The rear of the dresser is flat and unornamented.

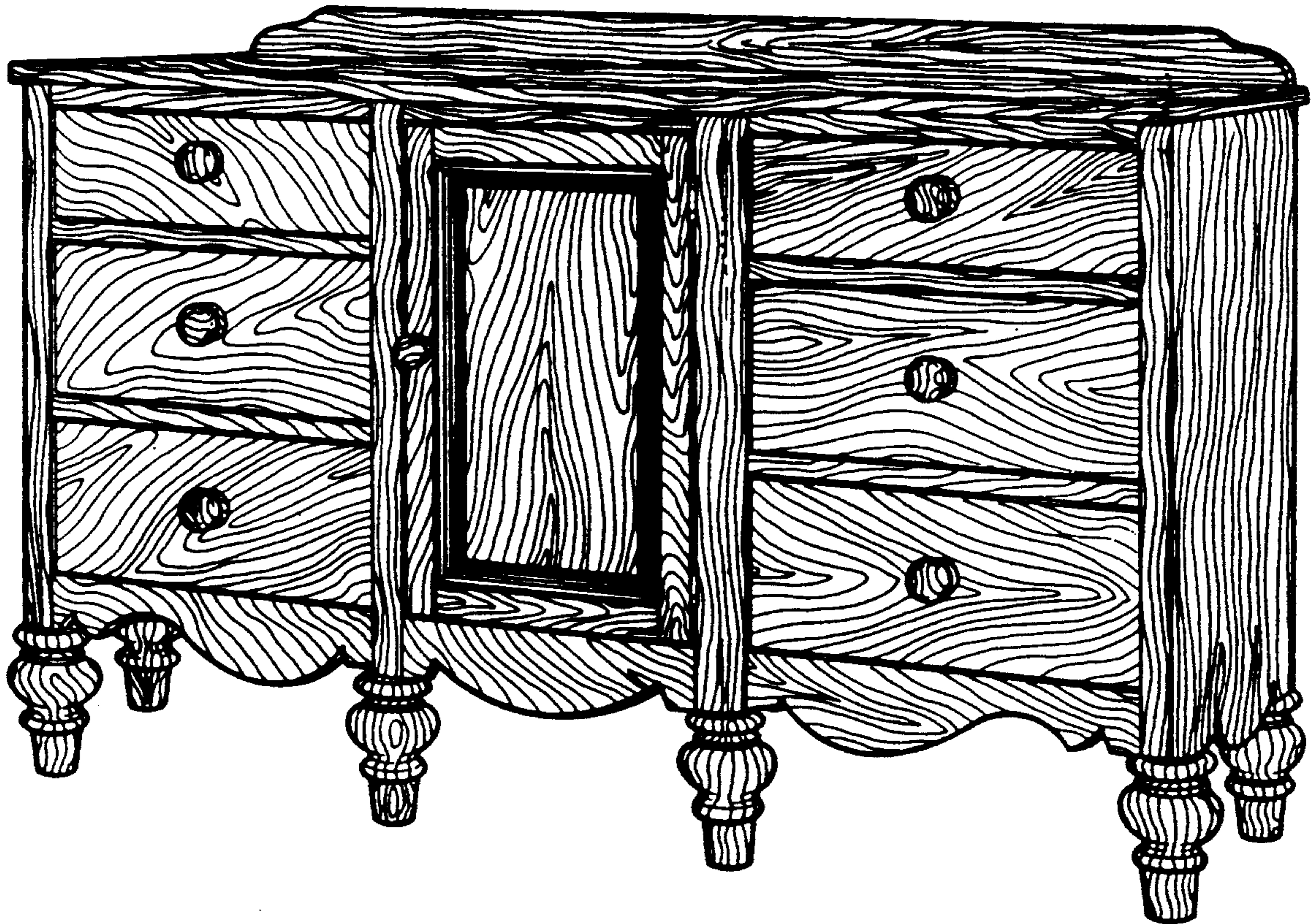

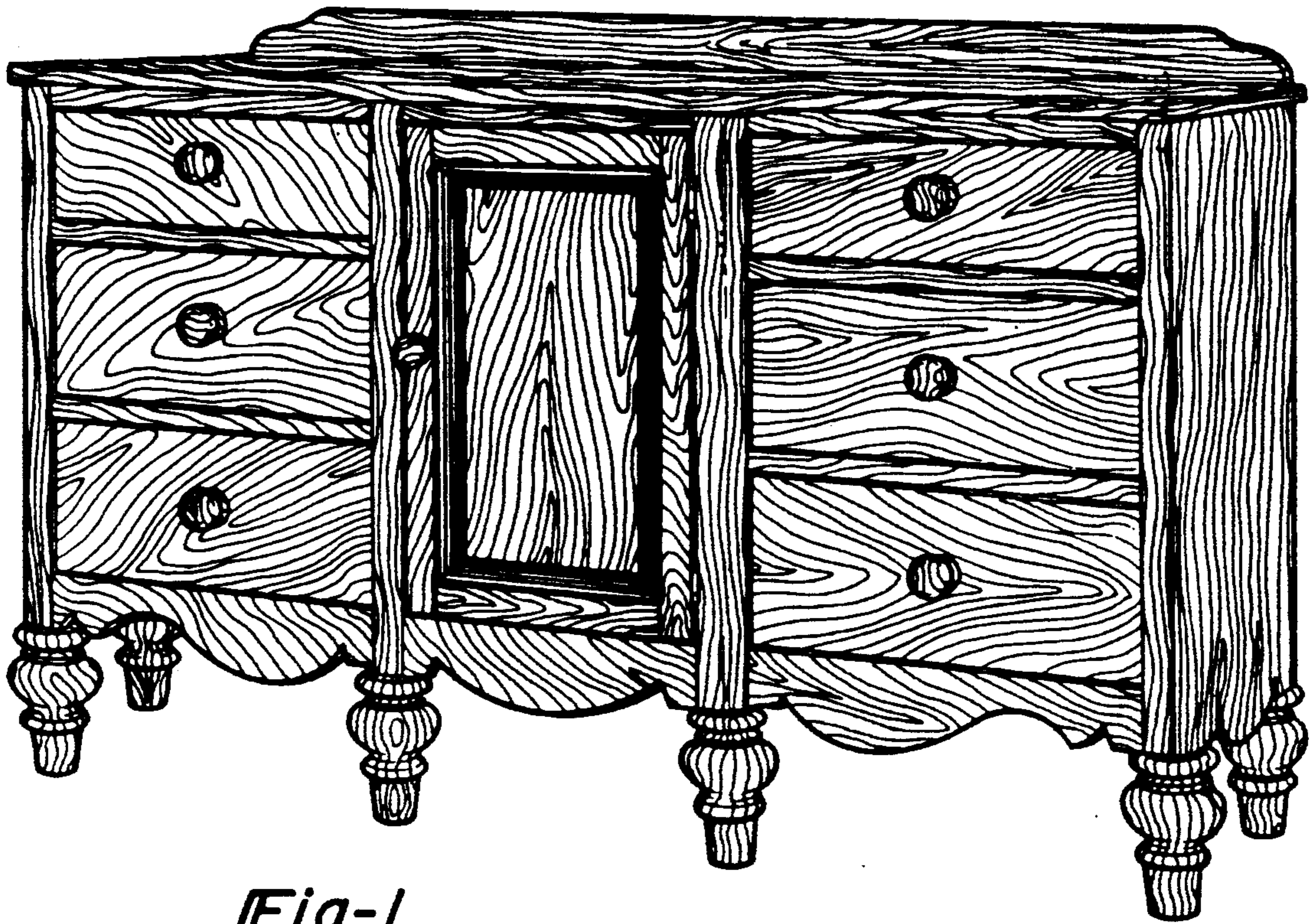

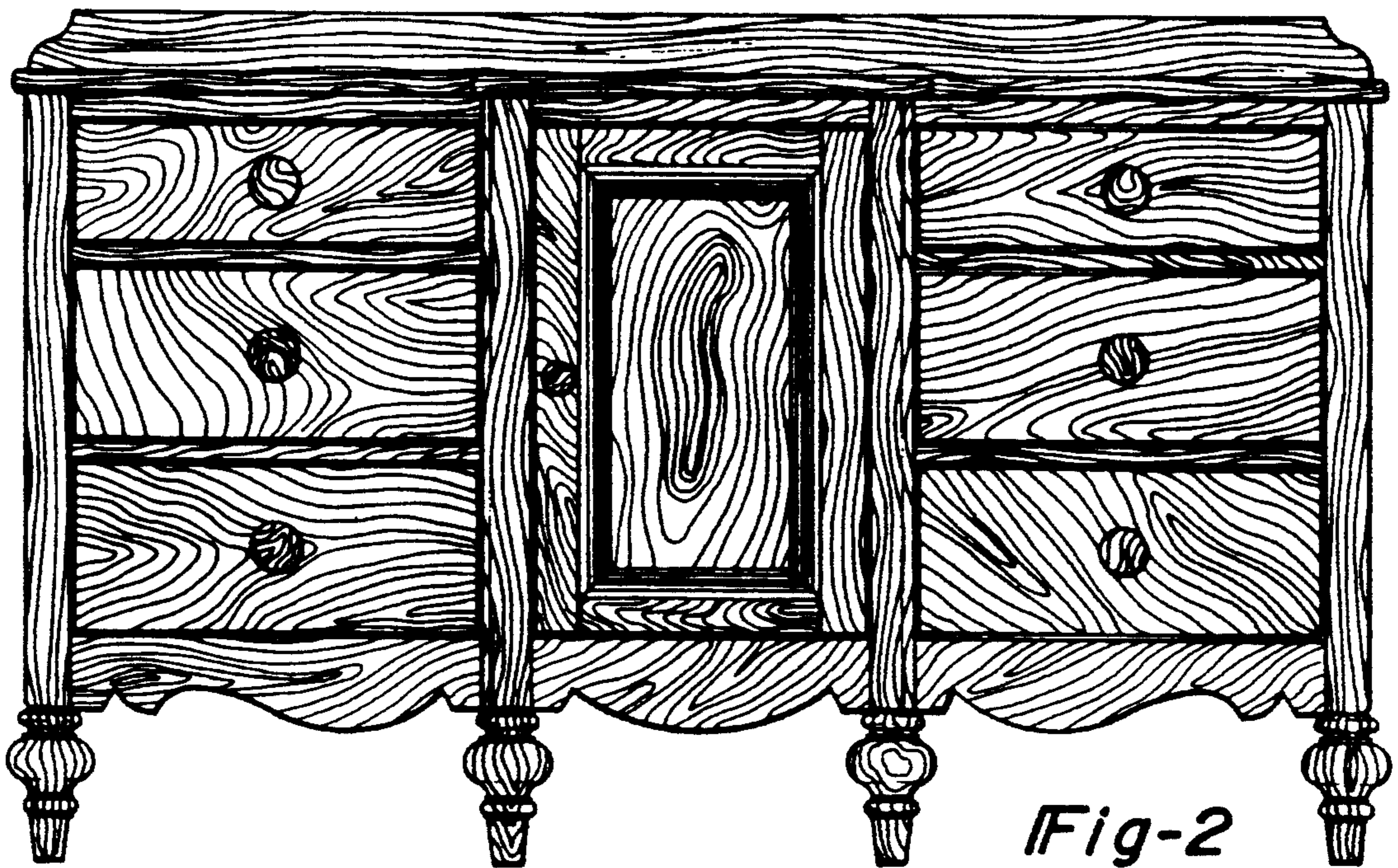

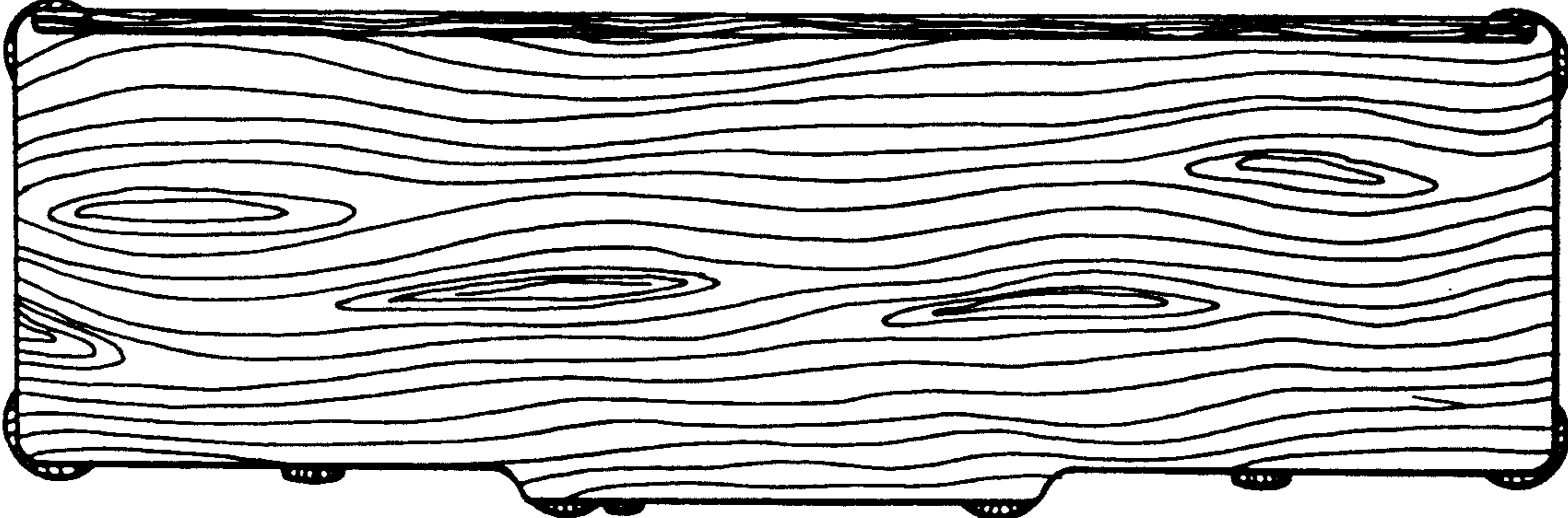

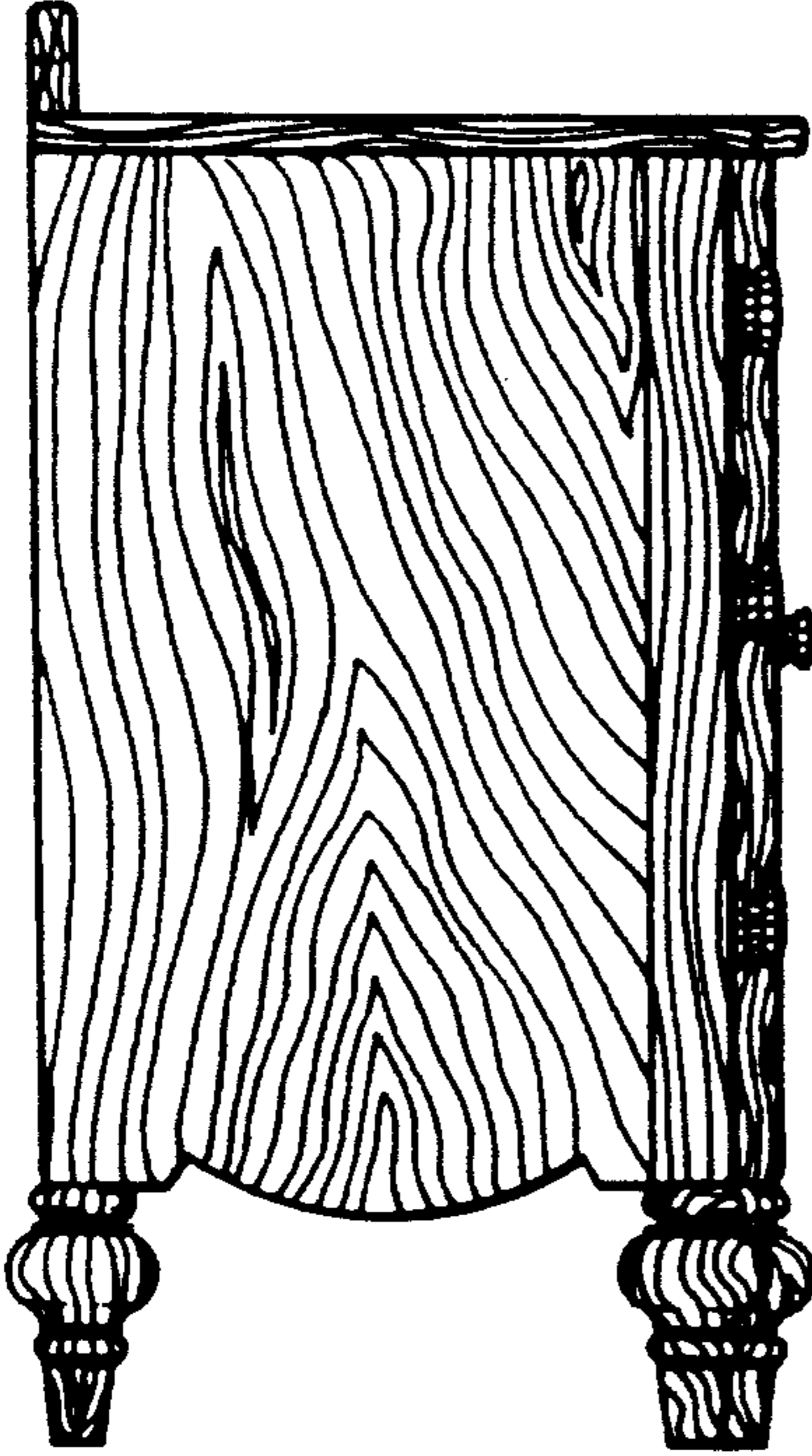

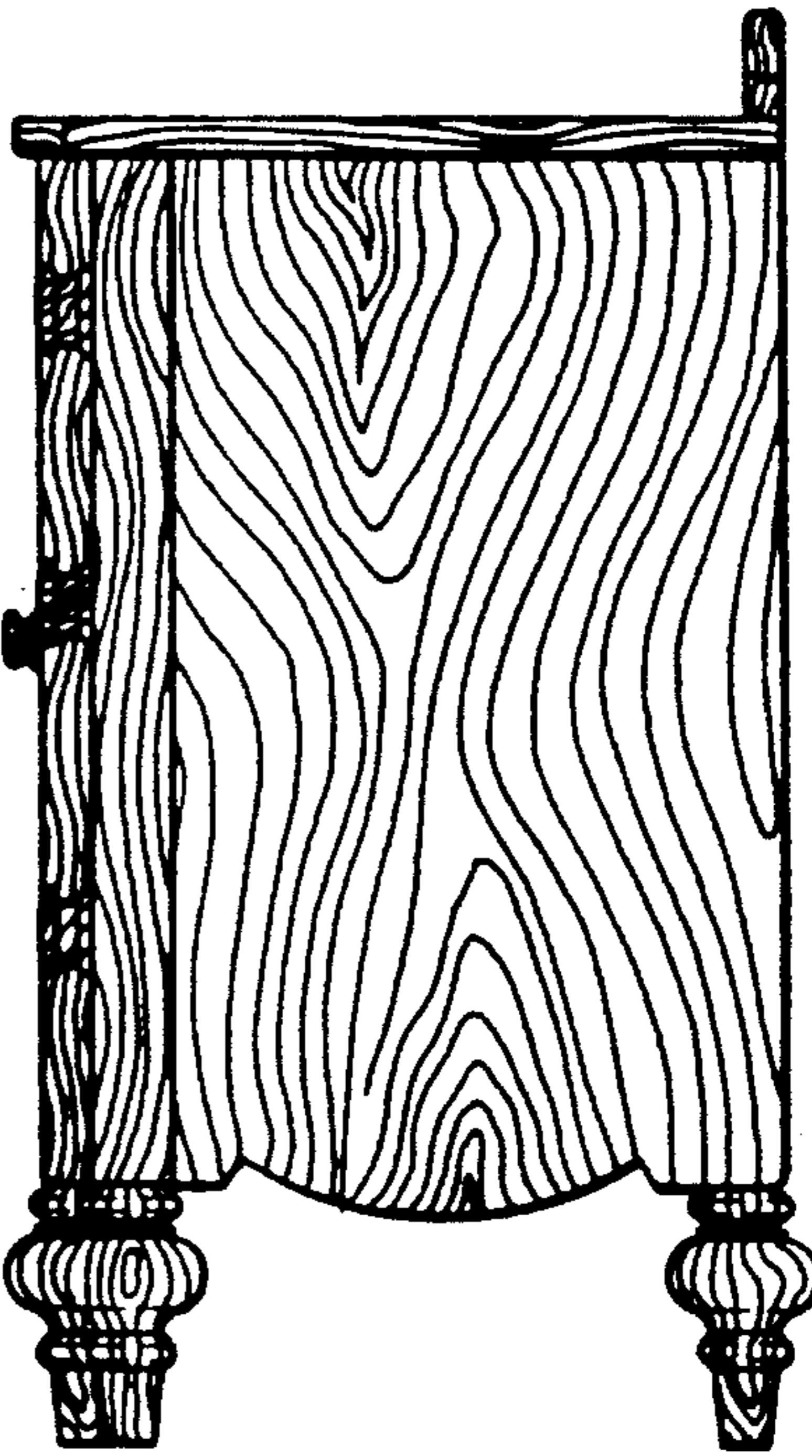
