DESCRIPTION

FIG. 31 is a perspective view, taken slightly from above, of a sixth embodiment of an arm chair showing my new design;

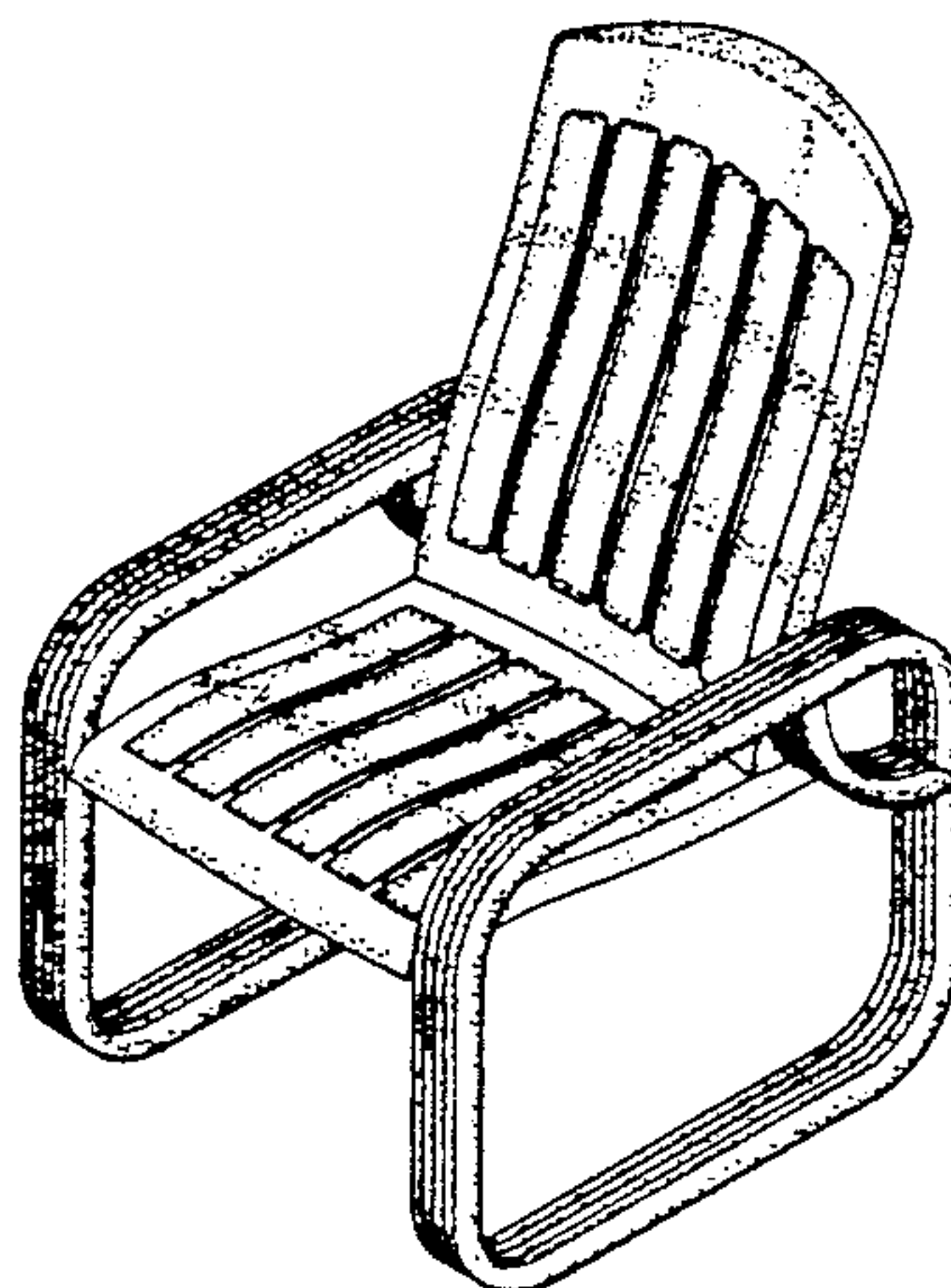
FIG. 32 is a front elevational view;

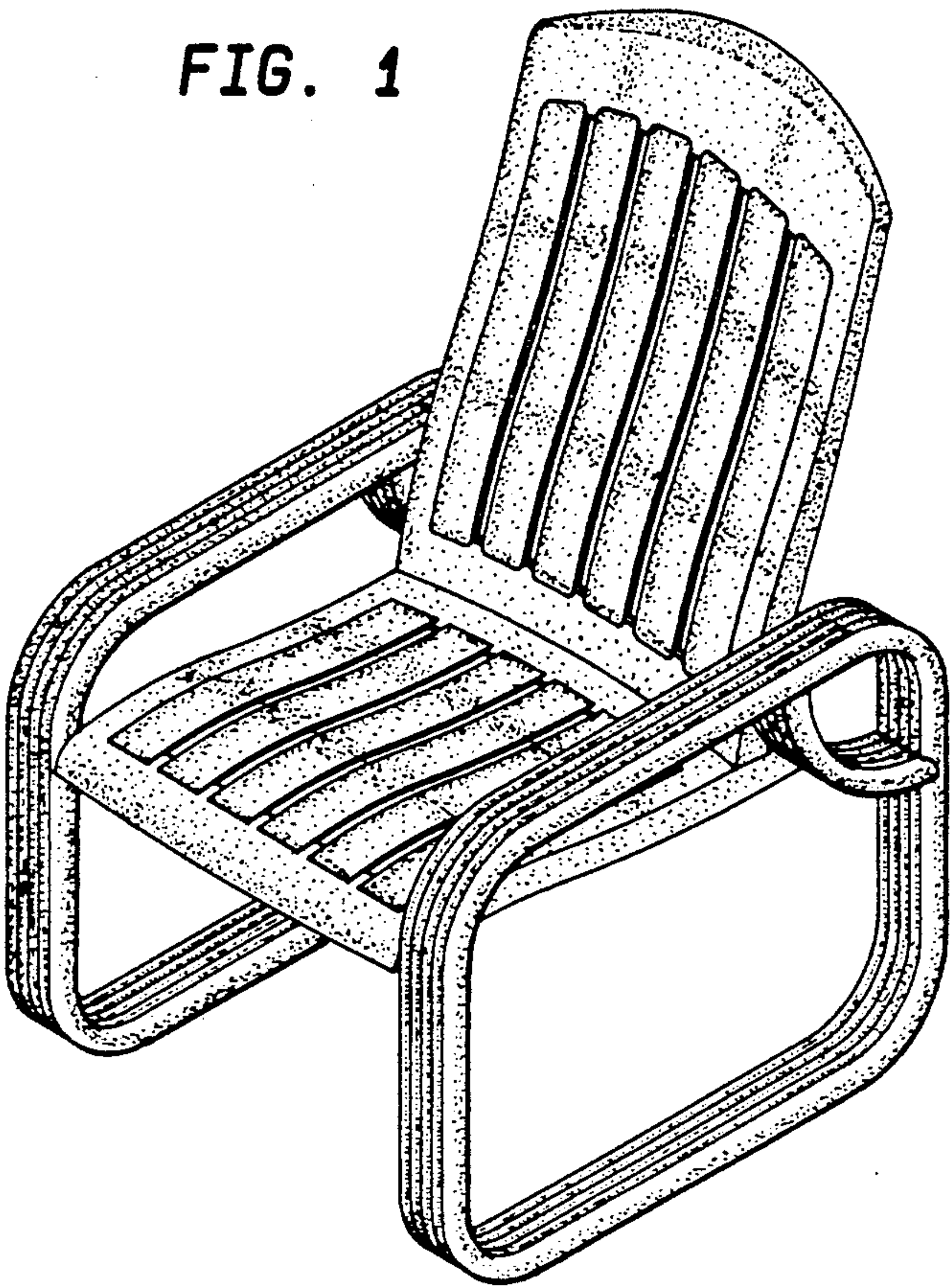

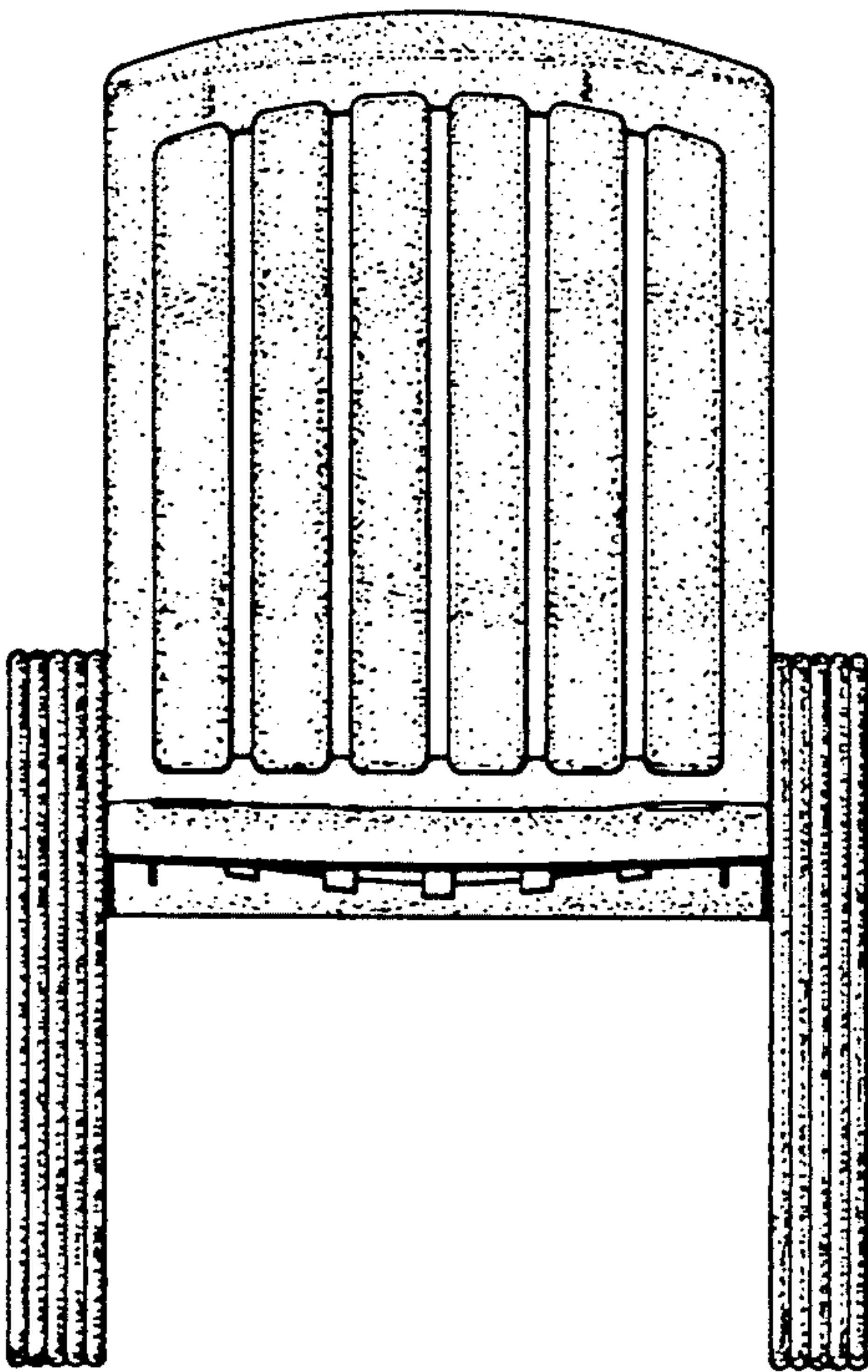

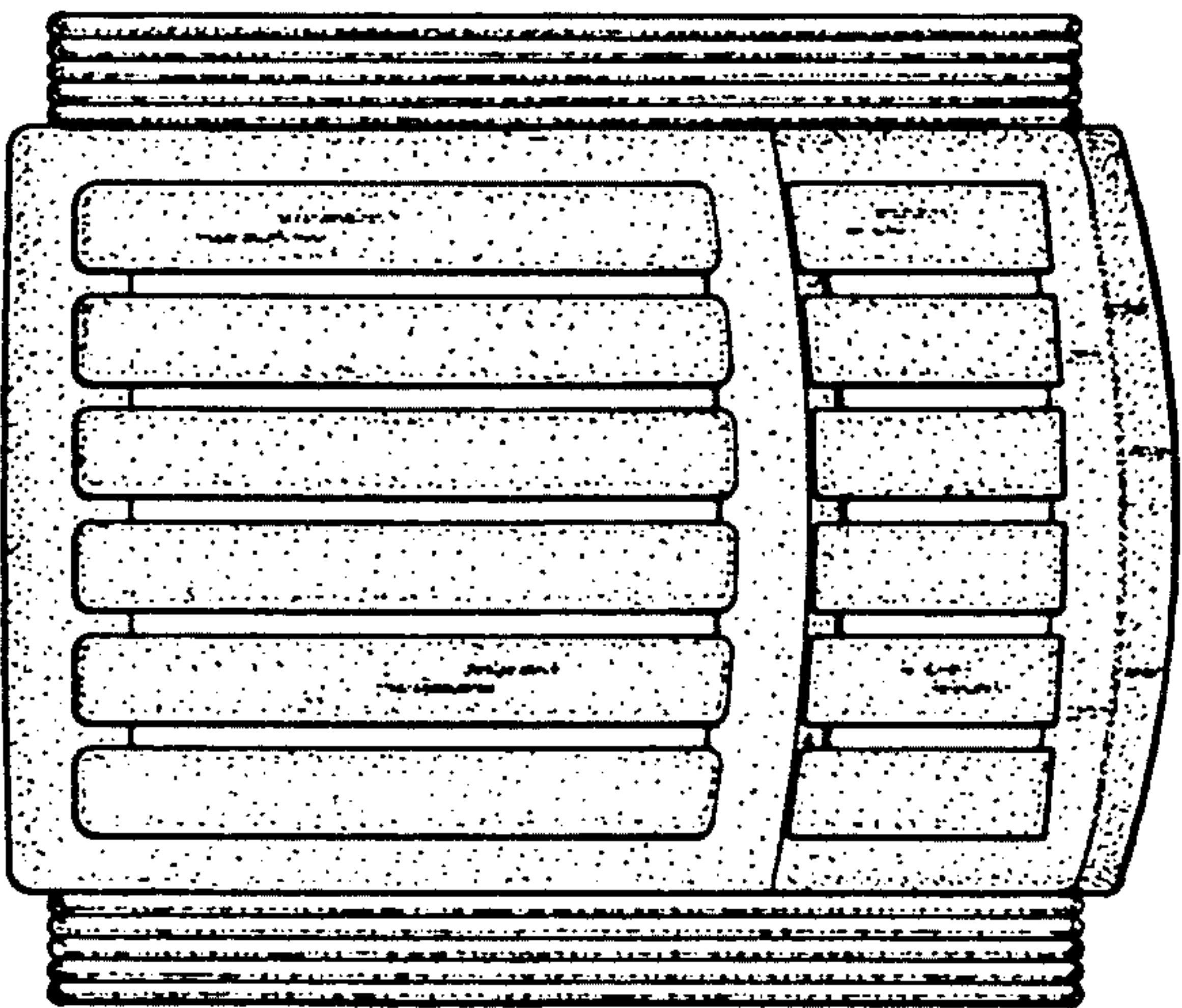

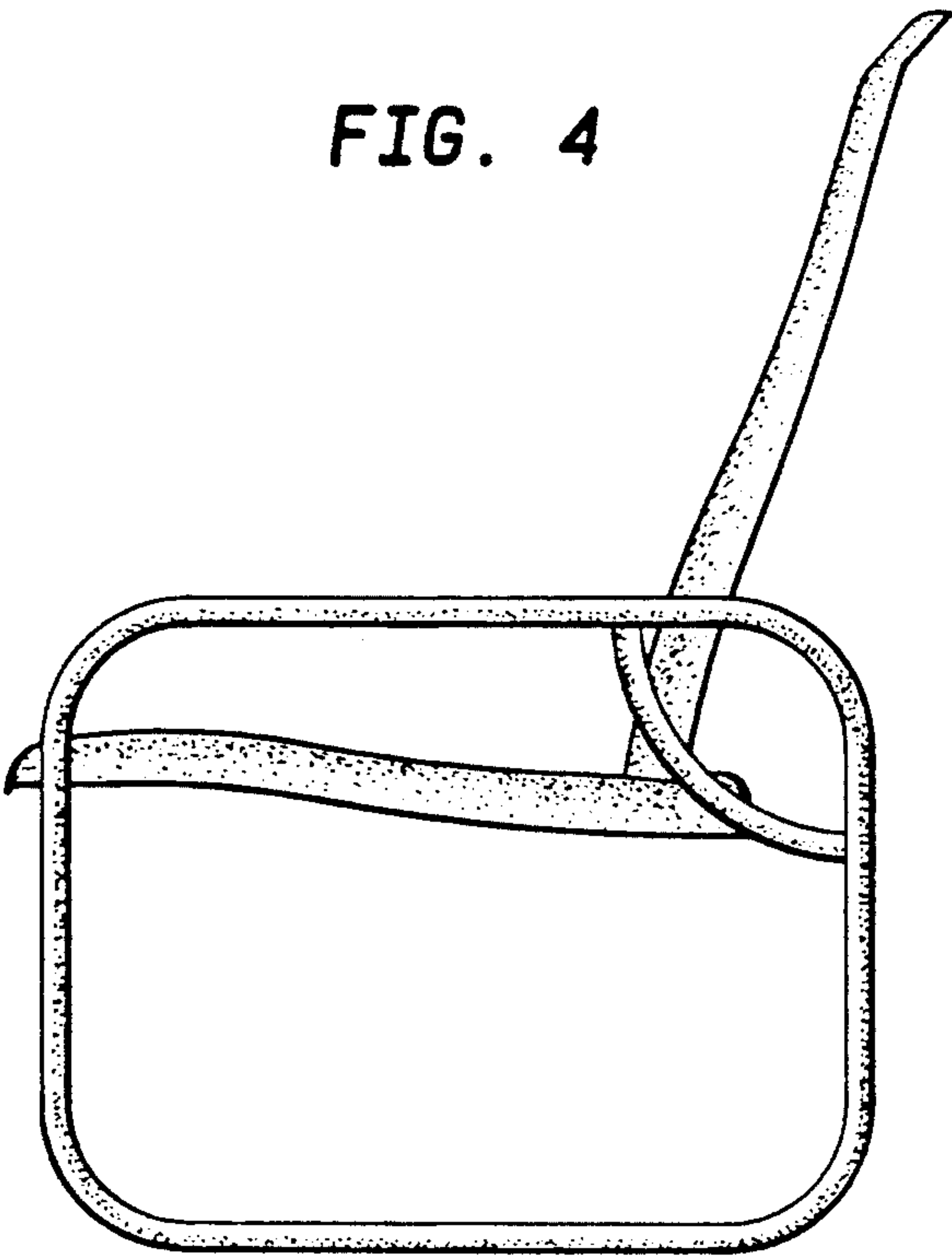

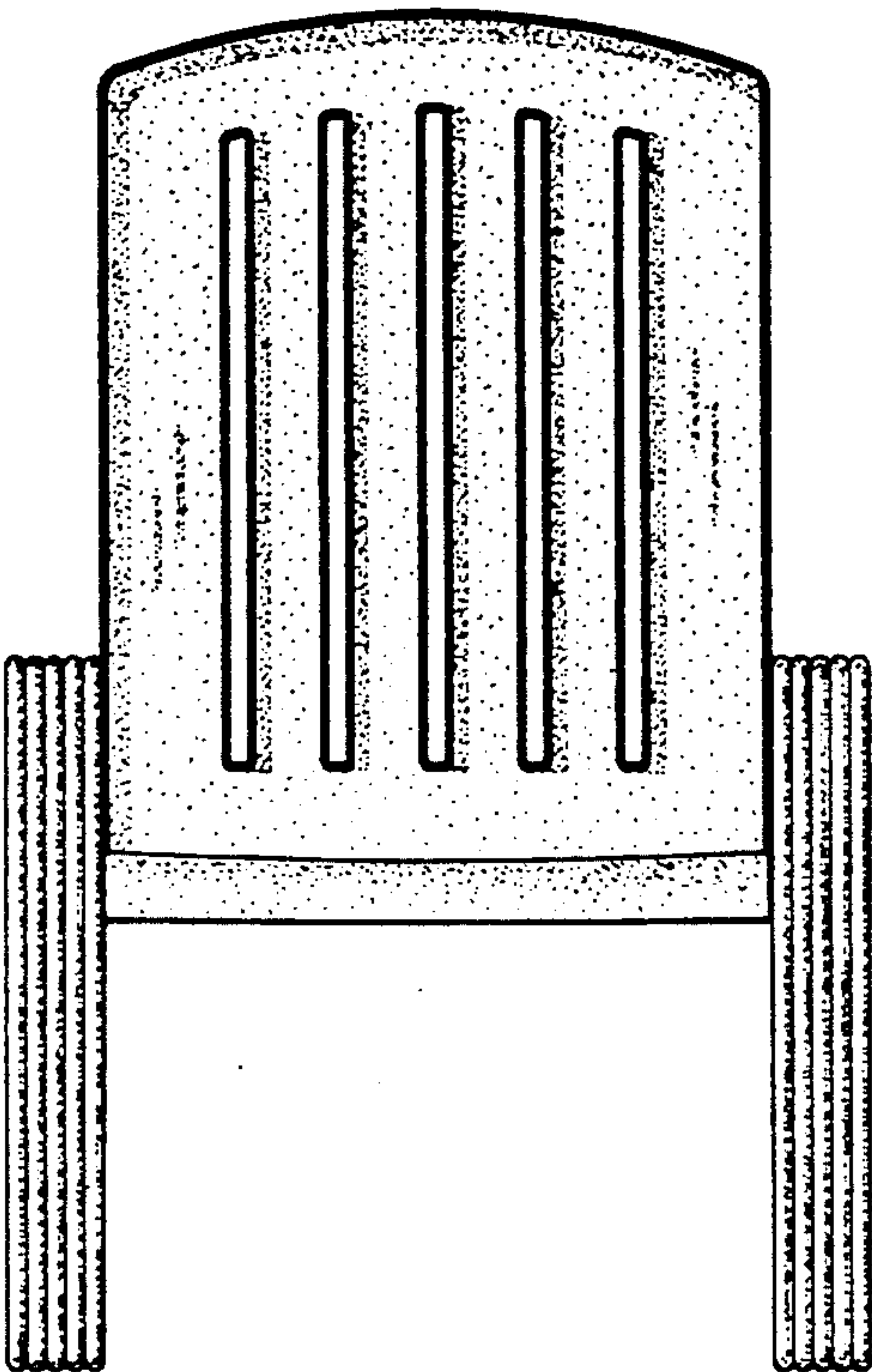

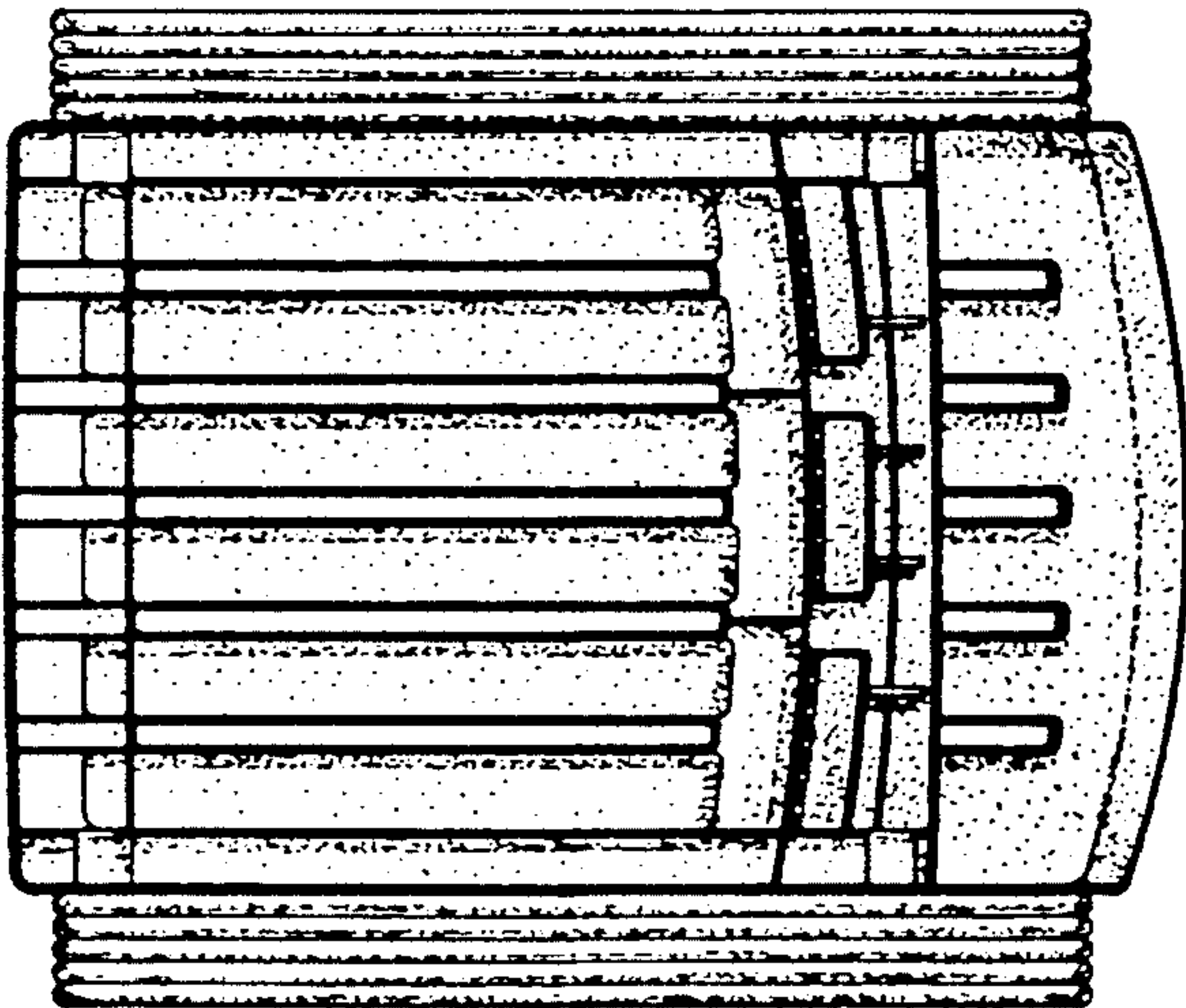

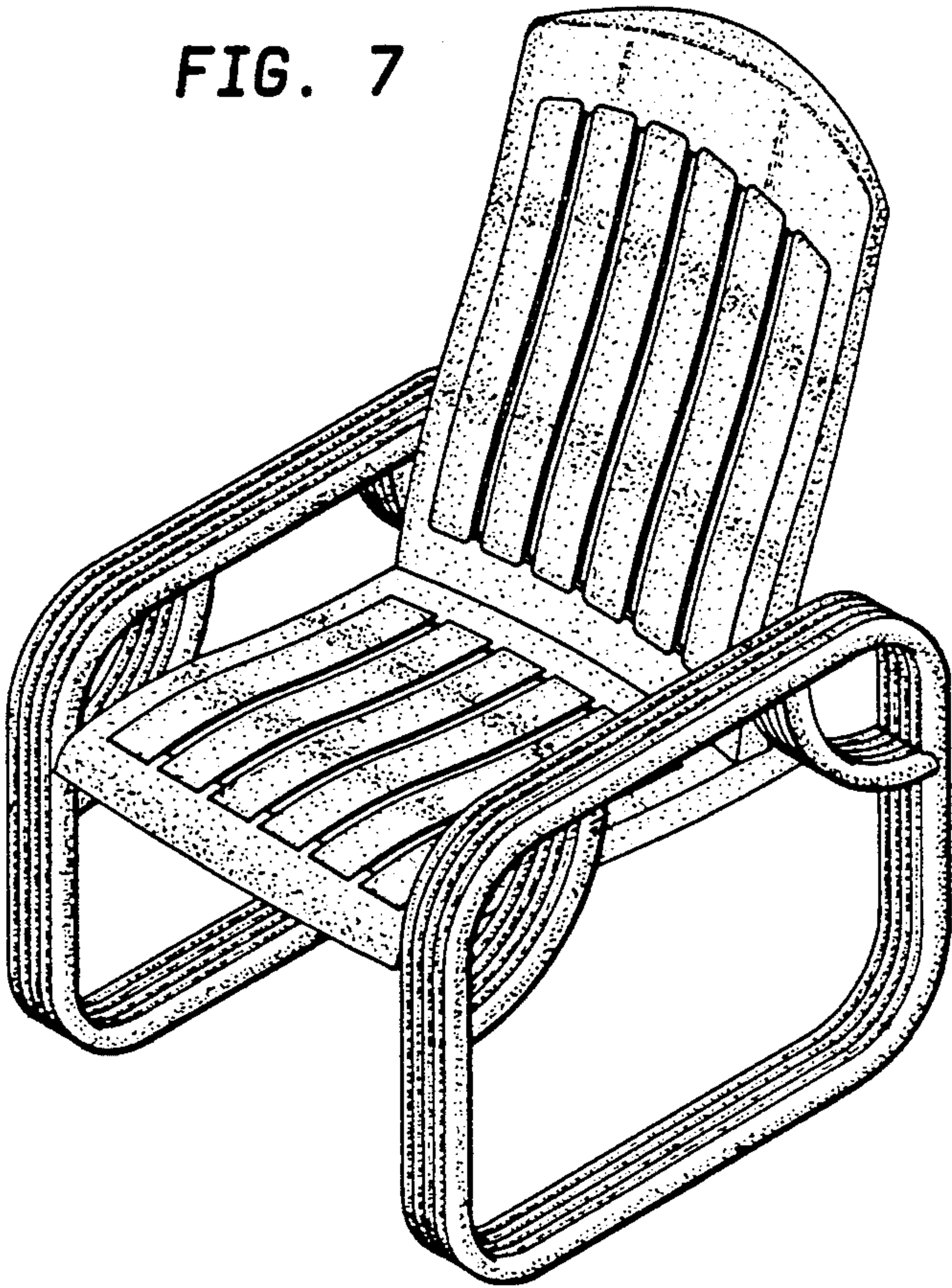

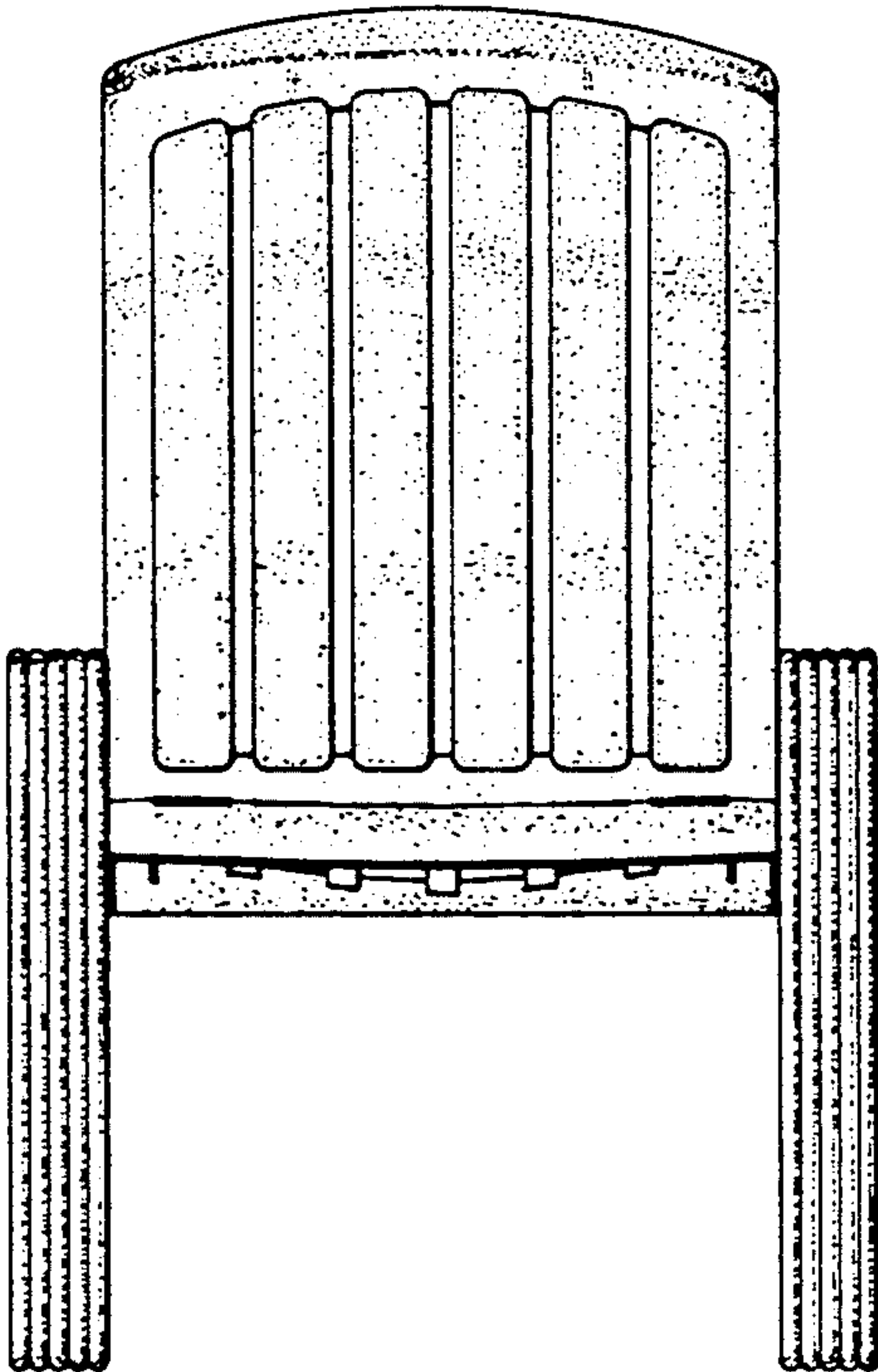

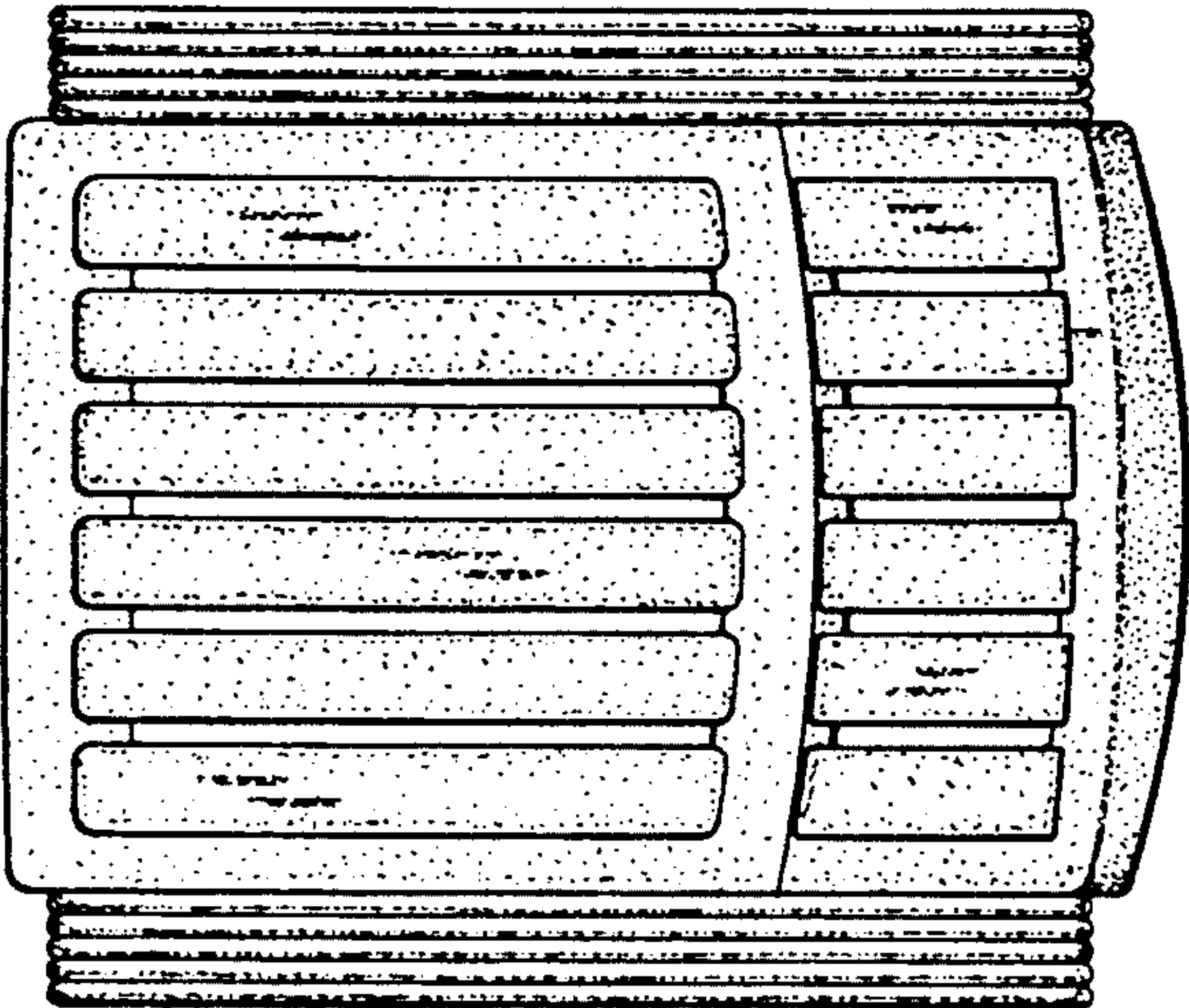

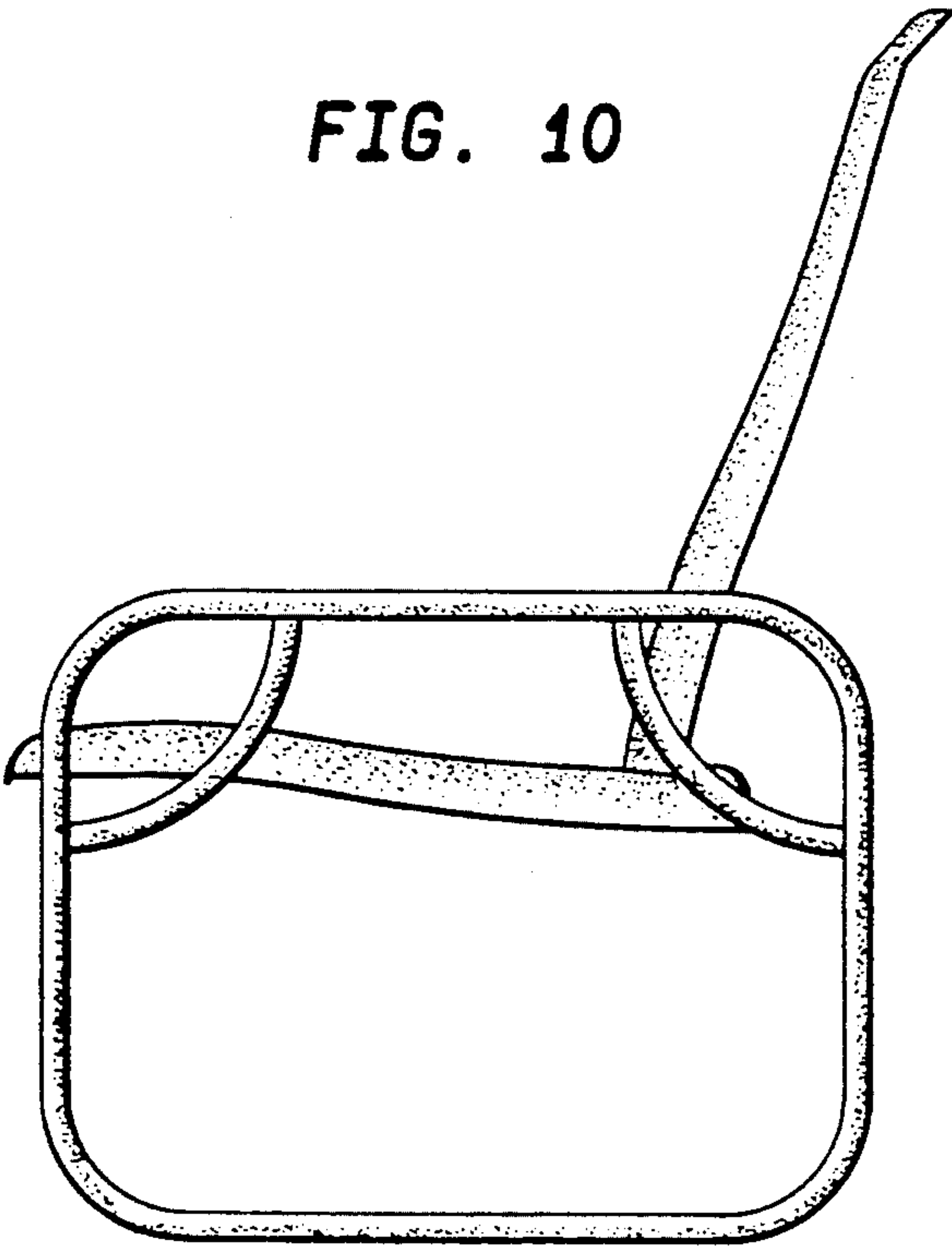

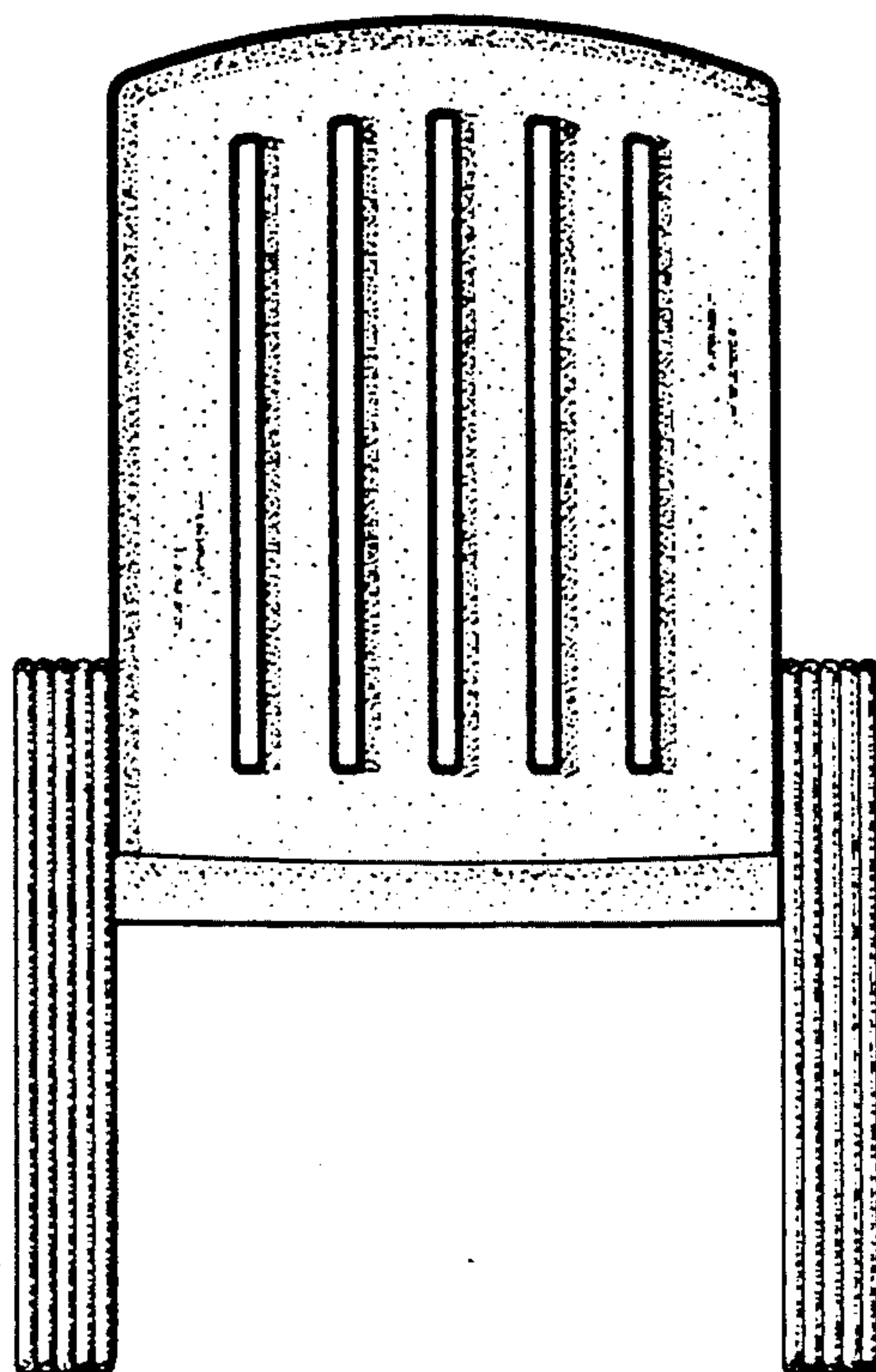


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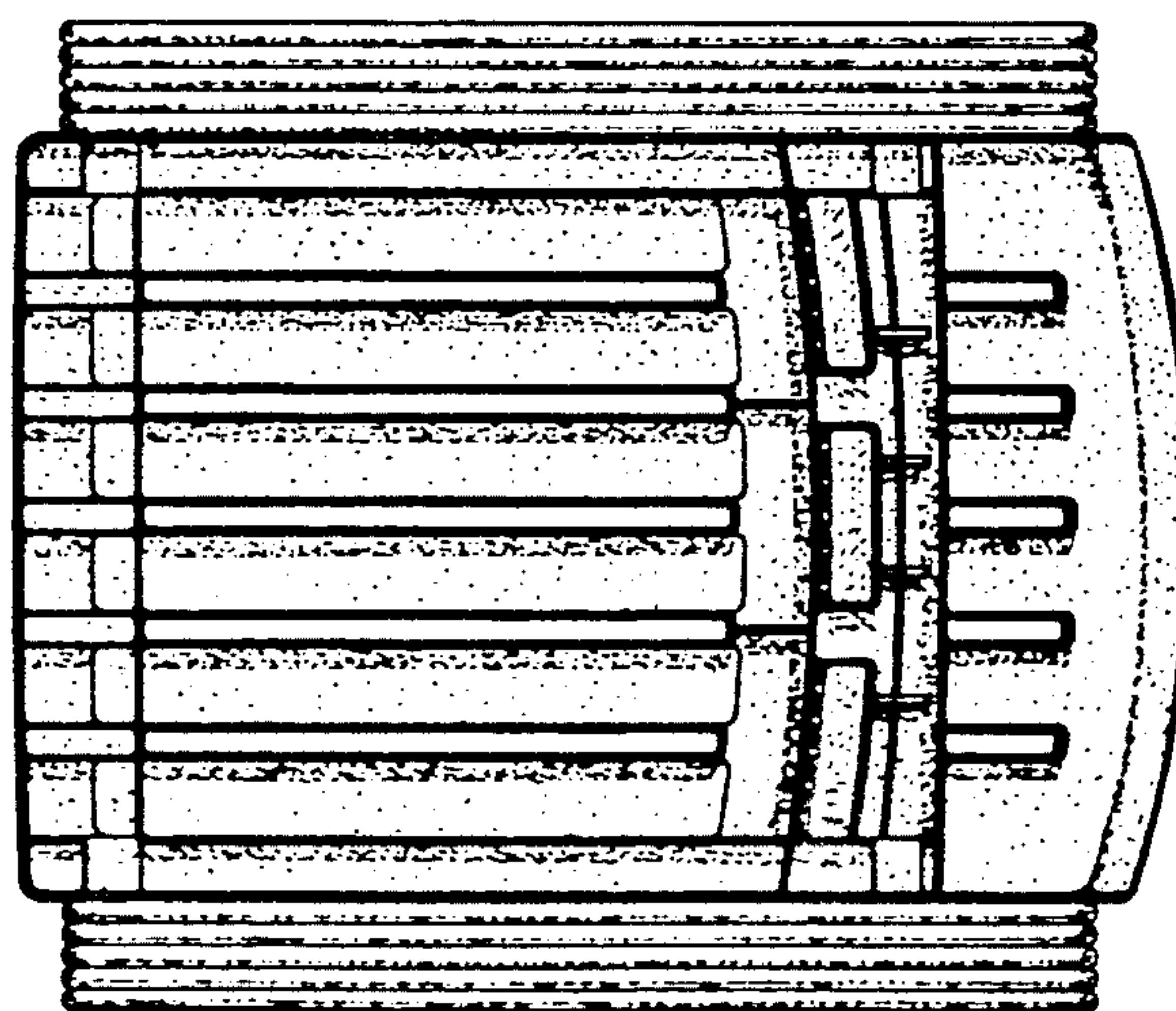


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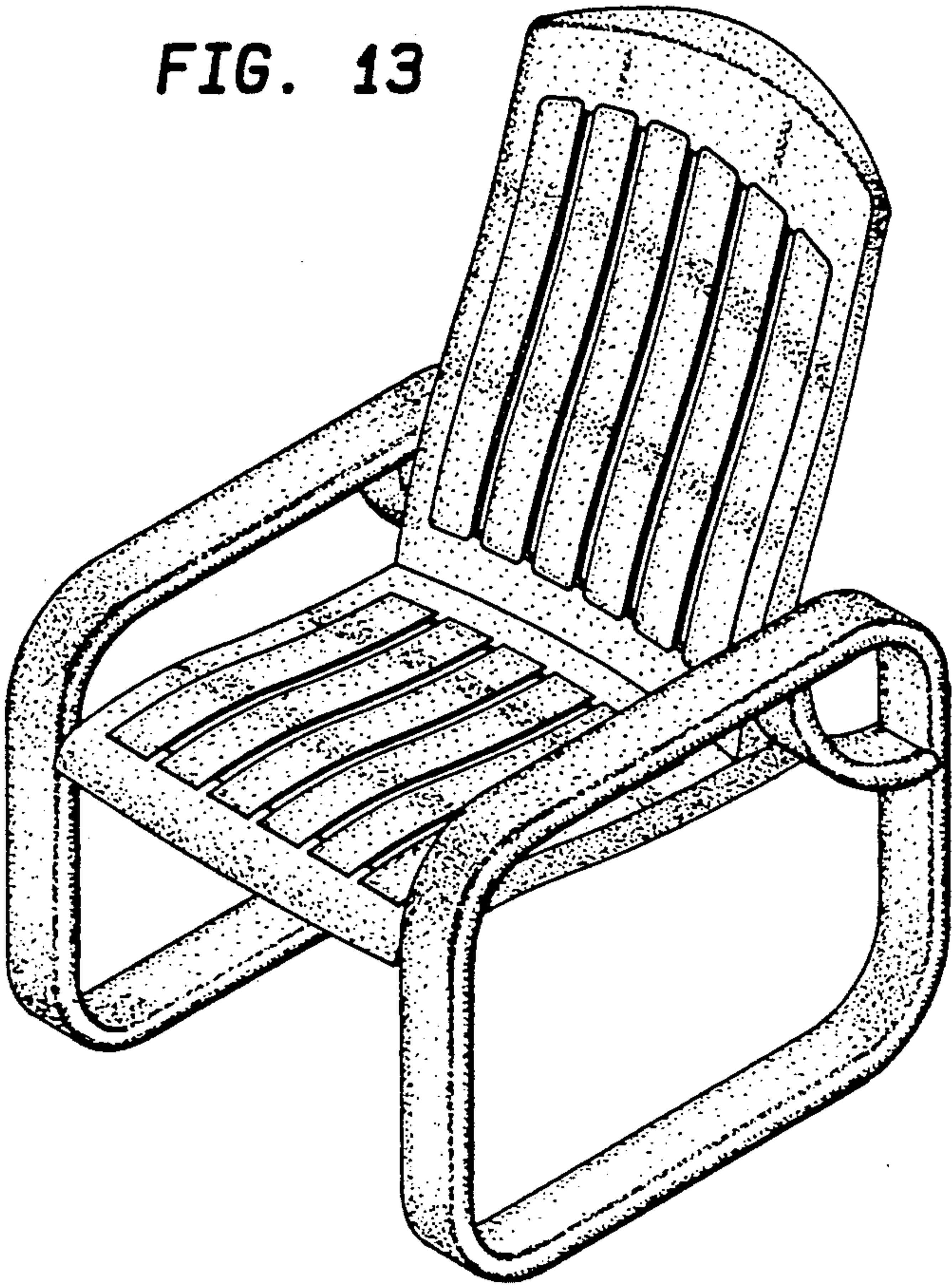

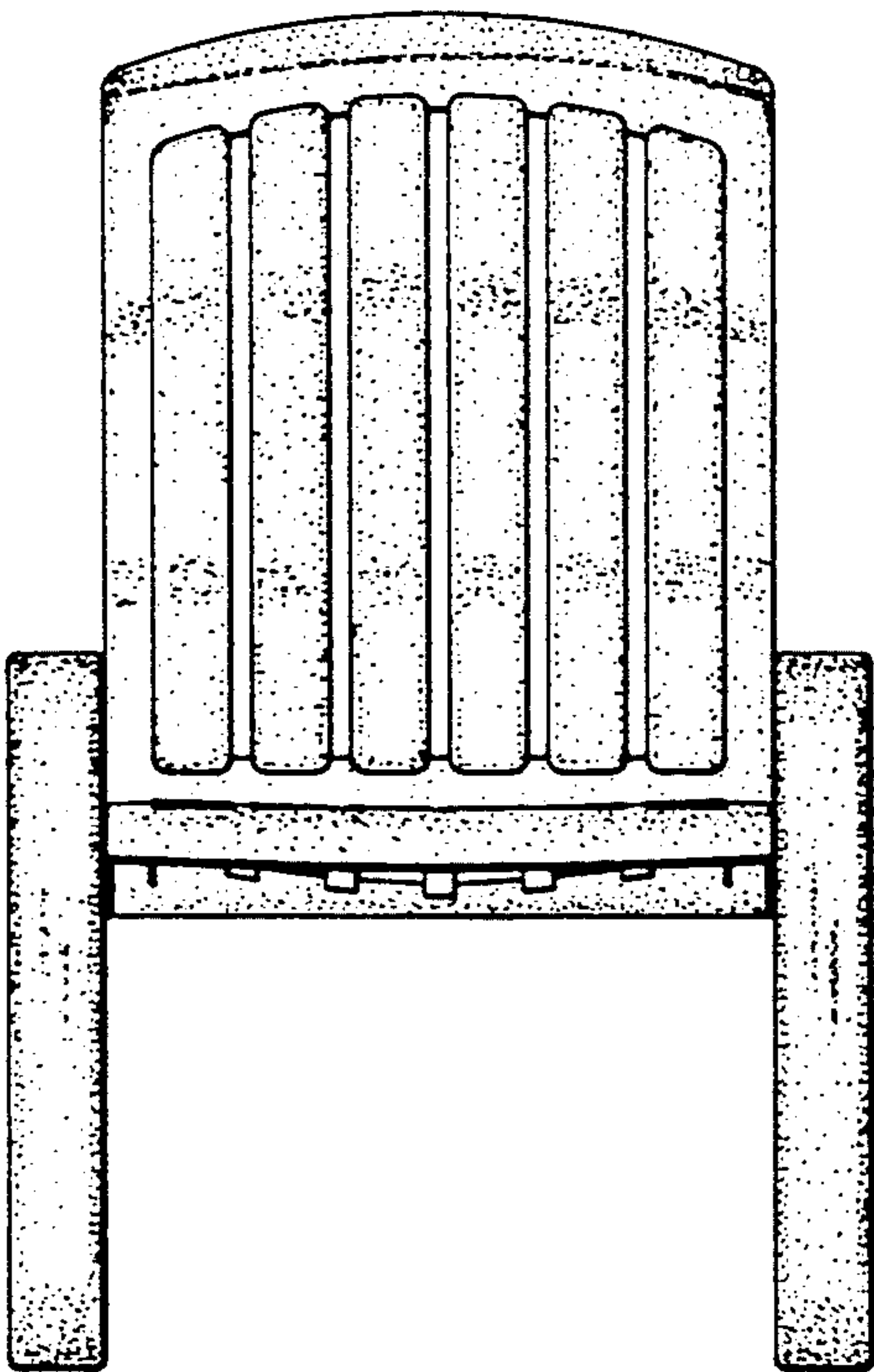


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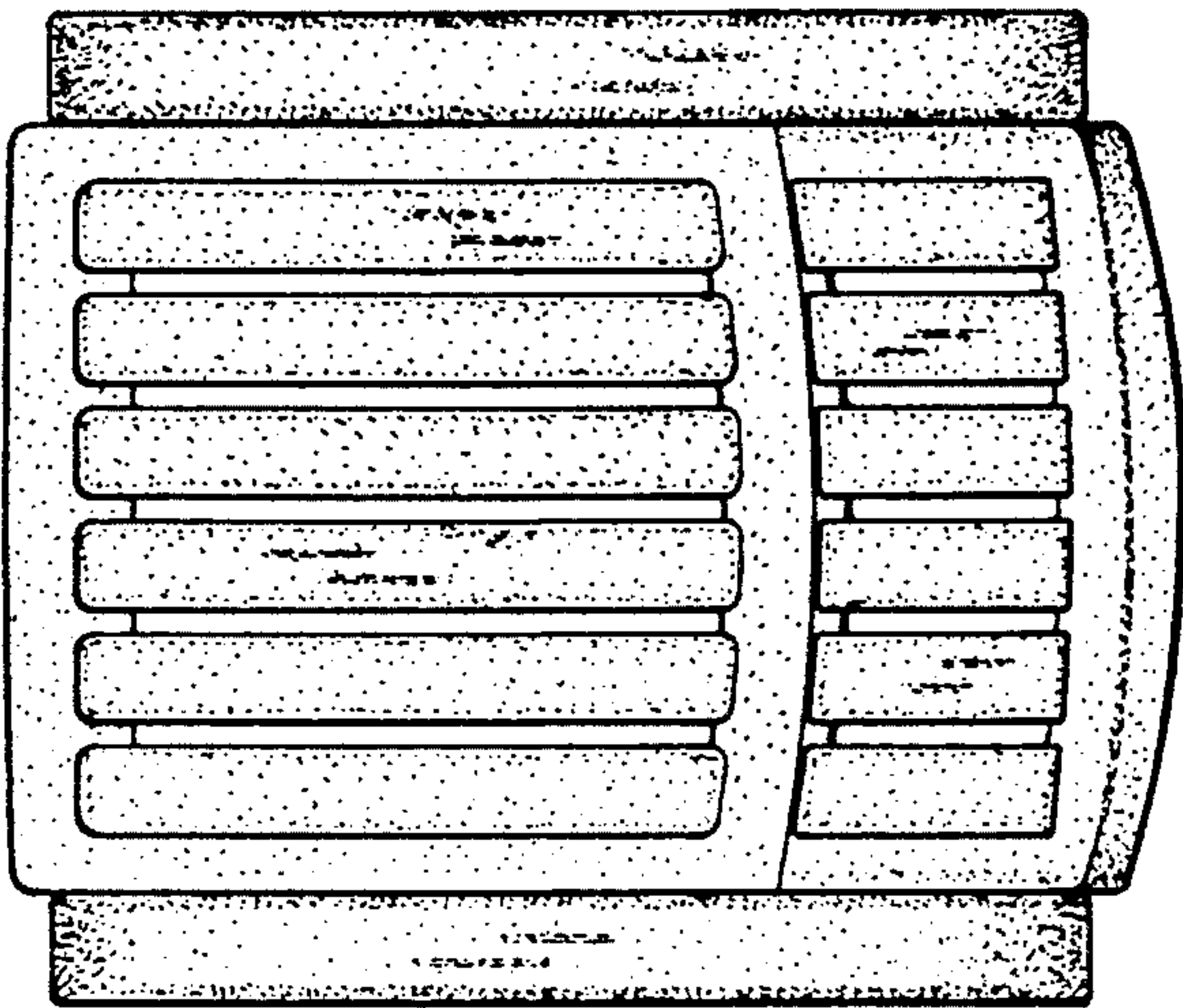


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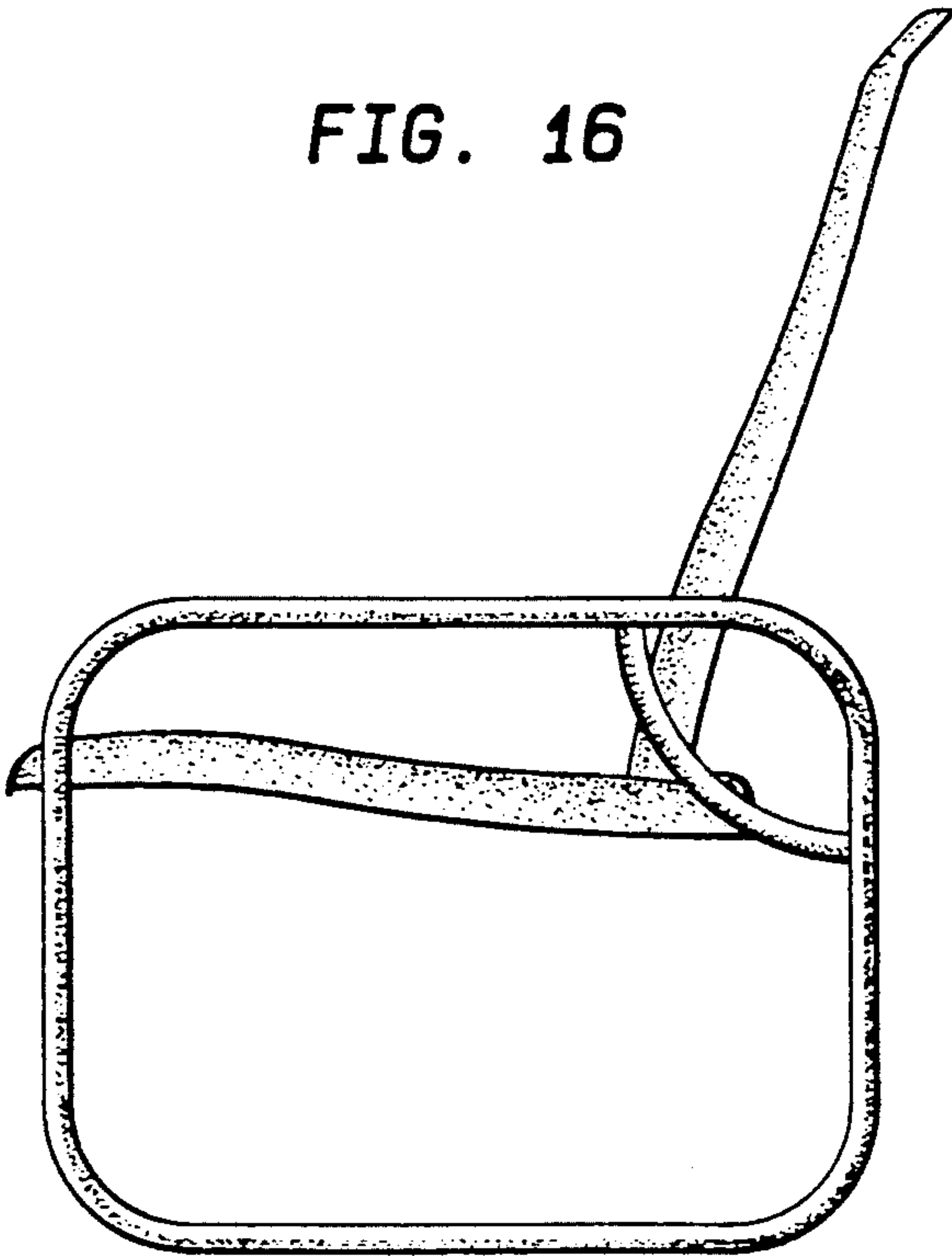


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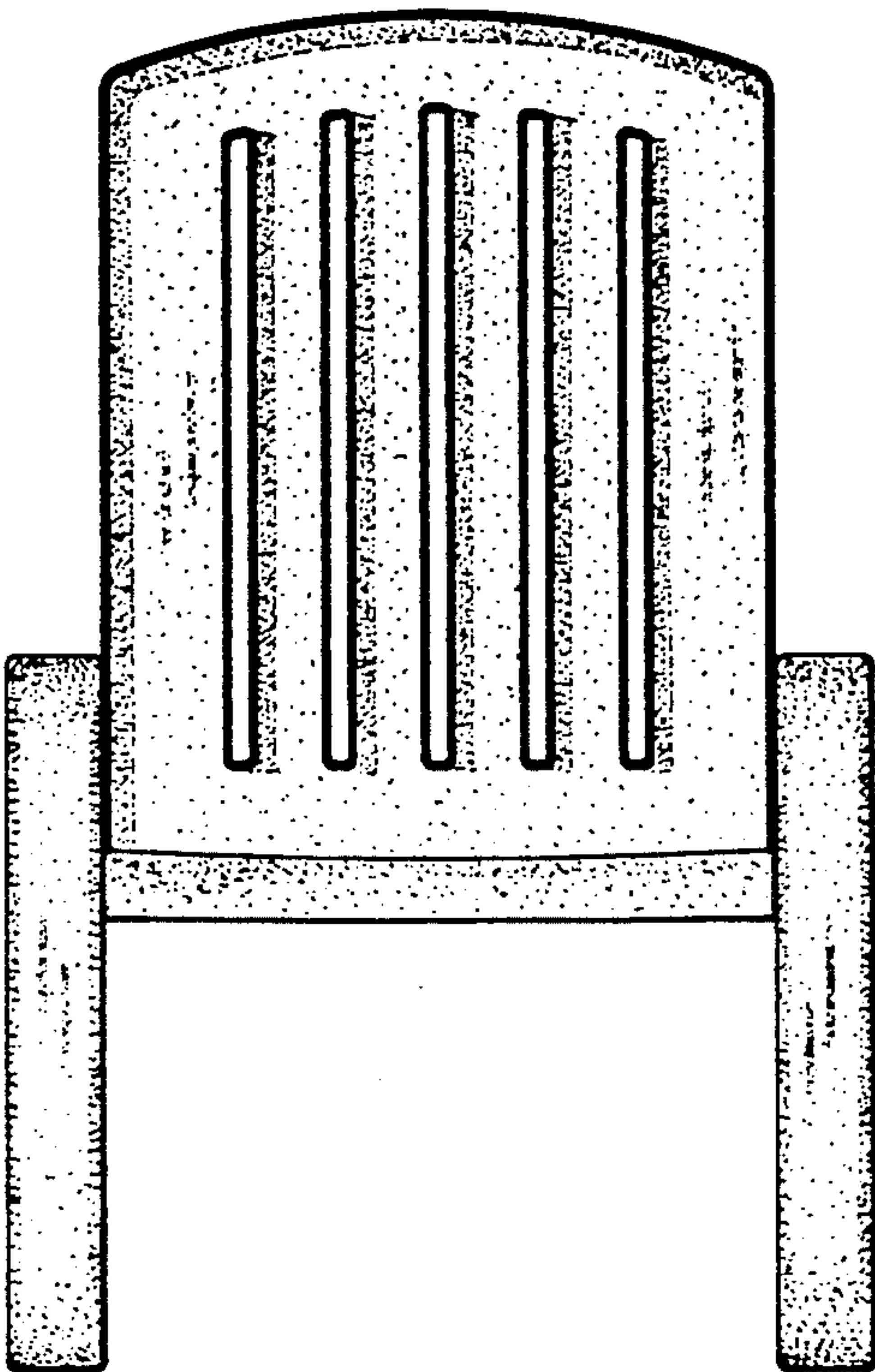

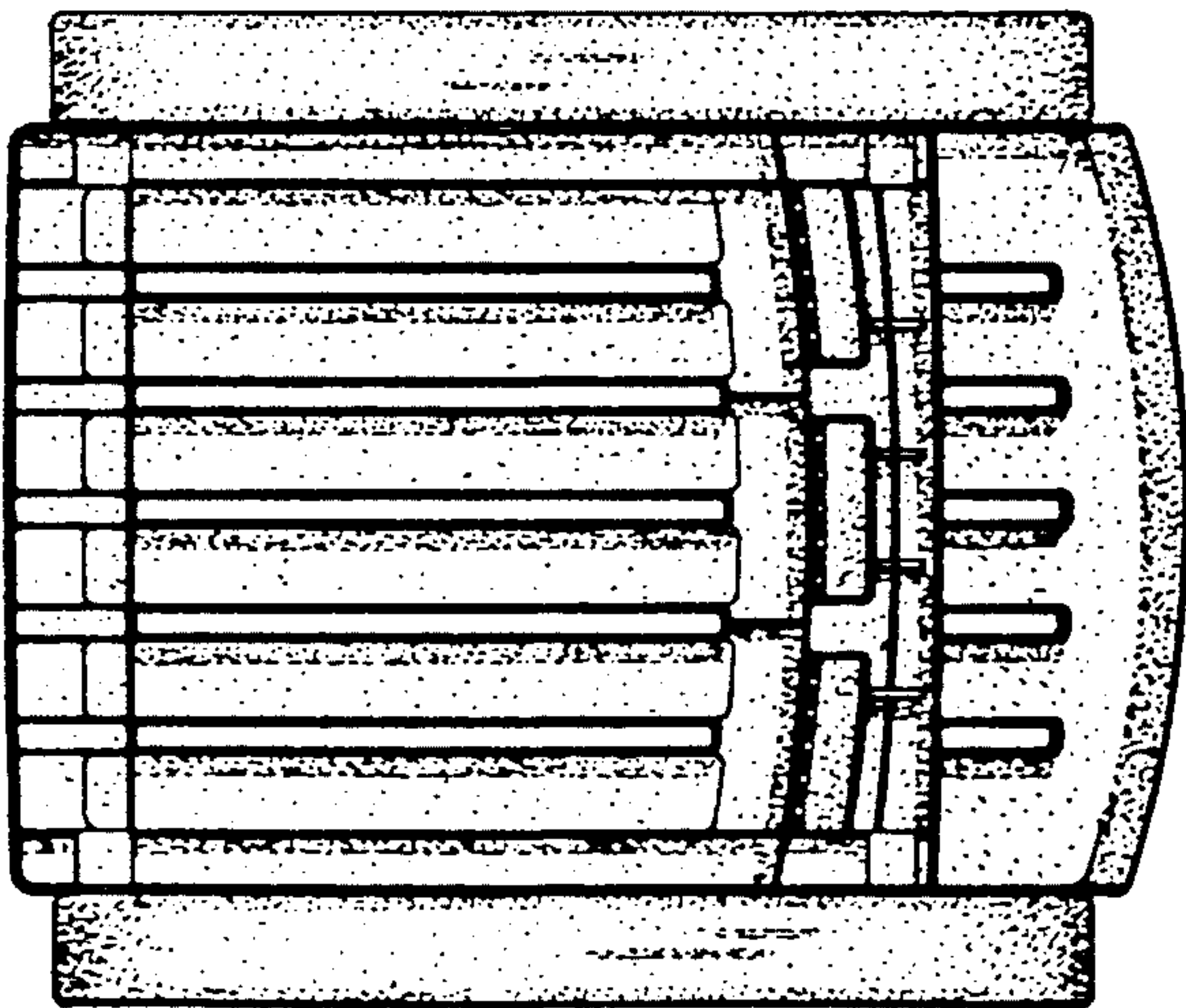

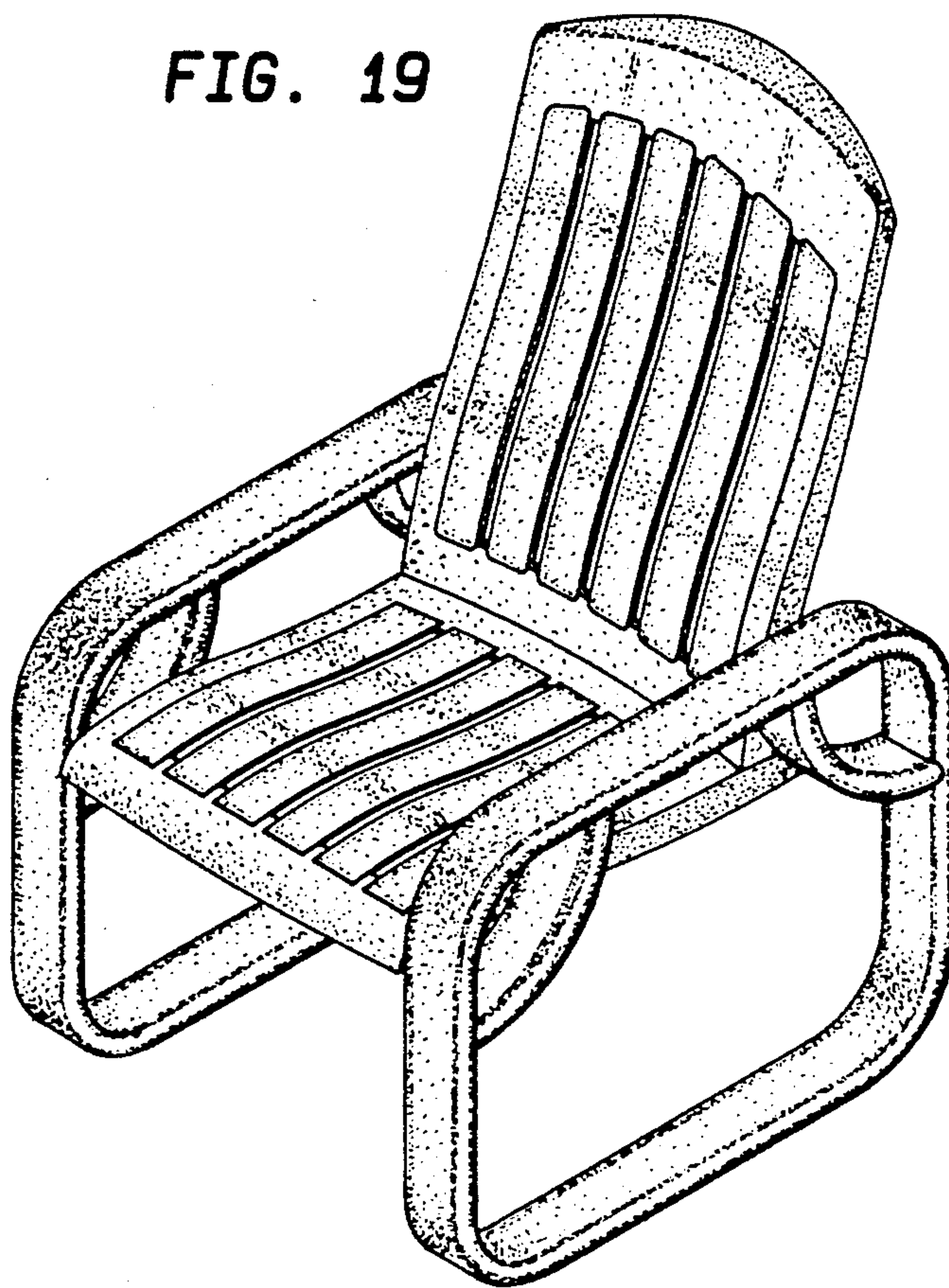


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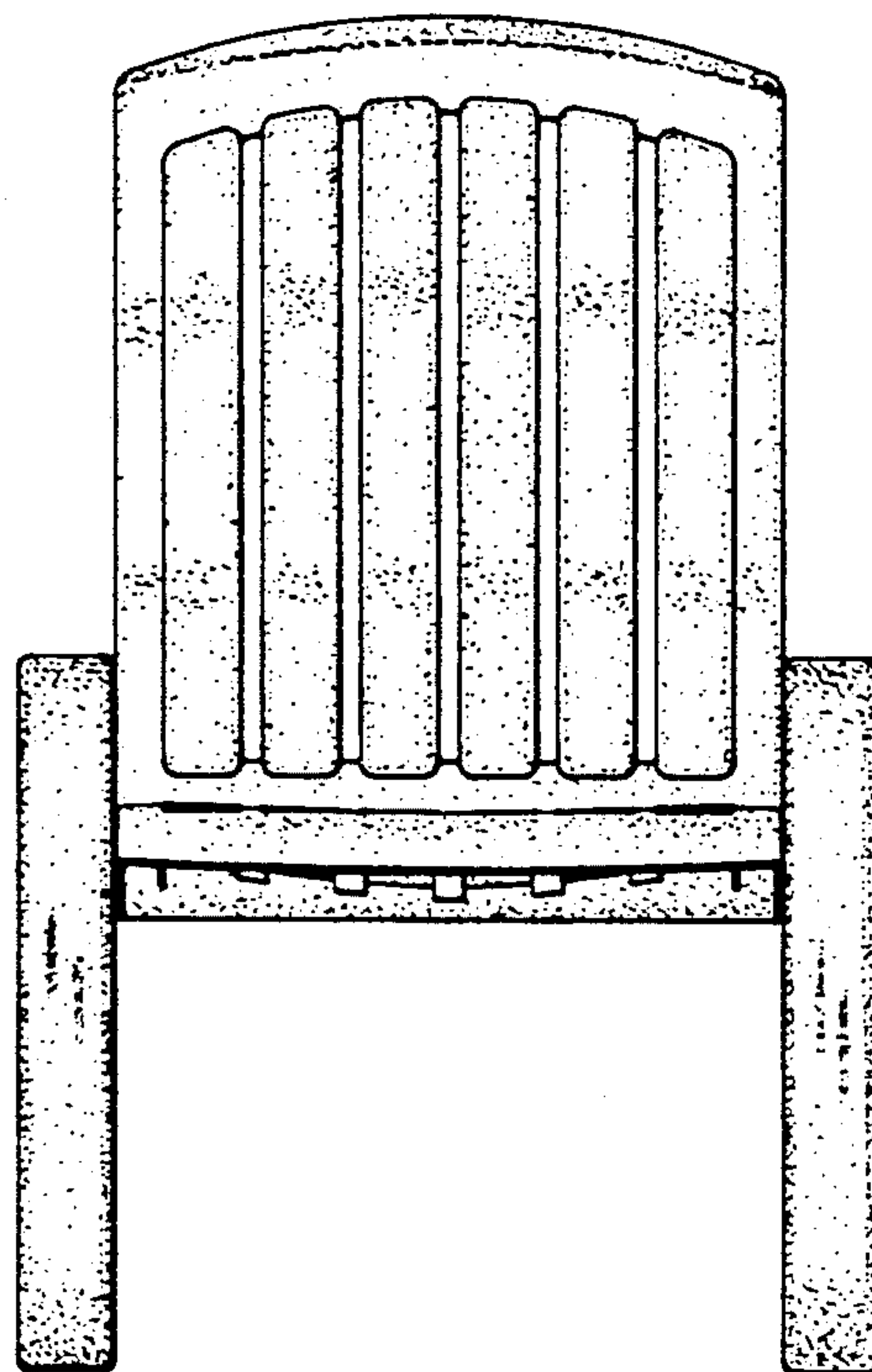


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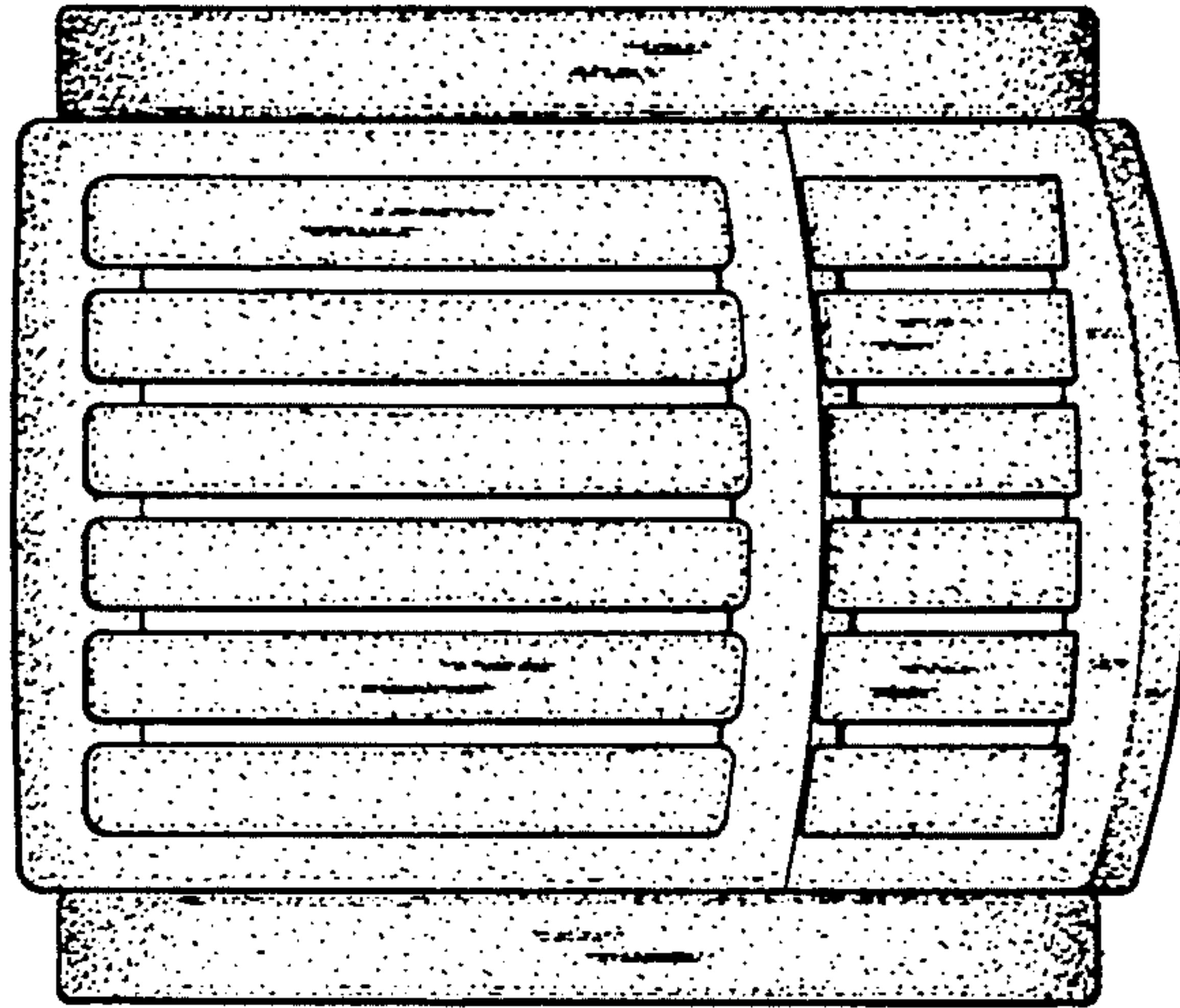

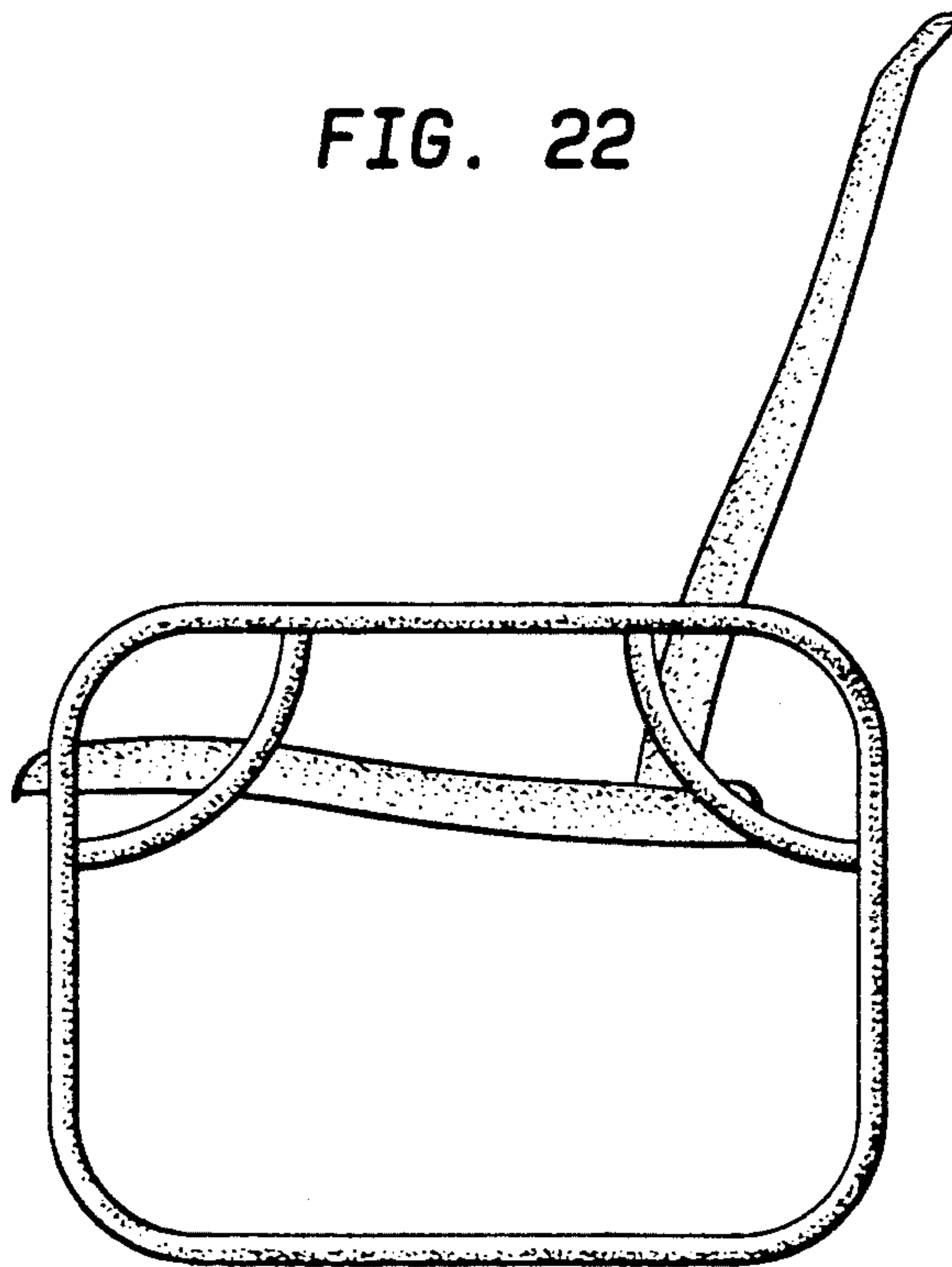

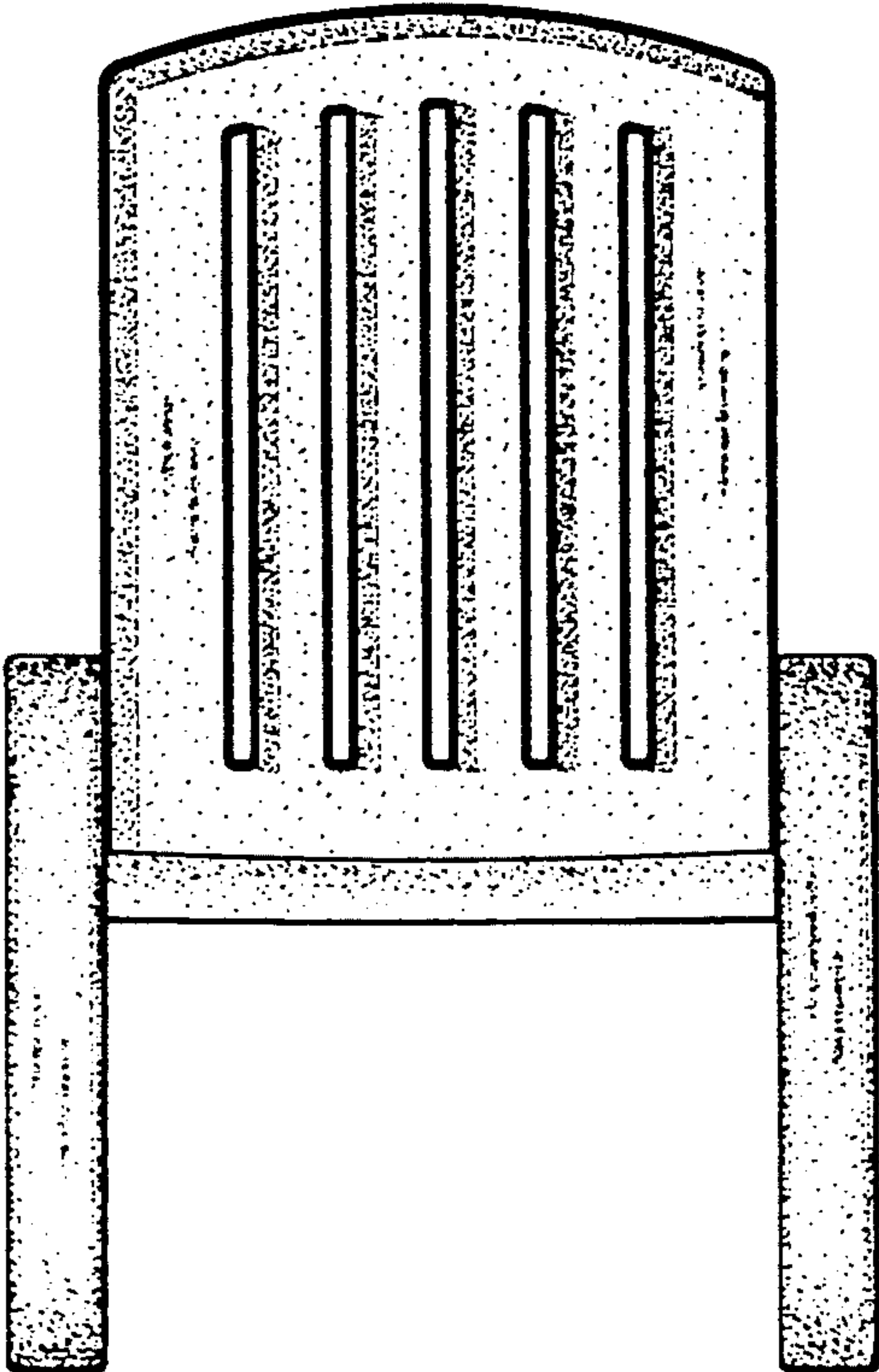

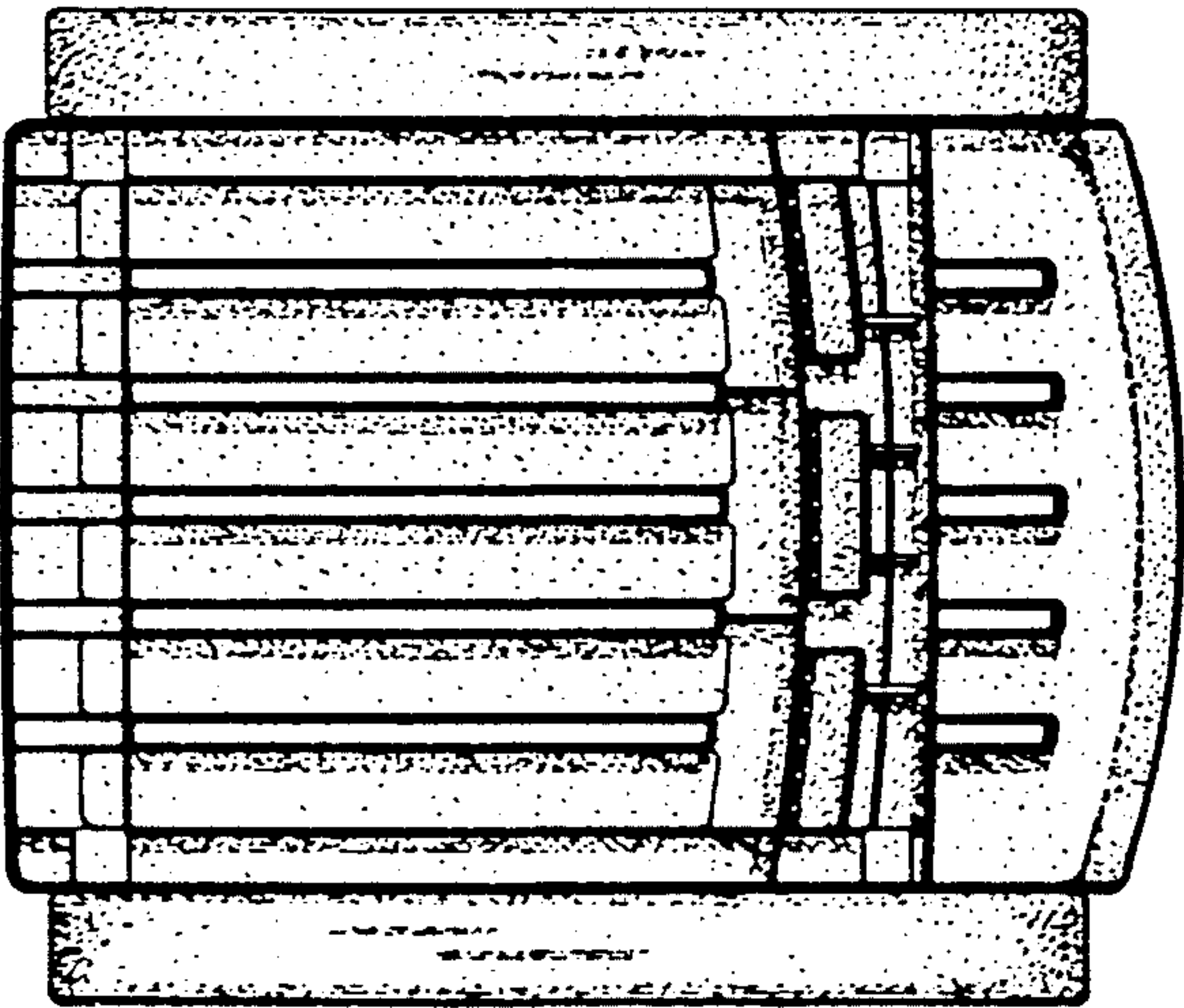

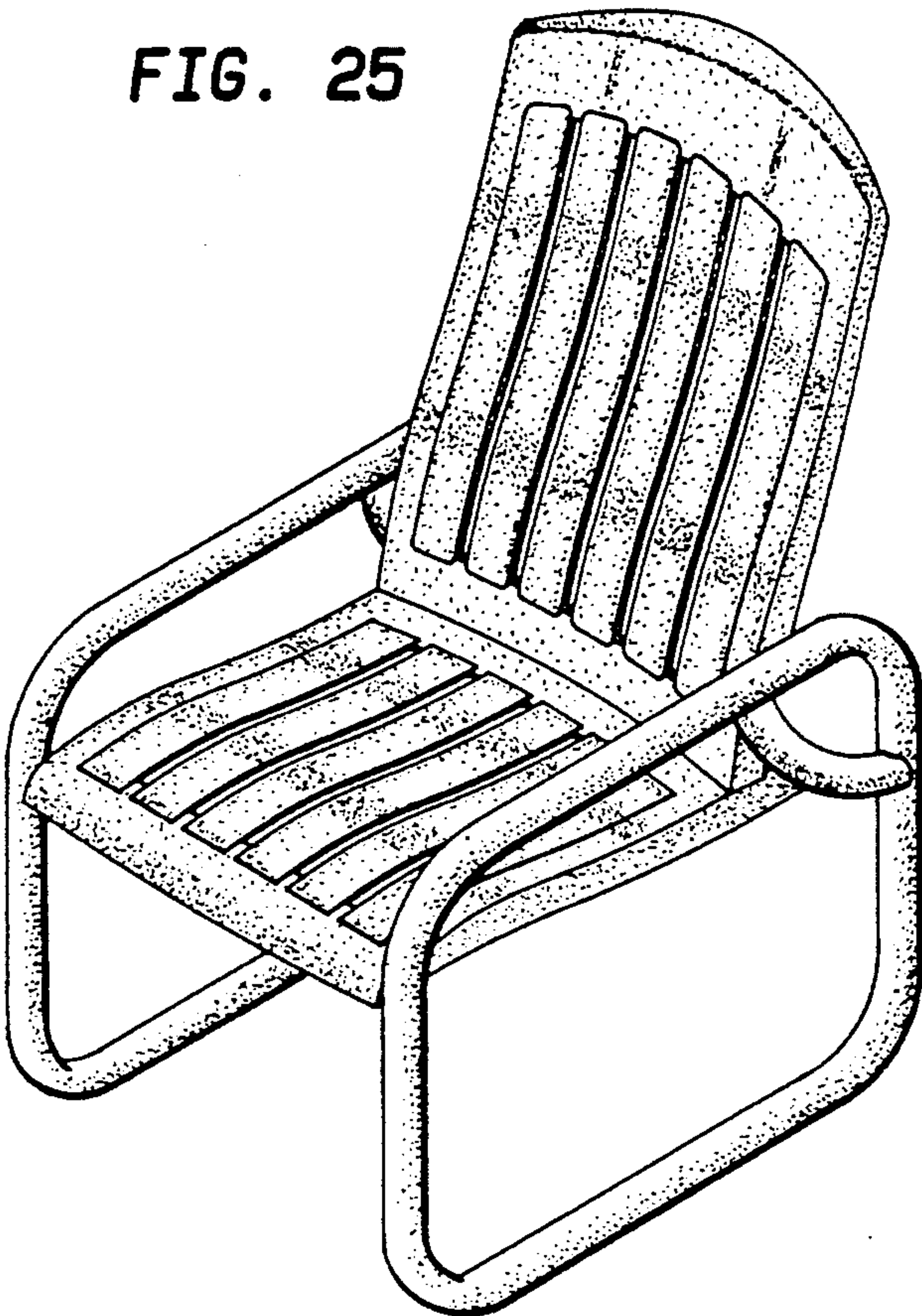


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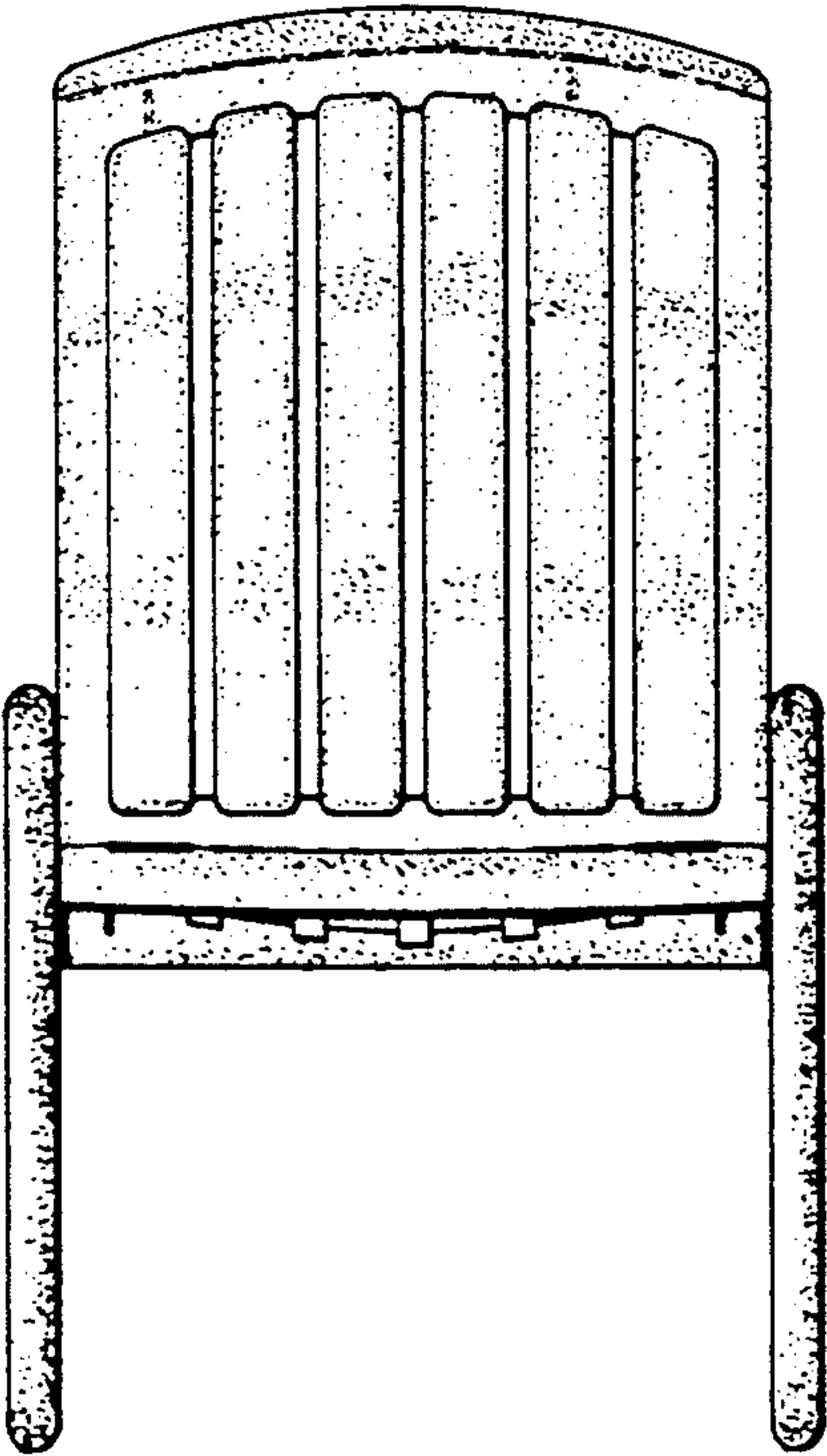

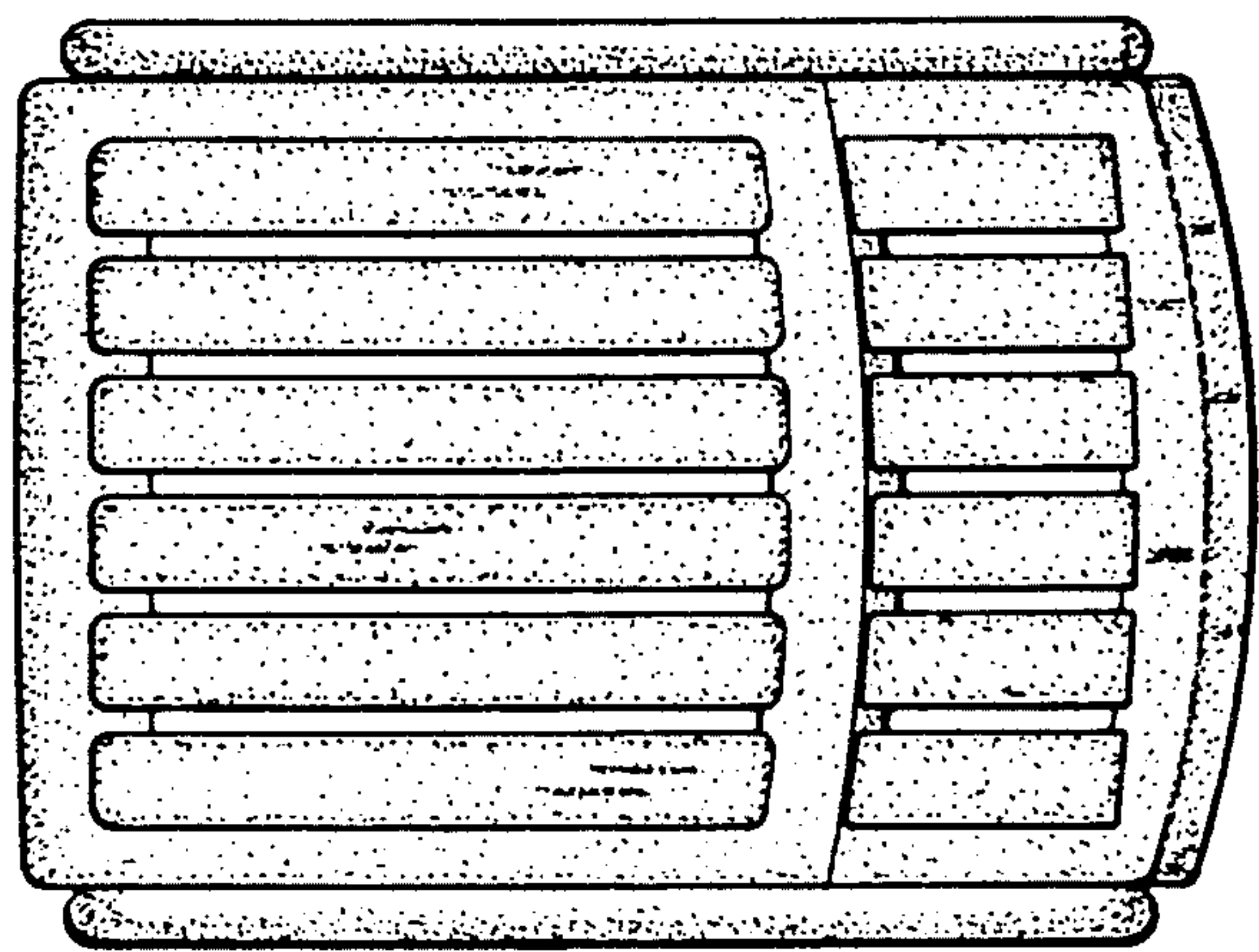

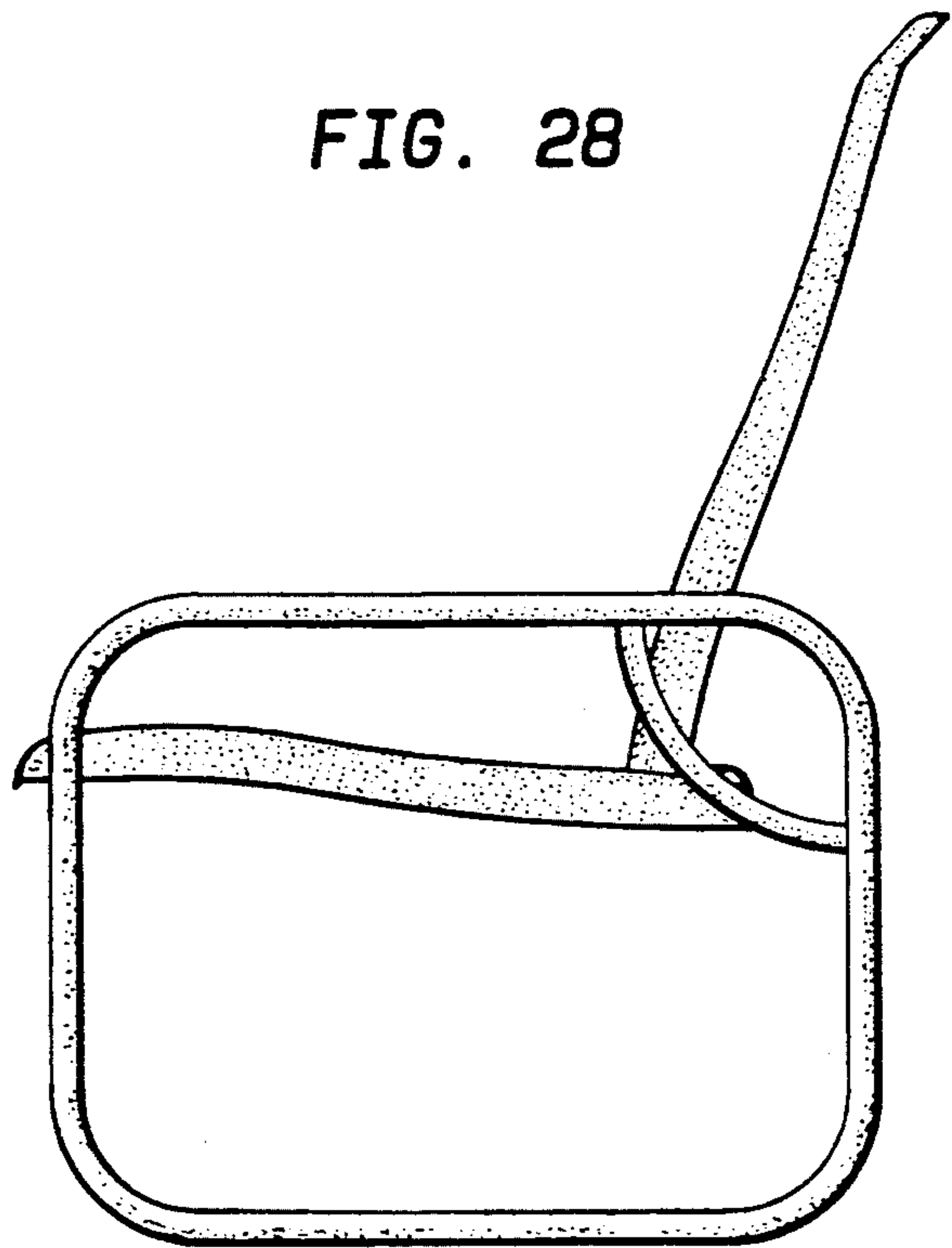


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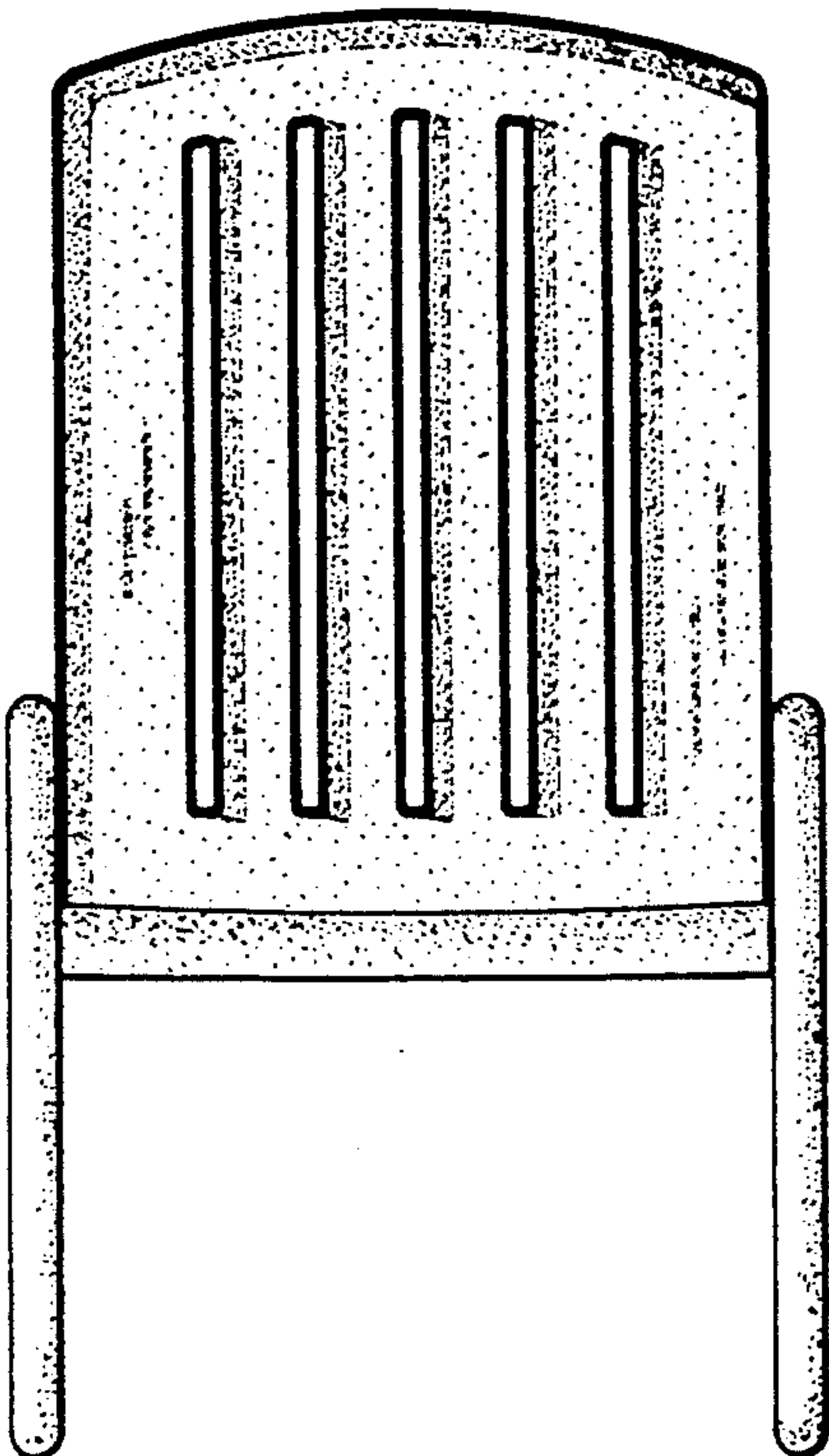


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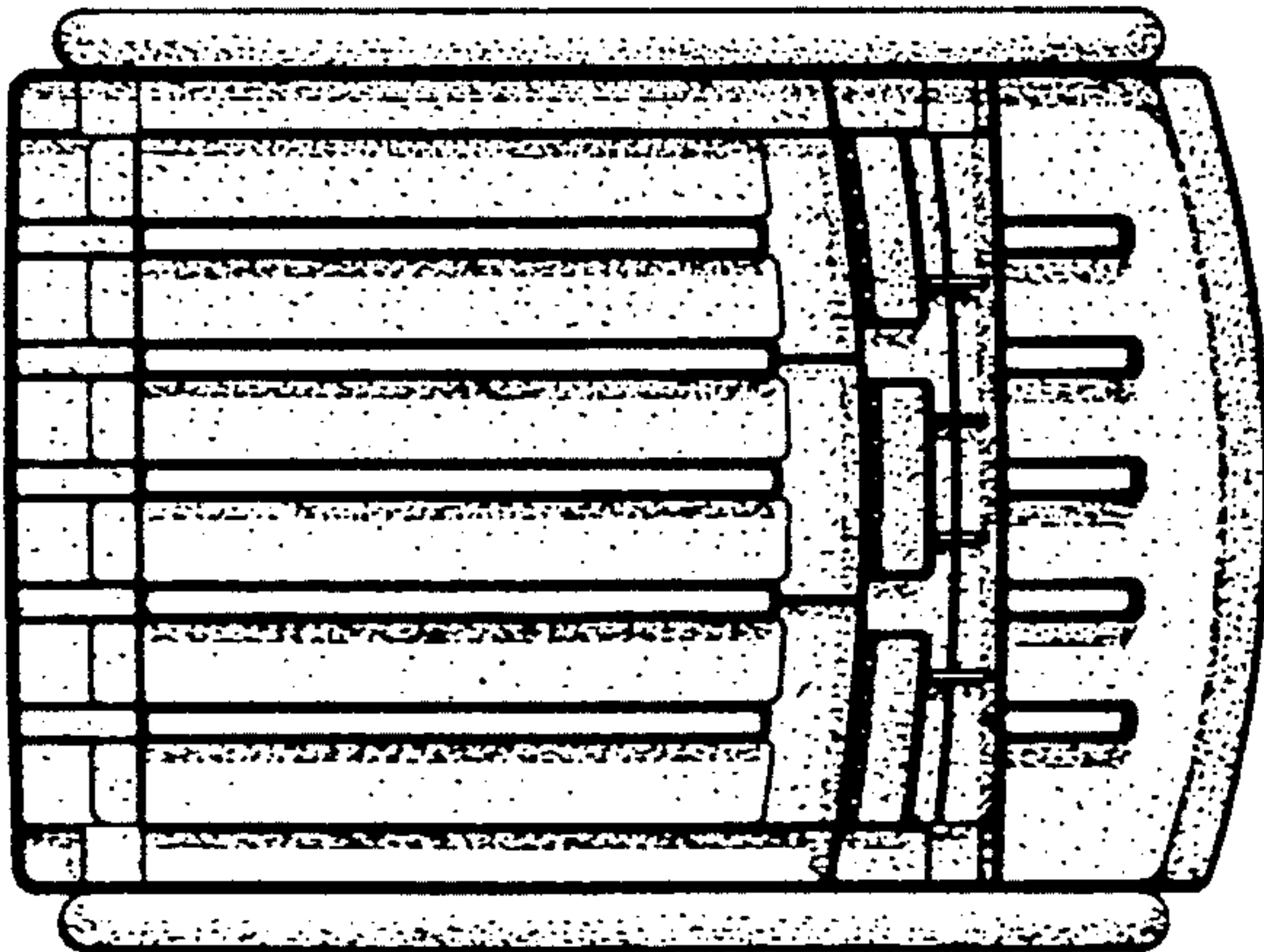


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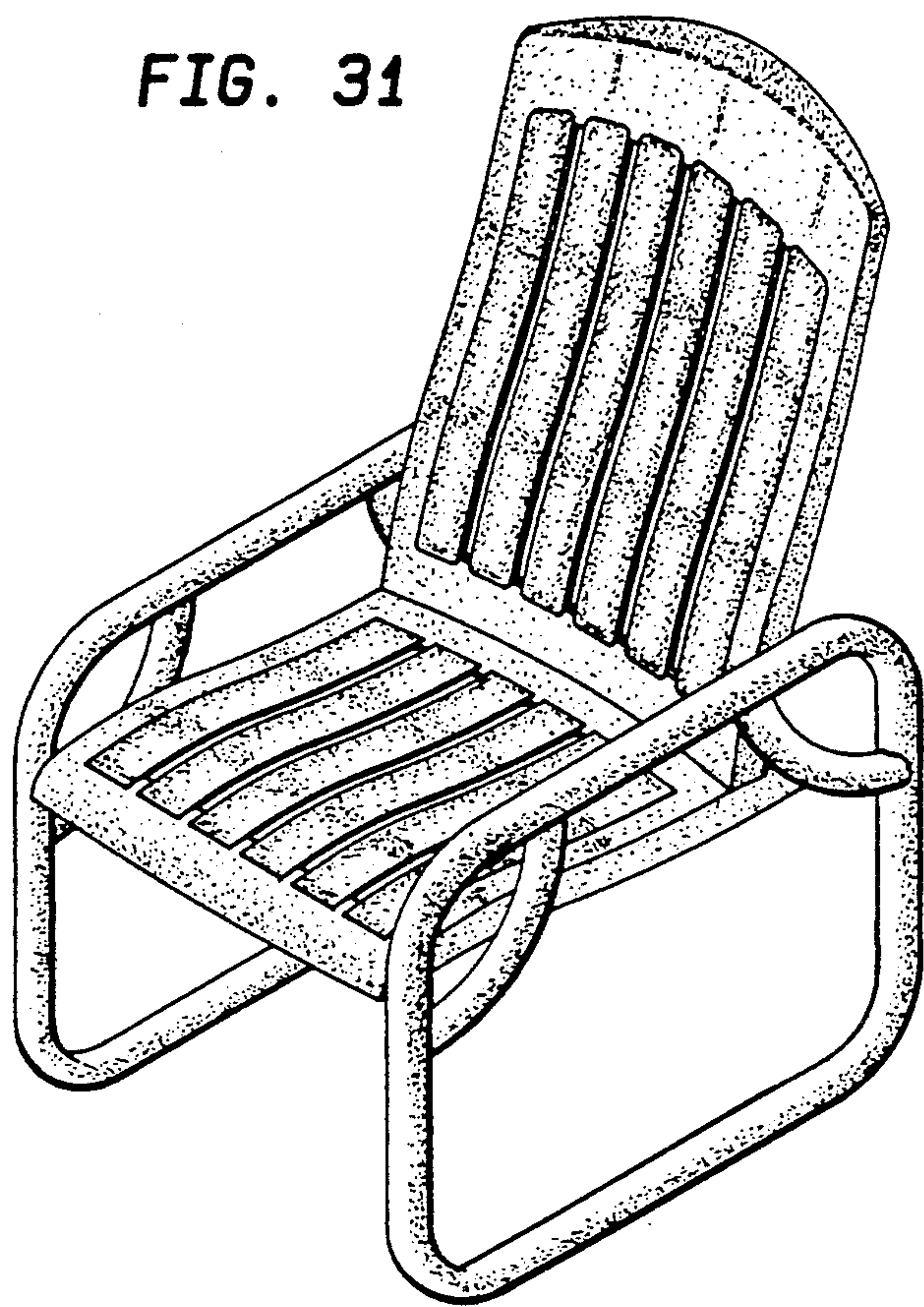

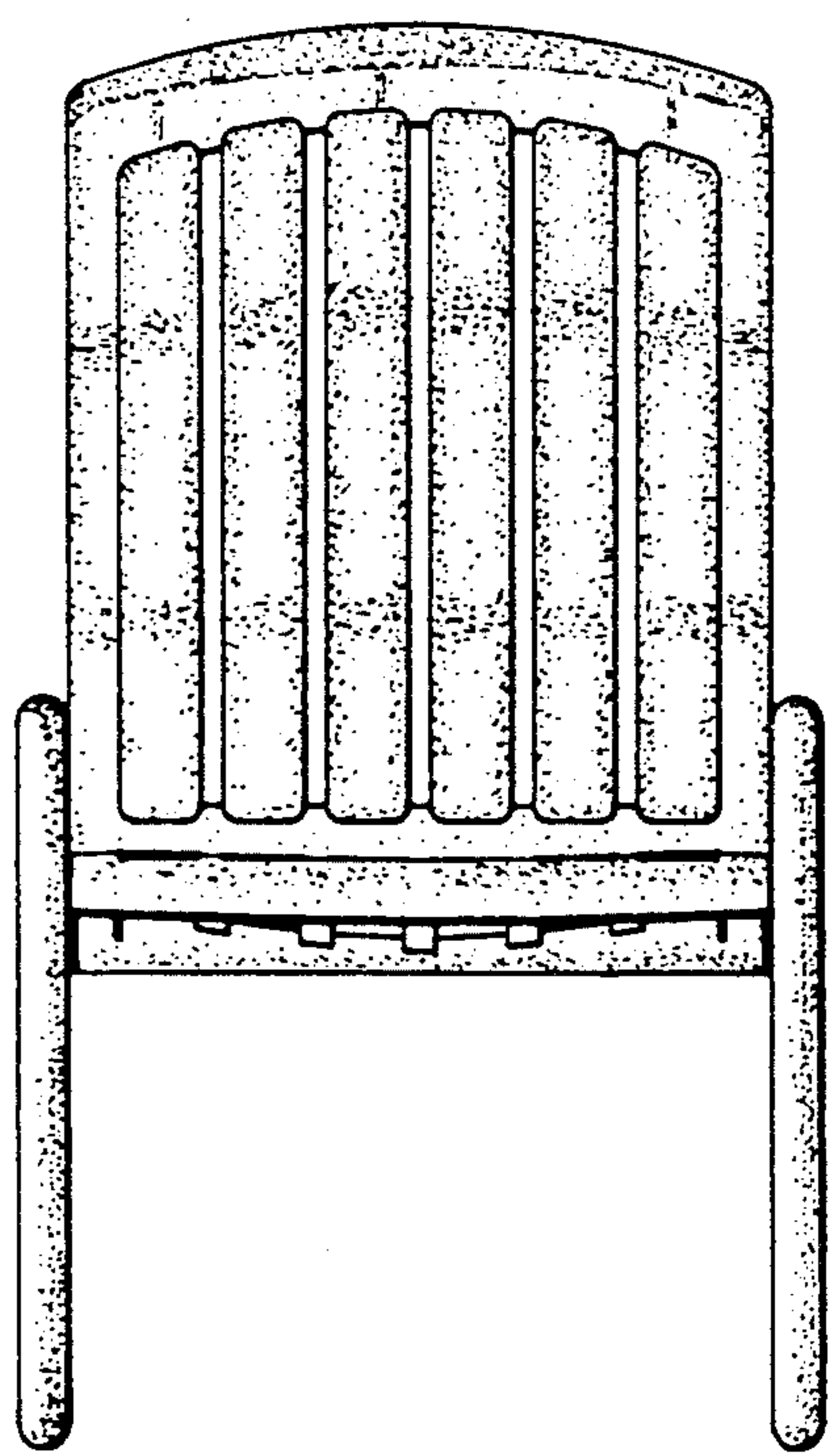

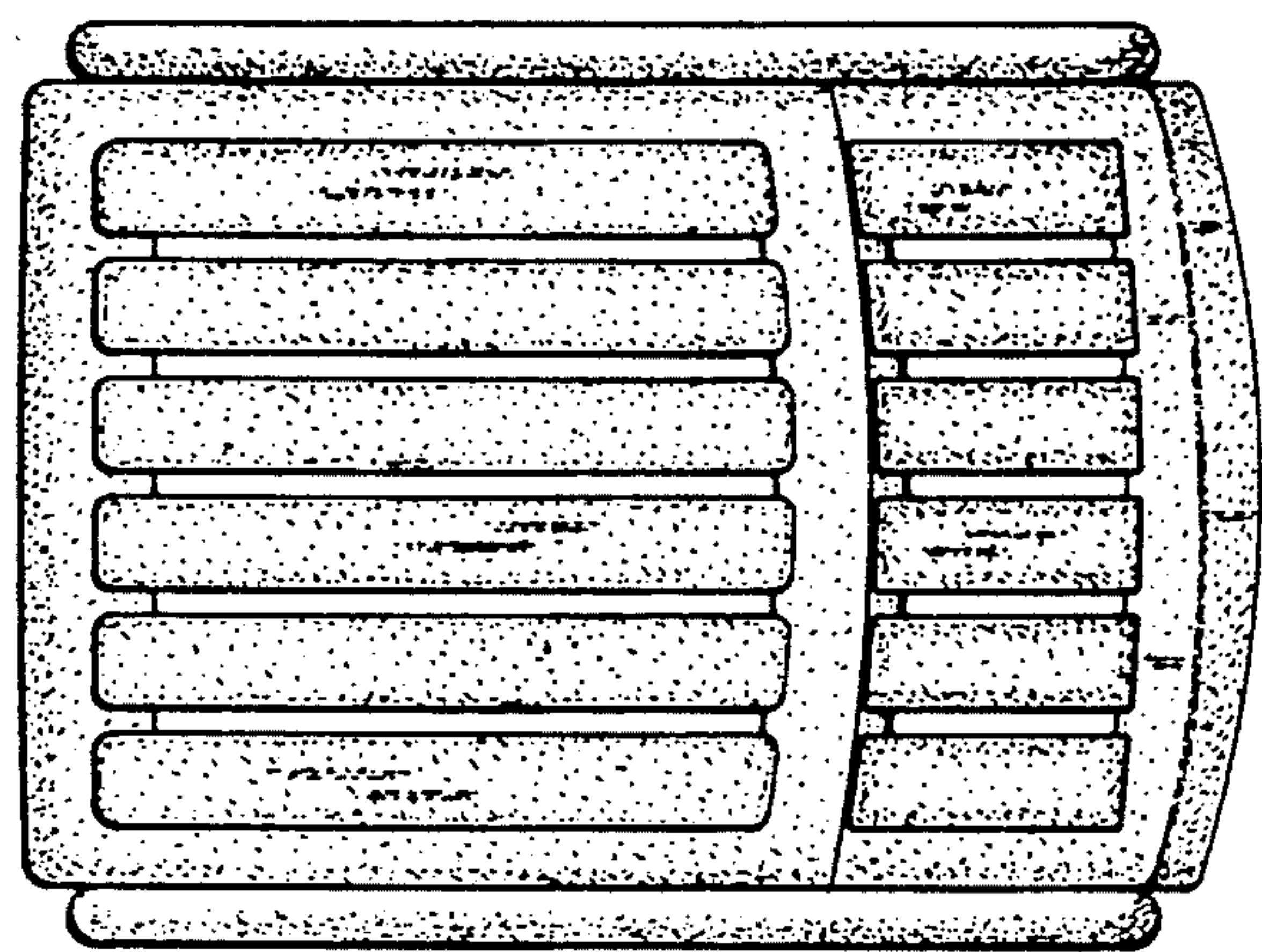

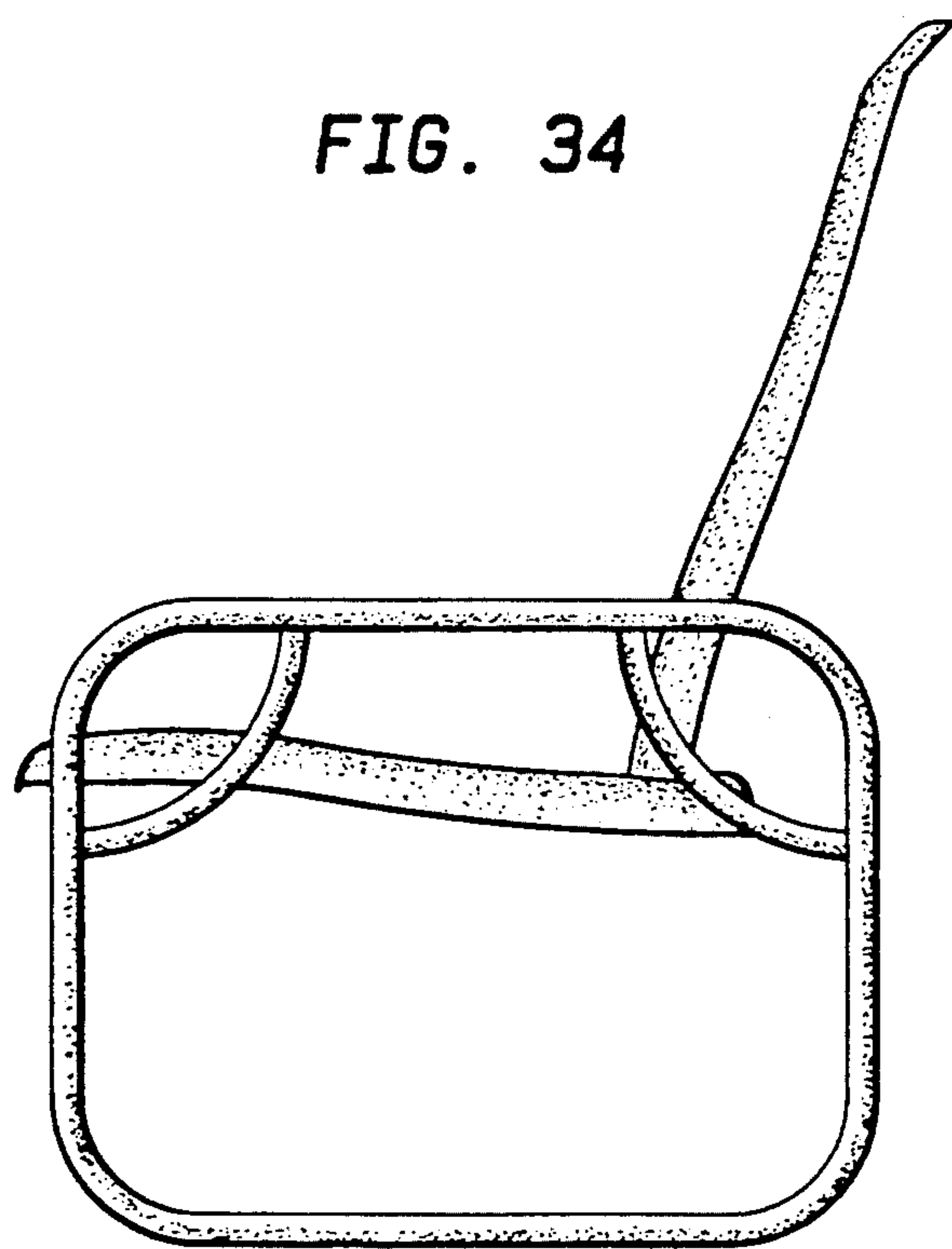

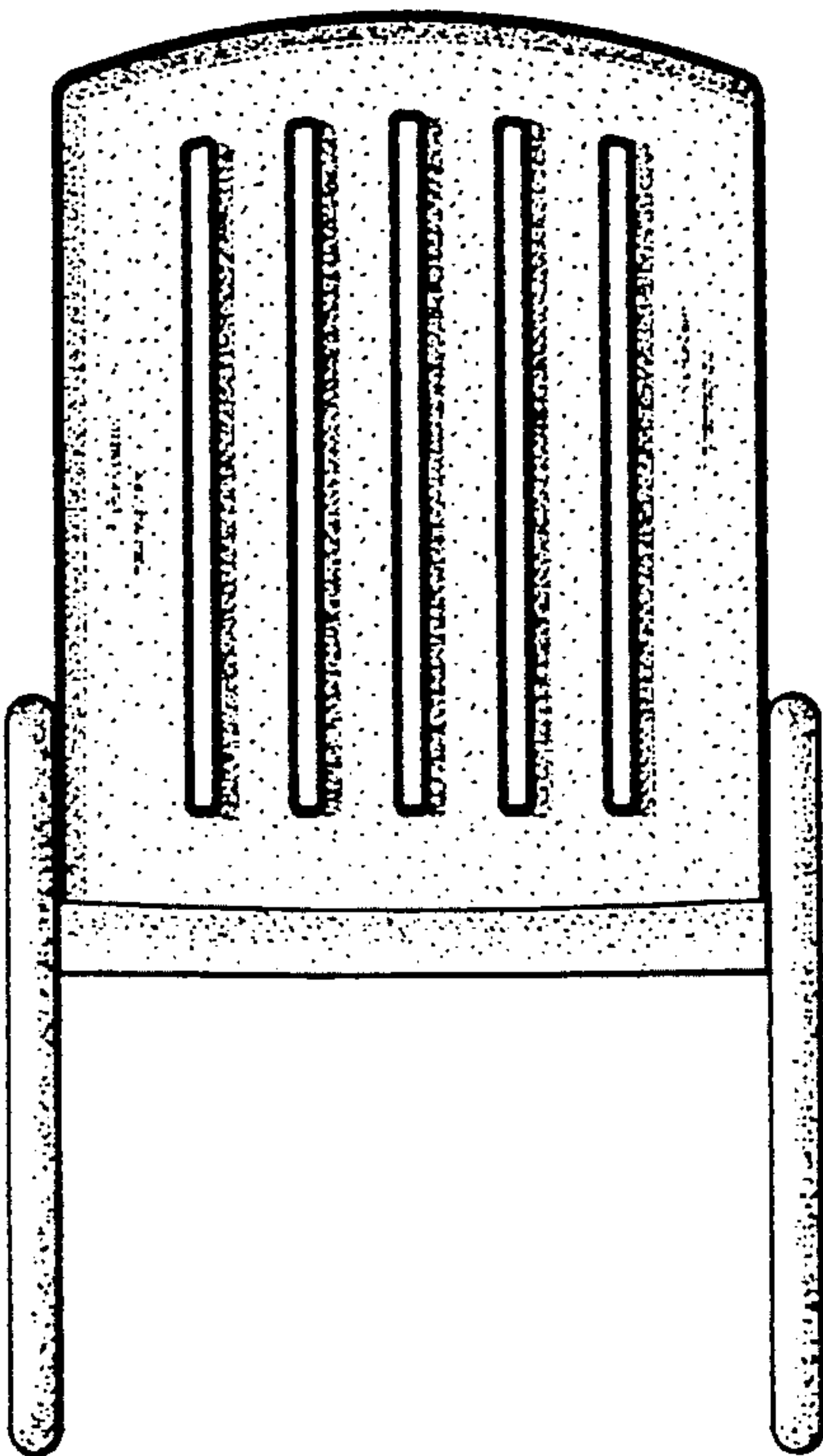
