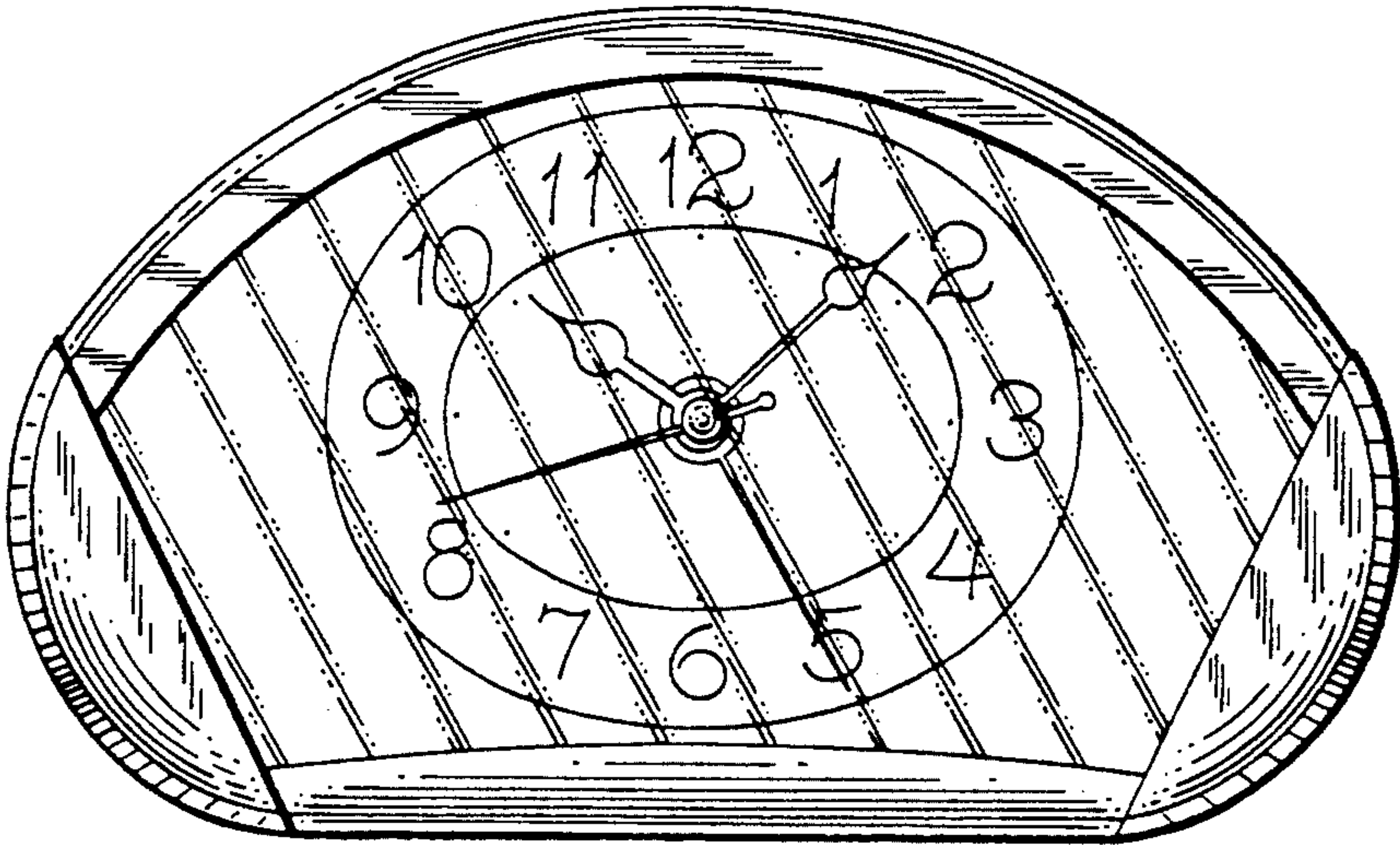

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being the same in appearance as the right side.



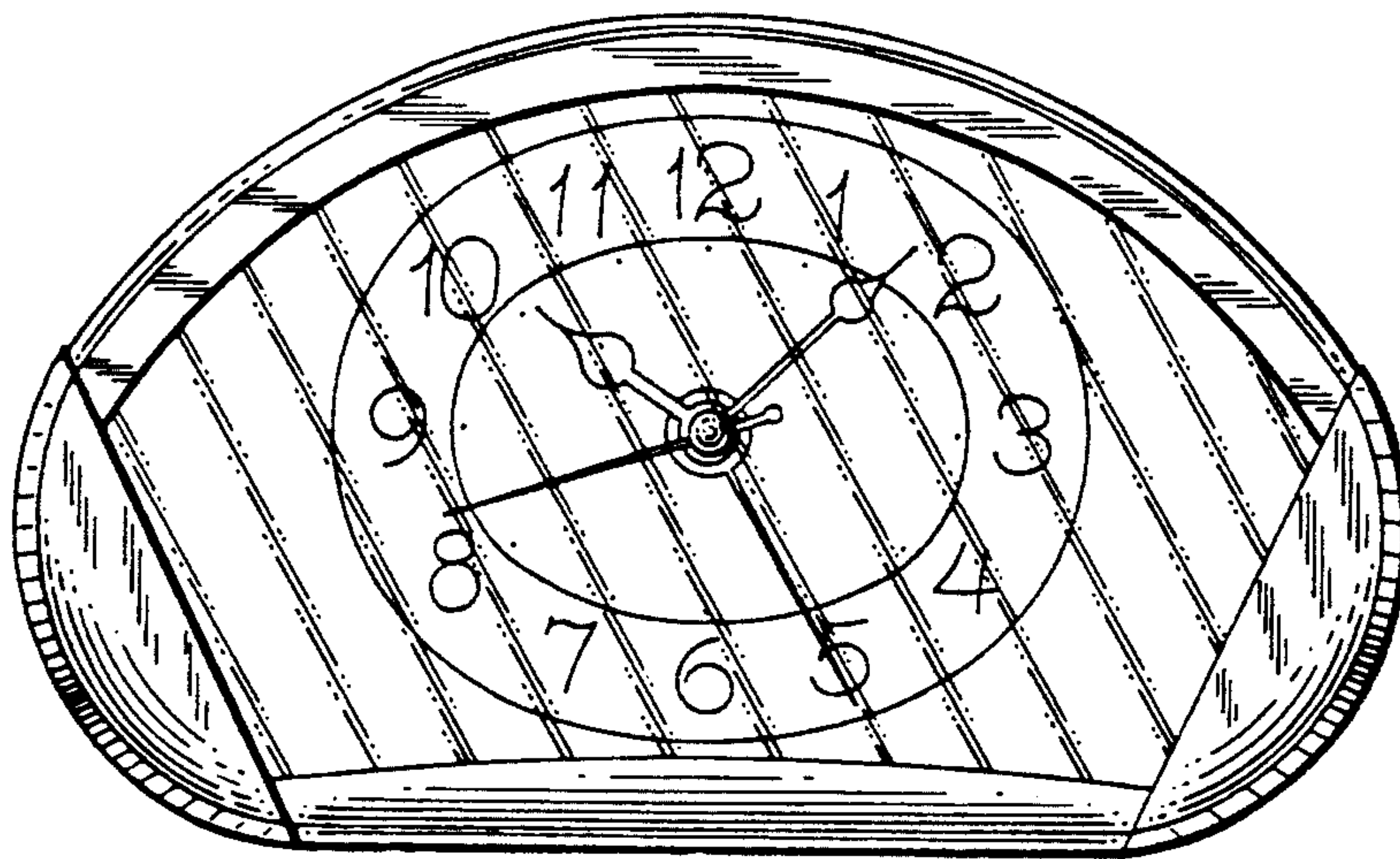

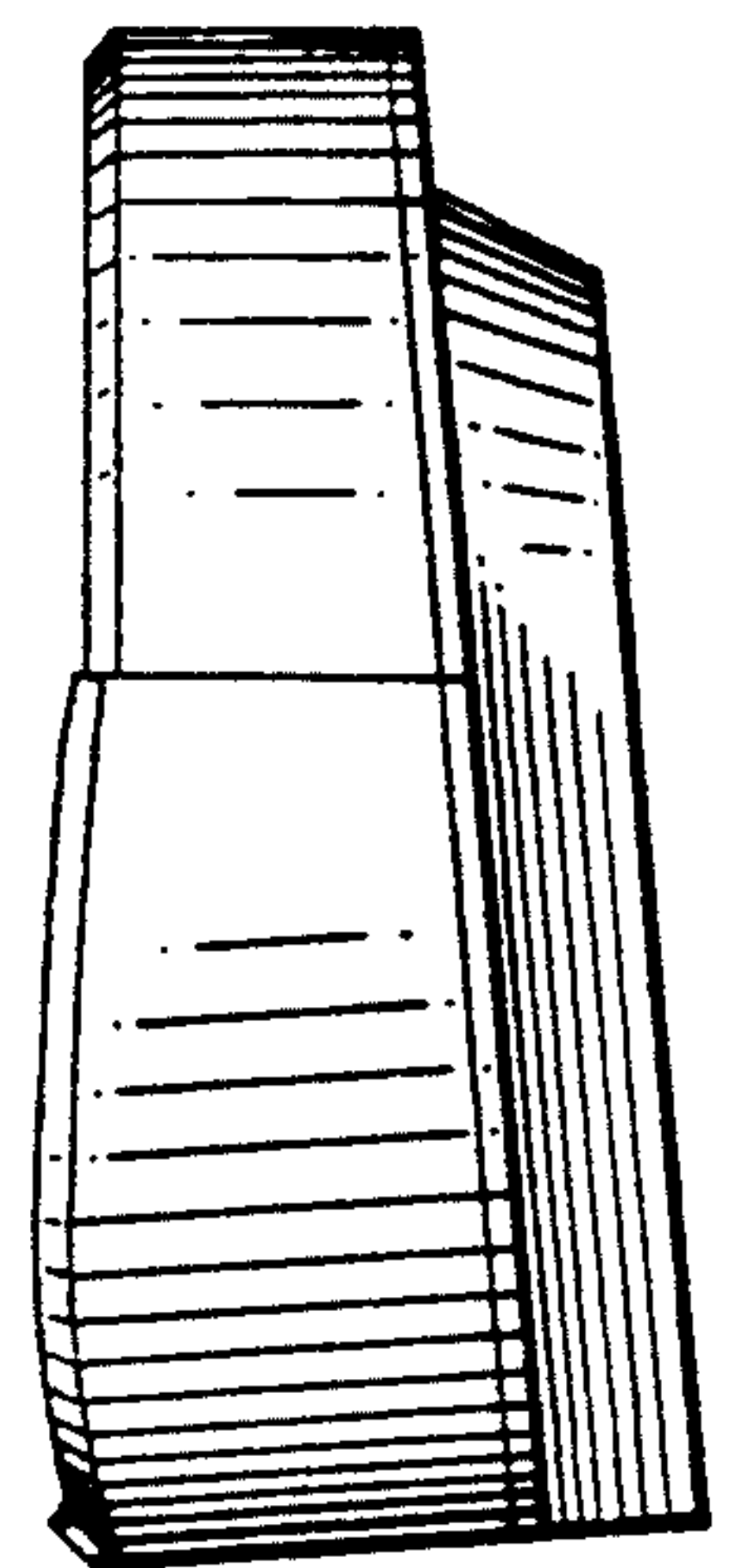

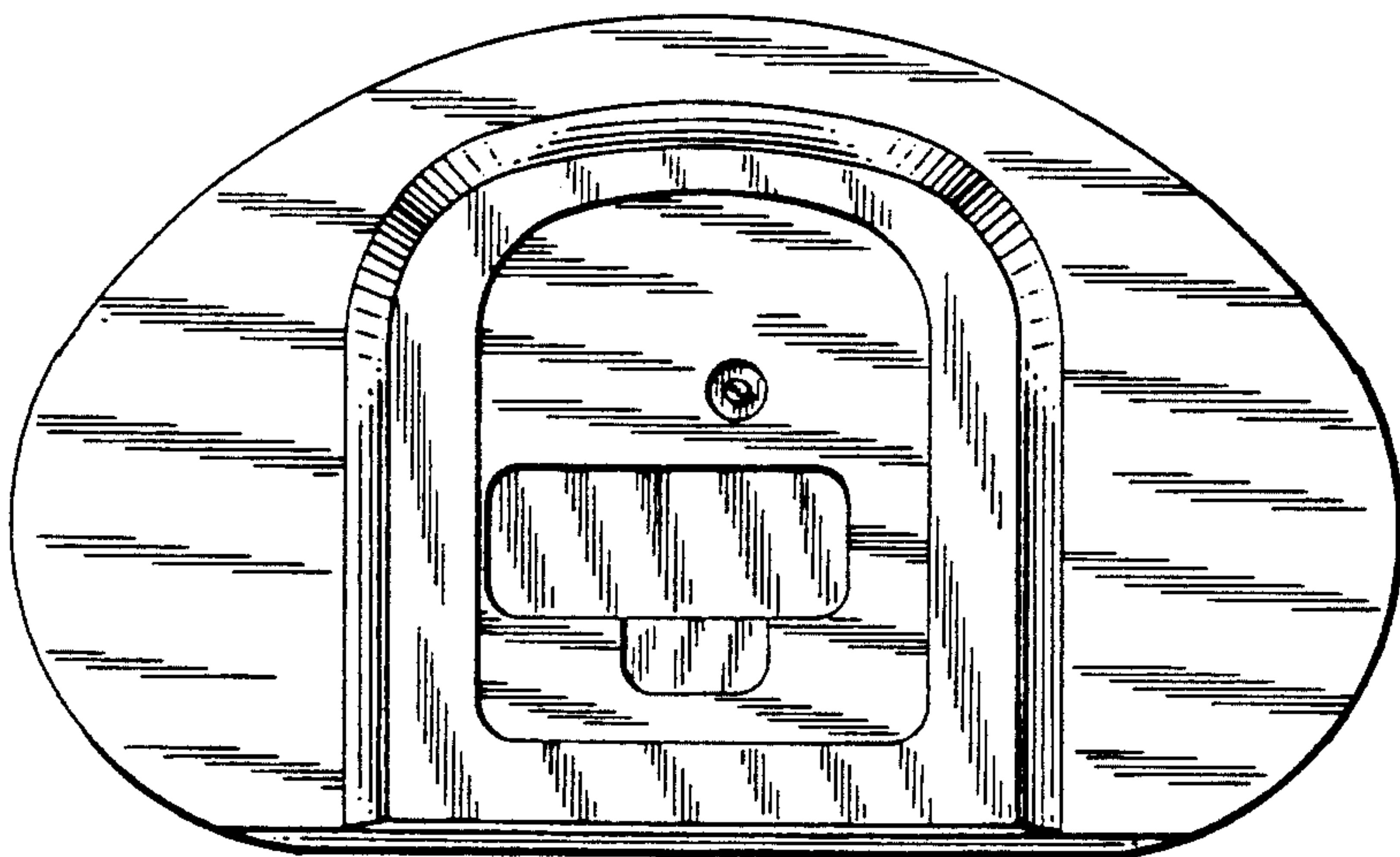

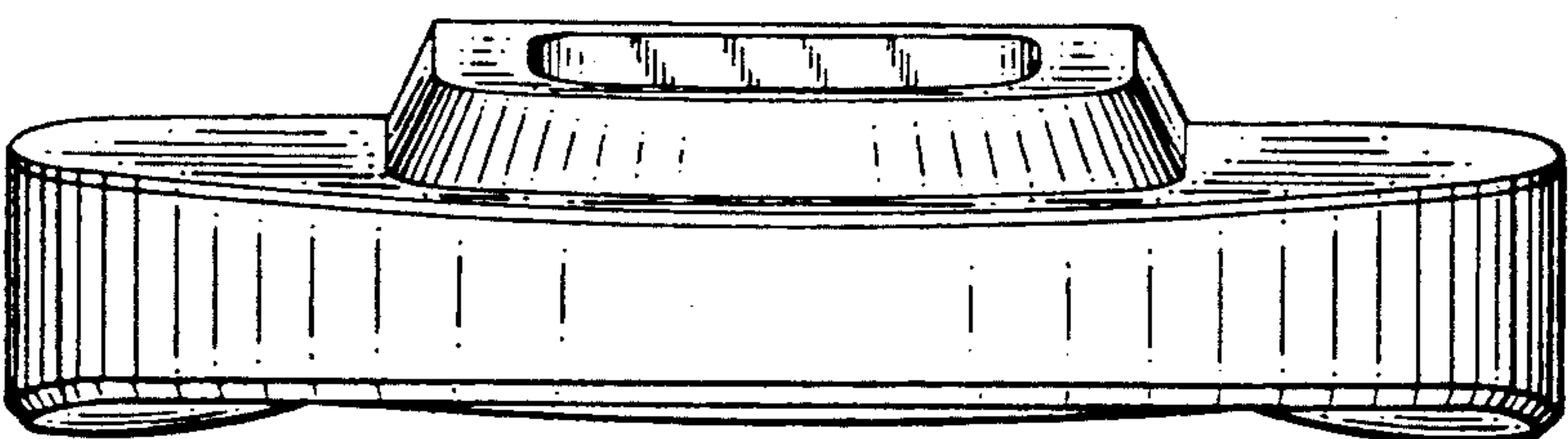

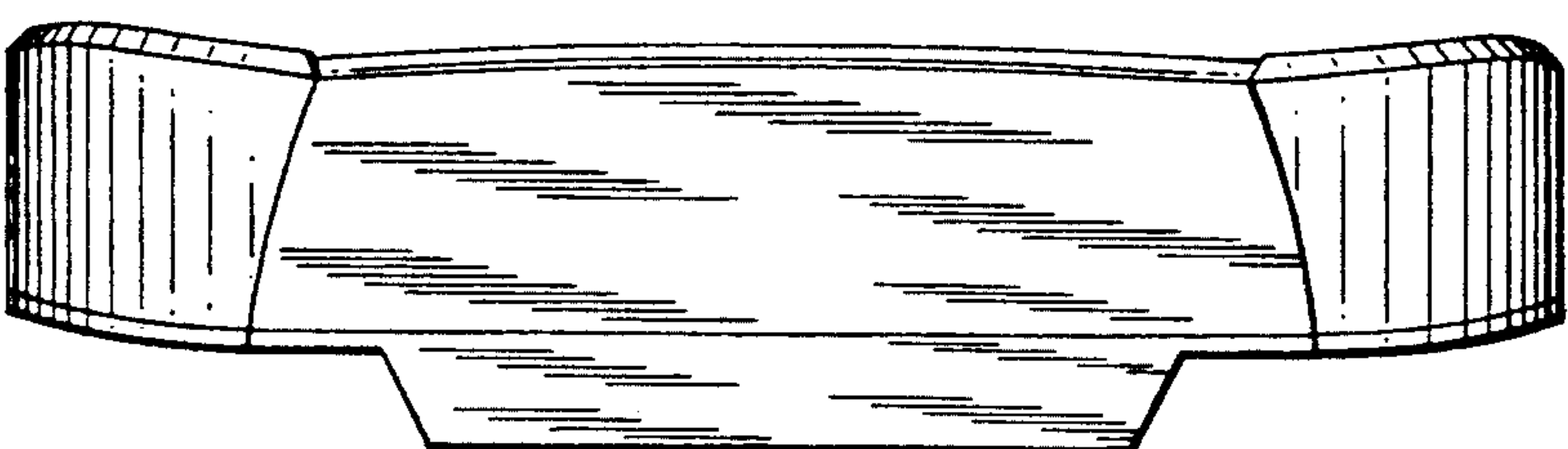
