[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for door handle-
set, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of my new design of
a door handle-
set;

FIG. 2 is a right side view of my new design of the door
handle-
set, a left side view of my new design of the door
handle-
set being a mirror image of the right side view
thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of my new design of the door
handle-
set;

FIG. 4 is a top view of my new design of the door
handle-
set;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of my new design of the door
handle-
set;

FIG. 6, 7 and 8 are enlarged sectional views taken along
lines 6—6, 7—7 and 8—8, respectively, of FIG. 2 show-
ing design features of a portion of my new design of the
door handle-
set;

FIG. 9 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line
9—9 of FIG. 1 showing design features of a portion of
my new design of the door handle-
set;

FIG. 10 is an enlarged view of FIG. 5 showing design
features of portions of my design of the door handle-
set
as viewed from the bottom;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged view of FIG. 4 showing design
features of portions of my design of the door handle-
set
as viewed from the top; and,

FIG. 12 is a reduced perspective view of my new
design of the door handle-
set.

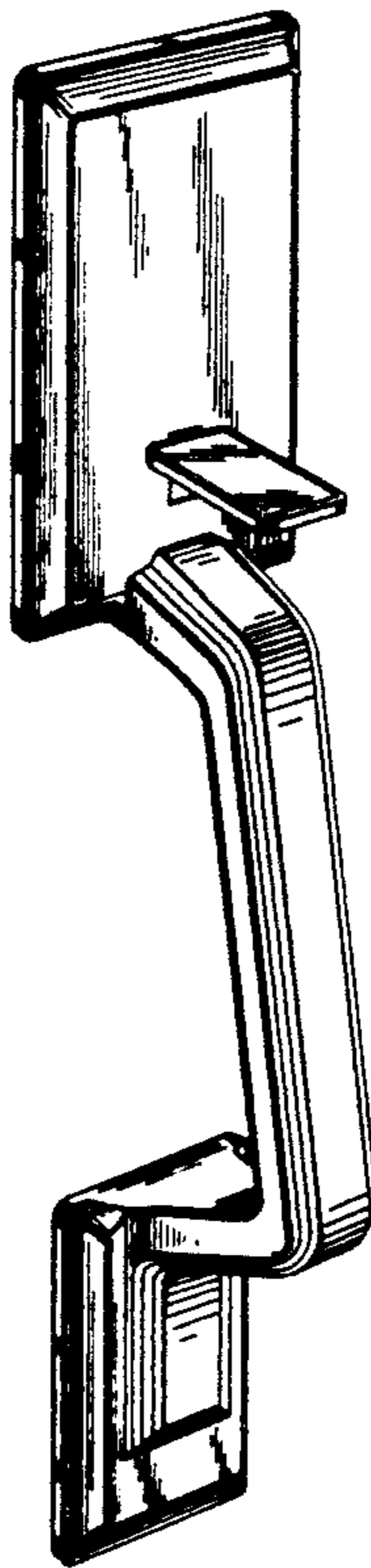

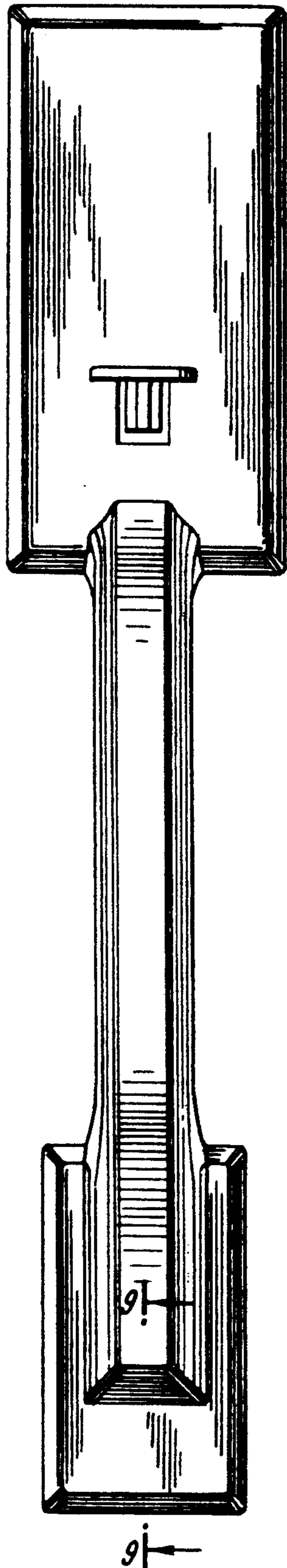

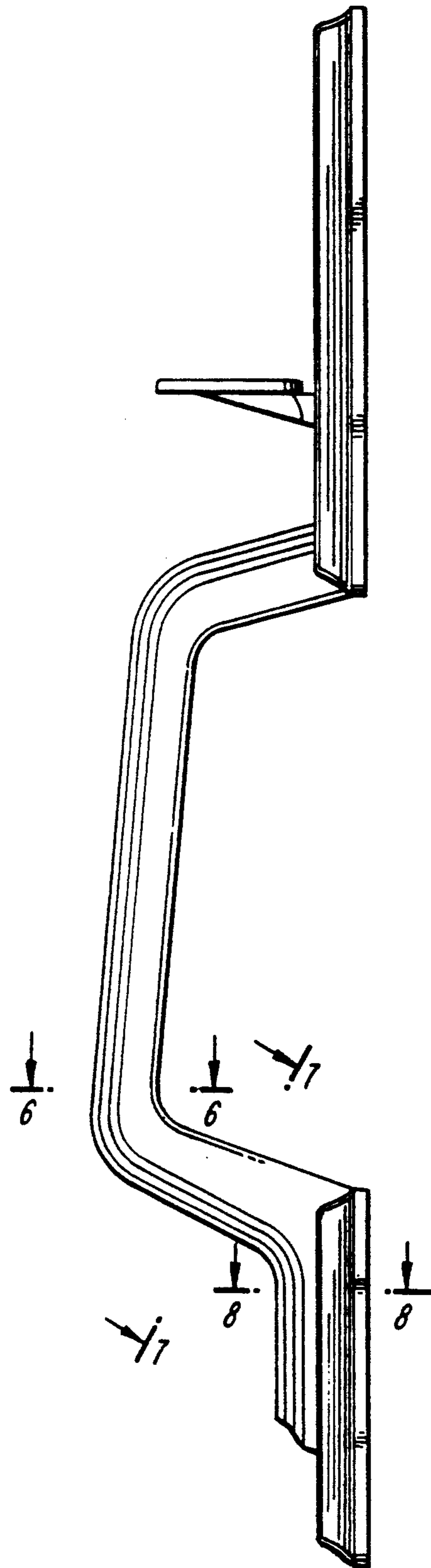

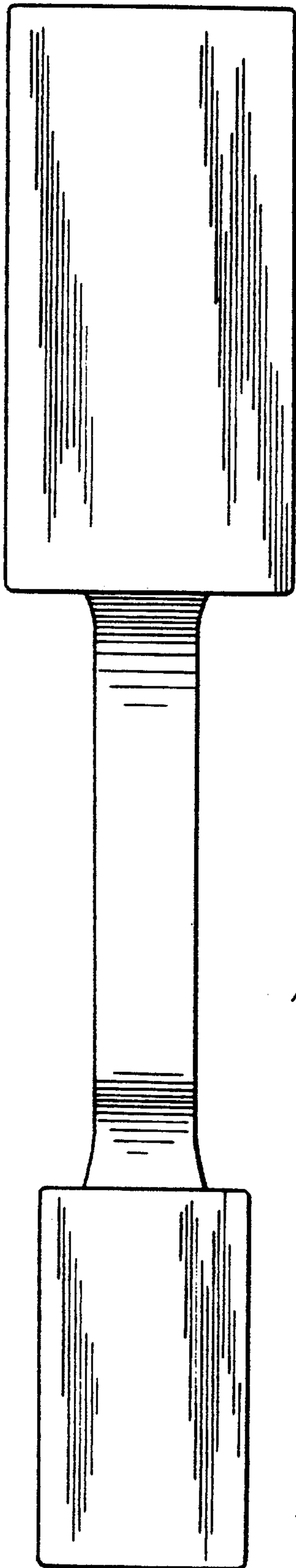

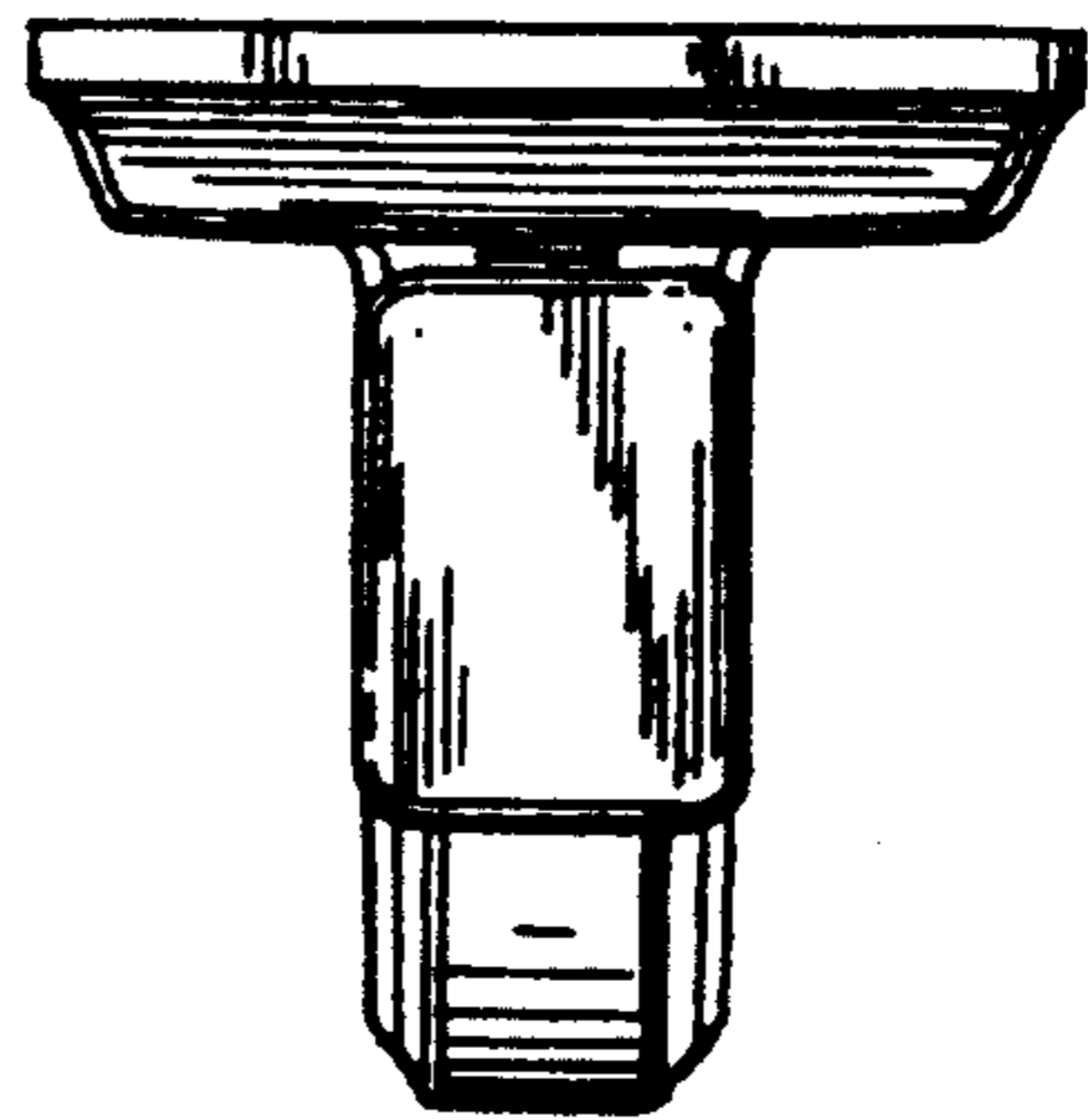

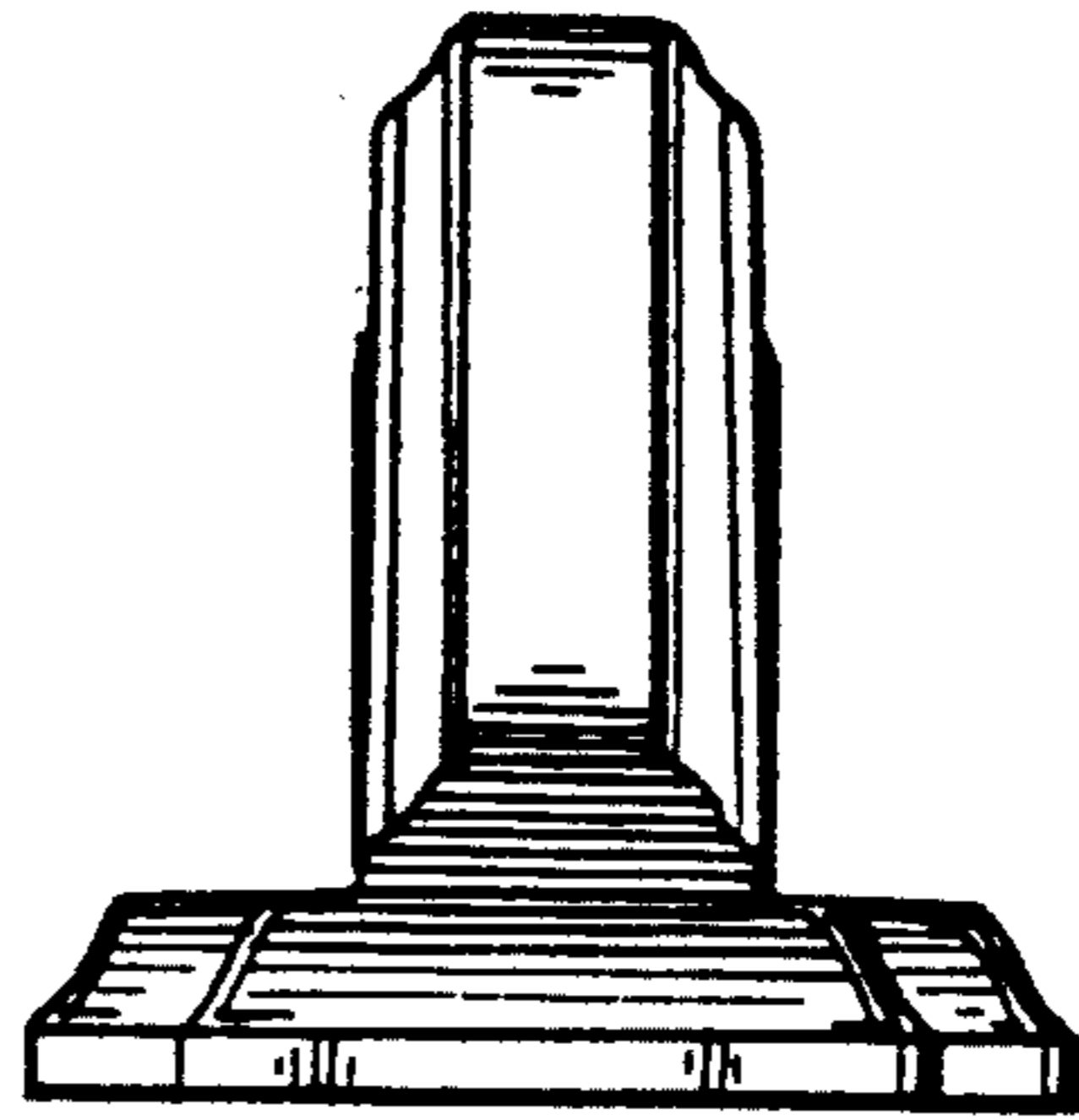

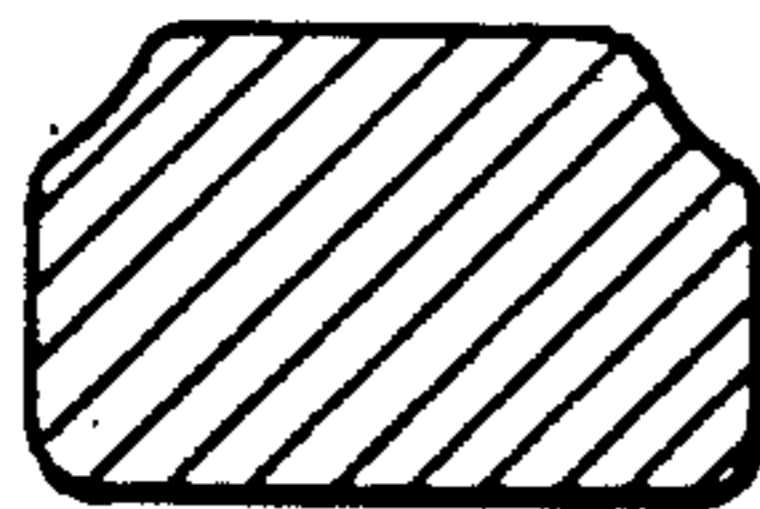

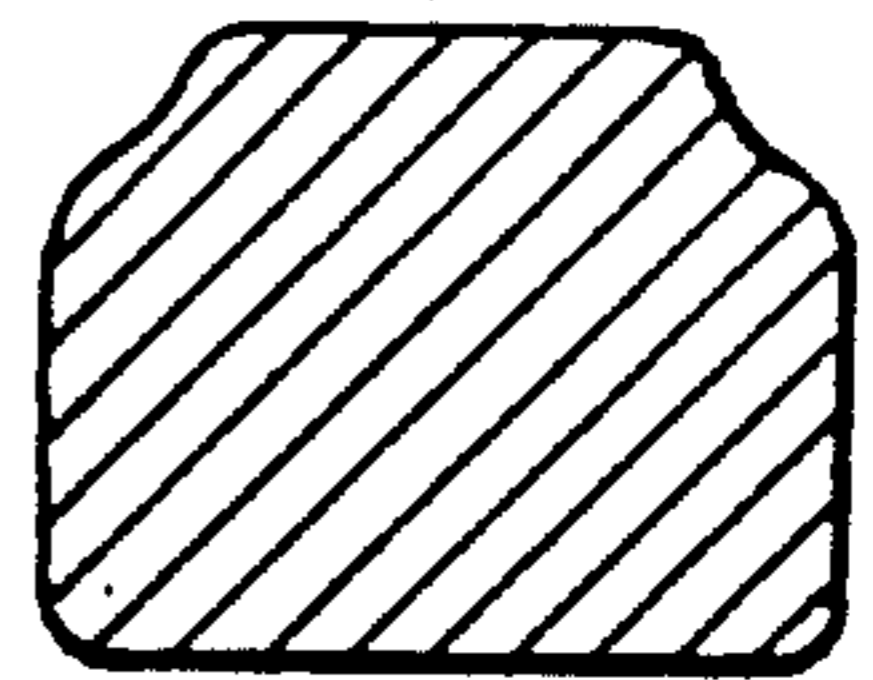
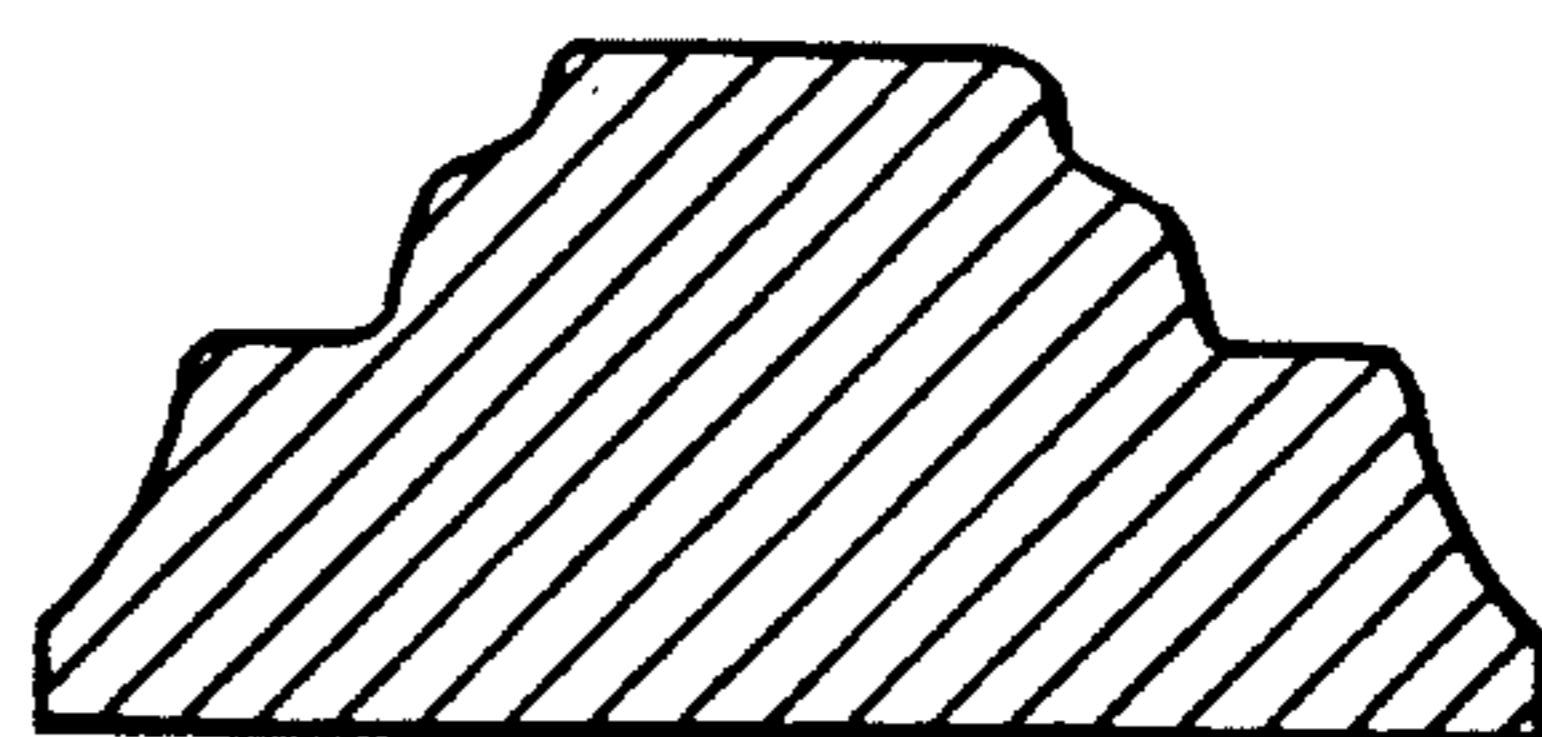

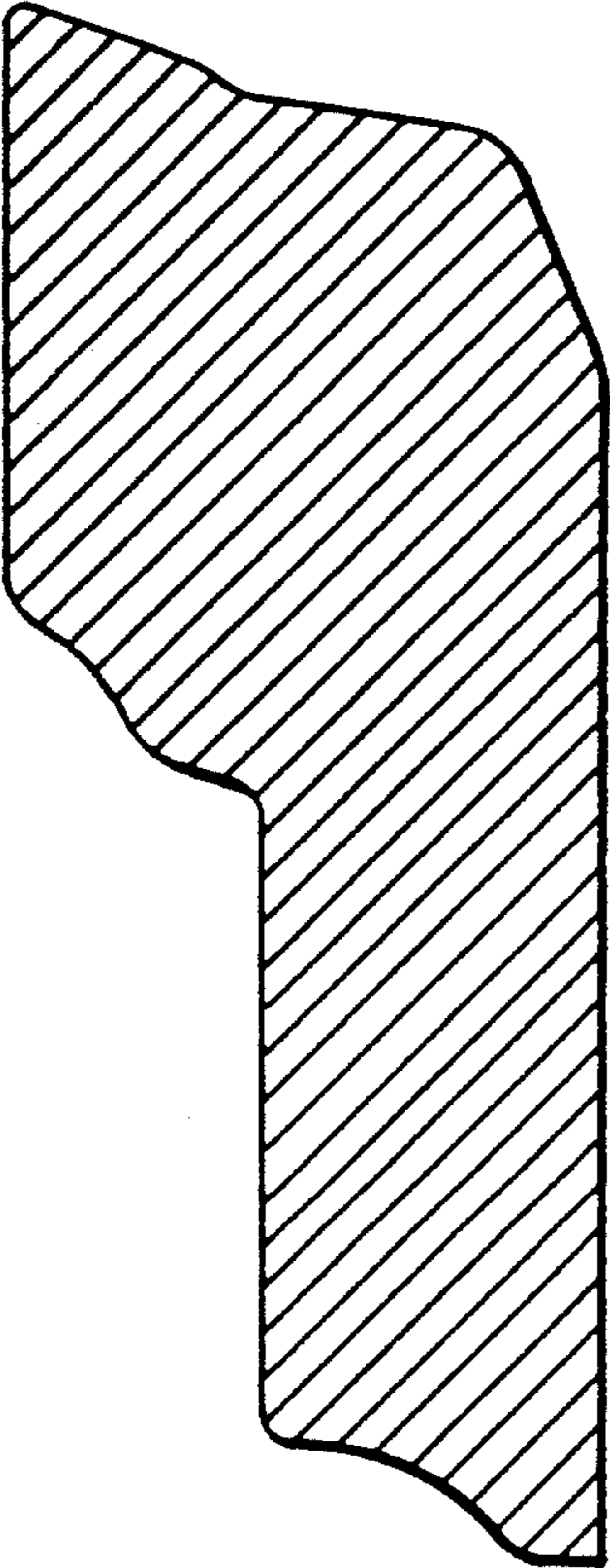

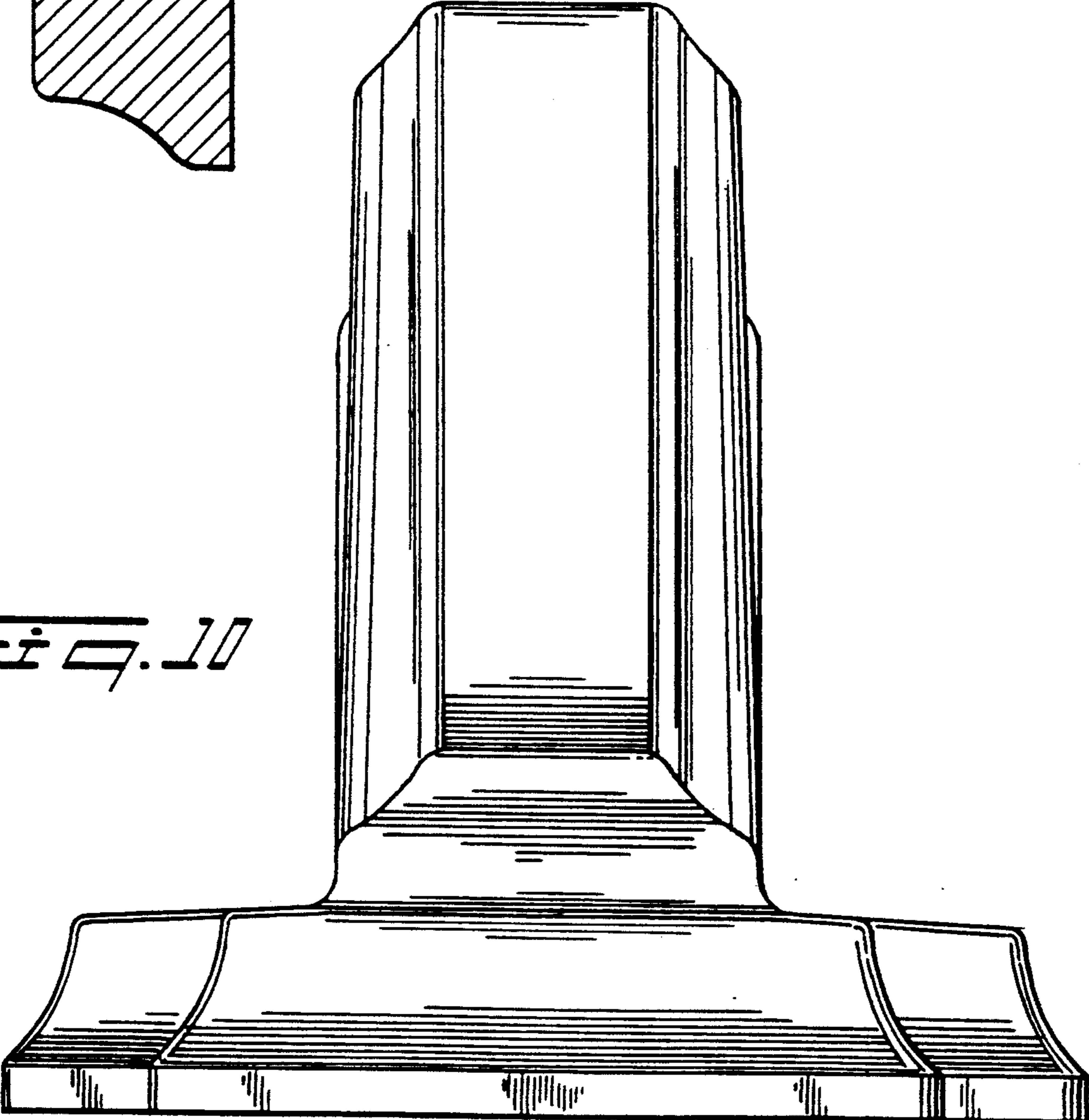
