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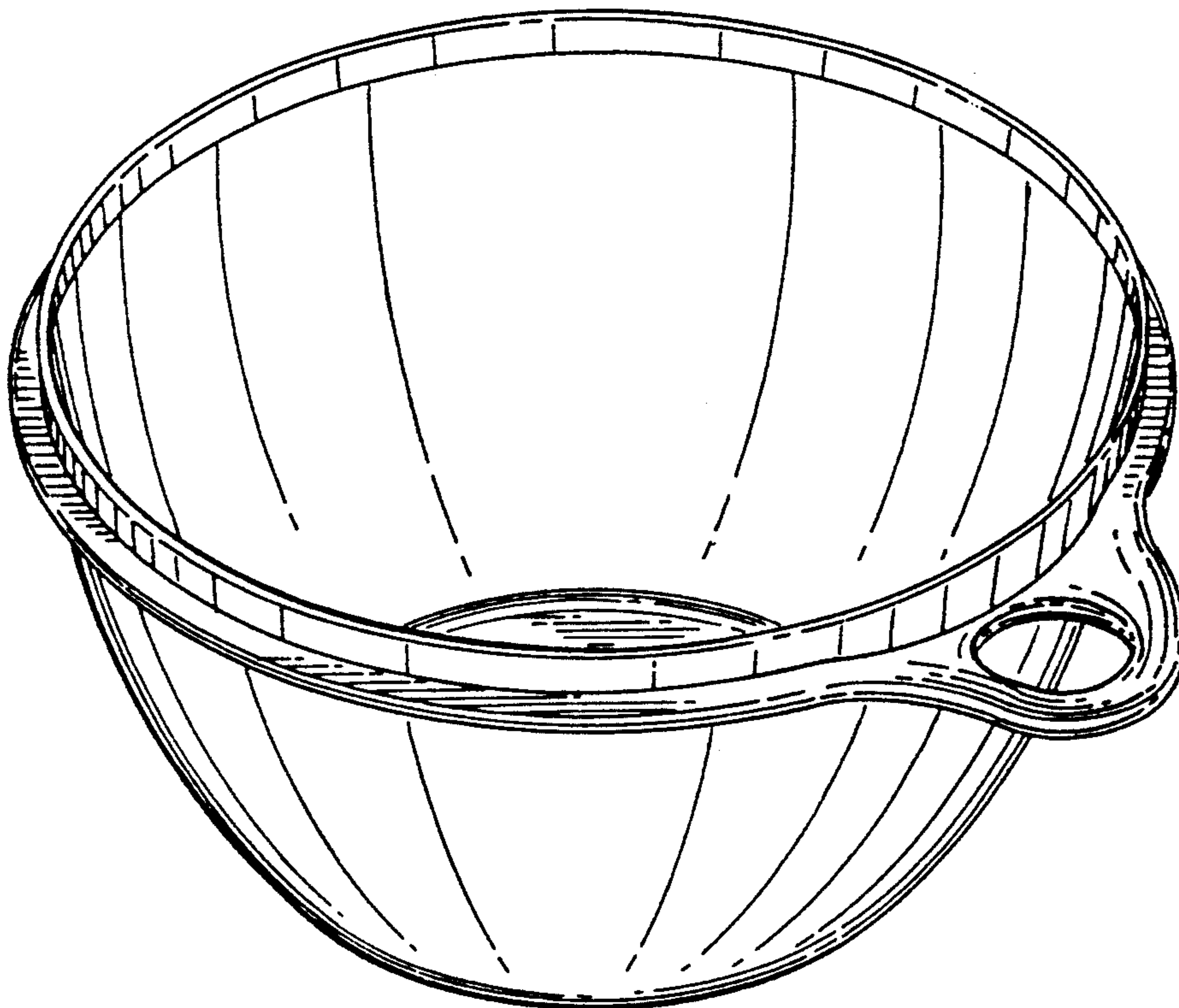

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and side perspective view of a
bowl with handle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being
a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and,
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 7—7 in
FIG. 5.



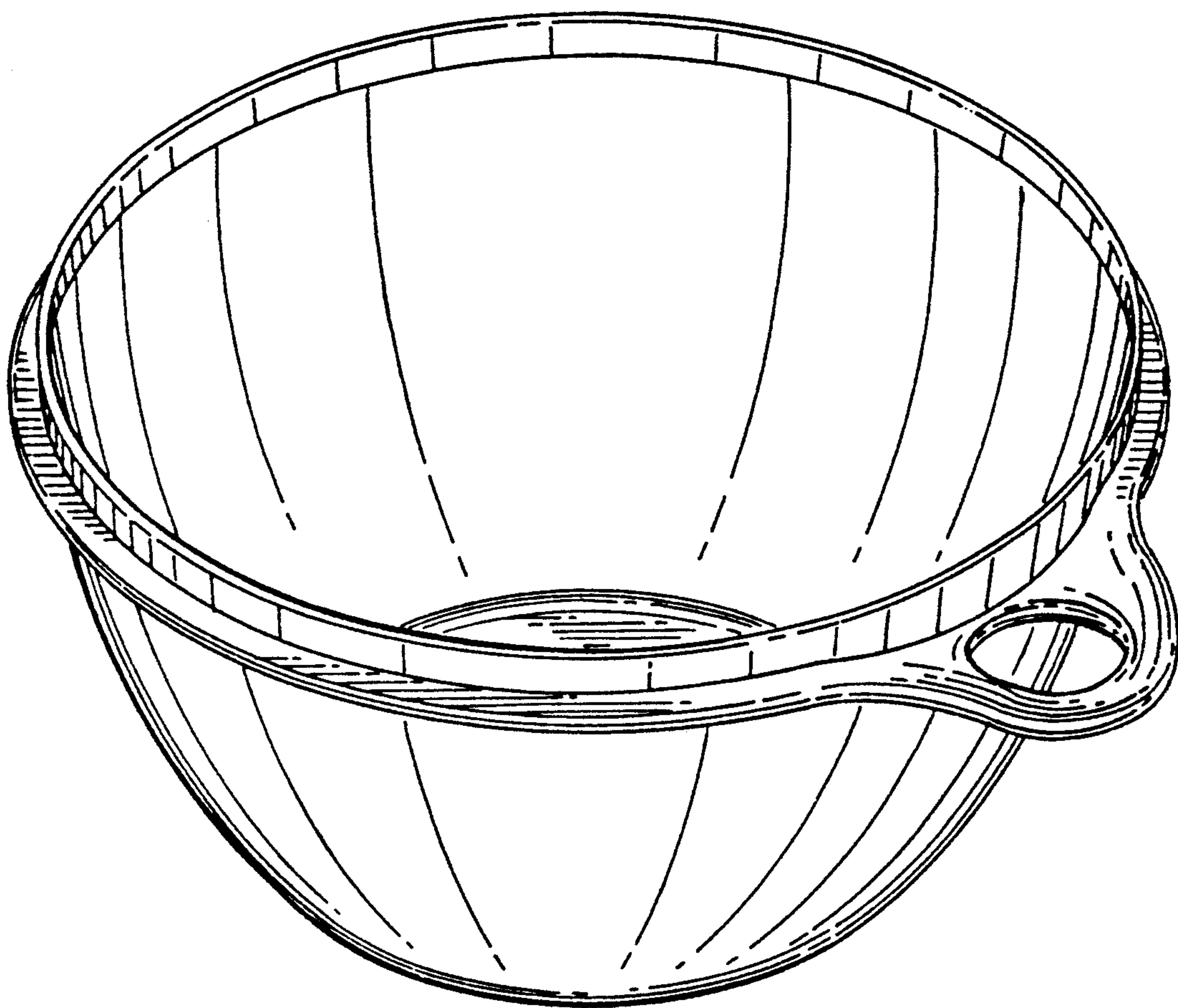

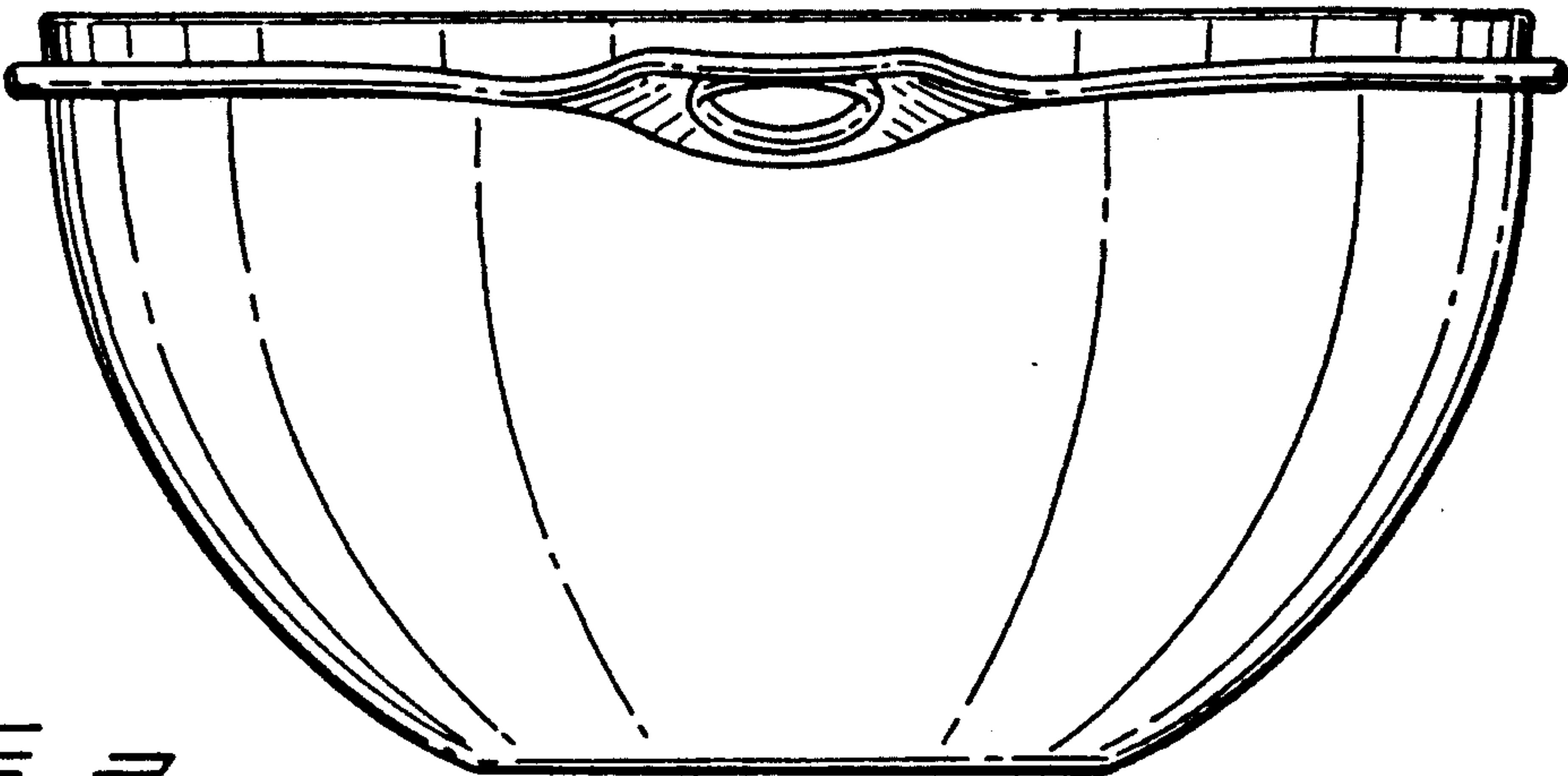

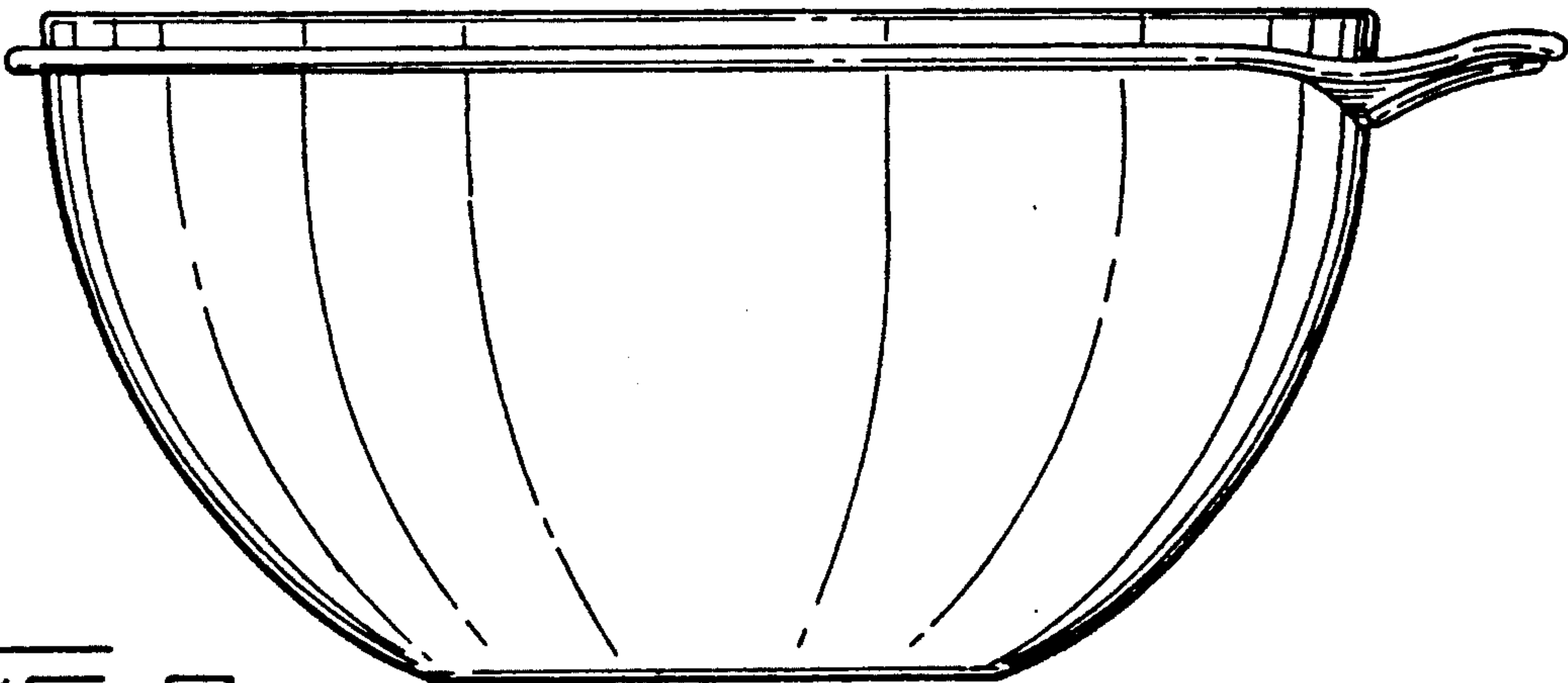

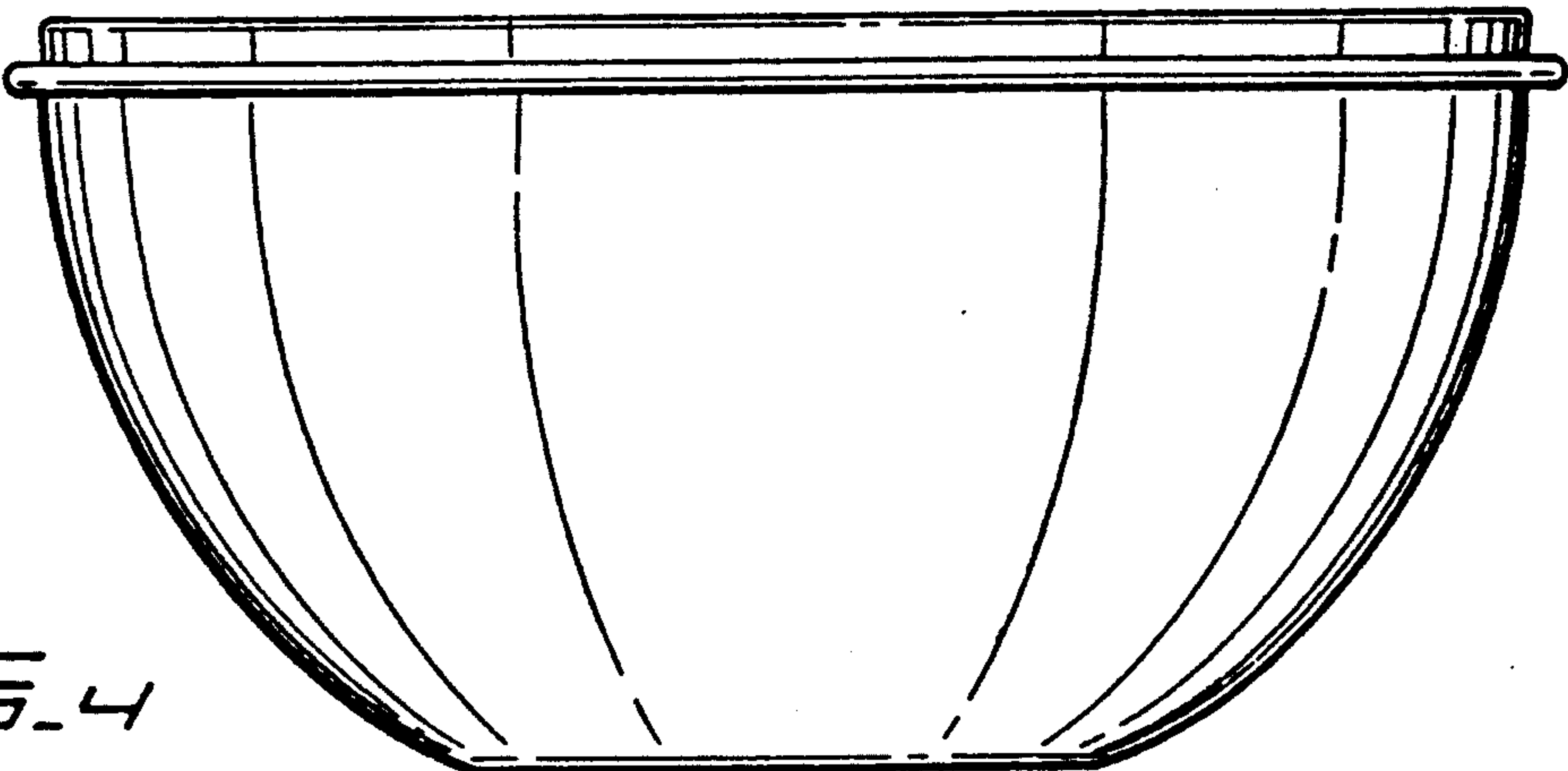
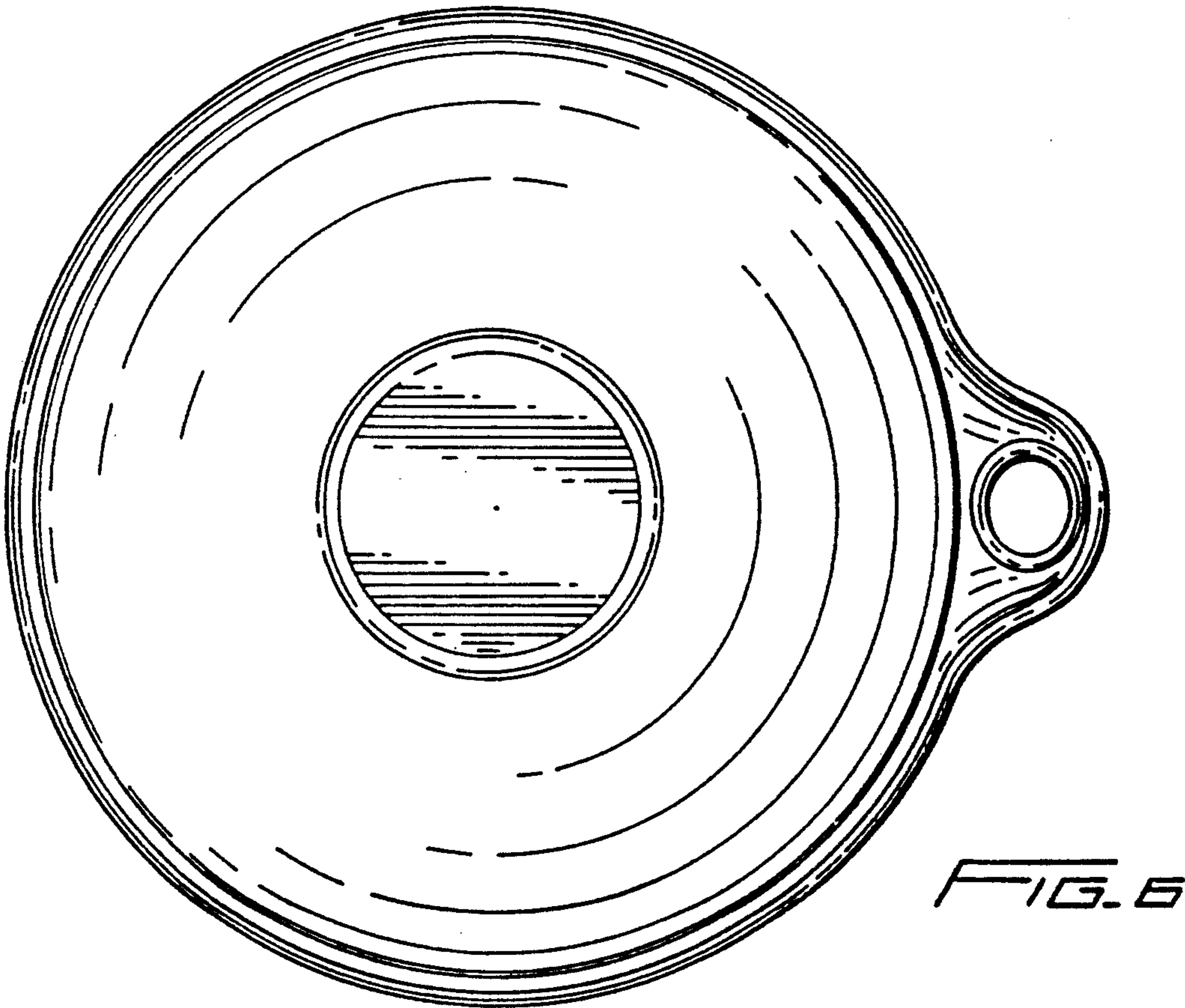
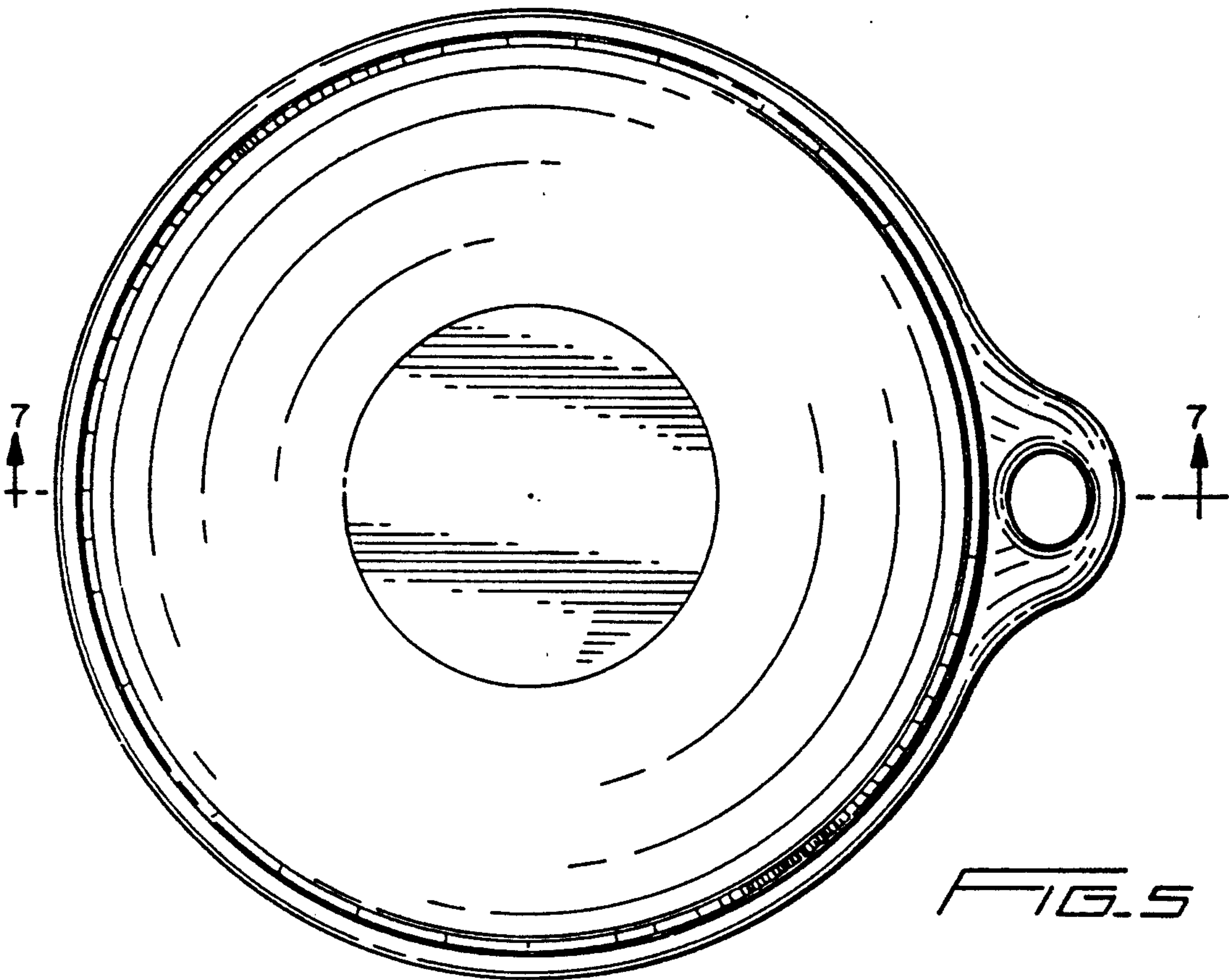

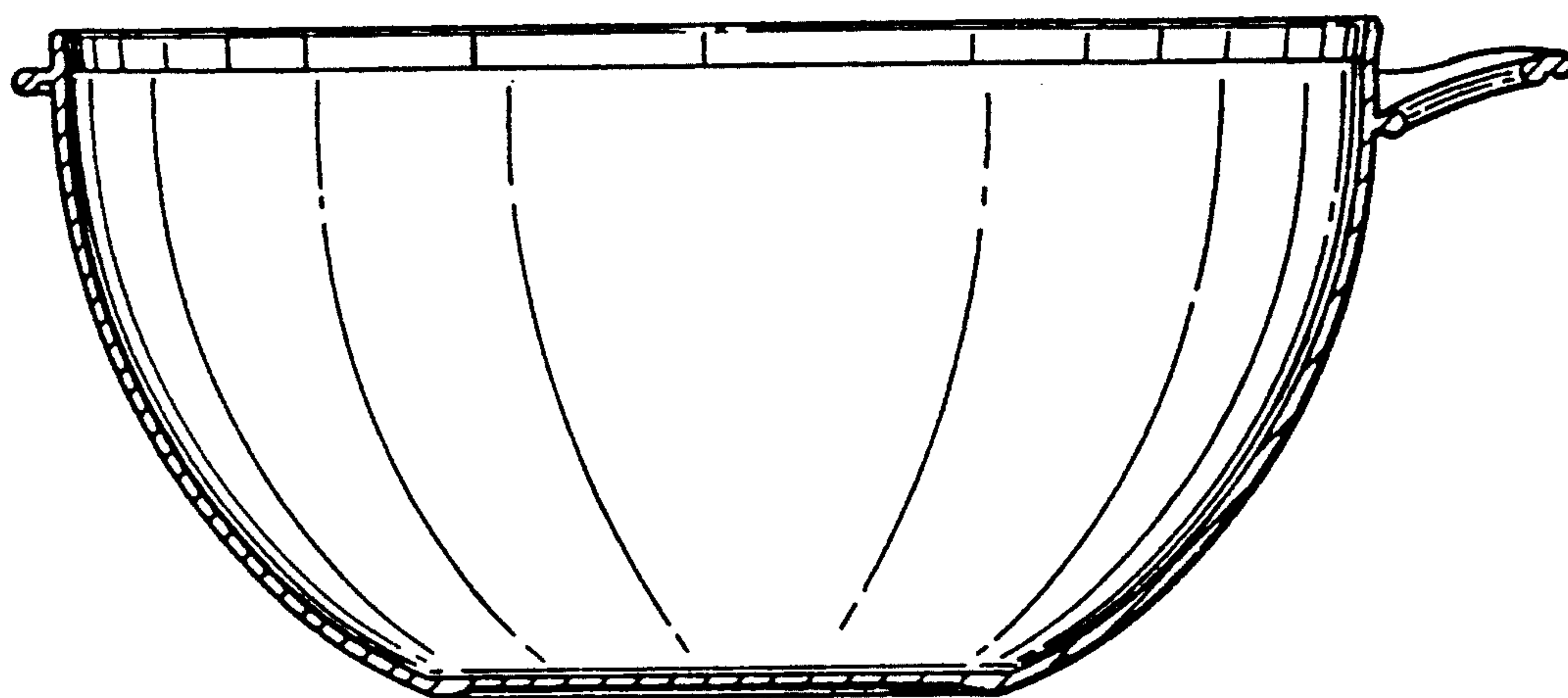
