[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a plant guard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a plant guard showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof; shown in an inverted condition for clarity of illustration;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a plan view of a plant guard shown in an unfolded condition for clarity of illustration; and,
FIG. 8 is an elevational view of FIG. 7.
The dash lines represent fold lines.
