FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

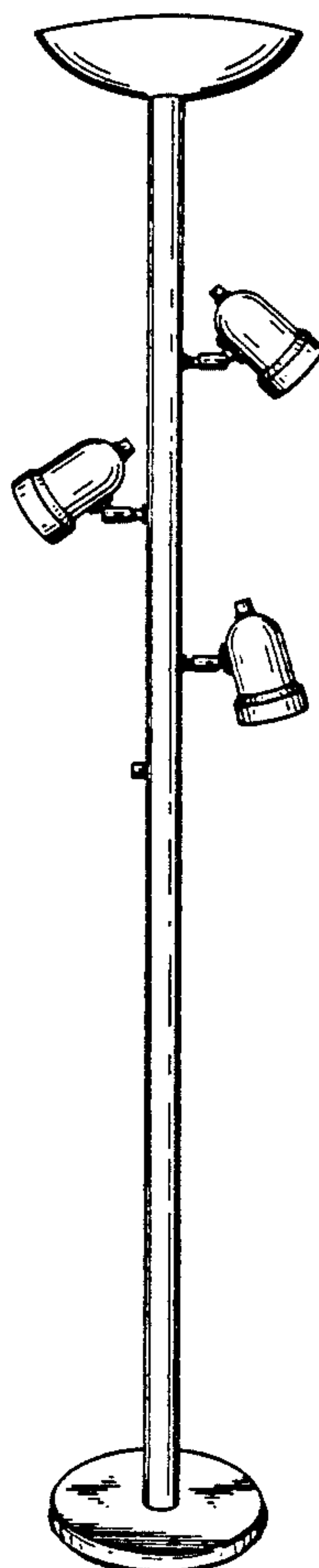
FIG. 3 is a left elevational view thereof;

being fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration.



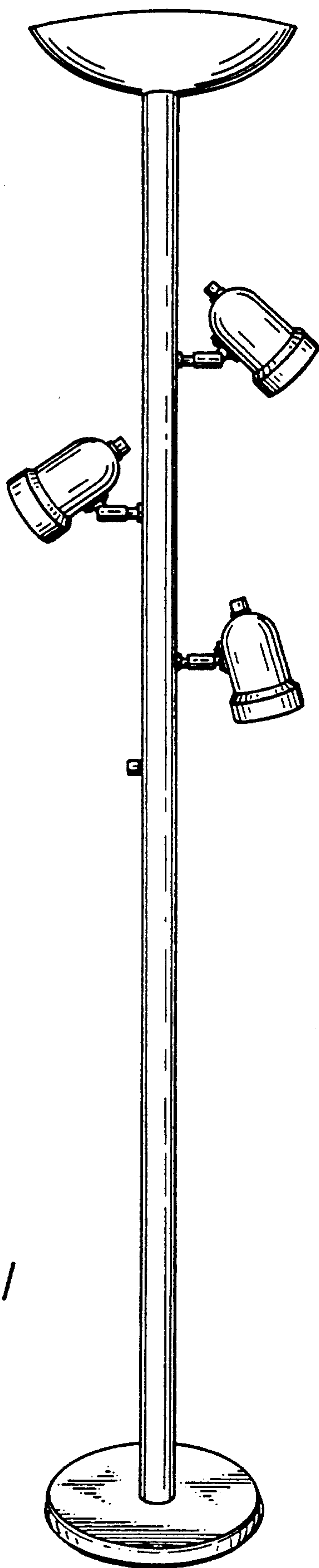

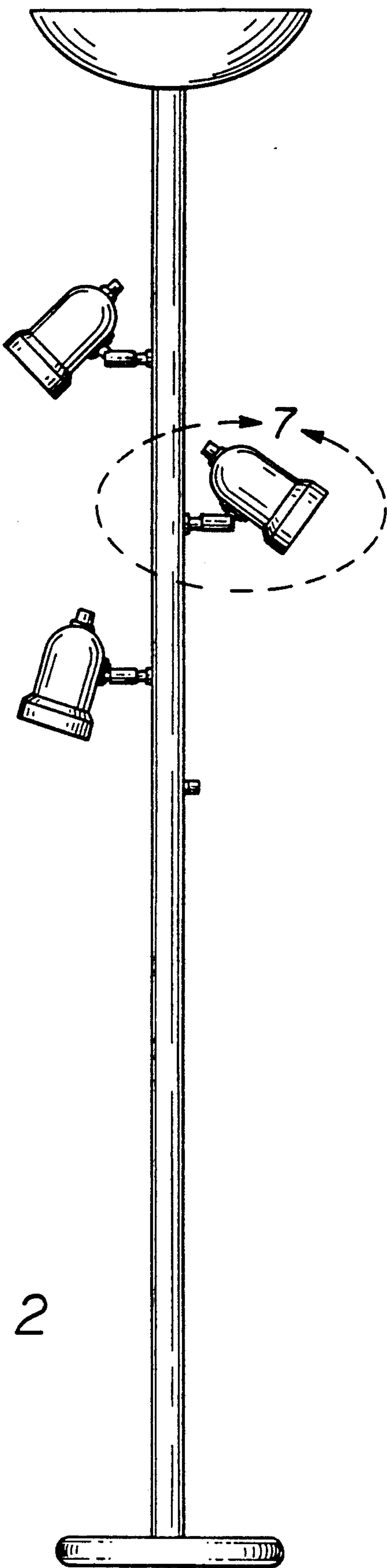
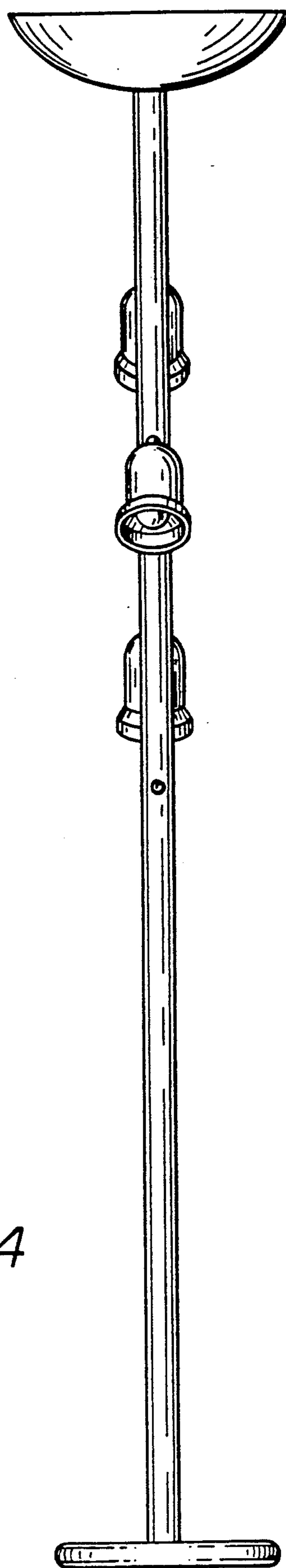
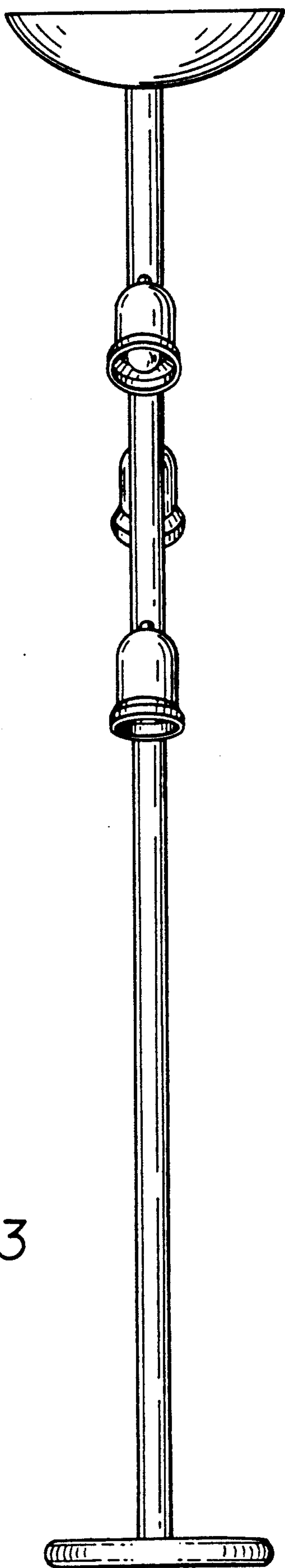

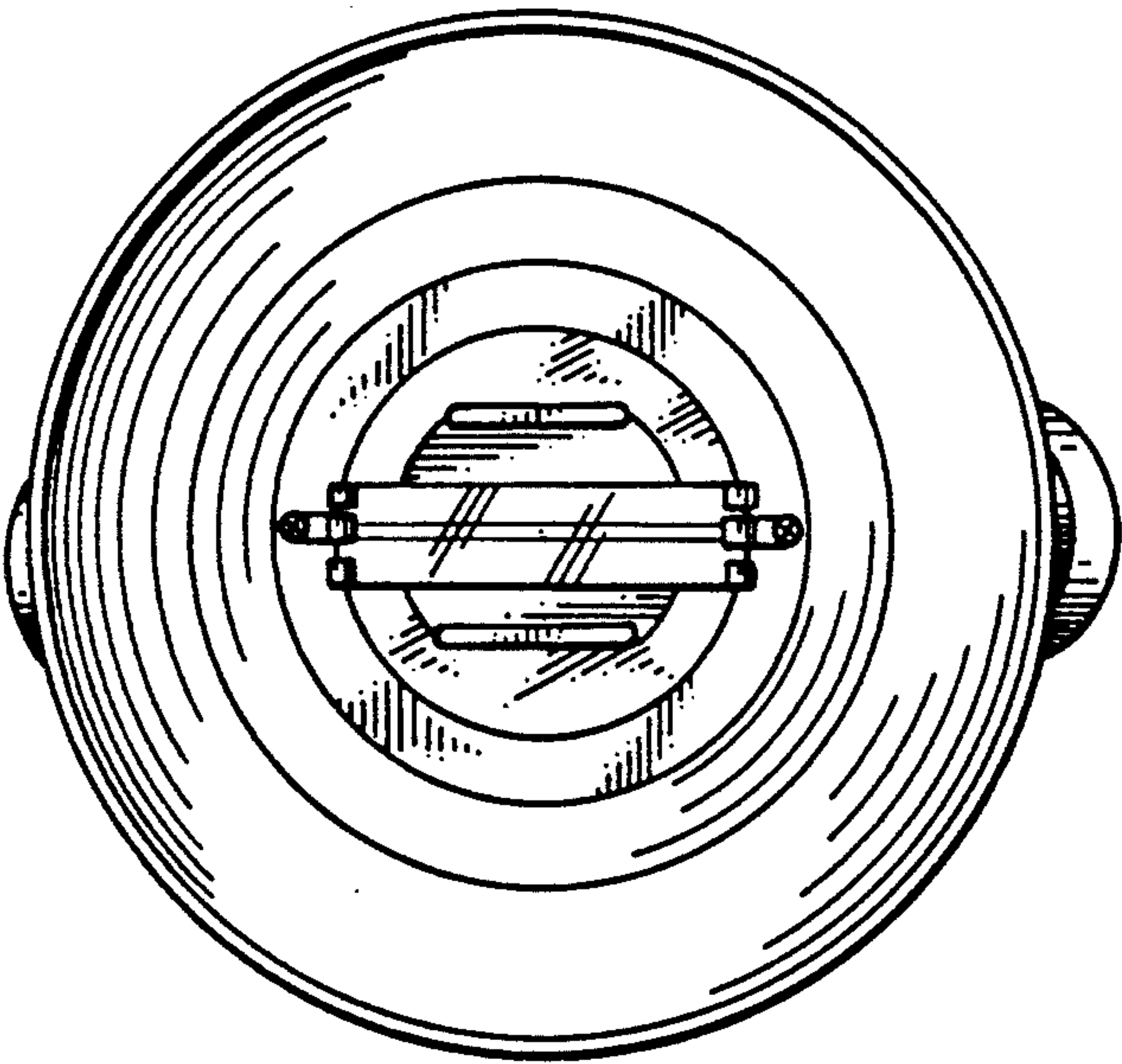

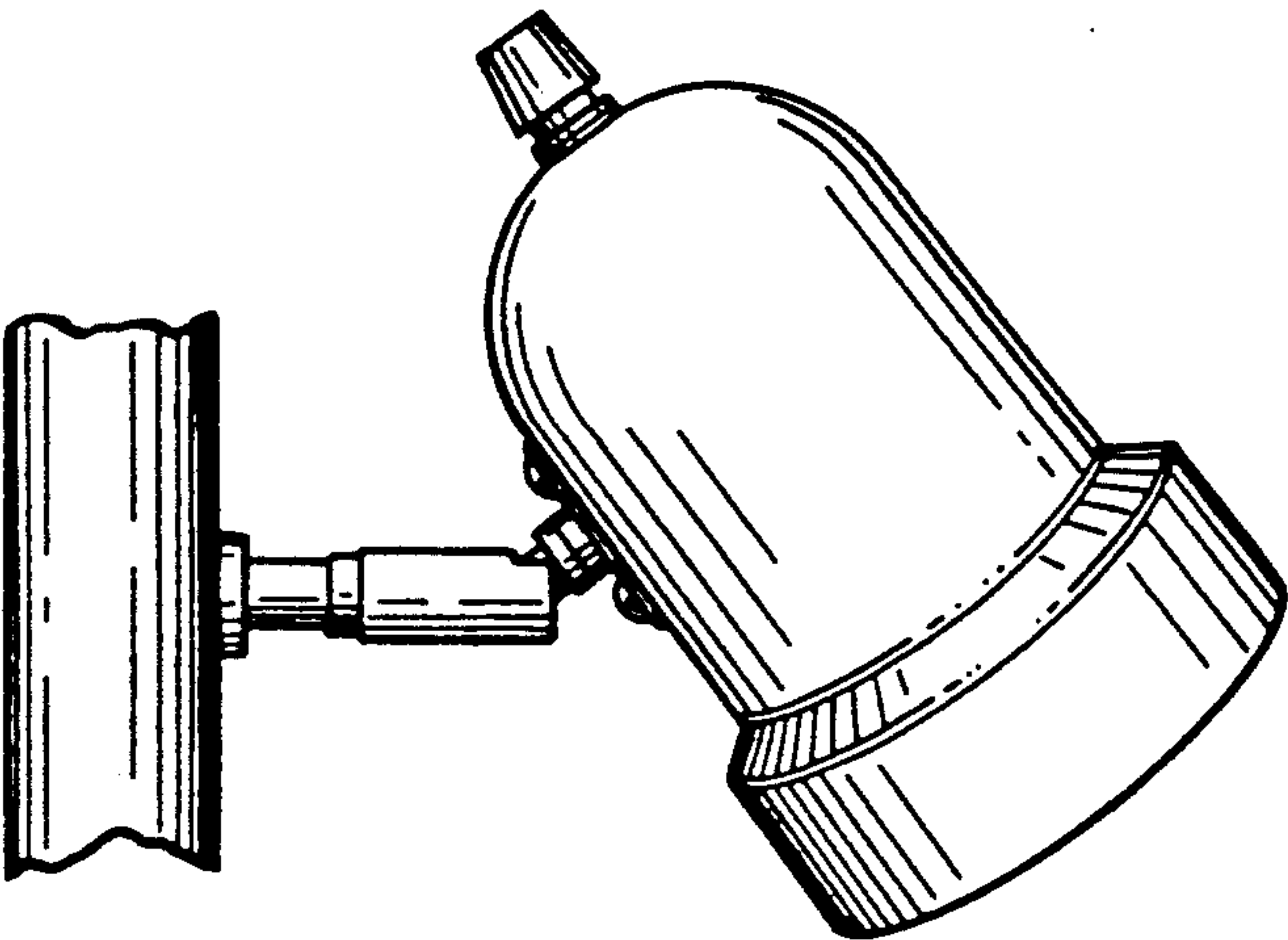
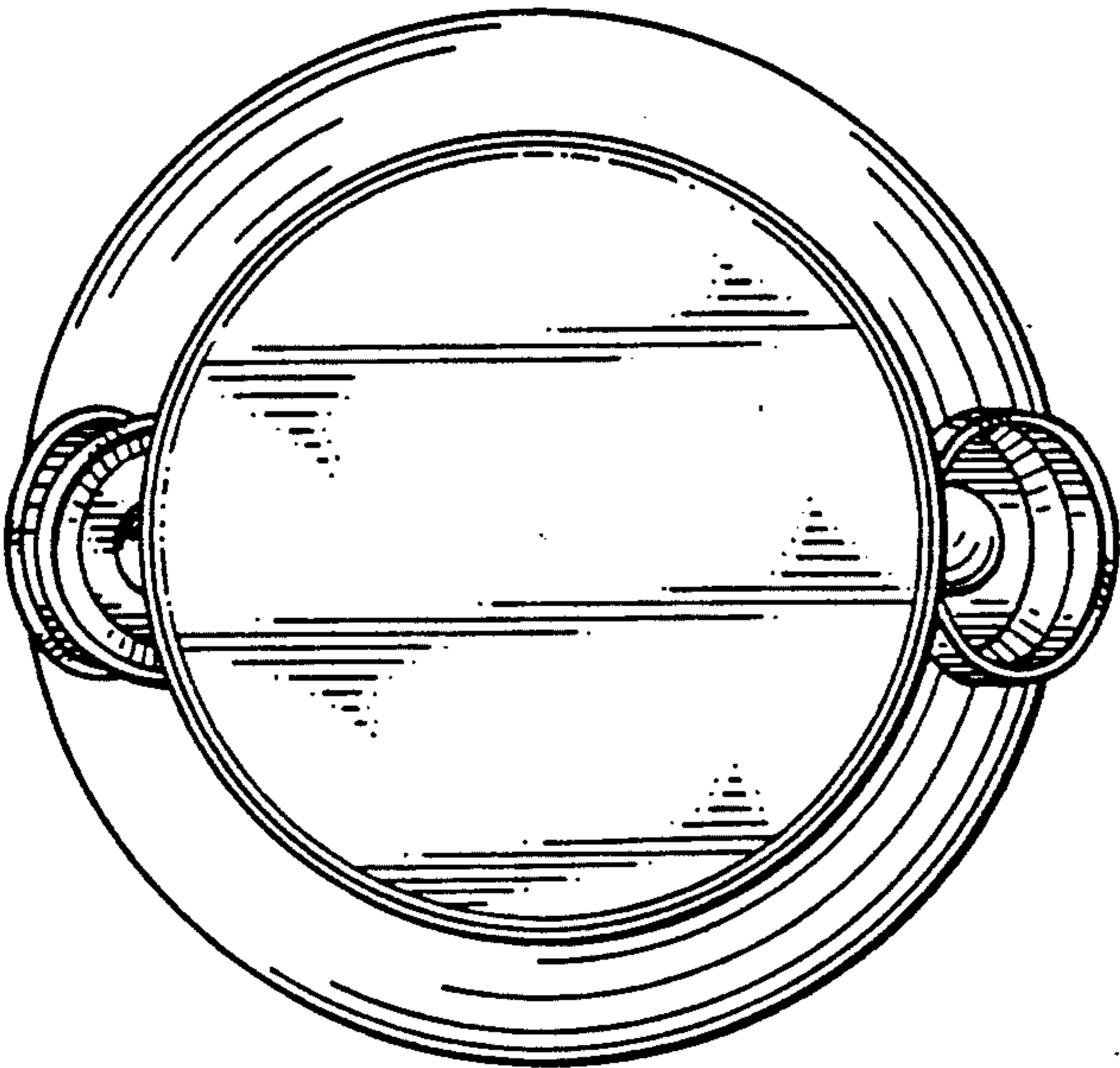
