[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined video tape recorder and camera, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a combined video tape recorder and camera showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a top, front perspective view thereof, with the viewfinder in horizontal position, the cassette holder opened and the handle pulled out.

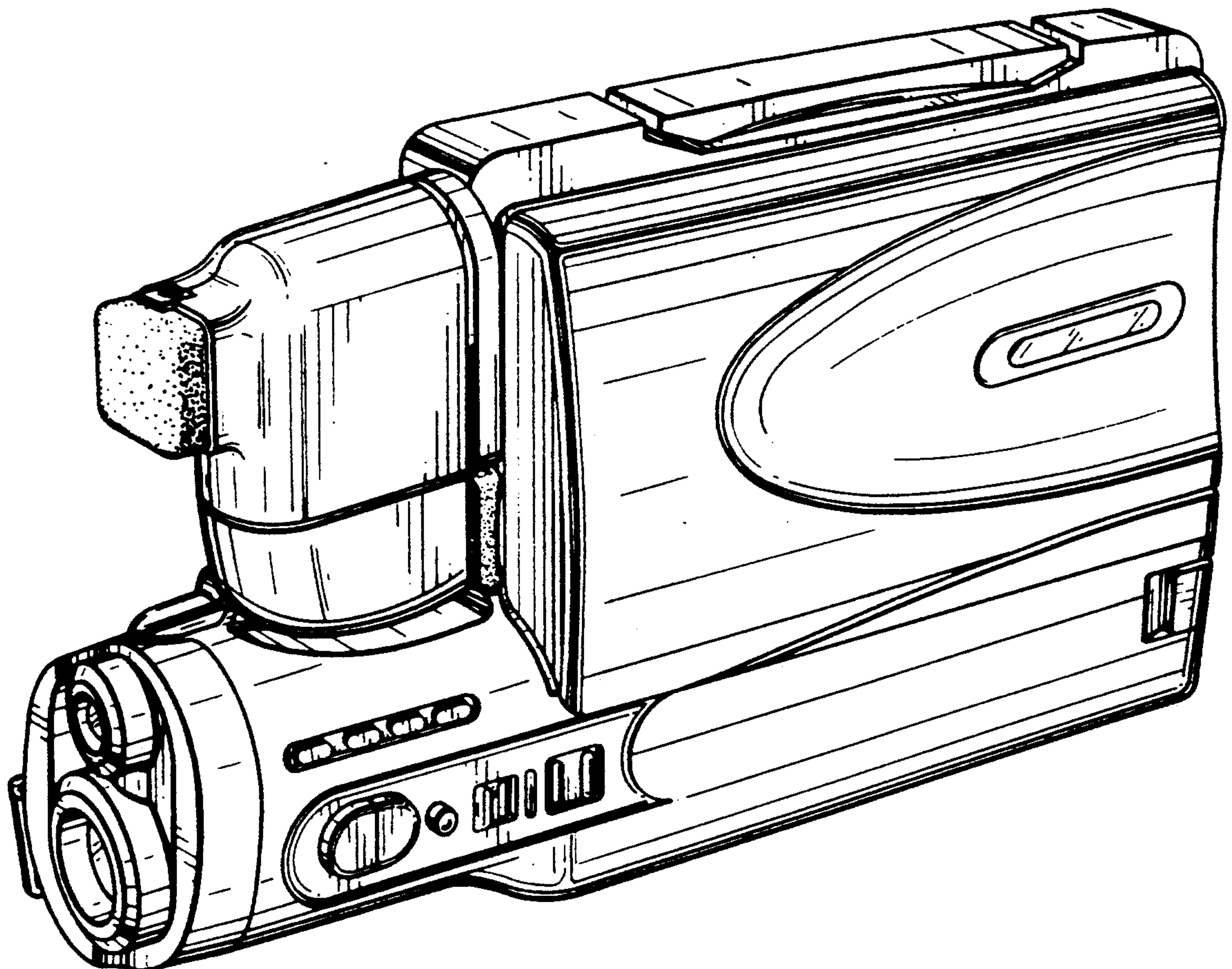

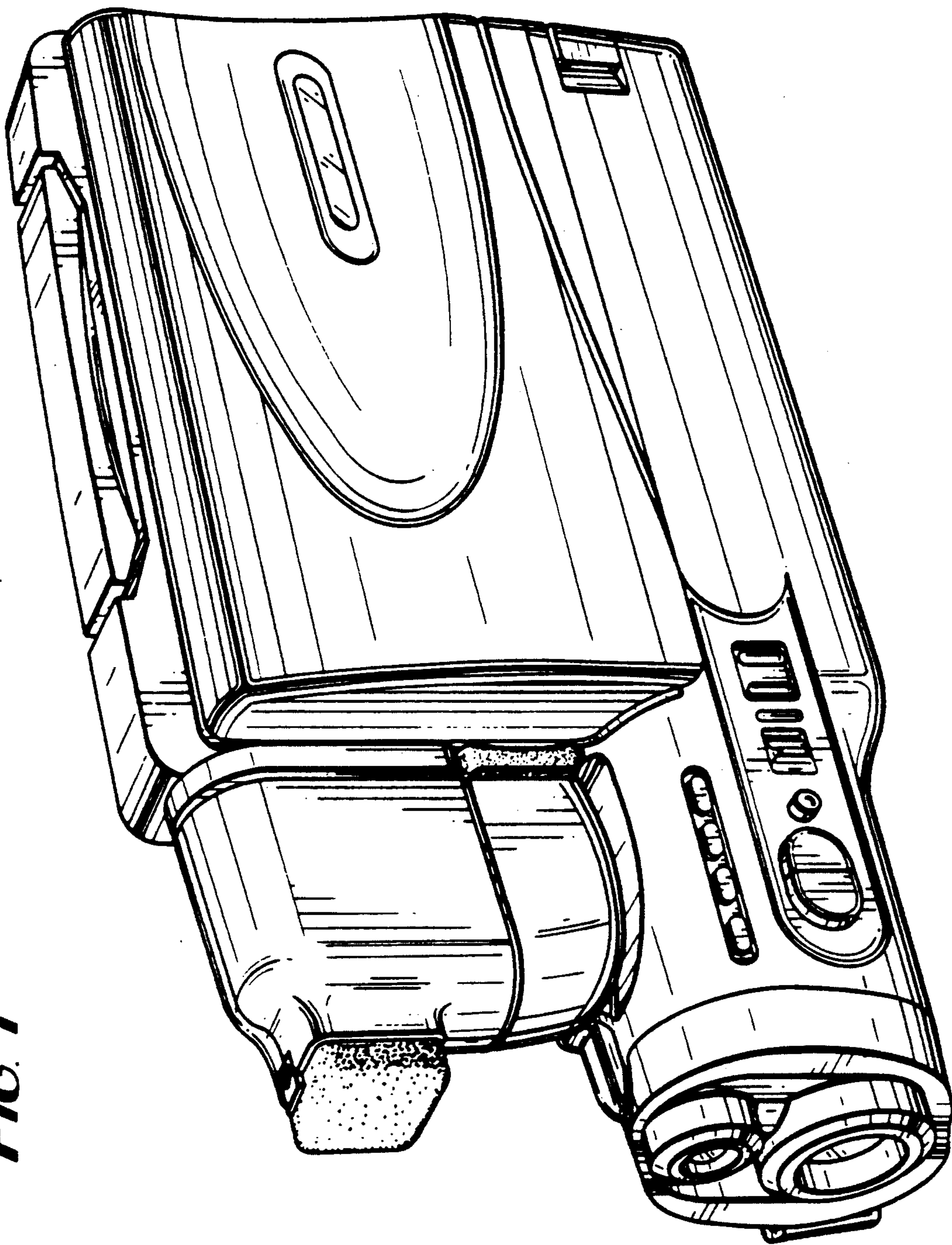

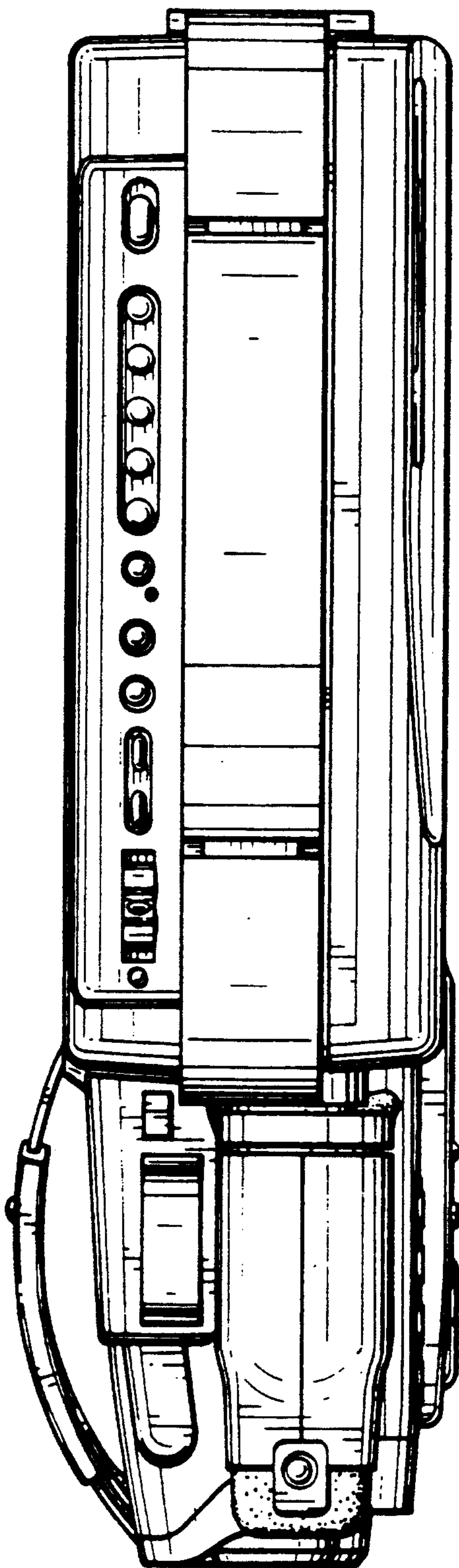

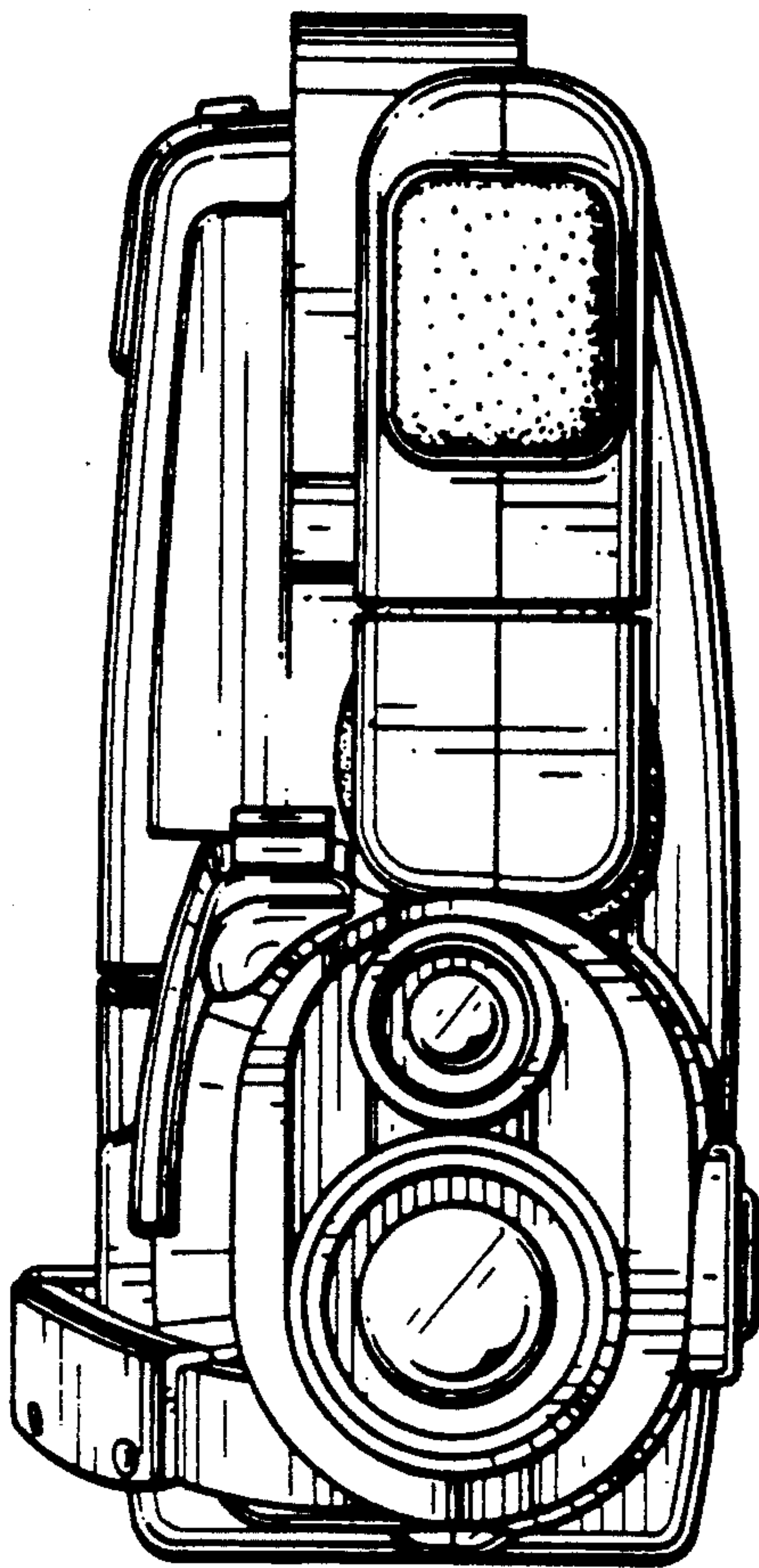

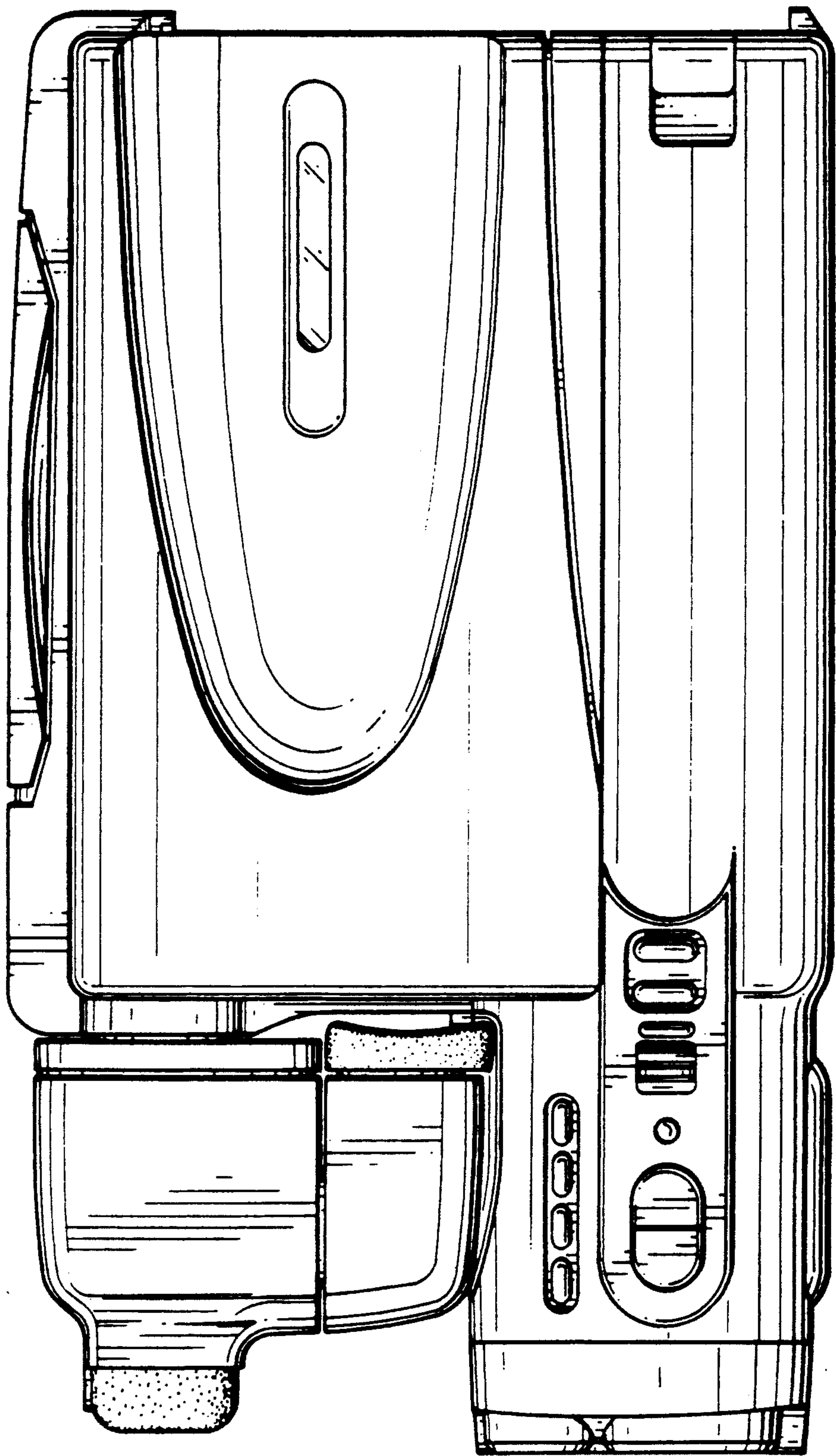

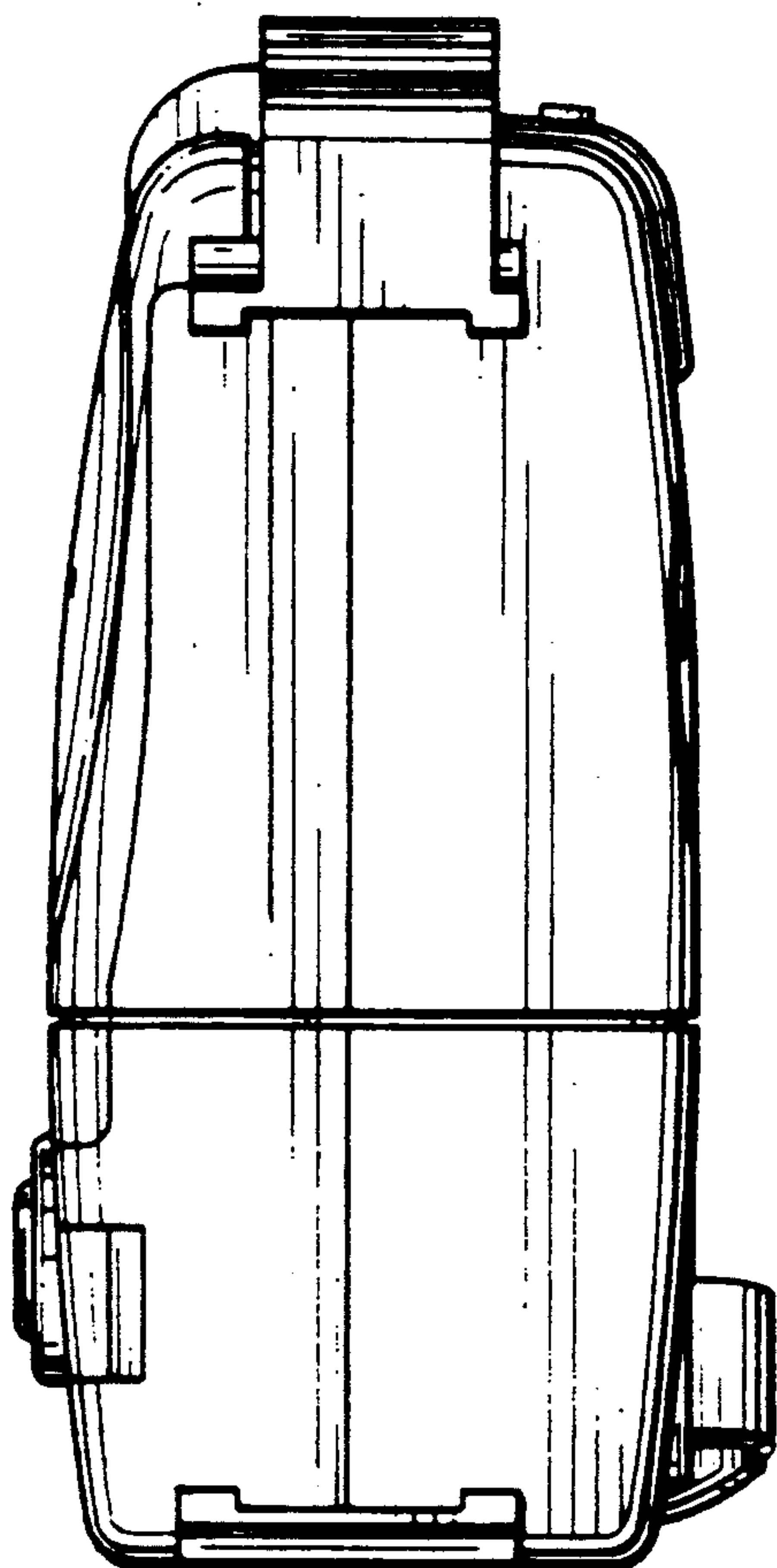

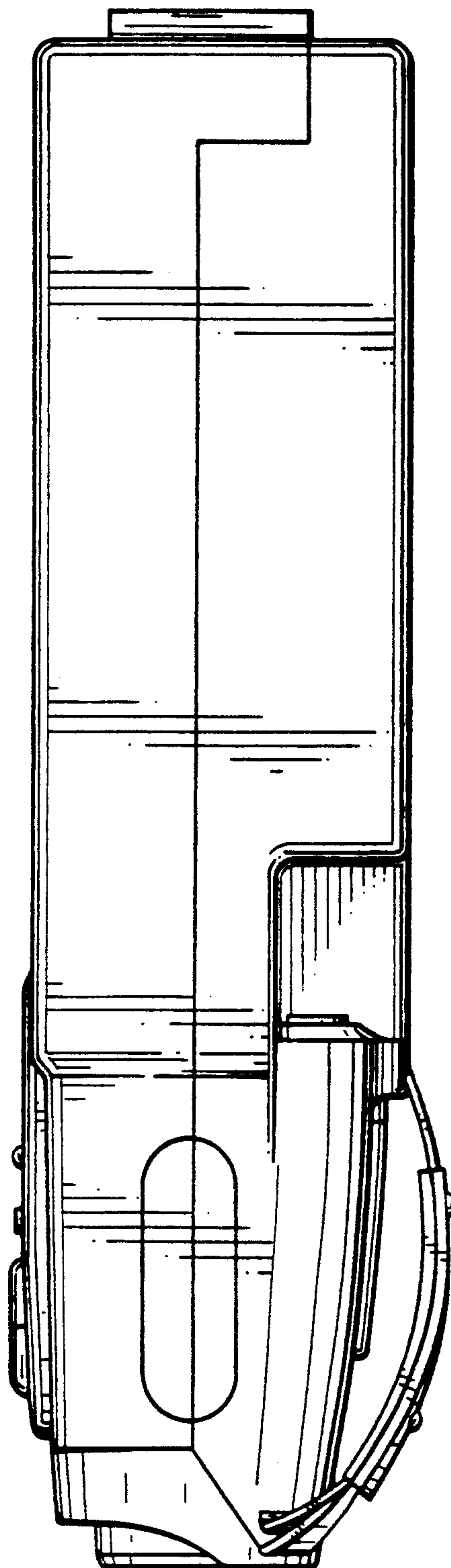

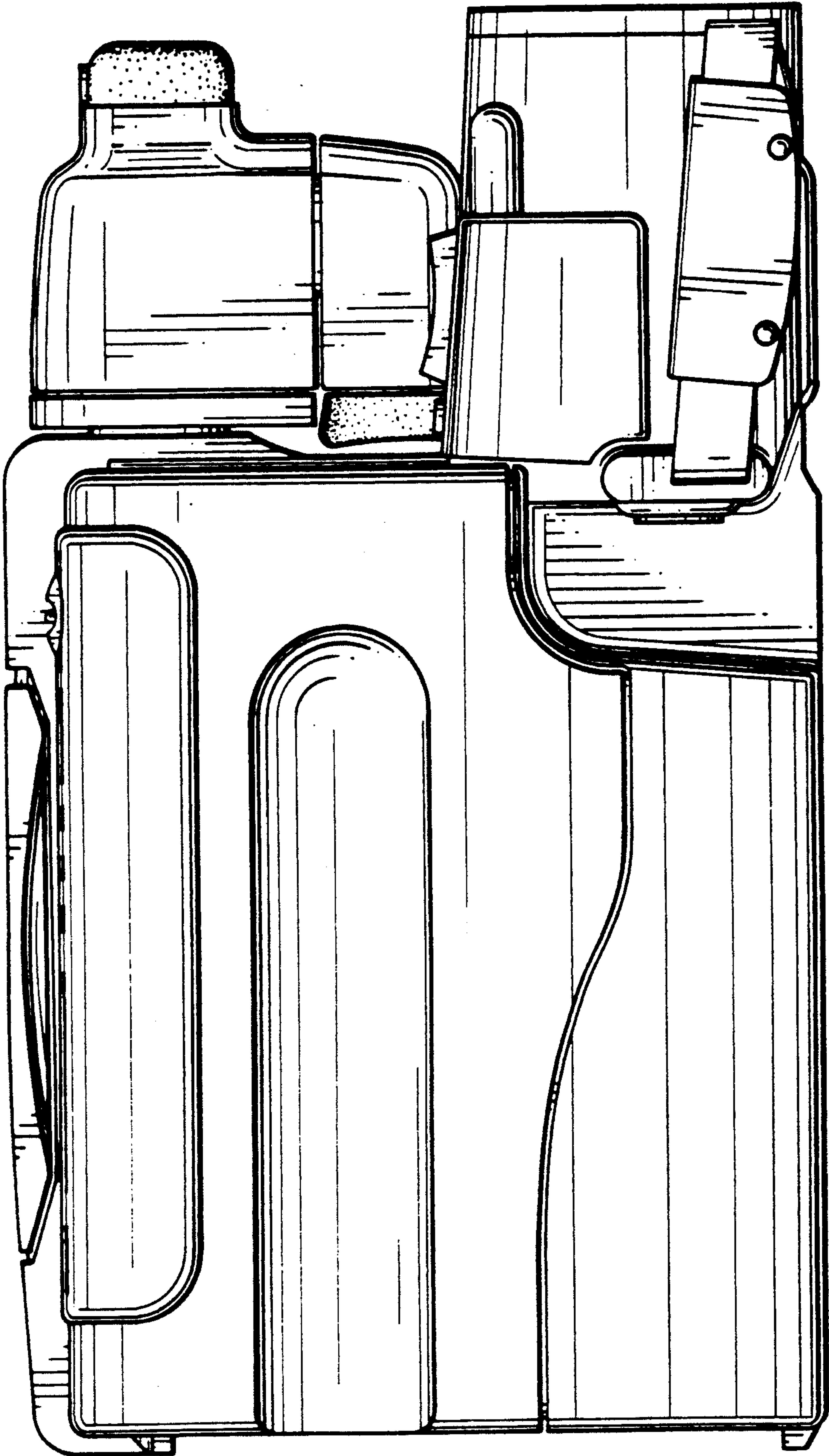
