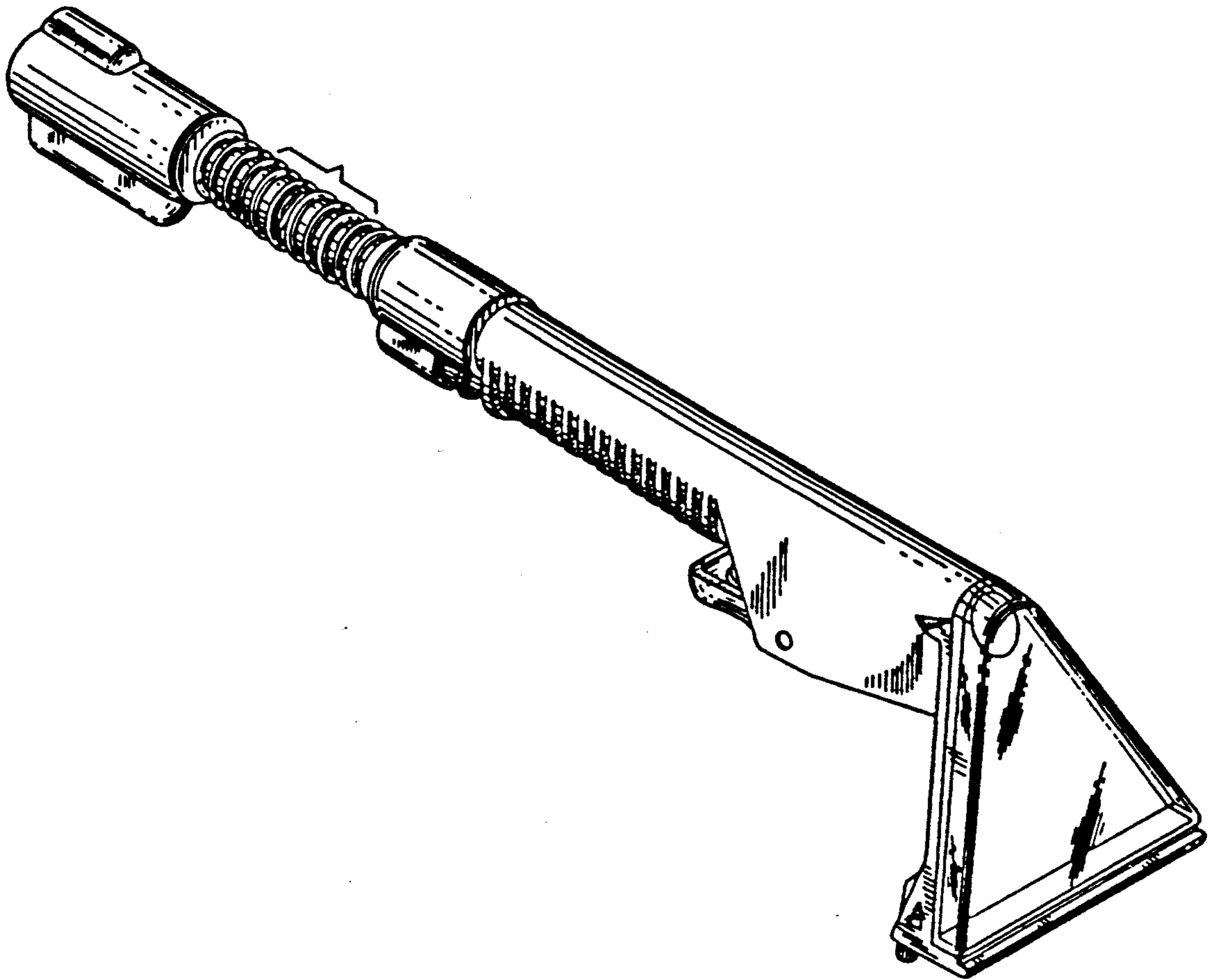

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hand tool for a cleaning device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left, top perspective view of a hand tool for a cleaning device showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a front, left, top perspective view of a second embodiment thereof; FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof. The hose shown broken away in FIGS. 1, 2, 5 and 6 is understood to represent indeterminate length.



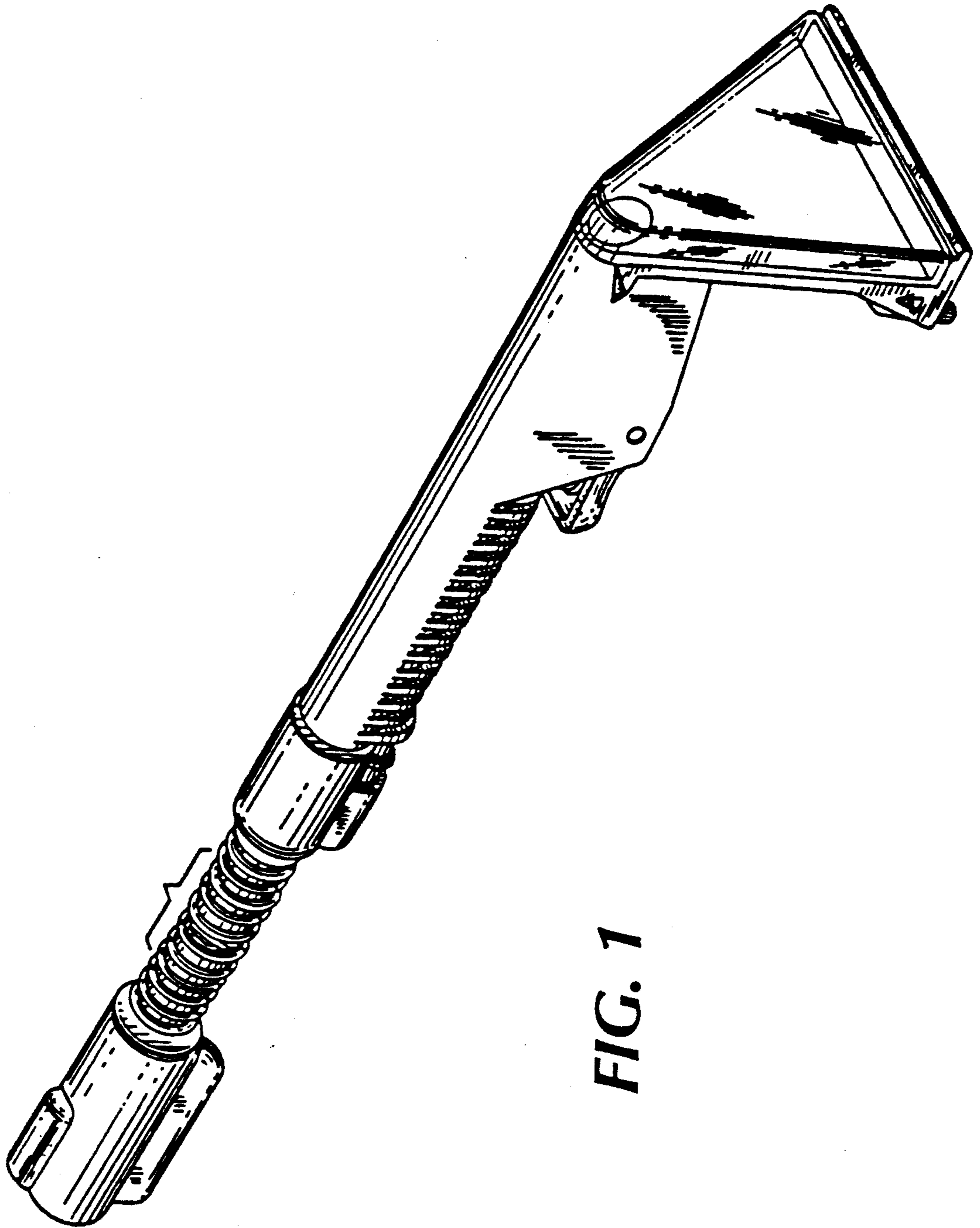

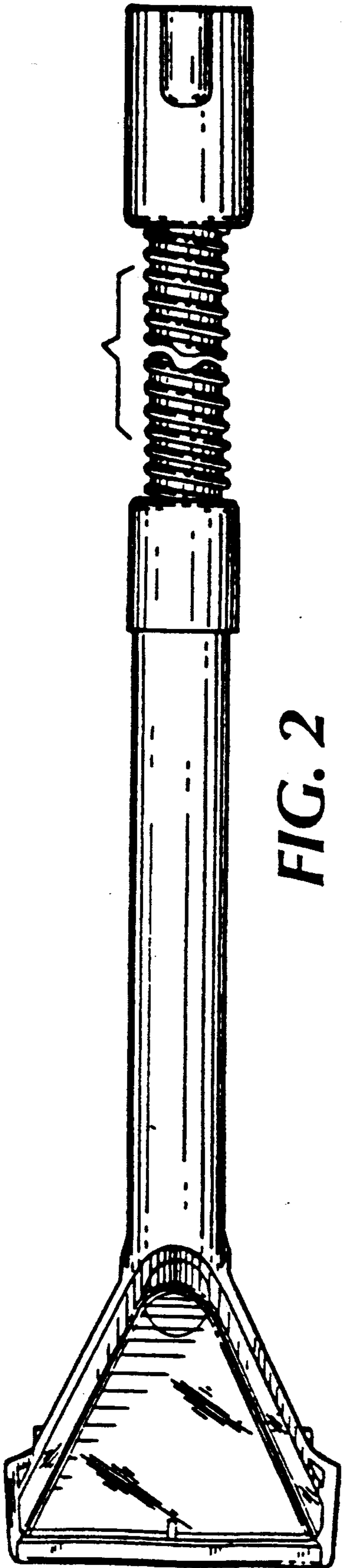

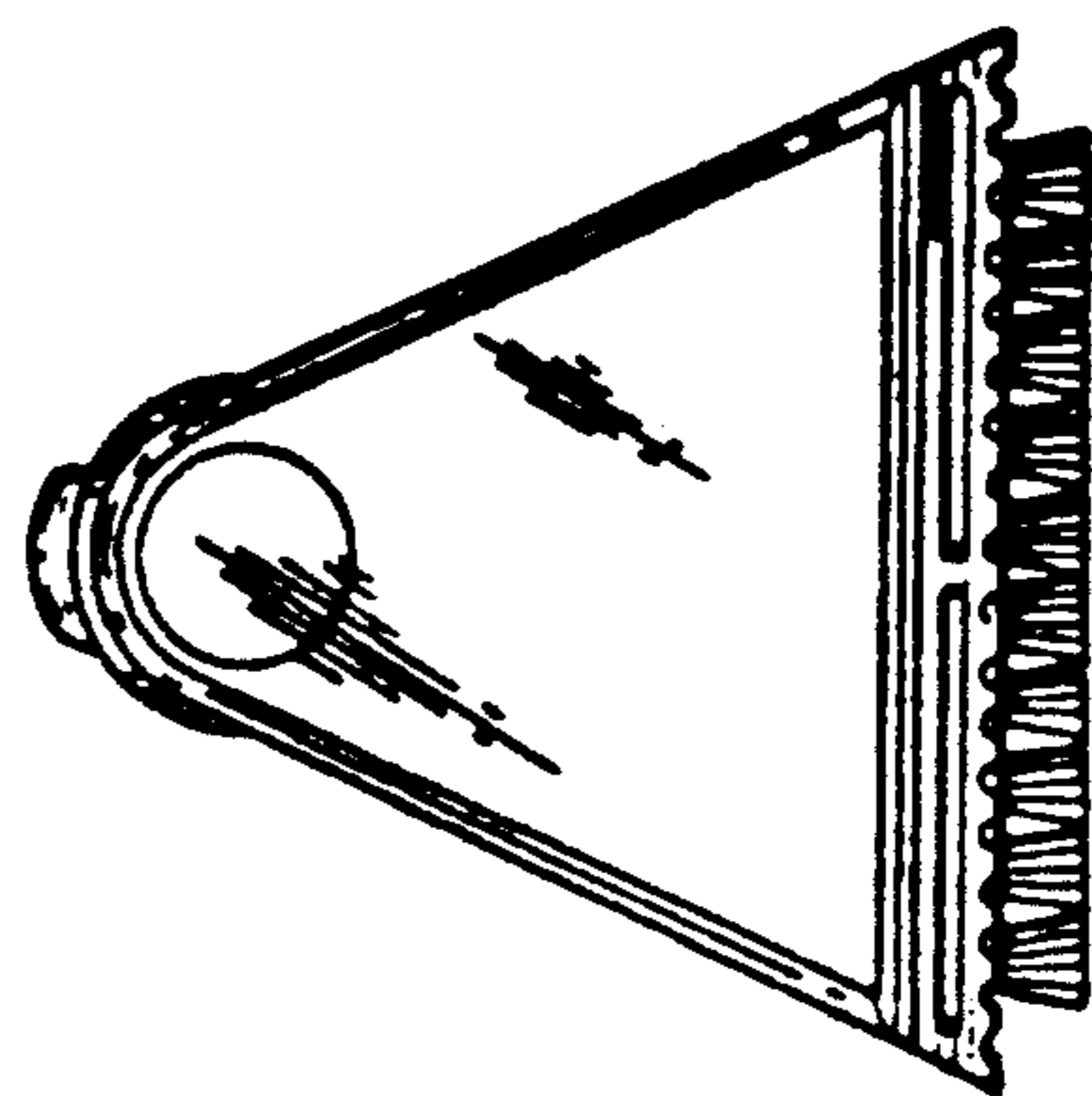

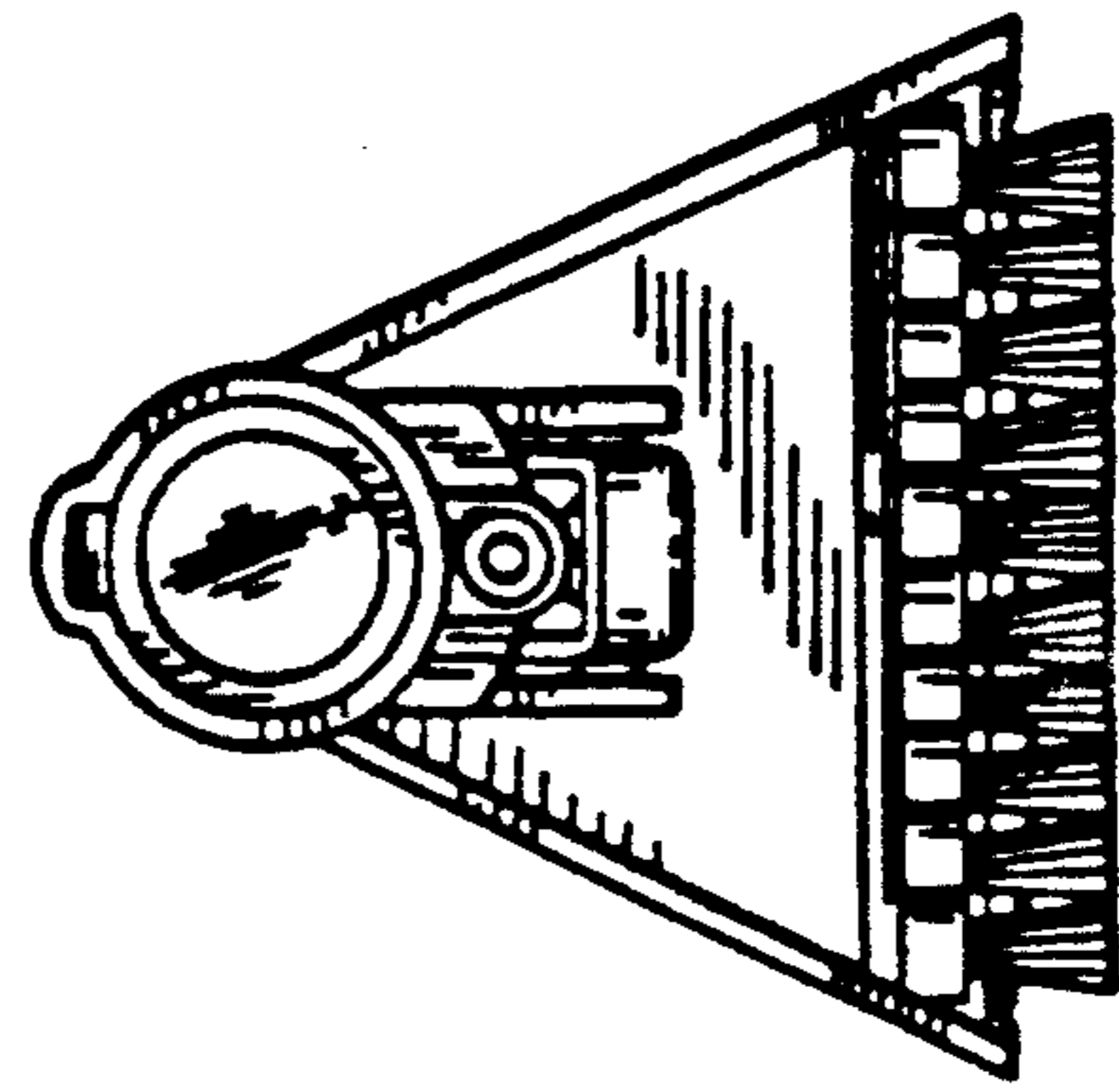
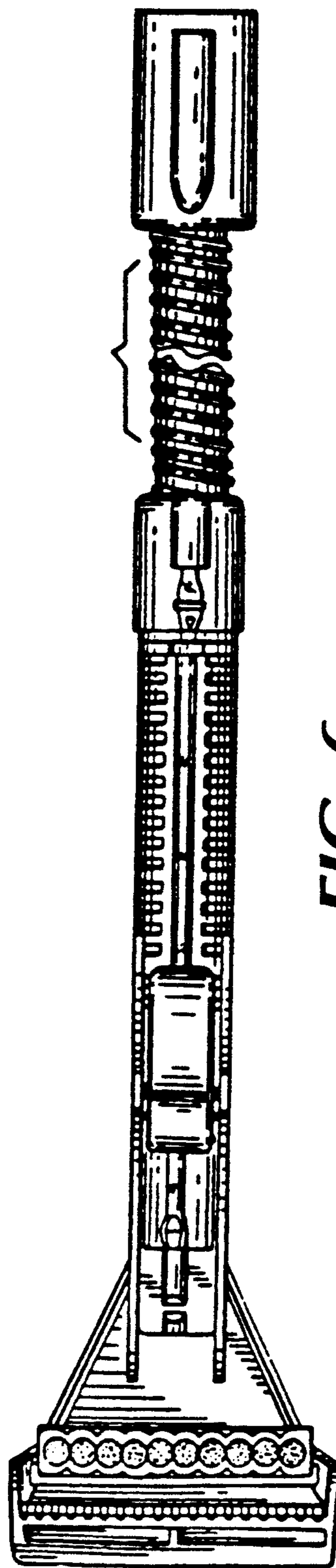
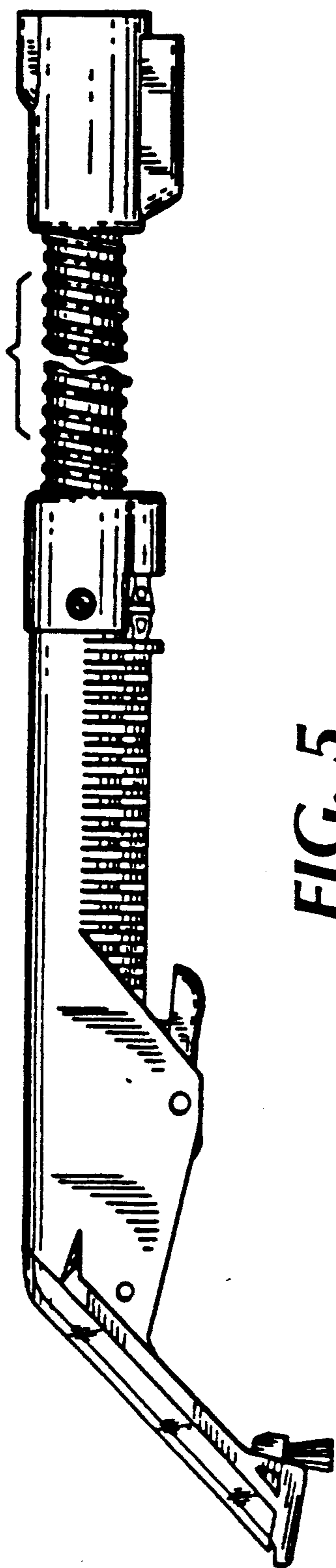

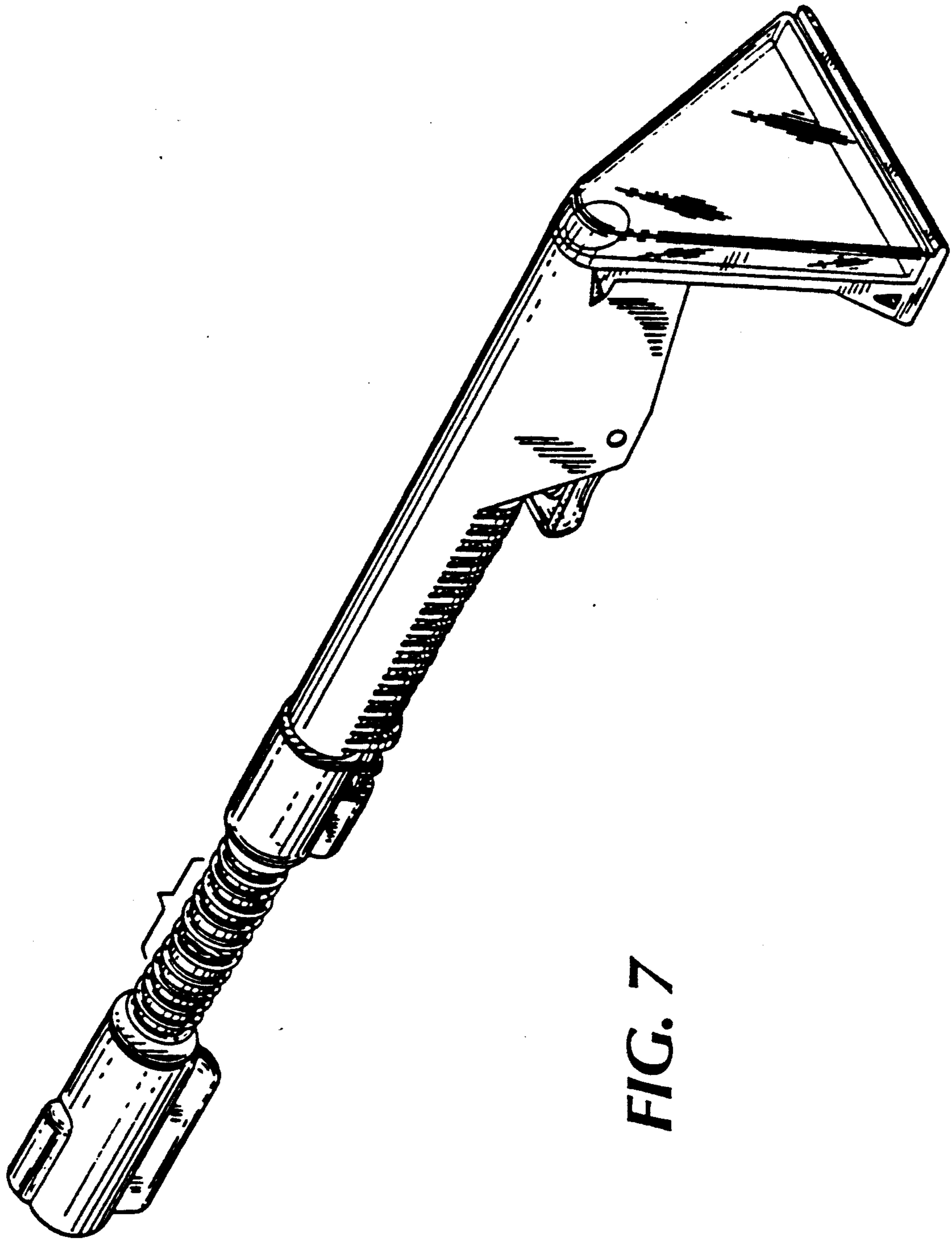

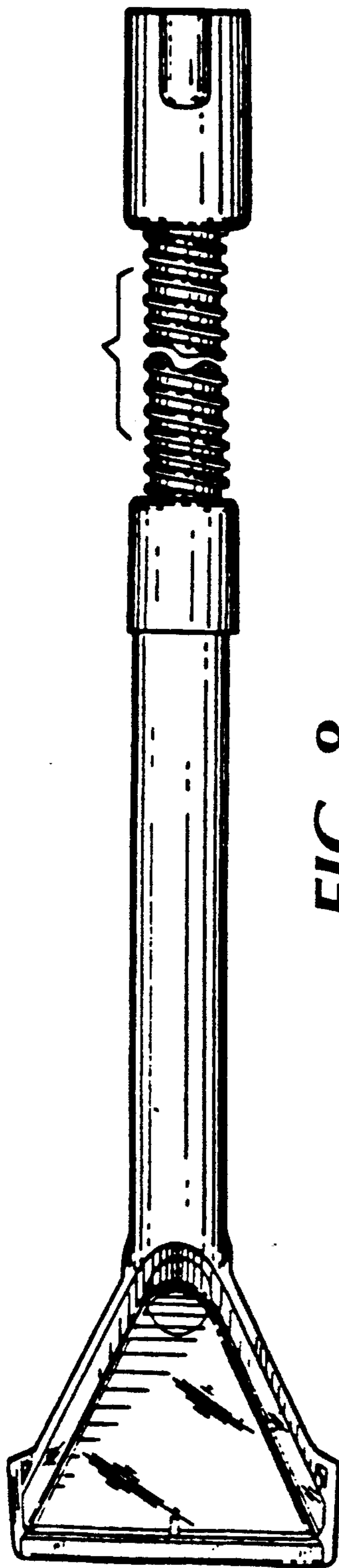

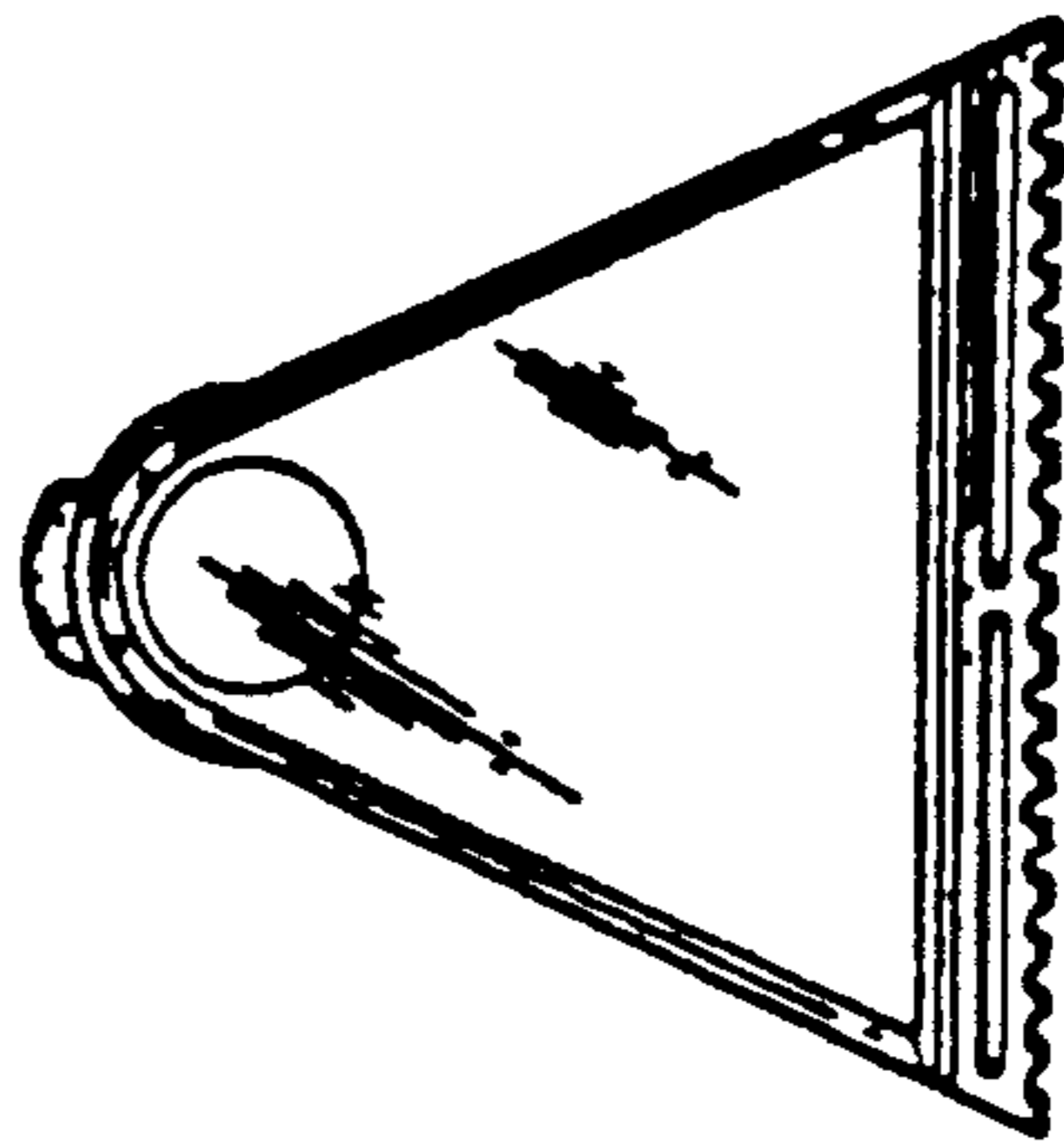

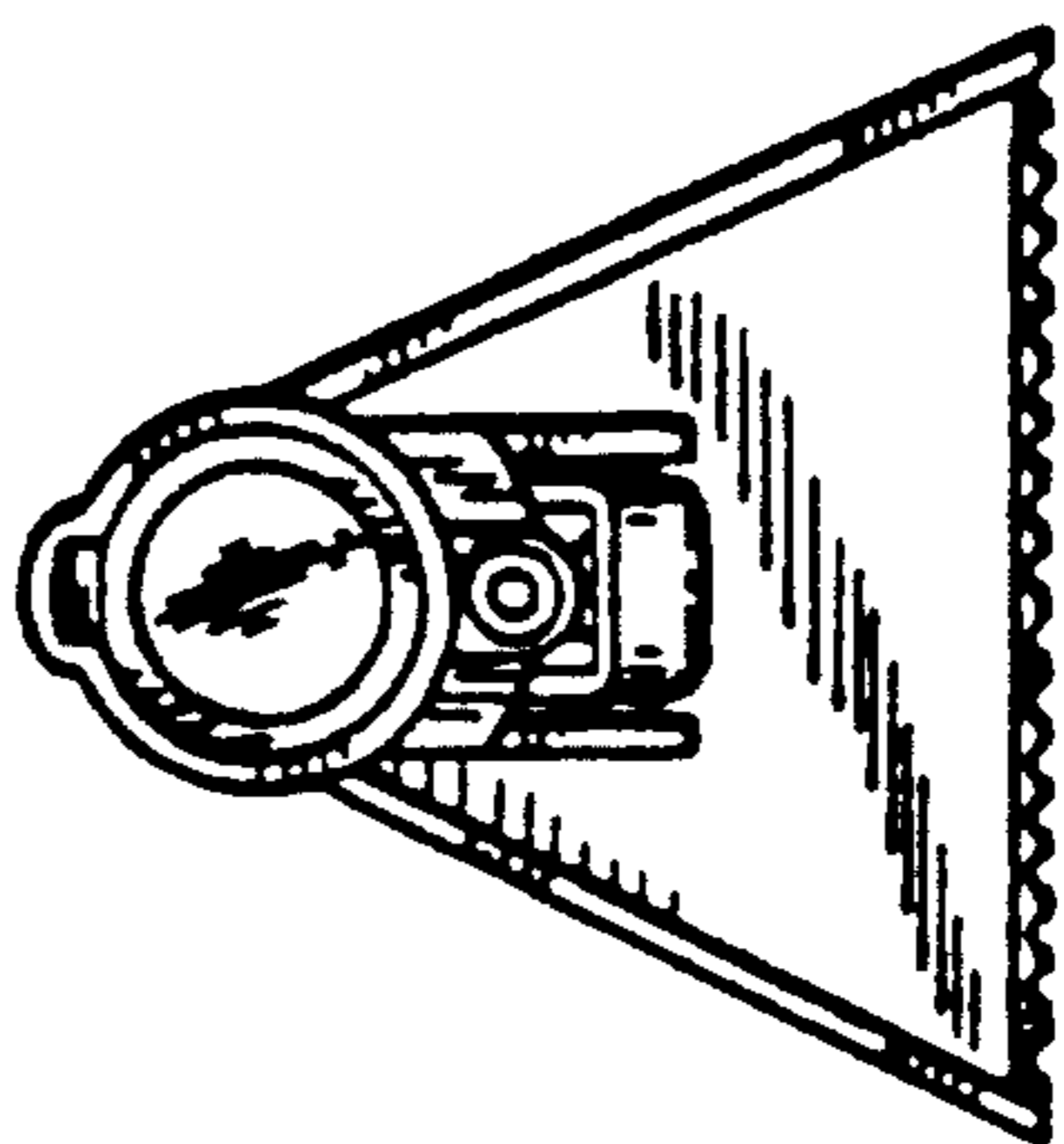

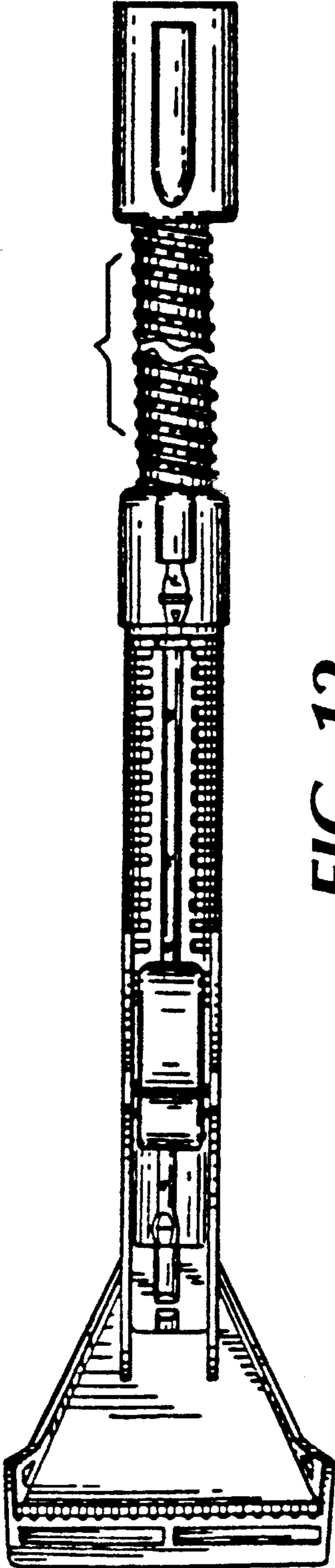
