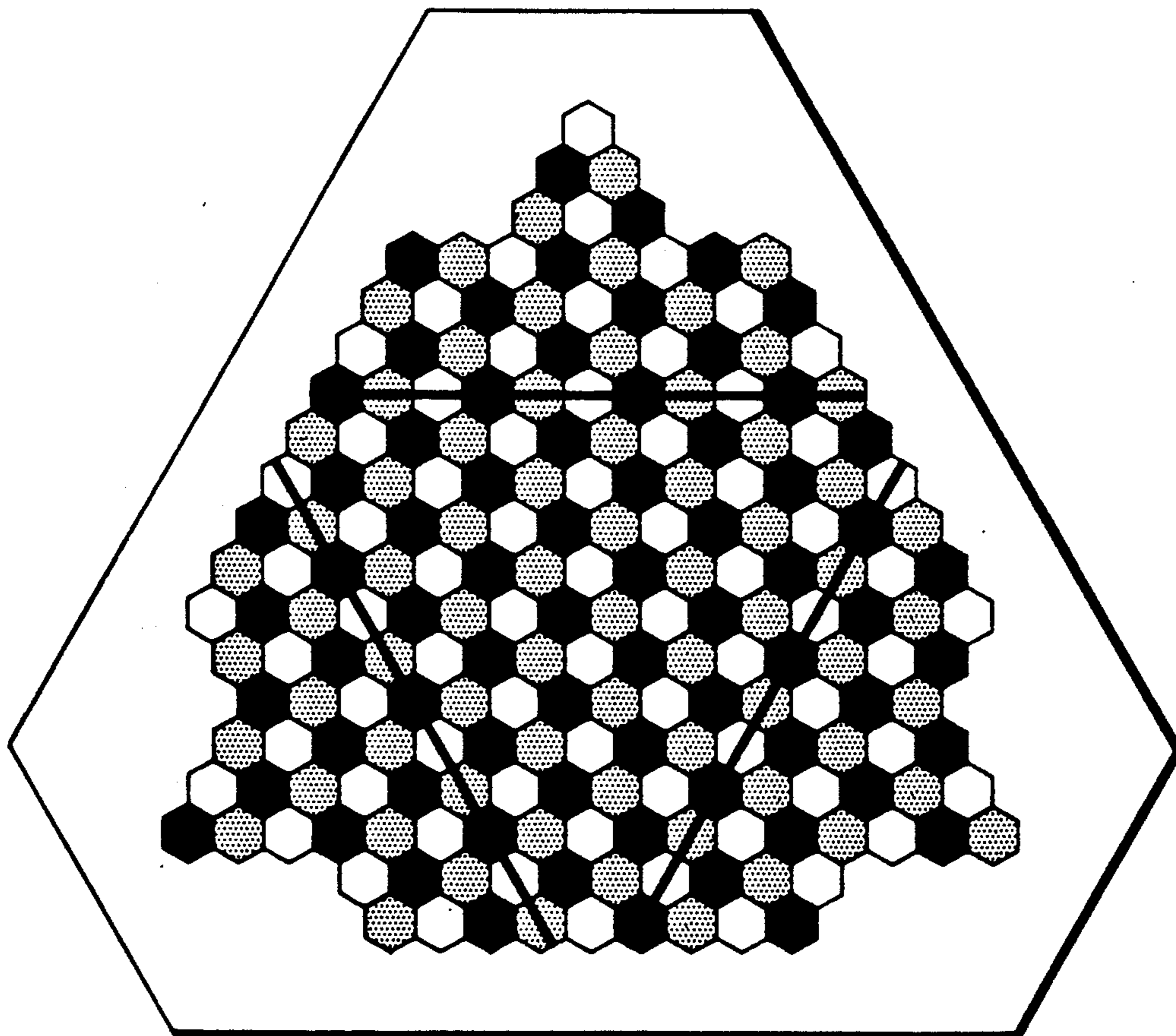

The ornamental design for a three-person chess game board, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the playing board of my three-person chess game board;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof.



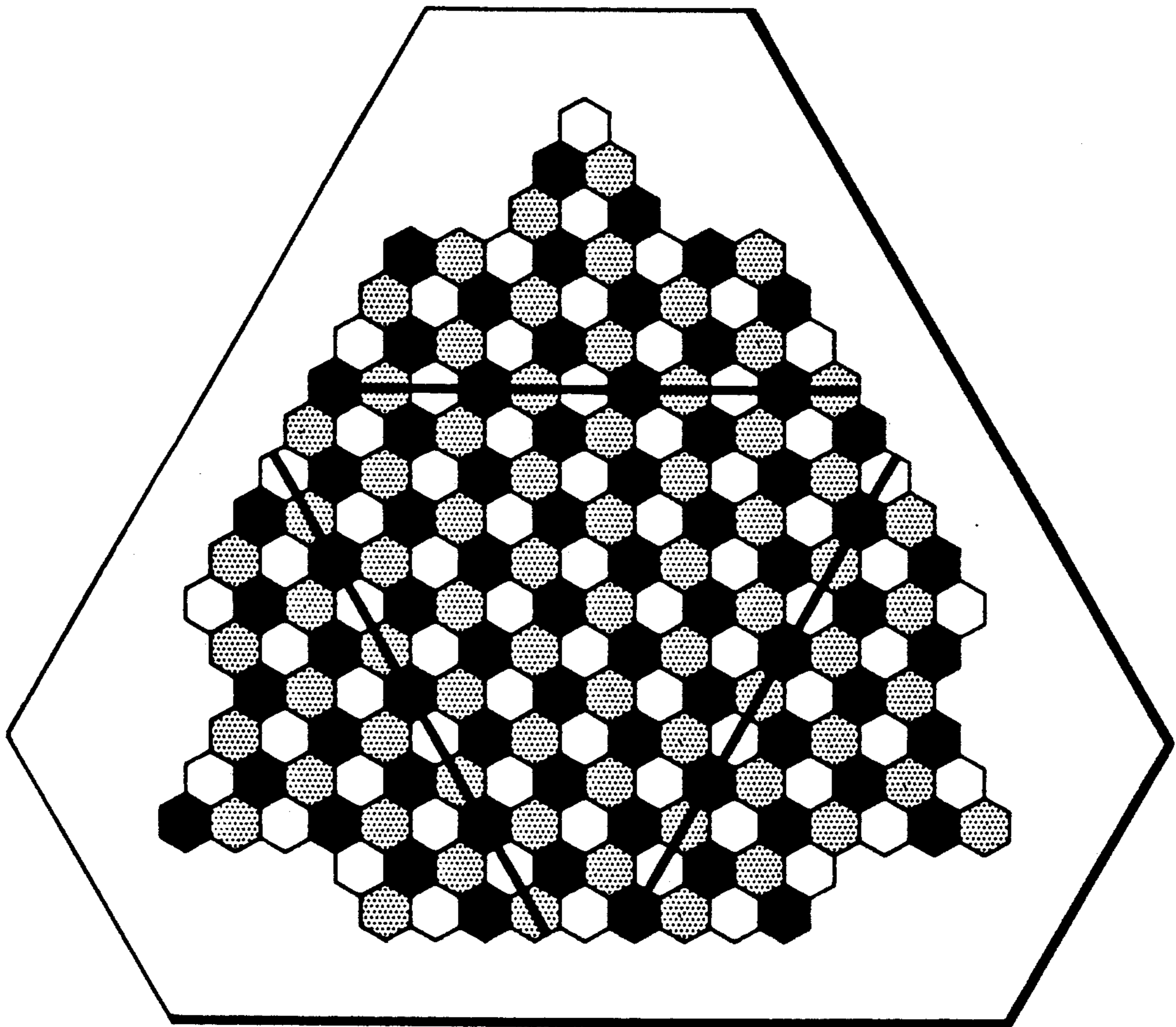

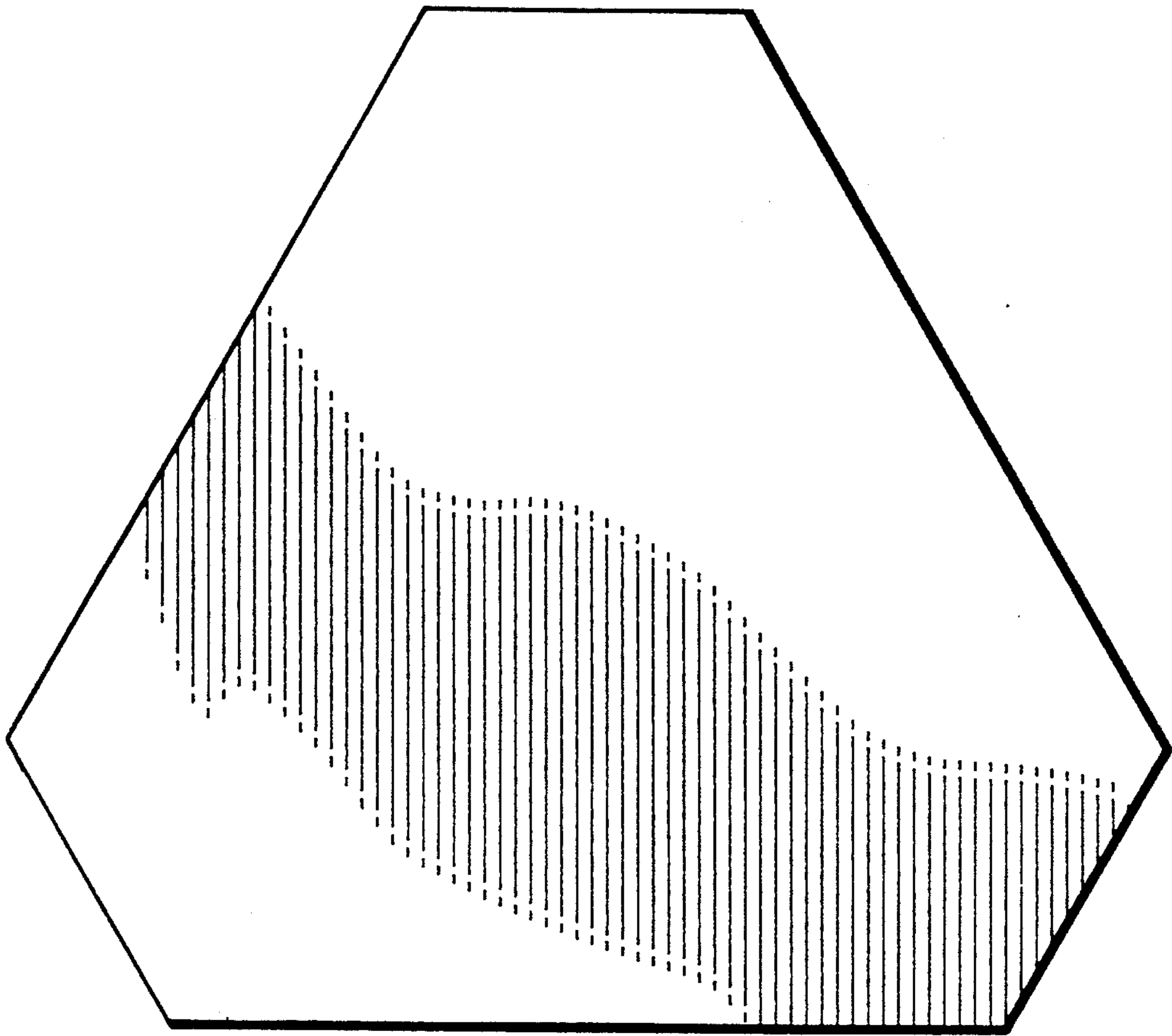
