[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a turkey caller, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of the turkey caller with the actuator top aligned with the body, the other side view is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a front end view of the turkey caller;

FIG. 3 is a rear end view of the turkey caller;

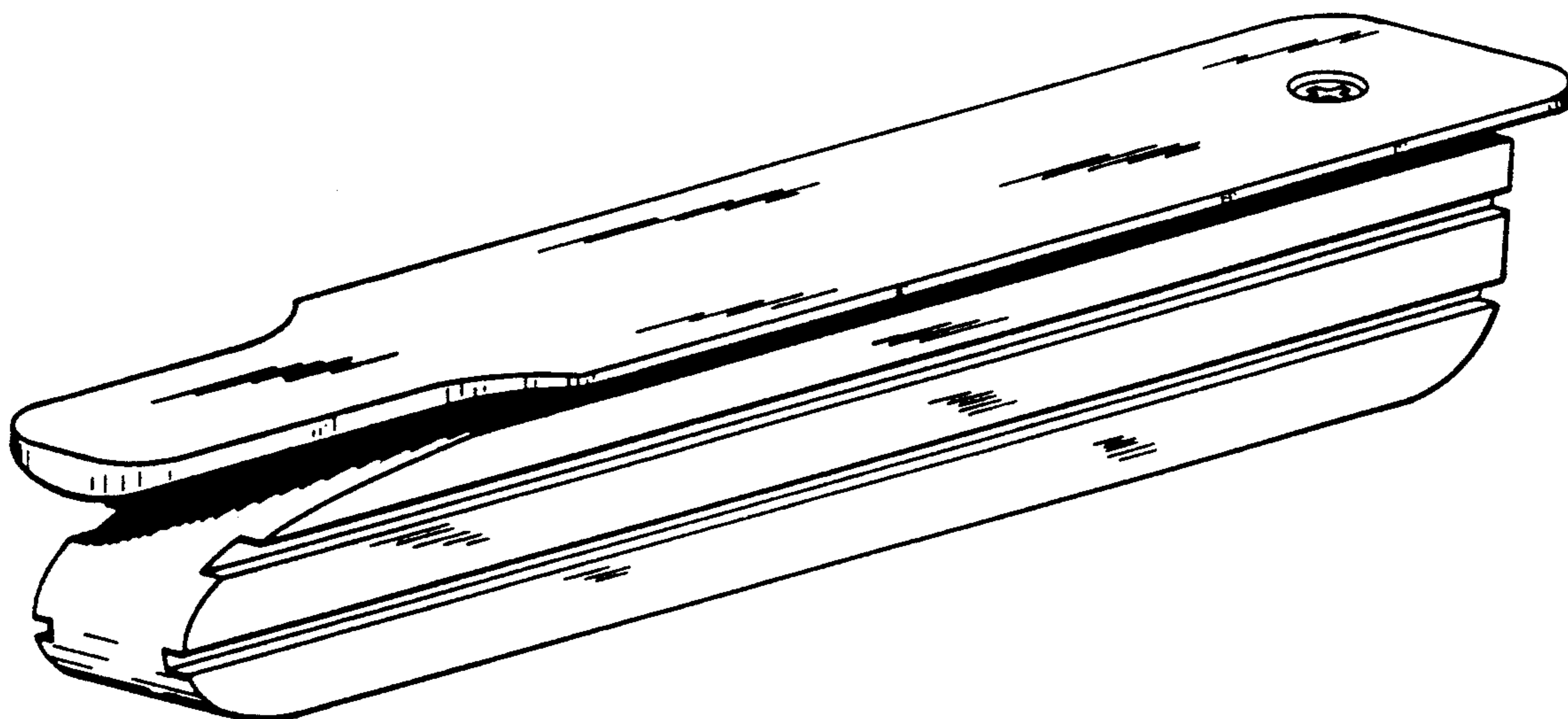
FIG. 4 is a top view of the turkey caller of FIG. 1 showing the actuator top aligned with the body;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the turkey caller of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken on the line 6—6 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the turkey caller as shown in FIG. 4 with the actuator top rotated to the side and with the actuator top broken in half for convenience of illustration; and,

FIG. 8 is an upper perspective view of the turkey caller of FIG. 1.



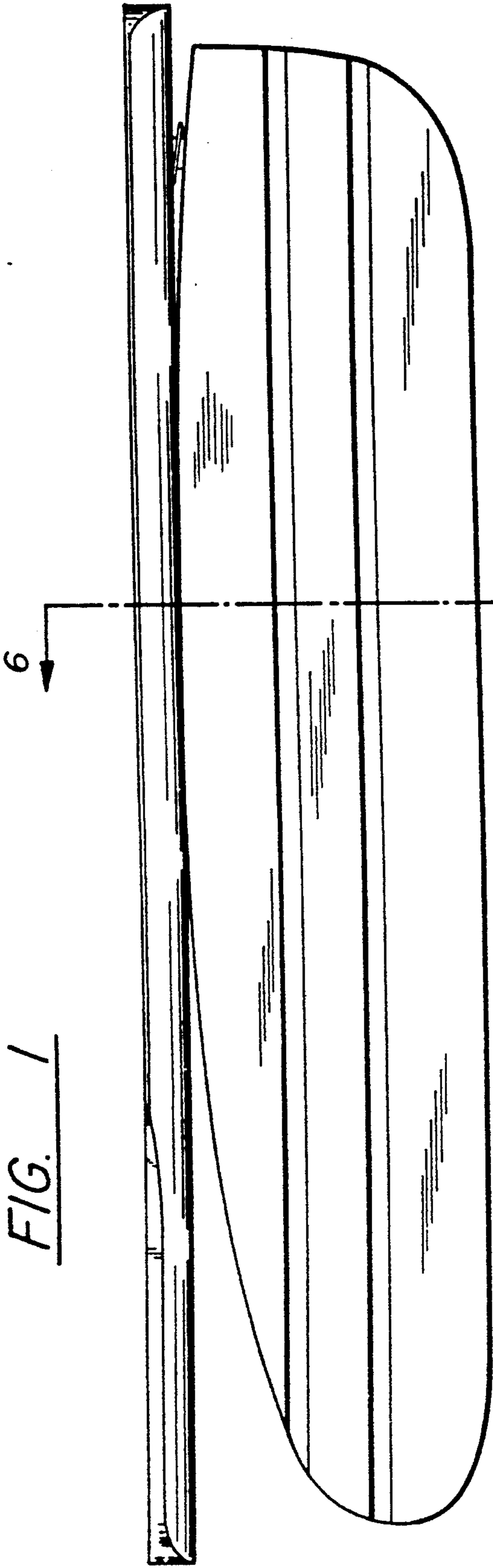

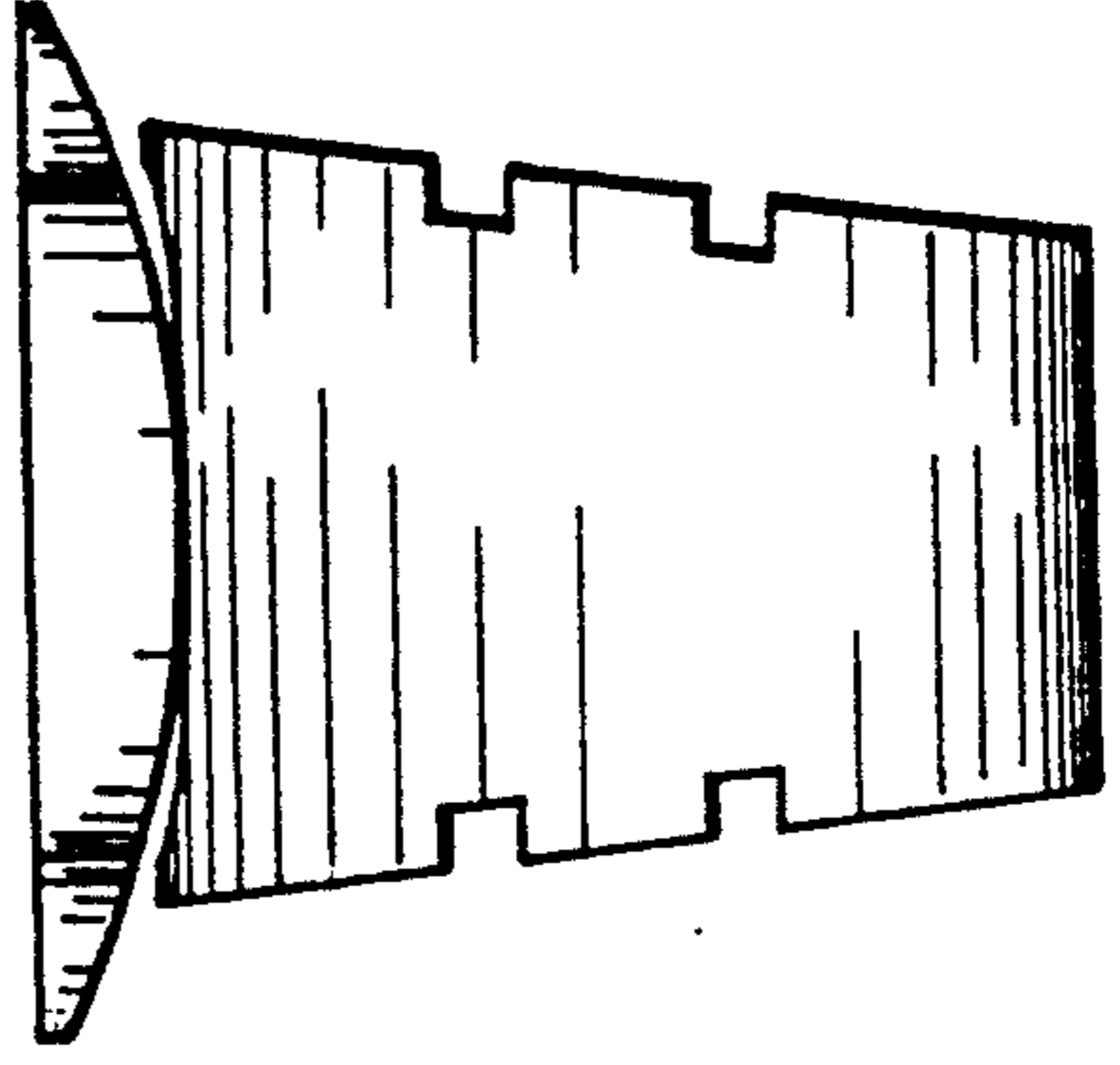
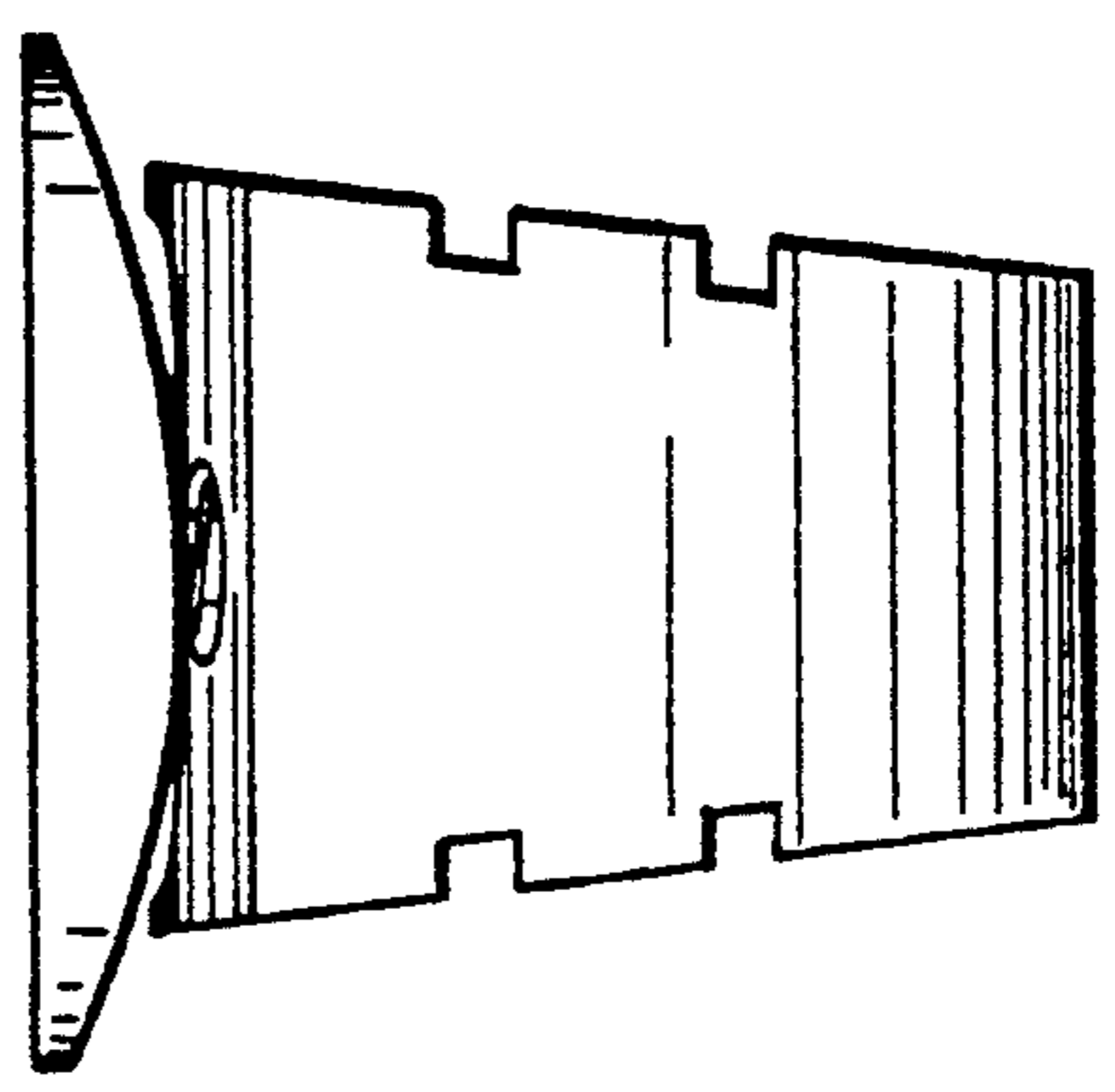

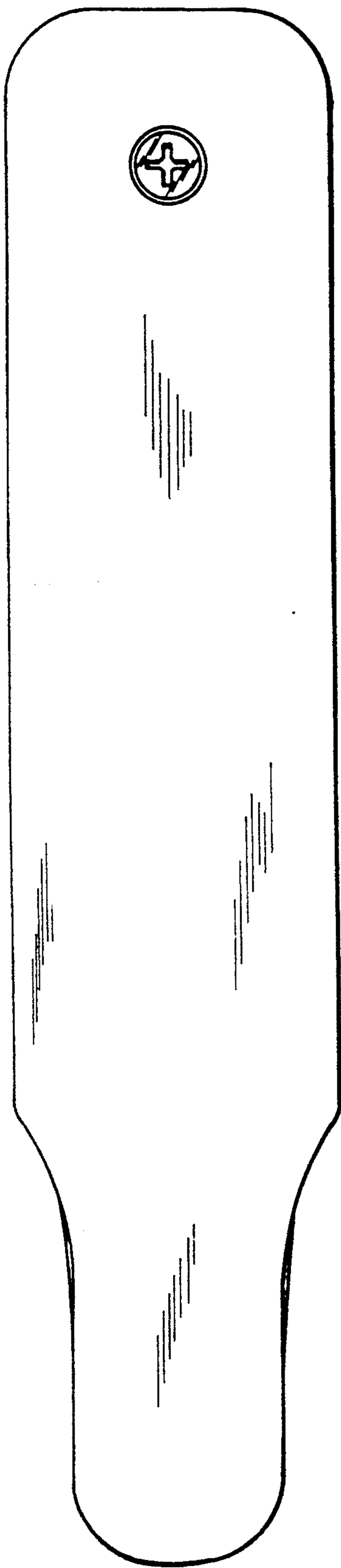

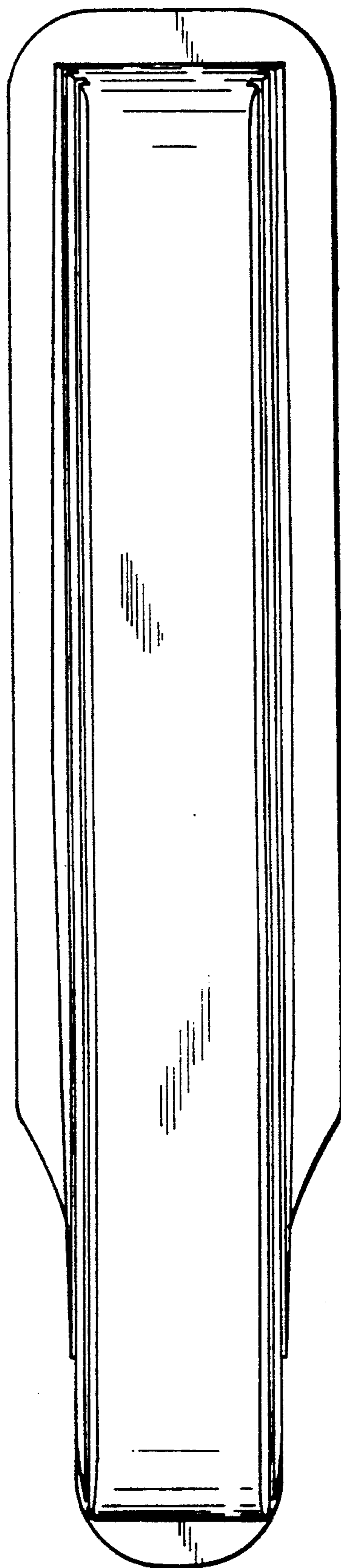

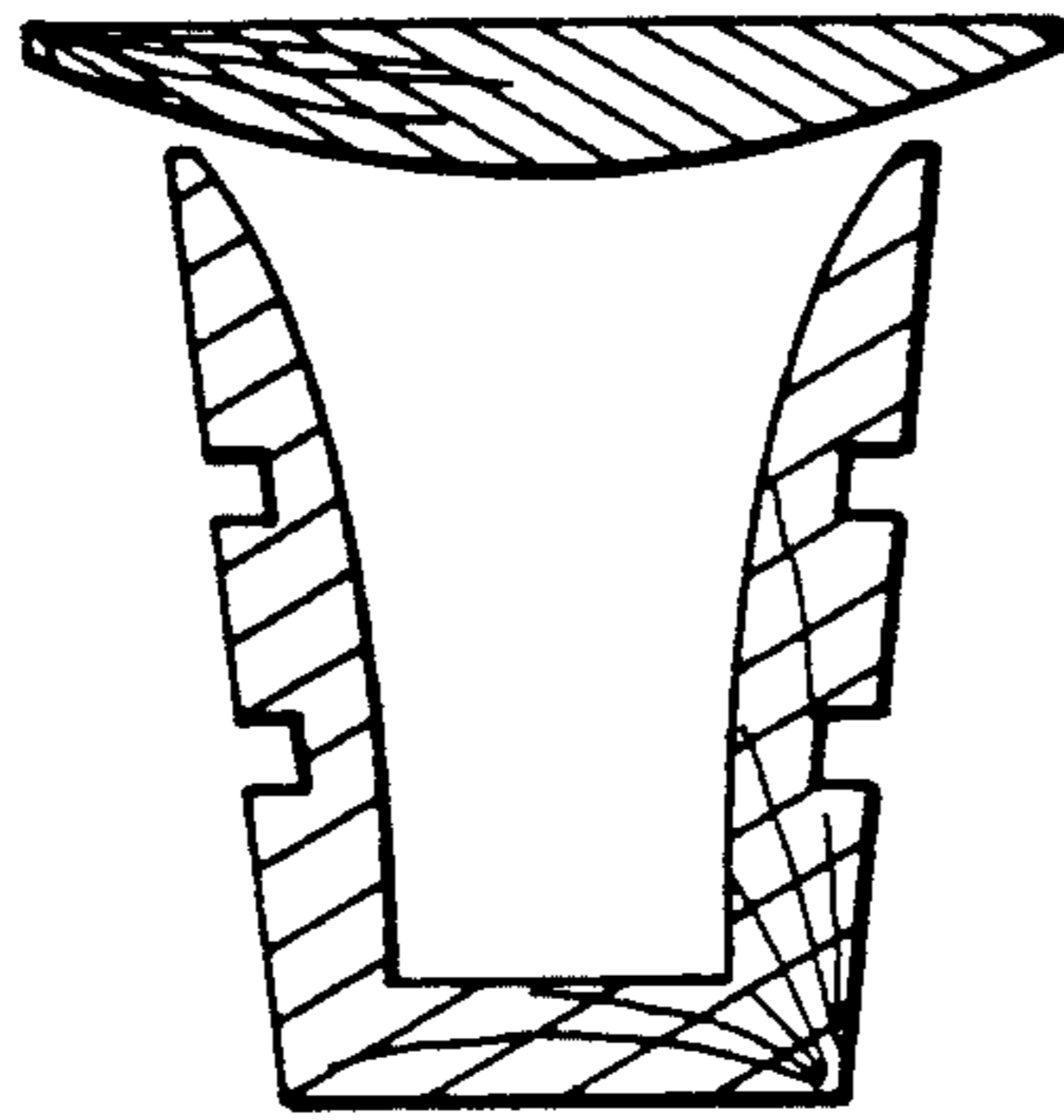

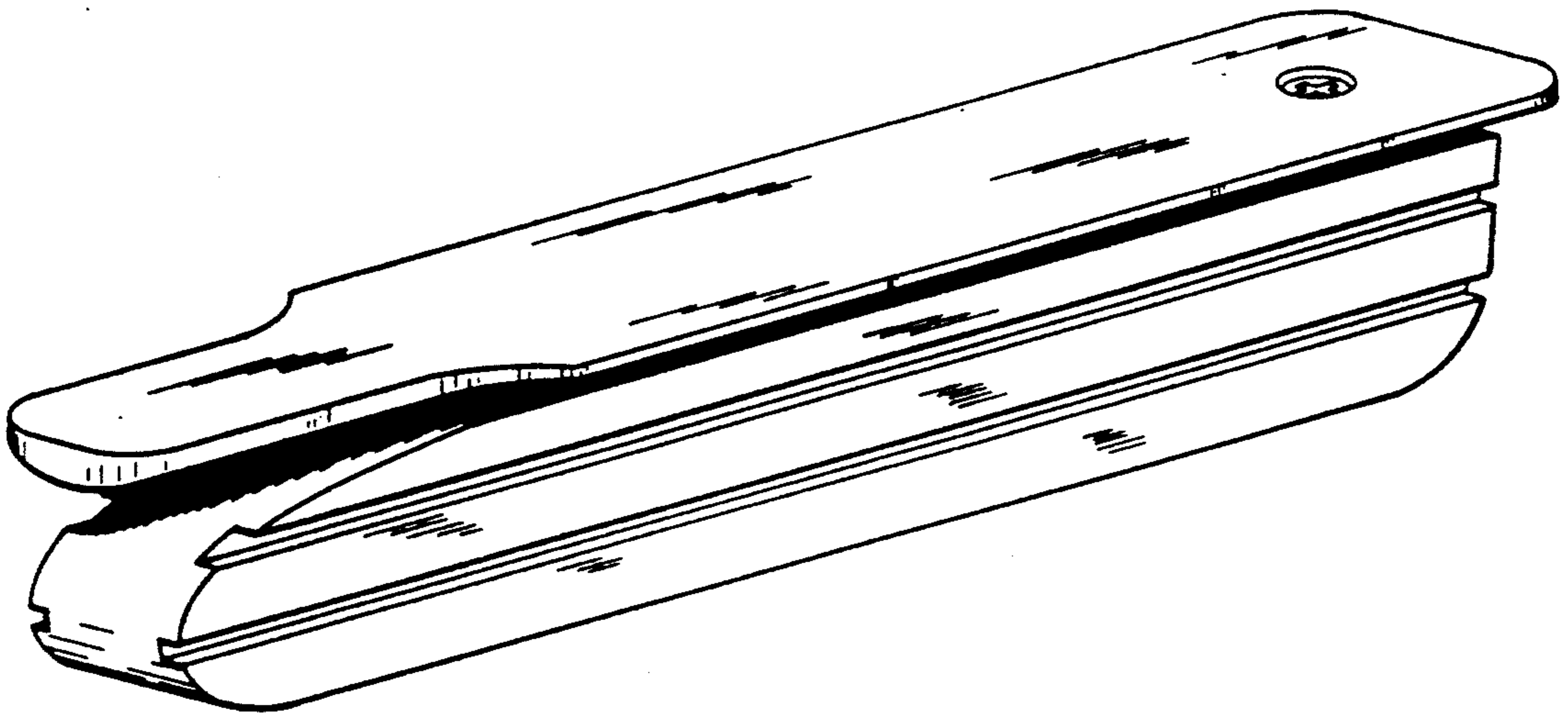

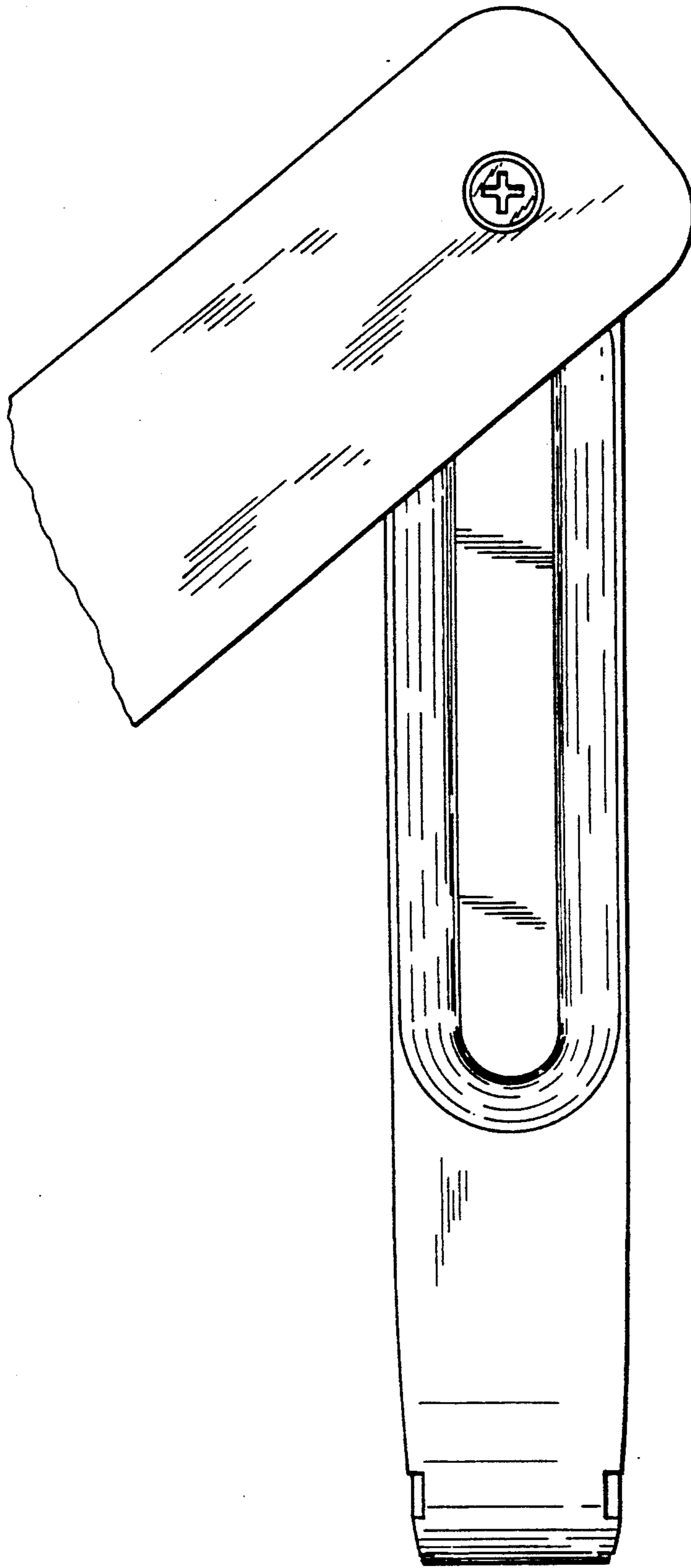
