FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view a shoe sole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side of the shoe sole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the other side of the shoe sole shown in FIG. 1;

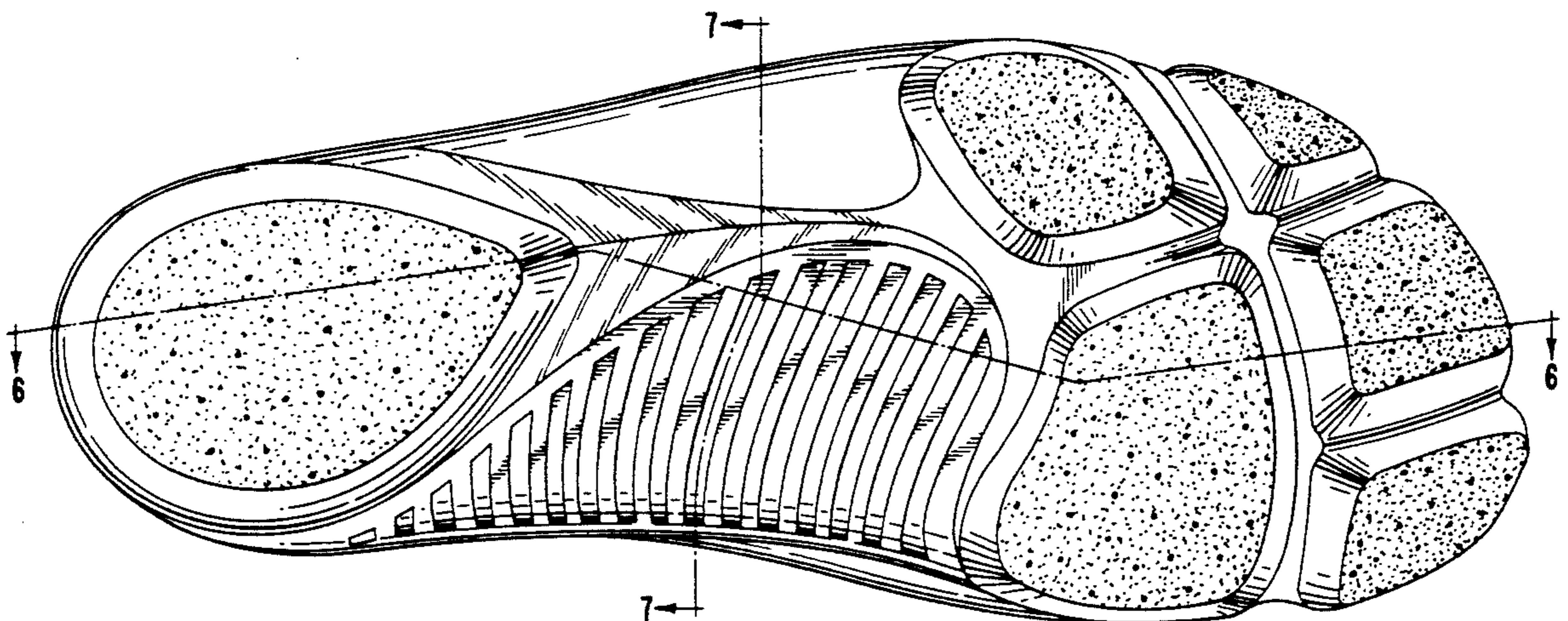
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the shoe sole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the shoe sole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 in FIG. 1; and,

The broken line showing of a shoe upper is for illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed design.



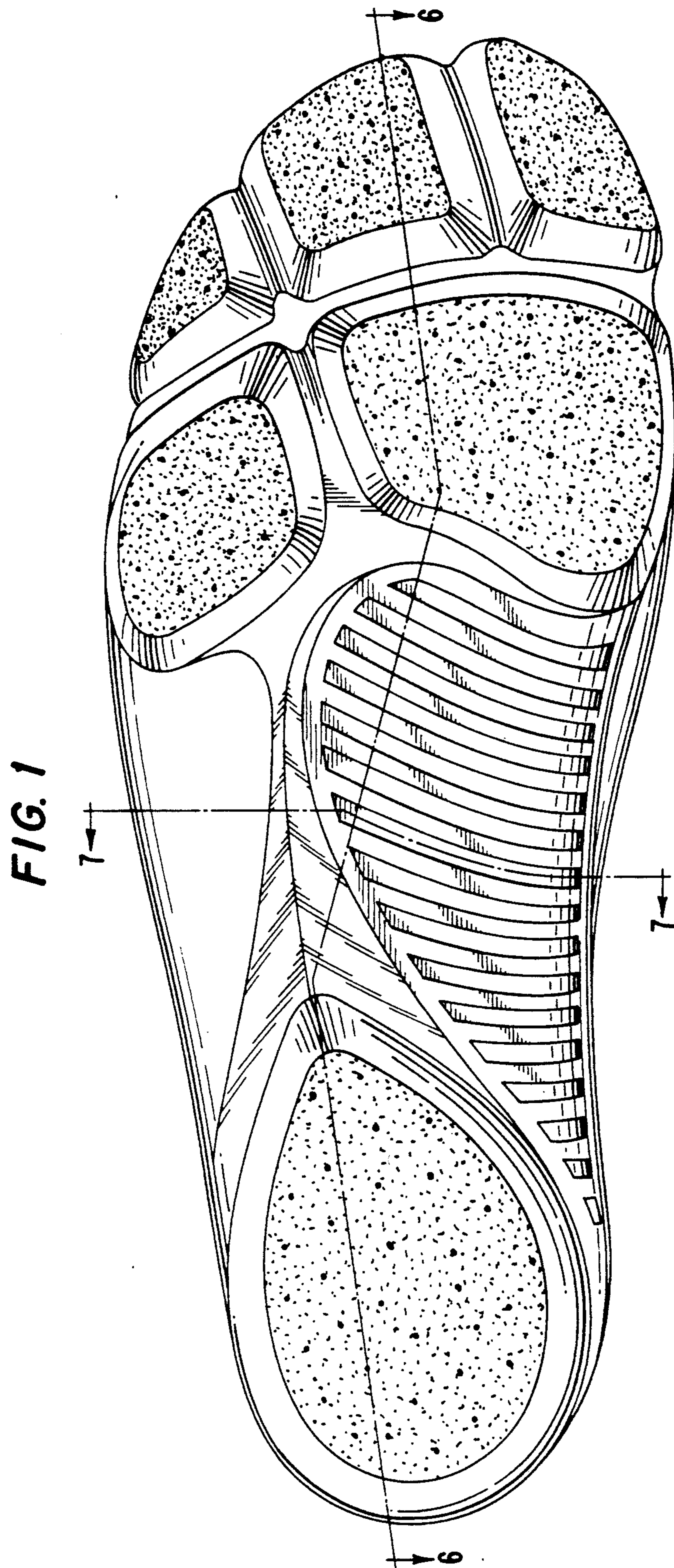

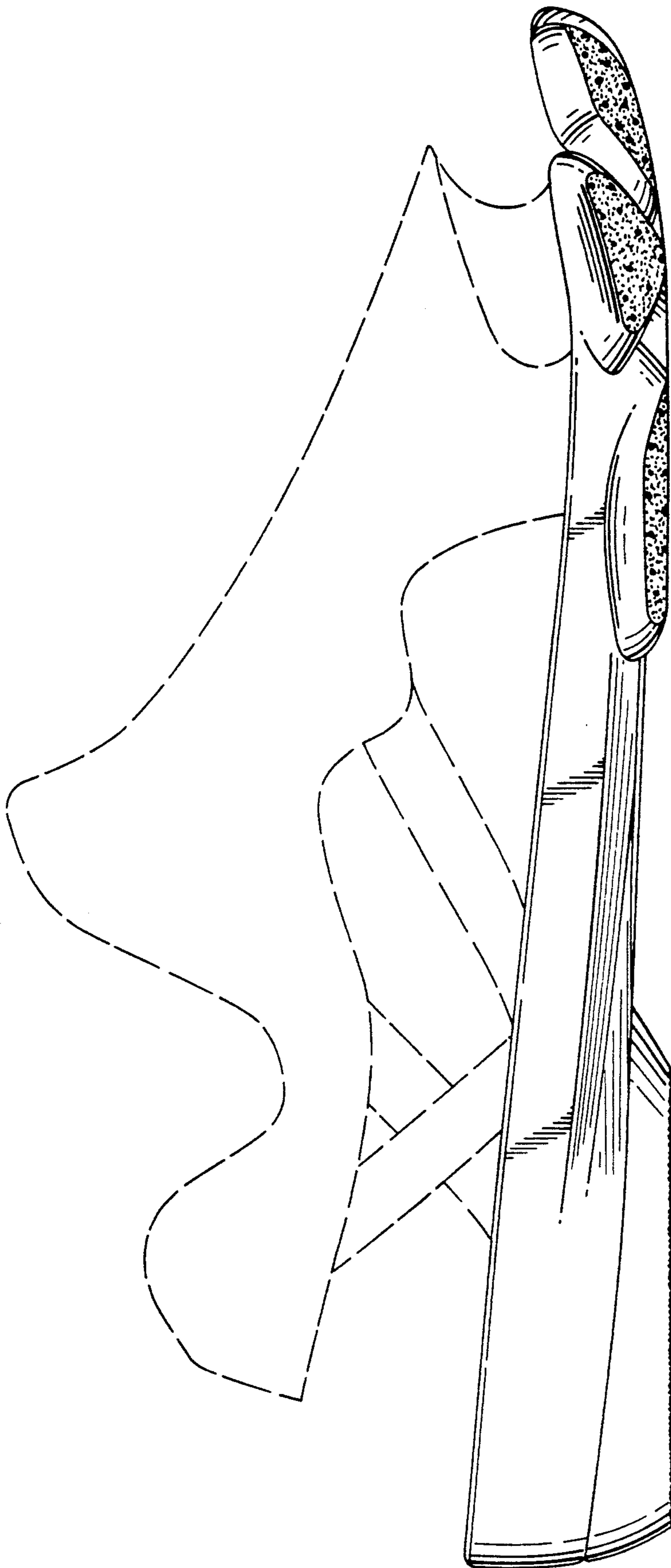

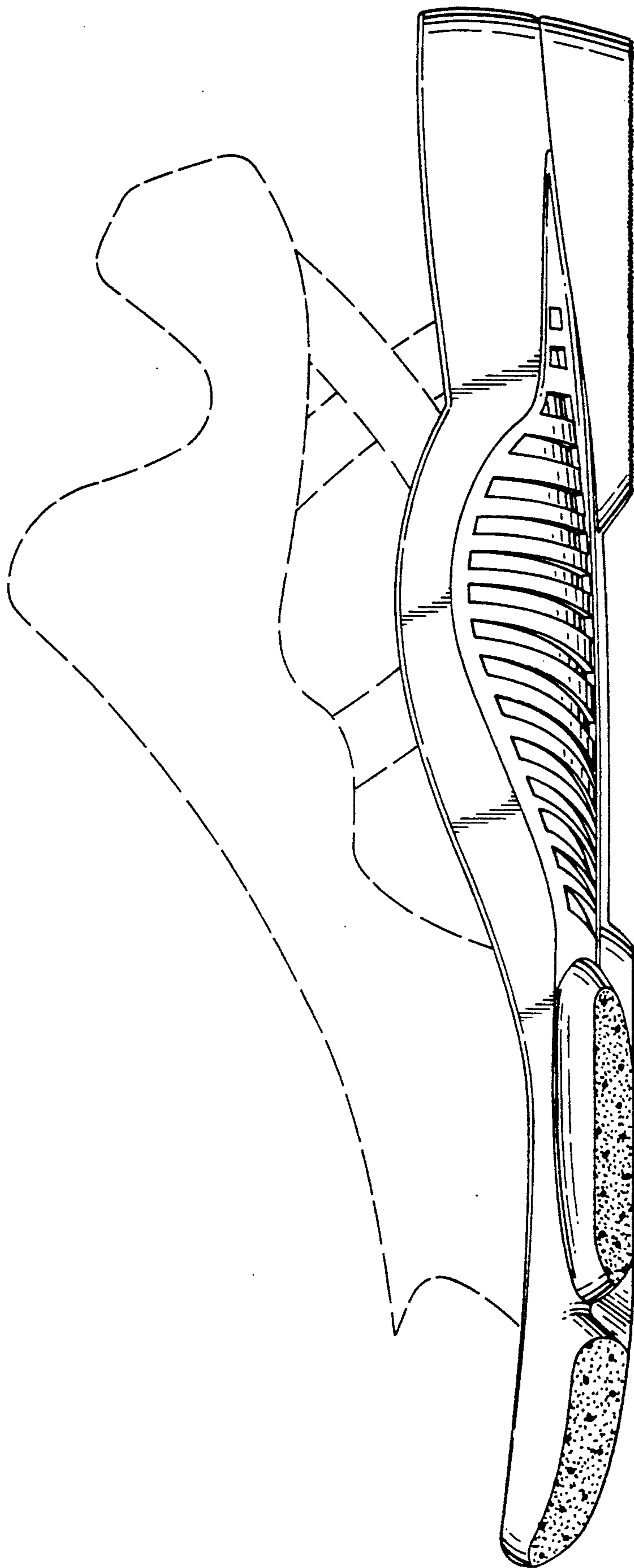

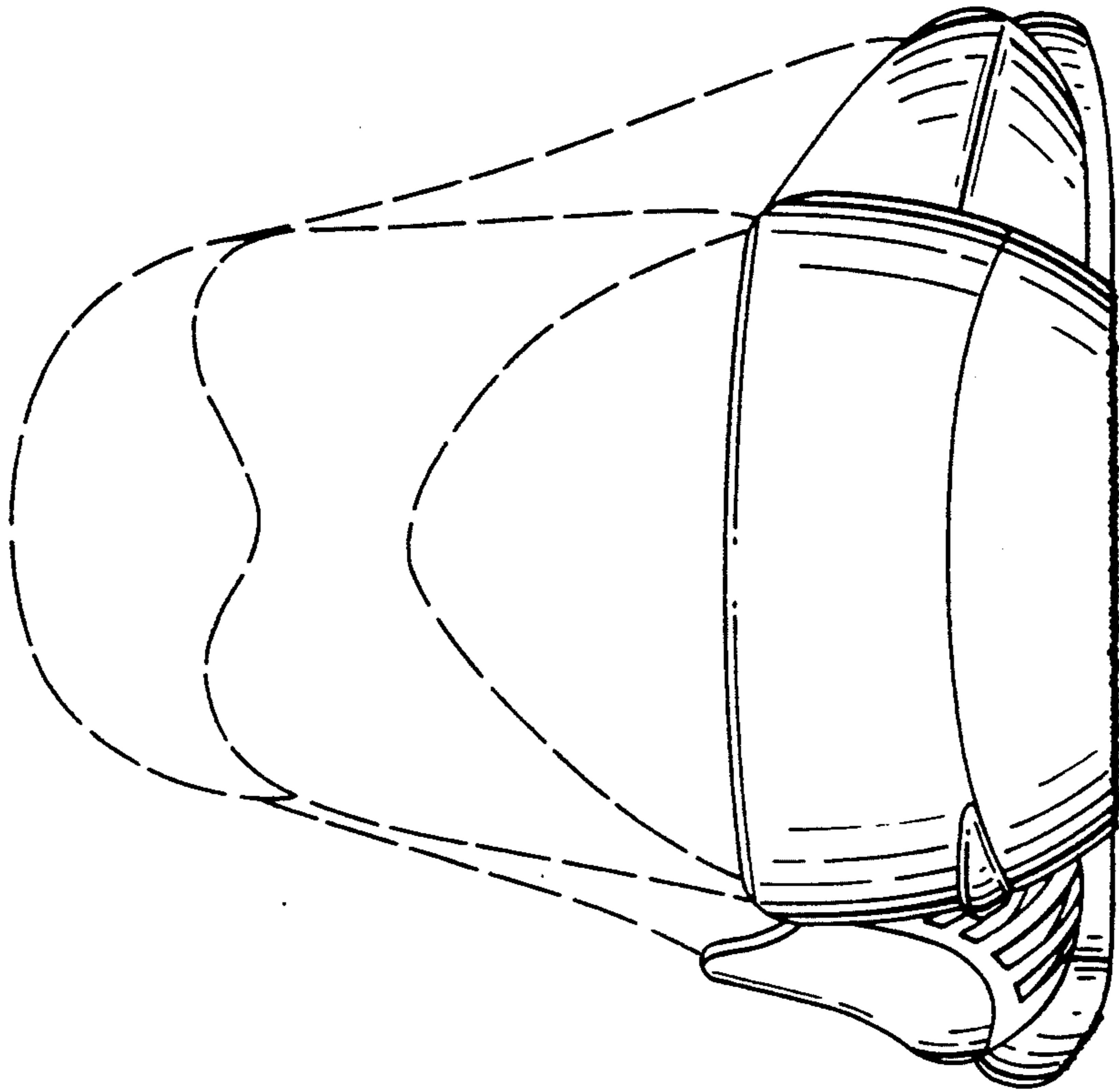
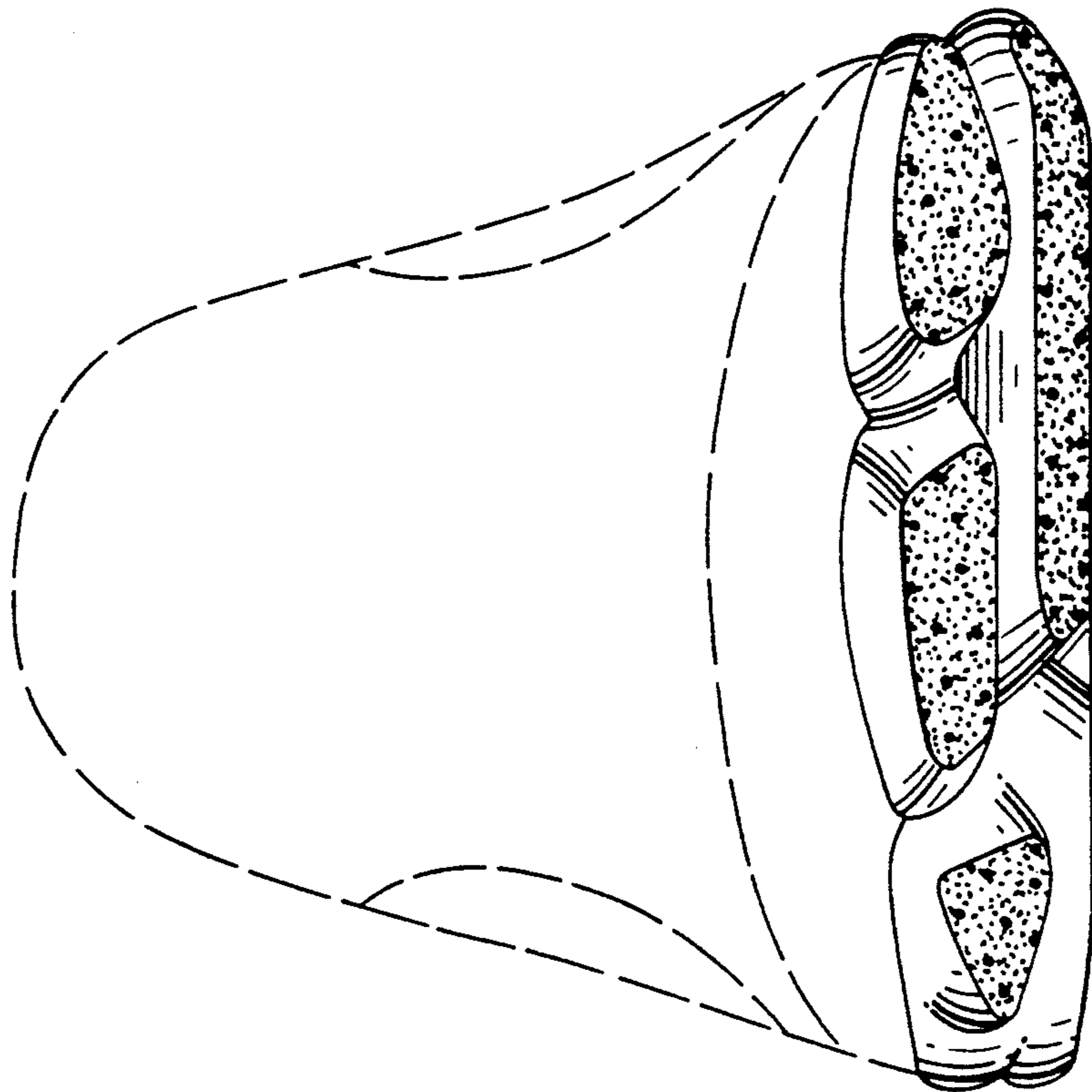

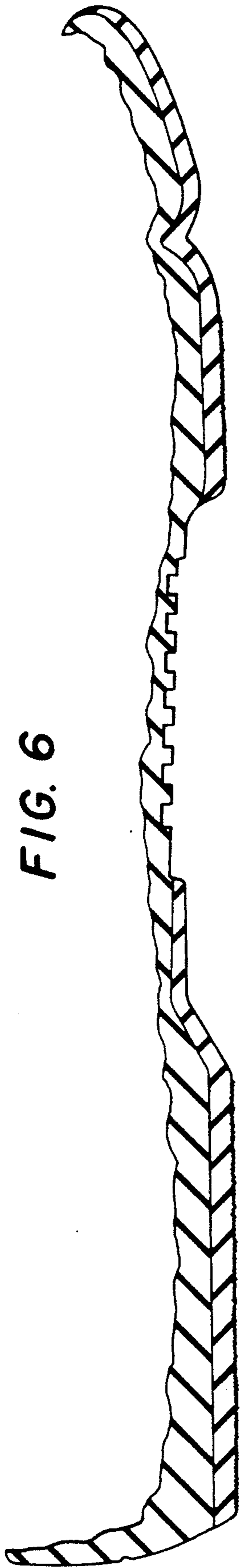
